



Nazis Use Ford's Name in Propaganda Drive

The First Day
The first day of the open hearings before the Congressional Committee investigating Nazi activities in this country brought forth testimony which linked the German ambassador, Dr. Hans Luther, and the former German consul general in New York, Dr. Otto Kiep, with German anti-Semitic propaganda in the United States.

The German ambassador was described by the Rev. Francis Gross, a priest of Perth Amboy, N. J., as the financial backer and sponsor of the anti-Semitic pamphlet published by Gross under the title, "Justice to Hungary, Germany and Austria."

The Rev. Dr. Gross received payment in bills from the German consul general, who informed him that the funds for the pamphlets were furnished by a friend of the New Germany, in a letter to his printer, Gross wrote:

"Concerning documents—correspondence in my possession by which the proof is established that in publishing my books Ambassador Luther was the sponsor, financial backer and promoter of my books—permit me to state if these documents would be used in a further discussion, repercussions and sensation in the American and world press might even cause the recall of Dr. Luther—and the friendly relationship between our country and Germany might become clouded for a long while. Overmore I myself will be in a storm center in which I might not be strong enough to overcome antagonism from opposing factions."

Apparently the Reverend Dr. Gross failed to get as much as he had expected from the German embassy and consulate for the writing and publication of his booklet, for in his letter to the printer he complains:

"I feel that I was not only used but abused by the German embassy at Washington, by which I have been used to fight Germany's battle and have been thrown overboard by the German embassy when the fight became heated."

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Police Raids, Nara Riots Harry Jews

Poland Ignores Pledge; Disguised Attack on Government Seen

WARSAW, June 6.—Despite the increasing seriousness of the anti-Semitic rioting engaged in by the Naras (National Radicals) and the pledge of the government to take steps to prevent attacks on the Jews, action of the authorities to maintain order today took the direction of raids on headquarters of Jewish organizations by the police to search for hidden arms and to prevent formation of Jewish self-defense units.

A new outrage was reported today when Naras, shortly after midnight, broke into Jewish residences on Bravova street, Warsaw, and attacked the sleeping families. Neighbors hearing the victims cry for help, summoned the police, who caught two of the hoodlums. Several wounded Jews required hospital treatment.

PRAGUE, June 6.—Information coming to light here shows that subversive propaganda activities are being carried on by Nazi agents in Strasbourg, France, against German refugees. Forged papers and pamphlets are circulated which give the impression that refugees are agitating against the Doumergue government and attempt to spread communist propaganda.

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'International Jew,' Repudiated By Magnate, Widely Distributed

Weideman Testifies Before Washington Quiz Body Book Is Published in Germany—Gissibl Admits Reich Dogmas Issued Through 'Friends'

WASHINGTON, June 6.—The Congressional committee investigating subversive activities in this country was told today that copies of "The International Jew," a collection of anti-Semitic articles attributed to Henry Ford, are being circulated in this country as well as in Germany.

Congressman Carl Weideman, member of the committee, testified that although Ford had repudiated the book and its contents and demanded that it no longer be distributed, Nazi propagandists are freely circulating the book here and broadcasting it in Germany.

Copies of the book, easily obtained here, Weideman said, bear the imprint of the Fritsch publishing house of Leipzig, for many years one of Germany's chief publishers of anti-Semitic literature.

The Michigan Congressman placed in the record, with a copy of the book, a telegram from H. E. Bennett, Ford aide, declaring use of Ford's name in connection with the book is entirely unauthorized.

The use of Henry Ford's name on the book is entirely unauthorized for the reason that Mr. Ford is not the author of the literature indicated," Bennett's telegram to the committee stated.

Weideman testified he had bought a copy of the book without any difficulty in a New York bookstore.

Ford repudiated the volume and the articles it contained, which previously had appeared in the Dearborn Independent. In 1927 Ford wrote to the Fritsch concern announcing that he had retracted charges against the Jews contained in the articles and demanding that the sale of the book be terminated immediately.

"You are accordingly notified that whatever rights you have or claim to have to publish 'The International Jew' anywhere or in any language whatsoever are hereby revoked and terminated and that the publication, sale or other distribution of 'The International Jew' and the use of the name of Henry Ford or of the Dearborn

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Reich Consul Injected Hitlerism Into Hostory Union, President Hints

Playing Mowitz as "the leading spirit and guide of the forces opposed to unionism," Rieve asked the strikers to "fight against the establishment of a Hitler form of government in the United States."

Anti-Nazi Leader Celebrates Birthday Fighting for Jewry

Samuel Untermeyer, 76, Makes New Plans to Aid Reich Victims

YONKERS, N. Y., June 6.—Celebrating his seventy-sixth birthday this evening at a family dinner at his estate, Greystone, Samuel Untermeyer told the Jewish Daily Bulletin reporter that his one great ambition in life is "to see justice done to my people in Germany."

