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## Riots Force Hungary To Close Universities, Class Beats Teacher

Jewish Students Forced Out, Anti-Semitic Group Make Demands Against Them

## NATIONALISTS DIVIDED

Christian Nationalists Seek Less Drastic Measures Than Nazis Inspire

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BUDAPEST, Dec. 8.—The government has closed until Monday all universities here following a new outbreak of disturbances presented by the Nazis. The Nazis were present at the university.

In spite of the site-locked treatment authorities are according demands made by their demands for the institution of classes defining freedom of registration by prospective Jewish students, the universities of Budapest have been closed since the scenes of a continuous round of racial riots. Jewish students were hauled out of their classrooms.

Dr. Károly Károlyi, president of the university, was subjected to a beating by anti-Semitic sympathizers for his refusal to cooperate with the agitators. He was rescued in the midst of a loc-

It is believed that these are a rift between Christian nationalists and Nazi-inspired nationalists who demand that the Jews be barred from the classes which would bind Jewish students and control their registrations. Extremists are demanding that they be barred from the seats of higher learning. The nationalists are particularly hostile toward Jewish students who formerly were matriculated in the universities. A strike is hanging fire awaiting the outcome of the demand for the closure.

Catholic students have indicated their intention of accepting the partial concession made by President Julius Goetzebohm.

There is no doubt that student opposition has been hampered by the fact that the government has been easy in punishing the violators of the peace. To date forty student offenders have been sentenced for the disturbances, but have been fined three pence apiece. (A penny is equivalent to seventeen and a half cents in American money.)

We're Not Anti-Semites, Only Anti-Jewish, Nazis Tell Non-Jewish Semites

BERLIN, Dec. 8.—The anti-German movement among the non-Jews in Germany, particularly the Nazis and the Hitlerites, which has aroused great concern among the Germans, reached today in Berlin its highest point when it was used with the slogan: "Not anti-Semitism, but anti-Judaism." This is an attempt to make it clear that the Nazis in Germany is directly against the Jews.

The leader of this new movement is the German philosopher, Otto Orel. Special literature to further the movement among the Semitic peoples is being prepared.

BERLIN, Dec. 8.—Jews imprisoned in Nazi concentration camps throughout the Reich are not being released, the government has decided yesterday. From the Government of Prussia, acting chief of the police force, which affords five thousand political prisoners.

The police chief directed the release of the prisoners "in view of the favorable results of the election, especially in the concentration camps, on the occasion of the release of the political prisoners to be freed was left to the police inspectors who declared that those arrested for religious offenses would be the first released."

The police's order warned the prisoners to be freed that if they engage in anti-Nazi activities, "we will eliminate them ruthlessly," and if they do not, they will be released.

Five hundred prisoners in Bavaria were the first to be released under Goering's proclamation. Not a single one of them, according to word reaching here today, was a Jew.

## Breslau Labor Court Forbids Firing Jews

Anti-Hitler Inscriptions Declared Insufficient Grounds For Mass Dismissal

BRESLAU, Dec. 8.—The Labor court here today declared illegal the mass dismissal of the Jewish employees of the Blaustein department store, who were dismissed on the grounds that they had written anti-Hitler inscriptions had been found in the lavatories.

BUCHAREST, Dec. 8.—The Union of Roumanians Jews decided today by a vote of twenty to eight against forming a bloc with the Jewish party in the forthcoming elections.

At the meeting, Dr. William Filderman, president of the Union, Dr. William Filderman, advised the Roumanian Jewish population to vote for those candidates which stand for peace and order.

The Liberal party, which is new and includes Zigmund Kiraly, president of the Roumanian Bank, Dr. Aron Beckovits, in its list of parliamentary candidates.

The Jewish party has named an independent candidate, Dr. Ion Michael Landau, Rabbi Zirzelson and Jacob Zispe.

Government supporters are doing everything in their power to hinder the Jewish party in the elections. In Galatz, the Jewish party list of candidates suddenly disappeared from the election headquarters. As a result the Jewish party was unable to participate in the election in this town.

However, the Liberal government headed by Premier Ion Duca is proceeding with the same uncompromising measures against the Roumanian anti-Semites.

As a result of the recent disturbances in Galatz, the Jewish party was forced to leave the city. The Iron Guards were headed by Professor Alexander Cusa, forty-three members of the anti-Semitic Iron Guard are still in Galatz and will be tried for their share in the riots.

