Chief Rabbi Kook
Governor Campbell of Jerusalem warned Chief Rabbi Kook and Meir for making an appeal in behalf of Abraham Stavsky, sentenced to death in the Alsholich murder case. The Governor notified the Rabbis that their appeals involved contempt of court "with all its consequences."

Chief Rabbi Kook explained that he had no intention of reflecting on the court that sentenced Stavsky, but that he was appealing for a new trial for an innocent man who was condemned to death.

Chief Rabbi Kook's plea to the Archbishop of Canterbury reads as follows:

"Abraham Stavsky, who is innocent, was sentenced to death. I beg you to exert all your efforts for the sake of the sanctity of truth and justice and the honor of England which is very dear to me."

The warning to Chief Rabbi Kook is just as strange as the preliminary investigation and certain phases of the trial of Alsholich were. Zola, Clemenceau and others who fought for a new trial for Alfred Dreyfus because they believed in his innocence did what Rabbi Kook and others are trying to do for Stavsky.

Rabbi Kook possesses the wisdom, the broad-mindedness, the courage and the dignity of a Jewish spiritual leader who does honor to the Jewish name. As a hundred times he has been the admiration of most of the re-builders of Zion by his tact and sympathetic understanding, and by his great Jewish heart.

The Boycott in Poland

The effect of the Goebbels visit to Poland is now manifesting itself in the demand made by the Polish Chambers of Commerce that the anti-German boycott in Poland be stopped. Nazi Germany, crumbling under the weight of its blundering policy of bigotry and cruelty, is trying to exert its influence over Poland, and if Poland is short-sighted enough to fall under the sway of Nazism, it is embarking upon a suicidal adventure.

The chairman of the Jewish guilds in Poland wisely and courageously responded to the demand of the Polish chambers of the Chamber of Commerce for the cessation of the anti-German boycott that "no force in the world will coerce us to desert the anti-German boycott ranks of the Jews throughout the world." That is an attitude of self-respect and self-defense. As Jews, whose brethren in Germany are persecuted and humiliated, they could adopt no other attitude; however great their own sacrifices may be. The anti-German moral and economic boycott is a measure that will save the German people from their present misleaders and will

Arabs Scent

Laws in Zion

Claim British Told Emir
of Proposed Land,
Entry Limits

JERUSALEM, June 28.—Serious anti-Jewish legislation may be expected in Palestine in the near future, reports reaching the Arab Executive from London declare. According to the reports a legislative assembly for Palestine is to be proclaimed shortly, despite the bitter opposition of the Jews, and immigration and purchase of land by Jews are to be sharply curtailed.

A sensational feature of the reports is an alleged statement said to have been made to Emir Abdullah of Trans-Jordan while he is present visiting London, by the British Colonial Office that strict laws would soon be introduced in Palestine in regard to Jewish immigration and the sale of land to Jews. "In that way the Arabs used not fear dispossession," The Emir was allegedly told.

Polish Jews Hail Nomination

He has suppressed Nara attacks on Jews ruthlessly. As mayor of Warsaw he issued an appeal to the population asking them not to be misled by Nara propaganda.

He is regarded as a staunch supporter of Marshal Pilsudski.

New Bombings Boycott Groups
Strike Terror Warn Against
Over Austria False Reports

Nazis Believed Behind
Blasts at Barthou Is
Endangered

VIENNA, June 28.—A series of bomb explosions which caused considerable damage and killed a policeman broke out in Austria today. Government officials claimed that Austrian Nazis were bent upon destruction. A rumor persisted that the life of Louis Barthou, French Foreign Minister, who had been on a journey through Eastern Europe, was sought.

The explosion caused suspension of railway traffic at Voelckbruck, upper Austria, at Judenburg and at Bruck in Styria, and at several places in the Tyrol. Headquarters of the Catholic League at Innsbruck and the salt works at Mauthausen were bombed.

Political significance was attached to the outrages, which came on the heels of a clash between Austrian troops and the (Continued on Page Eight)

Von Papen Allies
Gain in Strength

Hitler Refusal to Dissolve Stahlhelm,
Dubious Status of Storm Troops
Bolster Conservatives

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
LONDON, June 28.—The alignment of forces fighting for control of Germany continued today to be drawn more closely, with the conservative elements apparently strengthening their position.

While Chancellor Hitler debated whether to throw overboard the Nazi radical wing chiefly responsible for putting him into a striking position for supreme power in the Reich in favor of the conservative element represented by Vice Chancellor von Papen and the great industrialists, the latter group stood strengthened considerably by Hitler's decision not to permit forced dissolution of the Stahlhelm, which is lined up solidly with the conservatives, and by doubt as to whether the Nazi storm troops, mainstay of the radical Nazis, would be continued as a private army.

