

## EDITORIAL NOTES By HERMAN BERNSTEIN

### Awakening Germany

On March 1 I analyzed the accomplishments of the Hitler regime and gave the reasons why in my opinion Hitlerism could not last long.

Hitlerism is unquestionably reaching the end of its rope. All the signs of the approaching doom of the reign of bigotry and folly are manifesting themselves.

The von Papen speech, its suppression in the German press notwithstanding the fact that President von Hindenburg telegraphed his congratulations to von Papen, was but one of a number of evidences of unrest and discontent that can be compiled no longer.

John Elliott, the Berlin correspondent of the Herald Tribune in a cable reviewing the Hitler crisis, writes:

"The atmosphere in Germany today is oppressive and clogs as on the eve of a terrific electrical storm. . . .

"The days of flag-waving are definitely over, and the time when the German people could be appeased with circuses is gone. The citizens are demanding bread and the Nazi chieftains are coming home to roost. The Hitlerites are being called upon to fulfill the promises made in the days of the opposition. The German people are beginning to realize that Hitler is not a demigod.

"The Nazis have created dissatisfaction and astonishment in many quarters. Unemployment has been reduced, but at the cost of many workers having to take a cut in wages. The Nazis have revived domestic trade by heavy subsidies to the industries. The campaign of anti-Semitism has stirred the Reich by diminishing exports, reducing its supply of foreign exchange. Consequently Germany has had to take measures resembling those of war time to regulate imports. . . . A regime of terror unknown since the days of Metetrich has reduced the German press to a state of dull monotony and driven thousands of German readers to buying foreign publications to keep the news normal and in their own country."

Dr. Georg Bernhard, the eminent German Jewish publicist, in his latest warning against over-optimism with regard to the nearing collapse of Hitler.

The handwriting on the wall is unmistakable. But all efforts to hasten the process normally and economically must be continued. Hitlerism must be disarmed, for the sake of the German people, for the sake of mankind, for the sake of peace.

## Nazi Crisis Due: Strife Splits Ranks

While discontent seethes in Germany under the surface and with open revolt in the trusted storm troop guards, including the personal bodyguard of Premier Goering; while the mass of Germans grumble and speak of unfulfilled Nazi promises, and German workers refuse to vote for Nazi candidates in split elections; the Nazi cabinet, split into three groups, engages in hectic intrigues against (Continued on Page Eight)

## Lasker to Give \$500,000 for Refugee Help

### Sum to Go Toward New Relief Body Projected By McDonald

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
BRADLEY BEACH, N. J., June 24.—Prospects of relief for victims of the scourge of Hitlerism received tremendous impetus today when Louis Lasker, American Zionist leader, told the Jewish Daily Bulletin that Albert C. Lasker of Chicago will donate \$500,000 toward a new corporation to deal with the refugee problem, now being formed by High Commissioner James G. McDonald.

The revelation came during the opening session of the twenty-fifth annual convention of the Order Sons of Zion, being held at the Lareine Hotel here today and tomorrow. There were approximately 300 delegates and visitors from six states present, most of them from Greater New York and New Jersey.

Lipsky, in a speech which was intended as an answer to the critics of Zionism, praised McDonald for the influence he has had on such men as Lasker and Felix M. Warburg. Lasker, he said, had until recently been a pronounced anti-Zionist but after hearing McDonald speak he pledged his cooperation with the Zionist cause and shortly thereafter promised the half-million-dollar donation toward McDonald's contemplated corporation for refugee relief.

McDonald Rebuffed

In vindication of his claim that Palestine is the only hope of the harassed Jews of many nations, Lipsky pointed out that McDonald originally had hoped to be "another Hoover." The High Commissioner had refused to accept his plan for a national corporation for refugee relief.

## Austrian Police Order Fails to Deter March To Grave of Dr. Herzl

VIENNA, June 24.—Austrian police today prohibited the annual march and procession of Austrian Zionists to the grave of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement, who is buried in a Viennese Jewish cemetery. Thousands of Zionists of all factions, however, came to the cemetery singly and in groups, formed a procession and marched past the grave in tribute to the Zionist leader.

