Racial Issue Raised in City Election With Charge McKee Is Anti-Semitic

An article which Joseph V. McKee, independent Democratic candidate for mayor of New York City, wrote in 1915, in which he criticized Jewish students as lacking moral principles, revived last week, continued to arouse a storm of protest yesterday among the Jewish population of the city and threw the racial issue squarely into the election arena.

Brought into the open by Fiorella H. La Guardia, Fusion candidate for the mayoralty, the charge that Mr. McKee was anti-Semitic appeared certain to cause serious damage to his candidacy by alienating a good part of the support of Jewish voters and of the liberal and reform elements which had flocked to him as their standard-bearer in the municipal elections.

The article, which appeared in the Catholic World, in 1915, declared that Jews in the high schools "recognize no code of morals and are concerned with no motives higher than those originating from fear of detection and consequent loss of money, etc."

The article arose openly to plague Mr. McKee when, in response to a telegram he sent Major La Guardia demanding that he disavow Samuel Seabury's attack on Governor Lehman, the fiery Fusion leader accused Mr. McKee of drawing "a red her-

Roumanian Nazis Vote Boycott of Jews, Promise Action on Jewish Expulsion

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BUCHAREST, Oct. 16—A boycott of Jewish goods, and particularly of the Jewish press was voted today at the first meeting of the newly-constituted Nazi Christian-Fascist party of which Stepan Tatarescu is the head.

Immediate action leading to the expulsion of a half-million Jews who allegedly entered Roumania since 1916 is being taken by the party, Tatarescu declared. This expulsion, to take place before May 1, 1934, is one of the eleven points in the party program adopted at its first conference last week. Other anti-Semitic points of the program

Part of Marx Trial to Be Held Behind Closed Doors; Five Witnesses Summoned

FRANKFURT, Germany, Oct. 16—The trial of Dr. Marx, representative of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, and Ferdinand Muerdel, former chief of the Frankfurt political police, will now be continued behind closed doors. Evidence that is allegedly dangerous to the Nazi state will be heard. The trial is expected to continue for some days.

Dr. Marx is accused of having bribed Herr Muerdel in order to obtain confidential information on Nazi activities, which was in the hands of the political police.

The trial continues to concentrate and revolve around the question of the Central Union activities in preventing the spread of Nazi propaganda and acts against the Jews. The prosecution is still endeavoring to establish that collaboration be-

Dr. Sherwood Eddy Tribute Dinner Being Held Tonight At the Hotel Commodore

Over three hundred prominent men and women, Jewish and non-Jewish, will attend the dinner this evening, at seven o'clock, at the Hotel Commodore in honor of Dr. Sherwood Eddy, author and sociologist, tendered in tribute to Dr. Eddy's courageous condemnation of the persecution of the Jews in Germany uttered in the course of a speech he delivered in Berlin.

Dr. Eddy, R. D. Blumfeld, famous British newspaper editor, who arrives here today on the liner Olympic, Justice Joseph M. Proskauer, Kirby Page, editor of World Tomorrow, and B. C. Vladeck, will speak at the dinner which is sponsored by the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

The Rev. Dr. Harry Emerson Fosdick, Judge Irving Lehman and Dr. Mary Woolley, of Mt. Holyoke College, are honorary chairmen of the dinner committee. Paul Block, Dr. Emanuel Libman, James Marshall, Justice Joseph M. Proskauer, Dr. Nathan Ratnoff, James N. Rosenberg, Morris Rothenberg and Roger W. Straus are honorary vice-chairmen. Frank L. Weil is chairman of the committee.

Nazi Press Mixes Attacks On Jews With Invitation To Visit Reich as Tourists

BERLIN, Oct. 15—A Nazi organization network directed against the Jews in various countries outside of Germany was disclosed here in articles in a number of Berlin newspapers including Adolf Hitler's Voelkischer Beobachter. The articles were devoted exclusively to the stirring up of anti-Semitic feeling abroad.

Special articles were published on the role of the Jews in Hungary, Denmark, Poland, Holland, Switzerland, Lithuania and other countries adjacent to the Reich where the Nazis expect fertile soil for anti-Jewish agitation among the German-speaking elements of the population.

