Austria's Blunder

WE POINTED out here a few days ago that the policy of the Dollfus Government toward Hitlerism by its own brand of Nazism is suicidal. The latest events in Austria substantiate this view. Chancellor Dollfus, relying on the Heimwehr and his other Fascist supporters, is practically paving the way for the Nazi triumph in Austria.

The New York Times correspondent, Frederick T. Birchall, cabling from Vienna, writes that the only difference between the Hitler and Stenberger doctrines are those of degree and personality, that while anti-Semitism has not yet reared its ugly head in Heimwehr action, it surely will, and then the sole divergences will be those of efficiency and personality.

The outrageous attack by the Government troops on peaceful workers, on women and children, many of whom were killed, is sure to intensify bitterness and strife in Austria and to create a situation which will hasten the coming of Hitlerism.

"Why the Socialists were made objects of this attack is still a mystery, because the tattle call for a general strike came only after resistance to the search for arms in Linz had resulted in bloodshed," writes Mr. Birchall. "It was not the Socialists but the Nazis who were exploding bombs all over Austria, propagandizing against the Government and striving to upset the regime of Chancellor Engelbert Dollfus. The Socialists were striving to induce the Chancellor to enlist them in his defense of Austria."

"Little Dollfus has chosen the reactionary anti-Semitic Heimwehr Fascists to lean on. The weakness of Austria was its strength. Dollfus had gained the sympathy of other nations because of his courageous efforts to resist the German Nazis. By resorting now to cowardly methods that are as despicable as those of the Hitlerite Nazis, Dollfus is practically making ready to hand Austria over to Hitler. The Fascism of the Dollfus and supporters of the Heimwehr closely the Nazism of Hitler than the Fascism of Mussolini."

Restrictions In Palestine Reconsidered

British House Questions Malcolm MacDonald on Tourist Deposit

LONDON, Feb. 14.—The House of Commons today once more considered the restrictions imposed by the Palestine government against tourists in Palestine, when members of the House questioned Malcolm MacDonald, son of the Prime Minister and Under Secretary for Dominions, on the subject.

MacDonald revealed that all tourists except those traveling first class must leave a deposit of \$60 at the Palestine frontier. This condition is applied to tourists from all countries, including England and the United States, he said.

He denied, however, that the restrictions interfered with legitimate tourists. They merely prevented tourists entering the country for the purpose of remaining there illegally, he said.

Untermeyer Is Guarded By Police After Speech

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 14.—Louis Untermeyer, noted jurist and president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi organization, is being guarded by a police detail as the result of disturbances incident to a denunciatory speech on Adolf Hitler, he delivered last night at a concert featuring of more than 10,000 persons.

A blond youth yelled, "Hell, Hitler!" Another blond, this time a woman, also caused some annoyance. Police took care of them both.

In his attack upon Hitler, Untermeyer said the entire world must concern itself with the actions of Germany's dictator. He also declared that America must defend herself "against the insidious activities of Germany's false rulers."

Nazi Film Agent Flees Coop; Demonstration Fizzles Out

Charles B. Herritz, who represents the Bavarian Film Exchange, now engaged in peddling a concern titled "A Man Brand," anti-Jewish, Nazi-produced movie, has removed his business address from Room 406, 489 Fifth avenue. His destination remains a mystery.

Inquiry at the Fifth avenue address yesterday disclosed that Herritz, alleged to be a salaried agent of Hitlerites, had rented a mail box from Max Teller whose business is subtlety office space and mail boxes.

Hitler Assailed by Green; Says Nazis Annihilate Labor

American Federation Head Speaks at Dinner in His Honor

Assailing Hitler and Nazism for policies which have been enforced by Nazi officials at the expense of Jews and labor organizations in Germany and avowing his condemnation of these policies, William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, speaking at a testimonial dinner in his honor at the Aldine Club, 200 Fifth avenue, last night, echoed the stand taken by the A.F. of L. and asked that the anti-German boycott be vigorously pursued.

