"Fantastic Projects"

DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, chairman of the Central Bureau for the Settlement of German Jews in Palestine, has sent a report to the United Jewish Appeal, in which he refers to "fantastic projects" to settle large numbers of refugees in such lands as Angola and South Africa.

Dr. Weizmann writes, in part, as follows:

"In the search for a new homeland for German Jews, adventurous and fantastic projects have been eagerly brought up, whilst the great opportunities which Palestine offers to them as to others are persistently overlooked. We are told that Palestine is too small, and fantastic schemes are constantly being sprung on us which speak of remote territories where to receive immediately millions of Jews. Names of exotic countries are tossed at the public and plans involving millions are lightly—and without any shred of expert knowledge—discussed. We have never claimed that Palestine as it is today is capable of receiving immigrants in the millions. What we did, and still do claim, is that the absorptive capacity of Palestine, even of Palestine as a part of the Jordan, could be increased many times over."

According to Dr. Weizmann's report 11,000 German Jews settled in Palestine during 1933 and an additional 4,000 refugees entered Palestine thus far this year.

The "adventurous and fantastic projects" referred to by Dr. Weizmann have not even been considered seriously, as far as we know, and immediately upon the publication of the Angola project in a London newspaper, the Joint Distribution Committee, the I.O.A., as well as High Commissioner McDonald denied categorically that such a plan was being seriously considered.

There can be no doubt that Palestine today is the most logical and most practical solution to the problem of the German Jewish refugees. The dreamers of Zion turned out to be the most frightened and the most practical leaders in Israel, as evidenced by the Jewish achievement in Palestine and by the asylum which that little country is now in position to offer to the victims of anti-Semitic persecutions in Naziland.

Dr. Weizmann has been more instrumental than any other Jew in obtaining the Balfour Declaration and thus making possible the rehabilitation of Palestine. But the Balfour Declaration and the plan have been subjected to various interpretations by the Colonial Office and by Prime Minister MacDonald during the past years so that the unforeseen obstacles have been placed in the way and Jewish immigration to Palestine has been limited to a most deplorable

German-American Trade Board Acts to Force Amity on U. S.

The Board of Trade for German-American Commerce, which is ten years old and feels its age, is badly in need of teeth and Dr. Albert Degener has come to Germany in quest of complete upper and lower plates, the Jewish Daily Bulletin learned yesterday.

The board, an organization whose membership is "confidential" and whose deliberations are carried on in meeting places which are "never revealed beforehand," has instituted a campaign to fight the boycott of Nazi goods by American firms.

Dr. Degener, secretary and full-time working head of the board, whose title, in the words of his

own assistant, represents "one of those German University Ph.D.'s," sailed Saturday aboard the Stuttgart for Berlin.

Will Go Into Huddle

One of Dr. Degener's purposes while he is in Berlin, according to Julius P. Meyer, board chairman, will be "to confer with the Deutsch Amerikanischer Wirtschaftverband, German affiliate of the local organization, with the avowed aim of promoting German-American trade amity."

Herbert Denies Charges Filed With Mayor by Simon

Charges that racketeer control of Schoechet Union, Local 440, has made it impossible for slaughterers from the Vaad Schochiet Union or other union groups to obtain employment are the feature of the report on the investigation into the kosher poultry situation on which Mayor LaGuardia is studying today.

The report filed by Arthur Simon, is based on an inquiry begun March 16 at the direction of Mayor LaGuardia, following complaints lodged with the Health Department by the Vaad Schochiet Oifis.

The report alleges that officers of the union, replaced on June 1 as the scope of the investigation became apparent, were "an unscrupulous lot—especially the delegate at large, one Charlie Herbert."

Browbeating Means Used

Schochiet not affiliated with Union Local 440, the report alleges, were "coerced, brow-beaten and intimidated," as a means of forcing them from their jobs into the union, or else their employers were harassed by oppressive measures resorted to by teamsters groups and other trade unions.

It was Mr. Altheimer who, in 1910, first conceived the idea and at whose suggestion President Woodrow Wilson said June 14, as national holiday in 1916. In 1927 he was awarded the Cross of Honor by the United States Flag Association.