## Lynching Cry Is Raised Against Palestinian Spy

TEL AVIV, Dec. 8.—The lynching of a spy, accused in the recent series of incidents illegally in Palestine, to the police, was repeatedly threatened here last night, when an excited Jewish crowd surrounded the police station and cried "Death to the spy."

After the informer had been rescued by two policemen and a detective, the crowd followed the officials and pursued them. Some were buried in the police station and cries of "Death to the spy" were frequently heard. Several attempts to disperse the crowd failed, as they reassembled repeatedly.

## NEW EXODUS OF JEWS FROM REICH FEARED AS REFUGEE BODY MEETS

Senator Borenger Tells McDonald Commission New Nazi Edict May Set in Flight New Thousands — But Nation's Hospitality Is Being Strained — Polish Delegates Approve Weizmann Stand

LAUSANNE, Dec. 8.—Warning that Germany, today a great concentration camp for the Jews, may make the situation intolerable by expelling them and that a new wave of refugees may thus be created, was sounded today at the meeting of the autonomous governing body created by the League of Nations to handle the German refugee situation, by Senator Henri Borenger, French member of the body.

Senate Borenger's warning came in the course of declarations regarding the refugee situation by the government of Poland, which had so far been most lenient in its treatment of the refugees.

"Germany today is a great concentration camp for the Jews," he declared. "If the government does not issue some Jewish status giving the Jews independent slave rights which will again force larger numbers of Jews to escape from Germany, the Polish government must move refugees. Other countries will be asked to take the refugees."

Latin America views the refugee problem with apprehension, but is willing to collaborate in its solution, he declared, because it is "passionately attached to the principle of liberty and equality."

## Son of Arab Mayor Is Jailed in Rioting

British Constable Describes How Life Was Saved from Mob by Intervention

The British constable R. U. C. Mott described in testimony being given by a special commission investigating the recent riot disturbances, how timely intervention by an English constable saved his life.

On Oct. 29, Mr. Mott had been overpowered and knocked down by a mob and by firing his gun, the policeman had warded off the attack.

## Tribute to Boris Katzman

Boris Katzman, leader of the Jewish self-defense movement in Palestine, died in the early 1920's. His father, David, was born in Rehovoth, at the age of 20.

A few words from Jerusalem record the passing of one of the most fascinating personalities in the modern Zionism. The name of Boris Katzman rarely appeared in the press. It is not distinguished for any specific contribution to the cause of Zionism. Yet to a small circle of Zionists in America, Berlin, New York and in Palestine—he was a glowing intellectual and spiritual influence and will never be forgotten. He had the spirit of the legendary D'Artagnan. He was the embodiment of courageous chivalry which was infectious. He was not only the exponent of an ideal, but he lived embodiment.

The spirit of majestic which Thaddeus Herold reflected in a public manner for public purposes, Katzman carried with him in every turn of influence. He was a man who despised the Galilean savagery; despised its severity and physical deformity; and therefore threw off all the halo of the saintly and ascetic as he imagined a true hero should be. With loyalties only toward the living Jewish nationality which, being represented, he had no respect in every act of his life.

### Father Helped Found Colony

Boris Katzman was born in the Ukraine. He was the son of a well-to-do land-owner and contractor who was one of the earliest supporters of Chaim Weizmann, and one of the founders of the colony of Rehovoth. When the time came for Boris to enter a Yeshiva, he was refused to accept the conditions imposed by Jewish students, and left for Vienna where he matriculated at the Vienna University. There he was associated with the Herold, the Jewish Student Organization in which Theodore Herzl found a great deal of support. As a student, Katzman soon acquired popularity through his uncompromising denunciations passed upon Jewish students. He precipitated himself in the classrooms upon the heads of the anti-Semitic students to teach, organized the Jewish students for self-defense, and reorganized, in a brief time, to bring about his dismission from the University and his return to Palestine. In the fall of 1919, in Vienna, the Jewish Students Organizations were united with legends of the academy of the Zionist Congress. After he had dismissed from the University, he went to Rehovoth and worked as a field hand, but was laid down with malaria and had to return home.

He was the son of Theodore Herzl, and, together with a classmate, Bischel, who later became an engineer, he helped to organize the first Zionist Congress held in town to town at the election of delegates. He was a delegate to the first Zionist Congress himself.