The dinner was held under the auspices of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League for Champion Human Rights. About 1,000 persons, including prominent public officials and civic leaders, attended.

"It is because of the devotion of working people to the doctrine of human rights and human freedom that we were shocked when they learned of the atrocious treatment which, under the Hitler

Vienna Bars Jewish Labor Organizations

Banks Refuse Merchants Credit. Free 'Non-Aryans'

VIENNA, Feb. 14.—Serious trouble for the Jews of Austria was indicated last night in the appeal issued by the government of Lower Austria. While heavy guns are still bombarding Vienna suburbs, the local government made it clear that "the fight is being carried out in order to make Austria a free Christian country." This is the first time that the note of nationalism has been introduced into the battle with the Austrian Socialists.

The appeal, which was broadcasted to the entire country, urged all listeners to "stand with us for Dollfus and help us make Austria free, Christian and German." All Austrian Jewish Socialist organizations were dissolved today by order of the Dollfus government. Among them were the Poale Zion, Socialist Zionists group, and the Jewish Socialist youth organizations. However, only Mendel Singer, Poale Zion leader and representative of his party on the Jewish community, was arrested so far.

Employes Dismissed

The Municipal Bank of Vienna today refused to extend credit to Jewish merchants, while several other banks dismissed their Jewish employees under the pretext that economy forced cuts in the staffs.

Max Lenk, director of the Union of Austrian Jews, through the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, voiced the great anxiety of Austrian Jewry whether Dollfus, who is now fighting the Socialists with the help of the Fascist Heimwehr, would also have the desire or the strength to turn against the powerful Austrian Nazi party in a similar fashion.

Warsaw Jews in Panic As Leper Flees Hospital

WARSAW, Feb. 14.—A virtual state of panic reigned today in the Warsaw Jewish quarter, when it was revealed that a Jewish leprosy patient had escaped from the isolation hospital, and was at large.

A few Rzeszow Echbauer, who recently returned from Palestine, went to a clinic complaining of "eczema." Doctors diagnosed the case as leprosy and placed him in an isolation hospital, but he escaped.

Despite the announcement of medical men that leprosy is not contagious in Poland because of the climate, the Jewish section was in a tumult of worry.

Expulsion Threatened Reich Guild Members

BERLIN, Feb. 14.—The Nazi commissar for propaganda in Hindenburg in Braunschweig announced today that members of the artisans guild will be expelled from the guild if they do not buy in German shops.

Recent Nazi attempts to apply the "Aryan clause" in the artisans guild were defeated by orders from Minister of Economics Kurt Schmitt, who ordered the guild to admit Jewish members and Jewish apprentices.

Suastika Background As Lincoln Is Praised

MILWAUKEE, Feb. 14.—Speeches extolling Abraham Lincoln on the one hand and German heroism on the other were linked here at a meeting of the Deutscher Erben Legion (German Legion of Honor), described by its opponents as another disguised Nazi organization.

It was probably the first time that any tribute to Lincoln was paid in a setting of German government, Nazi swastika and German navy flags, as well as the stars and stripes.

Temple Marks 86th Birthday In Paterson

Justice Perskie Urges United Action of Jewry at Dinner

PATERSON, N. J., Feb. 14.—The Barnert Temple is celebrating its eighty-sixth anniversary this week.

At a dinner held Monday night, Supreme Court Justice Joseph E. Perskie, the principal speaker, urged a united action on the part of the Jew to uphold the ideals of his race. He declared that certain governments and people in control have "instituted a most vicious policy unparalleled in modern history against the Jew." He expressed the hope that, in the not too distant future a voice shall be raised on behalf of world civilization and the Jew shall be heard.

Other speakers at the dinner included Rabbi Max Raisin, Moe I. Fuld, president of the Barnert Temple; Abram I. Feltman, president of the Brotherhood; and Mr. E. A. Fuld, president of the Sisterhood. Representatives from all the outstanding Jewish organizations in Paterson attended the dinner.

