'Goyim' Insults Nazis; Jews Hailed to Jail

BERLIN, Jan. 15.—Max Hirschenberg and Moritz Schriesheimer, Jewish employees of a Karlsruhe firm, were arrested today by the political police and sent to a concentration camp.

Secret police declared that Aryan girls employed by the firm had said, "we can no longer stand the Jewish molestation." Hirschenberg is also charged with having insultingly referred to non-Jews as "Goyim." The word "Goyim" is merely a translation of the Hebrew word for Gentile.

No Hope for Jews In Reich—Von Papen

German Vice Chancellor Would
Eliminate Jew from
Public Life

BERLIN, Jan. 15.—German Jews can hope for no change in their status in the future, Vice-Chancellor Franz von Papen stated in a speech delivered several days ago at Gleiwitz, Upper Silesia. The text of the speech was published today for the first time.

The German government intends to proceed with its racial policy and make the "Jew disappear from public life in Germany," von Papen declared. He replied to the attack made by the Austrian Catholic Bishop, who charged Germany with stimulating racial hatred. He insisted that Germany is not acting against the Jews but merely combating their growth, which is frequently aided in Austria, the Vice-Chancellor pointed out.

"We hope," von Papen concluded, "that the prophetic words pronounced in 1896 by the Christian leader, Leuter, that the nations of the world will cease quarreling among themselves, when the Jews are once and forever conquered, will find immediate realization, especially in German-Austrian relations."

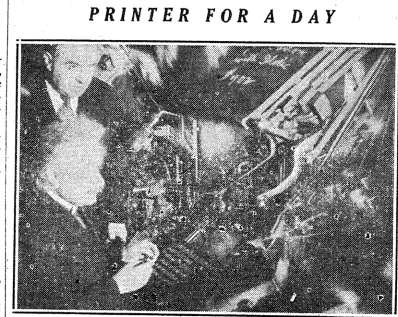
Nathan Straus Memory Honored in Palestine

Einstein Sets Type For First Edition Of New Bulletin

Distinguished Group Hails the
Paper as Influence for
Unifying Jewry

The Jewish Daily Bulletin yesterday entered the family of full-size metropolitan dailies published in English when Professor Albert Einstein set the first type for the newspaper. The scientist made a special trip from his home in Princeton, New Jersey, to visit the plant of the Jewish Daily Bulletin at 221 Centre Street and later attended an inaugural luncheon of which he was guest of honor. Messages from other distinguished figures, including President Roosevelt, Governor Lehman, former Governor Alfred E. Smith and Mayor F. H. LaGuardia, felicitating the new daily, were received at the luncheon.

The unusual sight of a scientist whose theories as to planetary movement and the size of the universe have made him one of the foremost thinkers in the world, seated at a linotype machine poised over its keyboard, opened the eyes of many. Dr. Einstein, accompanied

Schmitt Assailed By Hitler's Paper For Stand on Jews

Voelkischer Beobachter Says
Pro-Semitic Attitude
Is Dangerous

BERLIN, Jan. 15.—The Voelkischer Beobachter, leading Nazi newspaper, today bluntly told Minister of Economics Kurt Schmitt that he must either give up his liberal attitude toward the Jews, or most of the leading officials of the Ministry would be forced to resign. "A huge sweeping of high officials from the Ministry is forthcoming," the Beobachter declared.

The Beobachter added that Minister Schmitt must finally make up his mind whether he prefers to retain the old pro-Jewish officials or to replace them with young Nazis. The Nazi paper particularly attacked Schmitt for daring to suggest to the government to order newspapers and even the official Nazi papers to publish Jewish advertisements.

"Can any one say that such leading officials should be tolerated?" the Beobachter asked. It warned Schmitt that he will be held responsible for every member of his staff, and that the argument that the pro-Jewish officials have the greatest economic and social experience, is no excuse for retaining them.

Mixed Marriages Legal In Salonica; Old Law Is Scrapped by Authorities

SALONICA, Jan. 15.—Mixed marriages became possible here today with the publication of the new civil code permitting marriages between members of different religions. Previous laws provided for religious marriages only, and persons of different faiths were unable to have religious ceremonies performed.

ARAB PROTEST IS PUT OVER TO WEDNESDAY

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15.—The proposed Arab demonstration against the Jewish Executive Board was postponed until Jan. 17, owing to a mistake in the lunar calculations in the end of the Ramadan, forty day Mohammedan fast. The demonstration was originally scheduled for Jan. 16.

The Arab Executive is carrying on extensive preparations for the protest. Country-wide routes for the demonstration parade have been fixed with the consent of the Palestine government officials. The largest demonstration will take place at Tulikarm. In the Jerusalem area, the Grand Mufti will head the demonstration owing to the illness of Musa Kazim Pasha.

Troop Movements Completed (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15.—Recent movements of troops in Palestine, begun on January 2, is in reality only the completion of the redeployment of the First Seaforth Highlanders, now stationed in Palestine, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today from reliable sources. The redeployment has no connection with present security conditions. The Seaforth Highlanders arrived in Palestine far below the normal strength of an infantry battalion, and the redeployment in Palestine will make the full battalion strength, in accordance with the normal arrangements of the British War Office.

merchandise have fallen off more than fifty percent. The unpopularity of German goods is reflected most emphatically in the diminution of this department store's recent purchases from Germany, a country which formerly was one of the world's greatest sources of manufactured goods. Macy's used to be probably Germany's best department store customer. During the last four months as a result of this consumer resistance, Macy's orders placed in Germany have an aggregate of \$17,900, as against over \$65,000 for the same months in 1932.

"It is true that a small stream of

German goods, as compared with a veritable flood in previous years, continues to run into our store rooms; but in time, if consumer resistance continues, this will dry up altogether. Most merchandise still being received, we contracted to buy before popular reaction against the Hitler regime set in," Mr. Straus said.

Orders far in Advance
While he did not give exact figures to indicate the value of German goods being received at Macy's, the department store president explained that orders are frequently

WORLD NEWS IN BRIEF

The LaGuardia administration plans to retain the five-cent subway fare, City Chamberlain A. A. Berle, the Mayor's representative in the transit negotiations, revealed.

