It was Lloyd George, with he aid of Clemenceau, who feared Woodrow Wilson's idealism as the great peacemaker, the embodiment of the world's hope at the close of the w ought about the tragic failure of Woodrow Wilson's plans for durable and equitable peace.

Proposed Polish Law Would Disqualify Jews in Trade

ish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, March 4.—The trade commission of the Polish Sejm adopted with the customary government majority the first, se and third readings of the new economic law. The proposed law would institute a system of qualifications for merchants, artisans and men engaged in industry. The Minister of Economics, under the terms of the law would decide on the qualifications necessary.

The Club of the Jewish Depu-The Club of the Jewish Deputies of the Sejm issued a statement warning that the proposed law as it stands is a menace to Jews in business and industry.

However, the government per-mitted two amendments to the bill as it stands. One postpones en-forcement of the law for three years. The second provides that existing enterprises be unaffected

'Only Statesman in Europe Keeping His Head'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, March 4. — David Lloyd George, war-time Prime Minister of Great Britain and leader of the Liberal party, praised Adolf Hitler in a lengthy article in the London Sunday Dispatch as "the only statesman in Europe keeping his head." The "Welsh Wizard" also praised Hitler for making peace with Poland. "His pact with Poland, his courageous statesmanship and its acceptance by the German people demonstrates his complete hold on them," he said

"The British people would discourage aggressive action against Germany," Lloyd George contin-"The prejudices aroused by Hitler's persecutions of the Jews is subsiding. The impression is that the Jew-hunt has been called off and Hitler's utterances on foreign policy are having a soothing effect. When Sir Austin Chamberlain, a fanatical Francophile, delain, a fanatital Francophile, de-nounced Hitlerism in the House of Commons, he was cheered. When he repeated the tirade re-cently, it fell flat. This change of attitude in England is reflected in other countries, which is good since this makes for peace," the Liberal leader declared.

Austrian Refugee Predicts Victory for Socialism

Dr. Winter Says His Party Welcomes Allegiance of Austrian Jewry

Himself a non-Jew, Dr. Max Winter, Socialist refugee from the Austrian Fascist Government, doesn't care a hang what the race, religion, or nationality of a man

be.
"If he is honest with himself, if he is true to his comrades, and if he has the interests of the com-mon people at heart—that is all I wish to ask of any man," he said.

Dr. Winter, intends remaining in and around New York for three weeks, after which he will spend three months in a nationwide ture tour. He said that if Socialist party leaders here ask him to stay longer in the United States, he will remain indefinitely.

World Socialist Victory An energetic, stout old fellow of

omething more than sixty years, Dr. Winter believes that the con-version of the world to Socialism has only begun. "The Austrian Heimwehr and,

indeed, the armies of all the na-tions of the earth can not quench the Socialist spirit," he remarked.
"I remember twenty-five years ago, my old friend, Jack London, appeared surprised that there were twenty-five million Socialists in the world. In the last twenty-five years we have expanded and developed, and now we have three hundred million Socialists in the world." His reckoning included, he pointed out, the Russian popu-

Asked about the future of the Austrian Jews, Dr. Winter re-plied, "Unlike the prophets of the Old Testament, I can not foretel the future. For accurate prediction regarding the Jews and world politics, I can only refer you to the Bible." Dr. Winter said that the Social-

ist party welcomed the allegiance of Austrian Jews. "When one of Austrian Jews. "When one joins the Socialist Party," said he, "we do not ask about his religion or his race. Catholics, Protestants, and Jews are acceptable. If Mohammedans or Buddhists care to join with us, they too are quite welcome. Our requirement is that they be prepared to defend the rights of the proletariat." In his discourse on the future of

the Austrians, generally, and par-ticularly the Austrian Jews, Dr. Winter declared that regardless of the present status of affairs in Austria, Socialism eventually will replace any form of government that might be set up.

"It may require ten days, or ten weeks, or ten years," he said. "But eventually Austria will have a Socialist form of government, No man and no government can deny

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for long the expressed demands of

the people being governed.
"In the last election, the Socialists polled the greatest number of votes cast in Austria. Forty-sev-en percent of the total franchise en percent of the total franchise were uncompromisingly Socialist —forty-seven percent throughout the entire nation, far more than the votes for any other party. And yet, a few weeks ago the govern-ment tried to blot out of existence this great plurality of voters."

Victims of Fighting

When the anti-Socialist war was mentioned, Dr. Winter choked with emotion. "In some ways I am an old man," he said as tears welled in his eyes. "Too old to welled in his eyes. "Too old to fight, I suppose. I would only be in the way of the young strong men who defended the rights of the people.

