Paths of Peace

IT HAS been reported that Ernest Bloch's Avodath Hakodesh, (Sacred Service), which was acclaimed in Carnegie Hall on Wednesday evening, is soon to be produced in Germany. We do not know how authentic this information is. Perhaps the Sacred Service will be presented under the auspices of the Jewish cultural organization which is permitted to give plays and concerts exclusively for Jews. But even under such circumstances the Nazis are sure to feel irritated when in the Cantor in the Sacred Service will read in Hebrew:

"The Law of the Lord is perfect.

It doth restore the soul.
His precepts are sure and enduring.

And give wisdom to the simple.
The Laws of the Lord are just as laws.

Rejoice the heart;
The Law of the Lord is holy, enduring forever.

Behold these precepts the Lord hath shown thee;
Take heed of them, neither forsake them.

These lines are followed by the peace song, sung by the Cantor and the chorus:

"Tree of Life,
Life unto thee: that receive it,
And its preservers are happy.
For its ways are ways of beauty,
And all its paths are paths of peace."

While the Hitler government is discriminating against the Jews and persecuting them on racial rather than religious grounds, it may regard these Hebrew sentiments, accentuated in Bloch's impressive music, as treason.

If the Law of the Lord is perfect, what are the Nazis laws? And if the Lord's paths are paths of peace, what are the Nazis laws?

The laws of love and justice and righteousness and peace have been replaced in Nazi Germany by those of hate and blood and by a psychosis of war-madness. A reminder of this even in a Hebrew prayer may arouse the Nazi ire.

A Timely Warning

Dr. Paul Heintz, former Parliamentary Secretary of the German Socialist party, now in exile in Prague, is reported to have declared in an interview with the New York Times correspondent:

"If the United States grants Germany credits for raw materials in equal quantities, the United States will be responsible for the next war in Europe. . . . Without a foreign loan—credit for raw materials, which amounts to the same thing—Hitlerism in Germany is doomed. With the aid of a foreign loan Hitler may continue for some

Colby May Be Named For Nazi Probe

U. S. Inquiry Body Also Considers Pecora as Its Counsel

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WASHINGTON, April 12.—Meeting today for the first time, the Congressional committee to investigate Nazi propaganda activities in the United States considered in executive session the selection of counsel and the determination of policy in connection with the conduct of its forthcoming nationwide investigation.

Representative John W. McCormack of Massachusetts, chairman, presided at the meeting.

It is understood that Ferdinand Pecora, the dynamic New York attorney who last spring conducted the stock market inquiry for a congressional committee headed by Representative Colby of New York, the former Secretary of State, are considered by the committee as leading candidates for the position as counsel.

Definite announcement as to who will be chosen will not be made until differences of opinion among committee members are ironed out.

Sir Philip declared, however, that woman suffrage in places like Tel Aviv was justified.

'Aryan Clause' For Reichswehr Strikes a Snag

Regular Army Opposes Ousting Officers, Prague Reports

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

PRAGUE, April 12.—The Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today from unusually reliable sources that the introduction of the "Aryan clause" in the Reichswehr, the regular German army, encountered serious difficulties and there have been practically no dismissals.

Most of the officers served in the World War and are therefore exempt from the application of the "Aryan clause," but nevertheless an attempt has been made to replace the "non-Aryan" officers with storm troopers.

The officers corps of the Reichswehr is consistently opposing the

Streicher Chosen Commissioner With Highest Authority Over Pogrom-Ridden Area

Decision Is In Line With Policy Coordinating Bavarian Regime and Nazi Party—Anti-Semite Also Heads Hago

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, April 12.—Julius Streicher, arch exponent of Nazi anti-Semitism, editor of the notorious Nuremberg weekly, Dr. Stuermer, and political czar of the region around Nuremberg, was today appointed government commissioner for Franconia. Representing the highest government authority in his district, Streicher will be entitled to participate in the sessions of the Bavarian cabinet council.

The appointment of Streicher is in line with a recent decision of the Bavarian cabinet uniting the government and the Nazi party in Bavaria by appointing all Bavarian district leaders of the Nazi party government functionaries responsible for the political direction of their respective district administrations.

