The Balfour Interpretation
IN his plea for greater sympathy for the homeless victims of German persecutions and for a more liberal immigration policy by the governments of the world in the present crisis, High Commissioner McDonald, speaking before the council of the autonomous body created by the League of Nations, declared: "The Jewish leaders throughout the world, not only in theory, but in actual practice, give their funds to non-Jews. But I am forced to conclude that the great disappointment over the failure of the Christian world to meet responsibilities in this matter, if Christians had done as much as the Jews, there would be no refugee problem today. I feel it necessary to declare this before this governing body which does not contain a single Jew."
In the course of his report, Mr. McDonald emphasized the progress of settlement of refugees in Palestine and declared that Palestine is at this time practically the only area offering immediate opportunity for refugee colonization upon an appreciable scale.

Lord Robert Cecil, that great humanitarian statesman, one of the world's greatest champions of peace, chairman of the governing body created by the League of Nations to aid the refugees, stirred the council by an impressive appeal for the permanent solution of the refugee problem "essential for the credit of civilization."
He also pointed out that Germany should aid in this work, saying:

"We feel we have a strong claim on the German government to make easier that part of our work concerned with passport enabling refugees to travel and find permanent homes, and not to stay where they originally fled, and where there is no solution. This trouble, for which we are responsible, is caused by measures which the German government has seen fit to take. The German government must do something to relieve us of the burden imposed by nothing that we have done."
"Merely providing a solution for the day is no solution. We must provide subsistence to prevent starvation, but we must seek a permanent solution."

Very little is asked of the German government—to adjust the problem of passports for the refugees. The German government has created an international program by violating the human rights of an element of its own population, by setting up false race theories and by inventing all sorts of pretexts for persecuting the Jews. The Nazis "arrest" who is to be regarded as the "Chosen People," as superior to the rest of the

Report Reveals Anti-Semite Fight Peril to Poland

Drive Against Endeks Is Urged; Jews Attacked in Several Cities

WARSAW, May 6.—The great danger to Poland resulting from the artificially fostered anti-Semitic spirit which is growing here, apace was established in a report submitted today to the council of the Polish Socialist Party.

The report, detailing methods used by propagandists to create a spirit of anti-Semitism among the Polish masses, urged an immediate campaign against the Endeks, the National Democrats, a militant anti-government, anti-Jewish party, which the report accused of using Hitler methods.

The report to the council followed a week in which anti-Semitic activities reached a climax in several communities where Jews were attacked on the streets and in their homes by Endeks, Naras (members of the National Radical faction which recently seceded from the Endeks) and Nazis.

Nazis Will Not Give Up Racial Laws as Basis Of Living, Says Frank

BERLIN, May 6.—Nazi Germany will never surrender the principle of race legislation and German Jews will never surrender it as a fundamental basis for a racial life, Minister of Justice Hans Frank declared here at a press reception at the German Academy of Law.

"We do not interfere with the constitutional problems of other countries and therefore cannot tolerate that the German nation be attacked for its constitutional principles," Frank asserted. "Hardly ever has any other great constitutional change been so humanely accomplished as has German racial legislation."

Synagogues at Parley Fight Anti-Semite

Monday to Mark Ceremonies of Jerusalem Cornerstone Laying

WASHINGTON, May 6.—The United Synagogue of America last night raised its battle axe to do what it can to throttle the young but thriving infant anti-Semitism in this country.

Meeting at its twenty-second annual conference held in the Hotel Willard here, delegates from a considerable number of synagogues throughout America gathered to consider problems as to how to strengthen organization work among temple and synagogue supporters. These problems included "the present crisis in Jewry," "social welfare," "cultural and education work," "what the shtetl can do to fight anti-Jewish prejudice," Jewish education in general, etc.

