Truce in Hungary Colleges as Nazi Students Await Gov't Reply on Clausus Demand

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BUDAPEST, Nov. 20-A truce has been declared between govern-mental authorities and students of various universities here which have been closed on account of recent anti-Semitic outbursts by the student Nazi sympathizers. The pro-Nazi students are impatiently awaiting the reply of the government to demands for the injection of clauses curtailing the number of Jewish scholars who are admitted to the schools of higher learning.

Against the claim that the num-ber of Jewish students is consider-ably above normal, the rectorate is-sued warnings that the most stringent measures would be taken if the anti-Jewish demonstrations recur.

Authorities are under the suspicion that there is a well-organized army of Nazi sympathizers working in harmony with the parent body in Germany.

An aggressive Nazi offensive is reported to be under way here di-rected by former Minister Count Al-exander Festitich, who is the party chieftain in Hungary. His leadership of the Hitlerite party in Hungary is looked upon with perplexity, since he also remains a member of the pro-government party of national unity. The latter party is under the leadership of Count Stephen Bethlen, National Assembly chief, and Premier Julius Goemboes.

Communist 'Chistka' Orders Editor of Emes Expelled (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

MOSCOW, Nov. 20-Moses Litvakoff, for twelve years the editor of the Moscow Communist Yiddish daily, Emes, Central organ of the Jewish Communists, was expelled from the Communist party of Rus-sia today on the order of the com-mittee delegated to cleanse the party ranks of non-Communist elements.

At stated periods every member of the Communist party is called before a party commission in a "chistka" or cleaning, where he must account to the commission for his actions during the period in question. Steuben Society Invites President Roosevelt, Luther To Swastika-Draped Fete

With plans for the celebration of German Day in the Madison Square Garden on December 6 advancing rapidly under the sponsorship of the Steuben Society of America, who on Sunday announced their intention of hoisting the swastika banner in the garden and inviting Dr. Hans Luther, the German ambassador, to address the gathering, the Federa-tion of German-Jewish Socities will meet tonight to define the German

Jewish attitude toward the occasion. Theodore Hoffman, head of the Steuben Society, in an address before the Plattdeutsche Society in the Brooklyn Schwaben Hall on Sunday, related the events incidental to a recent visit to Washington, where he invited President Roosevelt to attend the German Day celebration, and announced a few of the features scheduled for the fest. He said that the program will not be announced until Wednesday night, when the Steuben Society will meet with representatives from other German (Continued on Page 4)

National Conference Votes \$2,000,000 Drive to Settle German Jews in Palestine

One thousand Jewish leaders from communities all over the United States meeting in a national emer-gency conference at the Hotel Astor, on Sunday, adopted a resolution to raise \$2,000,000 during the com-ing year for the settlement of German Jewish refugees in Palestine. The money is to be raised by the American Palestine Campaign.

The one-day conference also dis-cussed political, economic and financial plans in connection with the settlement of German Jewish refugees in Palestine.

While the conference emphasized that Palestine must be given "pre-eminent consideration" in finding a refuge for the victims of the Nazis, it protested against the attitude of the Palestine government in issuing restrictive regulations against the entry of Jews into Palestine.

Austrian Grossmanites Seek Vote of Non-Confidence in World Zionist Executive

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) VIENNA, Nov. 20-Mass meetings of protest against the Jewish immigration policy of the Palestine government are being organized all over Austria, by the varoius Zionist

A meeting of the Juden Staat party, formerly the Democratic Revisionists, under the chairmanship of Meer Grossman, demanded the immediate convocation of the Ac-tions Committee of the World Zionist Organization in order to vote lack of confidence in the present executive, which was chosen at the Eighteenth Zionist Congress at Prague in August.

The Revisionists are holding meetings at which sharp criticism is lev-elled against the Palestine government and the British government. At a meeting today, Wolfgang von Weisl, journalist and leader of the Revisionists, declared that the expulsion of the Jews from Palestine. that is, the expulsion of immigrants who entered the country illegally, was a worse catastrophe than that which overtook the Jews under the Nazis.

Salonica Jews Fear Riots

British Jews Confer Today On Palestine Restrictions

(Tewish Telestraphic Agency) LONDON, Nov. 20-Recent measures of the Palestine government affecting Jewish immigration into Palestine will be the subject of a conference between the Palestine committee of the Board of Deputies. of British Jews and the Joint For-eign Committee to be held Tuesday. it was announced yesterday at the meeting of the Board of Deputies.