Trial of Seven Reveals Achmeier Kept Eyes Peeled for Dictator

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, June 13.—Evidence was produced at today's session of the trial of seven Zionist Revisionist leaders, including Achmeier, who are charged with advocating and encouraging the overthrow of the Palestine government, purporting to show that Achmeier had been in search for a "Mussolini for the Holy Land." The trial is being held in the Jaffa District Court which has become a focal point for the eyes of Palestine's Jews, who are not a little concerned over the outcome of the proceedings.

A police officer who was on the witness stand during today's hearing testified that a letter had been found at the home of one of the Revisionists reading in part:

"The Jews have been in the hands of Achmeier, who is looking for such an individual."

The Revisionist whose name is mentioned is charged of complicity in the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, labor leader, who was shot on the seashore at Tel Aviv on the night of June 16, 1933. Achmeier was Zol Berenblatt, another Revisionist. Abraham Slavsky, another member of the party, was convicted of complicity in the murder of Dr. Arlosoroff.

Demonstrators Quelled, Workers' Quarters Invaded

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, June 13.—Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Nazi Minister of Propaganda, arrived here this afternoon by airplane to deliver at the University of Warsaw a lecture on the aims and purposes of the National Socialist movement. Goebbels was accompanied by a party of German officials and Nazi journalists. The entire party was heavily guarded by Polish police because of the storm of protest and indignation which the announcement of the visit had aroused.

Presumptions taken by the police against disorders attendant on demonstrations against the visit of Hitler's ally, included the closing of the public parks. Labor organizations attempting to distribute anti-Hitler proclamations in the streets of Warsaw found themselves prevented from doing so by the police, who rushed all distributors of the leaflets off the streets.

Headquarters of the labor organizations and of the Jewish youth groups, including the Zionist youth organization, were occupied by police guards to prevent any massing of groups for demonstrations.

Protests against the appearance of Goebbels, "evertheless, took many forms. The League for the Rights of Man made public a resolution against the visit of Goebbels "at a time when the Hitler movement here is raising its head in imitation of the German example."

Jewish Papers Protest

Jewish intellectuals who had been sent cards of admission to the lecture followed by the example of Jewish newspapermen in refusing to attend.

Viereck's Nose Rubbed in Mud By His Erstwhile Collaborator

Paul Eldridge Pens Masterly Vituperation of 'Cringing, Three-Faced' Hiredling of Hitler's Hate-Ridden Reich

In a brilliant, stinging article in the June issue of Panorama, a magazine published in Boston, the Editor of the United States has figured so prominently in the Congressional investigation of Nazi intrigue in this country and who has attacked the United States mouthing admiration for Hitler in one breath and complete freedom from anti-Semitism in the next, he was so exposed and thoroughly defeated as "a cringing scound," a "trickster" and a "man with three masks."

The author of the article is Paul Eldridge, erstwhile collaborator of Viereck in literary ventures. Eldridge, a Jew, will never again collaborate with Viereck, judging from the vitriolic nature of his attack on the Hitler swastika-singer.

The article, captioned "George Swastika Viereck" is in the form of a direct "answer to a speech delivered in Madison Square Garden by the DAWA leader May 17, wherein the monarchist-republican-fascist chameleon and foe of liberty proclaimed his hymn of hate."

Excerpts from Article
Excerpts from the article follow:

"When I read quotations from your speech in the various newspapers, I thought: The young Narcissus grown drunken as he saw his image in the ripples of the fountain; the middle-aged one who is drunken as he watches his name shimmer on the front page, and my indignation turned to disdain. When I read, however, you sent me a typewritten copy of your entire speech delivered at the Madison Square Garden. It was an answer to the brazen challenge. I must take up my cudgel once more."

"You have lived for a half-century, George Sylvester Viereck. He who does not grow turns into a repellent dwarf. There is no grace after maturity, no 'virtu' save truth and courage. You lack lamentably both."