The man who once received a fee of \$75,000 for his part in a \$100,000,000 copper merger twenty years ago, is now devoting himself exclusively to the propaganda fighting of the anti-Nazi boycott of Germany. Pse of power trusts, veteran of the Pujo investigation, he is principally interested in men and events likely to weaken down the Hitler maltreatment of Jews.

His only message to the Jews of America, he said, was to "have courage."

"Feeling fine" and "going strong," he declined to comment further on Jewish problems. "My office in the city," he declared, "is issuing my statement on Ambassador Hatzel's recent propaganda activities in America as revealed in the opening day's sessions of the Congressional investigation."

Gathered at the festive board celebration were two brothers and their wives, his daughter and her husband, and his grandchildren. The celebration in June is an annual event, although Mr. Untermeyer's birthday is celebrated in January. This custom has been in vogue with the Untermeyers since the lawyer made it a point of spending his winters at his California estate.

Mr. Untermeyer's sons are Stephen and Irwin Untermeyer, and his daughter is Mrs. Stanley L. Richter. The grandchildren present were Louis Putnam Myers, son of Mrs. Richter, and Samuel, Joan and Frank Untermeyer, children of the Judge. Samuel Untermeyer made the trip to Greystone from Cambridge, where he has been attending town on the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Greystone, the Untermeyer estate, was the former residence of Samuel J. Tilden, one-time Governor of New York.

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Cables Assure Greek Jews On Castoria

Peace Reigns There, Answer to Query Sent by Body

The Greek Jewish community here was reassured yesterday by cables from Castoria, Greece, that peace reigned there once more and Jews are un molested.

Alarmed by reports of anti-Jewish excesses, in which Isaac Iliaou, son of the president of Castoria's Jewish community, was said to have been severely injured by members of the EEE, Greek Nazi organization, New York's Greek Jews not only cabled through the Hessed Ne Elimek of Castoria, but also induced a large and important local society of non-Jew-the mayor of that town.

Practically all the 2,000 Greek Jews who came here to escape the war were aroused by reports of the atrocities and eagerly awaited the reply. Cables came from Jacob Iliaou, president of Castoria's Jewish community, and from Moris Hazan, father of Victor Hazan, who is secretary of the Hessed Ne Elimek in New York.

The committee of New York's Castoria Jews who investigated included Mathew Russo, Samuel Elias, Bockio Mayo, Victor Hazan and Max Cohen. Russo returned from visit to Castoria only three months ago, at which time, he said, its 1,000 Jews, mostly merchants, were living unmolested.

Aldermen Summons Fama On Bigotry Charges

The Board of Aldermen yesterday ordered Dr. Charles A. Fama, recent John J. Cashmore, chairman of the city employees' retirement system, to appear in connection with charges that he is a religious bigot.

A resolution introduced by Alderman John J. Cashmore, and William P. Flood calling the physician "unfit and unqualified" to hold public office was adopted unanimously by the Aldermanic board. It charged that Fama had substituted for former United States Senator Heflin at an anti-Catholic Ku Klux Klan meeting, and that his prejudice extends to the Jews.

Women to Attend Young Israel Rally

Presence at Atlantic City Parley Will Establish Precedent for Group

For the first time in the history of a Young Israel convention, women will be allowed to participate, when the annual parley of the group gets under way at Atlantic City during the week-end of June 22. The women will represent their separately organized units, created recently.

Plans for enlargement of educational and religious activities of the organization will be discussed, including a program for the organization of a kashruth system in this country.

Reports from a representative of Young Israel in Palestine, where two branches are flourishing in Jerusalem and Tel Aviv, will be read to the assembled delegates of all important Jewish communities of the United States. Ways of bringing about closer ties between Young Israel and the Holy Land will be discussed.

Charities Division Raises Half Quota

Federation Men's Clothing Group Announces \$5,000 Already Realized

The men's clothing and furnishings division of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities has raised approximately \$5,000, half its quota for the Federation's current \$500,000 campaign, it was announced last night following a dinner meeting of the men's and boys' wear buyers' group of the division.

More than \$1,000 was raised at the gathering, which was attended by members of the trade from Manhattan, Brooklyn, Philadelphia and Boston. Sol Feldman, chairman of the unit, presided. Speeches were made by Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, president of the Federation; Maxwell W. Schneider, member of the executive board of the group, and Mr. Feldman.

Reich Bar of Anti-Nazi Economic Paper Means Nothing, Says League

After receiving cabled notice Tuesday that the Economic League was barred from Germany, the Anti-Nazi Non-Sectarian League, of which Samuel Untermeyer is president, issued a statement that its Bulletin is almost exclusively circulated in the United States to "importers, merchants and professional men, designed to keep dealers informed about adequate substitutions for Nazi goods to further the aims of the anti-Nazi boycott."

Published monthly with a circulation of about 50,000, the publication, according to the records of the organization, has no subscribers in Germany. It has a few in Austria and Czechoslovakia and these, it is believed, may have kept it from being banned.

