Abraham Lincoln

THE 125th birthday anniversary of Abraham Lincoln, which we are celebrating today, recalls once more the immortal life story of the Great Emancipator, the humble, kindly, wise and courageous man who abhorred the Hitler menace, if he were alive and President today. Mr. Hertz's speculations on this subject are highly illuminating.

In an interview in this issue Emanuel Hertz, recognized authority on Lincoln, expresses his opinions as to what Lincoln would have said and done with regard to the Hitler menace.

By spreading propaganda of bigotry and war madness to other lands, the present rulers of Germany have themselves removed the diplomatic obstacle of non-interference with the internal affairs of the United States. Germany today is deliberately interfering with the internal affairs of other nations, inciting race hatred and war against established institutions of justice and mercy. Lincoln would have assumed moral leadership in an effort to curb the Hitler's monstrosities which are intended to undermine the welfare and peace of the world.

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Poland's Opportunity

THE Polish National Democratic movement, anti-Semites of long standing, now re-inforced by the German Nazis, are intensifying their anti-Jewish campaign in Poland. In a recent debate in the Sejm the National Democratic deputies attacked the Jews, exclaiming that there were too many Jews in Poland, and that a number of them should be driven out of the country. He added that if the government failed to take precautionary measures against the Jewish "peril," the Polish people would be compelled to defend themselves against the Jewish "Minister of the Interior," replied that the government would never have per-

Green to Talk In Garden Rally Against Hitler

A. F. of L. Co-Sponsor of Meeting at Which Seabury Speaks

In the name of organized labor, William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, yesterday announced his organization's co-sponsorship of "The Case of Civilization Against Hitlerism" to be presented March 7 in Madison Square Garden. Samuel Seabury, political reformer and jurist, will declare the collective indictment of civilization against Nazism.

"Free people who love liberty and who believe in democracy and democratic principles cannot remain silent, refusing to protest when injustice and persecution are being inflicted upon free, liberty-loving people in other lands," asserted Mr. Green. Zionists Balk On Calling a World Congress

Astor Meeting Votes to Give Committee the Deciding Right

Following four hours of heated debate, the national executive committee of the Zionist Organization of America voted at a meeting in the Astor yesterday to shelve the proposal to convene a World Jewish Congress in the spring of this year. The matter was placed in the hands of a committee to be named.

By a vote of 35 to 17, the executive committee voted in favor of postponement of the Congress until a more appropriate time.

The meeting was treated to verbal arguments which centered around a resolution made the out-set by Dr. S. Margoshes, editor of The Day, that the Zionist Organization of America put its support behind a movement on foot for some time to convene a world convocation of Jews. The objective of the convocation would be the organization of a permanent body for Jewish self-defense and for the settlement of Palestine.

Following the speech of Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, representing respectively the negative and positive views on the resolution, took up the cudgels and supported each by the respective speakers discussed the issue which almost ended in a snarl and which resulted in a forensic battle of the most engaging

Gladbach Jews May Not Meet Except in Temple

BERLIN, Feb. 11.—Police President Rhedde of Gladbach issued an order today "for the maintenance of public peace and order" forbidding until further notice the calling of any meeting by any Jewish association including sports clubs. Only the convening of synagogues for regular services "will be allowed, the police chief declared.

Austria Ultimatum Attacks 'Alien Race'

Defends Congress

New Anti-Semitic Activity Demands Vicious Curb, Numerous Clausus

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Feb. 11.—Waterlandfront, which includes the Heimwehr, the clericals and all the other pro-Dollfus elements, has submitted numerous extreme anti-Semitic Jewish proposals to Chancellor Engelbert Dollfus in the form of an ultimatum, it became known today.

Among the exact text of the ultimatum is being kept secret, it is, however, understood that in addition to demanding the curtailment of the constitutional rights of the Jews, the ultimatum, which is being employed by the Austrian government, insists that the Dollfus regime rid the Austrian universities and the professions of the Jews. A demand is also made that even private industrialists be compelled to employ members of the Waterlandfront from which all Jews are banished.

At the same time the Antisemitism Bund (Anti-Semitic League), which includes the Austrian Nazis as well as government functionaries who agree with the Nazis on the Jewish question, issued a proclamation setting forth its anti-Jewish program.

Adopt Aryan Myth
The League, the proclamation declared, does not consider the Jews as members of the Austrian nation or of the Austrian national family. The solution of the Austrian Jewish problem lies in declaring the Jews "a national minority of an alien race," which would establish their inequality with the Aryans, it continued.

The proclamation also proposed a numerous clause, proportionate to the Jewish population, for lawyers, judges, notaries and doctors. This would ensure Austrian representation for the Jews, the document maintained.