In his address, Rabbi Raisin said: "It is the afflicted Jew who is worth while as a Jew. He is the Jew without his bits and butts. He has no apologies to make for being of Jewish stock. He clings to his people because it is the only natural and the only decent way to live. He clings to his people and his habits I would divide the Jew into two categories: the Jews who look for no excuses for their Jewishness, and the Jews who are Jews and think that they are, and that's the end of it. The second category is that of Jews who go through life as a trance, who do not begin to know the meaning of it all, who cannot even understand the beauty of the tragedy and the martyrdom of the Jew. It is the Jew of the first category who insure the safety and survival of our people."

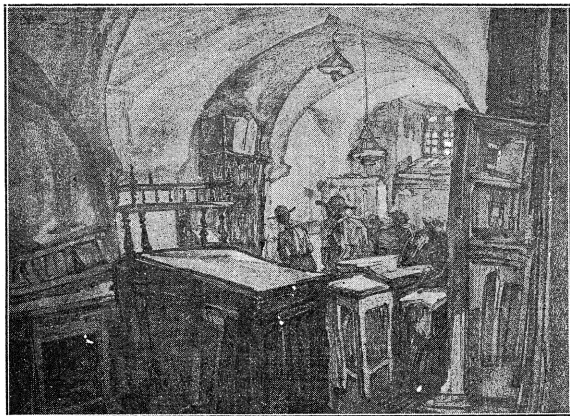
Buffalo Jewish Program

Palestine Only Jewish Solution

Asserts Rothenberg in Talk at Buffalo Zion Meeting

BUFFALO, Feb. 14.—That Palestine is the solution to the Jewish problem is the firm conviction of Morris Rothenberg, president of the Zionist Organization of America, speaking before the Zionist forum at the Hotel Statler.

"The idea that culture and education will bring a change is wrong," he said. "They don't. It is the college professors, university students, leaders of thought who are the head and front of the anti-Semitic movement in Germany."

The Zionist leader emphasized the agricultural possibilities of Transjordan.

"Today Transjordan is arid and waste. But Palestine, too, was wilderness until the modern Jewish pioneers came there, feeling themselves to be instruments of Jewish history, and turned it into green pastures."

Siger, conveying to him the opinions of the lodge concerning the subject of Germany's treatment of its Jewish citizens.

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Jewish Life Reviewed in Latest Cables and Letters

Farm Council Discusses Aid To Agriculture

To Establish Analytical Service; Also Will Improve Roads

 JERUSALEM, Jan. 30.—The establishment of an analytical service for soil surveys and analyses, a request for consultation on proposed legislation in irrigation and land tax, license fees for wine and the compilation of a booklet of information for local shippers to foreign countries, were among the matters discussed at the seventh meeting of the General Agricultural Council, which has a membership of Englishmen, Jews, Arabs, German Christians and Catholic monks, all engaged in agriculture. Three of the five Jewish members are American.

The demand for an analytical service as part of the Department of Agriculture is considered essential in view of large sums invested in land development and the importance of such investigations in the progress and development of agriculture generally and plantation industries particularly. In addition to a survey, analysis of soils, irrigation and agricultural products, will be conducted if the Government adopts the proposal. Other matters reviewed were proposals for improvement of village roads in the citrus belt; a shipping board to control export of fruit; fruit to ensure better marketing; regulations to prevent despatch of unripe fruit; proposals involving expenditure, such as animal husbandry, citrus marketing, erection of dipping tanks for control of tick-fever; and a proposal to publish an agricultural journal.

Hebrew Union Council Discusses New Duties At Tel Aviv Meeting

 TEL AVIV, Jan. 30.—A meeting of the council of the World Hebrew Union, under the chairmanship of Chaim Nachman Bialik, has been held here with representatives of cultural and national organizations as well as of executive council members of the Union resident in Palestine.

Dr. A. Rosenfeld addressed the gathering and the work of the council was held here on January 4, and the plans submitted for approval. A world central committee was elected consisting of Bialik, Adler, J. J. Goldberg, Messrs. Dinaburg, Yavneel, Lipetz, Matmon-Cohen, and Drs. Nahum Slousch, M. Solovitchik, A. A. Wolfson and Abraham Schwadron.