German Seaman Freed by Court

Pays for Window Broken During Demonstration in Yorkville Against Nazis

Theodore Egingburg, 26, one of the five German seamen who invaded Yorkville Tuesday morning and tried to be rescued by police with drawn revolvers, was given a suspended sentence yesterday by Judge Jonah J. Goldstein in the East Fifty-seventh Street Magistrate's Court.

Egingburg, wiper on the Albert Ballin of the Hamburg-American line, was charged with malicious mischief. He and four others, including Walter Miller, 24, of the same ship, now recuperating in Bellevue Hospital from lacerations incurred while falling through a broken window, marched through Yorkville Tuesday morning.

Complications arose when Judge Goldstein was obliged to subpoena a German interpreter from Domestic Relations Court who refused to appear of his own accord.

It was made clear by Goldstein Tuesday evening that if Egingburg paid the \$25.00 cost of the window and had shattered his sentence would be suspended. Yesterday morning Egingburg volunteered to pay and the Judge kept his word. Dr. Evingburg's attorney, who expressed surprise that the sentence of his crew could have acted so, but would not state whether the men will be disciplined.

Order Places Jewish Colony In U. S. Control

Federal Aid Withdrawal Faces Hightstown Farm Project

The Jewish farm project at Hightstown, N. J., which was to have received aid from the substance homestead division of the Department of the Interior, will have that aid withdrawn unless some reorganization is placed under the management of that Division, the Association for Jewish Farm Settlements reports, following receipt of an order from Washington.

The government had previously agreed that the Hightstown colony was to be purely a Jewish cooperative venture, as submitted in the plans of the Association.

In direct contradiction to the previous understanding, the Washington order states that all colonies started or financed by the government are to be under direct Federal control.

Term Change Unjust
A special meeting of the association's executive committee resolved that this change of the government's plan was not just, since, the association claims, the government had broken a promise, on the basis of which statements had been made that the project would be under Jewish control and that the government had had applied for information regarding the proposed colony.

A second resolution stated that the selection of colonists will be made entirely without control by any organized Jewish body, and may have an adverse influence upon the future existence of the colony and endanger the ideal.

The change on the part of the administrative body of the division may be part of the general policy in regard to all substance projects, the executive stated, but it does not think the Hightstown colony should be placed in the same category with other bodies of its specific nature.

To Seek Original Plan
A committee will be sent to Washington to explain to officials of the Interior Department the viewpoint of the association and endeavor to return to the original plan.

Members of the advisory board at the meeting were requested by the executive body to resign and take no further part in activities until the question of registration should be settled to the association's satisfaction.

Benjamin Brown, president of the association, resigned, stating he did not consider himself bound by the decision of the board. His resignation was accepted and the action commended.

The work of Jewish colonization in America will continue, the executive group declared, notwithstanding resolutions adopted at the last annual convention of the association.

Dr. Ira A. Kaplan Returns; Studied Cancer in Palestine

Dr. Ira A. Kaplan, director of the Cancer Division of the Department of Hospitals of the City of New York, returned yesterday from the Conte de Savoie from Palestine, where he recently presented 100 milligrams of radium to the Hadassah Institute of Radiology. While abroad, Dr. Kaplan made a survey of health conditions, with particular reference to cancer and the facilities and means for combating the disease in Palestine.

800 Students From 22 States And Canada at Yeshiva College

At a membership meeting for the Yeshiva and Yeshiva College, held in the college auditorium at 180th street and Amsterdam Avenue, New York, last night, Dr. Reviel, president of the college; Peter Wienerick; Rabbi I. Rosenberg, honorary president of the college; and Dr. Reviel, president of the college, were present.

The work of the Yeshiva College of liberal arts and science, Dr. Reviel reported, has been expanded during the year. Formerly open only to students in other departments of the Yeshiva, its courses leading to the degrees of A. B. and B. S. are now offered to all qualified students, with Hebrew subjects as a regular part of the college curriculum.

Two additions have been made to the college faculty, for the academic year of 1934-1935, President Reviel announced. Erich Gutkind, scholar and refugee from Germany, has been appointed lecturer in modern philosophy. Arnold N. Lowan, Ch.E. (Bucharest), Ph.D. (Columbia), and a member of the new graduate institution at Princeton, has been appointed instructor in mathematics.

Onslaughts Against Woolworth Stores Force Closing in Reich

LONDON, June 6.—The series of window-smashing assaults start yesterday against stores of the W. W. Woolworth Company in various cities throughout Germany in order to other cities of the Reich with unacted violence.

Woolworth stores have been shut down in Bonn and Dessau.

The boycotting of Woolworth stores in Frankfurt am Main on the grounds that the stores are "owned by American Jews" resulted today in attacks on women shopkeepers in the stores.

This fever heat aroused by the boycott campaigns resulted today in an extension of the boycott to all Jewish stores in Frankfurt and Nazi pickets today occupied positions at the entrance of all Jewish enterprises.

Today's demonstrations were staged by angry mobs of Nazis spurred by a campaign of inflammatory attacks on the W. Woolworth organization in the German press, in Hirschberg, Lower Saxony. Yesterday violence broke out in Kassel and Bonn.

