## Unhindered Discussion of German Situation Demanded Of Minorities Congress

**(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)**  
GENEVA, Sept. 11—A blunt and emphatic ultimatum to the Minorities Congress, which opens its sessions on Sept. 14, was submitted today by Dr. Leo Motzkin, chairman of the Committee of Jewish Delegations, following a consultation in Geneva of delegates representing the Jewish minorities in Poland, Roumania, Latvia, Lithuania, Czechoslovakia and Bulgaria. The communication, signed by Dr. Motzkin, was addressed to M. Wilton, president of the Minorities Congress.

The letter declares that only upon the acceptance of two conditions will the Jewish minority representatives be prepared to be at the Congress. Firstly, there must be the possibility of unhindered discussion of the Jewish position in Germany; secondly, the Jewish delegates must be permitted to submit resolutions which condemn in undisguised terms the Jewish persecution in Germany.

Dr. Motzkin stressed the fact that the conditions enumerated were in themselves a compromise impossible to negotiate further, since half of the Jewish delegation had favored non-participation in the Congress, under all circumstances. Therefore, if the conditions laid down in the letter are not granted in full, Jewish participation in the Congress would be impossible, he stated.

## Swastika Display Banned By Hungarian Government

BUDAPEST, Sept. 11—An order issued by the Minister of the Interior, Franz K. Fischer, strictly prohibits the use of the swastika emblem in any form on the ground that the swastika is the emblem of an alien state. ## Mussolini Organ Advises Nazis to Let Jews Export At Least Part of Capital

ROME, Sept. 11—Premier Mussolini's newspaper, *Il Popolo D'Italia*, in an editorial entitled "Wisdom," today urges the German government to permit German Jews to "export at least part of their capital to Palestine."

The paper, in reviewing the Eighteenth World Zionist Congress recently concluded at Prague, holds as particularly wise the decision of the congress to abstain from the economic anti-Nazi boycott. Such action, it points out, will undoubtedly facilitate the emigration of Jews from the Reich.

"For the Jewish problem only one solution exists and that is a Jewish state in Palestine," the paper states. "The Zionist congress has clearly proclaimed that Jewry is not a religion but a nation and an exhaustive, final solution of this question is becoming most pressing."

## Reich Government Stand On Jewish Workers' Body Bar to Its Formation

BERLIN, Sept. 11—The reasons that prompted the Reich's Vertretung of Jewish Federations, most representative Jewish body in Germany, to advise against the formation of Jewish employees organizations was divulged today.

The statement declared that many inquiries reached them from those puzzled by the advice, particularly in view of the urgent need to help Jewish employees find new occupations.

Although everyone agrees that the German Jews must strive for the formation of just such organizations, it must be realized that their effectiveness rests in agreement with the government.

The statement discloses that the government remains, as yet, unapproachable in regard to this question and therefore the creation of employees organizations must remain in abeyance.

## 1,500 HONOR UNTERMYER AT TESTIMONIAL DINNER; BOYCOTT CONFERENCE ORGANIZES FOR WORK

Jews and non-Jews, including some of the most distinguished leaders of the nation, joined in honoring Samuel Untermyer, leader of the boycott movement against Germany, at the dinner tendered him at the Hotel Astor, Sunday evening. The dinner, which was attended by 1,500 people, discussed the national boycott conference held during the day at the Hotel Astor. At the conference two hundred and fifty business leaders, professional men and civic workers from various cities in the country, voted to raise a fund of \$50,000 with which to organize and prosecute the boycott on a nation wide scale.

At the same time that the distinguished speakers at the dinner who included George Gordon Battle, treasurer; James W. Gerard, former Ambassador to Germany; Reinhold Colby, former Secretary of State; General John V. Chanin

of Chicago; Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver of Cleveland, and former Governor Alfred E. Smith, paid tribute to Mr. Untermyer as a great lawyer, an unselfish public servant and

## Boycott Only Weapon to Fight Nazi Intolerance, General Clinin Declares

General John V. Clinin of Chicago, anti-Jewish delegate to the national boycott conference and one of the speakers who paid tribute to Samuel Untermyer, declared to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, that he had consented to serve as a delegate because he was against intolerance "in any form by any group in any country."

"Intolerance in Germany," said General Clinin, "is depriving the Jews of Germany of life, liberty and property and has established a national sacrifice in the person of the German Jews."

"It is proper for all liberty loving humanitarians in all countries of the world to show resentment against Hitlerism. International law does not permit interference with the state policies of another nation. Our only means of showing resentment is the boycott, an economic lesson to be brought home to the German government."

General Clinin commanded the 120th infantry in the World War, was chairman of the Illinois Boxing Commission, president of the National Boxing Commission and Deputy United States Attorney General. He is now practicing law in Chicago.

