Roumania Declares State Of Martial Law After Anti-Jewish Outburst

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BUCHAREST, Roumania, Oct. 14—The government of Roumania decided today to reintroduce martial law in the country beginning in November. This decision was taken in view of the resumed unrest in Roumania and the growing anti-Semitic agitation, now assuming more menacing forms.

Today's anti-Semitic disturbance at Braila resulted in Police President Michalescu being beaten unconscious by Iron Guardists, Roumanian anti-Semites, when he attempted to prevent their Jew-baiting activities. The Iron Guardists thereupon marched through the streets of the town shouting anti-Semitic abuse and breaking windows in the homes of Jews. This continued until the police, heavily reinforced, finally dispersed the demonstration, arresting several of the participants.

The Roumanian press reports growing incitement against the Jews, particularly in Bucharest, where anti-Semitic students have developed a fierce agitation against the Jews. They are distributing leaflets and books attacking the Jews freely all over the city and are marching nightly through Bucharest singing anti-Jewish songs and shouting, "Unmask Zidane" (unmask the Jews).

The Cuzist agitation, led by the

Jerusalem Is Quiet After

Arab Demonstration

JERUSALEM, Oct. 14—Peace was completely reestablished in Jerusalem today following the abortive attempt made by the Arabs Friday to demonstrate as a protest against the continuing of Jewish immigration into Palestine and the sale of land to Jews. The city is quiet, harmony has been restored and the stores, closed in anticipation of trouble, are once more open.

During the entire incident, which was short of duration, not a single Jew was injured. The clashes were confined to the police and the Arab demonstrators.

Twenty-two were injured, it was

FEAR EXIT OF GERMANY FROM LEAGUE OF NATIONS SEALS DOOM OF REICH'S JEWRY

AMSTERDAM, Oct. 14—The withdrawal of Germany from the League of Nations is expected to have immediate repercussions on the situation of the Jews in Germany, which will make it more critical than at any time since Adolf Hitler and his brown-shirt cohorts seized supreme power in the Reich.

An immediate effect will be the complete collapse of whatever moderating influences foreign public opinion, as expressed especially at Geneva, has had on Nazi Jewish policies. Only the almost unanimous condemnation of the world beyond the Reich has checked, up to now, the complete extinction of Jewish life in Germany and induced the Nazi leaders to modify their policies.

Berlin Sees Decision Blow to Jewish Hope

BERLIN, Oct. 14—Germany's resignation from the League of Nations and the summoning of a new Reichstag election for November 12 constitute a blow to Jewish interests because it eliminates the moral pressure which the League has thus far exercised in modifying the anti-Jewish policies put into effect by the Nazi regime.

Whatever the attitude of the German Government may be towards the German Jews, it is clear that the fight conducted by Jews abroad for the restoration of Jewish rights henceforth will have to be conducted along altogether different lines since League intercession is no longer of influence here.

Foreign circles here point out that the decision of the German government to quit the League is due not only to the disagreement over disarmament but also to the recent discussions of the Jewish question regarding which the German delegation at Geneva felt very bitter. The decision of the government to withdraw from the League was no surprise to the public since it had been forecast on the grounds of the Jewish question in the German press during the past few days.

With Germany out of the League and in a position where she can expect no further favors from the powers, foreign disapproval of the Nazi anti-Jewish program, it is pointed out here, will no longer carry weight and the Jews of Germany may be sacrificed to the virulent anti-Semitism created by fourteen years of unceasing anti-Jewish propaganda carried on by the National Socialist party.

New Reichstag Election

The calling of new Reichstag elections at this time, when the nationalist and chauvinist spirit is bound to be aroused to its most feverish pitch, constitutes a new element of danger to the Jewish population since Nazi propaganda activities, as in the past, will undoubtedly stir the populace against the Jews as the root of all of Germany's evils and ascribe Germany's action in quitting the League as having been necessitated by Jewish manipulations abroad. The gravest fears are therefore entertained among Jewish leaders here regarding the fate of the Jews in Germany in the immediate future.

The withdrawal of Germany from the League is expected here to be accompanied by an intensification of

Hitler, in Radio Address, Refers to 'Slanders' Abroad

BERLIN, Oct. 14—While Chancellor Hitler in his radio speech to-night over a national hook-up made no direct attack on the Jews and abstained from raising the Jewish question directly, he referred to German refugees abroad who are misinterpreting German youth's march against Communism, as preparations for war. The Chancellor denounced these homeless refugees as men who are prepared to do anything for personal gain.

At the same time he attacked those who spread atrocity propaganda, but failed to specify to whom he referred.

