#### Havana Jewish Community. Fearful of New Disorders. Seeks Aid of Poland (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

HAVANA, Dec. 23-The juridical committee of the Havana Jewish community today sent a memorandum to the Polish Ambassador at Washington, urging protection for the Iews here who are Polish citizens.

The Iewish community in Havana and other Cuban cities has been in a state of terror since the overthrow of the Machado regime. Soldiers accompanied by mobs of Negroes have made frequent raids on the Havana Jewish quarters and have threatened to exterminate the "Po-liakos," a derisive title for Cuban Jews. Last Sunday a sudden raid on the Jewish quarter by soldiers and Negroes resulted in the killing of two Jews waiting in a store and the wounding of the Jewish proprie-

A Czechoslovakian board of trade has been established here to facilitate and increase trade relations between Czechoslovakia and Cuba. Meyer Lisowitsh, president of the Adas Israel, was named president of the new board of trade.

## Nazi Nest Discovered in Newark: Schilling Bros. Held by Police Officials

(Jewish Dally Bulletin) NEWARK, N. J., Dec. 23—Secret service men from New York headquarters are continuing their investigations into the activities of Oscar and Frank Schilling, accused of be-ing chieftains of a widespread campaign of Nazi activities and propaganda. The secret service agents re-fused however to divulge the result of their investigations.

The activities of the Schilling brothers were discovered when a small fire broke out in the basement of the house they occupied at 34 Gillette Place. Both are still in the custody of police and will be held until police officials complete their

#### Celebrate Christmas By Boycotting Jews, Nazi Newspaper Advises (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 23—Der Stuermer, the newspaper published at Nurem-berg by Julius Streicher, one of the most notorious anti-Semitic leaders in Germany, marked the occasion of Christmas, the traditional season of "peace on earth, good-will to men,"
with a victous attack on the Jews
of Germany which called on all
Aryans to refrain from purchasing
from "Jesus's murderers."

In its Christmas Eve issue, the paper which has been barred from paper which has been barred from circulating abroad as part of the plan to silence foreign criticism by preventing the circulation of matter on which it could be based, ad-dresses a proclamation to "all Christians".

"You Christians," it declaimed "all go to church, even today, and cry at the terrible end at Golgotha (scene of the crucifixion). You wish to be associated in spirit with the cracified Jesus. Nevertheless, you pass by Christian stores to make Christmas purchases from Jesus's murderers."

In the same issue the Streicher organ, which is now the most vio-lent anti-Semitic publication in the Reich, features a list of concerns keich, features a list of concerns controlled by Aryans which have been engaged in litigation in re-cent months and employed Jewish counsel to represent them. Because these firms made use of the Jewish attorneys who because of their war records have been permitted to re-sume practice, Der Stuermer exhorts its readers to boycott the concerns.

#### \$500,000 Government Loan To Turn 200 Jewish Families Into Jersey Homesteaders

A government loan of \$500,000 to In ance establishment of a home-stead settlement of 200 Jewish families in Monmouth county, New Jersey, was hailed Saturday night at the opening of the conference called Settlements.

The loan is being made by the Federal Subsistence Homesteads Corporation, through which the Subsistence Homesteads Division of the Department of the Interior functions, to a corporation to be organized for the project. Needle Trade Workers Settlement

Two hundred families, recruited from the needle trade industries, will be settled on small farms each of which will have at least one acre for gardening. The homesteads are expected to cost about \$3,000 each. A cooperative farm, with a dairy herd, a hennery and facilities for providing other foods for the settlement will also be organized. school for 300 pupils and a community center will be erected on the settlement grounds for which options have already been obtained on 1,253 acres.

Each settler will be required to pay \$500 down and the remainder over a twenty-year period.

A modern factory building, designed to serve as a model for other projects will be erected at a total cost of \$35,000. The factory will have private support to the extent where homesteaders will be assured of a definite cash income and will

#### German Default on Debts Due Foreign Investments Accredited to Army Costs

The failure of the German government to meet its foreign commitments whose largest item is an approximate annual sum due American investors amounting to tens of mil-lions of dollars, was accredited to the fact that the Nazi powers are spending vast outlays on "non-pro-ductive purposes", according to Max Winkler, head of the American Council of Foreign Bondholders, in a statement he issued Saturday.

These purposes include military expenditures for the mobilization of an army, nightly parades, torchlight processions, festivals, marches and displays arranged by the rulers of the Third Reich.

