#### A Victim of Politics

The Jews of Palestine as well as the Jews of other lands have been shocked by the unexpected verdict in the Arlosoroff murder case and the death sentence imposed upon Abraham Stavsky. The appeals issued by the Laborites and the Revisionists and by Chief Rabbi Kook, calling upon the Jews in Palestine to control their passions at this moment and to maintain order, indicate the sense of responsibility of Jewish leadership in Palestine.

Nothing would please the enemies of Jewish Palestine more than intensified strife and conflict among the various political factions of Palestinian Jewry just now. Conviction of Stavsky for premeditated murder, on the basis of the flimsiest circumstantial evidence, naturally has aroused the Jewish population, by whom both the trial and the conviction are construed as a mysterious political maneuver to discredit the Jews by discrediting the element regarded as most objectionable to the Palestine administration.

It is difficult to believe that the Court of Justice in Palestine would lend itself to political pressure or influence. But unfortunately the course of the investigation and the trial has been marked by most puzzling incidents that have created doubt and suspicion.

The shocking verdict has been appealed. A new trial is almost certain to result in the acquittal of Stavsky. The vast majority of the Jews of Palestine are convinced of his innocence. Every legal effort should be made to save the life of this innocent youth. An adequate fund should be raised quickly for the legal defense of this victim of political atmosphere and intrigue.

The murderer of Chaim Arlosoroff has not yet been found. The Palestine police should concentrate their efforts on finding the real murderer. And the murderer, whoever he may be, Arab or Jew, should receive the full penalty for his dastardly crime, provided his guilt is substantiated beyond any doubt.

#### Viereck's Attempt

The attempt by indirect insinuation on the part of George Sylvester Viereck to divert the attention of the Congressional Committee to the investigation of Communist and Fascist propaganda is a shrewd pro-Nazi move. It is to be hoped that the committee will not permit itself to be misguidedly undertaken the task of former investigating committees instead of

## Nazi Probe Reopens in Newark With Doors Closed to Public

While members of the House committee investigating subversive propaganda activities in this country are digesting evidence of Nazi intrigue uncovered at last week's open hearing in Washington, Representative Samuel Dickstein announced yesterday that he would continue his private investigation in the federal building in Newark, N. J., next Saturday.

This hearing, like the one conducted over the week-end in the Bar Association Building at 42 West Forty-fourth street, will be secret.

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## Afghan Jews Lose Rights Of Citizenship

# Politics Back of Stavsky Verdict Is Charge of World Revisionists

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## Jewish Judge for Condemned Man, Report Shows

JERUSALEM, June 10.—Judge Moshe Valero, Jewish member of the mixed tribunal, which on Friday decreed the death penalty for Abraham Stavsky in the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, voted to acquit the young Polish Revisionist, it was revealed today in an official report of the decision given out to the press.

Thus far no Jew ever has been hanged in Palestine, newspapers point out in comments on the Stavsky verdict.

Zvi Rosenblatt, whom the same tribunal found not guilty of participation in the assassination of Dr. Arlosoroff, youthful Zionist labor leader who was killed on the night of June 16, 1933, left Kfar Saba last night as a measure to

## Portuguese Maramos Given a Holy Scroll By German Jews

BERLIN, June 10.—The Jewish community of Berlin yesterday presented a "sefer torah" (holy scroll) to the Maramos of Braganza, who had asked for one.

The presentation was made in a symbolic ceremony in the synagogue at Heiderstrasse Gasse, where representatives of the community and the Reichvertretung were present. Dr. Jacob Freundman, rabbi, declared during the service that "God hears those who when they are themselves in need of help give help to others."

The symbolic gift of the Berlin community to the Portuguese Jews was the outcome of a recent visit to Braganza by Dr. Alfred Klee, German Zionist leader, to whom the Maramos expressed their desire for a sefer torah.



# Politics Back of Stavsky Verdict, Is Charge of World Revisionists

Rosenblatt fired the shots which felled Arlosoroff, was convicted while Rosenblatt was acquitted, the statement accused the court of "attempting to cover the verdict with a veil of judicial impartiality."

"The verdict is unjust and results from outside pressure of political considerations, being an attempt to extend civil strife provoked by the trial among the Jews, detracting the attention of the Galuth (the Jews outside Palestine) from the anti-Zionist policy of the Palestine government standing in flagrant contradiction to the Mandate."