'A Cringing Scound'
"You claim you believe in the New Germany, but you dare not become a member of the League of the Friends of New Germany, you dare not become a member of the United German Societies, you dare not enlist in DAWA. Your opening paragraph shows you a cringing scound. You say, 'I am the friend of Germany under the Republic and I am today a friend of Hitler's Germany.'"

"How easy it is for you to turn your coat, to learn new shibboleths!"

"George Sylvester Viereck—your speech is a mass of lies, packed with parties of truth, the strong condiments to hide the foulness of the meat. You have made of truth a wooden stick with which you beat the lying bolting cauldron of falsehood without blistering your fingers."

"I am not and will never be an anti-Semite!"

"What a grotesque and incongruous refrain in a cacophonous litany of hate! You declaim against the Jews as bigoted racists who have brought about a reign of terror in America . . . as a racketeer of race hatred . . . as a man who has sold out to the bankers, and you marvel at the equanimity with which Germany and her friends in the United States at home dish out the provocation of insult and abuse, and you end with

"We don't want to fight But by Jingo! If we can't win we've got the votes, We've got the courage too! We can't and never will be an anti-Semite!"

the pockets of those who spread it! I shall give you my answer: There are scoundrels in all camps! . . .

"George Sylvester Viereck, I have spoken to you about the Jews because your speech was an arraignment against them. But the truth of the matter lies elsewhere. You have been instructed by your superiors to hate the people to the real issue. The real issue is not the Jews. The real issue is tyranny versus civilization. The Jews are the only people who would indeed be "aligned" as you put it, but you know that it is a boycott by all labor, by all artists, by all writers, by all scientists, poets, by all workers who having at last achieved a modicum of freedom, refuse to be made the property of a new generation destined as fodder for the cannon. You know all this, but you dared not breathe the word."

Brands Him with Shame

"You dispute the statement made 'that Germany under Hitler has returned to the law of the jungle' . . . the law of the jungle is an eye for an eye—a tooth for a tooth."

"Verily, the law of the jungle does not hold true, for in the land of Hitler it is an eye and a limb from him who has not plucked another's eye and not torn another's limb."

"It would require more than a passing sentence—chapters—nay, volumes—to rationalize your activities during the World War, your present activities so that the world may recognize in you a hero and a super-patriot. George Sylvester Viereck!"

"To pursue you further in your subterranean, muddy paths of empty words and insincere postures would be futile and altogether unprofitable. All your steps lead to the lair of the wild beasts who rule a once cultured and civilized nation."

"If history ever records your name, it will say: George Sylvester Viereck preferred darkness to light, falsehood to truth, and lies to justice, to reason, a world of slaves to a world of freemen and will brand your memory with one word: 'Shame!'"

Minneapolis Rabbi Will Study Situation Of European Jewry

Rabbi David Aronson of Beth El Synagogue, Minneapolis, was aboard the S. S. Drottningholm today, en route to Gottenborg, Sweden, which he will use as a starting point for a study of the effect of nationalist movements on Jewish residential areas of eastern Europe. The Drottningholm sailed from New York Tuesday.

From Gottenborg Rabbi Aronson will journey to Leningrad, spending one month in travel in the USSR. He also will visit Poland and Austria, returning to this country in mid-August to rejoin his congregation in Minneapolis.

Where Will He Turn Up Next? Trade Journal Asks of Byoir

An editorial administering a verbal spanking to Carl Byoir and Associates is published in the latest issue of Editor and Publisher under the title, "Nazi Slingers Stung." Members of the publicity firm testified before the House committee investigating subversive propaganda that their organization had collected \$108,000 under a contract to publicize Nazi propaganda in the United States.

Criticizing what is termed the "come-out" game, the editorial denounces publicity agents who serve colonial diplomats and bribe the people who harbor the fatuous notion that for a few thousand dollars one can buy public opinion through an easily exploited press. The editorial adds that Byoir knew when he made the contract with Germany that newspapers would not print his pamphlets.