State Senator J. J. McNaboe bolted the Democratic majority in the State Senate yesterday, thus breaking the Democratic majority of one in the Upper House. The LaGuardia bill for special powers is expected to benefit.

Financial and commodity markets rose sharply yesterday. Active stocks gained from 1 to 6 points in heavy trading.

Police Commissioner O'Ryan revealed that more than \$1,000,000 in police relief funds are tied up in frozen assets.

Washington

President Roosevelt asked Congress for power to stabilize the dollar at 20 to 60 cents. The President recommended the creation of a \$2,000,000,000 fund to tide in gold.

Secretary of the Treasury Morgenthau announced that beginning tomorrow, the price of newly-minted domestic gold would be \$34.45 an ounce, less one-quarter of one percent for handling charges.

Instigated by Representative Dickstein, Federal immigration authorities began an investigation of Italian Fascist propaganda activities in New York City.

President Roosevelt has renewed his attempts to have the St. Lawrence waterway bill passed.

CALCUTTA—Twenty-one persons were killed and hundreds injured in a riot here which rocked all India yesterday.

FOOCHOW, China—Thirty American bluejackets were landed here to protect American interests in the war-torn city.

HAVANA, Cuba—Carlos Hevia, Secretary of Agriculture, was named president of Cuba yesterday.

ISTANBUL, Turkey—The Turkish Minister of the Interior announced that Samuel Insull, former Chicago utilities magnate, would not be permitted to take refuge in Turkey.

wave of discontent and unrest. His program was based mainly on the forged "Protocols of the Wise Men of Zion". The German unemployed were told by the Nazi demagogues that the Jews were responsible both for the war and for the "dictated" peace. The starving Germans were told that the Jews had conspired to dominate Germany, that they had amassed fabulous fortunes, that they were holding the most important government posts, that they controlled the press and the universities, finance and commerce, that communism in Germany was a distinctly Jewish movement. The Hitler agitators told the hungry German masses that the Jews were of an inferior, destructive race and that the Jews were to blame for all the ills that had befallen Germany.

It did not matter that the accusations against the Jews were brazen and absurd falsehoods. The deluded German masses believed them.

Following the line of least resistance, the Hitler regime set out to persecute, humiliate and exterminate the Jews of Germany, forcing the professionals out of their occupations, driving the intellectuals from the press and the universities, burning the books of the authors who had raised the prestige of German literature in the world, depriving countless thousands of the opportunity to earn their livelihood. And all this was done to purify the Teutonic Aryans.

I do not share the view that German Jewry is doomed beyond hope. It is inconceivable that the German people will not awaken before long from their delirium caused by the venomous and savage propaganda of hate.

The awful tragedy of the Jews is not merely a Jewish problem. While the liberals outside of Germany have chosen to ignore the Jewish question in expression to their abhorrence of the Nazi acts of violence, the conscience of the world is not sufficiently aroused by the Hitler reign of terror because the world does not yet fully realize that the Hitler policy is really directed against the Jews not on account of their wealth or power, nor on account of their racial inferiority, but rather because the Jews in general are regarded by the Hitlerites as symbols of progress, of peace, of social justice. On various occasions reactionary, retrogressive governments have chosen the Jews as the first scapegoats, whenever the aim was to clip the wings of progress, to conceal or justify the crimes or blunders of despotism, to divert the minds of the masses from the real causes of their sufferings. Jews have thus been sacrificed in the past for various causes — sometimes religious, sometimes racial, sometimes economic, sometimes political — for all sorts of mythical grievances. In Germany today all these invented reasons have been combined in the Nazi program.

The absurd and spurious Aryan theory is but a sham. It is a pretext employed for the purpose of persecuting and exterminating the Jews as symbols of

peace and progress. The martial spirit of Prussian militarism is being reawakened by the demagogues that rule Germany today. A new and real threat to peace is being developed with unparalleled cynicism. The children and the youth of Germany are taught that by force alone can the German nation live.

Yesterday General von Horn, artillery commander during the World War, at a demonstration of the war veterans' league, in the presence of President von Hindenburg, said:

"Adolf Hitler has given to war a new meaning; he has given to it the idea of being a blessing for the fatherland."

Hitler himself is talking about peace. But General von Horn has blurted out the truth.

The happenings in Germany should not be regarded merely as an internal problem, for they may have grave consequences affecting other nations beyond the boundaries of Germany.

Haifa Labor Dispute Ends in Arrest of Fifty-eight Rioters

Revisionists Refuse to Sign
Collective Agreement on
Jewish Workers

HAIFA, Jan. 15—Fourteen Revisionists, right wing Zionists, and four members of the Histadruth, central labor organization, were arrested here and several more were injured as the result of a labor quarrel between the Revisionists and the Histadruth which broke out last Tuesday, and which has resulted in the arrest of fifty-eight of the combatants.

The dispute began when a contracting firm owned by the Revisionists refused to sign a collective agreement regarding terms for the employment of Jewish workers. This agreement has already been signed by thirty-two contracting firms of Haifa. The Revisionists alone refused to sign. The Histadruth thereupon called a strike in a building in Hadar HaCarmel upon which Revisionists and members of the Histadruth were working. When the Revisionists refrained from striking and offered to make up the shortage of labor, the local workers' council began picketing. The Revisionist workers resented the picketing and declared that they were exclusively entitled to the work, and had merely allowed a few Histadruth workers to enter the building.

After the Haifa Communal council failed in an attempt to mediate, the Revisionists, who have few members in Haifa, brought in reinforcements from outside contractors they paraded through the main street of Hadar HaCarmel. The marchers clashed with onlookers in the streets. Attorney Yeravitsky, secretary of the Palestine Revisionists, was injured in the fighting.

An appeal issued by the Haifa contractors protested the attitude adopted by the Revisionist contractors. The Vaad Leumi, the Jewish National Council, has been invited to arbitrate. Pending a settlement of the dispute, a truce has been arranged between the two factions.