As if the various articles, each of which purports to be a report on Jewish activity in a particular land, had been written by one, all carry identical allegations that the Jews are deceiving the local non-Jewish population, are spreading communist propaganda and are capturing control of the press. All strongly urge that German Jews be not permitted to enter the countries under discussion.

Invite Jewish Tourists

At the same time that the press reveals the alleged machinations of Jews abroad, a substantial portion

Salonica Jews Victims Of Nightly Attacks as Police Fail to Act

SALONICA, Greece, Oct. 16—Attacks on Salonica Jews are growing in number and assuming serious proportions. Most of the attacks on Jews are made late at night and despite the fact that in each instance the police have been informed of the attacks, not a single one of the attackers has been apprehended and brought to justice.

A Jewish chemist was among those who were attacked last night. He was seriously injured and taken to a hospital.

The Jewish inhabitants of the Syngrou quarter of Salonica, where the attacks chiefly occur, are terrified and complain of the incompetence of the police.

Dealer Gets Death Threat For Boycotting Nazis

Warned in an anonymous letter yesterday, that he was on a Nazi death list and his store would be burned and he would be killed if he did not revoke a boycott against candies made in Germany, H. Richman, wholesale confectioner of 145 East Houston Street, appealed to Julius Hochfelder, counsel of the Jewish War Veterans, and notified the police.

Early in September, Mr. Richman refused to handle German-made goods in protest against the Nazi treatment of the Jews. Since then, he said, several men have visited him urging him to sell German candy. He refused, and last Tuesday a brick was thrown through his window with a swastika sign attached to it.

The letter he received had a swastika sign drawn on the bottom and said:

"You have been warned a few times to buy and sell German candy. We broke your window to show you we mean business. If you still refuse we will burn your store and later kill you take this as a final warning to hell with the police we can take care of that your appeals to the police will not wipe you off our death list your days are numbered sell German goods or die."

Young Israel Education Program

ring across the cowardly, contemptible and unjust attack that you have made and published against a great race so gloriously represented by our Governor."

Untermyer Joins Attack

Samuel Untermyer, who had previously endorsed the candidacies of Nathan Straus, Jr., for president of the board of aldermen, and of Ferdinand Pecora, for district attorney, both of whom are running on the McKee "Recovery Party" ticket, also joined in the attack on Mr. McKee, describing the article as "a gross libel upon thirty percent of the people of this city," which "sounds to me like a reverberation of Hitlerism."

Denying anti-Semitism, Mr. McKee declared the article was a dead issue, that he had convinced the late Louis Marshall, in 1925, that he had not intended an attack on the Jews and had formed a close friendship with the great Jewish leader which lasted until Mr. Marshall's death. He bitterly denounced Major LaGuardia for "deliberately, viciously and for self-gain," injecting the racial issue in the election. He was to discuss the question in a broadcast speech last night over WABC.

Commenting on the McKee answer, Mr. Untermyer declared yesterday, "I am sorry and disappointed that Mr. McKee's explanation explains nothing. This lifelong friendship with my friend and partner, Louis Marshall, is news to me. Knowing Mr. Marshall as I did, I have a pretty lively conception of how he would feel about such a libel on our people as that contained in The Catholic World.

"He is not here to speak for himself."

Major LaGuardia declined to comment on the answer yesterday. He is to address the Council of Jewish Women today and is expected to make some reference to this at the time.

Straus Defends McKee

Mr. Straus, speaking in defense of his running mate, declared there is "no man in this city or in this country, in or out of office, who is more completely free from racial or religious intolerance. Joseph V. McKee's adult life is a record of friendliness and of service to people of all races and creeds whom he could help in this city."

The first announced defection from the ranks of McKee supporters was that of H. Bennett Salomon, Bronx attorney, who cited Mr. Mc-

Report of Foreign Policy Association Gives Lie to Whitewashing of Nazis

A summary of events in Germany since the advent of the Nazis to power has been issued by the Foreign Policy Association in the form of a report, "The Jews in the Third Reich."

The report, signed by Mildred S. Wertheimer, research associate, reaches the conclusion that the position of all non-Aryans in the Reich is precarious and that their "economic future is black." It also stresses that the younger generation of non-Aryans will, "not only be unable to earn a living, but the educational opportunities open to them even now are strictly limited."

