His Death at Age of 48 at Berne Regarded as Unsettling Influence in the Near East

WAS FRIEND OF ZIONISM?

Many of His Public Statements Believed Indicative of Friendly Attitude

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERNE, Switzerland, Sept. 8—King Feisal of Iraq, who recently arrived here from Bagdad to receive medical attention, died suddenly here today following a heart attack. He was forty-eight years old. His body will be taken to Haifa on a British warship and from there to Bagdad by airplane.

IERUSALEM, Sept. 8-The Jewish Agency for Palestine today tele-graphed the royal family, the pre-mier of the kingdom of Iraq and the people of Iraq expressing the condolences of the Jewish people at the death of King Feisal. A telegram expressing the "profound sympathies" of the Jews was also dispatched to Emir Abdullah of Transjordania, elder brother of Feisal.

A telegram of condolence was also sent to the premier at Bagdad by the Vaad Leumi of Palestine (Jewish National Council).

Third son of the Sheriff of Mecca and Ruler of the Hejaz, Feisal came into prominence during the World War when, with "Lawrence of Arabia", he organized the Arab revolt against their Turkish rulers. The Paris Peace Conference failed to give him the Arab throne which he claimed had been promised him for his services in behalf of the Allies, and he returned to Damascus and

proclaimed himself king of Syria.

The French, who had been given the Syrian mandate, ousted him. In a plebiscite the following year in the newly-founded state of Iraq, Feisal (Continued on Page 11)

Rathenau Society To Dissolve Itself

Nazis Erect Statues Honoring Slayers of Martyr, So Group Breaks Up

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Sept. 8—The Rathenau Society, founded in memory of Walter Rathenau, first minister of foreign affairs in the German Republic, resolved to dissolve itself on September 27. The property remaining after the publication of the com-plete works of Rathenau is to be used for helping the German dis-

Walter Rathenau, statesman, in-dustrialist, author, banker and nat-uralist, became after the Revolution of 1918, one of the chief figures in Germany and the first minister of foreign affairs.

He was a descendant of an old established Jewish family and was born in Berlin. After a career in the commercial field that involved international banking and the founding of the Allgemeine Elektrizitat Gesselschaft, one of the largest trusts in the world, he turned to statesmanship. His brilliant efforts to break the ring of enemies around Germany were acclaimed by all thinking Germans but the bullets of a reactionary murder band ended his life on June 24, 1922.

Rathenau was hailed as a martyr of the German Republic and his memory honored. When the Hit-lerites attained power they tore down the plaque commemorating the memory of Rathenau and erect-ed statutes to the murderers.

Hitler's Paper Sees Zionists Uniting to Attack Germany (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Sept. 8-The 18th World Zionist Congress, "with its Jewish brown shirts, its stolen Hitler salute and its so-called colonists in white frocks", is nothing but the first united Jewish attack against Germany, the Voelkischer Beobachter, newspaper owned by Adolf Hitler, declares in summing up the Congress.

The article simultaneously attacks Prague as a "fourfold sullied city" which is dishonored first by the "Austrian Court", second by the Czechs, third by its "modern life" and fourth by the Jews who have made Prague a "citadel of Juda-

World Conference Boycott Resolution

The resolution adopted by the World Jewish Conference at Geneva on the boycott of German goods follows:

"The world Jewish conference notes with deepest satisfaction that from the beginning of the Hitler regime and its anti-Jewish laws and acts, the Jewish people instinctively and continuously resorted to the one immediately accessible weapon of self-defense, the moral and economic boycott.

"In the spirit of individual and collective self-respect, the Jewish people, through the boycott, affirm they cannot hold any economic or other relations with the Third Reich and believe the boycott must continue supported by many non-Jews in all lands who understand and sympathize with the Jewish people's abhorrence of Nazi anti-Jewish precepts and practices.

"When the German Jewish boycott is to be ended entirely depends not on the Jewish people but on the Nazi government. This instrumentality of moral and economic pressure the Jews have been compelled reluctantly to adopt, utilize and not lay down until such time when the great wrong inflicted on the German Jews ends and the German Jews once again, are placed in the position which was

rightly their own before the accession of the Hitler government. This conference solemnly calls the Jewish people loyally to continue in their legitimate, honorable and peaceable resistance against th war waged by Hitlerism against the German Jews and all the Jewish people."

Two Previously Arrested Are Freed; Surrendered Youth Admits Using Knife

WILNO, Poland, Sept. 8 - A fourth Jewish boy implicated in the Kutzner, whose family is one of the poorest in the city, admitted that he stabbed Klimaszewski with a pocketknife. All the boys involved in the affray were between eleven and fourteen years old.

LEAGUE'S AID IS ASKED

Passports for Jewish Refugees All Over World and Help in Migrations Requested

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) GENEVA, Sept. 8 - Resolutions calling for intervention by the League of Nations in the Jewish situation in Germany and endorsing the world-wide Jewish anti-Nazi boycott were adopted by the preliminary conference of the world Jewish congress in its closing sessions here today.

The conference voted to call the congress into session in March, 1934. and that the delegates to the congress should be named in democratic elec-tions to be held throughout the world no later than January.

The adoption of the boycott resolution came after opposition to it had been made in the political committee's deliberations by Rabbi Angelo Sacerdoti, chief rabbi of Rome In Stabbing of Pole and a triend of Fremer Mussonm. It was strenuously advocated by Rabbi Stephen S. Wise of New York, Dr. Leo Motzkin of Paris, and others. The Italian delegates

abstained from voting on it.