Park Avenue Synagogue Alumni

30,000 IMMIGRANTS ENTER HOLY LAND DURING YEAR 1933

Jewish Newcomers Do Not
Include Tourists Remaining
in Country Illegally

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15—According to figures made public here today by the executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, 30,000 Jewish immigrants legally entered Palestine in 1933. These figures do not include tourists who have remained in Palestine without permission. The Agency figures are based on official government statements up to the end of November and included an estimate for December 1933.

8,000 GERMAN JEWS NOW IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15—Nearly eight thousand German Jews are now in Palestine and the German department of the Jewish Agency for Palestine has 125,000 pounds with which to settle them on the land, in addition to the funds the settlers themselves have. Dr. Arthur Ruppin, head of the colonization department and the permanent agent, disclosed today at a press conference. Dr. Ruppin told the journalists of the plans developed by the Agency for the settlement of the German Jewish refugees.

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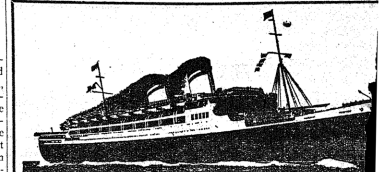

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The Truth About Hitler's War on the Jews

I. Germany Feeling the Pressure of the Boycott

Trade Decline Opens Nazi Eyes to Effects of Boycott

SS CHANGES TONE

Formerly Jeering Jew- Efforts Now Blame Jews for Present Conditions

This article is the first of a series in which Mr. Smolar will give the present situation in Germany in the light of the past year's events. Subsequent articles to appear in this series will discuss the political, economic and other fields of endeavor, analyzing the effects of the Jewish boycott on the Jews. The article will discuss the problem of readjustment.

BERLIN, Jan. 15.—Germany is being to feel the results of the boycott abroad. She is being to feel them strongly now as a serious extent.

Therefore, German newspapers usually belittled the effects of boycott movement. "The Jewish boycott is more smoke than they jokingly considered them. It is more noise than actual. At any rate, German exports are not fallen as a result of Jewish boycott. On the other hand, they have risen."

At the month—since revolution—every foreign agent in Berlin has received figures and statistics which have been the purpose of that showing that German exports abroad are growing; that the Jews and their propaganda abroad are without effect; that the world does not take this propaganda seriously and that in Germany proper this boycott is certainly not taken seriously.

Not a single foreign correspondent or diplomat believed the official figures and statistics; nevertheless, they were used. They were used to show the American newspapers and to those of England, and in one country to a greater extent and in another to a lesser— they helped break down Jewish confidence and weaken the Jewish attack.

But official statistical figures of an interested government are one thing and the observations of experts and specialists is quite another. The foreign and professional men who are now studying the economic condition of Germany thoroughly and with special interest, could not help but smile when they examined the government's statistical tables showing an increase in German industry. They, these foreign experts—had quite different information about the condition of the present German economic system. They did know of a "rise" in German industry. But in the military. The chemical. The automobile industry. In all those industries which had in the preparations for war, and in which the government is itself the

Different in Other Fields
But it was different in the case of other industries, where the state is not the general population is the consumer, where the money must come from the pockets of the people and from the government's account in the Reichbank.
In these industries—in the leather, in Germany—any increase in "rise," but a heavy loss of capital, and still greater losses.

About these losses—losses of bankruptcy and unemployment—one could not read in the German press. Nor was it easy to find them in the official government tables. In monthly statistics on economic situation, too, they were veiled and clouded over. Mention of them was avoided.

It was impossible to deny them completely, so they remained unmentioned. Now, however, it is no longer possible to ignore them. The month of November has shown a German industry something which Germany has never experienced before.

November Best Month

The month of November is always the very best for German foreign export. In that month Germany imports which are exported to all parts of the globe, the sales amounting to many millions of dollars.

Hundreds of German towns and villages depend upon Christmas. November, their whole populations are devoted to one work; that of producing for foreign consumption toys unrivaled in any other country in the world.

Thousands of German firms look forward all year to the export of toys in November to bring their best income of the year.

And ships, the whole German merchant marine—are always mobilized for the November shipping of thousands of cases of Christmas goods to the United States, Canada, Argentina, Brazil, South Africa and every other possible place.

Ships Did Not Sail

In November, 1933, however, ships did not sail, the firms obtained no orders and the populations of entire German provinces which had worked for months to prepare the usual quantities of Christmas merchandise not only did not get paid for the work but were left with monstrous debts for raw materials on their hands.

This Christmas season German toys were boycotted abroad, with the result that in the month of November about twelve percent of exports with the exports in November of 1932. This Christmas season, merchants abroad ignored Germany, with the result that German exports totalling forty million marks less than they did last year. The whole of Germany's shipping industry was paralyzed. Germany was stuck with the Christmas goods she had prepared. These goods are a total loss because they must be shelved until another Christmas. Thousands of German families worked for nothing. The whole "Christmas industry" suffered a deficit this year unequalled by that of any other year in German history.

Non-Jewish Consumers

The "Christmas industry" in Germany—this industry intended for non-Jewish consumers. The German government therefore had reasonable grounds for thinking that although they felt the effects of the Jewish boycott in other fields, she would surely not feel them in the field of trade with strictly-Christian articles. The great disappointment which German experienced in the matter therefore came as a very unpleasant surprise, one which showed that Jewish boycott of Germany is not at purely Jewish as various Hitler officials represented it to be.

A "re-estimation of values" has therefore begun in government circles with regard to the question of whether it would be better to deny the effects of the Jewish boycott upon German exports to the world or to speak openly about them.
To come out into the open and discuss the effect of the foreign boycott means not only to admit that "official" figures announced were not completely accurate, but it also means admitting that the Jews are really

successful in their fight against Germany. It means a loss in prestige.

Schacht's Public Admission

Nevertheless Dr. Schacht, President of the German Reichsbank and virtual Minister of Finance in Germany, has just made a long speech in which he publicly disclosed the "secret" that Germany can no longer endure the foreign anti-German boycott; that if the export of German goods continues to fall as it has been falling, Germany would simply be on the threshold of bankruptcy and would not be able to pay her foreign debts; that something must be done abroad in order to terminate the boycott campaign which the Jews are carrying on against Germany everywhere.

