## Name Attorney to Argue Rights of Jewish Minority Violated in Upper Silesia

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 28.—The Jewish advocate, Dr. Reichman of Kattowitz, Upper Silesia, will argue the petition submitted by Dr. Perl, a Jewish doctor of Hindenburg, before the Upper Silesian Mixed Commission appointed by the League of Nations when it comes up for consideration, it was learned today.

Dr. Perl, who was dismissed from the sick fund panel at Hindenburg, maintains that his dismissal was wrongful and contrary to German undertakings towards the Jewish minority in Upper Silesia.

Despite the fact that the Perl petition, which appears destined to achieve the fame of the petition submitted by Franz Bernheim, and

## New Ruling to Wrest Citizenship From Jews Living in Germany

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 28.—Confirmation of the German government's intention to deprive German Jews of their citizenship is seen in today's announcement by the Prussian Ministry of the Interior. The population of Prussia, according to the announcement, is divided in two categories, residents and citizens. In the first category are all those lawfully residing in Prussia. In the latter are all Germans over twenty-five years of age. The Minister stresses the explanation that the new regulations are being issued pending the conversion of citizens into residents.

## Bavaria Arrests Jews For Atrocity Stories Against Nazi Germany

MUNICH, Dec. 28.—Thirteen Jewish visitors and several residents of the Jewish hotel Park Villa which is located near Munich, were arrested today by the Bavarian political police, who allege that the visitors have been carrying on atrocity propaganda. Police insisted that the Jews used the hotel as a headquarters for spreading atrocity stories against Germany.

## Jewish Students Barred From Reich Universities, Ministry Announces

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 28.—Jewish students will be excluded altogether from German universities in 1934, according to an official announcement issued today by the Ministry of Education. Only ten percent of the total number of students will be women and the 1934 total student enrollment is fixed at 15,000, the announcement stated.

Only those students who are "physically and spiritually mature and of strict nationalistic reliability" will be enrolled.

## Jewish Lawyers Ousted From Reich Association

BERLIN, Dec. 28.—The All-German Lawyers Association, the largest association of its kind in Germany, agreed upon dissolution of the organization at a general meeting. The association had fifteen thousand members, including three thousand Jews.

All the Aryans will be transferred to the new Nazi Lawyers Association, while the Jewish members will remain outside any organization.

## Exempted Medical Men Targets of New Drive To Enforce Aryan Clause

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 28.—Mass dismissals of Jewish doctors and dentists still attached to the sick fund panels on the strength of their war record which exempts them from the Aryan clause, is under way in Berlin and in various German states.

The excuse used is the recent government order restricting Jewish doctors to towns with more than 100,000 population. Jewish doctors and dentists are being excluded from the official medical directories on the same pretense.

According to reliable information obtained by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, the pretext under which the Jewish war veterans are being dismissed is a deliberate misinterpretation of the government order which was directed exclusively against the employment of new Jewish doctors, and not against the exempted Jewish war veterans.

The Jewish Telegraphic Agency also learned that a new campaign against Jewish doctors is to be expected. German government circles maintain that the proportion of Jewish doctors on the sick fund panels is still too high, allegedly reaching fifty percent in Berlin.

## GREEN, A. F. OF L. HEAD, CALLS ON AFFILIATED UNITS TO MAKE NAZI BOYCOTT EFFECTIVE

WASHINGTON, Dec. 28.—William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, today issued an official communication to subordinate organizations calling upon them to make effective by whatever means possible the boycott against German-made goods and German service which was adopted in the form of a resolution at the recent convention of the Federation.

The text of Mr. Green's communication repeated the two counts upon which Germany was condemned by the Federation, which represents an aggregate of five million workers in the United States. They are:

1. "The utter destruction of the Trade Union Movement in Germany and the arrest of many of its officers."

2. "The cruel treatment afforded the Jewish people."

The boycott is to continue "until the German government recognizes the right of the working people of Germany to organize bona fide, independent trade unions of their own

### Rabbi Released by Nazis; Arrested for Allegedly Criticizing Atrocities

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Dec. 28—Rabbi M. Dienemann of Offenbach was released from the Osthofen concentration camp today. He was arrested after a police spy who had been listening to his sermon said that the rabbi stated that to German Jews there is no difference whether atrocities are committed by French generals or by Nazis.

The aged rabbi was arrested immediately after his sermon and transferred to the concentration camp despite the declarations of local Jewish leaders that the police had misunderstood the speaker.