The procession this year was marked by the presence of large youth groups of all the Zionist factions. Presence of a large number of Trumpeldorists, members of the Revisionist Zionist youth organization, evoked wide comment.

## Cadman, J. T. A., Warburg Also Assailed as 'Schemers'

BERLIN, June 24.—A bitter attack against Felix M. Warburg, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Dr. S. Parkes Cadman and other leaders of the committee to aid Christian German refugees was launched here today by Die Deutsche Wochenchau, leading Nazi paper, which alleged that "agitators finding that Jewish atrocity stories have been exploded are now campaigning for the poor, persecuted Catholics and Protestants."

The financial drive against Germany, the Nazi paper declared, was opened by Mr. Warburg with the gift of \$1,000,000, and the Jewish bankers, Lehman, Seligman and Lewishohn, are financing the Wehrmacht. According to the paper, the "gigantic campaign is closely tied up with the work of Dr. Harry F. Ward, liberal Protestant minister, who together with Rabbi Abraham Goldstein of the Free Synagogue in New York is aiding the work of the "boycott leader, Untermeyer." The Nazi paper solemnly declared that the "gigantic sum of money raised in the United States are devoted to publishing in English the sermons of Cardinal Faulhaber of Munich, with a preface by Rabbi Solomon S. Thomas Mann, noted German writer, at his recent visit to the United States, and paying Claus Mann, his son, for lecturing in Scandinavian and English against Germany. The paper also accused alleged Catholic news agencies of working hand in hand with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency in reporting new incidents, arrests and attacks."

## Officials to Weigh Palestine Assembly

### Decision Expected in July on Wauchope Visit to London

JERUSALEM, June 24.—A decision on the establishment of a legislative assembly for Palestine will be made definitely in London during the visit of High Commissioner Gifford Wauchope at the end of July, it was reported here today. The High Commissioner is also expected to take up with the Colonial office proposed changes in the Palestine constitution.

The project of a legislative assembly for Palestine in which the Jews, Arabs and English would be represented has met with the bitter opposition of Palestinian Jewry who regard the measure as calculated to help the government evade many of the conditions of the Palestine mandate.

Jewish leaders have declared in most emphatic language that under no circumstances will they participate in such a legislative assembly.

# Once Humble Newsboy Became Windsor Mayor; D. Arnold Croll Now Canadian Cabinet Minister

**Unyielding Liberal, He  
Has Built Up Strong  
Following**

No longer shall it be said, when story is related that a man has risen from newsboy to a minister or a municipal politician, that it is a mere Horatio Alger fiction.

David Arnold Croll's rise to political heights and to a position that may sound as fiction can also become reality.

Brought to Canada by his parents at the age of six, Croll was a turn newsboy, shoe-shiner and errand boy in Windsor. At twenty-five he was called to the bar. At thirty he was elected mayor of Windsor, receiving an overwhelming vote in spite of whispering campaigns on the grounds of his Jewishness. He re-elected as mayor in another fine demonstration of loyalty on the part of his constituents. Now, at the age of thirty-four, he is the member for in the Ontario Parliamentary elections—and on top of it has been chosen by Premier-elect Mitchell Hepburn to be the Minister of Labor in his cabinet.

**Strong Following**

An uncompromising liberal, Mayor Croll has built up one of the strongest followings of any by any political leader in Canada. Seeking election to the Ontario provincial Parliament in the Windsor district, he received 9,328 votes against the combined vote of 8,691 for the three candidates who opposed him. Mayor Croll was born in Moscow, Russia, on March 12, 1900, the first-born son of Hillel and Minnie Croll. His father was a Russian Jew who found life unbearable in Russia and left to settle in Canada, in 1904. Two years later he brought his family across the Atlantic. Only a handful of Jews lived in Windsor at that time. This city of 60,000, of whom only 1,000 are Jews, was then a manufacturing center. The industrial city of today, which borders on Detroit. It was a hard struggle for the Crolls—but the future mayor of the minister of labor found the hardships to be a school of experience.

