Cordon Around Mosque Prevents Demonstration Parade

RESENT IMMIGRATION

Jerusalem, in Tense State at Threat of Disturbances,
Now Reassured

(Jewish Telegraph Agency)

JERUSALEM, Oct. 13.—The tension between Moslems and Christians and much of the government offices avenged by the Arab Executive as a protest against continued Jewish immigration to Palestine. The Arab leaders, who failed to make their demands terminate today as a result of energetic intervention of the Palestine police.

As soon as the Moslems, inciting hundreds of Arabs who had come to Jerusalem for the demonstration, poured out of the Mosque of Omar after mid-day prayers, they were met by a cordon of British and Arab police detachments who finally succeeded in dispersing the crowd.

Eight Arab demonstrators and two policemen were injured in the scuffle, while 100 Arabs fled through the police lines outside the Mosque.

Not a single shot was fired by the police, who were called in because, although troops had been kept in readiness for immediate service. All the police were held harmless, but

Nazis Say 'Verboten' To Mixed Unions, in Or Out of Marriage

"Racial Treason" Will Lead
To Citizenship Annullment,
Prison and Other Things

(Jewish Telegraph Agency)

BERLIN, Oct. 13.—A proclamation published in the German press states or sexual relations with Jews has been issued in draft law by the Prussian Minister of Justice. The law apparently is to protect the Aryans.

Precariously heavy penalties are foreseen for persons who do not disclaim that they are not Aryans, or whose ancestry in any way may suggest his hidden contempt.

Such racial treason, whether committed in marriage or among unmarried persons, will be punished by the loss of the rights of citizenship in addition to heavy penalties.

Although the law has not yet been drafted, in many instances passed, it will depend on the strength of its provisions.

An Offenbach Jew was arrested by police for maintaining relations with a non-Jew. The woman was subsequently imprisoned. An official communication issued by the German Foreign Ministry, however, declares that at the present time such behavior by a Jew must be considered

American Believed Chosen by League To Aid Reich Jews

Neither Al Smith Nor Col.
Roosevelt Knows About It;
Affirm Minority Definition

GENEVA, Oct. 13.—The names of those Americans were reported under consideration today for the appointment of an ambassador to represent the League of Nations to deal with the question of caring for refugees.

Alfred E. Smith, Col. Theodore Roosevelt, former Governor-General of the Philippines, and Nichols Roosevelt, former Minister to Hungary, were mentioned in connection with the appointment.

Mr. Smith declined to comment on the report. Asked at Albany whether he would accept the appointment, the former Governor said: "I don't know anything about it. I never heard of it."

Colonel Roosevelt told the Jewish Telegraph Agency that he has received no official word concerning the appointment, but he is considered for appointment and declined to comment.

Dickstein to Confer With Hull on Nazi Propaganda in U.S.

Immigration Committee Head Seeks to Prove Hitler Is Smuggling Agents Here

Representative Samuel Dickstein, chairman of the House Committee on Immigration, will leave for Washington Sunday to confer with Secretary of State Hull on the question of Nazi propaganda in the United States. He will be accompanied by his wife, who is being held at the airport by authorities.

Mr. Dickstein attracted considerable attention when he announced a few weeks ago that he had obtained evidence tending to prove that the German government is smuggling aliens into this country. Their purpose, Mr. Dickstein alleged, is to enter a New American party and to recruit here the policies of the Hitler regime.

The facts which have been unearthed by Mr. Dickstein will be presented by him to the congressional committee investigating members who are to be named.

More than 300 civilian employees have entered the United States recently, mostly to engage in propaganda work. Some 200 of them are Nazi party members. The propaganda is conducted by aliens in an organized system. Many other aliens have been smuggled into the country at the request of Mayor O'Connor.

Major Fioccola La Guardia, fusion mayoralty candidate, pointed out to Secretary Wallace that the Nazis were spreading their Jewish diet and advised him that he would be an appreciated substitute.

He was advised yesterday that an amount of beef in proportion to the number of Jews applying for the Government-supplied produce, would be made available to the New York meat market.

Official circles at the Capitol are urging Dr. Lederer to resign the office of Nazi liaison to the German ambassador, to appear before the Congressional Committee on Immigration and Naturalization, although Dr. Lederer may decline on grounds of diplomatic immunity.

The statements of Mr. Dickstein were contested by Dr. Lederer, who said that the Nazi influence in the country had been considerably decreased on account of the depression. The State Department issued a statement that it could not believe the figure which that of Congressmen Dickstein gave regarding the arrival of German consul attaches.

Meanwhile, from Berlin came the announcement that the Reich government has agreed to postpone the visit of the German Ambassador to the United States.