Intermarriage should be prohibited and the racial principle carried out in all fields in order to ensure the country's freedom from Jewish aliens, the document declared. Furthermore, a census was to be established to determine the extent of Austria's "Jewification"—that is, to discover the number of inter-

No Race Hate In Poland, Says Cabinet Chief

Foreign Theories Perilous, He Avers, Answering Anti-Semitic

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Feb. 11.—In answer to a violent anti-Semitic campaign in the Polish Sejm by the Deputy Minister of the Interior Piaricki declared from the Sejm tribunes that "acts of terrorism and violence by individuals and collectives, irrespective of their motives and no matter against whom they are directed, will not be tolerated and the perpetrators will not escape severe punishment."

"In order to prevent all misunderstanding, allow me to state that we will not tolerate race and national conflicts because they are alien to the historical spirit of the Polish people," the Minister declared. "Poland's greatness in the past was achieved only thanks to the capacity for living with the alien races inhabiting Poland. It will be perilous if we adopt foreign race theories, which are serving political expansion purposes. The race theory transplanted to Polish soil will achieve contrary results and counteract Poland's material and spiritual ascent."

Warns Minorities

Pointing out that while the main principle of Polish policy was one of full equality to all citizens, the Minister warned the national minorities in Poland against extreme nationalism, which hinders peaceful living with the Polish people.

After Minister Piaricki concluded, Deputy Piazek, member of the government bloc, in a vigorous speech repudiated the Endeck declaration that the government favored the Jews and declared that the police must protect the lives and property of all citizens irre-

BERLIN, Feb. 11.—Addressing a meeting of film artists, directors and producers in the Kroll Opera House here Minister of Propaganda Goebbels declared that the elimination of Jews from the production of films was essential in order to clear the way for talented young Germans.

"Maybe this sometimes leads to human tragedies," Goebbels added, "but our feeling is not easily affected by this view, since many of the Jews that during the past years concerned us, are the Jews."

Tydings Asks Public Hearing On Resolution Will Urge Senate Group Open Doors on Anti-Nazi Declaration

(Special to the J.D.B.)
WASHINGTON, Feb. 11.—Senator Millard E. Tydings of Maryland will appear before the Foreign Relations Committee to request a public hearing on his resolution calling upon the Senate to protect the persecution of the Jews in Germany, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today. The committee is scheduled to meet in executive session some time this week.
Senator Key Pittman of Nevada indicated to certain Congressmen that the Foreign Relations Committee, of which he is the chairman, is reluctant about holding a public hearing on the Tydings resolution. He said that if Senator Tydings himself makes the request when the committee meets in secret session during the week, the committee would give it serious consideration.
Senator Tydings said that he intended to appear before the committee to make his request during the last few days and that since the committee first met secretly to take up the Tydings resolution, hundreds of telegrams have been received from Key Pittman, the Maryland Senator and the committee members, requesting favorable action on the resolution of protest to the Hitler regime.

Portland Gives To Exiles' Fund \$5,500. Contributed to Help Put German Refugees in Palestine

PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 11.—Portland Jews have contributed \$5,500 to the fund for the resettlement of German Jewish refugees in Palestine, it was announced at a banquet which closed the campaign. Governor Julius Meier of Oregon was toastmaster at the banquet.
Rabbi Solomon Goldman, touring the country in the interests of the Zionist Organization of America, was the principal speaker at the banquet. "Jewish conditions here are constructive statelessness, not for philanthropy," Rabbi Goldman declared. "German Jews must not only be fed, their morale must be restored. They need an atmosphere that will give them the feeling of at homeness that Palestine alone offers," he stated.

Judge Rosalsky to Speak At Anti-Nazi Rally Sunday

Pictures of scenes of attack and brutality against German towns will be shown at a mass meeting under the auspices of the Anti-Nazi League and the Grand Street Boys' Association at the latter's headquarters at 100 West 12th St. Among the speakers will be Judge Otto A. Rosalsky, James E. Beck, former United States Attorney, and Frank B. Walsh. The meeting is part of a city-wide drive to intensify the anti-German boycott.

Van Paassen's '9-Day Hell' In Nazi Camp Merely Lacks Detail and Verification

He Can't Tell Names of Place, Nor Show Official Evidence

He doesn't remember the name of the concentration camp and—There was little if any publicity surrounding the incident, which occurred at a time when the news story would have been most timely, and—
There seems to be difficulty in finding official evidence to verify Pierre Van Paassen's imprisonment in a Nazi concentration camp last March was held.
Mr. Van Paassen, foreign correspondent for a number of American and Canadian dailies, admits that life in Nazi concentration camps corresponds with Sherman's conception of war.