"The conscience of world Jewry is profoundly shocked by such a deliberate miscarriage of justice and intends to continue stubbornly its fight for its ultimate repeal."

"Hitherto," it asserted, "the Jews condemned the Palestine regime since it was harmful to Zionism. But now we are compelled to fight the administration of justice under the British mandate."

The statement denounces the Palestine police for using stockpiles and for "deliberately" failing to investigate the "confessions" of Abdul Mejid, Arab admitting the slaying. It promises that the executives will support any efforts in "bringing the situation which is approved by both the Palestine court and government to the notice of world public opinion, and also to honest British opinion."

"Discussing other aspects of the case the statement points out that 'the verdict also raises a moral issue for international Zionism, since circles which are closely connected with the present Zionist executive are practically identified with the executive of the Jewish Agency elected at the Eighteenth World Zionist Congress, deliberately staged the trial.'"

## "Libel Influenced Decision"

The decision would have been quite different but for "the campaign of blood and libel" against the Revisionists, the statement charged.

"The tragic though partial success of an un-Jewish, inhuman intrigue would force the immediate resignation of an executive in an organized nation," it continued, "but since the Jews are living in dispersion, and have not the concentrated moral pressure for this, it is necessary to glorify the reconstruction of Herzl's world Zionist organization on a new, clean basis."

The statement continues with greetings to Stavsky, declaring that the Jewish people are convinced of his innocence and will fight "until your honor and freedom are vindicated."

It concludes with an expression of gratitude to Horace Samuel, chief defense attorney, and attorneys Rosenblatt and Rosenblatt for their work in behalf of the defendants in the case.

## Pinkisi Motives

**Statement on Verdict**

Pinkisi, noted Yiddish author and playwright, who was quoted in Sunday's Jewish Daily Bulletin as applauding the Stavsky verdict, yesterday offered an explanation of his stand.

"When your reporter," he said, "telephoned me the news of Stavsky's verdict and asked me for a statement, I did think of the death sentence which this verdict carries with it. I'm an opponent of capital punishment as a matter of principle and hope that this sentence will be changed on appeal."

In his previous statement Pinkisi had said "it was the propaganda of Revisionism of the kind that made the murder possible. . . . We must accept the decision of the court. It is a fair one. The court

had sufficient evidence." Pinkisi was the only one of a score of notables questioned on the verdict who expressed approval of it.

## Revisionist Appeals Against Violence Here

An appeal against use of provocation was issued here yesterday by the Central Committees of the Zionist Revisionist Organization and the Brith Trumpeldor. The appeal warns against "provocations which may emanate from sources seeking to hamper the efforts of leading Jewish circles to do all in their power to bring about the triumph of justice in this case."

"Leading Jewish circles in this country and the world over are deeply concerned about the terrible tragedy of the Stavsky verdict and the grave possible consequences to the Jewish community in Palestine and the future of Zionism," it states. "The leading Jewish circles understand that the release and full acquittal of Stavsky and the triumph of justice will come about if the Jewish people are united for this cause. A sense of national responsibility, self-discipline, and dignified utterances and action are the order of the day."

"Unfortunately, irresponsible individuals, who to our sorrow head non-partisan Jewish organizations, have already resorted to provocative statements. Such statements made at the time when Stavsky's attorney, Horace Samuel, has appealed to a higher court seeking to save the Jewish martyr, Stavsky, from the gallows, may have a detrimental effect on the further developments of the case and perhaps lead to tragic incidents in Palestine and other countries."

"We deem it our holy duty to warn against such provocations. The smouldering fires of interfaith hatreds must be extinguished. Let the sense of national responsibility and the concern for the life of an innocent man guide our actions and utterances."

The verdict was deemed imminent on the part of those who disapproved his exoneration.

"Until when will murderer Rosenblatt walk our Kfar Saba streets?" he hurriedly posted placards, scrawled in handwriting, demanded.

A slight clash resulted when a small crowd attempted to tear down the placards. One of the persons was arrested for attacking the Rosenblatt sympathizers.

**Warnings Are Warned**

All Jewish editors have been warned that their newspapers will be suppressed if they are found to be inciting disturbances in connection with the verdict.

Residents of Palestine, however, were inclined to respect appeals for peace and quiet, issued immediately after the verdict. One was announced by Chist Rabbi I. HaChen Kook, by Revisionists and by the Histadruth (Jewish labor federation).