Offices Padlocked of Pole Anti-Jew Group

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Poland, Oct. 14.—The anti-Semitic boycott organization known as the "Rozwoj" was closed down by the Polish authorities today and their premises sealed on the ground that they were endangering the public peace.

At the same time new outbursts of anti-Semitism are being reported daily, provoked by the Endeks, notorious anti-Semite political party, despite the fact that they are strongly checked by the authorities.

The opening of the colleges has been used by the Endeks as the occasion for strong anti-Semitic disturbances. An Endek student actually attempted to drag a Jewish professor from the platform during a lecture in the Agricultural College. Pro-government students succeeded in collaring the offender and turning him over to the police. He is now faced with expulsion. During the incident Endek students supported the assailant, sang anti-Jewish songs and shouted abuse at the Jewish professors.

At the Polytechnic University, the rector was shouted down by anti-Semitic students when he appealed for peace in his opening address.

Vilno Jews Complain Of New Nazi Outfit

VILNO, Poland, Oct. 14 — Responsible Jewish citizens of the village of Driszowa, have complained to the authorities against the formation of a Nazi organization in their town.

The complaint describes the constant fear under which the Jews are living and cites attacks, beatings and breaking of windows in the houses of the Jews.

rearmament activities in Germany. Rearmament in Germany, it is an open secret, has been proceeding with the utmost haste ever since Hitler came into power.

It is hardly likely that France and the other nations bordering on the Reich will permit this to continue without an attempt to enforce on Germany the disarmament clauses of the Versailles Treaty. A conflict which might even lead to war has been brought much nearer as a result of the German withdrawal.

Germany's reiteration of her willingness to disarm providing the other nations also do so, is scouted by the Dutch press as being merely camouflage for Germany's real intention to rearm. The economic situation in Germany, which has become more and more serious, it is believed, may have influenced the decision to withdraw from the League in order to shift public interest from the economic to the political situation. It is generally considered that Hitler and moderate elements in the party were opposed to the move, with Premier Goering of Prussia and Dr. Goebbels, the propaganda minister, chiefly responsible.

The worst misgivings in case of war are felt here for the Jews of Germany. Deprived of the protection of foreign opinion from which Germany no longer expects to gain anything, the Jews may easily become the victims of the hysteria and excitement of war fever and the unleashed anti-Semitic passions stirred up by propagandists. President von Hindenburg will no longer be in a position, as he was seven months ago, to resist Hitler's plea for "a night of the long knives" and a failed attempt on Hitler's life—a danger which German Jews have had to fear for months—would be the signal for a nation-wide massa-

cre which no external public opinion could circumvent.

Another immediate effect of the German withdrawal from the League will concern the Jews in the plebiscite area of Upper Silesia, which Germany administers under the German-Polish convention of 1922. Germany was reluctantly forced to accede to League demands last Spring to remove anti-Jewish restrictions in Upper Silesia and to accord the Jewish population there full minority rights.

With Germany out of the League and no longer feeling itself bound to observe the League's decisions, the speedy removal of the few rights still held by Upper Silesian Jews is anticipated. Profound misgivings are felt in Jewish circles generally at the fate of the Upper Silesian Jews at the hands of the Nazis there who have had to chafe under League restraint while their colleagues in the Reich proper were able to do almost as they pleased with and to the Jews among them.

See Election as Hitler Bid for Blank Check

LONDON, Oct. 14.—The new elections in Germany will be held exclusively on the basis of the disarmament question and will not have a domestic aspect, the liberal press here points out in dispatches from Berlin. It will not affect the Jewish question, which is considered an internal matter, these papers hold.

The Nazi regime, from the internal viewpoint, has been unpopular in Germany lately, and Hitler hopes to regain the national confidence on the issue of disarmament. In this, they predict, he will undoubtedly be supported by an overwhelming majority.

The result of the election, as it is seen here by the press, will be that Hitler will receive a blank check from the German people and that his regime, the existence of which was in danger of collapse owing to its unpopularity in its domestic policy, will now receive a new lease on life.

Antwerp Cathedral Chimes Play the Jewish Anthem

ANTWERP, Belgium, Oct. 13.—Today on the occasion of Simchat Torah (the Rejoicing in the Law), the Antwerp Cathedral chimes played the Jewish anthem "Hatikvah." The chimes were heard all over Antwerp, increasing the festive atmosphere and gratifying the Jewish population.

Nazi M.D.s. Must Display Sign They Are "German"

BERLIN, Oct. 14.—The Nazi doctors union in the Hessen district has made it compulsory for all members to supply a sign, "German Doctor."

At the same time Wuerttemberg Nazis distributed Aryan signs to all shopkeepers excluding only non-Aryans, those married to non-Aryans and shops where Jewish capital is known to be interested.