### Talmudic Scholars at Radin Yeshiva on Strike for Food

WARSAW, Dec. 28—A unique strike was declared here today by the students of the Radin Yeshiva, a Jewish theological seminary.

The students announced that they would refrain from participation in Talmud study, the chief occupation at the Yeshiva, so long as they are not provided with food.

The Radin Yeshiva was founded by the late "Chofetz Chaim", aged Jewish scholar and sage who died a short time ago. Since his death officials in charge of the Yeshiva have been unable to provide the students with food. As long as the "Chofetz Chaim" was alive, his enormous prestige among orthodox Jews and the world-wide recognition of his saintly character brought heavy contributions to the Yeshiva, which appear to have stopped on his death.

### To Enforce Aryan Clause In Forthcoming Laws Ministry Official States

BERLIN, Dec. 28—The Aryan clause will not be modified and will be used in all future legislation for furthering the racial rebirth of the German nation, Dr. Pfunder, state secretary of the Ministry of the Interior, announced today. The Nazi official elaborated the aims of the Ministry for the coming year.

Under the Aryan clause, no one can occupy specified posts, unless he can prove that his ancestors for three, and in certain cases, for four generations, had no Jewish blood in them.

### Free Two Jewish Youths In Trial of Demonstrators

JAFFA, Dec. 28—Two Jewish youths, participants in the Tel Aviv disturbances of December 9, were freed today on the second day of the trial. Eighteen Tel Aviv Jewish boys are on trial for having participated in an illegal demonstration which grew out of a meeting called to protest immigration restrictions against the Jews and the hunt for tourists who overstayed their visas. Police attempted to disperse the demonstrators carrying the Zionist banner and a number of placards succeeding only after several hours of fighting between police and the demonstrators who were joined by many Jews on the streets.

Police inspectors Spector and Krutkoff testified today on the demonstration.

Attorney Kaiserman, defense lawyer, today urged Chief Magistrate Ralph Bodilly to apply article thirty-four of the penal code against the accused instead of article twenty-three. The first provides a maximum penalty of three months imprisonment, while the other carries a penalty of two years imprisonment under the Seditious Offenses Ordinance. The trial will continue tomorrow.

### German Jewish Scientist Gets Conn. State Post

HARTFORD, Conn., Dec. 28—Dr. Max Sulzbacher, internationally famous German-Jewish bio-chemist, has been offered a research post in the Connecticut State College, it was announced today. Dr. Sulzbacher, who is 32 years old and unmarried, is believed to be in Berlin at present.

The distinguished Jewish bio-chemist is one of the many who lost their professorial posts after the Nazis came into power.

### Arab Autoist to be Tried For Manslaughter in Myles Elliot Accident

JERUSALEM, Dec. 28—The Negro Arab whose automobile ran over and fatally injured Myles L. F. Elliot, government prosecutor, on December 17, was committed to stand trial for manslaughter today. Bail for the accused man was refused.

Mr. Elliot had prosecuted the Jerusalem Arab demonstrators. He was struck by an automobile on the same evening the Jerusalem Arab rioters were convicted by the court. He died in a hospital the following night.

Three English residents of Palestine who witnessed the accident testified that the car which struck Elliot was driven at a fast clip and had only one headlight. The driver failed to blow the horn, they said.

### 'Racial Passport' System Established in Germany For Government Workers

BERLIN, Dec. 28—A system of special cards called "Abstammungsnachweis", tantamount to racial passports, has been introduced for all officials and employees of state and municipal institutions in Germany. The new system goes into effect January 1.

Cards will be printed by the government printing works and will be considered official documents.

The system is intended to introduce a unified method of establishing the origin of the bearer, and contains space for details of the history of parents, grandparents and wives. This will necessitate a new and complete registration of all officials and government employees all over the country.

### Pittsburgh Congregation Installs Rabbi Shapiro

PITTSBURGH, Dec. 28—Rabbi Joseph Shapiro, newly-elected rabbi of Congregation Poale Zedeck, was installed in his charge before a capacity audience in Temple Poale Zedeck. Every congregation in Pittsburgh and the surrounding suburbs was represented.

The installation address was delivered by Rabbi Bernard Drachman of New York, who was assisted by Rabbi Samuel I. Zar, registrar of the Yeshiva Isaac Elchanan of New York. Adolph Edlis presided.