Hiller's Paper Attacks Dickstein's Investigation

BERLIN, Oct. 13.—The Voelkische Beobachter, leading Nazi organ, has attacked Samuel Dickstein for his announcement of an investigation of Nazi propagandists in the United States, submitted by the German government.

The Berlin paper asserted that to mention "all his lies was too much honor for Dickstein." In the same issue, Alfred Rosenberg, Nazi minister of propaganda of the Nazi party, indicated that the "influence of others," depicts the attitude of the League of Nations on the refugee question and stated that Germany would not be in private relief action for Ernst Thaeler, Professor Albert Einstein and others as long as the League is uninterested in the fate of the Golgotha.

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Irving Ben Cooper Keeps Up the Battle Against Tammany, Corruption, Rackets

Fusion's Candidate for the Bench Gives Reporter a Peep into His Amazing Supply of Evidence

Manhattan's problem of corrupt government is a modern Minstrel- Reformer, violent critics, campaigns and screaming journalists have avoided nothing against the master. It survives today let according to one of Tammany's most bitter foes, Irving Ben Cooper, Fusion candidate for City Court Judge, the reckoning is about to arrive.

What Tammany has done to Mr. Cooper can be seen in New York's Jewish attorney, and what Mr. Cooper is hoping to do to Tammany will some day make a newspaper. His case will possibly recede into myth when this short, lively, direct-from-the-shoulder investigator writes the record of the case.

The rough material for the story consisting of thousands of clippings, records, photographs and printed matter, was viewed by a representative of the Jewish Daily Bulletin at the office of Mr. Cooper, 531 Fifth Avenue. Mr. Cooper quoted the rising achievement of a reported 100,000 signatures to his "No to Tammany" on the steps of his nine-year's work as crusading member of the bar. But the temptation to search the files to determine what he did in the "doctor and nurse racket," the "super racket," the "ambulance chaser's racket," the genesis of "Tim Box Town," Brooklyn, and countless other stories of front-page interest, was too great.

Mr. Cooper was born February 7, 1892, in London, England, the son of poor parents who brought him to the United States at the age of 11. As a boy he worked for pin-money during the summer, including dish-washing, cigar and cigarette stringing, boot- shining and helped his folks at home. He studied at P. S. 323, Brooklyn, and later at the University of Brooklyn, Brooklyn College, and of George Washington University.

"I earned my own way by teaching foreign languages which I didn't know very well, but slightly better than my peers," he said. "In my childhood I always had a keen sense of justice. Today I feel sympathy for the underdog, for the oppressed, and am deeply moved by the fact that so many people have a lot of money to which they have no right."

Mr. Cooper has a sense for catchwords. He called the actions of the rich "greedy" and the poor "poor." He knew them at college. He knows them today. He coined the famous "Tammany Parties" nickname. He established the "McGraws" and "34 Little McQuadeans" a result of his investigation into the five million dollar barrel of oil which the Tammany Hall gang embezzled from the McGraws. He also coined the name "the 'stuff' on which my family feeds and lives." Senator Seaford's claim that "McCooper can't stand streets made against his life during the notorious investigation by thugs whom he judged to be emissaries of certain

individuals into whose affairs he was investigating. One of the themes was a letter warning that physical violence would be done his unless he remained from the investigation Committee.

Mr. Cooper told of how he had "by means of a kind intuition," happened upon persons who had been tampered with in his investigation of the Magistrate's Court when he assisted Isidor Koenig. He explained millions of dollars were stolen from women clients as prostitutes by members of the chaotic vice squad which had been created and reorganized by Mr. Cooper. The former eloquent, possibly forgetting for the moment he was not talking before the press, said:

"Mr. Cooper is never without a cigar in his mouth. He acquired the nervous habit during the intense days of the Wall Street trial when for hours without end he hit into the walls of his study, shouting 'Break it! Break it!' and began to provide much of the 'dope' which sent the former Mayor out of office."

With pride Mr. Cooper exhibited a forged check which he had forged in glowing terms his service in the investigation.

Then Mr. Cooper did something which he did not expect to reward a large, and embarrassed his hostess. He touched his little white moustache and smiled.

"Then there was the forged check racket . . ."

Milwaukee Divided On Rioting, Arrests Luther Visit Caused

Score City Attorney's Failure To Prosecute Demonstrators Against Nazis's Reception

MILWAUKEE, Wis., Oct. 13.—In the ranks of their brethren over the anti-Semitic barbarities over Germany, Milwaukee Jews are being concerned by the possibility of terrorist demonstrations still going on over the suppression by the police of a radical demonstration against Hitlerism when Dr. Klaus Luther, German ambassador, visited Milwaukee.