Opening with a prayer by Rabbi Solomon H. Metz of this city, Louis Solt, of Brooklyn, delivered an address. Other speakers who followed were Bernard S. Convict Orthodox Jews Who Stopped Cars on Sabbath

TEL AVIV, May 6.—Seven orthodox Jews were convicted and five acquitted following the conclusion here of a two-day trial in which the defendants were accused of disorderly conduct in stopping gautomobiles on the streets of Tel Aviv because the drivers were violating the Sabbath.

Five of the defendants were given the alternative of fines of ten pounds (\$50) or imprisonment for two months; two, five pounds, or one month's imprisonment, and five were bound over on good behavior for six months.

Deutsch Assaults Laughlin Over Race Measure

'Scur on Jews,' Says Aldermanic President at Congress Meeting

A slashing attack on Dr. Harry H. Laughlin's recent recommendation to the New York State Chamber of Commerce urging that it refuse to entertain a hearing of immigration laws to permit German refugee Jews to enter this country featured the morning session of an all-day conference of the American Jewish Congress held yesterday at the Hotel Edison. More than 1,500 delegates, representing affiliated and independent Jewish organizations, attended.

The conference had been called by the American Jewish Congress for the purpose of discussing major problems confronting the Jews of the United States and abroad, and to formulate plans for their solution. Organizations represented included labor, fraternal, beneficial, social, religious, communal and Zionist districts.

The attack on Dr. Laughlin, who is connected with the Department of Eugenics at the Carnegie In-

stitute, has been given official sanction and widespread publicity.

Dr. J. H. Hertz, chief rabbi of England, today quoted part of the statement of the German notables at a meeting of the Anglo-Jewish Association. Dr. Hertz read the part of the statement protesting "against the unscrupulous fiction without a shadow of proof, which is causing misguided crowds to

\$2,000,000 Loan by Gov't Causes Turnoil

Excitement Equaled Only When White Paper Appeared in 1930

JERUSALEM, May 6.—Palestine Jewry was in a state of furor today when it became known officially that the government had granted the Agency for Palestine a total of only 5,000 immigration certificates, and in addition had issued a ordinance prohibiting Jews from picketing enterprises owned by Jews and employing Arab labor. The new law will thus make illegal the united fight waged by all parties and factions to employ Jews only.

The excitement in Jewish Palestine today was equaled only by the publication of the White Paper of 1930 by the British government, which was based on Sir John Hope Simpson's last report. The White Paper, which was issued by the MacDonald Labor government, contained a declaration of policy which was regarded by Zionists as a vital blow against the Balfour Declaration and the Mandate. Dr. Chaim Weizmann, then president of the World Zionist Organization, resigned as a protest against the document.

Added excitement was lent here by the simultaneous publication of the news concerning the \$2,000,000 loan granted by the Palestine government. The entire Hebrew press was unanimous in condemning the loan as a "blow to Jewish interests."

Mosley Denies Persecution Of Jews in Fascist Program

LONDON, May 6.—Sir Oswald Mosley, leader of the chief British Fascist movement, today officially stated the Fascist attitude toward the Jews does not include persecution or discrimination. Mosley has been under heavy attack for his alleged anti-Semitism in the press since his rise for power at the Albert Hall Fascist rally.

He declared today regarding the Jews that there will be "no racial or religious persecution." It is not the British way," he asserted, "to persecute for birth or religion. But, like the rest, the Jews must Britain, not Jewry, first."

PREACHED IN CITY PULPITS

Hits Brooklyn Democracy

RABBI STEPHEN S. WISE, Free Synagogue, at Carnegie Hall, in the worst sermon of the Jew is the political racketeer and gangster who uses the name of his faith for his own filthy gain. I am referring especially to the gentleman responsible for the Brooklyn Jewish Democracy. Anyone who dares link the name of 'Jew' with any political organization ought to be scourged and excommunicated. They are the vilest type of professional Jew.

"Those who undermine our faith most are the wrongers, because the world will always have to be representative of our race. I would organize a vigilance committee to visit every judge in the city urging that they punish these men to the full extent of the law.