Dr. Schacht's speech was naturally a very diplomatic one. On the one hand it was intended to warn the American government and that of England that they would not collect their debts if they would tolerate Jewish propaganda against Germany in their countries, and on the other hand, it was an announcement to the world that Germany simply can no longer pay any debts.

But Dr. Schacht had merely to fire the first "shot," and now even such Hitlerite officials as have no claim whatever to schooled diplomacy are making speeches about the effect of the Jewish boycott upon German finances—speeches intended to keep Germany from actual bankruptcy and increased unemployment.

Since Dr. Schacht's speech, speeches have been made by Dr. Schmitt, Minister of Economics, and Dr. Ley, Commissar of Labor. The latter is by no means a friend of the Jews but in his address he was forced to admit that Germany could now easily be submerged by a great wave of unemployment if the boycott of Germany should continue as intensively abroad as heretofore.

Nazi Press Repouchful

And the German press, which a few months ago was making fun of the Jewish boycott of Germany abroad, now openly and distinctly, in bitter editorials, reproaches the world for permitting the Jews to hurt Germany's export; for not understanding that Germany is a victim of the Jews; firms will not be able to pay their foreign debts and the German government will have to fall behind schedule with her payments of foreign loans.

The "secret" of the declining German exports now has suddenly ceased to be a political mystery. It can no longer be kept "up a sleeve." Especially now can it no longer be kept a secret, because the American and English governments have finally put a stop to the "dumping" which the German government was able to carry on when the American dollar and the English pound fell and which enabled her to sell German goods abroad at "prices less than their original German cost."
Fear of the Jewish boycott cam-

paign against Germany which, with the ban on German dumping in America, is actually undermining the economic foundations of Germany, is now growing not only because the decline in German exports can lead Germany into bankruptcy, but also because of the possibility of still greater unemployment.

The most delicate problem in Germany today is that of unemployment. Hitler promised the unemployed that he would make work for them. If he does not create work for them—and if, in addition, unemployment increases—the present government can never win the confidence and the satisfaction of the masses.

The Hitler government fears this more than anything else. This is also why it has suddenly decided to come out with the truth about the Jewish boycott of Germany. Unemployment will increase; the excuse will be ready:

"The Jews are to blame!"
Unemployment must increase in Germany this winter. With such shrinking in industry it cannot diminish. It will have to grow, irrespective of all broad plans for work which the present German government is at present attempting to put into effect. Why not, then, prepare the dissatisfied unemployed for the idea that it is not the government but

By his wife, Frau Einstein, who looked up with interest at the machine which shapes these words into lead and carries them to the printing offices before noon. Accompanied by Jacob Landau, publisher of The Bulletin, he inspected the plant and editorial rooms. He shook hands individually with members of the Jewish Daily Bulletin staff and took a moment to say a word of greeting to the elevator boy who promised to tell his grandchildren about it.

Newspaper Men Audience

Newspaper men and women, together with a detail of ten policemen directed by Deputy Inspector James Wall and Captain Daniel O'Hearn, of Police Headquarters, composed the composing room of The Bulletin until Dr. Einstein operated a linotype.

Another detail of patrolmen guarded the entrance of the Turnbull Building which houses The Bulletin plant and offices. Dr. Einstein was escorted by a detail of ten policemen to the printing department of The Bulletin, which is equipped to turn out thousands of newspapers at high speed.

Luncheon at Commodore

The luncheon at the Commodore was attended by a host of distinguished leaders in public life who came to pay respects to the inception of the enlarged daily.

The gathering hailed the venture with predictions that it will meet with success. Speakers applauded the enlarged daily, alluding to it as a "unifying influence for Jewish life." Mr. Landau received a tribute for his efforts. Herman Bernstein, who last week became the editor of The Jewish Daily Bulletin, received encomiums. Dr. and Frau Einstein were warmly commended for their presence and their active interest in Jewish affairs. The scientist was showered with plaudits and was termed "the most beloved leader of Jews everywhere."

the population. But, to repeat, at
esent no problem is made of it."
I have been ordered to re-
press all anti-Semitic attacks in

"For the Nazis of Chile," the Fas-
leader continued, "the Jewish
question is not one of race, but of
omantics. We cannot have any
al prejudices against the Jews, if
only because there is Jewish blood
in their veins. The trouble with us
is that they wish to be master
everywhere and to concentrate ev-
ything into their own hands."
I asked comment on the recent
acts in Germany, Senor Marets
said:
"Every nation has every right to
defend its existence, and Germany
right to defend itself against us
and to suppress them."
Assessing the tactics of the Chile
Nazis, Senor Marets explained that
"only those Jews who were born in
Chile are considered good Chileans.
Immigrant Jews, even though they
have become naturalized, we consid-
er undesirable. We are therefore
working for strict control of immi-
gration and the deportation of any
immigrant who has not, within six
months, proved useful."

I asked whether there were any
Jews in the Chilean Nazi movement,
the attorney replied that there were
perhaps a few who had denied and
suppressed their Jewishness.

"That we do not need any Jews
whatsoever," he said. "How-
ever, if a separate Jewish Nazi party
were founded in Chile, we should
reject it joyfully."

Senor Marets assured my corre-
spondent that the Jews of Chile need
not fear any aggression as yet, since
there was no Jewish problem. "But
even so, as the problem arises, we
will take up the fight with deter-
mination and with every means at
our disposal," he concluded.

by the High Commissioner will
take," Sir Osmond declared.

Sir Osmond was created a baronet
in the King's New Year Honors list
for valuable public services to the
County of Kent, of which Sir Os-
mond has long been a resident.

Anti-German Boycott Here Opens English Market, Paper Says

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)
LONDON, Jan. 2.—The New York
correspondent for The Daily Express
has, in a recent dispatch, com-
municated the message that "the re-
cent whispering campaign activities
of Jewish organizations in New
York have led to a total boycott of
German goods has opened to British
manufacturers a sudden and unex-
pected market opportunity."

The writer enumerates the prod-
ucts most all of which, he says,
can be imported from countries other
than Germany and especially
from Great Britain, where prices are
moderate.

He draws the conclusion that "it
was price rather than exceptional
quality" which opened the German
market to American buyers, and
pointedly asks that British man-
ufacturers take special pains to "fit
their prices to American consumers."

