**Relief—Not Advice**

MR. IRVING M. YOUNKER, President of the Jewish Social Service Association and co-chairman of the Greater New York Drive of the United Jewish Appeal, tried to dramatize the tragic plight of German Jewry by saying in substance that the Jews of Germany are under a moral obligation to state of their children while Hitler is in power. Mr. Younker, in explaining his remarks as published in a metropolitan newspaper, declared in a statement to the Jewish Daily Bulletin:

"I certainly do not advocate Jewish race suicide. My own feeling is, however, that if I lived in Germany I would certainly not wish to bring into the world children who would have to face as terrible a future as confronts them in Nazi Germany today. . . . Only by thus sharply dramatizing the state of their children can we in America be made to realize the full extent of the horror for Jews under Hitlerism."

Mr. Younker has rendered a distinct disservice to the United Jewish Campaign by injecting a highly controversial issue into the relief drive. This is an unwise and rather harmful dramatization of the sorrows of the Jews of Germany. The majority of American Jews will disagree with Mr. Younker's suggestion of Jewish race suicide in Germany, however well-intentioned his dramatized suggestion may be.

As for the German Jews, they are in the desperate position of not even being able to complain of their sufferings and their humiliation. We do not know exactly whether they approve of the methods employed by the various factions of American Jewry in combating Hitlerism and denouncing the Nazi outrages perpetrated upon the German Jews. The German Jews have no specific means of them have even been compelled to minimize the anti-Jewish atrocities in Germany and to ask that no vigorous protests be made by the Jews of other lands.

But as the Jewish tragedy in Germany is not merely a German Jewish tragedy, for the Hitlerian anti-Jewish menace is reaching far beyond the borders of Germany, the Jews of other lands and particularly the Jews of America realize that Hitlerism is a world-wide menace against Jewry. They are not, regardless of whether or not the German Jews approve such a defensive measure. When the Jews of Russia were threatened, the Jews of America denounced the Jews of America, the Jews of America did not ask the Russian Jews whether they should raise their voice in a mighty protest. The Russian Jews, oppressed by the Tsar, also had to maintain silence. They, too, had to fear lest their complaints abroad might intensify the Tsar's anti-

## Mejid Says Duo Offered Him Money

Claims Brother Was in Cell With Him, Overhearing Talks

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, May 10. Abdul Mejid, Arab convict who has occupied the witness stand at the trial of the three Revisionist Zionists accused of the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff for three days of grueling cross-examination by defense counsel Horace Samuel, today went on the stand for the fourth time.

Although Samuel had concluded his cross-examination of the witness, he was recalled by the prosecution. Mejid had said during Samuel's examination that he was approached by Abraham Stavsky and Zvi Rosenblatt, two of the accused, and offered \$1,000 to assume the blame for the murder.

For three days the Arab testified in detail as to the alleged bribe and the story of how he was caught in the details of the murder by the accused and by another Arab, Sufchi.

At the close of his cross-examination Samuel created a sensation when he declared that, irrespective of the result of the present trial, he was prepared to prove that Mejid and his companion Issa Darwish had killed Dr. Arlosoroff. Musa al Alami, Arab government prosecutor, began by asking Mejid whether the convict's brother, Hamid, who was in the same cell with him, had overheard his conversation with Stavsky and Rosenblatt.

Mejid answered that his brother had overheard one of the talks and asked him what they had wanted. "I told him they are talking about the Arlosoroff case, offering me money and teaching me the details of the case," Mejid replied.

**Jewish Judge Intervenes**

At this point the Jewish judge, Moise Valero, intervened and for the first time during the trial asked Mejid in Arabic: "Were you" (Continued on Page Eight)

## Deutsch Chides Anti-Nazi Unit At City Hall

Blue Men Invasion Receives Rebuff From Mayor's Lieutenant

Fists banged desks and many determined voices were raised as a delegation of National Blue Men of America invaded City Hall, and later the Police Commissioner's office, seeking to bring about a ban on the Nazi mass meeting in Madison Square Garden slated for May 17. Threats were uttered to bring thousands of Blue Men to see the Mayor. There were intimations of possible bloodshed on the night of the meeting.

And the Minute Men would not take No for an answer. Rebuffed by the Mayor's secretary and diplomatically turned away by the tactful Lieutenant James Harten, watchdog of the Mayoral sanctum, the Blue Men, with ex-Magistrate Joseph Goldstein as one of their spokesmen, stormed the Alameda President's precinct. Mr. Deutsch finally received them.

## Poles Will Act Against Nara Peril to Jews

Consider Ban on Party Uniforms—Systematic Attacks Reach Serious Proportions

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, May 10.—The Polish government is fully cognizant of the dangers of the new campaign of the Naras, the National Radical party, against the Jews and is considering a ban on the party's uniforms, it was reliably learned today.