Later, he entered the University of Vienna and Frankfort, graduated as an agricultural chemist. He decided to come to America in order to practical work in his profession and prepare himself for service in Palestine. At the time of his life related to Palestine. And although it took him many years before he finally found himself in Palestine, he did not let his spirit in exile which was not to be spent in exile which was not to be spent to think and set for his ideal.

### Fifteen Years in U.S.

For about fifteen years he was with us in the United States. For a time he taught in Cuba and in West New York, at the Battle Creek Seminary, but always his Zionist associations and pro-Zionist sympathies brought him back to the Jewish Gold, the center of which was New York.

He was not a speaker; he furnished all the languages he knew (Russian, Yiddish, German, French and Hebrew). But though he seemed a stammerer and inarticulate, he could make his thoughts known and felt by the fiery power and deep meaning of his words, the essential rationality of his ideas. Scores of the younger Zionists, mature and active now, were deeply impressed by the logic of his views, and whatever they have of intellectual character in Zionist work may be due to the influence of Boris Katzman.

### His Self-Map Project

He was a party to almost every activity of the Zionist movement, practically from the period of the Turkish constitutional reforms up to the present. In 1920, when Ossip Ohns' obsession was that in order to prove Palestine as the logical solution of the Jewish problem, it was necessary to have a map of all the lands of Palestine which might be known, with scientific accuracy how many hundreds of thousands of Jews the land could absorb. The plan was to have a map of the entire area, dollars and would have taken probably a decade to execute. Some of us tried to persuade Katzman to begin the compilation of his plan in a more modest way, but he insisted that a frank and open map should be made available only toward the living Jewish nationality which, being represented, he had no respect in every act of his life.

Subsequently, the soil map project was abandoned temporarily, and the project of the "Self-Map" of Palestine was in certain respects replaced by the Knesset Law and all, which, according to his calculations, could be measured as least approximately, and which he intended to be performed elsewhere. The Knesset Law was advanced in refusing to go ahead unless there was an undertaking on the part of the Jewish leaders to invest all the funds the plan required.

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### Aided Self-Defense

While Katzman was with us, he was a worker in the Kibbutz relief fund, a member of the Kibbutz self-defense movement. He argued in many studies against acceptance of the Turkish Constitution, and helped to organize the movement. In 1920, Dr. Jules M. Agassiz accepted the granting of a concession to Turkey as the realization of the Zionist aim. He worked with as in the Kibbutz relief fund, the Kibbutz Congress in 1925. And when the clash came about with the Karen Hayesod, he supported in all the discussions in which he participated, the position of the Kibbutz against the Zionist Congress and of the polar right of the Karen Hayesod as the fund-raising instrument of the Congress.

When he finally went to Palestine to excuse the place for which Mr. Justice Brandeis assumed a financial interest, all his wanderings were at last over. He had never been home with his wife and son, never to have much luggage, although he was the father of two children whose names were David and Hillel. He had the chance of staying for a year in his father's home in Rehovoth.

In spite of the fact that he gave the impression of being a simple man, a man of the people, a simple man, a thrifty householder, and was capable of living with a friend, Dr. Jules M. ### Tall, Lean, Springy

He was a man of striking appearance. He was tall, with a well-built body, always lean and sprightly. His face recorded the struggles and experiences of his life, and crowned by a mass of grey hair in recent

# New York and Chicago Plan Chanukah Festivals

## Observance of Feast Starts Wednesday

Eight-Day Holiday Includes Gift-Giving to Children, Games and Rejoicing

**C**HANUKAH, known variously as the Feast of Dedication, Festival of the Maccabees and the Festival of Lights, will be celebrated by the Jewish community for the eight days beginning December 13 to commemorate the cleansing and dedication of the altar in the Temple of Jerusalem during the year 165 before the Christian era and to commemorate the victory achieved over the Syrians by the Maccabean Maccabees and his sons, whose descendants we honor as the Maccabees.

In the Talmud Chanukah is principally known as the Feast of Lights or the Festival of Candles, lasting for eight days in memory of the miracle which occurred at the dedication of the purified temple when a single cruse of oil, which was supposed to last only one day, was found unspilled. Although the amount of oil in it was insignificant, it burned for eight days.