No mention of the riots has been allowed in the German press. However, the German propaganda ministry, on inquiry of the London Daily Telegraph, is reported to have stated that "the demonstrations may be regarded as a protest against the American boycott of German goods, 'inspired by Jews.'" The Telegraph adds that the protests for the action of the crowds has been disowned by the Nazi authorities in the cities affected.

Supplementing the press campaign, handbills are being circulated throughout Germany since the middle of May, containing violent onslaughts against the Woolworth stores on the ground that it was owned by Jews. The Telegraph comments as follows on the situation:

"These attacks anti-Jews today had little apparent effect on the German people, whose interest in the anti-Semitic campaign is now very slight, except when artificially stimulated."

Zion Immigration Inquiry Is Urged

Commons Hears Plea to End Unrest in Jewish Community in Palestine

LONDON, June 6.—A proposal that an impartial inquiry of the method of issuing labor certificates to would-be immigrants for Palestine be launched there was made in the House of Commons today. The unrest which prevails in the Jewish community of Palestine on account of what is deemed an unequal allotment of the number of certificates issued in view of the labor shortage there, was cited as the motive for such an inquiry.

Sir Arthur Cripps, Minister of the Interior, said in reply to the proposal that Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchop, High Commissioner of Palestine, is the best judge of the relative capacity of the country. He said he doesn't see the need for an inquiry.

New Anti-Semitic Paper Is Published in Turkey

CONSTANTINOPLE, May 22.—A new anti-Semitic paper on Nazi lines has appeared here called "Mill Inkilap (National Revolution)." It is published monthly. The tone of the paper is so violently anti-Semitic that nobody like it has been known before in Turkey. It is full of Nazi propaganda, and all its advertisements are from German business houses in Constantinople.

Synagogue at Worms Marks 900th Birthday

BERLIN, June 6.—The patriarchs in the German Jewry for his fatherland was again brought home today by the rabbi, Dr. Leo Baeck, who, in an address at evening celebrating the 900th anniversary of Worms synagogue, said in part:

"Whatever new Germany's sentiments may be, this synagogue makes us German Jews conscious of our association with this soil, and with future centuries."

He said that he made this statement in the name of the Reichs Vertretung, all German Jewish representative body.

Many Jews Are Represented in Venice Exhibit

Polish, U. S., Hungarian, Dutch and Soviet Artists Show

VENICE, May 15.—The works of a number of Jewish artists are on view here at the biennial International Art exhibition, which opened in the presence of King Victor Emmanuel and many diplomatic and parliamentary officials.

The Jewish artists represented include the two Seydenbeutel brothers of Poland; Harry Gottlieb, Morris Kantor, Leon Krol, Louis Ribak and Herman Trunk of the United States; Avraham of Hungary; Israel Isaac, David Schulman and Jo Koster of Holland; and Brodski and Isaac and Sara Lebedev of Soviet Russia.

Dr. Beppo Rava, Jewish art patron, has established the exhibition's decorative arts pavilion, which is one of the most beautiful at the Biennial, while the American gallery was in charge of Martin Birnbaum, who also arranged some of the American collections exhibited here in former years.

Reinhardt Home Bombed by Nazis

Damage to His Salzburg Residence Not Known; Three Arrested

VIENNA, June 6.—The summer residence of Max Reinhardt, German-Jewish theatrical producer, was the target for bomb throwing supposedly by Nazis. The extent of the damage done the dwelling, situated in Salzburg, was not reported. Police have arrested three suspects.

All Reinhardt theatres were liquidated early in March in accordance with an order issued by Nazi Minister of Propaganda Goebbels, who decreed that Jews were to be ousted from the German theatre. Reinhardt's brother-in-law, Hermann Rosenberg, was dismissed from an administrative post in the Deutsche Theatre.

Since this and other incidents perpetrated by Nazis against Reinhardt has directed plays in various European capitals. In recognition of his services in the art of drama, the Golden Order of Merit was awarded him by the Austrian government.

the German consul general in New York to Carl Dicke, associate in journalism at Columbia School of Journalism. According to Carl Dicke, on the witness stand, he had received this sum from Dr. Klep, the German consul general in currency, "for helping to get out releases for the consul for publication in newspapers."

When Chairman McCormack asked Dr. Dicke "If he paid you \$4,000 to obtain publicity in this country on statements favoring anti-Semitism?" Dicke replied "Yes." Afterwards the witness qualified his answer, saying that the statements covered many subjects other than anti-Semitism.

Dicke also testified that Carl Byoir, his associate, received a monthly fee of \$6,000 for publicity for the German tourist information office, the German railways and steamships, the German Board of Trade and the Leipzig fair. Of this sum George S. Viereck received a monthly salary of \$1,000 and a commission of \$750 a month for having obtained the contract for Carl Byoir and Associates.