M. Chaitkin is president of the congregation, which is one of the oldest congregations in Pittsburgh, having been founded more than fifty years ago.

## Untermeyer Probes Nazi Campaign to Stir Up Trouble for Jews Here

Samuel Untermeyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, yesterday began an investigation of Nazi propaganda activities which are designed to incite race hatred against the Jews.

Stickers, profusely distributed over the city, urge the boycott of Gentiles. Artistically designed, the stickers bear large black print reading: "Buy Jewish—Boycott Gentiles." That there be no doubt as to the authenticity of the stickers their makers have inscribed the star of David in the center of which is the law of Moses, and other tracings symbolic of Jewish traditions appear in the stamp.

"I intend locating the source of this false and insidious propaganda," Mr. Untermeyer declared yesterday. "These stickers have been pasted profusely through New Jersey particularly and in New York with the intention of bringing hatred down upon the Jew."

"These stickers, together with other samples of Nazi propaganda will be called to the attention of the Committee of Congress that is expected to be authorized at the forthcoming session to make a thorough investigation of Nazi activities in this country."

## Maurice Rosenfeld Dies in Chicago After Brief Illness

CHICAGO, Dec. 28—Maurice Rosenfeld, retired Jewish capitalist, died suddenly at his home here yesterday. A throat ailment, which began on December 25, resulted in his death.

Mr. Rosenfeld was born in Chicago on January 15, 1855 and was educated in the local public schools and in a commercial college in Germany. On his return to the United States, he entered the real estate business and was active until his retirement in 1920. For many years, Mr. Rosenfeld was a director of the Southern Railway. In 1900, he was elected Cook County Commissioner and served for a term of two years. He was a member of the board of directors of the Michael Reese Hospital. Mr. Rosenfeld is survived by his widow, Mrs. Marie Rosenfeld, and by a daughter, Grace.

## Jewish Workers in Haifa Boycott German Steamer

HAIFA, Dec. 28—Jewish porters employed in the Haifa harbor today refused to load oranges on the German steamer Tynus, which flies the Nazi flag. Arab porters were substituted and loaded the ship.

## Manning, Straus, Colby, Speaking in Bronx Forum, Assail Nazi Persecutions

A warm plea for religious toleration couched in language which plainly indicated that it was in the opinion of speakers provoked by incidents here and abroad not conducive to either "peace on earth" or "good will to men", was sounded by religious, civic and political leaders at a meeting of the Bronx Forum held Wednesday night in Temple Adath Israel, Grand Concourse and 169th Street.

Bishop Manning, principal speaker, decried the violation of "this civilized principle" of good will and toleration, voicing bitter condemnation of the Nazi persecutions in Germany and warning that "we must not hesitate to speak out against wrongdoing that is destroying the foundations of peace and good-will."

"We must speak out and bear our witness against any manifestations of race prejudice or race discrimination, or racial or religious discrimination, whether it be in Germany or in Russia or wherever it be in the world."

"For such acts as those which have already taken place in Germany we can hardly find words adequate. There is no place in the world for such acts as those among decent or civilized men."

Bishop Manning said that the spirit of religion, "if it is real", must "draw all of us together." He insisted that the great source of peace is religion.

He mentioned the Menorah Lights which burn in the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, a gift of Adolph Ochs, as evidence of good will. Rabbi Henry A. Schorr, minister of Temple Adath Israel, who presided, said that the flag in the Temple was given by John D. Rockefeller, Jr.

Bainbridge Colby, former Secretary of State, referred to political affairs in Germany as an "unbelievable aberration." He said that "we have little ground for indulging in self-congratulation on the state of the world" and in no less ironic language launched into a tirade of criticism against the German persecutions of Jewish and political non-conformists.

He scored the "inadequate" machinery of peace set up by international bodies and said that the greater portion of responsibility for world peace rests upon the individual.

Nathan Straus, Jr., former State Senator and an outstanding leader in Jewish affairs and philanthropist, made a plea for "study of the other man's viewpoint", adding that an understanding of other cultures and other beliefs leads to tolerance.

Byrnes MacDonald, son of the Papal Marquis, declared that the per-

## Lawyers to Study Check On Misrepresentations of German Merchandise Here

Leading lawyers of the city will meet at the Hotel Astor Wednesday evening, January 3, to discuss methods of checking the defrauding of American consumers through the misrepresentation of merchandise imported from Germany. The call for the meeting was issued yesterday by the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, of which Samuel Untermeyer is president.