The resolutions calling for League of Nations action on the German-Jewish question, demanded that the League take over supervision and regulation of the emigration of Jews from Germany, as it did in the fourth Jewish boy implicated in the death of a Wilno Polish youth named Klimaszewski, was surrendered to the police yesteday by his father. In the interim, until the congress begins functioning, the entire task of defending Jewish rights was delegated by the conference to the Committee of Jewish Delegations, haded by Dr. Motzkin and Dr. Emil Margulies of Czechoslovakia, with nine executive members to be elected by the conference and six representa-tives from six different countries. The central office of the congress will remain at Geneva but two branches will be established at Paris and Warsaw. The American Jewish Congress will act for the world congress in New York.

A tremendous impression made on the conference when Rabbi Wise in a speech today referred to the presence in the correspondents' section of a representative of the Voelkischer Beobachter, Hitler's own newspaper. Most of the delegates

LONDON, Sept. 8-It ought to be placed indelibly on record wherever people can read that the most foolish business deal that was ever made has to be placed to the discredit of a handful of Jews. This amazing, insane, inexplicable, un-

authorized, un-desirable com-pact to sell to Germany half a million cases of Palestine oranges in ex-change for a double value of unwanted Ger-man goods just about marks the limit to which stupidity can go. too late to stop this insult to a

proud race. Palestine is in no greater need of German goods than Germany appears to be in need of our own Jews. I was under the impression that unofficial Jews in all parts of the world were determined not to deal in German goods until such time as Germany showed a disposition to treat her Jewish citizens with fairness and honor. I say unofficial because for various reasons some of them, of quite understand-able official bodies, have found it inexpedient to pronounce themselves in favor of the boycott. I do not think I can be successfully contradicted if I say that ninety-nine percent of world Jewry are wholly in favor of a complete, water-tight boycott of all German goods wherever they may be

ever they may be.

That being so, who is it that dares to arrange to sell goods to Germany on terms that sound like blackmail? Have you ever done business like that? Selling goods in exchange for the ridiculous privilege of buying by paying for goods at twice the price received? It sounds like Alice in Wonderland, Unfortunately, we are dealing with Nazi Land, which is not quite so delectable a story.

May I once more appeal to the Jews to scrap the majority of their talking committees and get to work? Weizmann says he will have nothing to do with the presidency of the Zionist movement, but is desirous of working only for the amelioration of the condition of the German Jews. The Zionist hierarchy is committed to a policy of laissez-faire so far as is possible. Jabotinsky, who is inspired with a real patriotic desire, is suspected all around, because he is too energetic,



For the first time people have learned, as a result of this public discussion, what a vast part the one percent of the Jewish population in Germany has played in a population of sixty millions. For the first time the world has found out what a disproportionately large section of those Germans who raised Germany to international fame in all branches of art, literature, science and sport are Jews, whose community has had the right to participate in the life of the country as full citizens for less than a hundred years. Nazi-ism itself was put into practice for the first time in Germany by the Jew Ferdinand Las-salle, as La Stampa, official organ of Mussolini, recently revealed.

World discussion of the Jewish question already has achieved a great moral success. For example the Italian charge d'affairs appeared at Prague at the Zionist Congress on behalf of Signor Mussolini and was officially welcomed. The official Italian Telegraphic Agency, the Agenzia Stefani, reported the Zionist Con-gress at length and through these reports the Italian press obtained for the first time a picture of Jewish persecution in Germany.

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NATION WITHOUT LAW

Document Hitler Swore to Obey Gives Men Theoretically the Right to Emigrate

Seven months have passed; and today Germany flounders in a state of perplexity, absolutely without laws to guide the destiny of the state and fully dependent upon the whims of politicians for the security of business interests, safety of person, and immunity from attacks of lawless elements.

The Weimar Constitution, promulgated in 1919, reads: "All Germans are equal before the law. Men and women have fundamentally the same rights and duties. Public advantages or disadvantages of birth or rank are to be suspended."

Lesson of Zuchthaus

few weeks ago I walked through the Sonnenburg Zuchthaus, a large political prison gradually being filled with German citizens who have committed no criminal offense, who have created no breach of the peace, and who have been neither charged, tried, nor sentenced. Many of the prisoners did not know why they were there. The reason, briefly, for their incarceration was that they are not National Socialist in political creed.


On the wall of the Communist leader Kaspar's cell was pasted an excerpt from the Weimar Constitution. Kaspar, once a member of the Reichstag, and still arrogantly de-fensive of his rights, has no objection to visitors reading the proclamation: "Article 130 -- The officials of the German Reich are servants of the whole community, not a party. To all officials, freedom of their political beliefs and right of association is assured."

Through the steel corridors of the Zuchthaus we passed, occasionally halting to talk with the unfortunate, entirely unhappy, sallow faced men, who leaped to attention and saluted my Nazi escorts. Here was the trembling little Mosiefsky, editor of a Berlin weekly whose principle policy was to bring about peace and understanding between nations. His lips quivered and tears came to his eyes as he referred to those happy, peaceful days before the war." The Nazis told us that his sole offense against the state had been his pacifist nature.

SCENES OF THE SONNENBERG CONCENTRATION CAMP

The Zuchthaus ("Safety House") where the Nazis have imprisoned, some allegedly for their own safety against attacks by hoodlum brown-shirts, 1,000 prisoners who have yet been un-charged, untried, unsentenced. Many of these prisoners have been evacuated from temporary camps, to be lodged here "permanently".

groups in the "recreation yard," their gait expressive of the despondency of utterly hopeless men, formerly celebrated political leaders and professional men shuffled like fettered sheep. A burly brownshirt guard stood nearby with rifle slung over his shoulder. Frequent attempts to escape had been thwarted by this rifle; and, according to released prisoners, a number of those who had not attempted to escape had been shot "escaping" nevertheless.