Streicher, life-long anti-Semite and publisher of pornographic papers, has been one of the most ferocious and unbridled foes of the Jews in Germany. Under Streicher, Nuremberg and the Franconian district around Nuremberg have become notorious throughout the world for excesses against the Jews.

During the early days of the Hitler regime, when the terror against the Jews was at its height, Nuremberg was the scene of the worst excesses. Since that time the terror against the Jews in the Nuremberg region has continued with Streicher's Stuermer calling for further and greater persecution of the Jews.

Toronto Bakers Reach Agreement; Get 8-Hour Day and Wage Raise

(Special to the J.D.B.)

TORONTO, Ont., April 12.—After a conference which lasted until the early hours of this morning an agreement was reached between the Hebrew Master Bakers' Association and the International Bakers Union Local 31, Toronto, settling the short strike which began last Saturday night.

The terms of the agreement favor the union, guaranteeing an eight-hour day and a wage raise of \$2 per week. Henceforth the pay of first-hands is to be \$36 a week, of second-hands \$32, and \$28 for third-hands.

Bakers will resume work on Saturday.

Bar Jewish Agents From New Nazi Union

BERLIN, April 12.—Jewish agents of German firms have been officially excluded from the recently formed Reichs Union of German Firm Agents which unites all existing agent associations.

A circular issued by the executive of the newly formed organization declared that only members who can prove their "Aryan" descent will be admitted to membership.

This means that another large group of German Jews will be deprived of a livelihood.

Nine Jewish charitable organizations received bequests totaling \$23,500 from the late Miss Josephine Jacobs, who died July 16, 1938. Miss Jacobs' estate was appraised yesterday at the New York State Transfer Tax Department at \$876,717 gross and \$356,531 net.

Following are the organizations receiving bequests: Montefiore Hospital for Chronic Diseases, Hebrew United Charities, National Jewish Hospital for Consumptives of Denver, Colo., Home for Aged and Infirm Hebrews, Mount Sinai Hospital, Beth Israel Hospital Association, the Social Service Department of Beth Israel Hospital, Home for Hebrew Parents, and Convalescent Home for Hebrew Children in Rockaway Park, L. I. Miss Jacobs left \$30,000 to her sister, Leonora Jacobs, \$10,000 to a nephew, Stanley Jacobs, and a niece, Mildred Linbur, and \$23,200 to other relatives, friends and servants. The residuary estate is to be divided equally among her brothers, Solomon and William Jacobs, Ralph Jacobs, and a nephew, Henry Gerstle.

No Immediate Kashruth Law Changes Seen

Weiss Recommendations Sent to Aldermanic Board Offices

Although recommendations for amendments to the sections of the New York State Penal Law concerning kashruth were presented yesterday morning to the office of the President of the Board of Aldermen by William Weiss, chairman of the Mayor's sub-committee on kashruth regulation, no immediate action will be taken.

This statement was made yesterday to the Jewish Daily Bulletin by Louis Lande, chief counsel yesterday morning to the office of the President of the Board of Aldermen. Mr. Lande explained that no action can be taken within the near future because the State Legislature is expected to adjourn shortly.

Suggests Amending Law
The suggestions made by Mr. Weiss involve amending or adding to Section 435 of the Penal Law, by amending the Sanitary Code of the New York City Department of Health.

An outline of Mr. Weiss's suggestions follows:

1. The removal of any seal or inscription from meat or food preparation already certified as kosher and the affixing of such seal or inscription on some other product would be deemed evidence of attempt to defraud.

2. The word "possesses" is to be added to the provisions concerning those who attempt to defraud in the sale or exposure of kosher products in stores.

Marking of Poultry

3. Poultry slaughtered according to kosher requirements should be marked or identified with a statement giving the name of the premises on which it was slaughtered, the name of the slaughterer and the date of slaughter.

4. No raw meat or slaughtered poultry intended for sale as kosher meat, but which has been prepared outside the city, should be offered for sale here unless it is certified or approved by a Rabbi or Board of Jewish rabbis, officially recognized by the Health Department or other city kashruth authority.