"The Jews in the Third Reich" is carefully documented and references are given for every quotation used. It discusses in detail, The Brown Terror, the position of the Jews before the national revolution, the "Cold Pogrom," the restrictions imposed by the new civil service law, "cultural" activities under the Nazis, commerce and industry and the refugee problem.

In addition there is a very comprehensive table of figures on the occupational distributions of Jews and non-Jews gainfully employed in Prussia, where one third of the German Jews live, which shows that the average percentage of Jews employed in various fields was only 1.06 per cent and that the number of Jews in public posts, on which the Nazis have laid so much stress, is only .32 of one per cent of the total number of officials.

The contention that no revolution was ever consummated with less bloodshed, is exposed as a sham in the report, which gives a number of instances to prove that the assertions of the Nazi leaders were meaningless and that violence against political opponents and Jews was carried out on a wide scale and continues to the present day.

The article in the Catholic World has been ripped out of the Public Library files of that magazine, it became known yesterday. The article was published in 1918 and the copy of the publication containing it was placed on file in the usual manner. At the library, it was said that it is impossible to discover who may be responsible, as the files of that magazine, like any other, are available on request to any reader.

Mogen Dovid and Swastika To Fly Side by Side on 2 Palestine Coast Boats

HAMBURG, Germany, Oct. 16.—The Blue and White Zionist flag with the Mogen Dovid, the star of David, will fly side by side with the German swastika flag, when two German boats will begin to operate, within a short time, on Palestinian coastal transport.

The Atlantic Shipping Company is sending two motorships to Palestine today loaded with the belongings of German Jews who have emigrated to Palestine. As the ships are registered in Germany they are bound to carry the official German flags. But upon their arrival in Palestine, where they will be used for local service, they will in addition fly the Zionist flag, probably in the hope of securing Jewish business and of counteracting the hatred of the swastika flag.

Sokolow Leads Memorial March to Herzl Grave

VIENNA, Oct. 15.—Dr. Nahum Sokolow, president of the World Zionist Organization, headed the traditional march to the grave of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement. In the procession to the grave in the Jewish cemetery where Dr. Herzl lies buried Dr. Sokolow was accompanied by the Zionist president of the Vienna Jewish community, Dr. Friedman.

Austrian chutzim, future pioneers in Palestine, and Zionist students acted as a guard of honor at the graveside.

In view of the general tension in Austria, the police prohibited a march through the streets and the display of Zionist banners and emblems. However, the number of Zionists assembled at the cemetery itself was larger than usual.

The annual procession to the grave of the founder of Zionism on the anniversary of his death the twentieth of Tammuz, which fell this year, according to the Jewish calendar on July 14, had not been held either, since police feared attacks by the Austrian Nazis.

Zionist leaders are anxious to transfer the remains of Dr. Herzl to Palestine at the earliest possible moment, in order that the tradition of processions to his grave may be continued.

Endeks Arrested in Bomb Plot
WARSAW, Oct. 15.—Seven members of the Endeks, the anti-Semitic, anti-Pilsudski organization which has been carrying on a reign of terror against the Jews of Poland, were arrested today following the discovery of a bomb in the plant of the Jewish newspaper, Naszprze-glad. The bomb failed to explode.

Federation's Annual Drive Begins as 2,500 Workers Seek to Raise \$4,200,000

Twenty-five hundred volunteers took the field yesterday to raise \$1,200,000 in the annual fund-raising drive of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies. The volunteer workers are under the joint leadership of Paul Adler and Benjamin J. Bittenwieser, campaign chairmen. They are divided into 130 committees, each designed to further Federation appeal in a specific trade or profession.

More than 1,000 persons attended the dinner at the Hotel Commodore on Sunday evening to inaugurate the campaign and listened to speeches by Lewis I. Douglas, director of the Federal Budget, Justice Joseph M. Proskauer and other leaders in Jewish affairs. After the dinner the guests heard President Roosevelt's radio address from Washington on "Mobilizing for Human Needs."

Justice Proskauer, speaking at the dinner, stated that philanthropic organizations will face their gravest obligations this year in making national recovery a reality for "the millions who have lost courage and confidence through the depression, as well as the sick, aged, orphaned and needy, whose care has always been the peculiar duty of private agencies." As a measure toward that recovery he urged the universal acceptance of a personal "code," patterned after the recovery codes in industry, with responsibility to aid the needy, sick and helpless as one of its major planks.