"But sometimes I wonder, are these men entirely responsible for their misdeeds? Are they responsible for seeking an illegitimate way of getting food when the utility companies and many banks have anywhere from 100 to 200,000 jobs to fill, and will not admit a Jew into their employ? Yes, I can safely link the names of these companies to the reason for many of our people turning to underground methods of making a living.

"And the most cowardly and indecent statement made by any orderly group of men is the report of the New York Chamber of Commerce which declared that no refugee Jews should be admitted to America. I am waiting to see what the Jewish members of this stuffed shirt group will say about the report.

"Many of our foremost enemies lie within our own ranks. There are those who will forsake everything that is Jewish merely for their own selfish gain. Or those who take pride in being mistaken for a Gentile.

"But the most dangerous enemy is the one who will make the Jew the scapegoat to take the blame for things which all the human race does."

Lauds Faulhaber for Stand

RABBI LOUIS I. NEWMAN, Congregation Rodeph Shalom, 7 West Eighty-third Street—"The Jewish people have given their highest regard for clergymen of faith other than their own, when they have exposed the great principles of goodwill, tolerance, freedom of conscience, and brotherhood, which alone can bring amity between races and religions.

"Hence we join in appreciation for the courageous Cardinal of Munich (Cardinal Faulhaber) who, when menaced by the Nazis if he dared leave the city, informed them of the train he would take and the station from which he would leave, challenging them to do their utmost. This is one of the greatest single acts of heroism in our times, and everyone, whether Gentile or Jew, in these troubled times when secret and treacherous forces are so menacing, with the help of men like Father Coughlin, 'o bedevil the emotions of the people, must hail him as the true servant of the Living God."

Concentrate on Palestine

RABBI ISRAEL GOLDSSTEIN, Congregation Bnai Beshurun, Eighty-ninth Street, West of 60th—"The Angola project today is no more worthy of serious consideration than was Uganda thirty years ago. As long as it is still possible for Jews to get into Palestine, the Jewish people must concentrate its energies upon Palestine. Even apart from sentimental and Zionist considerations, it is the one place in the world best suited for happy Jewish living. It has already proved to be the most successful colonizing enterprise the Jewish people have ever undertaken—successful eco-

nomically, culturally, and spiritually.

As a result of the thirty years Jewish labor in Palestine since the Uganda controversy arose, a foundation has been laid which, if only the political difficulties could be cleared away vis-a-vis the British government and freer immigration established, in accordance with the absorptive capacity of the country, could provide a basis for the immigration not of thousands but of hundreds of thousands of Jews in the course of the next decade."

Hits 'Men of Science' Apathy

RABBI JOSEPH ZEITLIN, Temple Anshe Chesed, West End Avenue at 100th Street—"It is a sad commentary on civilization when 'men of science' are apathetic towards the indignities and

cruelties that are practiced against their fellow scientists simply because these men happen to be Jews. Recently The American Spectator expressed itself as being bored because of our putting Nazi German on trial. There may be some justification for boredom when savage or brutal methods are used to combat the tyranny of Nazism, but how, in the name of mercy, can anyone withhold his protest against a reversion to medieval degeneracy? The martyrs of the past knew of no sacrifice too great for the cause of religious liberty. Would that this age were inspired by their noble example."

Israel 'Chosen People'

RABBI WILLIAM MARGOLIS, Congregation Chab Zedek, 118 West Ninety-fifth Street—"Throughout the centuries of punishment and persecution, of ceaseless affliction and oppression,

the Jew has continued to live and to thrive. Israel has emerged from the fiercest fires of bigotry and prejudice scarcely singed; Israel's spirit is scarcely scathed. Israel has been spared; Israel has sustained and survived what would have long ago destroyed stronger nations. And Israel has outlived all those who 'chose' our people for annihilation.