Articles enumerated by the British
correspondent which were hitherto
chiefly imported from Germany, but
which are available in England, in-
clude knives, luggage, cotton goods,
fancy luggage, rugs, leather small
goods chinaware, etc.

New York critics have come to
regard Germany as the natural
source of low-priced small cutlery,
for instance," writes the Express
correspondent. "Why, asks the
New York buyer, cannot the Eng-
lish cutlery supply us with a full line
of substitutes for the German article
at a price which, though it might
not presently meet the landed Ger-
man price, would be near enough to
alienate the customer who expects
to pay about the German price; but
will readily pay a little more for
higher-grade British counterparts?"
The writer avers a belief that
"America will cheerfully welcome
British replacements of German
goods" adding that the quoted price
on British goods "must be drawn
with respect to the prevailing Amer-
ican retail price habit."

be cured."

"I plan for a new development of
manhood through harmony and
unity in human relationships toward the
goal of world peace."

Third Phase of History

"We are now at the third phase
of the history of the Jewish people."
The first phase, during the first
exile, was to teach the doctrine of
freedom from oppression and the
destruction of the oppressor. The
second was the exercise of mercy
and forgiveness, even for the per-
secutor.

"Neither could be completely ful-
filled, because they lacked the essen-
tial teaching of human love."

Those who claim that history has
brought no salvation to the world
are like spectators who have wit-
nessed only two acts of a drama
without waiting for the third.

"This new message of Israel is
the antithesis of the whole philoso-
phy of Hitlerism. Not through the
glorification of man and the state
will man achieve deliverance, but
only through love, beauty and har-
mony," the writer declared.

LIBEL LAW EXTENDED FOR PALESTINE PRESS

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)
JERUSALEM, Jan. 5.—A measure
has been incorporated in the Draft
Ordinances here which represents
not so much a censorship of the
press as the desire on the part of
the administration to prevent trou-
ble.
The sore spot is the Arab press
which takes little or no pains to hide
the emotions of an often difficult
situation. Force is used, and the
early, those neighboring coun-
tries in the Near East, have been
reviled by Moslem newspaper men
much too often for administration
circles not to take notice.

The new libel law provides pen-
alties for the publication of "mat-
ter tending to degrade, revile or ex-
pose any prince, ruler, potentate, am-
bassador or other dignitary of any state
or territory other than Palestine." If
the published matter disturbs the
peace, the publisher is liable to im-
prisonment for a term not exceeding
three years, or to a fine of a hundred
pounds, or both.

Conditions which might militate
lamages include public need, judi-
cial proceedings, legal, moral or so-
cial duty or legitimate interest on the
part of a particular person.

Divorce in Palestine

My dear Sir:

It is a matter of common knowledge that the study of people and conditions in the land of the Barbarians presents all but insurmountable difficulties. The Race Determination Institute, under the pressure brought to bear upon it by the state administration and the secret service, established the fact, during the second year of the present regime, that the real name of Johann Gutenberg, of Mainz, inventor of the printing press, was Jacob Genselsohn and that his mother was a Jewess of Prague who eked out a living by selling gossamer. Accordingly, under the influence of this great discovery, printing was declared a piece of Jewish trickery, and outlawed. After public opinion had been duly flattered by the Department of Propaganda, all printing presses were reborn into

maps where red circles denote the numerous concentration camps scattered all over Barbary territory. Besides these red oases, one finds on the maps stretches of green which represent the turnip fields, and spots of brown for wooded areas. The cities have vanished altogether. Oaks have been planted on their sites, and thick groves of trees stretch for hundreds of Teutoburg to the Black Forest and the Harz River.

After a lengthy sojourn in Barbary, I returned to distinguish three distinct classes of Barbarians. The ruling class are the so-called Osaphs or Barbaryans proper. This aristocratic group dwells in forests and on tree-tops.

The less dominant class are the Helioits, a term bringing to mind both the truly German "Hell" and the ancient Greek Helot or slave. As a matter of fact, the Helioits are the negligible survivors of the lower middle classes who had been shouting "Hell" in honor of their ruling class so long and so ardently that they finally disintegrated into these miserable Helioits.

The former proletarian class, no longer exists in Barbary. What is left of the proletariat constitutes the points marked red on the map. It is there that these "concentrational" Europeans are confined, or, rather, are doomed to slow death and total annihilation. They live under strictest surveillance. Using the alphabet is a capital offense. Runic script, the characters of which require the use of pointed knives, is not accessible to them because they are not allowed to possess weapons of any kind. Thus, writing is the exclusive privilege of the upper class, whose members carry sharp knives with them. With these knives they also skin the oxen, whose flesh they eat out of chunks and devour raw.

The concentrational Europeans communicate with each other by means of a secret sign language reminiscent of that of dead-men. If one of them is caught talking to a fellow prisoner he is beaten up severely and, often as not, flogged to death. These concentrational Europeans are fed on turnip offal, dung and occasional leftovers thrown to them by some of the softer-hearted Barbaryans.

The members of the Helioit class are of fair complexion. They have blue eyes, tangled beards, and are clad in brown canvas suits. Had they worn animal skins instead, they might be taken for Huns. But skins are the exclusive privilege of the upper class. The female Helioits wear their hair in long braids and coquettishly display necklaces made of enemies' teeth. The last vestiges of civilization may be observed in these women's long finger nails dyed red in accordance with the style at present in vogue among our own ladies in the West. The men and women of this class toil in the turnip fields, the concentrational Europeans, and their women classes deprived of all opportunity to engage in any occupation.

What seemed particularly strange to me was that I noticed among the Helioits a number of people of an absolutely non-Aryan cast of countenance. My official guide, who would not let me out of sight either during waking or sleeping hours and who kept in his pocket—to be on the safe side—a test tube with a specimen of my blood, explained to me that not all Helioits were full-blooded Aryans but that many of them had assimilated themselves to such a degree that their actions and manners became no less Aryan than those of their masters.

After a long and fatiguing journey we succeeded at last in reaching the residence of the chiefs of Barbary's ruling caste. I had been accustomed, during my former travels, to meeting all kinds and manner of people. Particularly replete with surprises was the land of the Houghnhams. And yet, when I beheld for the first time the rulers of Barbary, the most exclusive and snobbish of all the globe, I was dumbfounded.