The observance of the festival does not involve the cessation of work nor any of the other prohibitions connected with other Jewish holidays. Besides the lighting of the menorah, the playing of the game of *Chashukh*, games, viddies and other pastimes are indulged in on Chanukah evenings. The game of *chashukh* is a card game, while viddies play "outside," a kind of Jewish card game. Each card bears a Hebrew character that is repeated twice. The object of the game is to get rid of all cards in "drobli," consisting of a revolving top with the Hebrew letters Nun, Gau, Hay, Zayin, which represent also the letters of the modern "par-and-take" tops. Gifts of money or objects, all known as "Chanukah-gelt" are made, generally to children. A gift of cash during Chanukah is "latkes" (pancakes).

**The Maccabees Tradition**  
The tradition established by the Maccabees has been perpetuated by a number of organizations, the most important of which is the Maccabee World Union, the sport organization of which Lord Melchett is the honorary president.

## HOUSECLEANING

**T**O ONE who is familiar with the technique of the anti-Semitic it is clear that even if all Jews were angels he would not be at a loss to find some reason for condemning them. Prejudice is not a logical attitude based on reason and inquiry. The very word implies a "prejudging", a conclusion reached without waiting for evidence or even in the face of contradictory evidence.

What would not be lacking with our social enemies a sense of realism to realize that we do not ourselves frequently provide our enemies with powerful weapons with which they easily bombard us. All too frequently we expose ourselves through the lamentable conduct of some members of our own group to their vicious castagnettes.

We have always been frank in acknowledging our shortcomings. Rabbi Solomon Alkabets, writing the bloody massacres which swept over Spain in 1901 and which ushered in the century of persecutions and disabilities culminating in the complete expulsion of the Jews from Spain, had the prophetic courage not to wish to place the whole burden of guilt upon the enemies of his people, but to admit the first responsibility of his people for his own people: "And if you ask why all these things have come upon us, know truly that from our own hands have these things come." In an amazing document of bitter self-reproach he enumerates the national "I" of the community, the ignorances, the arrogant display, the callousness, the indifference of the poor, the subversion of justice—in a word, the tragic tale of the spiritual decay of the Jews of his day.

Such relentless self-analysis has been the salvation of our people. The genius to exploit adversity for correction and improvement has stood in good stead in all anti-semitic. We dared to trust our national life, surgical but non-combative, and to regard our nation's health.

A dissident majority may feel itself in need of constant self-examination. It can even afford to ignore the moral judgments of others. But a minority group is denied such culpable innocence. Our states as a minority group stand upon us a stern discipline. We must not only be as good as the average but our average must be better. Not only does the world demand of us that we be as the price of our survival. A definite moral deferential is involved in our destiny.

Unfortunately we are not always mindful either of,

the practical considerations which our inescapable status as a minority group imposes upon us or of the mandates which our own moral tradition imposes upon us.

No one who is at all acquainted with Jewish life in America can fail to be impressed with the urgent need which exists for a real housecleaning. We know, of course, and it has been demonstrated over and over again statistically, that our people have a remarkable percentage of criminality among the ranks of the non-Jews population. This is a gratifying fact. Unfortunately this percentage is growing from year to year. A reading of the daily press is sufficient to show us that we are not being spared our full quota of Jewish gangsters, racketeers and gamblers. They are a shockingly new phenomenon in Jewish life. We know that the pro-Wall Street and prohibition era created these. This explanation unfortunately does not close the matter as far as we are concerned. We are profiting our full share of underworld folk as well as of such as offend against both good manners and morals by parlaying vulgar plays and entertainments, by writing and publishing obscene literature, by peddling pornographic books, shooting shoddy and revolting moving pictures.

In the higher brackets under our compass as to acknowledge that many Jews in business, finance and industry can be tured with the same brush of profiteering, gambling, speculation and exploitation as many non-Jews. Our prophetic tradition does not seem to have given them a keener appreciation of the stewardship of wealth and trustworthiness of the average Jew. Many prominent business men are not distinguished by standards of ethics higher than those which prevail generally about them. We are largely represented in some of these professions but we have not raised their standards. There are altogether too many Jewish lawyers who are similarly negligent to their professional nor to their people. Similarly Jewish politicians cannot be expected to be more public spirit than the average run of politicians and they are just as prone to graft and corruption.

Moral sobriety is just as little a characteristic of our young people as of others and the Jewish home is fast being invaded by these same forces which have proved so to be disruptive influences in the American home.

There are terrific liabilities for a minority group to carry. They weigh heavily upon our shoulders when we set out to fight our enemies.