"None but a chosen people with a chosen purpose and destiny could have done what Israel has done. And not Israel, but history, the world, human destiny has proclaimed us the chosen people—chosen, and to suffer and to survive, until our message, the message of divine justice, brotherhood and peace, shall proclaim all as God's chosen people."

Cites Rothschilds as Example

RABBI WILLIAM F. ROSENBLUM, Temple Israel, 210 West Ninety-first Street—"In this time of attack on Jewish ideals and

practices, the picture-making of the Rothschild brothers with their faithfulness towards the cause of peace in Europe, their devotion to their people, their honest and dignified prosecution of their business as bankers, offers one of the most striking refutations of the calumnies and the baldness about the Jews that is being circulated through the mails and over our news counters by the paid and semi-paid propagandists of the very country which Nathan Rothschild and his brothers helped to save in the early part of the nineteenth century from the ravages of Napoleon.

"Only is the crying need of the Jews of the world, and the House of Rothschild is a beautiful sermon uttered in the phraseology of the prophets. If there is one place where the Jews have liberty and freedom, they must not be content until a like situation prevails for the Jews throughout the world."

MILK PRICES

A STATEMENT TO THE PUBLIC

IN order that there may be no misunderstanding as to the purpose of Borden's Farm Products Co., Inc. in taking action against the law requiring advertised brands of milk through stores to be sold at a higher price than unadvertised brands, we wish to make our position clear.

By reason of the New York Milk Control law, a difference of one cent a quart exists today between the so called "well advertised" milk and "not well advertised" milk sold by stores in New York City.

In other words, the public must by law pay stores 11 cents a quart for Borden's Milk but may pay only 10 cents for a so called "not well advertised" brand of milk.

We do not think that we should be penalized for this course by being forced to sell Borden's milk at a higher price, or that the public should be penalized by having to pay more for a quality product because of its advertising, which is measurable and of a constructive character.

In seeking the right to sell Borden's milk through stores at the same price as other milk, we wish to make it clear that we are not in favor of any course which would result in higher retail prices for any milk. This company has stated clearly recently, and wishes to repeat emphatically here, that it believes any increase in milk prices at this time is undesirable because of the probable adverse effect on purchasing power and consumption, and therefore, on public health and the welfare of all concerned, including the dairy farmer.

Scientist Exiles Held Valuable To All England

Jewish Scholars Doing 'Notable' Work, Says London Paper

LONDON, May 6.—More than 178 exiled German scholars have been assisted to carry on their academic work in British universities, the British Academic Assistance Council has reported. Lord Ernest Rutherford, noted British scientist, is president of the Council. The council report also thanked the British Central Fund for German Jewry for a generous contribution of £2,500 for Jewish and non-Jewish scholars and scientists. The Daily Telegraph, London newspaper, speaking of the refugee scholars, declared, "What the refugees from Flanders and Huguenot France did for our textile industry may be paralleled by the victims of modern fanaticism can do for certain branches of science and scientific chemistry, in Great Britain."

Lord Rutherford, writing in the London Times, declared that the exiles have already made several notable scientific discoveries in their short period of residence in England.

Will Confiscate Kehilla Rents For Back Debts

Greeks Had Advanced 500,000 Drachmas for Construction Work

SALONICA, May 6.—All rents of houses belonging to the Jewish community (Kehilla) are to be seized by the Bank of Greece in accordance with an order by the municipality of the city. The order was issued because the kehilla has not paid back to the city an advance of 500,000 drachmas for the construction of drains. Failure to return the money is attributed to the fact that the kehilla is suffering a severe economic crisis.

Several statutes of the kehilla will be modified after being approved by Social Minister Maropoulos, to whom some of the changes were suggested without first having been brought before the assembly of the kehilla. Such a practice is contrary to previous custom.

The proposed changes include the lowering of the requisite voting age for members of the assembly to twenty-one years.

French Jews Organize Patriotic Group to Fight Spread of Radicalism

PARIS, May 6.—Under the leadership of Diamant Berger, a writer well known here, a group of Jewish ex-officers has formed a "National Union of Patriotic Israelites," which aims to fight the spread of radical and revolutionary ideas among French Jewry.

