Racial Issue Raised in City Election With Charge McKee Is Anti-Semitic

An article which Joseph V. Mc-Kee, independent Democratic candidate for mayor of New York City, wrote in 1915, in which he criticized Iewish students as lacking moral principles, revived last week, continued to arouse a storm of protest yesterday among the Jewish popula-tion of the city and threw the racial issue squarely into the election

Brought into the open by Fiorella H. La Guardia, Fusion candidate for the mayoralty, the charge that Mr. McKee was anti-Semitic appeared certain to cause serious damage to his candidacy by alienating a good part of the support of Jewish voters and of the liberal and reform elements which had flocked to him as their standard-bearer in the municipal elections.

The article, which appeared in the Catholic World, in 1915, declared that Jews in the high schools "recognize no code of morals and are concerned with no motives Dr. Sherwood Eddy Tribute higher than those originating from fear of detection and consequent loss of money, etc."

The article arose openly to plague Mr. McKee when, in response to a telegram he sent Major La Guardia demanding that he disavow Samuel Seabury's attack on Governor Lehman, the fiery Fusion leader accused Mr. McKee of drawing "a red her-(Continued on Page 2)

BUCHAREST, Oct. 16-A boycott of Jewish goods, and particularly of the Jewish press was voted today at the first meeting of the newly-con-stituted Nazi Christian-Fascist party of which Stepan Tatarescu is the head.

Immediate action leading to the expulsion of a half-million Jews who allegedly entered Roumania since Tatarescu declared. Part of Marx Trial to Be Held Behind Closed Doors: Five Witnesses Summoned

FRANKFURT, Germany, Oct. 16

The trial of Dr. Marx, representative of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, and Ferdinand Muerdel, former chief of the Frankfurt political police, will now be continued behind closed doors. Evidence that is allegedly dangerous to the Nazi state will be heard. The trial is expected to continue for some days.

Dr. Marx is accused of having bribed Herr Muerdel in order to obtain confidential information on Nazi activities, which was in the hands of the political police.

The trial continues to concentrate and revolve around the question of the Central Union activities in preventing the spread of Nazi propaganda and acts against the Jews. The prosecution is still endeavoring to establish that collaboration be-(Continued on Page 4)

Nazi Press Mixes Attacks On Jews With Invitation

To Visit Reich as Tourists (Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Oct. 15—A Nazi orga-

nization network directed against the Jews in various countries outside of Germany was disclosed here in articles in a number of Berlin newspapers including Adolf Hitler's Voelkischer Beobachter. The articles were devoted exclusively to the stirring up of anti-Semitic feeling abroad

Special articles were published on the role of the Jews in Hungary, Denmark, Poland, Holland, Switzerland, Lithuania and other countries adjacent to the Reich where the Nazis expect fertile soil for anti-Jewish agitation among the Germanspeaking elements of the population. As if the various articles, each of

which purports to be a report on Jewish activity in a particular land, had been written by one, all carry identical allegations that the Jews are deceiving the local non-Jewish population, are spreading communist propaganda and are capturing control of the press. Áll strongly urge that German Jews be not permitted to enter the countries under discussion.

Most of the attacks on Jews are made late at night and despite the fact that in each instance the police have been informed of the attacks, not a single one of the at-tackers has been apprehended and

brought to justice.

A Jewish chemist was among those who were attacked last night. He was seriously injured and taken

to a hospital.

The Tewish inhabitants of the Syngrou quarter of Salonica, where

the attacks chiefly occur, are terri-fied and complain of the incompetence of the police.

Report of Foreign Policy Association Gives Lie to Whitewashing of Nazis

A summary of events in Germany since the advent of the Nazis to pewer has been issued by the Foreign Policy Association in the form of a report, "The Jews in the Third Reich".

The report, signed by Mildred S. Wertheimer, research associate, reaches the conclusion that the position of all non-Aryans in the Reich is precarious and that their "connomic future is black." It also stresses that the younger generation of non-Aryans will, "nor only be of non-Aryans will, "nor only be cational opportunities open to the even now are strictly limited."

"The Jews in the Third Reich" is carefully documented and references are given for every quotation used. It discusses in detail, The Brown Terror, the position of the Jews beforce the national revolution, the "Cold Fegrom," the restrictions im-"cultural" activities under the Nazis, commerce and industry and the refugee problem.

In addition there is a very comprehensive table of figures on the occupational distributions of Jews and non-Jews gainfully employed in Frussia, where one third of the German Jews live, which shows that the average percentage of Jews employed in various fields was only posed in various fields was only Jews in public posts, on which the Nazis have laid so much stress, is only 32 of one per cent of the total number of officials.