Dr. Dicke also testified that Carl Byoir contract with the German tourist information office, inserted in the record, contains the specification that the American publicity firm "will refrain from disseminating any information of news matter which might be of value to the American, Socialist or racial propaganda." Such specification is merely camouflage. Hitlerite Germany is so identified with racial hate that any praise of Nazi Germany is necessarily also praise of its system of religious and racial bigotry and cruelty.

Who are the officers and the takers of funds for disseminating Nazi propaganda in this country?

The first, according to the testimony of the Rev. Dr. Gross, is Dr. Hans Luther, German ambassador to the United States. It is inconceivable that the ambassador himself was so indiscreet as to have committed himself in writing to the fact that he was backing and financing the scurrilous German pamphlet. However, the ambassador is responsible for the acts of the consul general, and witnesses have testified under oath that the German consul general made payments for this pamphlet and for other Nazi publicity.

Dr. Hans Luther was chancellor under the republic. He was also president of the Deutsche Reichsbank. His republicanism was rapidly converted into Nazism. The "republican" chancellor, Dr. Hans Luther, became an ardent and loyal Hitlerite.

The second giver, Dr. Otto Klep, until recently German consul general in New York, was under the republic the head of the press department connected with the German foreign office on Wilhelmstrasse. Then he was appointed councillor to the German Embassy in Washington. Finally he was transferred to New York as consul general. Dr. Klep is a very capable man, minutely familiar with the press and with publicity. In his eagerness to serve his Nazi masters in Berlin he so forgot himself that he personally negotiated with propagandists and publicity agents and made payments for their services while he was the German consul general.

Among the takers thus far mentioned are: the retired Hungarian priest, Franz Graf von Byoir, Carl Dicke and Sylvester Viereck.

The priest wrote and published pamphlets which contained vicious anti-Semitic material for

whatever revenue he got out of the German consulate in New York. He got less than he had hoped, and he expressed his disappointment in his letter to his printer. This priest, who adopted the Nazi attitude toward the Jews, tried to justify himself by writing to his printer "we all shall honestly work to keep the fire of passions already flaming under ashes and try to bring once more harmony into the disturbed relationship between our Jewish element and the present German."

Carl Byoir, who is said to be a Jew, entered into a contract with the German tourist information office to spread its propaganda, which is the propaganda of the Nazi regime, for a fat fee. His Jewish origin did not deter him from undertaking this job. Nor did it deter the Nazi firm using a "non-Aryan" for their purposes of disseminating evilities on Hitlerite Germany, which is endeavoring to exterminate the Jews.

Carl Dicke, an associate of Carl Byoir, admitted having accepted money from the German consul general for disseminating anti-Semitic publicity. Afterwards he issued a statement in which he said:

"The intentions of this firm have always been to allay anti-Semitism and racial hatred and their effects in the United States."

The Nazis in Germany will read this statement with considerable amazement and amusement.

Carl Dicke was recently appointed a member of the advisory council of the Columbia School of Journalism. What inspiring example this type of publicity work will be for the young journalists who are being trained in that splendid school! But we doubt that in the light of his testimony before the Con-

gressional Committee Mr. Dicke will be permitted to continue as a member of the advisory committee of the Columbia School of Journalism.

And as for George Sylvester Viereck, the talented author and publicist, who kept declaring that he was ninety per cent for Hitlerism, but opposed to the anti-Jewish policy of the Nazi regime, it is now established that he has been receiving a monthly fee of one thousand dollars per commission for having signed the publicity contract to the Carl Byoir firm.

In a statement issued after the first day's hearings in Washington, Mr. Viereck says that "it was specifically understood the work involved no anti-Jewish activity in any form."

And he went on to explain himself thus:

"I was a friend of imperial Germany. I was a friend of republican Germany. I was a friend of Adolf Hitler's Germany. I made my standpoint clear long before there was any thought of the Byoir contract."

Mr. Viereck has always been a friend of Germany. Now he is receiving \$1,750 a month for his friendship for Adolf Hitler's Germany.

27-Year-Old Rabbi Appointed To Fourth Term in Columbus

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The Human Touch

Adventures of a Talmudist
HE ARRIVED, one of an impoverished band of Russian refugees, in Seattle, a year or so after the end of the World War, in 1919 or thereabouts. The shipload of human cargo had come from some place like Vladivostok or a Chinese port in China, and he was a sort of home in the land of the Fourteen

Harry Salpeter, the self-determination of nationalities. They had not eaten very well on ships, and the ship, they were not paying guests. Nevertheless, they struck, after which the menu improved considerably.

The person who is the subject of the first anecdote is a Talmud student in the old country. He was a particularly gifted Talmud student; in fact, he might be called something of a Talmudist. But versed as he was in Holy Writ and in the commentaries thereon and able as he was to adjust himself to the most violent circumstances in the life of one time and country, he was no linguist. He knew Hebrew and Yiddish, of course, and a little German, culled from his stay in the Berlin of young days. Having traveled through China and Japan with a pack on his back, and sometimes not even that, but with no Chinese or Japanese to help him on his way, he had made himself somewhat of an adept in the sign language. But not content to keep himself out of an uncomfortable Chinese or Japanese cell when some petty officer failed to be convinced of his perfectly honorable intentions.