Mrs. Sima Arlosoroff, widow of the slain Zionist and central figure in the prosecution's fight to convict Stavsky and Rosenblatt, soon will leave Palestine for an unannounced destination.

Rosenblatt was released from jail Friday night. He was immediately taken from Jerusalem to Tel Aviv, where he had previously had resided. The measure was taken to avoid a possible demonstration in Jerusalem. He has been arrested by the Yarden, to refrain from making inciting comment regarding the

## Police Arrest Jews In Vienna Protests

In the Polish synagogue on Sofiatins street, Revisionists demanded that the service be interrupted for one minute, as a protest against the verdict.

## The Disturbance in Castoria

According to a cable from Salonica, Apostos Papazoglou, the principal aggressor in the attack on the Jews at Castoria, Greece, has been arrested. It is reported that measures have been taken to maintain order there and that a careful inquiry is being made by the authorities. Although the prefect declared that Jews have exaggerated the importance of the recent occurrences in Castoria, it is believed that the government is determined to deal drastically with the Nazified Greek organization that started the anti-Jewish disturbances.

American Greeks, Jews as well as non-Jews, former residents of Castoria, were so shocked at the news of anti-Jewish excesses in their native town because the Jews and the non-Jews of Castoria have lived for centuries on terms of friendship, and their relations have never been marred by any manifestations of religious prejudice or hate. It is the recent influence of the Nazi agitation that is held responsible for the first anti-Jewish disturbances in Castoria.

## HIAS Officials Go to Paris; Will Attend HICEM Meetings

Abraham Herman, president, and John L. Bernstein, former president of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society, are on their way from Palestine to Paris to attend the annual Rath shooting of the Hias-to-Biulet rect (HICEM), according to a cable dispatch received by HIAS from its European representative. The session will commence June 17, and will deal mostly with the German-Jewish situation, particularly with regard to the problems facing the Jewish refugees.

Immediately after the Paris meeting Mr. Herman and Mr. Bernstein will leave for Russia, where they will investigate the possibilities of opening HIAS offices there to serve those desiring to immigrate to other countries.

## July Rabbis' Assembly To Ponder U. S. Malice

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# Jewish Life Reviewed in Latest Cables and Letters

## German Courts Argue Right Of Jew to Act as Guardian

BERLIN, May 29.—Whether a Jew is qualified to assume guardianship over a Jewish minor is a problem over which two German courts have disagreed.

According to the Judeische Zeitung of Breslau, a Jewish lawyer of that city was appointed guardian of a minor. Shortly after his appointment he was notified he must not exercise his guardianship and the law court formally dismissed his appointment. There then followed a series of actions which have aroused widespread interest and comment in both Jewish and judicial circles.

**Retrial Ordered**

The lawyer appealed the decision of the lower court, but the decision was upheld by the district court. Thereupon the attorney took the case to the appeal court, which annulled the district court's decision and ordered it to retry the case. The latter again dismissed the application, but it went again to the higher tribunals and a second time the district court's ruling was annulled.

In its decision, the district court held that while the ward was "non-Aryan," like the guardian, "that does not justify the appointment of a non-Aryan guardian."

After considerable legal mumbo-jumbo undertaken to prove through a spurious comparison with the ancient minority rights claims of Jews in Upper Silesia that the German Jews "consciously place themselves outside Germanism," the court reached the interesting conclusion that the guardian could not be capable of adequately protecting the ward.

**Lower Court's Opinion**

"This fundamental position of the Jewish minority in Germany demonstrates that the Jews," the court holds, "contrary to their previous declarations, consciously place themselves outside Germanism."

"It such a state of separation exists between the minority and the State people in general, the interests of those who are appointed as guardians demand that they should be able to relieve this tension. If it is not relieved it would endanger the interests of the ward, and particularly so in this case where the administration of property is involved."

"The complainant in this case appears, however, to be unequalled in this sense, on the one hand, by the existence between the ward as a member of a racial minority and the German people and its members. He has been chosen by the National Socialist Revolution as guardian of his status and actually out of his profession."