My companion, Mr. Ben Riley, formerly a Labor member of the British Parliament, asked that a certain prisoner be allowed to talk with him. In a few moments the prisoner was brought before us. Although a strong man of not at all this prisoner cried as he told us of his wife and six children being without support during his imprisonment. He stated that he was in prison probably because Nazi competitors would benefit by the closing of his business. Our Nazi escorts admitted that many prisoners in the Zuchthaus were innocent even of infidelity toward the Nazi regime-they were there merely because business rivals had complained, and the absence of formal trial had made impossible even a simulation of investigation into their alleged political offenses. Jews, especially, were admitted to have come under this category.

Inside Walls, Outside Law

Outside the walls of the prison, police, guardians of whatever law still exists in Germany, stood; inside law-abiding citizens were kept, poorly fed, worked, tortured (as a narration by a released prisoner later revealed), and shot by the reigning party who acted quite outside the law of the country.

Hitler's Detroit Echo **Draws Spirited Reply**

Resentment Against Old Line About East European Jews Voiced by Dr. Aronstam

Aronstam, noted Detroit physician and scholar, who frequently in the past appeared on the same platform with Mr. Hailer.

Recalling the fiftieth birthday anniversary of Professor Albert Einstein, at which the German official paid tribute to the now-exiled scientist as "one of the most distinguished sons of Germany", Dr. Aronstam remarked that "times have changed and you, Mr. Hailer, are now throwing a flood of invectives against all the non-Aryans who at

present live in Germany.' Dr. Aronstam, pointing to the record of excesses against Jews in Germany, declared that these could not be condoned "as excesses unavoidable in times of revolution and attributable to irresponsible persons" and asserted that messages from German-Jewish organizations, quoted by Mr. Hailer, could not be used as proof that all had been serene since goodness knows under what stress and duress those quotations were made by the aforementioned orga-nizations."

Sachar Stirs St. Louis | Seek to Stimulate With Jewish Courses | Conservative Jewish About Our History

Controversy Within Ranks of Orthodox Jewry Expected To Be Settled Amicably

ST. LOUIS, Sept. 1-During the sweltering St. Louis hot weather, an unusual cultural event was carried on by the Y.M.H.A.-Y.W.H.A., in cooperation with a number of the younger set. Dr. Abraham Sachar, national director of the Hillel Foundation, formerly professor of History at the University of Illinois, a native son, conducted a series of courses that attracted more than 1,000 people. The skeptics who doubted the possibility of such a gigantic cultural event now acclaim the summer course as a "cultural

Prof. Sachar gave 16 lectures divided into two parts. "The Romance of a People," apparently inspired by the Jewish Pageant, dealt with cultural trends and Jewish life from the beginning of the Bible to the present time. Hundreds of young people who have never before taken courses in Jewish History flocked to the Roof Garden of the Y.M.H.A. to listen to Dr. Sachar. Among the subjects discussed in this course were Hellenism and Hebraism, and the development of ancient Judaism up to the completion of the formation of the Talmud. The second part of the course that has just been completed, consisted of "Religions of Mankind," in which Judaism and Christianity, and the allied creeds were objectively dealt with by the brilliant young scholar whose "History of the Jews" gave him national reputation. A discussion followed every lecture in which the audience participated. This is the first time such a systematic course was given in the summer months. At the conclusion of the course the audience expressed appreciation to Dr. Sachar as well as a desire that he continue the work. As a result, another series is being planned for the coming fall and win-

ter months.

The long and bitter controversy within the ranks of orthodox Jewry is about to be healed. Rabbi Jacob Grodsky, who had been ousted by the Vaad Oeir, the organized Orthodox community responsible for kashruths, for defying the authority of the Board supervising the Kosher meat business, may be taken back, it is rumored. If this should take place, as is expected, a complete united front will have been established in St. Louis. There is some opposition to the plan. The more extreme elements are still insisting that Rabbi Grodsky has no place in the ranks of organized Orthodoxy, but it is believed that no peace will be achieved unless some understanding is reached with him. Several kosher butchers have taken advantage of the division. President Louis Goodman has thus far made no definite statement as to the attitude of the Vaad Oeir, but some of his associates have said that peace is in-

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
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A FEW STEPS FROM RIVERSIDE DRIVE

Oldest Jewish Burial Ground, Established In 1656, Is Now Shut Out By Buildings of Chatham Square; Once Outside New York City Limits

Low Hills, Swamps, Marshes Stood on Cemetery Site Centuries Ago

In Chatham Square, a few minutes from Chinatown and behind the shadows of the Old Broadway elevated, crowded tenements and unsightly factory buildings, is the tiny old cemetery first used as a burial place for Jews two centuries

It is a place that seldom attracts visitors and never passersby, so securely fortified are its few ancient curery rortified are its few ancient stones by the altitude of tall buildings and the platitudes of wash lines which swing gracefully from kitchen windows. Yet "The Jews' Burial Ground", its title-name established in 1656, claims a history as long and romantic as the neighborhood in which it lies.

Everything about the New Boyney.