To Eliminate Fraud

In his latest statement yesterday Mr. Weiss, who is president of the Orthodox Jewish Congregation of America, declared that the Mayor's sub-committee has not as yet taken up the details of any of the plans submitted for consideration last Tuesday. Although a systematic plan of supervision will be suggested, he declared, "it is important to strike at abuses which might develop at the source of supply and to attempt to eliminate as far as possible the problem of fraud and misrepresentation at the outset."

He said that his committee was impartial in its viewpoint, but at the same time cautioned the committee against adopting any proposal which would levy excessive license or supervision fees against food dealers, because of the danger of increased prices would be resisted by both dealers and consumers.

National Young Judean To Meet in Cincinnati

National Young Judean, through its executive director, Max A. H. Vikman, has announced that its twenty-sixth annual convention will be held in Cincinnati, July 6-9. This will be the first time in the history of the organization that the national convention will be held elsewhere than in the East.

Mr. David Polish of Cincinnati, national president, has been named chairman of the convention committee.

Jewish Charities Will Gain By Will

Are Left Five-Eighths of Residuary Estate of Late Jacob Golland

Jewish charitable organizations will receive five-eighths of the residuary estate of the late Jacob Golland, who died April 6, under the terms of the will filed for probate at Surrogate's Court yesterday afternoon. According to the formal estimate, Mr. Golland left "more than \$1,000."

The will, dated October 22, 1931, bequeathed \$1,000 to the New York lodge for Elks No. 1, \$5,000 to a sister-in-law, Mrs. Lillian Golland, and leaves the residue in trust for the benefit of the deceased's brother, Israel Golland. On his death, the will provides that the trust shall continue for the benefit of Isaac Golland Jr., another brother, and Annie Golland, a sister.

On the death of each, the principal of the trust is to be divided as follows: one-half to the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies; one-eighth to the New York Guild for Jewish Blind; and one-eighth to whatever Catholic and Protestant institutions for the blind may be selected by the executors, the Fifth Avenue Bank and Frederick Falzberg. The remaining one-fourth will go to Mrs. Lillian Golland.

Announce Preparations For Motzkin Burial In Jerusalem April 19

JERUSALEM, April 12.—Elaborate preparations were announced today for the funeral of Dr. Leo Motzkin, noted Zionist leader, which is to be held here on April 19. The procession will start from the Jewish Agency Building, where eulogies on the dead statesman will be pronounced by prominent Palestinians. The funeral procession will then proceed to the Mount of Olives where Dr. Motzkin will be buried.

Dr. Motzkin died in Paris last November 7. He was 66 years old and had been in ill health for several years. His body was temporarily interred in a French Jewish cemetery. Yesterday the body was sent to Palestine for interment.

Steed Analyzes Nazis' Faith In Ascent Through 'Aryanism'

Hitler's Third Reich Must Be Founded Upon Race, Is Current German Belief; Jew Is Indicted as Enemy of Teuton Idealism

William Steed, former correspondent of the London Times in Berlin, Vienna and France, and finally its editor, explains the true nature of Hitlerism and to what extent it may be a menace to peace in this chapter, "Hitler, Whence and Whither?"

Now the fundamental idea of the German "Aryan" and finally its editor, explains the true nature of Hitlerism and to what extent it may be a menace to peace in this chapter, "Hitler, Whence and Whither?"

First, or Holy Roman Empire of the Germanic race, Voltaire naughtily said that it was neither a Holy nor the foulest idea Hitler enumerated from the Second, Hohenzollern, 1871-1918) must be founded solely upon race, and must unite in one realm all human beings of German race, and none else. This community of blood, sole source of national energy, is what the Hitlerites mean by "Volksstum."

The "Volksstum," the Germanic blood, the necessary, anything that is authentically German and unites the vital forces of the race.

The German "Aryan" principle is, as yet, hypothetical, aristocratic, since the Aryan race is an aristocracy among races and therefore entitled to rule the world. Inasmuch as Christianity is admitted to many false conceptions, it is necessary to Germanize Christianity. In 1924, the Germanic "Aryan" race is not enough. German Christians, according to a report in the Christian Scriptures is that Christ (whose name is to be written "Kriest") is none other than the Scandinavian deity, Baldur. Nations like these explain the recent subjugation of the Protestant German Churches by a Hitlerite group known as "German Christians"—against whom thousands of Protestant pastors, under the leadership of their elected Bishop, Dr. von Bodelschwingh, have been protesting.