**High Tribunal Disagrees**

The higher tribunal countered with the following:

"The entire attitude of the District Court is not in consonance with the attitude of the National Socialist State on the 'Aryan' question. The fact that the law for restoring officialdom does not apply to guardians, that the National Socialist State does not make the circumstance of a person being of Jewish origin a general and fundamental obstacle to his holding any official position, or the position of a guardian, is a fact that the Jewish origin of the complainant is not in itself a ground for his dismissal from his appointment as the guardian of a Jewish ward."

"We must in this connection draw attention to the fact that the government has repeatedly declared itself against any extension of the 'Aryan' paragraph to realms in which it is not intended to apply, and that it has demanded

in all cases that the limits set by the government itself for national and state reasons must be observed.

**Attitude in Conflict**

"The attitude of the district court is in conflict with this since it considers the complainant, by the fact that he is a Jew, as being unable, in his view, to remove existing tension between the minority and the State, and it therefore assumes that he endangers the interests of the ward."

"The fear of the district court that the complainant in his anxiety to prevent prejudicing himself personally will not represent the interests of the ward with the necessary determination would be justified only if there were an actual fact before the court giving rise to such an eventuality, which, again, could be taken into consideration if the complainant were actually threatened with serious consequences, because he had stood out for the interests of his ward with determination. For this there is no basis whatever. It is not visible how far a determined attitude in protecting the interests of this minor might result in a collision between he and the German people."

## Anti-Semite Parley Encounters Snags

**English, Italian, Dutch Fascists Refuse to Participate**

PRAGUE, June 10.—Preparations for Julius Streicher's proposed international anti-Semitic congress are encountering difficulties, reports from Nuremberg where Streicher's publisher, Dr. Sturmmer and leads anti-Semitic incitement, show.

The Fascist group headed by Sir Oswald Mosley in England refused to attend, these reports state, so that there will be no representative of the Fascist element in England, Italian and Dutch. The Aryans have said to have declined the invitation to participate.

On the other hand, the new Nara, or National Radical, party of Poland, the Iron Guard of Rumania and the Clausen group of Denmark are understood to be willing to come to the congress.

As the plans stand now, the Reich government is not to take part in the conclusive 'Aryan' concern itself principally to "finding a uniform method for fighting Jewry."

## Chile Reception Accorded Nazi Paper's Use of Outrage Photo

SANTIAGO, May 21.—El Correo De Valdivia, organ of the German Nazis of Chile, is in a precarious predicament because it inadvertently published a photograph showing Nazi brutality.

To everyone's amazement, the newspaper, which has been conspicuous for its anti-Semitic assertions, appeared with a front-page photograph of the Jewish lawyer whom the Nazis forced to parade through the streets of Munich with a sign reading, "I shall not complain against the Nazis."

The caption over the picture read, "A Victim of Nazi Terror."

## Reich Jews Deny Smuggling Plans

BERLIN, June 8.—Charges that Reich Jews are holding secret meetings with a possible view to smuggling persons and property out of Germany and into Palestine, published in Der Angriff, official organ of Germany's diminutive propaganda minister, Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, have been denied by those directly concerned.

The Judeische Rundschau, speaking on behalf of the hard-riden Jewish population of Germany, publishes a report today in which the so-called "secret meetings" of Berlin's Zionist societies are explained. They were convoked, Judeische Rundschau states, with the permission of the police. They were simply the regular meetings of an innocuous Zionist society. Uniformed troopers were not present, as recorded in Der Angriff. According to the denial, Revisionist hecklers present at the meeting, described in Der Angriff as indicative of the pugnacious inclinations of Zionists, were quickly removed and the meeting proceeded.

### World Intrigue Seen by Gen. Blakeney, Who Advocates 'Control'

MONTREAL, Que., June 10. — "World intrigue is apparent everywhere," declared General R. B. G. Blakeney, British anti-Semitic who passed through Montreal on his way back to England on the last leg of a world tour.

Blakeney, who led and helped organize the original British Fascist party in 1926, stated in part: "There can be no world peace until the Jews are put under control. All governments and Jewish subsidiary states are Jew-ridden. The Jews are behind the trouble in Japan. The Jews seek world domination. War is the Jewish harvest."

He also hinted that the English government dare not exploit "the great oil fields in the Middle East" in Palestine because it is afraid of Jewish intrigue."

He concluded with a prophecy that soon there will be serious trouble in the United States because the "Jews are running the country."