Before General Clinin left to attend the national boycott conference he received a threat warning him not to go.

a valiant champion of the oppressed, they unanimously denounced the Hitlerite regime in Germany.

### Excoriates Nazis

In his response to the many speeches in his praise Mr. Untermyer excoriated the German regime and declared that Hitlerism was a threat not only to the Jews but to all the civilized world as well. He appealed to Jews and non-Jews to join in the boycott movement against Hitlerism which he said was the only weapon available against the Nazis.

Governor Smith's speech brought forth a tremendous ovation.

"No nation can live under ridicule," he said. "They can stand criticism, they can meet it, and they can answer it, but it is impossible for them to survive any length of time under ridicule."

"The Jews can stand persecution," he went on, "but civilization can't stand it. And above everything else, Germany can't stand it."

In his speech, which was broadcast over a national hookup, Mr. Untermyer declared, "A once proud and cultivated people have been converted to a den of savage beasts of prey, senselessly bent upon the starvation and extermination of their own citizens."

He derided as a ridiculous charlatanism the Hitler thesis of racial purity and declared that in the history of the world, since the time of Nero, no nation had ever had such a government as now exists in Germany. He characterized the persecution of the German Jews as being obviously sadistic in purpose and quoted letters and declarations by Nazi leaders to prove his point.

### Accuses Hitler of Distortion

Mr. Untermyer accused Chancellor Hitler of twisting a phrase of the historian, Theodor Mommsen, calling the Jews "a ferment of decomposition" to make it appear as a condemnation of the Jews, when the full quotation shows that the historian really meant to praise the Jews.

He recoiled with scorn the Hitlerite creed which would make drudges of the German women and deprive them of the freedom they have had and reduce them to household slaves and playthings.

Mr. Untermyer declared that the boycott was succeeding beyond his

hopes and urged all Americans, Jews and non-Jews alike, to fight against Hitlerism.

"It is in the spirit of humanity and in the holy cause of civilization that we ask and expect of you that you will do your share," he said.

Others on the speakers' dais included Mayor O'Brien, Norman Thomas, J. David Stern, publisher of the Philadelphia Record; Charles C. Lockwood, and Senator Royal S. Copeland.

Earlier in the day, the national boycott conference, under the chairmanship of Mr. Untermyer, now the president of the Jewish League for the Defense of Jewish Rights, emphasized that the boycott was in retaliation for the persecution of religious, racial and political minorities in Germany.

The conference adopted resolutions to prosecute the boycott with all possible vigor. It was made clear that the boycott was not directed at the German people, but solely against the Nazi regime.

All organizations, Jewish and non-Jewish, were invited to cooperate "in the end that a united front may be established and maintained and a single plan of strategy made possible."

A national executive committee of 100 was chosen to direct the movement and an administrative committee of 15 to have direct charge of all the work was also elected. The administrative committee consists of: Dr. B. Dobosky, New York; Elias Ginsburg, New York; J. Chaskin, New York; J. George Freedman, New Jersey; Louis Meyers, New York; Mrs. Mark Harris, New York; J. David Stern, Philadelphia; Max Silverstein, New York; Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, Cleveland; and Max M. Korshak, Chicago.

### Nazi Press Continuing Attacks on Einstein

BERLIN, Sept. 11—The German newspapers are continuing their attacks on Professor Albert Einstein despite his repeated declarations that he had no share in the writing of the "Brown Book of the Hitler Terror," published in London, a short time ago.

The *Voelkischer Beobachter*, leading Nazi paper, declares that only in a juristic and political sense is Professor Einstein a traitor to Germany since above all he is a Jew feeling as such and not as a German.

The Nazi paper insists that the Jews always hated the countries that resisted their predominant influence, but the world wide Jewish attacks on Germany which is defending itself against the growing pressure of the Jews, is all the more reason for Germans to handle the Jewish problem with cold blooded, imperturbable consistency.

### Histadruth, Revisionists Clash at Hadera; 5 Hurt

JERUSALEM, Sept. 11—Five were injured, one seriously, in a battle between the Histadruth, Palestinian Labor Federation, and the Revisionists, extremist Zionists, which took place Friday night at the colony of Hadera.

Tension reigns over the colony and sporadic assaults in which fists were freely used continued until the police arrived and took the situation in hand.

The injured included Dr. Glicker of Vicana, editor of the *Judgment*, who recently arrived in Palestine, and an unnamed girl who is said to have been seriously injured.

### Open Door for Refugees Asked by Civil Liberties Group

WASHINGTON, Sept. 11—The American Civil Liberties Union, in a memorial signed by leading educators, lawyers and clergymen, asks President Roosevelt to revise the existing immigration restrictions to admit religious and political refugees, particularly those from Germany.