"He fairly rolls in money," continues Editor and Publisher, "and if you will stop and listen, you will tell you of his riches in terms to make any racketeer turn green with envy. You can never tell where Byoir will break out next. We have seen him in the magazine business, the patent medicine game, with Creel on the committee on public information, tied in with anti-semitic advertising people to cooperate with the A. F. of L. and thus magically restore national prosperity in time of deep depression. . . . The boy is full of bright ideas."

able extent even at this time Dr. Weizmann could instead exert his great influence and energy to persuade the British government, the Colonial Office and the Palestine administration to abandon the restrictionist policy and to open the doors of Palestine for those unfortunate German Jewish refugees who have become homeless because of ruthless religious and racial persecution and who should be admitted to Palestine for according to the Churchill White Paper of 1922, "Jews may enter Palestine as of right and not suffer any special restrictions."

Palestine's prosperity has been made possible by Jewish initiative, Jewish labor and Jewish investments. The present arbitrary restriction of Jewish immigration to Palestine is quite indefensible.

Dr. Weizmann is attacking the "fantastic projects" of new settlements for Jews in the millions. But these projects are imaginary. Dr. Weizmann is wasting his energy in fighting schematics rather than irresponsible sensation-mongers.

Austria Lists a New Criminal—The 'Trade Trespasser'—A Jew

New Business Law Strikes at 'Emulation in Trade'—When Jew Closes Business He Must Receive 'Authentication for Qualification' to Resume

VIENNA, June 3.—A new class of "criminal" has arisen in Austria—the "trade trespasser." Until recently it was imagined that the only form of trespassing was walking without permission on another man's ground. Today, when unemployment is so rife and competition in trade has become an offense similar to trespassing.

It was in this spirit that the "Gewerbepasser" or trade law was introduced in Austria. When a man is forced to close down his business he is unable to start out in a new branch owing to the trade ban. He must first obtain from the authorities what is known as a "Befähigungs-Nachweis," or "authentication for qualification," for launching out in a new enterprise.

'Strike the Jew'
When the "trade ban" was introduced in Austria some time ago it was foretold in economic circles that its primary aim was to increase at a devastating rate. In effect, the "Gewerbepasser" has meant the hermetic sealing of the only door to reemployment of thousands of Austrian citizens. Today, with the new trend of political feeling, the Jew is the person who is most severely hit by the ban.

A new factor in the economic conflict has arisen. Trade regulations have been tightened up in such a way that many businesses which have been established for years are suddenly prevented from continuing in one or other of the most important branches of the commerce, since they do not themselves without the necessary "authentication for qualification." This authentication, however, has nothing to do with real qualifications.

'Ostjude' Excluded
An Ostjude today, if he attempts to obtain any necessary authentication, finds from the outset that he is excluded. That wonderfully vague word "Bodenstaendigkeit" which can be translated by the botanical term "hysteresis," plays an important part in present day Austria. "Originated from the soil"—and if you have not "originated from the soil," you are not "Bodenstaendigkeit"; that means that you have nothing in common with the traditions of Austria since you have not the unfortunate to arrive after 1914. Being a foreign element, you have no rights to a livelihood. So the Ostjude, who until a few months ago was a patriotic Austrian, bringing his children up to respect Austrian culture and Austrian traditions, now finds himself in a similar position to his fellow Jew across the German frontier. The difference is, that in Austria the present regime does not believe in the Ostjude, like in Germany, but in the silken glove, and little is known abroad of what is happening.

So the Ostjude is not "Bodenstaendigkeit" and finds it impossible to obtain authorization to trade. His only alternative to starvation is to try and trade without the necessary authentication. Then he becomes a criminal.

The Trade Ministry grants traders authorizations only after the sanction of the cooperative. These, however, are not merely preventing Jews from obtaining the authorizations, but are taking proceedings against "trade trespassers."

The latest method adopted for hounding out unfortunate alleged

Jewish trade trespassers is to print lists of names in the newspapers. The Wiener Montagsblatt, which is the Monday edition of the Christian-Socialist Reichspost, has just printed a list of Jewish, and particularly Ostjude, names of persons alleged to be trespassing in the clothing industry. The paper adds the following significant remark: "A general razia of the business founded by Eastern Jews who migrated to Vienna during the war fifteen years ago and have been given home rights by a Marxist Municipality, would give a most elucidating picture."