## Christian Official Hits Nazi Torture

**Can Scarcely Be Appreciated by Outside World, Says Hoffman After Trip**

LONDON, June 10.—The "spiritual and mental torture" to which the Jews and "non-Aryan" Christians of Germany are being subjected can scarcely be appreciated by the outside world, Conrad Hoffman, formerly of the Foreign Department of the Young Men's Christian Association, said in an interview on his return from a tour of Egypt, Palestine, the Balkans and Germany.

Hoffmann, member of the Committee on a Christian Approach toward the Jews, said that in Nazi Germany physical violence against "non-Aryans" is not affecting victims so much as the "moral subjection under which they are suffering."

### Hits British Rule as 'Regime of Colonial Bureaucracy'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
GENEVA, June 10.—The Jewish press charged that the Jews of the rest of the world are convinced that the whole work of rebuilding Jewish Palestine under present political conditions is futile. Vladimir Jabotinsky, Zionist Revisionist leader said, in an address to newspapermen attending the disarmament conference here, Jabotinsky charged that the Palestine administration is using Jewish enthusiasm for building up a non-Jewish Palestine, where the Jewish minority is in a ghetto, as it is elsewhere.

"This is not a rejection of the mandate system or a protest against Great Britain as the mandatory power," Jabotinsky said. "But it is a condemnation of the regime of colonial bureaucracy in Palestine."

"Guided by a stubborn belief in the intrinsic fairness of the British nation with regard to the re-establishment of Palestine as the national home of the Jewish people, we have addressed a petition to the League of Nations, to the various governments, to the British government and to the people of Britain, urging the masses of the Jewish people who are in distress, distress for which there is no real solution but that of abolishing 'Jabotinsky's Palestine,'" the speaker continued.

**Transjordanian Essential**

He declared that the opening of Transjordan to Jewish settlement is an essential condition no longer opposed by the Transjordanian Arabs but by the mandatory administration.

"A Transjordanian which would have the same population density as Palestine has room for one and a half million immigrants, while a Palestine on both sides of the Jordan would harbor five or six million," Jabotinsky said. "A political regime which would promote settlement instead of hindering it would in a few decades solve the 'harping' problem of the Jews without harming their non-Jewish neighbors."

## Canadians Map Proof of Nazi Dogma Scheme

### Anti-Fascists Bare Link Between DAWA and Steel Helmets

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
MONTREAL, Que., June 10.—The local Friends of New Germany and the anti-Semitic French-Canadian Steel Helmets are working hand in hand to spread Nazi propaganda throughout the Dominion of Canada, the German anti-Fascist organization here expects to prove in its forthcoming Nazi propaganda expose.

Spokesmen for the anti-Fascist society, the Deutscher Arbeiter Farmer Verband, assert that the local German consul, Dr. Ludwig Kemp, alleged leader of Nazi propaganda in this section of the party, is the backbone of the party. His activities will be brought to the attention of the Dominion government.

Others mentioned with Dr. Kemp are Dr. Walter Lanting, whose church allegedly has been used to foster Nazi activities, and "Fuehrer" George Holzer, recently returned Germany.

To combat the Nazi propaganda, the Deutscher Arbeiter Farmer Verband, which consists of eighteen groups in the larger cities of the Dominion, will publish anti-Nazi literature, launch a series of mass meetings, and will hold a convention Friday, Saturday and Sunday at Winnipeg.

## Dubinsky Elected ILGWU President

## Seattle Jews Commemorate 35 Years of Reform Judaism

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
SEATTLE, Wash., June 10.—This was the year of 1899, Seattle was a city whose main streets were of dirt, with plank sidewalks; a frontier town whose chief public convenience was a horsecar, which proudly ran through the woods to Lake Union. No automobiles had yet been seen in Seattle. The town's principal buildings were wooden, with false fronts. Indians were a common sight.

Amid these surroundings, on May 29, was born Seattle's only Reform congregation—its second congregation at the time. It had been preceded by five years by what was then the city's only Orthodox congregation, Biku Cholim Synagogue. Both stemmed from the same root—Congregation Ahavah Shalom, formed in 1889 and disbanded in 1895.

This week, in an imposing \$85,000 house of worship which adjoins a \$140,000 Temple Center, members of Temple de Hirsch Northwest's largest Reform congregation, gathered at exercises to commemorate the thirty-fifth anniversary of the bringing of Reform Judaism to Seattle and to dedicate Yahzeit plaques for those who, though they have passed beyond, are still remembered.