The new regulations put into ef-fect by the Palestine administration do not affect Jewish immigration but are concerned with the registration of tourists, Leonard Stein, prominent barrister and honorary coun-sel for the Jewish Agency for Palestine, declared at the meeting of the deputies. In general discussion on the subject, however, the situation was held grave.

Neville Laski, president of the Board of Deputies, who presided at the recent world conference for the relief of German Jews, held in London, reported that negotiations being conducted with James G. Mc-Donald, the League of Nations High Commissioner for relief of German refugees, are proceeding favorably.

Samuel L. Gordon, Hebraist. Is Dead in Tel Aviv (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, Nov. 20-Samuel Leib Gordon, noted Hebraist, teacher and scholar, who translated Shakespeare's "King Lear" and Zangwill's "Children of the Ghetto" into Hebrew, died in Tel Aviv yesterday. He was sixty-six years old and had resided in Tel Aviv since

Mr. Gordon translated many of the classics into Hebrew and had several volumes of poetry published in that language. Since 1903 he had been working on a scientific com-mentary on the Bible, of which several volumes had been published. He had been active in the Tarbuth, Hebrew education movement, of which his son, Moses Gordon, is now gen-eral secretary.

Mr. Gordon was born in Lida, Lithuania, in 1867.

A.A.U. Considers Switch Of Olympics from Berlin

PITTSBURGH, Nov. 20-The Amateur Athletic Union today adopted a resolution withdrawing its participation in the 1935 Olym-pic Games, scheduled to be held in Berlin, unless the German Govorment as well as the German Covernment as well as in theory? encouraged Jewish athletes to prepare for the athletic events. The reason cited in the Covernment of the state o is that Germany violated one of the fundamentals of democracy in sport. Only one dissenting vote was recorded against the resolution.

(Jewish Daily Bulletin) PITTSBURGH, Nov. 20 - The question of whether the Amateur Athletic Union, now meeting in convention here, will put its stamp of approval on the scheduled 1936 Olympic games which are slated to be held at Berlin, remained unsettled late this afternoon. Retiring president Avery Brundage, together with members of the executive committee, adopted a resolution at a secret conclave on the question which lasted until two o'clock this morning. The resolution was expected to be placed before the A.A.U. today.

In the face of assurances of the German delegation at the last meeting of the Olympic committee that athletes would not be debarred from participation in the games because of race, color or religion, many organizations in the United States demanded more convincing

proof on this score.

Many of these groups asked that the A.A.U. and other athletic organizations support a resolution demanding that the games be staged in another country.

Frick Asks Stricter Race Policy to 'Purify' Reich

(Yewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Nov. 20-A stricter policy which will purify Germany of Order Confiscation of any Jewish blood mixture was outlined today by Reichs Minister of the Interior, Dr. Wilhelm Frick, in addressing a new department of the ministry, which he created, the Reichsauschuss volksgesundheit, the board of national health, whose duty it is to purify the German nation.

North East Religious Union Protests Nazi Propaganda Spread in This Country

A resolution denouncing the Nazi regime in Germany and calling upon all Jewish and non-Jewish organizations in the United States to assist in curbing Nazi propaganda here was unanimously adopted Sunday by over 1,000 delegates at the third annual convention of the North East Religious Union at Temple Emanu-El, under the auspices of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations. The convention was attended by rabbis and laymen from eight states.

Ludwig Vogelstein, chairman of the Union of Hebrew Congrega-tions, offered the resolutions, which was unanimously approved by a rising vote proposed by Judge Irving Lehman. Judge Lehman, who is president of Congregation Emanu-Ei, presided over the conference.

"Our souls are racked with horthe resolution said, "at the ror." manifestations of cruelty, relentless hatred and blind arrogance of the Nazi despotism in Germany. destruction of liberty, suppression of speech and thought, man's inhumanity to man, call forth the indignation of all those who cherish liberty and love humanity and demand their united effort to meet this threat to civilization.

"The propaganda of the Nazi party has poisoned the minds of its followers with false doctrines of racial anti-Semitism and the Nazi regime has brought hideous wrongs and cruelest persecutions to our innocent brethren in Germany. Their suffering we share, their wrongs we

feel as our own.