Everything about the New Bowery Cemetery, including Watchman Per-ry who for more than twenty years has stood guard over its slowly decaying memories, is moss-covered and hoary with years. Only a few flags placed over the tombs of Jews who served their country, in the Revolutionary War, the War of 1812, or the later conflicts, proclaim that this small acre of land has not altogether been forgotten. Some few bushes and a grass patch here and there, kept green by the not over-attentive watchman and the sunshine which manages somehow to steal into the chasm between tenements, are the only signs of life. But then too, there is the recurring roar of the trains overhead and the raucous honks of automobile trucks and the human voices which proceed in varying degrees of violence from the apartments adjoining.

The Iron Plaque

New Bowery Cemetery announces its identity on a black iron plaque which peeps out from behind a black iron fence:
"The First Cemetery of the


Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue, Shearith Israel, in the City of New York, 1656-1833".

A winding brush-covered path twines in and out the stones which seem to resent the intrusion of visitors, so still and unassuming and uncomplaining they stand. A few are flat on the ground covering the graves and they appear better to have weathered the ravaging effect of the years. Daughters of the American Revolution and Veterans of Foreign Wars insignia are frequently to be seen mounted on iron which has been used to reinforce the dilapidated rock. But several of the stones are worn smooth, a few bear signs of vandal chipping. Some look queerly chiseled and have personalities of their own, which bear legends inscribed in He-brew, Spanish, Portuguese and Eng-

Perry Does His Best

Perry the watchman, who is Italian, explained that his job is to usher visitors through the cemetery that he lived nearby and doesn't man he need hearby and doesn't know how to read or write. Nevertheless in broken English his words haltingly personified many of the tombstones, "the oldest", "a famous old rabbi", "this one fought under Washington".

More fascinating than all of his staccato sentences, and considerably more explicit, were the archives in which the writer found voluminous detailed information with regard to the cemetery-how and where and why it was acquired, and who is buried there, and the folklore born of its establishment. It was no little surprise to learn that investiga-tors, including Naphtali Phillips, Charles P. Daly, Leon Huhner and Rosalie S. Phillips, as well as others, spared no effort in attempting to gather data that would prove cemetery had not been a grant of the Dutch of New Amsterdam to the early Jews in America but the gift of two enthusiastic, wealthy William Merrett and Mrs. Joseph Bueno, to their race. These writers uncovered from dust-laden files of deeds and papers of the City of New York figures and facts which were apparently of interest, and importance. All of their reand importance. All of their re-search, published in the papers of

the American Jewish Historical So-1 ciety, is a strange compound of historical intelligence some of which must prove of interest to readers of the article.

Full Possession in 1701

Two hundred and seventy-eight years ago, in July, 1655, the handful of Jewish settlers in New Amsterdam where they had come from Europe a few years before to find religious freedom and peace, applied to the Dutch authorities for permission to purchase a parcel of land. They were to use this land as an exclusive burial place for their dead. They were denied the privilege, and once again, on February 22, 1656, appealed "that consent may be given" for the purchase.

Not until 1701, according to one authority, was the burial place amortized and did then go into the exclusive possession of New Amsterdam Jewry. Reads the original

7th August 1701. By Indres of this date between William Merrett and Margery his wife of one Part, and Joseph Bueno of the other Part, reciting a Deed from the said Joseph Bueno in the year 1681-2 for a certain parcel of land therein de-scribed lying at the Fresh Water (today Baxter Street on the east and Park Street, on the west Elm Street and on the south Reade Street), in length about 52 feet, and breadth about 50 feet, and that it was purchased by said Bueno for a Jew Burying Place, with free Liberty of passage from the Highway thereto to carry their dead. virtue thereof the Piece of Land continued from the Time of the first Grant aforesaid in 1681-2 the sole burying place for the Jew Congre-gation of the City of New York, until the year 1729, when it was thought proper to purchase an addition thereto for the same use."

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the second of the plaques declares, "outside City limits". There was (it is hard to believe history sometimes) a dense forest extending for two miles towards what is today Chatham Square. The land to the west was broken with low hills, swamps, marshes and large water deposits. Chatham Square, states one reliable geography, was "the southern limit of a range of high hills, or an elevated plateau-extendcanal Streets. The plateau was adapted for cultivators and meadows below were excellent for pasturing of cattle, the whole was parcelled among early settlers into farms, or as Dutch called them, Bouweries

The farms were leased by Dutch authorities to settlers who wanted them. Indian raids and devastating attacks made residence outside the walls of the City a hazardous affair. The reluctance of the Dutch to surrender this land to the Jewish populace was therefore quite inexplicable.



The Race and Nation of 'Columbus'

By Harry Salpeter

AURICE DAVID'S little work in scholarship, "Who Was 'Columbus'?" should be reviewed a month hence, on what is known as Columbus Day. The conclusions to which Mr. David is impelled, on the basis of his own researches and of those made by other scholars, are:

That the name of the discoverer of the Western world was not Christopher Columbus, but Cristobal Colon, and nothing else.

That he was not born in Genoa, Italy-despite his own assertions to that effect-but in a small town in Spain, Pontevedra.

That he was not a Catholic, but a Jew and, moreover,

That he remained a Jew and that he left indications in his method of signature to indicate the invulner-

ability of his Jewishness. The reasoning by which we are led to each one of these conclusions seems sound and strong. There would be less confusion today in the record of Columbus, or Colon, had the discoverer of the Western world not had the motives for concealing his origin and his race that he appears to have had. We see, for example, why, as a Spanish Jew, he would lay claim to citizenship in a maritime port of such great importance as Genoa. Mr. David points out the damning fact that the Spaniard Colon who claimed to have been bred in Italy barely knew Italian, while he was proficient in Spanish. But of course these are round-about reasons, showing that he had a motive for concealing something, but not that he had reason to conceal the fact that he was a Jew. But Mr. David pursues the investigation to the point of proving to his own satisfaction at least that he was a

"On all of these thirteen intimate letters but one [letters to his son] the attentive reader can plainly see at the left top corner a little monogram which may seem cryptic to him, but which is, in fact, nothing more or less than an old Hebrew greeting or benediction, frequently used among religious Jews all over the world even to this day.