Mr. Douglas warned against hopes that the Government can perform "miracles" in achieving recovery. "No President, irrespective of how great a leader he may be, and no government can accomplish such a miracle," he said. "We must be patient. And while we are exercising that patience, every individual has a responsibility to perform." Although the Government has taken over "some of the activities and functions of private philanthropy," final responsibility for maintaining philanthropic work during the depression must rest on private institutions, he concluded.

Speaking on behalf of more than 750 women volunteer workers in the campaign, Mrs. Felix M. Warburg said in view of the fact that such emergency bureaus as the Gibson and Belmont Committees have discontinued collecting funds and Federal aid only to be given when each locality has done its utmost, the support of the vastly larger part of the community must be enlisted.

Others who spoke at the dinner were: Felix M. Warburg, Paul Adler, Benjamin J. Bittenwieser and Supreme Court Justice Samuel I. Rosenman, who presided.

Jewish War Invalids Must Get Permission to Leave Reich Without Pension Loss

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Oct. 16.—Cancellation of the pensions of Jewish war invalids going abroad unless they obtain permission to leave Germany from the authorities was announced today in a communication to the Jewish Soldiers' Association.

War invalids must also obtain permission from the Labor Ministry if they plan to leave Germany, but even if the permission is granted by the authorities, the pension may be withdrawn at any time, without any reason being given, thus leaving the invalid stranded abroad.

The Jewish Soldiers' Association at the same time declared that Jewish war invalids who were excluded from the labor unions because they were Jews but who reside in Germany are entitled to continuation of their pensions.

Austrian Student Nazis In Clashes With Police

VIENNA, Austria, Oct. 16.—Nazi disturbances were resumed in the universities and colleges this morning following the retirement of several Nazi professors including Professor Gleispach, notorious advocate of the anti-Semitic student movement.

Clashes between the Nazi students and the police continued for some time and a number of shots were fired. So far it has not been established whether Jews were injured in the rioting. The Polytechnic Institute was closed by the police as a result of the outbreak.

The unfurling of a large swastika flag at the Polytechnic Institute was the signal for a country-wide demonstration at the universities. The clashes immediately assumed a serious character and the students were not dispersed until the police resorted to the use of their sabres.

Stresses Palestine Solution Of Jewish Homelessness

NORFOLK, Va., Oct. 16.—A large influx of German Jews into Palestine in the next six months, was predicted by Morris Margulies, secretary of the Zionist Organization of America, in an address delivered here Sunday night.

Mr. Margulies is visiting Virginia cities on the invitation of the Seaboard Zionist Region.

Pointing out that of the twenty thousand settlers who entered Palestine in the first six months of this year, more than eight thousand were German refugees, Mr. Margulies declared that Zionism offers the only practical solution for Jewish homelessness.

of it, including Der Stuermer, notorious anti-Semitic paper published by Julius Streicher, invites Jews from abroad to visit Germany as tourists. Jews can feel safe in Germany, Der Stuermer declares, listing names of eighteen Jews, who, the paper asserts, are now visiting at Gernish, a resort.

With characteristic inconsistency, the same issue of this paper contains several poisonous anti-Semitic articles calling for the driving out of German Jews from all resorts, especially at Deschendorfer-Weiher, near Erlangen, which was to have been renamed Adolfhitlersee. The change in name was held up and is pending because as yet there are no signs posted at the spa prohibiting the entrance of Jews.

tween Dr. Marx and Herr Muerdel was illegal and that the former head of the political police was not entitled to acquaint Dr. Marx with the contents of police documents.

However, both of the defendants insist that they were working together for the same cause, to protect the then existing regime, and that they were entitled to exchange confidences.

Herr Steinberg, former president of the Frankfurt police and prominent Frankfurt Jewish leader, who was certified as being ill in Berlin and therefore unable to attend the trial as a witness, was ordered, in a telegram sent by the court, to appear tomorrow.

The prosecutor urgently demanded the presence in the court of Herr Steinberg. Otherwise he demanded that the court proceed to Berlin to cross-examine the former Jewish police president.

Today several police officers testified that the rewards given by the Central Union to Herr Muerdel were not justified since the tracing of offenders who had desecrated the Jewish cemetery was carried out without any difficulty.