"We protest against the sinister attempts by the Nazi government and its agencies to spread these false and poisonous doctrines upon the soil of our own land. "They are aimed not only against

Envoy Threatened by Nazis For Anti-Semitism Warning (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Nov. 20-The flood of threatening leters received by George H. Earle, III, American Minister to Austria, since his statement of warning against the adoption of anti-Semitic policies by this country, continued over the week-end with more than a hundred be-

ing received at the embassy.

Mr. Earle has not communicated with the police regarding the threats against his personal safety contained in the letters but the authorities are Most of the letters, it is believed, were sent by Nazis.

Mr. Earle created something of a

sensation here last week when he revealed that he had warned government officials throughout the Austrian provinces, where he had been on a motor tour, that Austria would forfeit America's sympathy if the country adopted a program or racial or religious persecution.

German Pastors Object to Nazification of Church (Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Nov. 20-The 450th anniversary celebration of the birth of Martin Luther was used by 3,000 Evangelical pastors yesterday as a forum for protesting against the intensive Aryanization program which is being carried on by the German Christian Church, wing of the Nazi party. Fear was prevalent among the aroused clergymen that their powers would be completely crushed.

The crux of the protests was the demand by Nazi church officials that the Old Testament be discarded and that the conception of Jesus as a gentle god be discarded for one picturing him as a militant. The pro-testing pastors denounced the bar-ring of Christians of Jewish descent from the church.

Expel Jewish Lawyers From German Bar Association (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Nov. 20-Attorneys of the Tewish faith or of Tewish origin. even those who have been readmitted to practice on proof of their war service, cannot remain as members of the bar association, the German Lawyers Association decreed yesterday.

The order issued by the associa-tion to its Jewish members an-nounced that they must consider themselves automatically expelled from the organization.

This order follows the decision reached at the recent convention of the All-German Lawyers Associa-tion at Leipzig to "purge" the legal the profession and the judicial system

The resolution also stated that the drive for the fund will be in concert with the central bureau for the establishment of German Jews, headed by Dr. Chaim Weizmann,

Judge William M. Lewis of Philadelphia introduced the resolution of protest against the government of Palestine. "The conference declares that in issuing new and restrictive regulations for the immigration of Jews into Palestine, the mandatory government has violated its heretofore guiding principle of the ab-sorptive capacity of the country in regulating immigration," the resolution stated.

"We demand the removal of the recent obstructions that have been placed in the way of entry into Palestine of Jews who come into Palestine as of right and not of suffer-

"This conference also urges a fundamental revision of the Palestine immigration laws to the end that immigration into Palestine may

conform to the letter and spirit of the mandate.

Other resolutions adopted by the conference included a pledge of co-operation with High Commissioner James G. McDonald; advocating the creation of a committee of Christian friends to cooperate in raising the fund, and giving authority for the creation of a committee to co-ordinate fund raising activity of all bodies concerned with the relief of German Jews.

Among the speakers who addressed the conference were Morris Rothenberg, president of the Zion-Kothenberg, president of in E. 20th-ist Organization of America; Dr. Cyrus Adler, president of the Ameri-can Jewish Committee; Rabbi Sam-uel Schulman, Dr. Chaim Green-berg, James Waterman Wise, Mrs. Archibald Silverman, Rabbi Jacob Sonderling and Nathan Straus, Jr. The conference was opened by Louis Lipsky, chairman of the American Palestine Campaign.

Other speakers at the meeting appealed for unity among the various German-American organizations in their efforts to put over the German Day celebration. A vote of confi-dence was asked from representa-tives of the United German Societies, traditional sponsors of the affair, whose plans were suspended this year by Mayor O'Brien when be used as a medium for the spread of Nazi propaganda.

The Brooklyn Plattdeutsche Society voted to protest to the mayor and City Court officials against an alleged attack upon Germans launched by Magistrate Strahl, who demanded before a lodge that German goods, merchants, and services be boycotted in protest against Hitlerism in Germany.

Unless their former decision is reversed at tonight's meeting, a turn that is considered most unlikely, the Federation of German Jewish So-cieties will adhere to their resolution of two months ago to take no part in affairs at which the swastika banner is on display.

Whether or not Jewish organiza-tions will oppose the new German Day celebration will also be discussed at tonight's meeting. The extension of an invitation to President Roosevelt is considered in many circles as a manoeuver on the Jal Grand Street, N. Y. part of the Steuben Society to