"This monogram, consisting of two characters, 'beth' and 'hai', the second and the fifth letter of the Hebrew alphabet . . . is an abbreviation of the Hebrew words, 'Boruch hashem' (Praised be the Lord). Any handwriting expert can confirm this."

Mr. David quotes further proof that Colon was a Jew; the shape and the letters of his mystic signature which translated into Hebrew equivalent letters form a last confession and a substitute for the Kaddish The mystic signature, upon which Colon insisted, forms a triangle, or, as Mr. David calls it, a shield of David. Mr. David translates the letters into the following:

Shadai, Shadai Adonoy, Shadai, Yehova molai chesed

It would take too long to take the reader over every square inch of the ground by which Mr. David comes to this conclusion. It seems persuasive enough. With what force Mr. David's plausible explanation touches the reader must be estimated by the reader himself, who is commended to obtain a copy of this work from the Research Publishing Co.

"Before the Nazis came into the market to supply ready-made salvation, Hanussen had something like a monopoly of this business. weekly, the Berliner Wochenschau, had the biggest circulation in its field, surveying the field of politics and finance, and giving 'prophecies' to the masses at reasonable cost. Mysticism, east and west and from around the corner, astrology, palmistry, daily horoscopes, voodoo and wah-wah-everything dripped out of Hanussen's universal, psychic sponger into the vast hell-scared German The Nazis 'absorbed' middle class. Hanussen. And suddenly he began to prophesy all sorts of political developments, with amazing accuracy, through collusion with the plotters. Hanussen had inside information in advance; and the Nazis had their horoscope favorably read every week. For the vulgus, they seemed to have the stars on their side. Hanussen would forecast their 'successes' almost to the hour, stunning the populace and winning numberless followers among the superstitious; and Hitler woud cry: 'Destiny has a task for me'. But one day Hanussen was mysteriously assassinated, no one knows by whom. . . .

This is but one of the instances in which the new thirty-two page John Day pamphlet shows unequivocally that every occurrence which is at all traceable to the Nazis must eventually stand revealed as part of a conscious plan painstakingly pre-pared by Hitler and his "leadership of talent."

Mr. Josephson tells us that the technique which these "leaders" adopted took the two forms of terror and high-pressure publicity, bor-rowed "from the Bolshevists of 1917 as well as from American salesmanship." In his chapter on the "Springs of Fascism" Mr. Josephson describes Germany as being in an "economic blind alley" and confronted by the two objectives of obviating the Versailles Treaty and overcoming "the menacing proletarian movements" and tells what has already been told in both French and American publithat it was the Ger cationsdustrial kings together with the French steel and ammunition cartel "who spawned Hitler, decided when his 'movement' should mark time, and when it should go ahead.

In the same section Mr. Josephson analyzes Hitler's Four-Year Plan and comes to the conclusion that "German industrialism, with teeming beehives of skilled serfs, will press upon the world market prodigiously, evoking the increasing economic war of embargoes tomorrow; then the more direct war of blood and iron afterward. And in hastening this end, destruction of the organized labor class and forcing it into the depths of bondage, Naziism in Germany achieves what we are coming to recognize as the historic mission



Uruguay Opens Door To 500 Exile Families, **Fund Drive Is Started**

Presidential Order Gives Cue To Anti-Semitic Papers; Counter-Journal Started

MORAL VICTORY SEEN

Decree Significant in View of Strict Immigration Laws Of the Country

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)

MONTEVIDEO, Aug. 20 - Five hundred Jewish families which have been forced to flee from Germany on account of the Hitler terror will be admitted into Uruguay as the reresult of a special decree by Dr. Gabriel Terra, President of the Republic of Uruguay.

Dr. Terra's decree is significant in the light of the fact that Uruguay, like most of the other American nations, has, because of unemployment and the economic crisis, very strict anti-immigration laws, and doubly so as a moral victory for South American Jewry. However, when the Jewish Immigrant Aid Society of Montevideo appealed to the government for permission to bring into the country a number of German-Jewish families whom the society promised to establish, the government's answer took the form of the president's decree.

A campaign to raise 300,000 Uruguayan pesos, the money to be used in colonizing the German refugees, has been begun. However, since the Jewish population of Uruguay numbers only about 20,000, it is probable that the larger Jewish institutions will have to contribute most of the Most of the work of colonization will be carried on by the Jewish Immigrant Aid Society, which is financed by the ICA (Jewish Col-

onization Association).

But even before the first refugee has come, an anti-Semitic grumbling against the decree admitting him is beginning to be heard. Those principally guilty in this matter are El Imparcial and La Tribuna Popular, two influential newspapers. El Imparcial is a Catholic newspaper, virtually the official Hitlerite organ here. La Tribuna Popular is a generally reactionary paper unfriendly to foreigners and largely responsible for the anti-immigration laws. La Tribuna views the government's decree permitting the entry of five hundred German-Jewish families as an autonomous act abrogating the anti-immigration laws

The campaign which both newspapers are carrying on is demagogical to an extreme and is, of course, having considerable effect upon those who are subjected to it, for most of the Uruguayan people know little about Jews and Jewish affairs.

counteraction to the campaign of the anti-Semitic newspapers was begun by the Uruguay Day, Yiddish newspaper published in Montevideo. Its editorials insisting that something be done immediately led to the founding of Vos Hebrea (The Jewish Voice), a newspaper printed in Spanish to carry on a quiet but de-termined rebuttal of the arguments of the anti-Semitic press.