Bulgar Premier Pledges Jews Their Rights

Receives Delegation and Promises Aid for Jewish Schools

SOFIA, May 29.—A friendly reception was accorded a delegation of Bulgarian Jews who paid a visit to Premier Kimon Georgiev, the chief of leaving his attitude on the Jewish question. The delegation represented the Central Consistory of Bulgarian Jewry and included Haim Palach, president of the Consistory, Jacques Pardoff and Buca Manohah.

After voicing the hope of the Jewish community that the new government will be successful, delegation members said the Jews of Bulgaria anticipate the same political and religious freedom which was theirs under preceding governments.

The virtues of the Jewish people were praised by the Premier, who said he is aware of their fealty to the country. He said that he will attempt in every way to assure these rights to the Jews, and added that he will not tolerate friction between one section of the population and another. He pledged his aid in obtaining a substantial grant for the continued support of Jewish schools in Bulgaria.

German Jews Undergo Fast Change of Opinion As Regards Palestine

PARIS, June 3.—One of the most striking changes that has taken place recently in the viewpoint of German Jewry toward Jewish questions is to be found in the attitude toward Palestine, writes Der Morgen, German daily, commenting on the results of Nazi rule.

Formerly the German Jew regarded Palestine as a place suitable only for the "unfortunate eastern Jew," and one entirely unfit for the German Jew, who thought that next to Germany no country could ever be a Jewish home. The last year has completely changed Jewish opinion on the matter.

"Palestine" is now no longer thought of as merely a Jewish spiritual center, but German Jewry is looking to it as the most admissible place in which to take up their residence, as so only hope of German Jews for the future, the paper states.

Viscount Praises Jewish Hospital

London Institution Has Kept Up Its Standards, He Notes as President

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)
LONDON, May 22.—The hospital has a fine record, especially in that it has not restricted its activities," Viscount Esleigh, president of the London Jewish Hospital, said at the annual Court of Governors of the London Jewish Hospital. "I hope that my association with the hospital will see a continued period of fruitful activity."

"Even in these difficult times the London Jewish Hospital has refused to reduce its standards of efficiency," Dr. A. Goodman Levy, the chairman of the Council, said. "In 1933 there was a deficit in the maintenance account of £3,400, £21,600 having been spent on running expenses."

"There is a not unnatural tendency on the part of donors to want to endow the hospital in perpetuity; but may I say that while an unconditional and free gift of £500 is invaluable, a perpetual income of £50 per annum is £7,500 to the bank, but in spite of existence. We have a debt of comparatively insignificant. Actually the gift is just as perpetual, donations of the hospital's continued because it ensures the very fundamental difficulties we have closed no beds, refused to see no patients. Indeed there has been some expansion for we have set up our own pathological department. A total of 1,611 in-patients were admitted during the year, and 69,000 out-patients attended the hospital.

"The indication is that the hospital tends to become more Jewish, not only the medical staff, but the patients' too."

"Within our limited powers we have been able to do something for German refugees; for although we are not a recognized teaching school, a number of German students and doctors have attended the hospital in an unofficial capacity."

Leon Rueff, treasurer, said forty per cent of the hospital's income was derived from institutions and patients' contributions, and sixty per cent from voluntary contributions.

Challenge Jews To Stamp Out Anti-Semitism

Carpatho-Russia Head Puts Burden of Fight on Community

PRAGUE, May 29.—"The province of Carpatho-Russia has a neat little anti-Semitic problem which has challenged the efforts of the Jewish community to stamp it out."

M. Roszypal, president of the province, a short time ago summoned representatives of the Jewish community in Zaborod, capital of the province. He told them in no uncertain terms that he will not be responsible for the growth of the anti-Semitic movement here. He said, in less bluntly, that if the Jewish community wished to combat the movement it was up to the community to take steps to amend the situation as best they could.

The Juedische Stimme, printed in Munkacs, in sharp editorial comment objects to the attitude taken by the president of the province, and avows the belief that it is the duty of the government to take a hand in the effort to stamp out racial hatred.