Among the prominent attorneys who signed the call are former Judge Victor J. Dowling, Appellate Division Justice Arthur S. Tompkins, and former Ambassador James W. Gerard.

After citing the large number of complaints received by the League and the accumulation of evidence of misrepresentation of German goods, the League call pointed out that the law requiring the stamping of all imported articles with the name of the country of origin was being violated. A large amount of German goods destined for the retail trade was reported inadequately marked or not marked at all.

On January 3, a conference of representatives of 500 Jewish youth groups of New York will be held at the Hotel Pennsylvania, the League announced. Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver of Cleveland, vice-president of the League, will speak on the "Moral Aspects of the Boycott."

## Newark Police Release Nazi Agents in Fire Case

NEWARK, N. J., Dec. 28—Oscar and Frank Schilling, who were detained while their Nazi activities were investigated by Newark police, were released last night and the guard maintained by police at their home on Gillette Place was removed. The Schillings were taken into custody when a fire in the basement of their home revealed the existence of a Nazi headquarters, photographs of bridges, Nazi literature and a large number of industrial chemical formulae, apparently collected here by Nazi enthusiasts.

Police declared that they were unable to detain the Schillings any longer in view of the fact that there were no specific charges against them. The brothers promptly left for an unknown destination and efforts to locate them proved unsuccessful.

However, the investigation of their activities begun by Federal secret service men is to continue. A request that it be supplemented by an investigation by the United States Department of Labor has been made by Congressman Dickstein. Both the Schillings are aliens.

## Academy Seeks Scholarship Fund for German Jews

Seven scholarships which are to be used for establishing research fellowships for German Jewish students and which are valued at \$2,500 each, will be distributed by the American Academy for Jewish Research when a fund-raising drive for the money is completed.

According to Professor Salo Barron, professor of Hebrew Literature at Columbia University and secretary of the academy, more than \$1,500 has already been subscribed for the fund.

Part of the fund will be sought among rabbinical leaders and the remainder from outside organizations. The recipients of the scholarships will be brought to the United States and placed in specialized fields for research.

## Dr. S. S. Goldwater Named Hospital Commissioner

Dr. Sigismund Schulz Goldwater, one of the most widely known hospital consultants in the United States, was named yesterday by Mayor-elect Fiorello H. LaGuardia as Commissioner of the Department of Hospitals.

The new Commissioner was born in New York City sixty years ago and studied at Columbia University. He received his medical training at Bellevue and in 1925 received the degree of doctor of science at Marquette College. He has been superintendent and director at Mt. Sinai Hospital and was Commissioner of Health between 1914 and 1918. For many years he has been municipal expert in hospital construction and administration.

## Green Calls on A.F. of L. Units To Make Boycott Effective

choosing, and until Germany ceases its persecutions of the Jews."

Mr. Green's communication makes the suggestion that committees be appointed in every community to deal with the problem of enforcing the boycott "in accordance with the economic, social and business requirements of each community."

Mr. Green called upon organized labor and its friends, through national and international unions, State Federations of Labor, City Central Bodies and Local Unions, to carry out the mandate of the parent body.

The president of the Federation in his letter emphasized the stand that labor "is not fighting against any political order set up in Germany or against the German people."

"We are asking only that the annihilation of German trade unions shall cease and that the persecution of the German working people and of the Jewish people merely because they are Jews, shall be terminated."

The communication cites among other instances of Germany's repressions the arrest and prosecution of Theodore Leipart and Peter Grassman, former leaders of the General German Trade Unions Association, the suppression of trade unions by the Hitler government during the week of March 2 and the appointment of Dr. Ley as chief commissar of German labor.

Stories from the Deutsche Allgemeine Zeitung and other German newspapers, including Hitler's paper, the Voelksischer Beobachter, are quoted to support the statements of Mr. Green.

## Untermyer Gratified

Samuel Untermyer, president of the Nonsectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, yesterday expressed gratification at the step taken by William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, in Washington in asking that the boycott be more strictly applied to German imports.

"I am greatly pleased with the statement issued by Mr. Green," Untermyer said. "His action is in line with what I understood to be the position of the American Federation of Labor on the question of the anti-German boycott."

Mr. Untermyer declared that the boycott is becoming more effective with recent resolutions of American buyers to refrain from purchasing wares made in Germany. He said that the efforts of his boycott committee are being intensified and that he anticipates a gradual tightening of the boycott until the objective of the committee is gained.