The charges made recently by the head of the Reichsbank that the denead of the secondark that the de-faulted payments are due to Ger-many's poverty, an obvious blow at international anti-German boycott activities, were exploded by Mr. Winkler, who said that the "defaults have been legalized."

## Hitlerism Pagan Uprising Against Religion, Wise Tells Boston Meeting (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

BOSTON, Dec. 23-Rabbi Stephen S. Wise of New York who was the principal speaker at a Jewish-Gentile meeting at Tremont Templehere, declared that "Hitlerism is the last mighty pagan uprising against religion generally and Christianity in particular," and charged that the sterilization program of the Nazis.

is in reality "an attempt to wipe out the Jewish race in Germany." Among the speakers who addressed the meeting were representatives of Catholic, Unitarian, Episcopal, Baptist and Methodist faiths.

Characterizing Hitler as a "paranoiac adventurer," Dr. Wise asserted that the peace of the world. which never seemed nearer of accomplishment than it did 16 months ago at Lausanne, had been blighted

and darkened by Hitlerism.
"The more the Nazis are heard," he said, "the more they will be con-demned by all right-minded Americans. They think they have a case; then let it be heard. And we, who believe in good will, think we have

The letter says: "The concordat recently concluded between the Holy See and Germany does not mean that the Catholic Church approves of the religious er-rors of Naziism. Everyone knows how tense is the situation between church and state in Germany. It is no wonder that the Austrian Church is anxious about what would become of the Catholic religion if the Nazis were to rule over Austria also.

"The Catholic Church has never agreed with the three fundamental errors of Nazi-ism, which are race madness, violent anti-Semitism and

extreme nationalism."

The letter asks that the Austrian people "stand firmly behind the Dollfuss government and the Catholic Church in order to prevent a situation similar to that now obtaining in Germany as regards the church and its clergy.

The letter says that the recent withdrawal of the Austrian clergy from politics, ordered by the Bi-shops, is only a temporary measure due to the "delicate" situation pre-

vailing in this country.

## Aron Still Imprisoned: Store Manager Under Charge of Immorality (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 23-Kurt Aron, Frankfurt department store manager, who was arrested last month for having "made an immoral proposal to an Aryan girl", is still imprisoned, the Nazi press revealed today. Previously the Nazi papers had stated several times that Aron had been released and even reinstated in his post.
Actually Herr Aron has been in a

Nazi concentration camp since Nov. 26. Today the Nazi press is filled with demands that he be immediately sterilized under the new law affecting criminals and imbeciles.

When the original charges were made against Herr Aron, a mob of enraged Nazis assembled before the department store in which he was employed and demanded that he be handed over to the mob for summary punishment. Police intervened and took him into "protective cus-tody" from which, despite frequent

### Nazi Nest Discovered in Newark; Schilling Bros. Held by Police Officials

(Continued from Page 1) ters. Police searching the rooms discovered papers which indicated the projection of the Nazi activities on ships plying in and out of New York harbor. One trunk was found containing a large number of chemical formulae written on flimsy pa-per. Police are of the opinion that Nazi enthusiasts in the United States have been collecting formulae for industrial chemical processes in use

Literature found in the rooms occupied by the brothers also estab-lished that Walter Kappe, said to be the editor of the Cincinnati Freie Presse, German language paper, is identified with the activities of the Friends of New Germany, an active Nazi organization here. Kappe is said to have continually protested in his newspapers that he is not a Nazi. He denied he is in any way connected with the Friends of New Germany.

Also included in the literature found was a round-robin signed "national leadership", bearing the signa-ture of Fritz Gissibl, head of the Western division of the Friends of New Germany. The literature warns against "suspicious elements within the group" and empowers local lead-ers to use "the most drastic disciplinary measures against each and every interloper."

Questioning in local German cir-cles here indicated that until the time of his arrest Oscar Schilling acted as secretary of the local branch of the Friends of New Germany but that recently an attempt had been made to get rid of him on the grounds that he is an alien. Naturalized American citizens usually fill these posts in order to have a better influence on American opinion. Schilling himself refused to confirm or deny the statement that he had been secretary of the Nazi organization.

The findings also included a considerable number of blueprints of bridges in the vicinity. Searchers also found an involved code ending with the initials P. L. and an address in Hamburg, Germany. There was also literature which was made up of many bulky Nazi pamphlets issued by the Friends of New Germany and petitions demanding the curtailment of the boycott of German-made products.