The Nazis ordered the storekeepers to display the signs prominently.

Kurt Hiller, Victim of Nazi 'Gestapo', in Serious Condition, Paper Reveals

LONDON, Oct. 14—Kurt Hiller, well-known Jewish journalist who was arrested in the early days of the Nazi regime, imprisoned in a concentration camp, released and subsequently rearrested in August by the Gestapo, terroristic Nazi secret police organization, is in a critical condition, according to a special article in The Manchester Guardian.

Hiller is reported as suffering from wounds received from beatings at the hands of the terrorists. It is alleged that steel rods were used on his body.

The article discloses that the Gestapo maintains a special prison in Columbia Strasse, Berlin, formerly a military prison. About twenty Jews are behind its bars. During the recent Jewish High Holidays they were ordered into the courtyard of the prison and obliged to mumble Hebrew prayers amid Nazi jeers.

According to the correspondent of The Guardian, flogging is the lightest form of torture. Other forms of torture are practiced, he writes, which are the exclusive invention of the Hitlerite government officials.

Dismissed Jews Are Shorn of Legal Right

BERLIN, Oct. 14—The existing employment law does not aim to protect Jewish employees; therefore dismissed Jewish employees, bringing action against employers, cannot claim protection under the law, today's Juristisches Wochenblatt, published by Minister of Justice Frank, declared. The statement was issued in order to clarify the confusion existing in the courts as to whether Jewish employees could be dismissed without any notice, the paper declared.

Although after the order issued on May 15, Jewish employees could not be dismissed without notice, a difference should nevertheless be made by the courts, Minister Frank's paper stated, between Jewish employers and Aryan employers. The latter are entitled to dismiss their Jewish employees, if the Aryan employees demand the dismissals or if customers boycott the firm for employing Jews.

Generally, the paper explains, the anti-Jewish boycott justifies the dismissal of Jews without notice and without compensation. But Jewish firms are not entitled to dismiss their Jewish employees without notice on the excuse of the boycott and must pay the dismissed employees compensation.

Three U. S. Inquiries Affecting Nazis Are Getting Under Way

Action by the federal government on three counts in arresting the Nazi propaganda campaign in America, investigating charges of custom officials that German-made products are being imported under trade names of other nations and providing protection for American citizens in Germany, crystallized here yesterday.

Representative Samuel Dickstein, chairman of the House Immigration Committee, was to entrain for Washington tonight to interview the President and Secretary of State Hull in connection with the propaganda campaign he is investigating. Assistant U. S. Attorney Joseph E. Brill was engaged in organizing an intensive investigation of firms which are alleged to be importing Nazi merchandise from which the trade sign "made in Germany" has been obliterated.

Representative Dickstein declared in a statement issued exclusively to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency that word from President Roosevelt with regard to the whole German situation as it relates to Americans can be expected this week.

Representative Dickstein declared that "the Government is fed up" with the Nazis. He said that he will cooperate with labor officials in prosecuting the boycott against German goods and services.

Assistant U. S. Attorney Brill will launch an investigation into illegal importation of German products. At his offices in the Federal Building he announced that three custom house officials, including Peter Sullivan, H. E. Wagner and Frank Large, are to assist him. He quoted the following paragraphs from section 304, Tariff Act of 1930, prohibiting the removal of labels from imported products.

"Every article imported into the United States, and its immediate container, and the package in which such article is imported, shall be marked, labeled, stamped, or branded, in legible English words, in a conspicuous place, in such a manner as to indicate the country of origin of such article, in accordance with such regulations as the Secretary of Treasury may, by regulations prescribed hereunder, except any article for the requirements of marking, stamping, branding or labeling if he is satisfied such article is incapable of being marked, stamped or labeled or cannot be marked, stamped or labeled without injury, or except at expense economically prohibitive of importation, or that the marking, stamping or branding or labeling of the immediate container of such article will reasonably indicate the country of origin of such article."

Dr. Marx, C. V. Official, On Trial for Bribery, Reveals Pact With Goering

FRANKFURT, Germany, Oct. 14—The trial of Dr. Marx, representative of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, and the former chief of the Frankfurt political police, Ferdinand Muerdel, has aroused considerable interest in Germany. Dr. Marx is accused of bribing Herr Muerdel in order to secure confidential information about Nazi activities in the possession of the police, prior to the Nazi advent to power.

Testimony in the first two days of the trial which began Wednesday and is expected to continue for a week, revealed that an agreement had been reached last March, immediately after the Nazis began to rule, between the Central Union and

regulation is a fine of \$5,000, a year in prison, or both.