Newspapers have entered the fray with sharply conflicting editorials. Communists in both local and national periodicals have made the most of the fact that in their Milwaukee the police club the workers. And Socialists find themselves pained from both radical and conservative ranks—from the former for having been the least with the police, from the latter, for being so severe.

The newspaper angle of the conflict is particularly interesting. The Milwaukee Journal, leading even the socialists, published a front-page editorial, denouncing the city attorney's office for refusing to prosecute the demonstrators arrested by police and beaten with nightsticks.

"The Socialists had a record of trying to interfere with the police department," the Journal pointedly, "They would serve Milwaukee better to let the police do their work."

"It is a poor spectacle, also, for a man to stand up in the city attorney's," the Journal wrote. "Is he for riots, or against them?"

The Milwaukee Sentinel, a Paul Block paper, defended the police, too, but at the same time deplored Luther's visit as unwelcome at a time when Germany was again so high.

From the Milwaukee Leader, the Socialist daily, came a ringing return to the Journal's stand.

"The Milwaukee Journal criticizes the police, the city attorney and the city attorney's office as well as the city does not have one solitary word to say in criticism of those who brought Hitler here."

Peter Bergman, Leader argued that if a group of bankers, or football fans, or military marchers blocked traffic for a few minutes, as the local radicals did, neither the Journal would have been so upset, nor the police dispersed sharply.

Hegemonizing that the police department is divorced from control by Socialist city officials, the Leader asserted that the police had the strength of the police to keep Luther from causing here because his presence was "calculated to be a menace to public order." The paper described Luther as the representative of an "occupied regime."

Meanwhile, the Socialists have a committee investigating the demonstration to determine whether the police used excessive, racial violence in breaking without permission. A widespread feeling exists among liberals that police treated too ready to the German leaders who brought Luther here, and that they were too quick to break up what was merely a non-violent assembly of the Hyde Park variety.

A Family Breaks Up

WHEN we say that fifty thousand Jews have left Germany or that 3,527 Jewish lawyers in Thuringia have been dismissed, the mind refuses to build out of such statistics a picture vivid enough to serve as a statement of the situation. Statistics unfortunately too often an occasion of the crisis which they are supposed to bring out. The 3,527 cold record of one typical refugee out of Germany will magnify the drama and the pathos in the "cases" of the other 49,999 refugees and a few brief announcements of the fate of the disbarred lawyers in the state of Thuringia will suggest the "cases" of the 3,526 other Jewish lawyers.

There is in Germany today the fragment of a Jewish family which is represented by a lone fragment—a paragraph or two of the epitome of the Jewish fate in Germany. I do not call this a typical German-Jewish family, but it is a specific family and its breakup is symptomatic of the temporary degeneration which Hitler is undergoing.

The family is curiously heterogeneous, with some of the members showing a distinct inclination to Nationalism rather than Socialism. Before his death, the father was a man of progressive business, which he widely continued to manage. His attitude may have been from the fact that shortly after Hitler's rise to power, she wrote one of her sons that she, and members of her set, would be happy to see Hitler succeed.

Sixty years ago, a year before Hitler, however, the only son had come in under the quota and taken out naturalization papers. Several years before, a daughter had left for the states. Shortly after the Nazis had suppressed the last of Hitler's No. 100,000, he had received a refugee friend in Paris news that another sister had fled to Prague. Now these remain in a small town in Germany but the mother and one daughter, out of a thriving family group, had died; another daughter, still loyal to the Nazis, who had been brought up to live as to her own mother, had refused to accompany the sister who had fled to Prague. And now, in the same way, that the nephew, daughter of the tall fatherless son for his motherless and sister are to sail out of Germany for parts unspecified. In the meantime, the white-haired woman is liquidating her little property, and it is in a fashion something like this, and much worse, that the family is breaking the Jews of Germany.

This paragraph says, in effect, that no son of a Jew or grandson of a Jew may preach the gospel of Christ or serve the Church in any way. Jews should recognize, for good or ill, that the Hitler racial ideology destroys, root and branch, that conception on which is based the enormous missionary effort of the Christian churches, whether in the jungles of Africa or in the cities of Western Europe and the Far East. The Aryan race theory destroys also, or seeks to destroy either, the principle of free will in the choice of a creed. The Hitlerites, in effect, preach predestination and damnation. A man does not choose his creed; his race chooses him and his race determines what body of his creed, of which the religious

faith of the man is the least considerable part. Indeed, in the early part of July, Adolf Hitler, in a speech to the anti-Semitic youth of his predecessors of his as Hitler was bulked of his race, because it was based on religious grounds, and the hundred could easily end anti-Semitism by submitting to the minor inconvenience of the baptismal waters.