Program Main Question
The struggle, as it has shaped up since von Papen's memorable speech at Marburg a week ago, is not so much a pro and anti-Hitler fight, this time as it is a question of program and the side that Hitler will take in it. The conservatives—for the moment at least—seek merely to win over Hitler to the program they think necessary to save Germany from utter collapse. The radicals insist on complete fulfillment of the Nazi program.

Hitler, who has until now managed to keep both factions in rein, and has successfully held together a cabinet composed of men of widely dissimilar beliefs and aims, has reached the point where he can no longer do this and must take one side or the other.

Prisoners of this view, gave much thought to reports from usually well-informed Warsaw circles that Hitler would act in accordance with advice given him by Mussolini and his Polish circles through Minister of Propaganda Goebbels, to cast his lot with the moderates.

The ousting of Goebbels from the cabinet, and its reconstruction along conservative lines, was considered here tonight a likely development. The name of Dr. Heinrich (Continued on Page Eight)

Anti-Semitic Paper
Praises Internes

Calls Rabinovitch Resignation
'Great Victory,' Predicts
Student Bids Strike

MONTREAL, Que., June 28.—Today's issue of the anti-Semitic newspaper Le Patriote expresses jubilation over the "great victory of our race" resulting from the strike of hospital internes when Jewish physician was named to the staff of a hospital.

The newspaper also threatens a strike of students at the French University here during the autumn session against admission of Jewish students, adding agitation which is now in progress to such a strike.

The Patriote's entire issue is devoted to the strike and includes bitter attacks against all the newspapers which praised the action of Dr. Sam Rabinovitch, the Jewish physician who was appointed and later voluntarily withdrew. Dr. Rabinovitch is an acknowledged specialist in diabetes, well known in the United States as well as in Canadian medical circles.

Becker Heads Lawyers Club Of Federation

Brooklyn Attorney Succeeds H. S. Bacharach —Was Born in Canada

Murry C. Becker is the new president of the Lawyers Club of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, succeeding H. S. Bacharach, who has resigned. It was announced last night at Federation headquarters, 94 Clinton street.

Mr. Bachrach, who was elected last December for his fifth consecutive term, had hoped to complete the year, but the pressure of other affairs intervened, and "it was therefore necessary that I relinquish the Lawyers Club presidency, as much as I regretted doing so," he said.

Mr. Becker has been affiliated with the Lawyers Club since its organization in 1926 and for the past year has served as first vice-president.

Mr. Becker was born at Hamilton, Ontario, in 1885. He was educated in Brooklyn public schools and at New York University, receiving his LL.B. in 1916. He is assistant treasurer of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, and a director of the Brooklyn Y. M. H. A., a Federation affiliate. He is a member of the American Bar Association and the New York County Lawyers Association. He was social director of the Williamsburg Y. M. H. A., another Federation constituent, from 1913 to 1916. He is married at Lawrence, L. I.

The Lawyers Club is one of the most important organizations in the Federation and has a membership of approximately 1,000. The club elected nearly 40,000 Jews in the Federation. It is expected to obtain an equal amount in the present twenty-fifth anniversary drive, \$25,000 having been secured already.

Friends Eulogize Joseph Grinspan

Proletarian Yiddish Poet Died Tuesday; Workers Pay Tribute at Center

Joseph Grinspan, thirty-two year old proletarian Yiddish poet who died Tuesday night of cancer, friends and colleagues at the Workers' Center, 50 East Thirtieth street, where his body was brought from his late home, 1764 Broadway, to be buried at the cemetery of the International Workers Order.

Hundreds of workers, members of the Proletarian (the literary league of which the deceased was a member) and many other writers came to pay their last respects. The speakers included A. Rahoy, Aaron Kurtz, M. Katz, I. B. Balin, L. Sobrin, I. Kastrtel, Almazov and others.

Grinspan was born in Kietek, a small town in White Russia. He came to New York about ten years ago from Canada. He is survived by his father, who lives in Winnipeg, and his wife, Beatrice.

Grinspan was one of the poets of L. Sobrin of "Before Storm," a volume of poems.

Jews' Plight Dark, Eyewitness Avows

Heinwehr Paid \$400,000 for Tribute, Br'n Brit'v Officer States

(Special to the J.D.B.) SEATTLE, Wash., June 28.—The desperate plight of Europe's Jews was described here by Henry Silver, Br'n Brit'v treasurer and business executive, who has just returned from a visit to France, Switzerland, Austria, Czechoslovakia and Poland.

"In Vienna I learned on the highest authority that the Jewish community was forced to pay \$400,000 to the Heinwehr to keep them from being 'cleansed' by violence," he related.