Nine Days of Hell

"Nine days of Hell? That's the way Mr. Van Paassen put it in an interview.

None of us getting up at five o'clock, nine days of being drilled by brutal brownshirts, nine days of castor oil, beatings, and indignities of all kinds," he said. "Not only that, but nine days of Nazi refusal to allow their prisoner, a British subject, to get in touch with the consulate, which was, for four of the nine days, within a few blocks of his prison."

As far as can be learned through communication with the foreign office in London, no official foreign record of Van Paassen's arrest is on file. London correspondence reveals this much: "The foreign office in London is in receipt of an alleged detention in concentration camp of Mr. Van Paassen. The British government never intervened in behalf of the prisoner. The office is certain that in the event of an arrest of a British subject in Germany, news would be communicated to the British government, particularly if an exceptional case, like a concentration camp arrest, because there have been few such arrests on record."

Mr. Van Paassen said that when he returned to Germany shortly after the Reichstag fire last March, he was seized in Munich, held in a locked yard behind a Nazi headquarters, four days, and detained in a concentration camp nine miles from Munich for five days.

But it was not Dachau.

"I don't remember the name of the concentration camp," Mr. Van Paassen said yesterday. "It wasn't Dachau, because Dachau is in Bavaria, and I was in Prussia."

When he was taken into custody by brownshirts, according to Van Paassen's story, he was searched and his belongings were found in his possession. He related how he had loaned his British passport to Otto Heller, author of "Hitler's Rise to Power," and that he might leave Germany. The passport, Van Paassen said, was returned to him only the day before his arrest in Munich.

"I was given away by a Nazi in the United States, a painter called Hengemann who has since returned to Germany," Van Paassen revealed. "The day before I was arrested in Germany the Toronto Globe, a rival paper to one I represent, reported that I was found in Germany without my passport and given castor oil. Precisely that happened."

When the Nazis found his three Russian visas they said, "This is certainly a Russian spy. I said, 'I also have a Bulgarian visa.' Does that make me a Bulgarian?"
Off to the Brown House
"They took my watch, my passport, and all my belongings and led me to the Reichstag brownshirts. When I demanded to be allowed to communicate with the British consulate in Munich, they refused to deliver my message. I was terribly beaten, and they made me swallow a pint of castor

before his British authorities.

"I was taken to a train, after I had been a prisoner nine days," he said, "and put on it. At the Swiss border I was given back my passport, my watch, my grip, and all my belongings. Even my hotel bill had been paid."

"When I put my case before the British authorities in Zurich, he said, "You are lucky to get away so easily. In England we deal with passport forgery more harshly."

After his release, Van Paassen said, the story of his arrest appeared in England and throughout the United States through the medium of a large news service. Engquiry at the news service disclosed that following a lead in the Montreal Star, which Van Paassen represented, a check-up was made throughout European capitals and no confirmation of the report could be obtained.

Says London Protested

Van Paassen asserted that the British Foreign Office had lodged a protest through the embassy in Berlin with the German government. The German government replied, according to the journalist, that it had been extremely lenient with Van Paassen, and the protest was dropped.

Stopt on Boards

"We were gotten up every morning and given a cup of black coffee, after which we were put through a lot of military drills in a forest near the concentration camp. We had to sleep on boards, and every man was given one blanket. The camp was formerly used by the boy scouts or girl guides; and when I was there I understood there were three hundred and eighty prisoners there."

The stories of Van Paassen's release bear in them some conflict. A news release from Hadassah, the women's Zionist organization, in London, on Wednesday, February 14, Hadassah will pay tribute to Pierre Van Paassen—a well known journalist, author, and statesman. Although a non-Jew, he is an ardent believer in Zionism and in the upbuilding of a Jewish national homeland.

"Monsieur Van Paassen," the release continues, "was in Germany at the beginning of the Hitler regime, and because of his assistance to Jewish refugees, he was placed in a concentration camp for nine days, to be released finally through the instrumentality of the British government. Because of his personal experience with the Nazi government Mr. Van Paassen is well qualified to give an all too realistic picture of this reign of terror."

Mr. Van Paassen in an interview Friday said that he was not released through the offices of the British government, but rather that his Nazi captors turned him loose before he could put his case

oil. When I related they knocked out my front teeth.
"The Nazis maintained one barracks for incorrigible prisoners. Every night they were handed ropes and told to go and hang themselves. During the time I was there nine prisoners hung themselves, and a lot more died of pneumonia."