The Nara movement, since its inception a few weeks ago as a seceding faction of the National Democrats (Endeks), has opened a systematic campaign against the Jews in all parts of the country and is using every method of terrorism and intimidation. Its most repeated excesses have been in Bialystok, Wilno, Lodz and Czenstochowa. The movement, which seeks to enlist all anti-Semitic, anti-government forces, and is reportedly aided by the German Nazis, has made enormous strides in the few weeks of its existence and now constitutes a pronounced menace to peace and order in the Polish Republic.

**Government Will Take Measures**

Reports reaching the capital today from Lodz, Bialystok and Czenstochowa, where the attacks against Jews this week reached serious proportions, have strengthened the determination of the government, it was learned, to take vigorous measures to maintain order. These measures would include the prohibition of the wearing of the gray uniforms, affected by the Naras.

Hooligans at Lodz, according to reports here today, stoned Jewish motorcyclists who put up a strong battle in self-defense. Reinforcements received by the Nara assailants turned the tide of the battle and the Jews were forced to flee. Several of them were wounded in the conflict.

At Wilno the Naras used the municipal park as a "battleground" where they assembled and demonstrated against the Jews. Shouting "Down with the Jews and save Poland" (Continued on Page Eight)

## Palestine Breaks Protest Meeting

But Demonstrators Leave Singing Hatikvah and Shouting

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

TEL AVIV, May 10.—A protest meeting against the government policy of restricting Jewish immigration which had been arranged by the Jewish Community Council at Tel Aviv, was suddenly dispersed by the authorities.

The meeting was supposed to be addressed by Rabbi Uziel, Rabbi Mayer Berlin and Dr. Ben-Zion Moosman, representing the government. At the last minute police entered Beth-Ah and informed a crowd of 2,000 persons that the meeting was prohibited by the authorities. They left the hall in an orderly manner, but shouting "Down with the government!" and singing Hatikvah.

## Net \$60,000 In St. Louis Appeal Drive

Local Drive Opened By  
Rabbi J. B. Wise—  
Mayor Supporter

ST. LOUIS, May 10.—Sixty thousand dollars in local donations was subscribed here last night as the local drive of the \$1,200,000 Jewish Welfare Campaign was launched by Rabbi Jonah B. Wise, national chairman of the United Jewish Appeal. In an impassioned address Rabbi Wise hailed the unity of American Jewry in the work to relieve German Jewry and the development of Palestine. The first \$50,000 donated in the welfare drive has been allocated directly to the United Jewish Appeal.

At a luncheon given yesterday by Aaron Rath, president of the Jewish Federation, four anonymous contributions of \$5,000 were announced by Irvin Betman, chairman of the initial gifts committee. Rabbi Ferdinand M. Iserman spoke at the luncheon.

Emil Mayer, general campaign chairman, presided at a dinner last night in Temple Israel House. Robert W. Friedman is head of the men's division of 750 workers, who plan to conduct the most intensive citywide campaign since the the World War. One of the largest contributions announced last night was \$2,800 by the Macomb-Zionist Club.

### 2-Day Appeal for Anderson

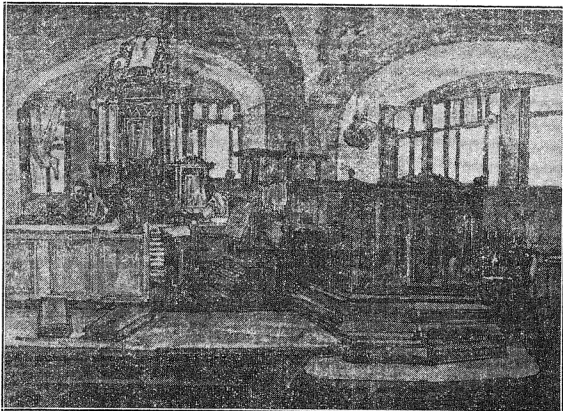

## Receiver for Galahad Press Takes Over Records of 'Shirts'

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
W. Bowen Henderson, receiver in bankruptcy for Galahad Press, Inc., took charge of the records and moneys of the Silver Shirts and allied organizations upon instructions of George W. Craig, who last week was named special master in the matter by Federal Judge E. Yates Webb, Shelby, N. C.

Last week Judge Webb signed an order directing the Silver Legion of America, Silver Shirt Legion of America, Inc., and the Foundation for Christian Economics, Inc., to show cause why their records and moneys should not be placed in charge of the receiver for Galahad Press. The court order restrained these organizations from transferring or disposing of any moneys, accounts, records, mail or property until Special Master Craig had passed upon the matter.

### Hearing Scheduled

A hearing scheduled before Craig was postponed due to the illness of one of the attorneys for a group of out-of-town creditors of Galahad Press.

However, Robert M. Wells and the law firm of Ford, Cox and Carter, attorneys for the Foundation for Christian Economics, Inc., Silver Shirt Legion of America, Inc., Silver Legion of America and League of Liberators, gave notice that they would appear before Judge Webb at Shelby and ask him to vacate the order signed last week.