Maurice Schwartz has carved a magnificent spectre out of Leo Tolstoy's historical novel, "Anna Karenina," but the question is, Has he carved a play out of it? I fear not.

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# Life of U. S. Jewry As Reflected In Late Despatches

## Philadelphia Jewish Schooling Increasing

17,730 Children Are Receiving Some Form of Religious Education; Cost \$338,000

By DAVID J. GALTHER

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 8.—For the first time in four years, Jewish education in Philadelphia is at an all-time high, and Jewish educational leaders are considering what steps they might take to encourage this wholesome movement.

Figures compiled by Ben Rosen, executive director of the Associated Talmud Torahs, and successor-at-large to the other educational institutions in the city, show that in all the 100 Jewish congregational schools there was an increased enrollment over last year of 433 pupils, representing a gain of 10 percent over that of the previous year. The Associated Talmud Torahs there has been an increase of about 200 pupils or a gain of approximately 9 percent. The Hebrew Seminary, the oldest and largest institution of its kind in the country, having been founded by Rebbees Gratz, reports similar progress.

The present enrollment is in the Jewish schools, which is estimated roughly as follows:

Elementary schools, including weekday, Sunday and Yiddish schools ..... 11,899

Secondary High Schools and the High School Department of the Sunday School ..... 299

Exhibition education, including Hebrew schools and youth ..... 5,450

Teacher's Training Schools, including training departments and general or academic departments ..... 130

This makes a total of 17,730 children receiving some type or another of Jewish education through organized channels.

It is estimated that the total cost of this education is \$338,000 a year, and that the Federation of Jewish Charities contributes approximately \$50,000.

There is another aspect of the problem revealed by these figures. While the enrollment in the Jewish child population at approximately 30,000, it means that 35 percent of the children are at a given time found in the Jewish schools. This is the percentage is said to be higher than in previous years. It is felt that the third largest Jewish community in America should not permit itself to be surpassed by approximately 30,000 of its young people are growing up without receiving any Jewish education whatsoever.

Commenting on the condition obtaining in the Associated Talmud Torahs, Dr. Rosen said: "After the war, Dr. Rosen stressed the fact that the availability of funds determines the size of the enrollment. There is not the slightest doubt that if greater funds were available, the number of children attending communal schools would be greatly increased, since so many parents would consider it favorable to Jewish education. Parents who remained indifferent in the past seem to be breaking to a realization that the lack of Jewish education is the loss of their children."

## Seek to Clear Name Of Polish Rabbi Shot By Military Tribunal

Swaying During Prayer Inter-  
vened as Signal to the  
Invading Bolsheviks

WARSAW, Nov. 30.—The case of the late Rabbi Chaim Shapiro, court-martialed ten years ago on the charge of treason, was brought before a special platoon against the government, which has since been unseated here.

The issue at stake is the honor of the deceased as well as the name of the country, which still retains the name of a Bolshevik sympathizer.

## MUSIC

By LAWRENCE H. LIPSKIN  
The most "alive," witty, sprightly and at the same time most significant event of the past week or so is New York's Carnegie Sunday evening of Bernhard Herrmann and his New Chamber Orchestra, with Harry Cohen and Russell Lewis.

If this is to be logical criticism of the more firmly entrenched figures in our music world, yes and they are entitled to it.

Five of the seven pieces on the program were "first times" in America; another was a "first time" anniversary and lastly, three of these selections were worth playing because the soloists were worthy carriers that ought to make three reason enough to look them over. Haydn's "Philosopher" Symphony, the "first time," Haile's "Sage Fragment" and Vaughan Williams' "Chariots of Fire" were the highlights of the program. Herrmann's services: Hilfman's jazz "Creation du Monde" and Berio's "Six Variations on a Theme by Jerome Kern," were brilliant at the piano and Kern's "I'm in Love" was a real success. The soloists were worth playing because this was conspicuously out of its class. The Russians call Gnessin "the Jewish Galak." It is agreeable.

All of this music is not important nor was it all admirably performed but there were displays of vitality and humor and catholicity of taste.

Brass Water conducted the Philadelphia Orchestra here last Saturday in Carnegie Hall an extremely high level. The French symphony band hardly deserved recognition, though. Respighi's "Church Windows," full of Latin sound and fury, and Wagner's "Siegfried" made up the rest of the program.