New Cooperatives in Palestine

Arab Newspaper Launches Attack on Fake Leaders; Says They Cause Riots

 JAFFA, Jan. 30.—A sensational article bitterly attacking the present Arab leadership was published today in Al Akhar (News), Arabic bi-weekly of this city. Warning the Arabs that they were being misled by "self-appointed and self-interested" leaders, the paper termed Arab leadership "the curse of Allah."
 "They pose as friends, but they are our enemies," Al Akhar declared. "From time to time they call upon the population to preserve the peace while they incite against it. They are like those who pour out gasoline to start a fire, and then call for water to extinguish it."
 Addressing itself to the Arab leaders the paper asked: "Whom do you deceive? How many riots

have you instigated? What is the country's benefit from you? Who of you has undertaken to support the families of the killed and wounded and those imprisoned? How long will you continue to delude the poor people?" The article also points out that these new effendis cannot be believed, and that they are not real leaders as they are neither noble, learned or rich. Their sole concern, the paper said, "is to endanger other people's lives so that they can prove to the government that they are the Arab leaders and men of authority. If one of these leaders is asked for a \$100 loan, he asks for \$30 in interest and that is their nationalism. Their weapons are lies, libels and agitation," the article concluded.

Warsaw Thieves Distressed as Leader Reforms

But Revenge Themselves by Stealing His Show's Theatrical Costumes

 WARSAW, Feb. 3.—Distress is rampant in the Warsaw underworld these days because a former inhabitant, Isaac Faberovitch, known as "Urke Nachalnink," has gone straight and is exposing the life of the underworld in a series of literary creations.

The underworld has been under a cloud ever since the last time Urke was released from prison and began writing his books. His former cronies are particularly incensed because Urke gave up his previous profession, and their ire cumulated in an act of revenge which they recently perpetrated, although indirectly, upon him.

One of Urke's plays, "The Law Suit," is now running at the Scala Yiddish Theatre here. Late one night a group of unknown persons made their way into the theatre and made off with the costumes of a number of actors, particularly of those taking leading parts. The thieves were certain that the play could not go on without costumes.

Negotiate With Thieves
 When a robbery is committed in Warsaw, one of two means of negotiating with the thieves is usually employed. In some instances personal notices must, like those which appear in American newspapers in kidnapping cases are inserted in the newspapers. In these notices the "Messrs. Thieves" are urged to communicate with the owners of the stolen goods, who offer them various conditions for the return of the objects. In other instances the thieves are the ones

to make the first move, using the telephone to make their demands to those they have robbed. In this case, the thieves made the first overtures.

On the morning following the stealing of the wardrobe, a representative of the thieves telephoned the director of the Scala and apologized for any trouble they might have caused him. "We would never have robbed a theatre, much less a Yiddish theatre," the voice of the telephone said, "but since you gave us trouble, we are returning some."

The director proposed paying the thieves a sum of money for the return of the stolen costumes, but his offer was refused. His friends didn't need the money, the emissary of the underworld declared. The costumes would be returned only if and just as soon as the play was taken off the boards.

The director, in his turn, spurned this offer and continued to give the production, presumably with new costumes. The damage amounted to about ten thousand zloty.

Some of Urke Nachalnink's disclosures, all of which are written in Yiddish, ran serially in a local newspaper.

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League Is Asked To Define Status

Vienna Conference Appeals to Other Countries for Liberal Treatment

 VIENNA, Feb. 2.—A resolution demanding that the League of Nations act immediately to regulate the status of the Staatlose, was adopted unanimously at a conference held here under the auspices of the Austrian League of Nations Union. The conference considered in detail the acute problem of the Staatlose, among whom are thousands of Jews. The Staatlose are those without citizenship rights in any country.
 Dr. Emil Margulies, representative of the Jewish League of Nations Union, was present at the conference and the Congress of European Minority Nationalities was represented by its president, Deputy Wilfan.