Hillel Croll remained in the business but it was not long before he turned to educate five sons and a daughter. The boys had to ply for themselves, and David set out to sell newspapers. With Jacob Geller, now the head of the Windsor News Company, Dave acquired a newsstand. He graduated from the Collegiate School and secured a place for his education at the office of the late Frank D. Davis, K.C., and became a law student. It was the Collegiate School that met his wife—Sarah, a Levin of Detroit, University of Michigan graduate, mother of his three daughters, the youngest born only a month ago.

**His Studies**

In 1921 Croll enrolled in Osgoode Hall Law School in Toronto. He served as a student with Mr. Justice Hughes, now of the Supreme Court of Canada. He graduated in 1925, was called to the Bar in May, married in June. Then began the law career and the eventual election to political office. A thirty-second degree Mason and a Shriner, a member of I.O.O.F., the Macabees and the Grotto, David Croll never forgot his Jewish roots. Always a Zionist, a member of B'nai B'rith, a devotee of Hebrew education, it is easy to see why he should have been so successful in Windsor, without an exception. Talk to any Windsorite, however, and he will tell you that David Croll has many friends because he is consistent in his politics. He makes no compromises in his liberalism. He is always prepared to sacrifice. He is ready to make for a free life, and he is the champion of the cause of the oppressed.

Mayor Croll of Windsor

Mayor in 1930

He was elected Mayor of Windsor in 1930 because he had very decided ideas on how to rule a city of 60,000 people. And he missed not a single opportunity to tell the voters what his views were. When he became mayor, Windsor suffered from the tremendous burden of caring for the unemployed. About 10,000 who had previously committed to Detroit were barred by United States laws from retaining their positions. Tax collections were declining, but the cost of running the government was mounting.

Croll managed to save his city. Not only did he solve the various problems which opposed his government when he assumed the reins, but he made of Windsor a model of good government, now the history of the city. He is now, therefore, that he was re-elected by the largest clear majority in the history of the city. A majority of 6,780 in a field of three.

**Tours Country**

A most spectacular incident marked the career of Mayor Croll. He visited the land settlers in Northern Ontario in the Spring of

1933. He visited the homes of settlers from Windsor in the course of a motor tour and discovered lack of attention by the government, inadequate supplies of food and equipment, an oppression of the landless, and published findings rocked the province and secured considerable relief for the sufferers. It is an interest in the welfare of the people, as manifested by this incident, that won for Mayor Croll the affection of tens of thousands of Canadians.

On the day of Mayor Croll's elevation to a ministerial post, the Border Cities Star of Windsor paid him a high editorial tribute. Calling his election one of the outstanding features of the provincial contests and labeling the record of his life a thrilling one, the Border Cities Star concluded the two-column editorial by stating:

"Why did Dave Croll win two majority elections? Because the people know an able man, a fighter, a true son of democracy who finds himself out of harmony with the world. A fault finder has no friends. He who sees only weaknesses and shortcomings in others cannot possibly be devoted to them, and as he does not give devotion to others, he cannot receive devotion from them. For in friendship there is always room for measure."

are persecuting the Jew. Hillman is a terrible mistake, and they are ceasing to give their sympathy to the Nazis either here or abroad. When German-Americans were called "mongrels" by one of their own number, Nazi in sympathy, it alienated scores of them from Hillman's cause. The DAWA has ceased to secure financial subsidy to conduct the propaganda of recent months, and it is rapidly disintegrating. Germany must eliminate all traces of Hitlerism and make a fresh start in the family of nations.

Until Hitlerism is definitely overthrown, the battle against it is the champion of the cause of the oppressed.

## Jewish Firms In Reich Hiring Nazi Lawyers

**Fear Men of Own Race Have Lost Cases, Paper Opines**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BERLIN, June 24.—Jewish firms even such of them as have not yet been "co-ordinated" by the Nazi rule, have stopped employing Jewish lawyers, complains the CV-Zeitung, organ of the Central Verein of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith.

This phenomenon is attributed by the newspaper to fear on the part of the firms that Jewish lawyers would be unable to defend their interests successfully in the German courts.

"Even non-Jews deplore this lack of solidarity," the CV-Zeitung declares. "We do not want Jews who for years have employed non-Jewish lawyers to send them away and retain Jews, but we protest against exchanging Jewish lawyers, after years of confidence, and solely because they are Jews for non-Jews."