The local protest committee against the persecution of Jews in Germany keeps in close touch with the similar committee in Buenos Aires. When the Montevideo committee arranged a protest meeting the German diplomatic representative did everything possible to prevent the meeting from taking place. It was, however, held, and was, an effective moral demonstration attended by representatives of various governmental departments, all of whom expressed their sympathy for the unfortunate German Jews. A sum of money was also collected to help establish refugee German Jews in Palestine.

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Rigid Definitions of "Front" Soldiers Tend to Negate Service of Non-Aryans

SEEL IS RESPSONSIBLE

Application of "Aryan" Laws Is Widened By Order Of Ministry

(I.T.A. Special Correspondence) BERLIN, Aug. 18—The circle round the small number of Jews that are still allowed to practice as doctors or lawyers, or to hold official positions, is being drawn closer and closer. The original Nazi law and closer. for the exclusion of Jews from these occupations exempted so-called "Frontkaempfer" (front fighters) from its provisions. Such Jews as had fought for Germany during the War, or whose fathers or sons had been killed in the War, were to be allowed to continue in their posts.

Apparently this law, which left only a very small number of Jews in their posts, did not go far enough for the Nazi "purists." But the law had been passed, and they had to make the best of it—and so it was subjected to the interpretations of The simplest apthe Nazi jurists. the Nazi jurists. The simplest approach was through the word "Front-kaempfer". What was the exact meaning of the word? It had naturally been supposed that it meant those who had participated on the German side in the Great War.

Variety of Definitions

But, since there was no legal definition of the word, the various authorities that had to put the law into practice began to define the word in whatever way suited them best. In some cases it was taken to mean a man who had actually been in the trenches—and Jews who had been attached to the Headquarters staff or the military transport service, were excluded from the category "Front-kaempfer". In other cases it was taken to imply membership of a "fighting squad", and Jews who were attached to other sections were excluded, even if they could prove that they had actually participated in the

Now at last, the question has been cleared up by Herr Seel, Councillor in the Ministry of the Interior, who is the official responsible for the carrying out of the law concerning the Civil Service, and whose views may be taken as authoritative. According to Herr Seel, the word "Frontkaempfer" implies actual participation in a battle. Nurses and Red Cross staff, therefore, even if they worked in front-line hospitals, and were exposed to the greatest danger, are not "Frontkaempfer"; nor such Jews as were members of a "fighting squad" which happened not to participate in a battle; nor, presumably, even such as were wounded behind the lines. The greatest danger to life and limb is not sufficient actual front line fighting is the essential condition.

The Post-War Trenches

Herr Seel goes on to say that, for the purposes of the law, the battles in the Baltic Provinces after the War, the fights against the Spartacists in Berlin, the Communists in Munich and the "Red Army in Cen-tral Germany" rank with the battles of the Great War proper, and that participants in these battles are, if the other conditions are satisfied, to be considered as "Frontkaempfer." This, however, is not to apply to the battles against the "Separatists" in the Rhineland, or to fights with the enemies of the "National Resurrec-

The Prussian Minister of the Interior has now issued an order, that the "Aryan" laws are to be applied not only against present employees of the State and the municipalities, but also to all previous ones and even to their heirs and survivors. Goering Drug Fiend, Locked Up in Asylum, Documents Attest

Court Declared Him Incapable of Caring for Son; His Wife Declared Epileptic

That Capt. Hermann Goering, president of the Prussian Council of State and president of the Reichstag, was at one time a patient in an insane hospital is proven by documentary evidence reprinted in the "Brown Book," recently published in London by Lord Morley, president of the World Committee for the Victims of National Socialist Fas-cism. The documentary evidence consists of two certificates, the first Capt. Goering's card as a patient in the Institute for the Cure of Nervous Diseases of Langbro, Sweden. The second is a declaration signed by the legal medical expert at Stockholm that Goering is a morphinomaniac and that the former Madame Goering, nee Baroness von Rock, is an epileptic, and that, therefore, neither of their houses is a suitable home for their only son.

The history of Capt. Goering is a favorite theme for the patriotic panegyrics of the Nazis; but the official biographers seem to leave out the most telling details. All Goering's vaunted aviation exploits were accomplished during his morphine intoxication. This "war hero . . . who assaulted the very clouds" fled to Rome after the unsuccessful "outsch" of 1923 before the prospect of a few months in a fortress. As a minority leader he never had the courage to risk the half of what he himself imposes upon minority leaders today.

In Sweden, where he worked for an aviation company (1925-1926), he was shut up in the insane hospital at Langbro, removed thence to Konradsberg, and thence back to Langbro. There his fits were so violent that he was transferred to the section for dangerous madmen. Finally, the Nazi biographers fail to mention that the man to whom they have intrusted the tutelage

was named king by a great majority. Feisal's attitude toward Zionism as it affected his dream of a Pan-Arab federation to include Palestine Syria, the Hejaz and Transjordania was always a subject of considerable question.