Polish Cabinet Member Joins Refugee Aid Group

 WARSAW, Feb. 14.—A Polish relief committee for German refugees was recognized yesterday by the Polish government. Among the members of the committee are Foreign Minister Zaleski and the Speaker of the Senate.
 The committee expects to raise money for inviting several German scientists to come to Poland.

Exodus of German Jewish Doctors

234 Physicians Emigrated in 1933, While 128 Left During January

 BERLIN, Feb. 2.—More than 234 German Jewish doctors emigrated from Berlin in 1933, and 128 left Berlin last month, the Arbeitsblatt of Berlin announced.
 Of the total 117 went to Palestine; twenty-two left for England, and the rest in small groups to various parts of the world.

Jewish Agency Stand On Income Tax Plan Is Subject of Parley

 JERUSALEM, Feb. 14.—Dr. Arthur Ruppin and Moshe Sherkot, members of the Jerusalem executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, conferred here with Treasury officials regarding the proposal recently advanced for an income tax in Palestine.
 It is understood that the negative attitude of the Jewish Agency towards an income tax levy, outlined a year ago by the late Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, then head of the political department of the Jewish Agency, remains unchanged.
 The question of an income tax for Palestine, which has deeply agitated commercial and industrial circles of the country, is now in the hands of a commission appointed by the Palestine administration.

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THE HUMAN TOUCH

Race Betrayal?

THE OTHER NIGHT I visited some Gentile friends of mine, for talk and coffee. The young man of the house is the chap I wrote about in this space some time ago. Born and bred on Henry street, opposite the settlement house, he picked up a few odds and ends of Yiddish by asking his Jewish friends to translate for him, and, please, the signs on the window fronts of butcher, baker and confectionist make. He is the kind of Gentile friend in whose presence you need feel not your vigilant, nor apologetic, nor chip-on-the-shoulder. You can be yourself. His young wife is just as much the same sort, so that conversation is no strain.

But there was present another fellow, who is in some need of the kind of etiquette I have finally learned. It is possible to excuse him on the ground of youthfulness and callowness. One may hope that he will learn to be ready to bet any money on the possibility. I hadn't been in the room very long when this young fellow launched into a most objectionable mimicry of the ambulance-chasing type of lawyer, rendering the English with a thick nasal accent. I looked at him and he seemed youthful, his face unlined and untroubled, his coloring reddish blond, his hair wavy and shining. I thought that he was a Gentile who, mistaking me for a Gentile, thought himself perfectly at ease in mimicking an objectionable type of lawyer. I was not to be so easily deceived. He was a racial chauvinist, not only hesitating to admit that there are some objectionable Jews, though not many.

His remark in my hosts I didn't notice it, and thinking him a Gentile and believing that perhaps he thought mistakenly, that I was Gentile too, the best thing to do was, I thought, to change the subject. This I did.

But as the evening waned into early morning it became evident that the young man who had mimicked the objectionable lawyer with the Jewish accent was himself a Jew. I knew that I was Jewish, too, but profound respect, I assure you, for no good reason at all this young fellow launched into a most objectionable mimicry of the ambulance-chasing type of lawyer, rendering the English with a thick nasal accent. I looked at him and he seemed youthful, his face unlined and untroubled, his coloring reddish blond, his hair wavy and shining. I thought that he was a Gentile who, mistaking me for a Gentile, thought himself perfectly at ease in mimicking an objectionable type of lawyer. I was not to be so easily deceived. He was a racial chauvinist, not only hesitating to admit that there are some objectionable Jews, though not many.

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to his Gentile friends that he was a cut above the average Jew. The name he bears is intended to assure, to convey a similar impression. I do not mean to load a little passing incident with a heavy burden of moral responsibility. It seems to me the dearest thing to do is not to construct a whipping post for your own people in the presence of strangers. The young friends in whose presence our young man spoke are not going to be made anti-Semitic; the only fret, if any which his mimicry will have on them will be to make them think him a rather poor sort of fellow. This mimicry of his does not constitute a major case of race betrayal, but there is no telling but that at some other time he may expose his Jewish friends to Gentiles, who may take a cackling delight in his "wit."