"The German judges have not given us any cause to doubt their impartiality. They are not concerned whether the lawyer is a Jew or a non-Jew," the paper writes, "and at the same time which run away from their Jewish brethren are deserting those of their co-religionists who are struggling for existence," the paper warns, "and at the same time have no possibility of gaining any advantage for themselves thereby."

## Wauchop Closes Revisionist Paper

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
JERUSALEM, June 24.—Hayden Joseph, Revisionist daily newspaper, has been suspended for a month by High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchop, who found four articles printed by the newspaper on the Arlosoroff murder trial objectionable.

Hayden became a daily on April 15 of this year and is edited by Dr. Joseph Klausner. It was because that other Palestine publications may be tried for contempt of court because of comments they printed concerning the verdict of guilty handed down by the mixed tribunal against Abraham Stavsky, young Revisionist, for the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, Zionist labor leader, last June.

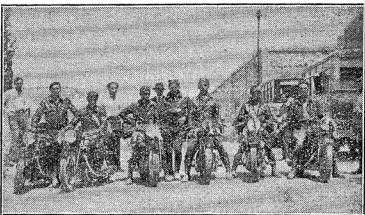

## Polish Officials Forbid Nara Party to Publish Anti-Jewish Newspaper

Publication of Sfateta was suspended last week, when authorities closed the newspaper's printing plant. A Jewish Telegraphic Agency report of June 18 revealed that the paper's editors had made an unsuccessful search for a provincial printer.

## Zion Receives Pinsker Remains Amidst Impressive Ceremonies

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
TEL AVIV, June 24.—Impressive funeral ceremonies were held here today over the remains of Dr. Leo Pinsker, noted Jewish writer, author of "Auto-emancipation," and hailed as the direct forerunner of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of modern Zionism.

After the remains had been carried in a huge procession through the principal streets of Tel Aviv, including Pinsker Street, recently named for him, the funeral cortege proceeded to Jerusalem, to a tomb on the grounds of the Hebrew University, where final interment took place.

Dr. Pinsker died in Odessa, Russia, in 1891, and was buried in a Jewish cemetery. His remains were recently brought from Odessa to Tel Aviv, where plans were made for a national Jewish funeral.

All business in Tel Aviv was at a standstill during the funeral. The procession followed a route which led through the main streets of this all-Jewish city, and wound up at the city hall, where vice-mayor Israel Rokach delivered an eulogy for Dr. Pinsker.

### Children Head Procession

The procession was headed by children from the upper grades of Tel Aviv schools. An honor guard was furnished by the Boy Scouts, Jewish policemen, representatives of Jewish national institutions, the municipality of Tel Aviv and delegations from all Jewish colonies. From Tel Aviv the funeral cortege wound to Jerusalem, where a huge crowd waited the procession in the courtyard of the Jewish Agency building, headed by members of the Jewish Agency and the Vaad Leumi, the Jewish National Council.

## Jews Helped Ullman Frown Finance Huge On Palestine Soviet Plane As Parley Si

**Journalist Began Move to Build World's Biggest Craft**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
MOSCOW, June 24.—The Maxim Gorky, largest airplane in the world which is creating a sensation here in its flight over the Red Square, where a demonstration is being held for the Chelyushkin expedition, is the achievement of Michael Kolzov, a Jewish journalist on the editorial staff of the Pravda.

Kolzov initiated the movement for a culture and propaganda-carrying airplane such as the Maxim Gorky in 1926. He organized 30,000 Soviet journalists, who pledged payment of a percentage of their salaries in order to start the fund for the plane, which was built with money raised among the people. A number of organizations, including the Society for the Establishment of Jews on Land, contributed tens of thousands of rubles, while Jewish artisans gave about 100,000 rubles toward construction of the airship.

The Maxim Gorky has a printing press, its own electric dynamo and a radio broadcasting station aboard.