Indeed, as my readers shall see, there was ample reason for astonishment. As soon as I caught sight of this all-highest Ruling Caste, I was struck by the ceaseless pecking and clucking of the birds, the ceaseless exclamations out loud, at the top of my voice:

"Good Lord, but they are Jews!"

When I communicated, after some hesitation, this thought to my companion, he burst out laughing. The Osaphs of

passing observations, of a purely scientific nature. As a former ship's surgeon took particular interest in the anatomical structure of the Barbaryans. Their developed organs are those indicative of the warlike spirit of the race. There to be observed in all one-hundred-perce Barbaryans a hyper-trophy, or super-enlargement of the thyroid or shield-shaped gland and of the sword-shaped appendix. The Supreme Osaph once made an attempt to bring the origin of Berthold Schwarz, inventor of gunpowder, under suspicion, issued a decree directing that war be waged by means of bows and arrows, catapults and burning pitch only. After protracted debates and arguments, however, it was decided to employ the most modern weapons, and converted printing presses a now turning out guns and munitions record speed.

So much for my brief survey of thin and conditions in Barbary. For more details, inquire over the radio. Keep in mind, though, that I am a two-hundred-year-old

machines for making fire arms, all type fonts were melted and recast into bullets, and the straight-lined runic script was made obligatory instead. As very few readers are familiar with this primitive method of recording human speech and events, one has to rely on eye-witnesses in order to learn what is actually going on in Barbary.

Those on whose behalf I undertook the mission did their utmost to persuade the leader of the Barbaryans, the so-called Supreme Osaph, to grant me permission to enter his country. In vain did they keep assuring him that I was the foremost and oldest journalist in His Majesty's domain, that my travelogues had gained me wide renown and that my visit would be in the best interests of Barbary herself. At one time, during the negotiations, the following insurmountable obstacle arose to my being admitted: the Barbaryans were suspecting that my Christian ambassador carried with him a contagious derivative of Lehman and Samuel, this being an unmistakable indication of my non-Aryan origin. Fortunately, however, the Department in charge of Race Determination and Vines demanded few drops of blood for analysis from an applicant for admission. Without this test, no entry permits are issued. A specimen of my blood was duly submitted, but as no favorable reply was forthcoming, I informed the Department that, in addition, I was willing to submit to sterilization, as practiced in Barbary. But I was informed that sterilization would not be applied to a man over two hundred years of age. After a long, interminable wait my documents were finally returned to me with the resolution: "To be admitted!" The seals with the Fascist insignia took up an entire page of my passport.

As is well known, the civilized countries bordering on Barbary are separated from it by deep moats, a few miles wide and filled with water to the brim. An airplane, after carrying me over the moat dividing that country from Belgium, landed me on the Barbaryan territory.

What struck me first on arrival were the endless turnip fields stretching away to the very horizon. Turnips are the sole food of four-fifths of the population. The border patrol, as well as the regular army, wear brown uniforms with large Fascist emblems both on the breast and on the back. These emblems are visible a great distance away. The basic colors of the country are brown and military gray. Red, which was still to be found in the old flag, has disappeared completely, except on

Barbary, he expatiated, had fed, so fanatically and so persistently, and for so many years, on Jews that they ended up by acquiring a full external resemblance to the enemies whom they had destroyed. This recalled to my mind that Sigmund Freud tells of savages who eat up their progenitors and, as a result, become like them in every respect. But let me point out right here that the Osaphs resemble the Jews in physical appearance only. As for spiritual traits and mental attributes—why, that is an altogether different matter. Be it as it may, however, the Barbaryans of today, like the immortal founders of

their state, Dr. Goebels, Dr. Ley, and others, look like typical Jews. The hirsute adornment of their physiognomies is jet black in color, and they are distinguished by a tempestuous temperament peculiar to the tribes of ancient Israel.

After they had eaten up all the edible Jews of the Empire, they had to resort to animal husbandry. Their diet consisted of animal skin. It was a truly amazing sight to watch these fur-clad Jews climb from limb to limb in the trees.

In conclusion, I shall indulge in a few

QUAKER CITY LEADER DEVELOPS TALENT OF YOUNG MUSICIANS

Edwin A. Fleisher Organized
Philadelphia Symphony
Club

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)
PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Jan. 15.—To Edwin A. Fleisher, who has the distinction of having one of his "boys" in virtually every large orchestra of the country, with fourteen of them in the Philadelphia Orchestra, has gone the 1934 award made annually by the Alumni Association of Congregation Keneseth Israel, one of the oldest and the largest reform congregations in America. This award is given in recognition of outstanding service in the interest of the entire community.

A modest unassuming person is Edwin A. Fleisher, son of a distinguished family famous for extraordinary service to the community. His brother, Samuel S. Fleisher, is the founder and sole support of the Graphic Sketch Club—a unique institution in this country—where some of America's leading artists have received not only their first inspiration, but also their early training. His sister, the late Helen Fleisher, in addition to her other benefactions, advocated vocational training for girls and supported such schools until several years ago when the Board of Education recognizing the value of this activity made it a part of the local school system.

Twenty-five years ago about this time, Mr. Fleisher saw the need for a place where young people with a natural love for music might receive guidance and instruction. To meet this need he established the Symphony Club, from which there have since been graduated a number of our outstanding musicians. The Symphony Club is conducted along non-sectarian lines. There is no charge for admission and no question is asked as to race or religion. Some knowledge of and love for music are the only requisites.

In addition to the Symphony Club Mr. Fleisher has given to Philadelphia a library of orchestral music recognized as one of the most complete in this country. This library is now a part of the Free Library of Philadelphia and is visited by music lovers and students of orchestral music from various parts of the world.