I am not a racial chauvinist and I don't like this story as much as perhaps the next fellow may, but here it is:

There is a famous virtuoso who is partly Jewish. His mother, they say, was a shiksa, a wig woman, of the orthodox. At a banquet, the wife of this performer, herself a Gentile, turned to the wife of another musician, Jewish and proud of it, and said: "You know, Arthur [he's call him Arthur] hasn't a drop of Jewish blood in him." "To be sure," the other woman replied. "Poor man! I didn't know he was that anemic!"

Oysters and Sturgeon

At the vegetarian restaurant around the corner, at the lunch time, more in haste than in state, I was making a facetious comment on the fish courses, to which a shiksa, a wig woman, and a couple of oysters about. "I know, of course, that oysters are not kosher," "But," piped up one of the proprietors over to our table, "I don't know for sure, but I don't serve oysters, why do you serve sturgeon?" "Well," he answered, "I haven't been decided yet whether it's kosher or not. And suppose it should be proved that sturgeon is not kosher, will you take sturgeon off your menu?" "I may do that, but I won't put oysters on!" Let's boycott him, boys!

As regards the naturalization of East European Jews in Germany, the following official record has been given by the Minister of the Interior in 1930 to a question in the Prussian Diet may be quoted:

With the resolution of the Prussian Diet of April 28, 1927, aliens from Eastern Europe not of German blood, who are subject to rule naturalized only after having lived in Germany for at least ten years. No such rule was applied to the required in the case of aliens who are of German antecedents. Since 1919 107,859 aliens have become naturalized in Prussia, of whom 96,854 were of German antecedents, and only 7,654 were of non-German blood, "not of German antecedents."

Even if 90 per cent of 7,654 naturalized people were Jews, only 6,900 East European

Jews would have been naturalized in Prussia during eleven years, or just over 600 a year, inhabitants of the Reich.

The official Central Press Bureau stated (after Hitler's accession to power) the number of East European Jews who were naturalized in the German Reich since the War at 12,500, making less than 1,000 a year, compared with 85,000 naturalized inhabitants. These 12,500 Jews had lived for ten or more years in Germany, their children being born in Germany.

Thus, (1) No millions of East European Jews passed through Germany since the war, but only 12,500, or about 100 a year; (2) No hundreds of thousands of East European Jews inundated Germany, but only 12,500, or about 100 a year; (3) The number of East European Jews naturalized in Germany since the War does not exceed 12,500.

The Jew in Germany Today

By F. A. VOIGHT

(This is the second of four articles on the Jews in Germany by the brilliant British journalist, F. A. Voight, for many years Berlin correspondent of the Manchester Guardian, leading liberal newspaper. Mr. Voight had to leave Germany following his disclosure of Nazi complicity in the Reichstag fire and is now stationed in Paris where he surveys the German scene for his newspaper.)

There can be no complete record of the innumerable acts of violence perpetrated against the Jews under the Hitler dictatorship. The body of unrefuted evidence that is available is enormous—even if it represented only all that had happened the persecution would not be one of the most frightful of modern times. But it represents only a small fraction of the whole. We have not and probably never shall have, more than a fragmentary knowledge of the beatings, the murders, the tortures, the robbing, the blackmailing, the arrests, the imprisonments, not to speak of the humiliations (both public and private) which have been perpetrated by Nazis on the Jews. No systematic inquiry is possible, for a victim of persecution who gives evidence is not only punishable under German law (the evidence being termed "grueselpropaganda," usually translated as "atrocity propaganda") but may be arrested without a warrant and may, without trial, be sent to a "Brown-house" for a beating, or to a concentration camp (a far greater hardship than ordinary imprisonment).