The forming of the new organization is regarded as a reaction against the tendency of the League for Combating Anti-Semitism which identifies the movement with extremist parties.

Assimilated and conservative Jewry here and a number of leading newspapers have expressed satisfaction with the new group, the manifesto of which was printed in full on the first page of Le Matin.

world. They are trying to demonstrate that "anti-semitism" by resorting to acts of barbarism, by uprooting not only the Jews but also Judaism as well as Christianity. The Nazi offensive is directed at Christianity because it sprang from Judaism. Hitlerism is just as great a challenge to the Christian world as to the Jews. And the answer to Hitlerism must come from the Christian world as well as from the Jewish world. It is a question of war and peace, of might and right, of darkness and light, of barbarism and civilization. It is the revolt of the hairy ape against civilized man."

High Commissioner McDonald and Lord Robert Cecil are right when they emphasize that the Jewish and German refugees is not merely a Jewish problem, but that it should be the concern of the entire civilized world.

Palestine is recognized as a selected policy area in connection with the settlement of refugees. But Palestine can at this time absorb a far larger number of refugees than are admitted there. The great British statesman, Lord Robert Cecil, who has done so much for the rehabilitation of Palestine in the spirit of the Balfour Declaration, should exert his influence in this crisis with the British government to give a more liberal interpretation of the historic Balfour Declaration and the Mandate, to fulfill the sacred pledge made by the British government to the Jewish people. Palestine is promising Jew because of the efforts of Jewish labor, of Jewish enterprise and of Jewish investments. There is a shortage of labor in Palestine just now. To keep down Jewish immigration to Palestine at such a time as this, when the country's absorptive capacity justifies a much larger number of immigration certificates than that granted by the government, and when the tragedy in Germany has made Palestine the abode of the most intelligent Jews homeless; to treat the present situation as normal, to resort to technicalities—all this is hardly in keeping with the world's conception of the fairness of the British people and is not in the spirit of the Balfour Declaration.

Herzl Exhibit Opens In Vienna; Shows Early Zionist Letters

VIENNA, May 6.—The beginnings of political Zionism are indicated here at a Herzl exhibit which has just opened. Among the objects shown are the various correspondence carried on between Theodor Herzl, father of Zionism, and Lloyd George, King Victor, of Iron, von Plehve, Grand Duke Friedrich of Baden and Premier Koerber.

Also at the exhibit are documents concerning Herzl which have been lent from the archives of various governments and League of Nations.

Palestine Communal Assembly Will Meet

JERUSALEM, May 6.—The Asafat Hanvacharin, the regularly elected assembly of the Jewish communities of Palestine, will open its session on May 15, according to an official announcement. The assembly will take up a number of political problems, including immigration, and also the regulation of labor and employment strife.

The Balfour Declaration has been subjected to various interpretations by Zionists and non-Zionists. Those Jews and non-Jews who try to justify the cautious British policy in Palestine by insisting that the Arabs have no claim to Palestine, and by referring to the promises made by Great Britain to the Arabs during the war, forget or overlook the interpretation of the Balfour Declaration given by the man who was most competent to interpret it—Lord Balfour himself.

Among many other striking statements Lord Balfour declared in the House of Lords, in 1922, as follows:

"The mandatory system always contemplated the Mandate for Palestine on general lines of the Declaration of November, 1917. It was not sprung upon the League of Nations, and, before the League of Nations came into existence, it was the policy upon the Powers that met together in Paris to deal with the peace negotiations. It was a settled policy among the Allies and Associated Powers before ever the Armistice came into existence. It was accepted in America, it was accepted in this country, it was published all over the world, and, if ever there was a Declaration which had behind it a general consensus of opinion, I believe it is the Declaration of November, 1917. . . .