Recalled Old Days

Called upon to accept the bronze medal and the scroll that went with it, Mr. Fleisher reminiscently referred to the year 25 years ago when he first embarked upon his career of public benefaction. He told how he recruited 65 boys from a neighborhood that was then considered one of the worst in the city. These young people, he said, were only too happy to take advantage of the opportunities he offered them to advance themselves in a musical way. In those days, he added, talent had nowhere to go for advice. Many of these boys needed more than advice; they needed the wherewithal to start them along the lines leading to a career. Out of that group have come some of our finest musicians. Fourteen of the group are now members of the Philadelphia Orchestra. There is hardly an orchestra of importance in this country that does not have a former student of the Symphony Club. Not long ago one of the Symphony Club students failed to pass the examinations of the Philadelphia Orchestra. Now he is earning more in one day than the other fourteen earn in a week. Mr. Fleisher refused to disclose the identity of this artist who is known to be one of the foremost violinists on the concert stage today.

The exercises attending the presentation of the award were impressive and the distinction conferred upon Mr. Fleisher has elicited commendation from all elements in the community.

Proposes to Settle Refugee Children in the United States

Herman Cohen, Detroit Head
Of Jewish Home, Suggests
Aid for Reich Youngsters

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)
DETROIT, Jan. 15.—Herman Cohen, president of the Jewish Children's Home here, has advanced a plan for the settlement of German-Jewish refugee children in children's homes throughout this country. Mr. Cohen points out that the Detroit Jewish Children's Home can accommodate from 25 to 30 children at an additional cost of \$5,000 a year, and he expressed the belief that similar institutions throughout the country could easily be able to make equal provisions for German children. He said that the Detroit Home is especially well prepared to care for German children because the superintendent of the home, Dr. Otto A. Hirsch, is a graduate of a German university and for years lived in Germany.

Mr. Cohen continued: "If the German Jewish children have to be placed away from their homes, they should be placed in American institutions where they would be free from every stigma of prejudice and they could adapt themselves to the circumstances prevailing and thoroughly blend with our environment. I believe that institutions like the Jewish Children's Home of Detroit are adaptable to such a purpose. A national movement with such an aim should be started immediately."

Gov. Henry Horner Of Illinois Ends His First Year in Office

Hard Work, No Play, Doesn't
Phase Leader Who
Loves It

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)
CHICAGO, Jan. 15.—Just a year ago, Henry Horner, the genial Pro-teme Judge of Cook County, became the governor of Illinois—the first Jewish governor of this commonwealth.

The first anniversary of his inauguration finds the chief executive, despite the fact that he spends an average of sixteen hours a day at his desk and that he had no vacation in twelve months, in good health with the exception of a slight cold.

Today as he prepared for another strenuous day in the executive mansion in Springfield, he was reminded of the anniversary and was asked to tell of his experiences, reactions, and his plans for the rest of his term.

"I knew the governorship was not a sinecure when I took office," he said, "but I had no idea that any position could contain the complex problems this one does."

"While I have accomplished, in a large measure, those things which I promised to do, I now find myself with an entirely new list of problems demanding solution. The future looks brighter, much brighter than when I assumed office a year ago. This, of course, is due largely to President Roosevelt and the new spirit he developed." During his year in Springfield, the governor has missed the golf games and horseback rides in which he indulged so freely while in Chicago. "I haven't time for those recreations," he said. "There is compensation, however, in the joy of solving a governmental problem."

Boycott Drives Reich
Engineers From
Manchukuo, China
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
HARBIN, Manchukuo, Jan. 15.—
The official Manchukuo news agency
today stated that the well-known
German engineering firm of Siemens
Schuckert is withdrawing from Man-
chukuo and China as a result of the
boycotting of German goods by Jew-
ish firms. Most of the Siemens
firm representatives in the Far East
were Jews who refused to continue
handling German goods. The Ger-
man firm thereupon ordered its
agent to leave Manchukuo and set-
tle in Hongkong.
At the same time a Fascist move-
ment, composed mainly of Russian
White Guard elements, former Czar-
ists, has developed a real threat
against the Harbin Jewish popula-
tion. Jacob Khabikin has resigned
from the chairmanship of the Har-
bin Bourse, a post he held for ten
years as the most important indus-
trialist in Harbin.
The White Guards are also per-
secuting the few German Jewish re-
fugees who have settled in Harbin.
Dr. Mannheim, a refugee, has re-
ceived an anonymous letter threat-
ening him with death if he speaks
against the Nazis.


Polish Jews Beaten
By Mob in Lodz City;
Prague Rabbi Injured
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
LODZ, Poland, Jan. 15.—Jews
were attacked here this afternoon
on the main streets of the city by
hooligans. About a dozen Jews
were beaten. The police intervened,
but the hooligans escaped.
The disturbances caused by "Endek"
students, members of the national-
ist anti-Semitic political group, the Na-
tional Democrats, have also occurred
in Warsaw several times in the last
few days. A number of Jewish shops
were invaded by the "Endeks"
stench bombs were thrown into the
stores and a quantity of goods were
destroyed by the use of chemical
fire.
A brutal attack was made on the
Czechoslovakian Rabbi, Zvi Mendel-
sohn of Prague. Rabbi Mendel-
sohn was gravely injured.
The disturbances, it is thought,
are connected with the differences
known to exist between the Polish
Minister of Education and the "En-
dek" students. The Minister de-
mands a revision of the statutes of
student corporations, and the omis-
sion of the Aryan clause, which
would exclude Jews entirely, while
the students insist on the retention
of the Aryan clause.

Racial Lessons Now
Compulsory for State
Officials in Thuringia
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
BERLIN, Jan. 15.—The Thuringian government today ordered officials not to grant naturalization pa-
pers until the applicant had under-
gone physical and mental tests and
had obtained a certificate of purity
from the racial department.
More than 130 applicants for nat-
uralization in Thuringia were or-
dered by the Thuringian Minister of
the Interior to prepare for examina-
tion on their racial descent. The or-
der is part of a special racial cam-
paign in Thuringia and provides also
that all teachers, policemen, and state
officials must undergo a compulsory
course in racial education, similar to
the one taken by all physicians, ex-
cept the Jews. In the future, it was
announced, even judges, social work-
ers and state and municipal employ-
ees must all take special courses or-
ganized by the racial department of
the Thuringian government.
The Thuringian state will also be
the first state in Germany to carry
out a racial registration of the en-
tire population. All residents must
establish their descent along three gen-
erations back and supply information
for the official files.