These dissenting pastors hold, with St. Paul, that in Christianity there is no place for racial discrimination, neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free, whereas the "German Christians" maintain that baptism alone is not enough. German Christians, unless he is an authentic "Aryan," and that the Jewish spirit must disappear from Christianity, the Old Testament reverts to a Nazi and to the Gospel according to St. Mark.

The ideal, which the "German Christians" have already sought to realize, would be to replace the Cross by the Swastika. In fact, the "Aryan" Germanic Christian doctrine goes to prove that the "Aryan" race" and the primitive religion of the Germans (who represent that race) alone embody the true spirit of Christianity.

The Bulletin's Day Book

We are indebted to the Surrey Advertiser, of Guilford, England, for a fascinating report of a rally there of the Imperial Fascist League, the anti-Semitic shirt group headed by Arnold Leese which spends its time equally in attacking the Moseley Fascists for their alleged subservience to the Jews and in attacking the Jews.

In the course of a long, and at times, it must be confessed, rambling discourse, Fuhrer Leese accused the good people of Guilford of being a "comible crowd, very slow to wake up."

One of his associates, "Mr. E. Lock, of headquarter's," complained that "the organization has the leaders. What we want now is members."

Mr. Leese pointed out that the League of Nations is one of the Jewish weapons by which the Jews hope to gain control of the world. Jewish finance, he informed his auditors, is driving a wedge between capital and labor in Britain.

There was no cure except the complete exclusion of Jews from England. The Advertiser reports as the gist of his conclusions.

No discussion was allowed at the meeting, but members of the audience were permitted to ask questions and receive answers. The questions and particularly the answers, were revealing.

Mr. Leese commented that he "was perfectly prepared to open and shut the lethal chamber door and that the Jews had got rid of the Jews that way," but admitted he did not think the people of England would "stand for it." The alternative he suggested, in reply to the question, was to send all the Jews to Madagascar.

Here are some of the questions and answers as carefully reported by the newspaper.

Question: Is not your league anti-Christian, seeing that we are taught as Englishmen that all men are brothers?

Answer: Christianity, if it says that all men are brothers, is perverted.

Question: If democracy has so failed in this country, why is it that in Fascist Italy the conditions of the working people are much lower, not only as far as wages are concerned, but their economic standard? (hear, hear).

Answer: From olden times the Italian standard of life has been a lower standard than the Nordic. Mussolini's stock does not stand very high among the members of the Imperial Fascist League at the moment, but, as far as we know, he has never carried out his own theories in the "last gasp." He would not recognize the Jewish domination of finance.

Question: Why not "India for the Indians" and "Africa for the Africans"? (hear, hear).

Answer: When we speak of Britain for the Britons, Germany for the Germans, and Italy for the Italians, we mean what we say. We don't believe in the equality of races. The African is "not in the same street" as the Italian, German, or Briton from a political standpoint.

Question: Have you never thought of equality of rights?

Answer: We believe there should be equality of rights. That is wrongheaded. We believe in "justice," but "equality" is rubbish.

Viva Villa Gory Spectacle

"Viva Villa" which Metro-Goldwyn brought into the Criterion Theatre for a two-day run is not a picture for the chicken-hearted. It is the goriest, most sadistic film to come, uncut out of Hollywood but for those who do not mind a maximum of bloodshed and a minimum of sentiment "Viva Villa" will titillate you thoroughly.

Personally I liked the picture. I thought it had zest, interest, movement, excitement and color. It is a full-bodied variation of one of the most exciting episodes in modern history. Historically, Ben Hecht, who wrote the picture, went far afield. Instead of following chronologically and faithfully the career of the Mexican bandit, Hecht embellished the myths that have arisen about this unrelenting cruel savage. With his talents as a dramatist Hecht cleverly emphasizes the more obvious characteristics of the bandit chief. He shows him as being cruel, ruthless, ignorant, yet hearty and often well meaning. To make the picture complete he uncovers Villa's weaknesses—his indecision, his man-like fear of his wife's nagging. These human touches do much to make the entire film more believable.