"No human being supposes that Palestine is an over-populated country. It is, I believe, an under-populated country at the moment at which I speak, before all the economic developments to which I look forward have had time to take place; and if the hopes that I entertain are not widely disappointed, the power of Palestine to maintain a population is greater than she had and could ever have under Turkish rule will be easily attained in consequence of the material well-being which under Turkish rule were wholly impossible. . . .

"The hopes that I have just expressed with regard to the growth of population in Palestine, with regard to the numbers it could support, of course are based, and necessarily based, upon the amount of capital expenditure you can give to that country, upon the character of the population who are going to make use of the machinery provided by that capital expenditure, and upon the character of the Government under which all these operations will be carried out. . . .

"But it can only do so, I believe, if you can draw upon the enthusiasm of the Jewish communities throughout the world. As soon as all this Mandate question is finally settled, as soon as all the technical legal difficulties have been got over, they will, I believe, come forward and freely help in the development of a Jewish Home."

"That is not going to be a great speculative investment; that is not going to bring millions into the pockets of international finance; that is not going to prove wildly successful on the Stock Exchange of London or New York; that is going to be carried out as much, indeed far more, in order to carry out these great ideal designs—ideal, if you prefer that name—than to earn dividends or to make fortunes. . . ."

With regard to the charge that the upbuilding of the Jewish Home in Palestine would inflict a serious wrong upon the local Arabs, Lord Balfour declared:

"He told us also that we were doing a great injustice to the Arab race as a whole, and that

our policy was in contradiction of pledges given by General MacMahon and the Anglo-French Declarations conveyed to the native populations by General Allenby. Of all the charges made against this country I must say that the charge that we have been unjust to the Arab race seems to me the strangest. It is through the expenditure largely of British blood, by the exercise of British skill and valour, by the conduct of British generals, by troops brought from all parts of the British Empire—it is by them in the main that the freeing of the Arab race from Turkish rule has been effected. And that we, after all the events of the war, should be held up as those who have done an injustice, that we, who have just established a king in the Mesopotamia, who had before that established an Arab king in the Hejaz, and who have done more for centuries past to put the Arab race in the position which they have attained—that we should be charged with being their enemies, with having taken mean advantage of the

course of international negotiations, seems to me not only most unjust to the policy of this country, but almost fantastic in its extravagance. . . .

"Surely, it is in order that we may send a message to every land where the Jewish race has been scattered, a message which will tell them that Christendom is not oblivious of their faith, is not ungrateful of the service they have rendered to the great religions of the world, and most of all, to the religion that the majority of your Lordships' House profess, and that we desire to be the best of our ability to give them the opportunity of developing, in peace and quietness under British rule, the great gifts which hitherto they have been compelled by the very nature of the case only to bring to fruition in countries which know not their language and belong not to their race! . . . That is the ideal I desire to see accomplished. . . .

The Balfour Declaration with regard to the Jewish National Home in Palestine should now be reinterpreted in the spirit of Balfour's own interpretation!

"So many of my congregation came to me with peculiar notions of the Jew, no doubt fostered by the forces which are now at work fomenting ill-feeling against the Jews in America," Dr. Friberg explained, "and so many of my flock brought to me the spurious 'Protocols of the Elders of Zion,' asking me if they were true, that I decided to give a series of sermons to my people to attempt to clear up some of the evident misunderstanding about this historic race."

In his first sermon, Dr. Friberg traced the history and origin of the Jewish race and enumerated the contributions to civilization of the Jewish prophets and heroes of

Rev. F. W. Rosenblum Talks at Youth Rally

PATERNON, N. J., May 6.—"Let no Jewish cause be foreign to you," Rabbi William F. Rosenblum of Temple Israel, New York, said in an address at a youth rally in Barnert Memorial Temple here tonight.