### Rabbi Resigns as Director

JERUSALEM, June 24.—The next world Zionist congress is not to be held in Jerusalem, Dr. F. Ullmann, permanent organizer of Zionists, concedes, told your correspondent here so that they would be suitable for the use of the congress, it was found that in Palestine the only place which would be large enough is the M. ### Hebrew Culture Body Set for Annual Meet at Atlantic City

Dr. Solomon Goldman of Chicago, is president of Histruth Ivrit. Other leaders, most of whom are expected to attend the sessions here at Hotel Ostend, include the Rev. Z. H. Masliansky of New York, Dr. Israel Herzog, Levinthal of Philadelphia and Professor Chaim Tchernowitz, New York.

A week ago Jewish visitors were expelled by police officers they had ignored signs placed in conspicuous places, reading for "Gentiles Only." Froment Jews and non-Jews from Toronto protested with the Town Council against the discrimination.

## Canadian Editor Assails Internes Pennsylvania Vets Arraign Germany

### Terms Anti-Semitism 'Social Monster,' Outgrowth of Troubled Times

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
MONTREAL, Que., June 24.—Strong criticism against the strike of anti-Semitic internes in the Notre Dame and other French hospitals is voiced by Edmund Turcot, editor of Le Canada, a French Canadian daily, who does not mince words in laying his offending compatriots.

In a long editorial in which he condemns racial animosity and religious persecutions, Turcot states that anti-Semitism is a social monster making its appearance in troubled times. He counsels sane-thinking people not to lose their heads.

Referring directly to the internes strike, the editor states: "The revolt of the internes of Notre Dame Hospital and of their colleagues in La Misericorde, Hotel Dieu and St. Justine give room for serious thought on the part of those citizens who have lost their common sense to allow themselves to be ruled by mob passions."

"The innocent Gogly press and the mental abortionists who are the apostles of the 'social monster' for the disease which has made such inroads in the French Canadian organism."

### German Protestant Hospital To Have Jew on Its Staff

### Adopt Resolution Urging U. S. to Sever Relations With Nazi Regime

HARRISBURG, Pa., June 24.—The United States Department of State was urged by the annual encampment of the Pennsylvania Veterans of Foreign Wars to sever diplomatic relations with Germany because of Nazi propaganda activities in this country.

A resolution adopted to this effect charged the Nazi government with disseminating foreign propaganda to disrupt social and economic life in the United States. The resolution called on the Department of Justice to prosecute leaders of the League of Friends of New Germany in this country, alleging that the organization was formed with the sole purpose of disseminating religious prejudice.

The resolution, copies of which were sent to the federal government departments, charged that the Friends of New Germany were financed and directed by the Nazi government through accredited diplomatic representatives in direct violation of the privileges accorded foreign nations.

### Boat Ride Brings in \$2,500 Toward Veritan Camp Fund

## Bed-Sheet Brigade Rides Forth Once More 'to Save the Nation'

(J.D.B. Special Correspondence)  
ATLANTA, Ga., June 25.—The Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, anti-Semitic and anti-Catholic organization, is being completely reorganized and will enter the national arena again to "combat un-American propaganda and to coordinate the forces of those who are interested in constitutional government." Dr. Hiram Wesley Evans, local organizer and Imperial Wizard of the organization, declared in announcing the appointment of M. O. Dunning, of Savannah, as chief of staff "in charge of propaganda."

The Klan is still opposed to Jews and Catholics, the Imperial Wizard revealed, declaring in reply to a question that members of these faiths cannot become members of the Klan. He added that the Klan believed that Catholics and Jews could best serve the "purposes of the organization" by working with and through their own church groups.

Secrecy Eschewed  
Dr. Evans announced that the Klan will discard its traditional helmets and masks, but will continue to wear the familiar white robes. Although the membership of the organization will continue to be secret, he said, all meetings will be open to the press and no effort will be made to keep Klan activities secret.

Declaring that the new work of the Klan would not involve religious, racial, or political issues, Dr. Evans said that the organization would direct its forces at propaganda that is "undermining our institutions." Although the organization has officially been dormant for the past few years the Imperial Wizard said that the membership was still active, and has suffered from the lack of contact with other organizations due during periods of depression. Credited with taking

an active part in the defeat of Alfred E. Smith for the presidential office in 1928, Dr. Evans said the Klan's last work was in connection with a campaign for the enactment of legislation restricting immigration. At its peak, the Klan is said to have numbered 5,000,000 members and the organization now has twenty-eight offices scattered throughout the country, with headquarters in Atlanta.