The memorial urges that changes be made to meet the nation's "tradition of asylum for refugees escaping from foreign countries." The Union states that the number of such refugees would be small.

### Savants Condemn Nazi-ism As a Menace to Europe

MONTREAL, Que., Sept. 11—The actions of Chancellor Adolf Hitler and his Nazi regime in Germany are a cause for international anxiety, according to Professor Alfred Zimmern, who holds the chair of international affairs at Oxford University and is director of the Geneva School of International Affairs. Professor Zimmern passed through Montreal en route to Toronto to attend the British Commonwealth Relations Conference.

England is watching the developments in Germany with considerable concern, he declared. He stated that Hitler, by continuing as a storm-center, was doing irreparable harm not only to himself and his cause, but to Germany and all Europe.

Equally outspoken against Hitlerism was Professor Arnold Toynbee, who holds the research chair in international history at the University of London.

"Hitlerism, one of the prime concerns of Europe today, has lost its flavor of Aryan-Jewish conflict and now savors of war and the fear of war," he said.

### Brockton Jewish Workers Organize to Aid Needy

BROCKTON, Mass., Sept. 11—The establishment of a soup-kitchen and breadline for needy workers involved in the shoe strike here, will be the first move of the Jewish workers in their effort to aid the newly organized Brotherhood of the Shoe and Allied Craftsmen.

Several hundred Jewish men and women employed in the local shoe factories were enthusiastic in their approval of this course of action which was advised at a mass meeting held at the Labor Lyceum. Both Harry Saltman and Joseph Cohen, leaders in the workers movement, believe that "a tough winner is in front of us."

The shoe industry here is badly crippled by the labor controversy. The Brotherhood is firm in its stand, supported by the code, which grants the right of workers to be represented in collective bargaining by men of their own choosing.

The Jews here are the first to organize as a racial group to take any definite step in the situation and their action is being followed by all the nationalities in the city.

### Dr. Marx, C. V. Official, On Trial Oct. 3 for Bribery

FRANKFURT-AM-MAIN, Germany, Sept. 11—The trial of Dr. Marx, head of the Frankfurt branch of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, and Herr Maschdel, former head of the political police, it was officially announced today, will open October 3.

The two men were arrested immediately after the Nazis came to power. Dr. Marx is accused of bribing Herr Maschdel to supply him with information concerning Nazi activities, and the former police official is charged with supplying Dr. Marx with information and documents obtained in his official capacity. The former president of the Frankfurt police, who was also arrested in the same case, was released after a short while, but Dr. Marx and Herr Maschdel were held in prison.

### Hebrew Of Course As School Requirement

BERLIN, Sept. 11—Modern Hebrew as a language for matriculation examinations in Germany, has been abolished according to an announcement by the Minister of the Interior, Wilhelm F. Frick.

Up to the present students desiring to matriculate had to take two modern languages one of which could be Hebrew. The order also declares that Jewish pupils will no longer be permitted to matriculate if they prepared themselves in other than officially recognized schools.

### Shulman Elected to Head Chicago Zionist Body

CHICAGO, Sept. 11—Max Shulman, president of the Midwest Zionist region, was elected president of the Chicago Zionist Organization at its annual meeting which was held Sunday. Mr. Shulman was president of the Chicago organization for many years but gave up the post two years ago.

William M. Katz and A. Z. Halperin are the new vice-presidents. Joel Davidson Wolfson was re-elected secretary and John Klisman re-elected treasurer.

The meeting adopted resolutions condemning the treatment of the German Jews, and urging the strengthening of work for Zionism all over the world for the upbuilding of Palestine as a haven for Jews.

## Tarrytown Jews Open Their New Jewish Center

TARRYTOWN, N. Y., Sept. 11—A twenty-year old dream of the Jewish community here was fulfilled yesterday when the Ladies Auxiliary of the Hebrew Congregation formally opened and dedicated the new Jewish Center on North Washington Street.

Mrs. Hyman Levy, president of the women's organization, presented a torch in memory of her son who was killed in the World War.

Among those who took part in the services were Harry Kadish, president of the congregation; Charles L. Abalos, the junior rabbi; Judge Benjamin Haas of Nyack; Rabbi Morris Kosterovky, of White Plains; Rabbi Moses Goldman, of Ossining, and Rabbi Gordon, of the Tarrytown congregation.

## Palestine Mourns Death Of Feisal, Iraq Monarch

JERUSALEM, Sept. 11—Jews and Arabs united this week-end to mourn the death of King Feisal of Iraq. Arab buildings, motor cars and houses are carrying black flags and the newspapers have a black border. All the Hebrew papers carried lengthy tributes to the dead monarch and gave much space to the memorial services for the King held at the mosques in Jerusalem. Genuine grief over the death of King Feisal is universal in Palestine.