A Break for Madero

After all these years Madero, the Jewish president of Mexico and one of the few rulers of that turbulent country who ever really concerned himself with the lot of the peons, comes in for a few kind breaks, at the hands of M-G-M.

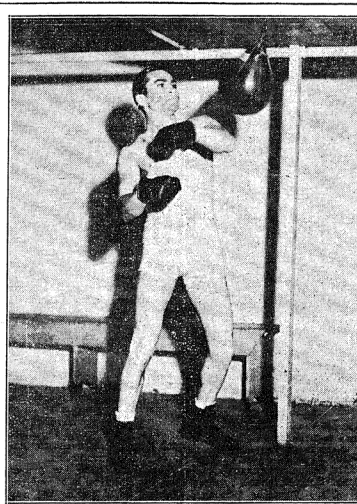

True Conception of Charity Most Alive in U. S., Einstein Relates

The true conception of charity is more alive in the United States than in Europe, in the opinion of Professor Albert Einstein, who so declared in a message yesterday from his home in Princeton, N. J., to Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, president of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities.

"The recognition that possessions are not a privilege but a trust must always remain alive among us. Among non-Jews, too, this conception is far more alive than here abroad."

Professor Einstein in his message urged that support be given the \$500,000 twenty-fifth anniversary campaign which the Brooklyn Federation is now conducting to meet the 1934 budget requirements of the twenty-five affiliated societies.

Writes of Charity

"I have been requested," wrote Professor Einstein to give a message in relation to Jewish charity, and especially concerning federations, or community chests, organized in communities throughout the country in aid of distressed Jews, and the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, which is observing its twenty-fifth anniversary with a campaign to meet appeals for aid through its twenty-five constituent societies."

The statement continued: "The spirit of mutual aid and self-sacrifice occurs first place in the moral traditions of the Jewish people. Had it not been for this tradition, there would be no Jews in existence now, and so long as this tradition continues to be transmitted solicitously from generation to generation, the hatred opposing us cannot do us any harm."

The fairest quality of Jewish charity is the fact that it does not stop at the bounds of our own people, but in many cases rebounds to the advantage of the poor and oppressed of other races. Benefactions are not regarded by good Jews as a sacrifice on the part of

the giver, but as a benefit to the donor himself. The recognition that possessions are not a privilege but a trust must always remain alive among us. Among non-Jews, too, this conception is far more alive in the United States than in Europe.

"Most peoples have preserved themselves by establishing States and by conquering and defending territory by force of arms. Even the Jewish people in the Bible era established existence on this basis. The Jews would long ago have been destroyed, like all other nations, if they had not discovered and maintained a more solid basis for their existence. This new basis was the moral law and the cherishing of tradition based on this law.

"So long as we ourselves may cherish the happy feeling that our tradition gives animation to lofty values, we Jews all over the world will not cease to feel our solidarity, and we shall continue to exist as a community even if spread all over the world. In this sense, benefactions are a blessing to the giver."

Jews Blamed For All Ills, Asserts Editor

Due to War's Aftermath, Says Bernstein at YMHA Talk

"The War's aftermath has brought upon the Jews blame for all the ills of mankind, declared Herman Bernstein, editor of the Jewish Daily Bulletin, speaking at the city's first conference of the Young Women's Association last night.

Some "minions of autocracy and reaction," he declared, "have blamed them for the War and others have blamed them for the peace. Some have attacked them for aiding the German military machine and economic structure, and others for the victory of the Allies. In Germany they were attacked soon after the war for having opposed the submarine warfare, and thereby assuring Germany's defeat; while in some of the allied countries they were denounced for constituting what they might have called the 'brain trust' of Germany.

"All revolutionary leaders were credited to the Jews and Communism was branded as a specific Jewish doctrine. And there was a time when certain German Jew-baiters in their blind madness went so far as to declare that the former Kaiser was not only influenced by Jews, but was himself of Jewish descent, and for that reason did not defend Germany as a loyal 'Aryan' should have done.