### "Nation in Great Danger"

Announcing the appointment of Dunning as head of the national staff, Dr. Evans said, "Public spirited people, hiansmen and non-members alike realize that this nation is in great danger."

"The Klan has delivered in every crisis since the war between the States and can be counted upon now to deliver the nation in a bold and courageous, will lead the American people to see that individual liberty and constitutional government are not perished and that this nation will no longer be the victim of alien propaganda. The Klan, a living, vital movement in itself, will be a party in any other movement whatsoever. There is no liaison between the Klan and fascism, communism, or shirkism, for all these are abhorrent to national liberty."

In accepting the appointment, Mr. Dunning, at one time winner of a trophy "for the most meritorious public service rendered by Savannahians," stressed the fact that the organization would tolerate no violence or intimidation, and added that both national and local Klan chapters are composed of "men of prominence and sound judgment. The Klan will not condone lawlessness," he said. "It will not tolerate any lawlessness and action toward, curbing lawlessness."

## Communists Break Up Nazi Milwaukee Rally, Police Arrest Three

MILWAUKEE, Wis., June 24.—Nazis who took first opposition offered by Communists when more than 200 people broke up a meeting of the Friends of New Germany.

Charles Schoenher of Chicago, Nazi agitator, had entered upon a scorching denunciation of Communism and Jews before the Nazi assemblage, when Communists outside the hall joined in a clamor against Hitler and his American sympathizers.

Police officers, the Reds and Brownshirts made fur fly before police intervened, arresting three of the Communists.

## European Hate Affecting Zion, Asserts Locker

### Warns Labor Parley of Dangers; Fascist Peril Seen

"The wave of hate which is sweeping Europe comes to the boundaries of Jewish life, and is not even kept out of the environs of Palestine itself," declared Berl Locker, member of the World Zionist Executive, to more than 1,000 members and guests of the National Labor Committee for Palestine at a farewell banquet held Saturday evening at the Central Palace, for the 400 delegates and co-workers who returned to Palestine next week after a year's campaigning in the United States.

"The Histadrut has tried to ease the Jewish sorrow in the last three years, and made possible a hope of home and a means of livelihood for thousands whose children are in Palestine," said Mrs. Cohen Meyerov, president of the Palestine Labor Delegation.

"Fascism from without and hate within stand in the way of the growth of the new Jewish endeavor and strength," pointed out the Sprinzak, Palestinian Labor leader, who has been touring the country in the interests of the Gewerkschaft campaign.

More than \$18,000 was contributed by various chapters of the Histadrut to be used in Palestine. Moses Nathanson gave a program of Palestine.

While the marchers paraded to the strains of the "International" and the "Red Front," approximately 175 mounted police and uniformed and plain clothes officers escorted the demonstrators. When a delegation of seven, accompanied by a police guard of double that number, ascended to the consulate offices on the seventeenth floor they were told that Dr. Hans Borchers, the consul-general, would not see them. They thereupon set up a cry for the release of Thaelman shouting "Down with Nazi terrorism!"

Meanwhile, Dr. Borchers who had his office unnoticed passed near a mass meeting on the street, which was protesting the atrocities of Hitler and recent orders issued by Police Commissioner O'Ryan.

## Nazi Parade Called As Police Frown

### Ban on Public Demonstrations Roid Union City Hilarities; All Quiet on Hudson

UNION CITY, N. J., June 24.—Nazis who had planned to celebrate German Day today with a parade through Union City called off their demonstration when it was made clear by police that such activity would not be tolerated.

For weeks local Nazis have been rolled because authorities have prevented them from demonstrating in public. In some circles it was expected that the police would be defied today, since a number of the Hitlerites had expressed intention of holding the parade, sanctioned or not.

Aside from a few unofficial Nazi gatherings all was quiet on the western front of the Hudson.

world from another and more devastating war."

Mr. Lampert, who is prominent in the American Jewish Club and a member of the Palestine Economic Council and numerous other Jewish organizations, proceeded to deliver a pungent description of the Hitler regime and striking contrasts to the Italian dictatorship.

