Will Not Ask Extradition Of Heinz Spanknoebel Who Reported in Germany

William W. Prager, assistant United States Attorney, Saturday announced that no efforts will be made to extradite Heinz Spanknoebel, who has been reported as being in Germany.

Spanknoebel, creator and leader of the League of Friends of New Germany, an organization whose branches throughout the country have been carrying on an intensive campaign against the Jews in support of Hiller, disappeared on October 1988 of the Country without having presented his credentials to the United States Department of State.

According to reports reaching the office of the United States Attorney, Mrs. Maria Griebl, who took a prominent part in the Idearal investigation of Nazi affairs in this city, has gone to Berlin to confer with Spanknobel.

With the advent of the Liberal government of Premier Duca, and his announcement that his government would not tolerate anti-Semitism, the activities of the Iron Guard have increased enormously. Responsibility for the numerous outbreaks against the Jews is laid to them, including the recent riot in Jassy, where many houses in the Jewish quarter were burned, and the military were called out.

Dorothy Thompson Favors Boycott of Nazi Goods As Rebuke to Hitler (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

OMAHA, Nebr., Dec. 9-"The boycott of Nazi-made goods will not bring about the downfall of Hitler or the Hitler regime, but I favor the boycott because public opinion is in this way mobilized against Nazi tactics", Dorothy Thompson, in pri-vate life Mrs. Sinclair Lewis, said in an address before the Omaha

Community Forum. "Mr. Hitler wants a military re-naissance in Germany," she said, "a Germany purged of all opposition to militarism, and he then plans to go on a crusade. His theme is based on 'blood and earth'."

Dr. Bruno Birnbaum Named To Yeshiva College Chair

Dr. Bruno Birnbaum, member of the faculty of Humboldt Hochschule in Berlin, who was dis-missed on account of his race, has been appointed professorial lecturer at Yeshiva College, B. Revel, president, announced yesterday.

Dr. Birnbaum is the author of many volumes dealing with taxation and industrial management and was editor of the Magazine for Indus-trial Organizations. He was also judge of the State Labor Court and associate judge in the German Federal Insurance Office.

The College also announced that a new course in International Relations and Law will be offered in February by Dr. Aaron N. Margulith, author of "The Mandate."

Legionnaires Acclaim Fund For Jewish Veterans' Colony

The decision of the Zionist Organization of America to use a sum of \$40,000 bequeathed to it, to establish a colony of Jewish veterans who fought under General Allenby in the taking of Palestine, was hailed by the president of the American Pal-estine Jewish Legion, Dr. Jacob M. Ravid, who declared that this would ensure the establishment of a colony of American Jewish Legionnaires in Palestine.

"The veterans of the Jewish Legion," said Dr. Ravid, "fought under General Allenby, contributed to the conquest of Palestine from the Turks, but they were never granted any bounty, bonus or compensation from the British or any other government. This decision of the American Zionists is an achievement of the first magnitude and is further enhanced by its pledge made at the same meeting to raise the balance of the first \$100,000 to constitute the Jewish Legion Fund, which will commemorate the name of the Jewish Legion and its contribution to

U. S. Intervention Asked In Behalf of Refugees

By B'nai B'rith Brochure Citing the precedent of a score of instances which proved that foreign government's have acted in behalf of persecuted peoples, a booklet circulated among government officials by B'nai B'rith entitled "The United States and German Jewish Persecutions" makes an appeal that the Roosevelt administration take steps in the interest of the German exiles. Written by Dr. Max J. Kohler, the booklet describes the famous John Hay negotiations in connection with the anti-Jewish persecutions in Czaristic Russia; the Charles Sumner investigation into Roumanian anti-Jewish atrocities in 1870; the Damascus blood libel of 1840; Minister Fay's efforts on behalf of Jewish emancipation in Switzerland, and the American government's action in connection with the Tewish persecutions in the Balkans at the Congress of Berlin in 1878. Mention is also given to the course taken by President Theodore Roosevelt fol-lowing the Kishineff massacre and by President Wilson and Colonel House at the 1919 Peace Conference regarding the Polish anti-Jewish ac-

BERLIN, Dec. 9-An aged Jewish couple, Jacob and Ida David, who live in Grossblumenau, East Prussia, and who recently celebrated the sixty-fifth anniversary of their marriage, received congratulations from the Prussian Premier, General Hermann Wilhelm Goering.