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Avukah Honors Lewin, Exiled Reich Savant

Two Day Conference Listens to Plea for Center Stand

Kurt Lewin, exiled German professor, was tendered a dinner at the Jewish Theological Seminary last night by the Avukah Student Zionist Federation. The dinner counted a two day Eastern conference.

Prof. Lewin, formerly of the University of Berlin and now teaching psychology at Cornell University, spoke on "Psychosociological Problems Belonging to the Jewish-Ground." He contended that antagonism against the Jew as a group has diminished since Jewish emancipation, while feeling against the Jew as an individual remains. Other speakers at the dinner were: Dr. Irving Gourtchik of the American Economic Committee, Rose L. Rosenberg, vice president of Avukah, and Mrs. A. B. Ruman, executive secretary of the Young Judea.

At the Saturday night and Sunday afternoon sessions, the delegates of the Young Judea, president of Avukah, speak on "The Center Position in Zionism," and Rabbi Maurice Pekarshy of the Jewish Frith Hill Foundation on "The Inadequacy of Student Zionism Education."

Attacks 'Squabbling'

Dr. Greenberg declared that "party squabbling will be the ruin of Zionism" and pleaded for a strong center position. Rabbi Pekarshy recommended that Avukah pay more attention to student economic problems.

Resolutions were adopted urging colleges and universities to institute Hebrew in their curriculum, demanding the passage of the Tydings resolution in Congress, and asking that the Zionist Organization of America support Avukah. The resolutions committee included: Lewis Kollin, New York University; Sol Lippman, N.Y.; Zeidan Rosenfeld, the College of the City of New York; Esther Drachler, Hunter College; and Abraham Halpern of Harvard University.

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'Nazis' Fight' Called Effort At Deception

Analysis Continued of Pamphlet Upholding Hitlerism

(This is the second of two articles by Mr. Fischer in which anti-Semitic allegations contained in "Germany's Fight for Western Civilization," the pamphlet which Nazi agents are attempting to distribute in this country, are systematically refuted. The first article appeared in Friday's issue.)

And then come the pictures of Kurt Eisner and his adherents, who were responsible for the revolution in Munich. When anxious Munich Jews implored Eisner, on their bended knees, to halt in his activity, he said to them: "Gentlemen, you forget that I am a Social Democrat and not a Jew!" The leading National Socialists, with Hitler and Goebbels at the head, are Catholics. Will it occur to anyone to accuse the Catholics of Germany of the "national revolution"?

Herr Jamrowski informs the world, with astute propagandist art, that not only political and cultural Bolshevism ("A Jewish Importation") found its way into Prussia and Germany but that the price paid for hushing up this scandal.

The greatest scandal the world has ever known—the Reichstag fire—is still to be exposed—Jews here, too, Herr Goering!

What else is there in this pamphlet of vilification?

A picture showing the struggles of the communists against the church. Why do not the pagan worshippers of Wotan point to themselves?

Next comes a full page reproduction of the Welt am Abend, the best read paper in Berlin, prior to 1933, published by Will Muenzenberg. It was innocuous, indeed, on the part of Muenzenberg to have published a more readable newspaper than Herr Goebbels' Der Angriff. Besides, it is not Muenzenberg who taught Goebbels how to make up a paper?

Karl Liebknecht? An honest socialist who forced the German republic to fight on two fronts and to whom Hitler should be grateful. The Republic had not atoned for Liebknecht's assassination.

Rosa Luxemburg? A radical woman with a great soul. The Republic has not atoned for Rosa's assassination.

Oscar Cohn? The kind-hearted sage now residing in Paris, busy day and night, trying to save as many Jews as possible from German paranoia.

The Rotters? Good theatrical men, but poor business men and somewhat light-minded in the bargain. Had they produced some of Goebbels' silly plays they would have never climbed to the heights of greatness and renown. They would have had a chance to would have sunk in oblivion before rise. And it might have been better for them. One of the brothers "exploded" his sine. Is this not enough of an atonement?

Dr. Hirschfeld, too

And, finally, after Kurt Tschol-ski, the gifted wit and humorist, comes the last in the "Rogues Gallery"—Magnus Hirschfeld, "the man who commercialized sexual science." Such are the thinks he has done for Germany.

Minister of "sexual science"? Oh, no—of education. Poor German youth!

I have already mentioned Herr Jamrowski's figure juggling ability. He should be appointed by Hitler commissar of elections in the next voting for members of the Reichstag.

prived of their economic, political and social freedom, they are permitted, on their High Holidays to go to the synagogues, unmolested. How humane! For three years pogroms took place regularly on the Kurstuentend in Berlin, in front of the synagogue, and the leaders of these pogroms now hold high posts in the government.