Varies in Distinction

The persecution varies in severity from district to district. There are Jews—who are quite open-minded and intelligent—who are not only persecuted in Germany, but honesty maintain that "things are not so bad." The reason is that in their own district there may be no active persecution, or as hardly anything appears in the German press, the truth may not have come to their knowledge. In a town like Wuppertal, where the cruder excesses have been avoided, although anti-Semitic legislation is operating in the Reich, in Baden the persecution of the Jews as well as of the political opponents of the regime has been relatively mild. In Berlin it has been fiercest in the early days of the persecution hundreds of Jews (and not only German Jews) were physically maltreated. Full account of what happened in Berlin alone would fill several volumes, and it would make such reading as is common in the Jewish press seem so dreadfully things are possible in the modern world. But Berlin is not the worst—it probably represents the worst that has happened to the Jews in Germany. In Hesse the anti-Semitic excesses went on month after month, so that the Jews of Frankfurt were compelled to seek refuge in the forests or to leave for other parts. The emigration of the Jews from Frankfurt has been rapid. Several townships have expelled their entire Jewish population. The Jews of Neidenburg, in East Prussia, for example, were or-

Many Jews have been the victims of double persecution—that is to say, they have been persecuted both as Jews and as political opponents of the Hitler dictatorship. In the concentration camps—which probably hold about 50,000 prisoners—Jews are treated for special maltreatment. Thus at Dachau the more repulsive camp duties are assigned to Jews. Several Jews have been murdered at Dachau. One of them was Dr. Spiegel, who became known to the world at large (though not by name) through a photograph that was published in many English and American newspapers and periodicals showing how he was paraded through the streets of Munich, without shoes, his trousers cut short at the knees, and a placard hanging around his neck with the words "I shall never complain to the police about the Nazis." In the concentration camp at Brandenburg Jewish prisoners get no proper food. They are made to eat the leavings from the meals of the other prisoners from one bowl and without knives to cut with. We have seen that in the concentration camps Jews are compelled to put up with special insults and indignities.

There is little doubt that the peculiarly malignant character of the persecution of the Jews in Nuremberg, a persecution which is now being extended to other parts, connected with the incessant agitation of the Stuermer, a weekly that specializes in anti-Semitism. It is edited by Julius Streicher, the Stuermer, who was in charge of the anti-Semitic boycott on April 1. The Stuermer not only incites to anti-Semitism, but it also continually publishes the names of individual Jews, with their addresses, as suitable for victimization. The Stuermer is the plotters, in which it publishes the names of Gentile girls who have associated with Jews (whose names are given in the Stuermer), demanding that they shall be boycotted by all, thus exposing them to public execration and possibly to physical violence. The Stuermer shows no sign to date of abandoning its campaign.

Hitler at Top

The persecution has been organized from top to bottom. Its chief originator and inspirer is, of course, the German Chancellor, Adolf Hitler. He has surrounded the other Nazi leaders, and then the professional and academic classes. The students, to some extent the smaller shopkeepers, and, of course, the disciplined Brown Shirts, follow.

Jewish Congress With- out Power to Alter Date for Election

The American Jewish Congress is without power to change the date of elections for the World Jewish Congress postponed convention, according to a statement issued yesterday by Dr. Stephen S. Wise, honorary president, and Bernard S. Deutsch, president of the organization. The organization, however, will recommend postponement of the world congress to the world congress executive committee.

The statement, embodying the views of the American Jewish Congress administrative committee, was expressed at a meeting Tuesday evening when Dr. Wise and Dr. S. Margoshes reported on the meeting Sunday of the national executive committee of the Organization of America, points out that preparations for the world congress are to continue. The organization called for postponement of elections.

It Takes Cognizance
The administrative committee of the American Jewish Congress took cognizance of the resolution adopted by the national executive committee of the Zionist organization, reaffirming the necessity of convening the World Jewish Congress which shall deal with the most critical problems of the Jewish people throughout the world, calling for the postponement of elections to the World Jewish Congress in order that preparations thereto may be more thoroughly made," according to the statement.