Committees are being organized by Jews in the community, says the Juedische Stimme, but support by authorities is necessary.

London Honors Arlosoroff at Memorial Rally

Trebled Effort Is Called Best Form of Tribute by Weizmann

LONDON, June 13.—Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, Zionist labor leader who was slain in Palestine one year ago this week, was honored today at memorial services held in the offices of the Zionist Executive here.

Dr. Chaim Weizmann, head of the Zionist campaign to settle German Jewish refugees in Palestine, delivering the principal address at the services, declared that Palestine is erecting memorials to Arlosoroff in the form of settlements and institutions.

"But the greatest memorial is the void he leaves behind," said Dr. Weizmann with emotion. "We must carry on and best honor his memory by trebling our work."

Beri Locker, Zionist labor leader, deplored the circumstances surrounding the death of Arlosoroff which, he said, "reopen the wound anew every day and make references to his death difficult."

Dr. Selig Brodetsky, head of the political department of the Jewish Agency, dwelt on the work and aims of Arlosoroff on behalf of a Jewish national home in Palestine.

Arlosoroff's chief object was cooperation with Britain, the Arabs and others, he said. He expressed a hope that we shall be able to establish internal cooperation in all quarters.

Zionists to Mark Arlosoroff Death

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The Human Touch

These Barren States

THERE is shortly to be published "The Provincial Lady in America," by E. M. Deland, an English novelist who recounts her travels in diary form, the record of an American lecture tour and a sight-seeing trip which included the World's Fair at Chicago, Niagara Falls, the Cotton Club in Harlem, the Alcott home outside Boston and a couple of other places.

Now a country visited for the first time is only as good, or as bad, as the men and women in it whom it meets. Mrs. E. M. Deland met many men and women, friends of friends, celebrity-hunters, persons of wealth and what is called "social prominence" who affect a patronage of the arts, Little Thinkers, persons who know what they want, autograph-hunters, boys and maidens, good-hearted and hospitable most of them. She met many of the Right People who turned out to be definitely the wrong people.

She met men and women mostly whose range of literary conversation was limited to "Have you read 'Anthony Adverse'?" and since she hadn't, conversation had to come to a full stop, to be retrieved by some question no less than "What do you think of 'Hugh Walpole'?" The nearest approach she made to an interesting person was Alexander Woolcott, who impressed her strangely by his internecine manner. Deland's telephone with a magazine editor who wanted an article Woolcott didn't care to write. But the happy Jews in her stay at the hotel during which she had a good cry over the moving picture version of "Little Women."

"What can I tell, Mrs. Deland traveled as far west as Chicago, as far north as Buffalo, as far east as Boston and as far south as Washington, D. C., meeting a single Jew. She was so thoroughly chaperoned and directed and managed and taken in hand that she had not an hour for private exploration. The nearest she came to meeting a Jew was in overhearing a fossil at a dinner party in New York, who was a crotchety exactly like Gladstone's, assert that "no club would dream of admitting Jews to its membership." She added: "This, if true, reflects no credit on the club," recalls Lewis Browne's discovery that a Jew-excluding club will usually admit up to a maximum of three Jews in order to keep out the charge of anti-Semitism. It would be interesting to learn the identity of the old fellow in white "cocktail" and "diamond" gramophones and modern young people are—like Jews—never admitted."

Impersonal Talk Wanted

If Mrs. Deland, who seems to be a bright and observant person and a sometimes brilliant novelist, didn't have the good time she described during her visit to these States, I think the reason is that she met too many people like this Old Fossil and the old one-sided in Washington, men and women who were inordinately opinionated, and not enough fellows of Alexander Woolcott's caliber. If she had met at least ten Woolcotts, four of them, I venture in all racial modesty to suggest, would have been Jews and whether they were Jews or not, they would have given her conversation for her teeth to sink into instead of asking the same banal questions and making the same banal statements. Where was Walter Lippmann and F. P.