Mr. Brill said that principal offenders were importers of chemicals, gloves, bric-a-brac, clothing and jewelry. He said that arrests may be expected soon.

The feeling against Germany which is manifesting itself in the widespread boycott which now has the support of about four million members of the American Federation of Labor in addition to numerous Jewish and non-Jewish organizations, has resulted in subterfuge on the part of importers who deal with German merchandisers. The latest method, he said, of marking goods is by attaching removable labels or tags. These are removed when they are placed in retail shops, he said. Others stamp their products with the legend "made in the United States."

stated by the authorities, including five members of the Arab Executive who were in the forefront of the procession. Among the injured members of the Arab Executive was the secretary, Moghannam. Twelve other Arab demonstrators were also injured. Five policemen received injuries. All the wounds were of a minor nature.

An official communique issued last night stressed the fact that the Palestine government after learning from the press of the contemplated demonstration, had issued an order prohibiting it. Nevertheless, a crowd of approximately two thousand Arabs attempted to form a procession upon leaving the Mosque of Omar, whereupon the police, the government declares, "displaying the greatest forbearance and restraint, endeavored to persuade the crowd to disperse peacefully." But the demonstrators persisted and the police were obliged to use their batons.

One hundred Arab women and many Arab notables headed the demonstration in order to make the police task in dispersing the demonstration more difficult, speculating on the likelihood that the police would not attack women.

Premier Goering of Prussia, in which the Central Union was permitted to continue its fight against anti-Semitism.

The trial was featured by attempts made by the prosecutor to discredit the Central Union activities and to interpret complaints made by the Central Union against officials with Nazi leanings as denunciations.

Dr. Marx stoutly denied that he had bribed Herr Muerdel and insisted that the police had been rewarded merely for legitimate actions such as discovering the desecrators of Jewish cemeteries and similar offenses. He upheld the activities of the Central Union and declared that the Central Union had rendered great services to Germany by combating atrocity stories abroad. He stated that the Central Union was non-political and that it had merely fought against anti-Semitism in Germany.

notorious Jew-baiter, Professor Alexander Cuza, is being particularly concentrated in connection with the trial on November 18, of the peasant Emil Siancu, who is accused of murdering the Jewish merchant Moritz Tischler, two months ago.

Tischler brought action against a group of peasants including Siancu for trespassing on his fields. And while the trial was being heard in court, Siancu fired at Tischler, killing him.

The Cuzists have formed a committee of two hundred lawyers and have invited two hundred political witnesses, including the Roumanian Patriarch, to show that Siancu acted under provocation of the Jews who are exploiting the bleeding peasantry.

The anti-Semitic press in Roumania has presented Siancu as a glorified victim of Jewish exploitation rather than as a murderer.

Hessen Jews Arrested for Reading Yiddish Paper

WARSAW, Oct. 14—The Polish Telegraphic Agency reported from Hessen, a southern German state, that five Jews have been arrested in the township of Hambirn on the charge that they bought and read the Warsaw "Hajnt", a Polish-Yiddish daily, which has not been forbidden by the German authorities.

The Polish consul intervened on behalf of the arrested Jews, claiming that the sale of the Hajnt is legal.

Board of Guardians, Social Service Bureau, Merge Their Activities

The Jewish Social Service Bureau of Brooklyn and the Jewish Board of Guardians have merged their organizations in order to meet the problems of delinquency among Jewish youth more efficiently, George Z. Medalie, United States District Attorney for the Southern district of New York and president of the Jewish Board of Guardians announced. The merger was the result of an intensive study of delinquency among Jewish boys and girls in New York City, made recently.

"The need for consolidation came principally from the fact that the Jewish population in Brooklyn has increased by leaps and bounds in the last two decades," said Mr. Medalie.

"It has been felt for some time that the efforts to aid those whom we called delinquents have been scattered and that the work should be concentrated in one agency. There were difficulties in the way, more of a formal nature, which had to be overcome; but with the aid of those interested in the work the two organizations have now pooled their efforts."

Schiff Scout Reservation To Be Dedicated Wednesday

MENDHAM, N. J., Oct. 14—Elaborate preparations are being made for the dedication here Wednesday, of the Mortimer L. Schiff Scout Reservation. Governor Moore will make the address of welcome and Dr. John H. Finley, associate editor of the New York Times, will deliver the principal address. Walter W. Head, president of the Boy Scouts of America, will preside. Governor Moore and Governor Lehman of New York are honorary chairmen of the reception committee.

The Reservation was purchased by the late Mrs. Jacob H. Schiff, mother of Mortimer Schiff. The latter during his lifetime was a charter member of the executive board, international commissioner and former president of the Boy Scouts of America.

Jewish Sport Body Banned