In 1930, in an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, King Feisal said: "I have come to Geneval" this time solely in the interests of my own country," referring to the admission of Iraq to the League of Nations in 1932. Several questions, including that of Zionism, were dis-

In an official statement issued at the close of the interview, the Arab ruler declared: "During the Peace conference, I represented my father (ex-King Hussein of the Hejaz) and owing to this position, I came into contact with delegates of all nations, meeting also several of the Zionist

"I had several interviews with Dr. Weizmann, and exchanged with him letters which were of a purely personal nature.

"At that time I wanted to find a means of arriving at a rapprochement, but events prevented a continuation of these efforts. Since then, I understand that Zionist policy underwent a change after the Peace Conference.'

Asked about his letter to Professor Felix Frankfurter, which prominently figured in the proceedings of the Shaw Inquiry into the 1929 Palestine uprisings, King Feisal said, "I exchanged letters with many people, but I cannot recall such a letter.

In the Frankfurter letter, Feisal expressed deepest sympathy with the Zionist movement and declared it was necessary for the success of the Arab national movement. The letter was written March 1, 1919, during the Peace Conference.

"I want to take this opportunity of my first contact with American Zionists to tell you what I have *ften been able to say to Dr. Weiz-nann in Arabia and Europe," King Feisal wrote Professor Frankfurter "We Arabs, especially the educated among us, look with the deepest sympathy on the Zionist movement. Our deputation here in Paris is fully acquainted with the proposals submitted yesterday by the Zionist Organization to the Peace Conference and we regard them as moderate and proper. We will do our best, so far as we are concerned, to help them through; we will wish the Jews a most hearty welcome home.

"With the chiefs of your movement, especially with Dr. Weizmann, we have had and continue to have the closest relations. He has been a great helper to our cause and I hope the Arabs may soon be in a position to make the Jews some return for

their kindness.
"We are working together for a reformed and revived Near East, and our two movements complete one another".

Achimeir Notes Read At Arlosoroff Hearing

Police Officer Tells Magistrate Persons on Seashore Are Recognizable

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JAFFA, Sept. 8—The magistrate's investigation into the murder last June of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, head of the political department of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, con-tinued today with presentation of additional testimony consisting of extracts from the notebooks of Aba Achimeir, one of the three defendants in the case.

Achimeir, with Zvi Rosenblatt and Abraham Stavsky, all of whom are identified with the extremist faction of the Revisionists, the right-wing Zionists, are accused of conspiracy to murder Dr. Arlosoroff and with the actual murder.

Police officer Tennenbaum, re-newing his testimony today, de-clared that on the basis of his own experiments, it was possible to recognize persons on the Tel Aviv seashore at night. Dr. Arlosoroff was murdered there at night and identification of his assassins had been questioned.

In Achimeir's notebooks the witness said he found ten commandments composed by the defendant. He quoted one of them: "A killer for motives of robbery has murdered, but murder is not a crime. The Bible is full of examples."

The witness also said he had found minutes of a meeting on the night of the murder of the Kfar-Saba branch of the Brith Trumpel-

THE 18th ZIONIST CONGRESS By Rabbi Louis I. Newman

Temple Rodeph Sholom, New York City The Prague Zionist Congress passed resolutions at once timid and courageous. With respect to Trans-Jordan, the Congress pussy-footed; with respect to the French Report, the commercial policy of the Palestine government, its customs regulations, its immigration restrictions, and other shortcomings of the Mandatory Power and its representatives, the Congress seemed commendably forthright. Likewise in its criticism of economic omissions of Jewish institutions in Palestine, the Congress did not mince words. The policy of "non-acceptance" which began at Basel in 1931 was continued at

Prague, and indicates that the Zionist leadership will not cringe before interference by Britain or others with Palestine's upbuilding. The decision of the Congress with respect to the Jewish Agency is also

praiseworthy. Unanimously the Congress declared that unless the non-Zionists voluntarily reduced their representation on the Agency Executive Board, the Zionists would not renew the agreement upon which the Agency is based. This outcome vindicates the judgment of those who for years questioned and opposed the empty gesture of a union, as between peers, of the Zionist cohorts and the handful of "Non-Zionist" generals without even a corporal's guard of followers. "Non-Zionists" should join the Zionist organization, if only for the duration of Hitlerism, and banish the folly of a duplicate or supergovernment in Zionist affairs.

Bound up with the fate of the Agency was the question of Dr. Weizmann's leadership. His silence on the 1925 Russian diversion, the confusion and defeatism of his policies for a decade, hampered Palestine's development, ensnarled the World Zionist Organization with respect to the Mandatory, and bewildered the Zionist masses. His recent addresses in America demonstrated that he had learned and forgotten nothing. Not even the Laborite's inclination toward Dr. Weizmann was sufficiently strong to prompt them to espouse his return to the headship, and the tumult and shouting of his American advocates at Chicago and elsewhere died away into vacuity. Dr. Sokolow will continue to lend dignity and harmony to Zionist forces.

But the personnel of the new Executive leaves much to be desired. It does not represent a united front in these crucial days, and at least three major units in the movement are unrepresented. The elimination of Heschel Farbstein and Emanuel Neumann is to be deplored. Neumann's two years on the Executive stamped him as one of the rising notables of Zionism, and it is regrettable that those who have been "gunning" for him because of his cooperation with the Szold-Brodie group, have temporarily attained their objective. The inclusion of

Louis Lipsky on the new Executive is no cause for rejoicing in American Zionism. Zionism gains little from this substitution of a man whose administration, after a career of chaos, ended in wreckage more than three years ago.