A. dining on the nights of Mrs. Deland's dinner parties? I don't believe it was much to the Jewish people of America whether or not the "provincial lady" had a good time in America. But if Mrs. Deland ever comes to these States again, she ought to be provided with conversational opportunities better than that afforded by the gushing Ella Blatts for whom neither literature nor impersonal conversation ever existed. Perhaps it is possible to see America without seeing a single Jew, but unless you meet at least a few Jewish intellectuals in New York, you cannot know all that New York may have to offer on the higher levels.

Thomas Mann's Surprise

I HAVE learned, thus belatedly, what single episodes during his American visit gave Thomas Mann his greatest surprise. From the manner in which he spoke of it later it is doubtful if he has got over it yet and should not undertake to write either a book or an essay on his American visit, he would undoubtedly give this episode as a horror and nuisance.

The members of a club limited to the executives of a New York newspaper august enough to be an institution gave Thomas Mann a luncheon. There is, of course, nothing astonishing in that, and he maintained his savoir faire. But the point at which you could see his surprise was when the members of this club arose and drank the health of Herr Mann—in loud voices.

Being inured to the customs of this country, I am neither surprised nor shocked. The value of a visiting celebrity is that through his eyes we are able to make new assays of our customs and ourselves which we have long taken for granted. The chief value Lemuel Gulliver offered to the Lilliputians was his knowledge of the Yahoos whom he visited, who took for granted their customs until they could see them afresh through Gulliver's intelligence. The mere fact that Thomas Mann should express surprise at the drinking of his health by loud voices immediately raises the question of the custom suspect—and certainly in a land from which the blight of Prohibition has been removed.

We can only hope that when Thomas Mann lands on European soil—he ought to be there any hour now—he will enrich the recollection of the food water toast in bumpers of good non-German beer, or, if that doesn't serve in a draught of wine. And under the circumstances, he will recall the food water toast as a symbol of Western individuality. I'm sure there would have been a wider world for him in the States had he paid us his first visit during the good old days of Prohibition.

As I walk the streets in melancholy state of mind, occasionally listening to all kinds of speeches, political, economic and social, I am often asked for my humble opinion as to "who is to blame?" or "what should be done?"

Here I am in desperate need and chaotic state of mind and people ask me whether the government, the capitalists or the capitalists are to blame. I cannot answer intelligently since all there is on my mind is the need to get a job.

Wherever I go to the street, the first question they fire at me is "What nationality are you?" And if I tell them I am an American, they just laugh at me. And if I tell them I am a Jew, they simply and politely (in my case) take my name and address and later merely throw it in the "wastebasket."

I am what I am. I am neither proud of it, nor ashamed of it. Looking around I see some Jews who are "made men," that is, successful in this country of equal opportunities. Some are still working to achieve that golden elusive diadem "wealth" or mere-

ly want a living. Some are, of course, as you will find in any other nationality, just plain trouble makers, that is, they are never satisfied. So going back to corner speeches, and listening in that abstract state of mind, I am often asked, "What is your political, communist or socialist or some other 'ism'?"

However, I fully realize that my abject poverty does me no lie among those human apostles of hypocrisy and opportunism.

And that's why I'm resorting to this form of appeal. I give you a brand, and to save if possible a decent young man from becoming a human jackal.

I sincerely hope that this appeal will not go unheeded.

High Commissioner at Testimonial Tea Says Situation Is Bad

"In one or two countries of Eastern Europe Jews are facing possibilities more terrible than anything that has happened to them yet," High Commissioner James G. McDonald, of the League of Nations German Refugee Body, declared yesterday afternoon at a tea in his honor tendered by the board of directors of the People's ORT Federation, at the Advertising Club, 23 Park avenue.

When he first undertook his task, the High Commissioner told his audience, he realized that a most democratic approach was essential in order to win the support and confidence of Jewry the world over. Today, Mr. McDonald said, there is a feeling of unity among Jews for the time being, which he said was a "contribution which the Nazis made to Jewish life."

One of the great problems confronting him is the orientation of the Jewish people toward a new kind of life. We must make people work with their hands, do things that are fundamental," said Mr. McDonald, who pointed out at that point, Mr. McDonald said, "In a larger sense, ours is a problem of rehabilitation, of retraining."