"It is a trinity of swindling, adulation and savagery," he declared, speaking of the Nazi government. "Mussolini is a different type, an idealist, loving humanity and ambitious for his country to progress by peaceful means. Hitler is a racketeer, Mussolini a statesman."

Reciting his observations on a European tour last year for the agricultural adjustment administration, Lampert declared that "if this cancer which Hitler is spreading over Europe is not cut out, that continent will be a place only for people who sack to gouge and tear until another war wipes out half its population."

**Youth Has Vital Part**  
In the crisis today, Mr. Lampert held that Young Israel has a vital part to play, "because old Israel had a thorough understanding of the present situation in the living under a code."

"Our code," he said, "has been the ten commandments, and the Nazis in its finest and noblest aspects cannot improve upon them."

In resolution passed at the closing session today at the Hotel Breakers, the Council pledged it will continue the fight for its brethren in Germany. The work of the American Jewish Congress and its calling a world congress were endorsed.

Plans were made to continue the Council's campaign for passage of laws in New York State to enable those who observe the Jewish sabbath on Saturday to carry out their business.

Another resolution protested the death sentence imposed upon Abra-

ham Slavsky in Palestine for the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff. Requests were formulated by the Council to the New York City Board of Education, suggesting that the opening of schools be postponed to September 12 to avoid conflict with the religious holidays that fall on the two preceding days.

### Roosevelt Lauds Council

Devout religious services and address on the need for more sincere observance of Jewish ethics and traditions marked the convention opening on Friday.

A special prayer for the welfare of the government and the continued good health of President Roosevelt and Vice-President Garner, offered before the sacred Ark, opened the services.

President Roosevelt sent this encouragement to the assembly: "I am glad to extend my greeting to the members of the Young Israel Synagogue organizations on the occasion of your annual convention."

The constructive program, the effectuation of which is your supreme purpose, helpful to your membership and the community in every phase of it, will prove a spur to increased activity and intense devotion. Such a movement cannot fail to achieve the success it deserves and merits.

As many communities and subject to the direction of the Central Council of Young Israel denote thirty agencies devoted to the promotion of Jewish good, the speaker encouraging and inspiring example they afford of willingness to sacrifice their time and energies in fostering the higher ideals inherited from the transcendent civilization of Israel. On the "left" are the Nazi radicals, whom Vice Chancellor Franz Papen called "National Socialist Revolutionaries," Goebbels, Darré or Reichsmann, commander-in-chief of the storm troops. They are of the opinion that the National Socialist revolution has not gone far enough. In the center is the group led by Franz Seidler, Minister of Labor, who are willing to follow the "middle" group, but not the "radicals." And on the right is the extremely powerful group around von Papen, who respect the Junkers and industrialists and who seem to have it complete confidence of the age German President von Hindenburg.

### Von Papen Calls Hitler

That the Nazi regime is facing a grave crisis which may lead its ultimate fate, becomes clear when one realizes that for the first time during Nazi rule von Papen has taken steps to openly criticize the Nazi regime and then even mild speech of criticism has provoked a cabinet crisis ironically enough, despite the opposition of the Junkers and industrialists and who seem to have it complete confidence of the age German President von Hindenburg.

missionaries planned to go overseas and to find a warm welcome in his efforts to alleviate suffering, Lipsky said, but he soon discovered that he would be unable to find financial support and that the doors of neither the League of Nations nor of individual nations were open to him.

McDonald soon came to the conclusion, Lipsky declared, that the doors of Palestine alone were open to him.

The speaker predicted that within the next two years between 60,000 and 70,000 German Jews will migrate to Palestine and that within the coming years Jews undoubtedly will be moving to the other side of Transjordan. Already, he said, they are doing business in Bagdad and Mesopotamia.

### Zionist Fears Displeased

Commenting on the cooperative drive of the American Palestine Campaign and the Joint Distribution Committee Lipsky made the following statement:

"Whereas in previous years the Zionists were afraid that if any such united campaign were effected, the Zionists would be swallowed up with their principles, now, however, as my fear has been dispelled because in reality Palestine is the only haven."

As to division of monies realized in the campaign, he declared that when the Joint Distribution Committee takes over its share it will find there are no other means of using it to succor German Jews by spending it in Palestine.