One Silver Dollar

Well, this young Talmudist landed in the new world some time after the end of the war with one silver dollar. He knew nothing about the United States except that in the old country it used to be known as "die goldene Medina," and even less about the state of Washington or the city of Seattle. He couldn't read a sign but he could smell a barber shop when he passed one, and he knew that he wanted a shave. He hadn't had a shave in a week. He was well on the way to growing a beard he didn't want, even if he had been a Talmudist. He needed a haircut just as badly but he knew enough about arithmetic to realize that he couldn't have that too and have enough left over for a bite of food and a bed for the night out of one silver dollar. Recalling what he was able to get out of a mark in the Berlin of 1912, he decided that a shave, with a little tip thrown in, would leave him seventy-five cents for the rest of the day.

He indicated by thumb show that he wanted a shave and not down. He remained seated for a long time. There was quite a buzz of activity around him. He was aware of someone fussing with his hands and his shoes and with his crop of hair, but he couldn't always see what was going on, because for much of the time his hands were swathed in hot towels and he didn't want to show too much ignorance by questioning the customs of this strange land. He didn't want to be taken for a greenhorn, even if he didn't know the language—at least not too much of a greenhorn.

A New Man Appears
 But it wasn't very difficult for him to penetrate his disguise. When all his ministrations were over and the towels had been removed from his too-shaven face, he looked at the mirror and saw for all practical purposes, a new

man. He wondered for a moment whether he was himself. Then the barber put a piece of paper in his hand and he wondered what for. It was later that he discovered that on the paper was written the sum of \$3.50, for all of the things he had acquired. When the folding of the piece of paper was finally communicated to our traveler by shouts and gesticulations and resort to plighted English, our Talmudist made some shuffling gestures with his hands, and shoulders. Then one of the men in the shop pointed out that this must be one of the immigrants who had just arrived from the East.

Someone who knew Yiddish was sought. A nearby tailor was summoned to act as interpreter. To him our Talmudist explained that he had only one silver dollar, that he wanted only a shave, that he desired, and needed, other things in return for that solitary silver dollar, and what the devil were they pestering him about anyway?

The whole issue was thrown in to a community conference and it was voted that in view of the currency, and that the devil were they that the party of the first part had received so much more than a shave that he was to pay over to the party of the second part the equivalent of one half of his silver dollar, with the other half of which he was to acquire as much food and shelter as he could in the capacity of that half dollar. And so it was done.

Lincoln Misapprehended

MY FRIEND Leo Katz has made give me somewhat of a clue to the alchemy, habit, or predisposition of Jews to claim non-Jews as members of the race. When he came to this country it was with some knowledge of a shock—and he is not easily shocked—and he came to the realization that perfectly non-Jewish men and women acquired Hebrew names, like Abraham, Simon, Gannabiel, Nehemiah, Joseph, David. I recall now that in my early newspaper days a Mormon missionary informed me that a point is made in Mormon families to name one son after a figure in the Old Testament and clergymen, in the Protestant denomination at least, follow the same practice.

But when he was in Russia, he didn't know all this, for the names of Russian Gentiles are generally Russian, and have no suspicion of Jewishness. Well, long before Katz came to America, he picked up a book, entitled, in Russian, "Abraham Lincoln and the Jew," and read about that the first President of the United States, who, having a Jewish name, he assumed to be Jewish. But there was a definite assurance that this President was a Jew—only his name which, for a Russian Jewish lad, would be called prima facie evi-

British Humor in America

Some months ago there sailed from these shores for England an American company whose purpose was to regale British audiences with a production of the American comedy sketch, "She Loves Me Not." In New York, Howard Lindsay's play had kept the Forty-six Street Theatre filled with both people and laughter but when the same lines came across the footlights of a British theatre they were greeted with almost complete apathy and after a few weeks the play was dropped.

Evidently the producers learned nothing from this, because the other night at the Playhouse, William Brady produced "White Parents Sleep," a very very English farce which it is said kept late Londoners in stitches for months. I am afraid American audiences will receive this comedy by Anthony Kimmins a reception similar to the one given "She Loves Me Not" in London.

It will not be in the spirit of revenge that New Yorkers will stay away from the Playhouse in large numbers but simply because "White Parents Sleep" is a trifle too English for native consumption.

The play deals with the events that transpire in Colonel Hammond's drawing-room and especially what happens to his snobbish wife, his two vacuous sons and their respective although not unprofitable female admirers. One of the sons, Neville, is interested in socialism and the convention. His brother, Jerry, is a naval man, slightly uncouth, lusty and without pretenses.

Neville is planning to go off to some Colonial possession as an aide. He is engaged to marry the wife of his childhood,

while Jerry conveniently jumps home a poor but honest working girl. The two couples plan to spend the night under Colonel Hammond's roof. Lady Catering, wife of the lord, is broadminded. In fact she attempts to seduce young Neville but is caught before she can accomplish her nefarious designs. Jerry's girl friend is much more respectable, which of course gives the author a chance to point out that the poor are virtuous and the rich have all the fun. Anyway, things become pretty complicated, as you can guess from the set-up, but before the final curtain rolls into place almost everything is settled to the author's satisfaction.