Seek Ban on Jewish Lawyers

Coincident with the visit of Dr. Goebbels, the National Polish Lawyers Association, which is affiliated with the National Democratic party (the Endeks), announced in the Gazeta Warszawa today that it will commence a blacklisting of Poles retaining Jewish attorneys to represent them.

The association, in a public appeal, urged the elimination of Jewish lawyers from practice at the bar in Poland.

Premier Kosciuszko, who was today to have granted an audience to members of the Club of Jewish Deputies in the Sejm with reference to the wave of excommunication by the National Radicals (Naras) against the Jews, announced that he was unable to receive the Jews and would receive them Monday.

Although the police announced that they had closed the Nara headquarters in the Piotrkow district where the Nara had been very active, the Szefsteta, Nara newspaper, today denied this. The Telegraphic Agency established that the Nara organization is opening other headquarters in the district.

Police Examine Revisionists

The police today summoned all members of the National Committee of Revisionists, a Zionist group, and of the Brith Trumpeldor, Revisionist youth group, and cross-examined them about organization work in the Warsaw district to protect the Jews from Nara attacks. To date, although the government promised to suppress excommunication of Jews, it has not acted, and all parts of the population from illegal attacks, the interest of the police has been centered about equally on the Nara and preventing the Jews from adopting measures for their own protection from the hoodlums bands of Nara youths.

Russia, gave a report ten years work of his organization.

Mr. Hyman's report reviewed that for the year 1933 and the first months of 1934, the Joint Distribution Committee expended approximately \$1,320,000 in various phases of German relief work. A little under \$500,000 was allotted for aid within Germany, and more than \$500,000 was given to various refugee aid committees and in cooperation with the High Commissioner and the League of Nations, spent for the continuance of vital work in Eastern Europe, aggravated by the return of thousands of repatriates from Germany.

Developments Encouraging

"Subventions have been given," the report continues, "not alone to Jewish committees, but also to organizations like the Country and National Student Service, International Committee for Securing Employment for Professional Refugees, Emergency Committee for Aid of Displaced German Scholars, Emergency Committee in Aid of Displaced Foreign Physicians, etc., all non-Jewish, but large national or district committees."

"One of the most encouraging developments of the year 1933 has been the new spirit given to the work of our Junior Division by Miss Pauline Barwald, its chairman. The Junior Division has been the highway in many communities of the country and bids fair to attract, to an intelligent understanding of our problems and to active participation in the relief work of the younger people of our communities."

"It is gratifying also to report that under the leadership of Dr. Charles G. Rosenberg, vice-chairman of the Junior Division, support of a number of Jewish organizations, the German Jewish Children's Aid has been incorporated, to make arrangements for such German children as will be sent here, to be cared for and trained in this country in the homes of Jewish adopted families. We have cooperated closely with the Committee, and your Secretary is likewise the Honorary Secretary of that organization."

The report also devoted leadership of Professor Joseph P. Chamber-

lain, a Solomon member of the Governing Body of the High Commissioner for Refugees, there has been established the National Coordinating Committee for Aid to Refugees and Emigrants Coming from Germany, on which are represented the various Jewish agencies in this country interested in the situation of German refugees and immigrants in the United States. It is planned that this organization will not only coordinate activities of such groups here, but will also centralize the contact with the High Commissioner. The Joint Distribution Committee is cooperating with the Coordinating Committee."

In conclusion, Mr. Hyman quotes paragraphs from the Wopod of the German Jewish leaders themselves on the work of the Joint Distribution Committee:

"It is a solemn obligation of German Jewry to express its gratitude to Jewry outside of Germany for the help afforded. Particularly, the necessity of expressing thanks to the Joint Distribution Committee which, from the beginning of the present emergency and up to the present, has been working with the greatest strength possible way. Above all, we are especially thankful for the understanding way in which this help was given. We need your help, it would not have been possible for German Jewry to have carried out its plans independently."

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3,367 Jews Entered Palestine in March, Says Official Gazette

JERUSALEM, June 13.—The Official Gazette reports that of the total of 3,480 immigrants who entered Palestine during the month of March, 1934, 3,367 were Jews.