Photographs of the pogroms would have been of more interest. Even though great pains seem to have been taken to adapt the text of the pamphlet to the mentality of the foreign reader, nevertheless the pictorial part excels the writers' efforts. No one in New York will be interested to learn that Jews flock from the country to the large cities, nor will any one in Brooklyn worry about the statement that no Jews whatsoever are to be found in the ranks of labor. The statement that workmen among Jews amount to but 9.2 per cent is the number of "salaried employees" is as high as 33.3 per cent is intended to show that Jews prefer "easy" occupations. That this is not so, any white collar employ in New York will testify, knowing full well that he would rather receive the decent wages of a common worker than his "salary." The seemingly truthful "accusation" that there were too many Jewish lawyers and doctors in Germany, will be answered abroad by the brief remark that men who, in a spirit of fair competition, prove themselves capable of attainment are indeed worthwhile. Therefore, hats off to them!

"Statistical Proof" spread over a number of pages to the effect that 600,000 "bad" Jews ruined morally a heroic people of Wotan worshippers, 60,000,000 strong, will be met with a derisive smile abroad, where intelligent people will refuse to believe such a subjugation possible. And, finally, the false statement declaring that the German press was for the most part in the hands of the Jews, will be countered by the remark: Even so still better than the "co-ordinated" New German "free lion" of the press.

And when one reads the last page of the art which states with sweet simplicity that not a hair has been touched on a Jew's head, that the Jews are going on with their commercial pursuits "as usual," one will recall the poor devil, the Jews of Zwickau who were taken to the Nazi barracks, tortured almost to death and from there, more dead than alive, removed to a hospital.

Rumanian Police Tried for Torture Put Off 9th Time

CZERNOWITZ, Feb. 11.—For the ninth time in the history of the case, the trial of the police gendarmes accused of torturing Samson Bronstein, Poale-Zionist leader of Yedynetz, has been postponed to March 20.

Bronstein was seriously mistreated when arrested on a charge, since disproven, of having carried on communist propaganda. The trial, after eight postponements, was to have been held this week.

At previous occasions when delay of the hearings was announced some reason for the postponement was given. This time however, the official notice contained no indication of the cause of the delay.

Zionist Scholar Seized at Vienna

Ben Zion Mossensohn Held on Belief He Insulted Dollfuss

VIENNA, Feb. 11.—Ben Zion Mossensohn, director of the Hebrew gymnasium at Tel Aviv, was kept under arrest for three hours here yesterday on the charge that he had insulted Chancellor Dollfuss in a speech delivered at Carlsbad last summer while the Zionist Congress was in session at Prague.

The president of the Zionist Organization of Austria and a number of other important witnesses intervened with the police, explaining that the allegation against Mossensohn was false, and that the Hebrew scholar was released.

Moss Calls for Youth Activity In Synagogue

Young People's League Convention Discusses Year's Work

Too much destructive criticism

has been bandied about in the synagogues, declared Harry E. Goebel, president of the Young People's League of the United Synagogue of America, at the society's tenth annual convention yesterday at the Hotel Pennsylvania.

Reviewing the past year of his administration, Goebel emphasized that "Jewish youth is interested in the familiar in the message to which the rabbi should really devote himself." He cautioned the spiritual leaders of the Jewish people against divorcing Jewish youth from the synagogue.

In his greeting to the representatives of more than 250 youth organizations, Louis J. Moss, president of the Unit-d Synagogue of America, told them that "with your future still before you, inspired by a will to achieve, you can do much to revitalize the synagogue, strengthen your religion, and help the cause of the Jew in

The convention was opened by Jules Backman, chairman of the convention committee, and Irving I. Hyman, chairman of the educational committee, led the opening prayer. Greetings were brought by Mrs Samuel Spiegel, president of the Women's League of the United Synagogue, and Theodore Charnas, president of the National Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs of the United Synagogue.

Discuss Topics of Day

Current problems of Jewish youth were discussed during the afternoon session of the convention, and reports on eight topics were presented. The first, "The Youth Movement in R-tigious Life," led by Eli A. Bohner, reported that as religion becomes more interested in social justice, the problem of the Jew becomes more complex than it is for the Christian. If the Jew is to espouse the cause of social justice he is certain to be accused of radicalism and even of treason. The young Jew must face reality and must decide whether Judaism shall be identified with progressive thought and take the consequences of whether it shall take the path of least resistance and become rotarian in its outlook."

Other seminars discussed "The Activities of the Group," "Technique for Building Programs," "The Function of Young People's Organizations in the Synagogue," "Cooperation between Leagues in Regions," "The Relation of the National Organization to the Individual League," and "The Attitude of the Jewish College Student to Religion."