### Affidavit Attached

Attached to the notice was an affidavit signed by Harry F. Sieber, treasurer for both the Foundation and the Silver Shirts, who said that "the Foundation for Christian Economics, Inc., since February, 1933, has sponsored and financed and distributed" Liberation, the weekly magazine, "and is solely responsible for publication of the magazine other than that the Galahad Press, Inc., is nominally the publisher."

The affidavit further points out that "Galahad Press has not actually engaged in business, except as a nominal publisher of Liberation, a weekly magazine sponsored, financed and distributed by the organization. . . . for more than

twelve months, and was not at the time of the filing of the petition in bankruptcy carrying on any business other than the nominal publisher of said magazine."

Further Details  
It also explained that the foundation "sponsored and financed unincorporated organization known and designated as Silver Legion of America which organization was taken over by Silver Shirt Legion of America, Inc., after its organization in March."

The Silver Shirt Legion of America, Inc., was incorporated under laws of Delaware last March 17, and domesticated in North Carolina.

## Communal Unity In Seattle Soon, Declares B'nai Brith Trustee

SEATTLE, Wash., May 10.—"I have anything to say about it," the Seattle Jewish community's long-awaited step toward communal unity—a central clearing house representing Seattle's twenty-six Jewish men's organizations—will become a reality before the end of May."

That was the declaration of Otto S. Grunbaum, B'nai Brith trustee and past president, and head of a special committee which is making plans to establish a Conference of Seattle Jewish Men's Organizations. His statement came in the face of refusal of Temple de Hirsch to join the proposed organization and after a meeting of the B'nai Brith Past Presidents' Club, sponsors of the unity move.

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# Text of Protest

## Will Increase Labor Shortage, Jeopardize Growth, Say Agency

### 5,600 Certificates Instead of 21,000 Asked for Palestine Hopelessly Inadequate, Statement Declares—World Plight of Jewry Adds to Crisis

The following is the full text of the statement issued by the executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine in Jerusalem explaining its position on the immigration restrictions imposed by the Palestine government.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, May 9.—"The executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine feels bound to define publicly its attitude on the grant by the government of Palestine of only 5,600 labor immigration certificates for the period between April and September, 1934."

"The executive perceived in this grant the continuation of a policy which restricts immigration, while the country is expanding its absorptive capacity of the country is creating a steadily growing gap between the demand for labor and the supply. The statement of the Jewish economic position, and gravely jeopardizing the chances of healthy, unhampered progress in Palestine. The collapse of German Jewry and the worldwide repercussions brought home to the masses of Jews that Palestine alone offers the opportunity for a assured existence."

**Governments' Revenue Increases**  
"The increasing flow of capital to Palestine, the investment in agriculture and the proceeds of the government's revenue has shown an enormous increase and the treasury has grown by 100,000 pounds in one year. Throughout this period, as the government so often admitted, there prevailed an acute shortage of labor, particularly felt in agriculture with the result that it was found impossible to recruit the necessary labor for the Jewish areas in Palestine."

"Orange plantations, agricultural settlements and industry also were severely handicapped and the major enterprises of the Ruttenberg concession, the Palestine potash concession and the Neber cement works found great difficulty in obtaining workers. The labor shortage proved that the former labor immigration schedule lagged behind the actual requirements and was grossly disproportionate to the country's growing absorptive capacity."

**Immigration Increased**  
"It is true that immigration to Palestine has shown a marked increase in the last three years. Immigrants of all categories with their dependents numbered 4,000 in 1931, 10,000 in 1932 and 24,000 in 1933, but the economic development of Palestine far outstripped the supply of labor which the immigration policy including those entering as travelers and stayed after finding employment. For at least three schedule periods the immigration of labor immigrants in Palestine was stationary and appeared to be stabilized at a rate far below the minimum claimed by the government."

"Schedules granted were 5,500 for October, 1933, and 5,600 for April, 1934. The Agency finds it impossible to reconcile this restriction of immigration with the declared policy of the Mandatory Power that immigration will be regulated in accordance with the economic absorptive capacity of Palestine, a principle which the Agency always agreed to. But this policy is not to be authorized in ex-

cess of the absorptive capacity, but should be authorized to the fullest extent of the country's capacity."

"Moreover a restrictive policy is fully prejudicial to the structure of the Jewish National Home and threatens to undermine the economic positions acquired by the Jews with so much effort and sacrifice."

"The present scarcity of labor has already led to a series of adverse developments in Palestine, which are bound to be further aggravated by the new schedule. The Agency statement pointed out:

**Huge Rise in Wages**  
"Building wages have risen to unprecedented heights upsetting investment calculations and raising capital markets, while the economic level. Labor has shifted from agriculture to better paid occupations, and immigrants destined for the farms have been driven to the towns, while the farms remained understocked and the orange groves undercultivated. No Jewish workers are available to allow the Jews to have their share in government projects. Important development projects have been held up. Industry has been prevented from taking the fullest advantage of the possibilities afforded by new investments and the number of enterprises were unable to keep pace with the rise in wages, and the building industry lost a large number of its skilled employees."