It is customary for the Prussian Premier to extend congratulations on the occasion of diamond wedding celebrations, but this is the first instance in which a Jewish couple were the recipients of such official congratulations. It is not known whether Premier Goering was aware of the fact that the couple were Jewish.

Swiss Trade and Labor Organizations Effectively Boycott Reich Goods

Earnestly and with characteristic resoluteness the Swiss Trade Union and Labor Party are retaliating for the Nazi treatment of the proletariat classes in the Third Reich with a boycott of German-made goods and German services. Almost on the heels of Hitler's accession to power, according to press reports of the International Federation of Trade Unions, these two small but powerful units of the great workmen's brotherhood recognized the danger, launched a boycott and have been

rigorously pursuing it since.

Backed by the cooperation of trade associations, bodies for the organization of exhibitions, private purchasing firms and chain stores, the Social Purchasers' League and other influential bodies in the republic, the boycott has succeeded to the extent that German goods have been prac-tically banned from the country. Oddly enough, the religious element has not entered at all.

The Joint Committee created by the Swiss Union for the coordination of the boycott plans, appointed a frontier subcommittee to control import and export of German goods. Its chief task, however, was to prepare lists of goods manufactured in Germany and to give information where substitute goods could be

purchased Included in a few of these lists are newspaper products, newspapers, books, films, chemical and photographic supplies, chemicals for domestic use, alarm clocks, electric ap-paratus, wireless, tools, toys, etc.

Emphasis on the importance of the cooperation by housewives who are pledged to join in the boycott, has been frequently made by M. Meister, president of the Joint Com-mittee. In a statement he said:

"Our boycott movement has begun very well. There is no danger that it will be exploited for nationalistic purposes. The import from Germany to Switzerland has declined considerably, although of course the crisis has been a contributing cause to the reduction

At a recent meeting of the Executive of the International Federation of Employees in Public Services held in Brussels, a boycott resolu-tion was passed against German products.

\$686,000 Allotted by Joint Distribution Committee

For Refugee Relief Work The American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee has allotted about \$686,000 for relief work in connection with German Jewish relief, according to an announcement made by Rabbi Jonah B. Wise, national chairman of the German Re-

lief Fund. Of the sum, approximately \$400,000 was used for work within Germany since April, and \$230,000 for refugee and emigration work outside Germany for reconstruction ac-tivities. The latter fund will last until March 1

The money was used to supplement the money raised in Germany by the Central Committee of Ger-man Jews for Relief and Recon-struction, and allied organizations including the Hilfsverein der Deutschen Juden, the Palestina Amt, the Central Bureau of Jewish Loan So-cieties, the Central Bureau for Economic Aid, the League of Jewish Women and a Committee for Mi-

Kliatchko, Russian "King of Reporters," Dies a Pauper

(Continued from Page 1) secret police watched his every step, repeatedly attempting to expel him from Petrograd, on the ground that he was a Jew. Under the Czarist regime. Yews were forbidden to live in large cities, unless they had spe-cial permission. But Kliatchko, on the strength of his influential connections, always ignored the expulsion orders. He even ignored the order of expulsion issued by the commander of the Petrograd military district in 1916.

After the Revolution and the subsequent seizure of power by the Bolsheviki, Kliatchko published two that commerce is a desecration of volumes of reminiscences and of the Holy place. had never been revealed. Included in the volumes were stories of various anti-Jewish incidents in the time of the Czar.

When the Bolshevik government proclaimed the NEP, the new economic policy, which removed many of the restrictions previously im-posed on all trade, Kliatchko became a publisher and conducted a successful business. Later the Russian government once more tightened its hold on Russian industry, liquidating private trade. Kliatchko died in and preventing further great need after a prolonged illness.