Amusing in Spots

As a play "White Parents Sleep" is pretty thin and forced fare. There are amusing lines and mirthful situations but they are few and the interesting gaps are too long. Miss Lily Chase as Lady Catering is good to look at and she interprets her role with tact and skill. Jane Bramley as the poor but honest miss is likewise satisfactory and the rest of the cast are all that could be desired.

"White Parents Sleep" is faintly entertaining but the parents who sit through it all didn't miss very much.

Ibsen on the Hudson

Up on Riverside drive at 103rd Street, in the auditorium of the Roerich Museum, an amateur company is giving until Saturday night a revival of Ibsen's "Hedda Gabler." Amateur companies are ambitious when they attempt to indulge their desire for theatricals in Ibsen plays. They should be praised for their industry and nerve but they should not expect theatrical-globe journey upturns to see them, even though the fleet is in.

Veterans Rap Appeal Drive Linking of Jews In Los Angeles To Communism Nets \$40,000

2,000 in Massachusetts Also Vote in Favor of Nazi Boycott

(Special to the J.D.B.) BOSTON, June 6.—A gathering of more than 2,000 veterans, members of the Jewish War Veterans, Massachusetts Branch, went unanimously on record for the continuation of the boycott of German goods at its annual convention this week at the Hotel Statler. A resolution also was adopted hitting at Communist activities and branding all attempts to limit the Red movement with Judaism as false.

William Bernan, national commander-in-chief, turned teachings of Communism and the spreading of Red propaganda "a menace to all citizens of this country." Meyer J. Rubin of Worcester was elected state commander. He succeeds Harry Mamber of Lynn. Other officers elected include Louis Rosenberg of Lawrence, senior vice-commander; Max Cohen of Lowell, junior vice-commander; Clarence Richmond of Chelsea, Junior Secretary; and Joseph Rosenberg of Brookline, surgeon; and Rabbi Joseph S. Shubow of Boston, chaplain.

Mrs. Josephine Abels of Worcester was elected state president of the women's auxiliary.

Motion Picture Division Reports Progress of Refugee Aid Fund

LOS ANGELES, June 6.—Due to the amazing success of the motion picture division of the local United Jewish Appeal, a campaign which was to begin here on July 9, the "opening" function scheduled for that date is now offically delayed until the "victory dinner." Rabbi Jonah S. Wink, one of the national co-chairmen of the United Jewish Appeal, will be the guest speaker.

Headed by Irving Thalberg, of Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer, the motion picture division, at its initial luncheon last week, secured subscriptions of \$10,000 from members of the film industry toward a total quota for the community of \$75,000.

The Bulletin's Day Book

It is no secret that Dr. Samuel Schulman was retired against his will by Temple Emanuel. This rabbi had no desire to be made an emeritus, even when that position carried with it a life salary of \$12,000 a year. But with the illness of Dr. Kraas, the balance of the Emanuel-EI rabbinical triumvirate was disturbed and the directorate of the temple had for some time realized that its leadership was out of line with the times. It was also a rabbinical truism that no first-line rabbi would come to New York's Jewish cathedral so long as Dr. Schulman was actively connected with it. His age and his definite leadership, coupled with his seniority, were factors that made discretion the better part of valor for the rabbi who was tempted to leave his happy provincial home for the metropolis. It was thus force of circumstances that resulted in the retirement of the late Dr. Hyman G. Enelow and Rabbi Kraas and Schulman.

The retirement of Dr. Schulman, one of the leading lights of the Reform rabbinate, is a loss to the metropolis and to Judaism. His mind is still active, his body agile and his voice quite as overpowering as it was in his younger days. It was a happy thought that resulted in the election of Dr. Schulman to the chairmanship of the Synagogue Council of America.

This organization—comprising the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the United Synagogue and the Union of Orthodox Hebrew Congregations, each with its rabbinical affiliate—had become a Jewish scene. One hears about each of its component parts. One is aware of the American Jewish Committee and the American Jewish Congress, the Jewish Frith is always in the background and the Untermyer Non-Sectarian Boycott League and the Jewish War Veterans are nearly always in the rise of Hitlerism. But rarely does one hear of the Synagogue Council.

This condition is not likely to continue. Dr. Schulman intimated so in his post-election pronouncement. He called it a "unique" in the Jewish field, by reason of its all-inclusive Judaism,

he issued a statement demanding a place for it in the Jewish scene. Particularly did he stress the fact that Judaism, which is a religion, should get a measure of its leadership from its religious leaders. The laity, Dr. Schulman feels—a thought long dormant in his mind—has usurped too great a degree of leadership.