Self-preservation is the first law of man. Woman Doctor Flees Nazi Camp, Faints of Hunger on Warsaw Street

WARSAW, Oct. 3.—A terrible tragedy was revealed here when a young woman who had fainted in the streets was brought before the local newspaper. She was alone and had been wandering about during the streets of Warsaw for several days, apparently homeless.

On inquiry it appeared that she was a Jewess by the name of Dr. Leopoldina Kornet, a physician who had a Doctor of Philosophy, who had been the daughter of a wealthy Leipzig few, who had studied at the University of Vienna, and had then practiced as a doctor in Leipzig. When Hitler came into power, she was

arrested and put in a concentration camp, from which she managed to escape to Poland. She had to Warsaw on foot, and had vainly been trying to find a position as a physician or even as a nurse, had walked about the city, homeless and hungry, until she fainted of hunger.

On being asked why she had not registered with the Warsaw Red Cross, she replied that she had not wanted to fall a burden to anyone, and she had been too proud to ask for help.

Her condition was immediately collected among sympathetic and presented to her, but she refused to accept it; and walked back to the walls in which she had been spending her nights.

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

Siberian Emigration Declines While Palestine Prospers; The Contrast

This year it has about 2,000 locomotives at its disposal, while the railway line which runs over Soviet territory to the left of the Amur, measures no less than 3,000 kilometers.

The occupation of the East-China railroad by the Japanese has thus already prolonged the transportation time from Vladivostok by two or three days (100 km. apart) from the fact that only a single railway line is at the disposal of the Russians. And this single line is within reach of the Japanese field army by the boundary.

The name "Wladivostok" therefore sounds today more like a picnic slogan than like a call to battle. Soviet Russia is on the defensive.

The East-China Amur province is in greater danger today than it was even since 1932, when the Japanese army withdrew from Vladivostok. Nevertheless, the Japanese field army

Refugees Streaming Into Poland Discover Hospitality of the Poverty-Stricken and Hostility of Natives Who Fear Competition

KATOWICE, Oct. 3.—Officials estimate that more than six thousand Jews have fled from Germany since April and passed through this little city in Polish Upper Silesia.

A few of them—perhaps one thousand—have remained here. The rest have scattered to various parts of Poland.

Each has brought his story of hardship and oppression. And from them one may learn more about who remains in Germany than from those who remain in that country.

Poland's two most industrialized parts of Poland are finding this country so provided land of milk and honey. Officially Denounced**

MUNICH, Germany, Oct. 13.—Disturbances of the newspaper pillars used particularly for denouncing and branding purchases in Jewish shops, was ordered yesterday by the Bavarian government.

The government declared that such unfriendly attacks against individuals and meddling in personal affairs of shopkeepers and their spouses and persons is not the business of newspapers who wish to cooperate in the national revolution.

The government said it is in effect conditions to deal with offenders against the nation, while others resist refusal from continuing the pillars; otherwise, action will be taken against them.

At the same time the Nazi party disclosed the crucial fact that "wide groups of the population are not making any purchases in other places where they are unknown, fearing that if they are seen buying in the Jewish shops of their own home town they will be persecuted."

The Nazi management therefore assures the population that they can continue to buy at home, without fear of molestation from any quarter.

The press statement of individual enterprises is not in the interest of economic peace.

"It is not to us to say to a form of government any nation may seek to impose," he said. "That is the business of the people themselves. Now it is when the people are bound to be as bonds of fraternities are represented or thrown into prison, when labor organizations are destroyed, I cannot conceive of an American laborer who would not be moved."

The speaker pleaded for widespread support of the boycott, adding, "If we declare the people of Germany that you will not buy goods and ride on your shoes, we strike at the heart of this curse."

"If there is one organization in the world or in America that stands for the protection of men, regardless of race, color, religion, or creed, it is the American Federation of Labor."

"I could not, as a responsible leader, support this cause to the best of my judgment, but attempting to cover up my feelings."

LANSING, Mich., Oct. 13.—Particular significance is Jewish life in Lansing and East Lansing to Alpha Lit Society, the Jewish fraternity at Michigan State College located in the latter city. Now in its fourth year of activity at this institution, it has become an important factor in campus life there. Organization of the fraternity was motivated in 1929 by the desire of the growing number of Jewish students at Michigan State to become more closely affiliated as a group with the various activities and interests on the campus and to create opportunities for social and fraternal contacts at the institution.

Out of a total of about 30 Jewish students at Michigan State, more than half of them are prominent in the various fields of study. Nearly twenty are members of the fraternity and the rest have signified their intention of joining the organization within a short time. Officers of the fraternity for 1933-34 are Prof. Philip Schwartz as general adviser for the group. Also included in the membership of Alpha Lit are a number of Jewish students from other colleges in the state, most of whom are now located in other parts of the country. Most of these men are prominent in athletics or other campus or university functions.