A racial exhibition has been
opened in Munich showing photo-
graphs and models of racial Jewish
traits. The object of the exhibition
is to educate the population how to
distinguish between Aryans and non-
Aryans.
Martin Plett Greeted
By Boston Labor Groups

BOSTON, Jan. 15.—Martin Plett,
exiled German labor leader, who ar-
rived in the United States two
months ago, told a group of labor
leaders gathered to do him honor at
a testimonial breakfast here, he pre-

themselves."

Reveals Sharp Drop in Macy's German Purchases But Wares Are Displayed

placed twelve months before the actual delivery of the goods. He said that in accordance to the traditional policy of Macy's to regard an order as a contract, these orders for merchandise had not been countermanded. The restriction of German supply, Mr. Straus said, began as far back as last April, when Macy's first noticed consumer resistance. Buyers were instructed at that time to find other sources of supply. American manufacturers were encouraged to try to produce those things previously bought in Germany.

Mr. Straus said that certain German manufacturers were difficult to replace, but that his concern was substituting for them as rapidly as possible. Women's fabric gloves and children's full fashion cotton hosiery he cited as examples of superior German merchandise, which could not as yet be duplicated without entailing much higher costs to the American consumer. In some lines, he said, manufacturers from Czechoslovakia, as well as from the U.S.A., and from other countries, were being substituted, but for the Czechoslovakian factories operating to capacity output cannot produce enough to replace entirely German manufactures.

Disposing of Stocks

"In the meantime," Mr. Straus said, "we are trying to sell what we have. To do this we must treat it much the same as goods from other countries. All imports are marked with a stamp of the country of origin as required by law. We have instructed our salespeople to call attention to the fact of German origin before purchase is consummated. We have received complaints from a number of German customers regarding our distinction of German goods from the rest. Likewise, we have received complaints in 'gradually diminishing' numbers from foreign customers against our handling German goods at all."

"Our present policy with regard to German goods will remain in effect until Americans agree to themselves willing to buy German-made merchandise," Mr. Straus concluded.

Mr. Straus emphasized the fact that Macy's handling of German goods is a reflection of the dwindling of popular demand for manufactures from New Germany. The continued diminution of this demand, reflected in the downward course of orders for German goods, he interpreted as the continuation of the boycott by the consumers.

Mr. Straus's interview followed an investigation of the sale of German goods in this city undertaken by a Jewish Daily Bulletin reporter after numerous complaints had been received by the newspaper that department stores were displaying and selling German-made products.

The investigator found that in Macy's chinaware department, German manufactures were displayed quite as prominently as those from other countries. Sets of German china were displayed on shelves where they could be seen to best advantage by customers. Their only identification as being of German make was the usual label printed in small letters on the back of each piece, "Made in Germany."

The saleslady at the perfume counter in Macy's described "Aur Wiederschen" perfume as being an excellent brand. As far as one might judge from her description of the article, German perfumes had not been boycotted or discriminated against in Macy's.

Women's fabric gloves made in Germany were displayed at Macy's glove counter, and their quality was described in highly favorable terms. No mention of the boycott was made by the saleslady, however. The German products appeared to be of larger stock than those made in other countries.

While salespeople in Macy's toy

department said that no German toys had been bought recently, they declared that they had for sale many articles of German make. The supply of German toys had not been dissipated by the Christmas sales. A number of cheap German cameras were on display on Macy's counters in the kodak department. They said German film and higher-priced German cameras.

The children's stocking department and glassware department carried German goods.

During the entire excursion salespeople had not once mentioned the anti-German boycott.

Macy's department store and its president become the object of an attack by Samuel Untermyer, president of the American League for the Defense of Jewish Rights, in an advertisement which the daily papers refused to publish a few months ago. He declared that non-Jewish department stores were observing the boycott to a greater extent than Macy's, inasmuch as they no longer maintained agencies in Germany for the purchase of goods there, and that they were discontinuing the purchase of goods in Germany.

Untermyer also charged that Macy's had been taking advantage of cheap block marks in their purchase of German goods and that many of the German products handled by Macy's could be obtained from other countries. He urged that Macy's take the lead in withdrawing patronage from Germany and expressed the conviction that other department stores would follow the example.

Paterson "Y" Campaigns

For New Membership

New Fascist Group Formed in Britain

Denies Anti-Semitic Stand But Charges Jews with Acts Of Villainy

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, Jan. 15.—The United British Party, the third anti-Semitic Fascist group to be formed in Great Britain, entered the political field today with the proclamation of Captain Edward Ralph Strozcolli, its candidate in the forthcoming parliamentary by-election at Cambridge.

The new party, in its program, denies antagonism toward any religion, but declared its adherence to British tradition and constitution as far as religious freedom is concerned. Nevertheless, the very first spokesman for the party, Skeels, is known as an anti-Semite, who only a few weeks ago published a lengthy attack on Sir Oswald Mosley, leader of another British Fascist group. He accused Sir Oswald of being an instrument of the Jews and a charlatan who was being paid by the Jews. The attack on Mosley was published in *The Sun* of November 1934, edited by the notorious Nazi anti-Semite, Julius Streicher.

Skeels recently participated in Nazi agitation in Germany, addressing numerous mass meetings with his friend Streicher. Up to a few days ago he was part of the leadership of the anti-Semitic Imperial Fascist group. It is generally suspected here that Skeels is a paid Nazi agent.

The growth of Fascism in England, which has been checked up to now by the continual splits among the Nazi groups, has received its strongest impetus through the five column editorial in the Daily Mail today signed by Viscount Rothermere, who declared "Hurrah for the black shirts," and urged British youth to join Mosley's organization, proclaiming that England's future lay in Fascism.

Mosley, although he originally denied being anti-Semitic, has lately turned out to be a virulent anti-Semite, viciously attacking not only Jewish foreigners, but also British Jews of foreign origin.

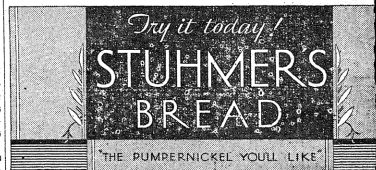
Meeting of Executive Discusses Restrictions and Land Purchase Policy