Leopold Stokowski and the Philadelphia Orchestra gave their new repertoire concert, the Glass-Metal bullet quartet and Menken's G Minor Symphony, besides introducing Carnegie Hall to New York in Henry Eschbach's "After the War" and "Patriot," in which rich tapestry it woven around typical musical elements.

Yesterday Ruth Sheppard, the soprano, played another amazing program at Brooklyn's Academy of Music.

Addie T. Katz will speak on "Music in the Court" Tuesday evening at the V.M.H.A., 23rd Street and Lexington Avenue.

Mario Charles will give his first recital of the year at Town Hall Wednesday evening, with Rose Blumkugel at the piano.

Breno Walter, by the way, will have his appearance of the season with the Philharmonic-Symphony next Saturday evening.

Of course you know that this is an extraordinary pianist year. Of course you want to see all the greats of the international stage. Of course you read that MEN IN WHITE opened in September. It is due to open again in January.

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## Propagandist Easley Lumps Jews, Radicals, Methodists in Drive

Ralph Easley, chairman of the National Christian Federation, professional anti-Communist and distributor of the anti-Semitic German volume, "Communism in Germany," intends to go out of Germany to "fight every Jew in the country to do it." Admitting that he is chief agent for the distribution of "Communism in Germany," Easley said: "I am going to go out of Germany to fight every Jew in the country to do it." Admitting that he is chief agent for the cost of publication of the book, or to his agents in his country, in whose hands would remain the profits, Easley said: "I am going to go further distributions, and I intend to discuss those subdivisions in operations in disseminating the book."

Among those in whose hands the book has placed the books for distribution are William Dudley Peery, historical anti-Semite and leader of the Fascist "Silver Shirts" and George Sylvester Viereck, author and present-day Hitlerite propagandist.

In an interview with the Jewish Daily Bulletin, Easley admitted that he is a member of the American Communist Party, and he declared himself ready to abolish Communism if he had to fight "every Jew in the country to do so." He later recanted the field of his campaign to "Methodist

### What He Stands Behind

Although Easley expresses the desire to aid the Jews in Germany, he asserts that his professional activities have been directed toward the destruction of Communism. "Communism in Germany" will not be disturbed. The book contains such passages as: "The teachers and leaders of Communism are the most dangerous enemies from the school of the old Russian Jewish revolution. The spirit of the invisible ghetto impremented us to stand up to Communism. Our Party, and also the spirit and general reservation which apparently was the justification for this terrible game, for lying, treachery, and all the other sins that were allowed."

"Other parts of the book are dotted with references of Jewish affiliation with Commemorative Jewish

Easley declared that he did not care who distributed the book, and he expressed the wish that it had "a thousand or a million copies sent to the hands of the Nazi, the Silver Shirts and other agents. Conserving one of his distributors,

Pelley, the Silver Shirt leader in whom Easley recently delivered 100 copies of the book for distribution, Easley recently wrote in a letter published in this paper: "And now we are at war with the Communists and also to fight the Jews as Jews—which latter program, I believe, to go to war, would offend and irritate us in the United States as a virulent form."

### His Idea About Viereck

Mr. Easley had this to say about George Sylvester Viereck: "I had no more use for him than had any other American during the War. He was a German agent who was trying to get into the country, and I regarded him as a man who should have been shot."

Easley mentioned alleged sabotage by Viereck, and he asserted that he had enough evidence that Viereck is accused of having tried to paralyze commerce on the entire Eastern coast by calling a strike of longshoremen, and that he was instrumental in getting a book admittedly favorable to the Hitler regime in Germany and absolving him from many crimes attributed to the chieftain of the world press.

Easley describes his present respect for Viereck in this manner: "However, he has played an important part in the world, and our government to send to Germany a Good Will Commission which would endeavor to interpret there the patriotic feelings of the American people, upon its return, the state of German public opinion on this question." Easley describes Viereck's signature in a cablegram received by the Jewish National Fund in this manner:

"Yours sincerely, V. Viereck, Dr. Hyman Schach, on the eve of the anti-Semitic boycott in Germany, signed a cablegram to the boycott, which it was stated, would alienate the sympathies of the world from Germany."

### Kick Nazis Here Out Ha Says

"It is charged, as the Nazis are organizing various movements here, such as the German Legion, centered around Hitler, and the German Army during the World War, the Friends of New Germany and others, which with their allied brands, are all set to work to dominate our country, as we kicked out last as we kicked out the Italian Fascists two or three years ago," Easley said.