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Soltes Scores 'Deserters' In Money Crisis

Jewish Education Loses Out in Press of Hard Times, He Says

The tendency of Jewish leaders to "desert the cause of Jewish education" in times of economic difficulty was deplored by Dr. Mordecai Soltes in a symposium conducted by the Jewish Welfare Board last night at the Hebrew Educational Society, 164 Hopkinton Avenue, Brooklyn. The topic was "Problems Confronting Jewish Youth."

Speaking at the meeting because Dr. Soltes was Dr. Adolphe Soltes, dean of Brooklyn College and Dr. Irving Sadas, psychiatrist.

"I am deeply concerned at the alarming manner in which Jewish education in this country is being provoked, desert the basic cause of Jewish education. I fail to comprehend the state of hysteria, retrogression and disorientation which have characterized Jewish communal life since the depression," Dr. Soltes said.

"It seems that at the first sign of economic difficulties the leaders of some of the Jewish communities retreat. Some of the Jewish institutions which it had taken decades to build up have been thoughtlessly and unceremoniously sacrificed upon the altar of economy and expediency."

"Jewish institutions are being shattered. The chief excuse for this is economic depression, but I maintain that this is a very narrow, short-sighted view. The grave error which we have committed in the past few years was the haste with which we proceeded to relieve ourselves of our Jewish communal responsibilities. In my mind that constitutes an indictment against Jewish leadership and a real source of danger for the future of American Jewry."

Haham Moshe Gasterof, of the Spanish and Portuguese congregations and former president of the English Zionist Federation, warned that the Jewish problem existed not only in Germany, but also in Poland, Russia, and in being intensified in the Moslem countries.

Lasnik Insists on Continuity

Neville Lasnik, president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, was also referred to in the designation of B. A. Zalman as secretary of the Joint Foreign Committee, composed of representatives of the Board of Deputies and of the English, Polish, and American Jewish Communities, which he declared was causing anxiety as to the future of the committee and insisted that there is continuity of policy, "whether I am president or not."

Mr. Lasnik complained of the difficulty of persuading English newspapers that events in Germany were still news. He explained, however, the London papers, the Daily Telegraph and the Manchester Guardian.

He announced that the Joint Board was maintaining a "drastic action against those guilty of spreading the notorious 'Protocols of the Elders of Zion,' citing the sensational charges made in London by Colonel Grandison S. Hutcheson, Nazi propagandist, who declared that King Albert of Belgium was "murdered by Communist international financiers."

Happy Over Freedom

Deutsch Assaults Laughlin Idea

stitute of Washington, was made by Alderman President Bernard S. Deutsch, president of the Congress, in his address of welcome to the delegates.

Characterizing the Laughlin report as a "knawish, deliberate slur upon the whole Jewish people," Deutsch charged that it "carries all the earmarks of an attempt to introduce a racial passport system in the United States, based on the Nazi model."

"For years we in this country have been lulled into a false sense of security," Deutsch declared. "We have regarded ourselves as a people apart, not subject to misfortunes and tragedies of the kind endured by our fellow Jews across the seas."

"In this concept we resembled the Jews of Germany who believed their prestige, their civilization, their contribution to Germany's progress would protect them from any serious assault upon their position."

"It is unnecessary here to expatiate on the fallacy of that view," Deutsch said, "the tragedy of German-Jewry which is being hung by the noose of the 'Aryan' paragraph."

"We have lived to see the attempt being made to introduce the 'Aryan' paragraph in these United States. A new and spurious race purification theory, similar to that of the Nazis, under which the Jews are singled out for attack and segregation is now being developed in this country."

Race Selection

"I call your attention to the 'white standard of race selection' advanced by Dr. Laughlin. Dr. Laughlin's theory is a 'theory of race,' is as dangerous and as spurious as the purified 'Aryan' race theories advanced by the Nazis, to which it bears suspicious resemblance."

"His singling out of the Jews for mention as a particular race group to be barred from general admission to the United States, despite the condescending tribute to the so-called 'superiority' of the Jewish race, is a knawish, deliberate slur upon the whole Jewish people, which differs only from the Nazi brand in that it is couched in more political language."