"The void created in the labor market has been filled to some extent by the employment of Arabs in Jewish employ and the illicit infiltration into Palestine of Arab laborers from neighboring territories."

**Labor Situation Tense**  
"The general labor situation has been one of high tension."

"Workers are leaving their jobs in reply to the more insistent demands of the government, hampered by their inability to find workers. Public resentment has been aroused by the sight of enterprises delayed by the immigration policy. The Jewish labor force for works undertaken for the specific purpose of absorbing Jewish immigrants."

"The government has given no official reasons for the discrepancy between the claims advanced by the Agency and the schedules granted. It is believed that this may be due to the fear of an economic setback, it would appear remarkable that this fear should have been so great as to cause the government to go against its own schedule, in spite of it being invalidated by subsequent developments."

"The Agency believes itself justified in refusing to take a pessimistic view of the future. In the present position of the Jews in the Diaspora the development of Palestine is unlikely to abate. Already large accumulations of capital in Palestine are seeking profitable investment in the Jewish orange area. The country has 1,000,000 dunams, two thirds of which are young plantations requiring a steadily growing volume of labor. The present estimate of the government prospects are infallible. All it can say is that the estimate made by the Agency is based on a detailed and careful survey of the labor market. The market was made in village after village in Palestine of the labor shortage in agriculture and allowance made for the prospects of new farming developments. The needs

of new large scale undertakings are bound to start in the near future. The local demand for manufactured products—steadily growing with the growth of the population—provides yet a wider scope for further industrial progress."

"As to the building industry, with all its signal development, it is still far from satisfying existing housing requirements. The accumulated capital being plentiful, it is unlikely to show a serious contraction in the near future. Even if the building industry could be attained on the same level for a period of years, the release of labor from the industry need not cause a crisis, as industrial development and agricultural colonization can be relied upon to absorb the surplus labor."

"The settlement of land and the conversion of agricultural laborers into independent farmers, is continuing uninterruptedly and a number of major settlements are being carried out with increasing realization."

"In the face of all these prospects it can hardly appear justifiable that a fear of a future crisis should cramp the present development of the balance in the labor market. As against the vague fears of a possible future crisis, the Agency must stress the fact that the shortage of labor has continued for more than a year. Recent experience proved that the development of the Jewish National Home is based on a wider basis and at a more rapid pace than was previously regarded as possible."

"The position of the Jewish people the world over, which is at the root of this development, makes it imperative that all opportunities for Jewish settlement in Palestine be utilized to the fullest extent and with the least avoidable delay."

**Keep Quality As Well**  
"However, it is not the quantitative aspect of immigration alone with which the Jewish Agency is concerned. Equally important is the quality of the immigrants. The question of the size of the Jewish population, its place and increase is the question of the economic quality of the Jewish population."

"It is the essence of Jewish endeavor in Palestine to create not only a large, but an economically healthy Jewish population, firmly rooted in the soil, possessing a broad agricultural basis and engaging in all branches of production."

"The Home will not be built only by the investment of Jewish capital. It is Jewish labor employed in Jewish enterprises created by Jewish capital which forms the basis of the Home and ensures its healthy existence. This principle is stressed in the letter of Mr. Donald's letter to Dr. Weizmann."

"The policy of preventing Jewish labor immigration corresponding to the needs of the Jewish community strikes at the root of the Jewish National Home. The Agency hoped that in the light of past experience the governments have enough to cover the present accumulated deficiency, and make due provision for further expansion."

"The Agency finds it singular indeed that apparently disregarding this experience the government once again has granted a schedule of a size which developments have shown to be utterly inadequate in relation to the actual pace of economic progress."

"The Agency cannot naturally claim that the present immigration prospects are infallible. All it can say is that the estimate made by the Agency is based on a detailed and careful survey of the labor market. ## Deutsche Urges Gentiles Help In Refugee Children Problem

Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch yesterday emphasized that the relief of German refugee children should not be regarded as a purely Jewish problem. A majority of them are of Gentile parentage.

In a press conference at City Hall in connection with the opening of the campaign by the American Committee for the Relief of Victimized German Children, Mr. Deutsch, who is chairman of the committee's forthcoming year, stressed the worldwide scope of the organization, the administrative board of which is headed by Lord Marley.

The bazaar will be held during the week of June 9 at the Pennsylvania Building. One evening will be devoted to a display and discussion of books banned in Germany, another to banned music. Twelve etchings of Professor Albrecht Dürer, all owned by him, will be offered for sale as well as a wide variety of other merchandise, all donated by groups, individuals and firms in sympathy with the project.

The organization is the only one, Mr. Deutsch asserted, which is assisting victims of Hitlerism within German borders.

**Many Children Aided**  
The funds are allocated directly to the victims by an international control commission. The children thus assisted are at present in Paris, and Holland, and near the German-Dutch border. Fifteen per

cent are children of Social Democrats, fifteen per cent of Communists and seventy per cent those of intellectuals, architects, university professors, writers, travelers, seamen and others who have saved themselves in political disagreement with the Nazis.