"I can not tell you about the bombardment of the Karl Marxhof and other modern Socialist buildings, because I did not see the actual warfare. I can only tell you of the many women and children who have been left without husbands and fathers. I can only tell you of the thousands of Austrians, honest, peaceful, industrious peo-ple, who are being forced from their fatherland in exile. I cau tell you of the hunger and want

among my people."

Asks American Aid

Dr. Winter honored the Amer-

ican nation as "a people who have time and time again shown themselves prepared to help the victims of man made war and natural calamities.

Dr. Winter was associated with former President Hoover in relief work in the Near East after the World War. He aided in distributing food to 300,000 children in Vienna and the Austrian prov-

help again. You have had depres-sion here; we have had war there. We have orphans and widows who do not know where they can ob-tain a crust of bread. We have people in Czechoslovakia and Italy, who have no means of helping themselves. I hope on Sunday night I may persuade Americans to help them," he concluded.

J. B. Wise Makes Report Public; Says Nazi Policy Unrelaxed

Nazi Germany's anti-Semitic policy has not been relaxed, it is declared in a report made public by Rabbi Jonah B. Wise, national chairman of fund-raising activities of the Joint Distribution Commit-The report is based upon the findings of Joseph C. Hyman, secretary of the organization, who recently visited Germany.


Since the beginning of the Hit-Ier regime 125,000 Jews have lost their jobs, it is stated. "This multitude of 125,000 persons and their dependent families are rendered destitute," the report explains, "because, as Jews, they were obliged to leave their occupations, their posts and their professions.

their posts and their professions. It is from this group that the bulk of the army of refugees, numbering over 50,000, is recruited."



Detroit Germans Divided On Nazism, Report States

By PHILIP SLOMOVITZ

DETROIT, March 1.—This city, nome of the first Nazi propagandist in this country, Heinz Spank-nobel, was without a sign of much pro-Nazi propaganda until about two months ago. As a matter of fact, sentiment among Germans was for many months known to be against the Nazi regime. While bitter strife marked meetings of German societies, the anti-Hitlerites were usually in the vast

But the tide has since turned. I have it on good authority that since the advent of the Friends of Nazi Germany the ranks of local Germans are about evenly divided —which is in effect a great gain for the Nazis. There are about 32,000 enrolled members in the combined German societies in Detroit, and in view of the fact that troit, and in view of the fact that about half are already definitely letting themselves be heard in favor of the home government even the most optimistic now admit that the anti-Hitlerist cause is lost here.

This has happened in spite of the fact that the local German daily newspaper—Detroiter Abend Post—has been consistently neu-tral, and was even known to have scharged its pro-Nazi editor for attempting to play too much on the Hitler fiddle.

What is perhaps the most interesting sidelight on the local German situation is the attitude of the German vice-consul, Fritz Hailer. Until a year ago Hailer played the game of friendship with the Jews. He appeared at numerplayed the game of friendship whom the Jews. He appeared at numer-ous Jewish functions, was a guest of honor at the Spinoza Tercen-tennial celebration and in general hobnobbed with Jews.

Vice-Consul Changes Attitude

But Fritz Hailer is now a loyal subject of Adolf Hitler. He flies the swastika from his office win-dow, writes letters to the newspapers condemning the Jews and maintaining that the East Europeans are the ones who caused trouble for the nice Jews of Germany. He visits the newspaper editors to complain that they are too friendly with the Jewish people and too antagonistic to Nazi Germany. Fritz Hailer's loyalty gets the

on tolerance!

Allege Propaganda in Schools The local scene was marred last week by reports of the spread of pro-German propaganda by school teachers who told their pupils that the reason Hitler hates the Jews is because they are disloyal, unis because they are disloyal, un-patriotic and had refused to join the army during the World War. To the credit of Frank Cody, superintendent of schools, be it said that he is prepared at all times to put a stop to the spread of such lies, provided the names of the guilty teachers are reported

to him. But the Jewish pupils invariably hesitate to name their varianty hesitate to hame their teachers—they may lose their jobs, they argue, or they may hurt them when handing out the marks. Another matter of interest in the local happenings of the past

week is the charge of mismanage-ment of funds by the Ku Klux Klan here. A branch of the KKK, recently revived, had been con-ducting anti-Jewish and anti-Catholic propaganda. Limits Rights Of Polish Jews

Jews Passively Accepted New Constitution Affecting Them

WARSAW, Feb. 16.—The new Polish constitution has been adopted by the Polish parliament with the passive support of the Jewish deputies. Though in theory it contains no distinctly anti-Jewish clauses in actual practice the ish clauses, in actual practice the new constitution will tend to re-strict the rights of the Polish Jowish community still further. Yet the Jews themselves voted for

The old constitution was fram in 1921. At that time, as now, Marshal Pilsudski was the strong man in Poland, and likely to stand the presidency of the republic. for the presudency of the repara-His opponents, then as now, were the National Democrats, the "En-deks," a violently anti-Semitic body, who feared Pilsudski's power and therefore insisted that the constitution should give only the constitution should give only very limited powers to the presi-dent. They succeeded so well that Pilsudski decided that the presi-dency would not give him sufficient scope, and so put one of his followers up for the post. He was clected, with the support of the Jews. But within a fortnight, the "Endeks" had him murdered. The mere fact that the Jews had also supported him had been enough damn him in the eyes of these rabid anti-Semites.