Mogen Dovid and Swastika To Fly Side by Side on 2 Palestine Coast Boats

HAMBURG, Germany, Oct. 16-The Eliza and White Zionist flan with the Mogen Dovid, the star of David, will fly side by side with the German swastika flag, when two German boats will begin to operate, within a short time, on Palestinian coastal transport

The Atlantic Shipping Company is sending two motorships to Palestine today loaded with the belong-ings of German Jews who have emigrated to Palestine. As the ships are registered in Germany they are bound to carry the official German flags. But upon their arrival in Palestine, where they will be used for local service, they will in addition fly the Zionist flag, probably in the hope of securing Jewish business and of counteracting the hatred of the swastika flag.

Sokolow Leads Memorial

March to Herzl Grave (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Oct. 15—Dr. Nahum Sokolow, president of the World Zionist Organization, headed the traditional march to the grave of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement. In the procession to the grave in the Jewish cemetery where Dr. Herzl lies buried Dr. Sokolow was accompanied by the Zionist president of the Vienna Jewish community, Dr. Friedman.

Austrian chalutzim, future pion-eers in Palestine, and Zionist students acted as a guard of honor at

the graveside.

In view of the general tension in Austria, the police prohibited a march through the streets and the display of Zionist banners and em-blems. However, the number of Zionists assembled at the cemetery

itself was larger than usual.

More than 1,000 persons attended the dinner at the Hotel Commodore on Sunday evening to inaugurate the campaign and listened to speeches by Lewis I. Douglas, director of the Federal Budget, Justice Joseph M. Proskauer and other leaders in Jewish affairs. After the dinner the guests heard President Roosevelt's radio address from Washington on

"Mobilizing for Human Needs." Justice Proskauer, speaking at the dinner, stated that philanthropic organizations will face their gravest obligations this year in making na-tional recovery a reality for "the millions who have lost courage and confidence through the depression, as well as the sick, aged, orphaned and needy, whose care has always been the peculiar duty of private agencies." As a measure toward acceptance of a personal "code," pat-terned after the recovery codes in industry, with responsibility to aid the needy, sick and helpless as one of its major planks.

Mr. Douglas warned against hopes that the Government can perform "miracles" in achieving recovery. "No President, irrespective of how great a leader he may be, and no government can accomplish such a miracle," he said. "We must be patient. Jewish War Invalids Must Get Permission to Leave Reich Without Pension Loss

(Jewish Talegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Oct. 16-Cancellation of the pensions of Jewish war invalids going abroad unless they obtain permission to leave Germany from port of Jewish Philanthropic Socie-ties. The volunteer workers are the authorities was announced today in a communication to the Jewish Soldiers' Association.

War invalids must also obtain permission from the Labor Ministry if they plan to leave Germany, but even if the permission is granted by the authorities, the pension may be withdrawn at any time, without any reason being given, thus leaving the invalid stranded abroad.

The Jewish Soldiers' Association at the same time declared that Tewish war invalids who were excluded from the labor unions because they were Jews but who reside in Germany are entitled to continuation of

their pensions.

Austrian Student Nazis In Clashes With Police (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Austria, Oct. 16-Nazi disturbances were resumed in the universities and colleges this morning following the retirement of several Nazi professors including Professor Gleispach, notorious advocate of the anti-Semitic student move-

Clashes between the Nazi students and the police continued for some time and a number of shots were fired. So far it has not been established whether Jews were injured in the rioting. The Poly-technic Institute was closed by the The Poly. police as a result of the outbreak.

The unfurling of a large swastikaflag at the Polytechnic Institute was. the signal for a country-wide demonstration at the universities. clashes immediately assumed a scrious character and the students were not dispersed until the police resorted to the use of their sabres.

(Continued from Page 1) tween Dr. Marx and Herr Muerdel was illegal and that the former head of the political police was not entitled to acquaint Dr. Marx with the

contents of police documents. However, both of the defendants insist that they were working to-

gether for the same cause, to protect the then existing regime, and that they were entitled to exchange confidences.

Herr Steinberg, former president of the Frankfurt police and promi-nent Frankfurt Jewish leader, who was certified as being ill in Berlin and therefore unable to attend the trial as a witness, was ordered, in a telegram sent by the court, to anpear tomorrow.

The prosecutor urgently demanded the presence in the court of Herr Steinberg. Otherwise he demanded that the court proceed to Berlin to cross-examine the former Jewish police president.

Today several police officers testified that the rewards given by the Central Union to Herr Muerdel were not justified since the tracing of offenders who had desecrated the Jewish cemetery was carried out without any difficulty.