"The need for the Jewish masses to go to Palestine is becoming more acute than ever. The Agency must insist that it is the duty of the Mandatory Power to allow immigration to the full extent of the territory, wherever Palestine itself capable."

"The Agency regrets to find in the present schedule striking testimony of the Mandatory's failure to discharge this fundamental obligation."

# Stavsky Offers Plan For Zionist Peace

## 'Free Confederacy' of Parties Urged by Revisionist Leader

**Threatened Split of Z. O., He Contends, Compels New Set-Up—Outlines Plan That Provides for Equal Party Representatives at World Congress**

The following article is a comprehensive, authoritative statement of the Zionist Revisionist viewpoint suggesting a method whereby the various Zionist parties can come to final agreement in the Palestine and other Jewish questions. It was written by Vladimir Jabotinsky, world leader of the Zionist-Revisionist Party, a former member of the World Zionist Executive, one of the founders of the Jewish Legion which fought in Palestine under the British Mandate, and a noted publicist.

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The Zionist organization is threatened with a split: there are those who think the split is already there and should not be discussed whose fault it is; the only thing that matters—to those who set any value by the preservation of the unity of the organization—is representing the joint will of all the Zionist parties, as I do—to try to establish those conditions upon which the united body of that character could be reborn, and reborn for permanence.

Such an attempt, of course, had better be made by somebody quite objective and impartial, which I do not claim to be. Still, the intelligent reader will himself judge upon what basis the suggestion should be accepted as cool sense or, on the contrary, as partisan outbursts.

In fashion with most Zionist writers and orators to endow the Zionist movement with all the dignity of non-territorialism, I believe, accordingly, that every "citizen" of this State-like community should obey the decisions of its "Parliament" ("Government") the same as a citizen of, say, Sweden or Holland obeys. I am afraid this is a construction not only premature but totally erroneous.

### Zionism Not a State

I wish to goodness we Jews could possess a real State, and the sooner the better; but the Zionist movement is only a movement, not a State. The difference lies, above all, in the realm of ethics. A State can compel, therefore, a citizen who obeys its orders even against his own convictions and conscience, commits no moral transgression; he must be forced, he acts under duress, and if his acts are morally wrong in his own judgment, the responsibility is not his. But the movement is not his. It is a movement on the free will and consent of each of its components. One is not only not compelled, he must be expected to remain a member if he the actions demanded of him become irreconcilable with his conscience. For the moral responsibility, in the eye of his innermost tribunal, rests upon him, and him only. He has no excuse for outward compliance, he was not forced or disobeyed, and if he acted against his own ethical judgment, it was his own fault and sin.

A very common example can illustrate this difference. Thousands and thousands may abhor the very thought of being neighbors from across the frontier in the name of patriotism; or, even if not entirely pacifists, they may dislike the path of the sword. If compelled to fight, they will do so with the profoundest aversion. But they need not let this fact influence their conscience: they are com-

pelled. It would be quite another story if they took part, say, in the Polish and Japanese wars, at the same time thinking it unjust. In that case, their action would be immoral.

Two Viewpoints Clash  
Today the Zionist movement comprises widely and deeply conflicting elements. There are those in its ranks who feel that it would be unworthy of our national traditions to seek domination even in Palestine; and there are those who believe that every nation is entitled to "dominate" in its own national home. The former, accordingly, cannot agree that the claim for a "Jewish majority on both sides of the Jordan" should be stated in the name of a body of which they, too, are a part. And the latter, equally, cannot agree that Zionism should be officially interpreted, in the name of a body which they, too, are a part, as an undertaking quite content with the present status of the Jewish minority. The same can be said as to tactics. Some Zionists are entirely convinced that hammering radical tactics upon the masses of powers is harmful; and some, again, are entirely convinced that "hammering," etc., is the only way to obtain the object which is to be made the master of the Zionist Organization's machinery, it would be quite natural for the former to insist that the subject of Zionism, but also to the world at large: "Our conscience forbids us to support methods of action likely to bring the subject of Zionism before the world to know that there is also another kind of Zionism serving the same ideal but rejecting such tactics; so that when the day of wrath will come, it should not strike all the Zionists but a portion of them which is left to carry on." And vice-versa.

So far it has been "vice-versa." For many years, Zionism has been officially presented to the mandatory powers as a project which does not imply the claim for a Jewish majority in Palestine. But a section of Zionists were profoundly convinced that the "mandatory" claim is the only argument which can compel the mandatory power to change its immigration policy, and the only way to make it more adequate to the needs of the Jewish tragedy. Let it not matter, for the moment, whether this is right or wrong; but it was their profound conviction, the voice of their conscience, and they felt that, should they keep silent, it would mean all the world means acquiescence) they would harm the Zionist future.