### Str Old Memories

For a handful of Seattle Jews ceremonies this week stirred old memories—of old days long gone by, when the Seattle Jewish community consisted of no more than 200 families and Temple de Hirsch was begun with seventy members.

Among the "old timers" now grey in the service of the Jewish cause who relived again the now historic moments when the new congregation was founded, were A. S. Hirschberg, Seattle's first Jewish

city councilman, who came to this city forty-four years ago; Emanuel Rosenberg, who was vice-president at the formation of Temple de Hirsch and today holds the same office; Jacob Berkman, Isaac Cooper, Henry Pickard, S. Kreishelmer and Nathan Echelein, hailed as Seattle's foremost Jew.

Heading the celebration are Melville Monheimer, congregation president, Merton Schwabacher and Richard E. Lang and Otto S. Grunbaum, all sons of former congregation officers.

On March 3, 1907, the cornerstone of the present Temple de Hirsch was laid.

## Assembly Hails Hungary's War Against Nazism

### Convention Also Passes Resolution Advocating Stronger Boycott

Two resolutions—one favoring militant cooperation in the boycott of German goods as a protest against the new anti-Jewish legislation, and a second expressing satisfaction with the activity of the Hungarian government toward suppressing Nazism in that country—were among the highlights of the first annual convention of the Association of Hungarian Jews of America at the Hotel Edison, West 42nd street, at the "Times Square, yesterday afternoon.

More than 400 delegates, representing twenty-seven member organizations in the metropolitan area, attended the two afternoon sessions and a banquet at the Hotel Edison in the evening.

While the assembly voiced its gratification at the past record of the Hungarian government in the suppression of the Nazi menace, it somewhat tempered its praise of the regime in a subordinate resolution which urged the Hungarian government to take more vigorous steps to "eliminate numerous clouds" in the form of Nazi out-breaks.

Herman Quittman, who presided at the second afternoon session, also delivered the opening address at the first meeting. He warned Hungarian Jews against thinking of themselves as an entity apart from the Jewish people, and urged strengthening of the Nazi boycott.

Samuel Ohlbaum, chairman of the board of directors, presided at the first session. Rabbi Lazar Weis, president of the American Jewish Congress, and Adolphe Charles Brody, of Bridgeport, Conn., and Max D. Steuer.

Nandor Schneeweiss presented the report of the greetings committee. Messages of greeting were read by Secretary Greenbaum from Gov. Lehman; Rabbi Fevencz of Hungary; Rabbi Herzog, Chief Rabbi of Hungarian parliament; Adolph Frankl, president of the orthodox congregations of Hungary; and Stern Samu, who holds a similar position in Hungarian reform Jewry. Frederick L. Hecksberg, as a personal representative of Mayor LaGuardia, read his chief's message of greeting before the convention.

Poliel, pastor of St. John's Evangelical Church in New York, said that the Germans were working toward the same goal—German unity and German-American unity, but that each had its own method of attaining that unity, and expressed regret that the DAWA delegates might go away disappointed.

Developments at today's meetings are being clouded with absolute secrecy. The full story of the long conflict over the boycott resolution has not been divulged by the press. Some of the delegates have stated confidentially that the resolution is meeting with unexpected opposition.

### Loyalists Win Point

"Be it resolved that we oppose all nations which in any way might pit nationality against race, because this is contrary to the ideals of our country and would undermine our constitutional rights and destroy the peace existing between our citizens."

The above resolution, passed yesterday afternoon, was followed by heated debate on the boycott proposal, which ended when the Congress decided to postpone voting on the latter measure in the evening.

Despite its amendment there continued to be violent opposition to passage of the boycott resolution. Some delegates, it is understood, considered this document a "pious fraud" and urged anti-American Federation of Labor boycott, and demanded amendment of the more aggressive portions.

Opposition was also reported on the part of the deep-dyed Nazi contingent, which was said to be unwilling to stomach the resolution. It is said to be of a character. This latter group would surrender the Congress into the hands of promoters of DAWA interests.

## Perlman Warns Poland Against Nazi Inroads

### Charges Reich Subsidizes Naras at Polish Jews Parley

ASBURY PARK, N. J., June 10.—A warning to Poland that unless it changed its attitude toward the Nazis, Poland would find herself a victim of Nazi conquest was sounded last night by former U.