Pilsudski Strengthened

And now, at last, Pilsudski has achieved his old idea, of giving more power to the State's Chief Since this could only Evecutive be done by suppressing some of means that the democratic syst has been modified, and Pilsudski has been given a considerable measure of dictatorial power. At the same time, the powers of the Senate have been extended, at the expense of the Seim.

The new constitution represents tremendous victory for Pilsud-But his victory has not been due to his personality alone. The whole tendency in European politics has been away from democ-racy and towards dictatorship. Everywhere there has emerged a desire for a "strong man." Poland has now followed suit.

The man in the street has paid little attention to this constitu-tional change. The word "consti-tution" has lost the all-important significance it had only a few years ago. People have seen that a constitution, with a little legal juggling, can be made to be whatever the group in power wishes it to be. In Poland, in particular, people saw that even the best conpeople saw that even the ness con-stitutions could not make them happy, or give them prosperity. And when a new constitution was proposed, the general attitude was: "A little less democracy? More power to the president an to the Senate, and less to the citizon? Well, let's try it, things can't be much worse, and they might be better."

The same applies to the Jews. They saw that the old constitution, which in theory gave them exactly the same rights as the Poles, had in practice enabled them to be deprived of just those rights. They saw that it made it possible for the Jews of Poland to be reduced to an undreamt of degrie of poverty and suffering. They saw that to have equal rights n paper was a very different

Will Jews be represented at all in the Senate? haps yes, perhaps no, but prob-ably the latter. It will be a matter of luck rather than parliamentary democracy. A community of 3,300,000 Jews will remain practically without representation in the governing body.

The Jews of Poland have seen their rights and their power reduced more and more in every successive Sejm. The new const tution will inevitably strengthen downward trend.

But there is one other reason for the aquiescence of the Jews. The new constitution strengthens Pilsudski and reduces the chances of the anti-Semitic "Endeks" gaining power to a minimum. And while Pilsudski's government has shown no particular love for the Jews, it has at least not been violently anti-Semitic. The Jews of Poland have merely chosen the lesser of two evils.

My reasons for disliking Rogers are not personal and I don't suppose it makes much difference to him, but I do believe that he is a pernicious influence. I am es-pecially annoyed at his utter dis-regard for facts, his ignorance of international affairs and politics and the authoritative manner with which he speaks. I don't ever remember him expressing a truly progressive sentiment. Not A Passing Phase

This National Socialism found its demagogic strength in anti-Semitism. We let ourselves beits demagogic strength in anti-Semitism. We let ourselves be-lieve that they considered it an easy way of making themselves popular and that once they came popular and that once they came into power—we had seen this happen at other times in other countries—they would abandon this anti-Semitism in order to keep peace in their land. Not at all. National Socialism has its deepest process in proceedings and until roots in pan-Germanism, and unti we understand that, we cannot un-derstand the spirit of the move-ment. Its anti-Semitism is not a passing phase, not one of these revolutionary passions that lasts for one or two months of terror, and then disappears . .

Pan-Germanism seems to be the direct and authentic ancestor of National Socialism. Ever since the Germanic Holy Roman Em-pire, since the Middle Ages, through the whole trend of German thought, of all the great rep-resentatives of German thought and German action, we always find this hatred for the Jews and this idea that the Jews are not a constituent part of the German na-Thus, National Socialism is tion. Thus, National Socialism is not a musifroom growth born by spontaneous combustion in the post-war disorders. It is a new outburst, a most violent, base, demagogic, but also a popular outburst against the Jew. If not see that, we cannot stand National Socialism.

Jewish Rights In Reich

It was only in 1848 that the Jews obtained the right to bec German citizens, citizens of "great" Germany. From 1848 to 1918 they enjoyed every privilege. They were free, equal, and had ac-cession to all positions according to their personal merits. The were considered German citizen like everyone else.