### Always Two Opinions

It would be idle for anybody here to intervene with the well known objection: "Is it not still more harmful to confront the 'mandatory' with the Jewish Zionism, thus promoting strangers to the role of judges in a Jewish dispute on things essentially Jewish?" And, of course, such a dispute is always plausible, but nobody really believes in it. There has always been, before the non-Jewish world, two Jewish opinions when the Zionist movement was born, there were the "Protest-Rabbiner." When, during the war, one group of Jews, the "Protest-Rabbiner," for what ultimately took the form of the Balfour Declaration, another group of Jews (and by far the more substantial) fought against it. One Jewish delegation

went to the War Office to insist on the suppression of the Jewish Regiment. Another hurried to the rescue of the Legion. (And both included prominent Zionists.) This play of dualism goes on: some Jews are in favor of the anti-German boycott, some are against it. Yet, above all those divisions, there is evidently the voice of the objective truth, of life's reality itself; and somehow, therefore, it is always the good cause that triumphs in the end. The Balfour Declaration became a fact; so did the Jewish Legion; and Germany's exports dwindle. It is, of course, very regrettable that Jews cannot talk in unison; but we must not overestimate the danger.

### Can't Enforce "Statutes"

In any case, it is idle and useless to dream that such differences can be solved by altering the paragraphs enjoining "discipline." The paragraphs will simply be ignored. The ruling majority then will have to "discipline" the minorities from the Zionist Organization; but everybody by now realizes that that will bring real hardship trying to enforce, on the contrary, the "minorities" who always get the biggest headlines in the press, and the "expulsions" of the minority who only result in a confession that the Zionist Organization, once identified with "Zionism" as a whole, no longer even pretends to represent the totality of Zionist Jewry. If I spoke as a partisan, I should say: go, eat em dead and drunk! But I speak in the name of cool common sense.

The common sense points to one solution only: the Zionist Organization can no longer exist on the basis of its present statutes: with parties fighting at each other at Congress elections in order to conquer the majority (and, here in Europe at least, victory depends, to a very large extent, on the extensive financial power of each—for Shekellim can be distributed free of charge); with the conquering party keeping trying to oppress and threatening the minority with dreadful executions. The very character of those dreadful executions is a tell-tale sign that gives away all the fallacy of that famous comparison of Zionism with a "State": the ultimate, the final threat is "expulsion." A State does not expel offenders against discipline: a State puts them in jail. . . . I apologize for too familiar and slangy a term, but I am about to use, but I can find no other: all this is "bunkum."

The Zionist Organization cannot be preserved by such methods. It is all very well when the Z. O. was young, and there was accordingly but little differentiation between its component elements. Today it consists of deeply differentiated parties, each one actually sovereign, independent, and unnameable to any compulsion. This fact has long been admitted, and more—this fact should

become the base on which the new World Zionist Organization should be built.

### Zionism a "Family"

Since comparisons are the fashion, I offer a better one: Zionism is not a "State" but a "family." As long as the children were small, and "Daddy" alive, it kept together without difficulty. Now there is no longer any trace of a person or a party likely to be recognized as the equivalent of "Daddy"; and the "children" are growing, long married, and are no longer under the influence of his own line of business. Such a family can only be kept from disbanding by free mutual consent, none of the brothers ever attempting to dominate.

Translated into the language of statute paragraphs this would mean:

The World Zionist Organization is a free confederacy of independent and sovereign Zionist parties.

At the World Zionist Congress each party is represented by an equal number of delegates, and no party can require the free consent of all the delegates.

All these parties shall use their best efforts to work out, in so far as possible, joint objects and methods of action with regard to such matters as raising the necessary funds, spreading the Hebrew language, training chutzpans, managing Palestinian institutions or enterprises, facilitating and regulating immigration. For these purposes they may fix by mutual consent, from time to time, fair quotas of the benefits and advantages to be derived by each party from the joint activity of all.

They elect, at the Congress, a joint executive—the Jewish Agency—whose powers shall be strictly confined to the times of action agreed upon mutually—including also the right of performing in the name of Zionism as a whole, such political steps as may be agreed upon by all.

The members of the executive undertake to consult each other on any separate action, political or otherwise, which they might stand independently to initiate, always endeavoring to achieve, at least some degree of coordination—while re-

maining, in the one, free to act as they like.

I think I can visualize an arrangement of this kind, and I feel sure that it would be quite a useful arrangement. But even pessimists should realize that this would be the only practicable form of comparative unity, simply because there can be no other.

## Housing Conference Starts Membership Drive Tomorrow

In an intensive penny membership campaign tomorrow the Lower East Side Public Housing Conference will start off the events of Better Housing Week program with concerted impetus.

Mayor LaGuardia will open the campaign by becoming the first member. Hundreds of boys, girls, and mothers from clubs, kindergartens, and settlements from the Lower East Side will assemble at Madison House, 226 Madison street, at 11 A. M. From there the group will march to City Hall and attend the ceremony at which the Mayor will be the principal figure. The campaign is intended to increase the present large membership of slum dwellers which the Lower East Side Public Housing Conference represents.