"The American Jewish Congress has no authority to determine or to alter the date for the elections of the world congress, by postponing them. In respect to matters affecting the World Jewish Congress, the American Jewish Congress is simply representative of the World Jewish Conference which has issued the call for the congress and is organizing the elections throughout the world.

It Will Recommend
"The American Jewish Congress, however, will recommend to the executive committee of the World Jewish Conference to accede to the recommendation of the administrative committee of the Zionist Organization of America and to postpone the date for the convening of the World Jewish Congress to some other time.

"Decision taken as to the date of the elections by the World Jewish Congress executive does not prevent the administrative committee of the American Jewish Congress to continue the work of preparing for the World Jewish Congress. The American Jewish Congress cannot postpone for a single moment discharging the responsibility imposed upon it by the World Jewish Congress. The administrative committee of the American Jewish Congress goes on with this work in the faith of the full support of all the Jews in America.

Invitation to Cooperate
"In connection with this work, the American Jewish Congress continues to look to the active support of all Zionists and non-Zionists who believe in the necessity for the World Jewish Congress.

"The American Jewish Congress continues to invite each and every Jewish group and individual, regardless of sect or party, to cooperate in the democratic and efficient organization of Jewry for the defense of their rights as Jews and as citizens, and for the greater service to civilization and democracy.

"The World Jewish Congress Committee is directed to go on with its work of preparation."

The article that the Canadian journalist objected to simply said that he may or may not have spent nine days in a German concentration camp, as he said he had.

"What's the big idea?" said van Paassen again, while a reporter from the Bulletin was trying to make out why he had come so big as to make Mr. van Paassen become so excited.

Meanwhile, "What's the big idea?" van Paassen asked once more.

"What big idea?" asked the re-

porter from the Bulletin.

"What do you mean by vilifying me like that?" said van Paassen.

"Like what?" asked the reporter.

"Like those lies you printed about me in the Bulletin," said van Paassen.

Peace Be With You
He turned to Dr. David de Sola Pool, president of the New York chapter of the Hadassah, who came forward, hand held out, welcoming van Paassen with a "Shalom!" The word, of course, means "Peace." But the man who either had or had not been in a concentration camp merely turned to the reporter and cried, "If you don't get out right now, I'll knock you down!"

Mrs. Pool's signals became frantic. Sympathizing with her predicament, the reporter turned and told Mr. van Paassen delivered his speech in peace.

The League is preparing a number of mimeographed "digests" of the S. A. Mann Brand moving picture which it calls "a hate picture" with venom against Communists, Jews and militant workers. The American Civil Liberties Union, according to one of the broadsides, has protested against showing the film.

that the existence of the institution is threatened because of its financial straits and that an appeal is sent out to world Jewry for help, creates a most painful impression. Many of the students were murdered, and the Yeshiva was destroyed. The flight of the institution aroused the sympathy of the entire Jewish world. After some time, the Hebron Yeshiva was re-established in Jerusalem.

At this time, when Palestine is economically prosperous, it comes as a shock that the leaders and students of a recognized and valuable institution of Jewish learning should have to appeal to world Jewry on the ground that they are on the point of starvation. It would seem that a matter of this sort should be handled promptly and discreetly by the leading representatives of the Jewish community of Jerusalem in order to prevent this disgraceful publicity. Other ways should and could be found to help this worthy institution.

Illness Halts Plan to Adopt Reich Children

Milwaukee Awaits Re- covery of Immigration Chief at Capitol

(Special to the J.D.B.)

MILWAUKEE, Feb. 14.—Illness of the commissioner of Immigration at Washington, holding up plans of the Milwaukee Jewish Orphan Home and private families here to adopt fifty children of German Jewish victims of the Nazi terror.

At a meeting of the home's board of directors today, a telegram was received from United States Senator Robert M. La Follette Jr., explaining that the local adoption petition was in the hands of the immigration bureau, but that illness of the bureau's head delayed action. Official government sanction must be obtained to bring the fifty children into the country.

A communication has also been received from the American Labor Party, asking for assistance in the proposed adoption.