In reality, the Jews, while hav-

ing civic rights and the rights of accession to all positions and all careers, only used a small part of their privilege in Germany between 1848 and 1918, the period most favorable to a possible fu-sion of German and Jew. By their talents, by their personal merit, by the great intelligence that developed in their families, they made places for themselves in the arts, at the bar, on the bench, in commerce, in industry, in banking. But whenever it came to direct power, that is, the important official functions, state administration, representation in parlia-ment, then ostracism began. It was not an illegal ostracism, but something even worse, a sort of prejudice. And when you study this question, you find immediate-ly that very few Jews have been able to arrive at the direction of power, either administrative or political, even in the emancipated Germany of 1848 to 1918.

What is going on now is not a passing drama, not one of these precarious and fleeting forms of popular agitation, but really a great struggle between the conception that is Germanism and the conception that is Judaism.

Tydings Bill Finds Favor All Over Country

Many Resolutions And Letters Received by Senate Group

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)
WASHINGTON, March 2.—
Hundreds of resolutions from
all sections of the country asking all sections of the country asking for the passage of Senate Resolu-tion 154, introduced by Senator Millard E. Tydings of Maryland, Millard E. Tydings of Maryland, are in the hands of the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations, where the Tydings measure is bewhere the Tydings measure is be-ing considered. Senate Resolution 154, if adopted by the Senate, would place that body on record as protesting against Germany's persecution of Jews.

The largest number of resolu-tions asking for the adoption of the Tydings resolution has come from B'nai B'rith lodges from all sections of the country. One of the most striking resolutions came from the City Council of Rochester, N. Y., expressing opposition to the discriminations against Jews in Germany. Other resolu-tions have come from citizens from leading cities throughout the country. Another city to go offi-cially on record favoring the Tydings resolution is Chelsea, Mass., where the Board of Alder-men adopted a resolution opposing the treatment of Jews by the Hitler government.

"Through my contact with Jewish students in various parts of Europe I have arrived at the decision that such an institution of learning in Palestine is essen-

"I have met the Jewish students of Austria, Hungary and of Russia, who are clamoring to complete their education in European universities. I have seen difficulties and hardships which these young men and women are experiencing. I have observed the discriminations which have become intensified since the war. Poverty, the economic collapse in Central European countries, have fanned flames of national hatrads. and the Jewish students have suffered in Germany, in Poland and especially in Hungary. A large number of Jewish students barred from the universities on religious grounds. I have seen their helplessness, their hardships and their needs. And thus I came to the realization that a Hebrew University in Palestine is an absolute necessity for the Jewish people.

"The traditional respect for knowledge which we Jews have maintained intact for many centuries of severe persecutions makes us feel all the more keenly the present discriminations against so many talented sons and daughters of the Jewish peoand daughters of the Jewish peo-ple who are knocking in vain at the doors of the Universities of Eastern and Central Europe. And those who have gained ac-cess to the spheres of free research had to do so by undergoing a process of assimilation which has crippled the free and natural character of our people and deprived them of their culfurel leaders".

Dr. Einstein made these remarks thirteen years ago. With prophetic vision he saw the consequences of the process of assi-milation and advocated the remedy. The cultural life of the Jewish people in Germany has now been destroyed by the over-whelming tide of chauvinism and bigotry. The Hebrew University in Jerusalem was created with the aid of this modern prophet in Israel and has already taken a high place among the great institutions of learning. It has beation of Jewish culture. It is the most eloquent answer to the enemies of Israel who are seeking to destroy the Jewish spirit. Anti-Semites Attack Pedestrians and Beat Traders

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, March 4 .- The Jewish community and the Zionist or-ganization of the township of Klobuck near Szenstochow today telegraphed the Jewish National Council in Warsaw asking for government intervention against anti-Semitism rioters who attacked Jewish pedestrians on the streets of the town. Five Jews were severely injured.

A number of Jewish merchants were badly beaten and forced to leave their market stalls with stocks of goods behind, when anti-Jewish attacks occurred at the annual fair at Jarocin, Posen, according to information made public here by the Union of Jewish merchants.

The peaceful progress of the fair was disturbed when a band of hooligans appeared and began to demolish the stalls of the J ish traders, severely beating those they caught. The rloting lasted for more than two hours, after which police appeared and dis-persed the attackers, who withstood the police for some time.

Among the Jewish traders se-verely injured in the rioting word Joseph Schachtel and his son, Isaac Dembinsky, Binem Kolm and Lea Cottlieb.

The victims of the attack registered their losses at a mass meet-ing held last night. The meeting was called by the Union of Jewish Small Traders of Kalish, to which most of the merchants belonged. The list will be forwarded to the Central Union at Warsaw, which will appeal to the government to take energetic steps to prevent re-

Assassinated Near Hi Hotel - No Motive Established