## Plight of Womanhood Pitiful Under Hitler, States Miriam Beard

"The Nazis are putting women back in the home but they do not intend to keep her company there," writes Miriam Beard, living in the current issue of Today, out today. Nazis think it ill becomes a Teutonic male to spend many waking hours in his home, she declares. A Nazi's son, as soon as he can go-stop, must be transferred to the drill-field.

The movement of the womanhood under Hitler is pitiful, Miriam Beard states, yet she has been conquered by her own vision.

## The Bulletin's Day Book

The Nazis are plotting. Beginning Saturday, May 19, a concerted effort will be made by one Nazi faction to secure the collapse of the main body of Hitler's tried and true friends in New Germany.

On that date at 8:30 p. m. in the Kreutzler Hall at 228 East 86 street the Deutscher Bund will begin its drive for membership. The Deutscher Bund under the fine leadership of Hans Wuert, former secretary of the American Branch of the National Socialist Party, and Friedrich Heiss, the growing man of anti-Semitism, has issued its first appeal for the following—cash customers, if you please.

Heiss and Wuert are convinced that Gisslitz and his successor, Reinhold Walter, are not Nazi enough (Heaven and Heiss only know how they could be more so). So they are starting their own outfit, into which they hope to drag Germans, German Americans, and all others who are willing to cross the Nazi palms with silver.

For Heiss it will be a day of glorious revenge. Some months ago the Friends of New Germany withdrew their national patron from Heiss' paper, Amerikas Deutsche Post, which had been the Nazi Party organ for many months. The Nazis rejoiced that Heiss was making too much dough for the fat, old duffer he is, and a few of the more far-sighted (Griebel and Stachelbeel, primarily) against the party line, thought that Heiss was making too the party living should grace their own pockets. So they set up Das Neue Deutschland, which later became the weekly Deutsche Zeitung.

In both these sheets they published announcements that went something like this: "Many persons have been misled by the misrepresentations concerning the identity of the organ of the Friends of New Germany. The Deutsche Zeitung is not the organ of this group, and we urge members and friends to buy no other."

But for Heiss a day of reckoning is at hand. In a cozy little corner of the May issue of Amerikas Deutsche Post, the ancient priester has come out with the following announcement:

**"WARNING AGAINST IMPOSTERS:** Various persons, including women, representing themselves as representatives of the

Deutscher Bund, seek out German business concerns to solicit purchases of the "Deutsche Zeitung" (Organ of the League of Friends of New Germany).

"The Deutscher Bund," (Heiss must have rubbed his hands and given vent to a satisfied, "Haw" as he wrote this) "has absolutely nothing to do with this filthy business, and it asks German business men, recognizing such persons, to turn them over to the police."

Bundesleiter Wuert's remarks, in connection to the announcement, but it smells like Heiss.

Heiss, as a leader of an Aryan-Christian Union was going to rule the world with that outfit some months ago. Apparently he must have lost faith in the movement and returned again to his first love, race politics with the religious element merely a caudal appendage to wage in the faces of fanatics of the Pelley calvary.

Now, whether or not Heiss is going to reap the golden harvest his anti-Semitic old soul craves, is a matter for time to decide. He has a fair chance of garnering a few dollars from members of the disgruntled Friends who have all been snubbed by a couple of the stench bubble recently uncoiled within the fold. Heiss is all ready for a skyrocketing of his revenues. He has made arrangements for the sale of bulk quantities of his sheet (100 for \$2.50—otherwise retailed at a dime apiece) to all groups who might, or fail to think, in the Heissian manner.

For a time, folks, you get some nice pictures of St. Adolf, the founder of his movement (swastika to the linguistically limited), and twelve pages of blood curdling stuff on the big, bad, old fight up, folks. Just a time, folks.

Maybe we shouldn't bring this up, but, damn it, the way this fellow Heiss goes around exposing the secrets of the Jewish International Money Fund, we really should, or at least ourselves.

We'll do it this way. Those interested can go through the criminal files for about the year 1936 and find out just what the hell this. You'll find nothing about Friedrich himself, but the stuff his shop at that time was printing. Hot Dog!!! P. M.

### Off the Milky Wagon

"The Milky Way," which the young Messrs. Harmon and Ullman presented at the Cort Theatre on Tuesday night is nearly as funny as the advance notices of the show promised. For a week this column has been unsmiling with space devoted to preliminary comments about the piece by Lynn Root and Harry Clark and now having seen the play I wonder whether I was not a bit overcome by the balhyloo.

Hugh O'Connell as skillful a comedian as Broadway can produce, plays the title role of a milkman, somewhat of a sap, who through a series of utterly incredible situations becomes middle-western champion of the world. He is ably aided by Leo Donnelly, the clowning fight manager who so foxy that he even out-foxes himself; Gladys George, as the manager's very hard boiled lady friend who has the funniest lines in the play; William Ford, in a character part as a trainer, and Brian Donlevy, as the very good looking prize fighter. There are also six or seven huge Saint Bernard dogs.