The failure of the Congress to include in the new Executive a representative of the Szold-Brodie group, espousing industrial investment and middle-class immigration, cannot halt the progress of their policies. The Yishub itself has approved the work of the American Economic Committee for Palestine by designating as its headquarters for information regarding agriculture and industry the Palestine offices of the The Laborites will err group. grievously if they encourage a struggle between labor and capital before Palestine has adequate capi tal. Permission of small industrial ists and tourists who have found employment to enter with less capital than heretofore required is an important item. But any financial agreement for profit by Palestinians with the Nazi terrorists deserves the utmost condemnation. In short, the "rump" Executive which is 'ny taking power begins under hear handicaps. The solid merit of the Szold-Brodie economic program is certain to give it authority, and an instrument is sure to be created whereby Trans-Jordan can be opened up to Jewish enterprise. But if Labor presses its numerical advantage and bedevils the situation, Palestine's development will be impeded, and the Jewish Homeland for all Jews, the victims of Nazidom included, will be the chief sufferer.

The Jewish Strategy

In the search for a slogan against the Nazis of Germany, a slogan which shall transcend even world Jewish feeling and enlist on the Jewish side of the defensive-offensive campaign against Hitler Germany all friends of humanity, more than perfunctory attention should be given to the phrase which Rabbi Stephen S. Wise employed this week in his address at the World Jewish Conference at Geneva: "What the world needs today is not a Germanized humanity, but a humanized Germany."

So long as the non-Jewish world accepts the theory that the Nazi policy and the Nazi practice constitute a threat only to Jews, the non-Jewish world will continue to be more or less indifferent. The Nazi policy and the Nazi practice must be seen as a threat to Jews AND Christians who are not of the Nazi persuasion. The present government of Austria is dominantly a Christian, a Clerical, government. Nazi venom, Nazi brutality against Austria are modified not by the Christianity of Austria, but by the balance of power which Mussolini wields. Nazi intentions against Switzerland, Czechoslovakia, Poland have nothing to do with the Jewish question.

Germany, a prevision of their method of "Divide and rule." With the help of the Nationalists and the Centrists they had the Communists outlawed. Then came the turn of the Socialists, the Nazi opposition being weakened step by step with the help of the divided forces of that opposition. Then came the turn of the Centrists, the National-

ists, or what have you? It is true that the Nazi policy is strongly anti-Jewish. But it is not only anti-Jewish. It is against every aspiration that is not Nazi. If the Nazis can succeed in breaking the Jews of Germany, as they seem likely to succeed in doing, and in setting against the Jews of other nations the non-Jews of those nations, they will have succeeded in breaking the first line of resistance against their drive on other nations, on other races, on other peoples. Only the Catholics seem aware of what may follow the anti-Jewish drive. And whether the Jews of the world accept for wider dissemination the phrase of Rabbi Wise, their strategy in enlisting non-Jewish allies should be governed by the fact that the Nazis constitute a danger to the internal peace of nations and to the peaceful relations between the nations of the world.

On the very day that H. G. Wells, in "The Shape of Things to Come," predicts that the next World War will start with the killing of a Polish Jew by a Nazi, the cables bring news of the slaying of a Polish farmhand by a Danzig Nazi. It is a bit fantastic to see the world, or Poland, going to war over a Jew. After all, no Jew can become an nave nothing to do with the Jewish Archduke these days, even if the nazis have given us, within blood in the Hapsburg dynasty.

To the Editor of the Jewish Daily Bulletin:

With regard to the recent review of "Triopoly—or Class War?" in your columns, it would appear that your reviewer did not fully assimiate the contents or message of the

My own impression from reading the book is that if ever there was a prophet able to see clearly and to analyze social and industrial trends objectively and whole, that prophet is Robert Segal.

His book furnishes us not only with an economic, but what the author calls "psychonomic", interpretation of history in which he shows that although man began with nothing he has worked himself up to a position of extreme poverty.

Mr. Segal has charted the road

on which industry is slowly and subhuman values in cultural and industrial relations, is, to say the least, provocative.

Mr. Segal indicates, by tracing man's development from the primitive, through the feudal ages, down to the present, that our economic issues and fetishes are complicated by spiritual factors the classical economist has overlooked, but which is part of the basis of economic aspirations and now finding expression in the National Recovery Act, representing the first phase of an American commonwealth becoming Triopoly-minded.

The last chapter of the book is of intense Jewish interest. In fact, one suspects that the entire volume was meant to lead up to this chapter. Here Mr. Segal defines the world position of the Jews since the Dis-

persion and traces Tewish influence on world history. Although he does not say so in so many words, one receives the impression that Triopoly, like the League of Nations, is the Jewish contribution to mankind, Zionists will be interested in Mr. Segal's characterization of the birth of the Jewish State as part of the polity of the Powers. He declares: "The new spirit was evinced most significantly, because most disinterestedly, in the mandate to restore the Jewish State. Doubtless, this disinterestedness has since plagued the Mandatory, the British Empire, as spelling lack of incentive to carry on. Notwithstanding a certain hesitation and intervals of backing and filling, the original impulse toward Jewish Restoration and the founding of the League of Nations—linked together as they are and belonging to the same genreconsciously proceeding and his and belonging to the same genre-analysis, involving a new philosophy represents the most remarkable outcropping of the World War strangely-hued flower of fulfillment appearing in the fullness of travail hat now and again marks a new high tide in human sensitiveness and inspiration.

'Was it felt that, after all, perhaps the Jews were the true protagonists of the elements of salvation in Christianity and should be permitted to re-form their lines with a view to staying the forces of destruction that had well-nigh undone the world?