With Dr. Schulman unsharpened by synagogue affiliations and with the council his only interest, one may safely wager that the Synagogue Council will come to life again. And now Dr. Schulman may return from his short period of retirement, a short few months he scarcely expected and did not accept too gracefully.

Speaking about it recently at a meeting of the Board of Jewish Ministers, gathered to pay homage to Dr. H. Pereira Mendes on the occasion of his sixtieth anniversary in the ministry, Dr. Schulman told of an informal conversation with some Jewish leaders in which lay members ruthlessly overruled the council of the rabbinical members.

"I couldn't accept this quietly," Dr. Schulman said. "I suppose I wasn't quite used to being an emeritus yet."

At this meeting Dr. Schulman also told of the message received from Dr. Mendes on the announcement of his retirement. He told of the letter from the aged rabbi which quoted Dr. Gaster's definition of a rabbi emeritus: "A living corpse buried in a silver casket."

"But this," said Dr. Schulman, "doesn't apply to me. I am buried in a gold casket. The last rabbi retired by Emanuel-EI lived to be over eighty. It was a great joke on the trustees."

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Life of North American Jewry in Review

Frankfurter 'Behind New Deal,' Ickes A 'Jew,' and Klan Foams

(Special to the J.D.B.)
ATLANTA, Ga., June 6.—Bemoaning the prominent part Jews are sharing in the present administration as well as the recovery program, the June issue of the Kourier, published here by the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, Inc., in an article captioned "Frankfurter's Jews Staff the New Deal," blames Felix Frankfurter for the relatively large number of Jews now occupying governmental positions.

"The administration of NRA ranks was swiftly and efficiently staffed with Jews," the article says. "It is telling no tales out of school to contend that Felix Frankfurter was among the leading managers to get the Nathan S. Perkins into her job. He seems also to have guided the foot-steps of the young Jew Morgenstern, related by marriage to Herbert Lehman, Governor of New York, on whom President Roosevelt has openly admitted he relies for aid in the selection of his political career—in shaping many of his policies."

Two Billion "Kitty"
Declaring that "Morgenstern has also related by marriage and otherwise to the Seligmanns and Lowys, the 'international bankers' called all through his readers that "Congress supplied this young protegee of Frankfurter with a 'kitty' of two billion dollars to 'control' the currency, usurping power delegate by Congress not to him but to President Roosevelt." Attributing to Mr. Weiner the appointment of Dean Acheson, Morgenstern's as-

sistant, whom the magazine calls a protégé of Judge Brandeis, the article also ascribes to Mr. Frankfurter the selection of Earle Balle for the Treasury Department.

Asserting that he also was responsible for the appointment of Jerome N. Frank as solicitor in the Department of Agriculture the article further attributes to Mr. Frankfurter the appointment of David Lilienthal to the most powerful position in the Tennessee Valley Authority. "To abuse the Jew Ickes," the article continues, "Frankfurter obviously got appointed the Jewish attorney Nathan R. Margold. For Secretary Perkins he evidently produced Charles E. Wynank. J., while Secretary Hull was prevailed upon to accept another Frankfurter protégé, Herbert Feis."

More "Revelations"
Making the "revelation" that Frankfurter has scores of young Jewish lieutenants and associates "fanned out, awaiting Dr. Tag, and that he has already placed about 100 of them in key positions in the different departments of the New Deal," the Kourier declares that "it is also a recognized fact in Washington that no one can be named for these positions without carrying Frankfurter's stamp of approval."

The exaggeration and misstatement of facts in this article is characteristic of the entire magazine. The author's ignorance evidently got the best of him when he referred to the non-Jewish Secretary of Interior as "the Jew Ickes."

It had fifty Chicago and twelve Detroit members, the leader of whom were under the leadership of Walter Hentschel, who is now in Germany.

Gissibl declared he met Heinz Spanknebel in 1932 in Detroit and involved the Teutonia in order to organize with Spanknebel, an American branch of the German Nazi party. In April, 1933, Rudolph Hess, general manager of the Nazi party, dissolved the American branch and at the convention in Chicago in July of former members of the group, Spanknebel formed the Friends of New Germany with himself at the head. As a second in command, Gissibl said, he succeeded Spanknebel on the latter's flight to Germany last October.

He asserted that until March 20, 1934, when he resigned, the membership rose a thousand per cent and is still increasing. The Chicago Nazi, he said, bought the shirts for their uniforms in an army store. When Hartwick asked about drills, the witness only smiled. Asked if he had guns, he laughed outright. He said he wrote last November

to Ernst Wilhelm Bohle, director of Nazi foreign activities in Hamburg, resigning from the German Nazi party in order to remain with the Friends of New Germany. He said he had received no reply from Bohle and decided to return to Germany to take up his matter.

When Gissibl was sworn in by McCormack, he raised his right hand in a gesture identical with the Hitler salute.

A series of cables between Bohle and the Friends of New Germany was read into the record.

Roasts Nazi Spy
In one Spanknebel denounces Schoellbach's installation as a Nazi confidential agent here and terms him irresponsible and a troublemaker. It was dated August 25 of last year.