### Doesn't Stand Analysis

If you delve too deeply into the mechanics of "The Milky Way" you must discover that it is pretty shallow stuff. The plot has none of the most impossible situations I've seen in weeks but the direction is intelligent and the dialogue is unusually bright. There are many hearty laughs in the lines and the cast does make the most of them. "The Milky Way" is a farce, a fantastic conglomeration of slap-stick comedy that will please you, if you are in the right frame of mind. It is at best light-hearted entertainment.

### To Be Irresolute

Perhaps I have taken too literally some of the press material that comes through the mail. I was informed that since the success of "Men in White," which they produced, Harmon and Ullman have been overwhelmed with play scripts and only after much cogitation did they pick "The Milky Way." If this is true the young Jewish producers either received very feeble stuff or they just wanted something they would keep a group of ushers working for a month or so.

papermen, Mr. Deutch set forth his philosophy of free speech, which makes it impossible for him to see things in the Blue Man night.

"A riot will be provoked on the night of May 17," shouted Mr. Goldstein. "It will be a disorderly meeting, inciting to riot, fomenting a riot against Jews and Catholics." He displayed Nazi promotion literature calling for "United Germanism in America."

"It is, in fact, the only committee meeting to protest against the boycott," Mr. Deutch said.

"It will precipitate a riot like of which New York has never seen," retorted Goldstein.

"Have a stenographer there to take down what you claim are inflammatory speeches. We can always trace those who stage meetings," Mr. Deutch said.

"We demand police protection for our stenographer," a number of Blue Men exclaimed in one voice.

"Personally I do not see the necessity for any Jew going there. No Jew has a right to go to that meeting," Deutch said emphatically.

"There will be ample police protection, but not for those who try to break up a meeting. This is still America."

"We won't prevent the meeting. We cannot interfere with free speech. All my life I have preached free speech when it does not contravene law and order."

"But our intelligence," said Ben Wolf, a national commander of Blue Men, said, "which includes a number of Germans, brings us information every day of their activities inciting to riot and fomenting hatred."

Philip Cook, Frank Radest and Abe Kasoff and Robert Cohen told their experience with Nazis in New York and elsewhere.

Deutch asked if Blue Men would be permitted to stage a parade and an outdoor meeting in front of Madison Square Garden on the night of May 17.

Mr. Deutch promised to speak to the Mayor about the matter.

"At our burning of German merchandise tonight," Commander Lazare announced, "I shall order arrested the Mayor and his staff on May 17. I am going to have 8,000 of them."

"And I am going to draw up a petition to the Supreme Court against the Mayor, Goldstein, in an order to the Mayor, Alderman President and the Police Commissioner to show cause why the Nazis should be incited to riot, should not be prevented. And we'll have plenty of affidavits on Hitlerites' previous activities."

"And where can I get a gun safe for myself, boys, I am going to parade with you in Brownsville tonight?"

Immediately after leaving City Hall the delegation proceeded to the Police Department. Although they had no previous appointment they refused to be overawed by the attendants. They were ultimately received by Allen Stuyvesant, secretary of the Police Department, telling him that either the Nazi conclave must be called off or the Blue Men must have their right to parade for the same night.

Stuyvesant's tact and diplomacy proved of no avail. The fiery Mr. Goldstein and his emphatic speech were the only ones finally admitted into the Commissioner's presence.

What transpired there is not known, but they were said to have left for Brooklyn, where it is understood that no permit has been granted yet. Police Commissioner O'Ryan, at the press conference, said that he would at the Headquarters today, will probably explain the disposition of the Blue Men's case.

An active boycott of shops failing to join the counter-boycott has been prosecuted for many weeks. Scores of shops are being boycotted in the Yorkville area, unselected and the ever-growing hatred of highly Hitlerized "Germanism in the U. S. A."

# Stores Hit Hard

An attendant at the Marlin Delicatessen Store on Lexington Avenue, near Fifty-sixth Street yesterday admitted that business had fallen off twenty per cent during the last few weeks. He said the store had no complaint with other shops in the district.

M. Teitelbaum, owner of a confectionery and stationery store at 1681 Second Avenue, was reported by his neighbor to have been forced out of business under pressure of the boycott.

A neighbor owner of a retail and wholesale business said that agents of the DAWA had called at his concern, asked employees whether or not the store was Jewish-owned, and left without making the purpose of his mission. The business has been boycotted by a number of former customers.

Women have entered the store to buy whether or not the store was German-made rubber ball. "I wouldn't use this American trash," he said.

Two doors from this shop is a large book shop handling exclusively German books. It is owned by a few Jews can not belong to the DAWA. The store is the most flourishing of its kind in Yorkville, is boycotted.

Members of the board of directors attempted to bar reporters in protest against what they felt was an invasion of privacy in the press. Through the intervention of teachers and parents, however, a Bulletin reporter was finally admitted.