"The threat implied in this anti-Semitic move, which he described as the more dangerous for its subtlety, as well as the other anti-Jewish assaults, the American press which has urged the 'classes and masses' of Jews in this country to 'close their ranks' and 'act together to save themselves.'"

"I call to 'boycott' Nazi-Germany to save humanity," said the keynote of an address made at the morning session of the conference by Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, chairman of the boycott committee of the American Jewish Congress.

"The Waterloo of Hitlerism," Dr. Tenenbaum said, "will come on the battleground of economics and it is the economic issue which will deliver the blow of mercy to the Nazi regime."

Pointing out that the boycott has become world-wide, and that its first year has brought Germany on the brink of bankruptcy, Dr. Tenenbaum expressed the hope that the American government would not accede to Hitler's request for a loan which would be used directly in an effort to break the boycott.

Other speakers included Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Professor Horace M. Kallen, Professor Jerome Michael, Dr. K. Vornhorst (whose speech was read by Oscar Loeb), Dr. D. P. Mann, and Louis Segal. Committee reports were read by Mrs. Stephen S. Wise, Dr. Benjamin Jolans and Emanuel H. Sonnenreich.

Refugee Couple in Asylum After Breakdown

horite paper, appeared early that evening with an extra containing a banner across the front page reading: "The Government is Chaining Immigration." Thousands of free copies were distributed in the streets of this city and Tel Aviv.

The executive of the Histadrut, Central Labor Federation of Palestine, was immediately called into session and issued a proclamation calling for "a decisive war against the terms of the Government," terminating them on the second edition of the White Paper of October 1930, which provoked Jewry all over the world."

At the same time steps were taken to arrange for large protest meetings in every city, town and colony in Palestine, and to mobilize all Jewish residents to fight for labor and immigration rights.

The proclamation of the Histadrut revealed that the Jewish Agency had asked the government for 20,000 immigration certificates.

The executive of the Jewish Agency held an extraordinary sitting here to consider the draft of a statement on the immigration problem. The statement expressed the Jews and attitude of the Jewish Agency toward the Palestine government. Meanwhile the immigration department of the Agency announced officially that all applications for certificates received since this week will be considered in September, when the winter immigration season is made up.

The government loan is regarded as an additional and severe blow, because as the Hebrew press pointed out, while the burden of the loan is placed on the shoulders of the Jewish people on Palestine Jewry, they will be paid at only to the extent of \$75,000. The remainder will go directly or indirectly to the Arabs, whose government—generally mainly Arab labor. Some \$250,000 will be used to obtain land for landless Arabs, while \$106,000 will go for Arab schools. The distribution of the loan has caused the Jews complained bitterly, "is entirely in the spirit of the White Paper, Lord Passfield, Simpson and French."

A series of organized anti-Jewish excesses broke out on the streets of Warsaw, Poland, and a number of other towns yesterday, the excuse being that the day was Polish National Day. Many persons were injured and much damage done to buildings in the city.

Groups of Nazis armed with sticks rushed in formation through the Jewish quarter of Lodz, attacking and beating passersby and smashing windows. In Kilmisd, a crowd of Jews tried to defend themselves, thus precipitating a street fight in which many Jews suffered severe injuries.

Report Against Palestine Tax

Special Commission States Country Is Not So Ripe for Such Levy

JERUSALEM, May 6.—The special commission designated to study the question of an income tax scheme for Palestine has concluded its inquiry with the decision that the country is not yet ripe for such a tax levy, it was reliably learned today.

Mr. Huntington, British Treasury official who came here last February to advise the commission, left Jerusalem for London today. His conclusion, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned reliably, was against levying an income tax. The commission, which took testimony from Jews and Arabs, was composed of William Joseph Johnson, treasurer of Palestine; Kingsley William Stead, director of excise customs and duties; and Sir F. Campbell, district commissioner of Jerusalem.