"In France there are 40,000 Jewish refugees from the Hitler regime, half of whom France is now trying to deport because there is no room for the excess pitiful people without a country."

Polish Jews, Silver said, "are taxed to death," but the government is not anti-Semitic. In Austria they can be found in the breadlines by the thousands, he declared.

Nazism Threatens 15,000 Jews In Mexico, Dr. Billikoff Finds

(Special to the J.D.B.) PHILADELPHIA, June 28.—Mexico, which contains approximately 15,000 Jews, not escaped the menace of Hitlerite reports Dr. Jacob Billikoff, executive director of the Federation of Jewish Charities, who returned last week from a month's stay in that republic.

German propagandists from Berlin are engaged in infecting the country with the virus of Nazism, declared Dr. Billikoff, who finds harmful results already discernible. The Federation director departed yesterday for Marshall Camp in the Adirondacks to complete his recuperation in preparation for resuming his work here in September. He left Philadelphia a month ago upon the advice of his physicians, who ordered a complete rest for him. Although he spent most of his time in Mexico in outdoor exercise, he also visited himself of the opportunity of examining the status of Jews in the southern republic.

Describes Influx Prior to the World War, he points out, there were not more than seventy-five Jewish families in Mexico, most of them from the United States, a few from Australia. Upon the influx of the Nazis there also were a handful of Levantine Jews, attracted to the country by language ties.

The total number of Jews in the country has greatly increased since 1914. Dr. Billikoff explained. A heavy influx of East European Jews began in 1921, bringing the Jewish population up to the present figure, he said. He pointed out that of the 15,000 Jews now in Mexico, from 8,000 to 9,000 reside in the capital.

"Discussing the status of the Jew in Mexico with a number of leading citizens," he declared, "I find that anywhere from three to five per cent of the population would be called the proletariat; ten per cent, the white-collar; from forty to fifty per cent, the small dealers' group; fifteen per cent represent installment merchants; twenty per cent, manufacturers, and ten per cent, capitalists."

Control Apparel Trade

"Less than ten per cent are dependent on charity. The East European immigrants are virtually in control of the entire wearing apparel industry, particularly women's clothing," he declared. "I think I am safe in making the statement that the 13,000 Jews who have settled in Mexico since 1921 are decidedly better off materially than they would have been in the United States."

"During the past year or so there have been some nasty manifestations of the part of what is known as the Comité pro-Raza y Accion Revolucionaria Mexicana,

whose members have been spreading vile reports of the Jews and plastering walls and telephone poles with filers containing such comments as, 'The Jew is the leper of civilization.'"

"Undoubtedly these groups have been instigated to such activity by German and other merchants, especially propagandists emanating from Berlin. While there is no anxiety among the newer immigrants, the older settlers do not attach much importance to these outbreaks."

Government Friendly

"When I discussed the matter with the rector of the national University, he assured me that the government was friendly to the Jewish colony; that the activities of the Comité pro-Raza and kindred groups are an expression of commercial resentment on the part of industrialists and storekeepers who have felt the encroachment by the immigrant Jew. The rector dismissed it as a commercial warfare not abetted by the government."

Jewish Nine Wins Title In Church League Play

(Special to the J.D.B.) SEATTLE, Wash., June 28.—The indoor baseball team of the Herzl Junior Guild went through the season without losing a game and was crowned champion of the Church League here. The Jewish nine is the only Jewish team among the sixteen in the league. The championship game was played against the Mount Zion Baptist colored congregation team.

Seattle Seeks \$5,000 to Aid Jews in Germany Drive Starts

(Special to the J.D.B.) SEATTLE, Wash., June 28.—Seattle Jewry's answer to the cries for help of 800,000 Jewish victims of the Nazi regime in Germany and 65,000 refugees who have fled the Hitler persecution was given at Temple Center when more than fifty workers launched a one-week canvass of the local Jewish community to raise \$15,000 for German relief.

and aims become known, their source of income dries up.

While many of the deluded German Americans discovered that their so-called leaders were getting large funds from Germany for their propaganda in this country, while they themselves were asked to contribute to this Nazi cause, they have become not only disillusioned but also weary of the cause.

Robert Edward Edmonson, an American who is publishing and trying to sell pamphlets exposing the American government by exposing the "German Jewish Advisory Council," says that "the Nazis, if they were in Washington, could do a better job of the present Administration."

This is typical of the mentality of the people who are trying to catch fish by muddying the waters.

Friendship Between Protestants, Jews in Canada Fostered Hate

Rabbi Stern of Montreal, Enroute to London Parley, Says Tie Caused Many Dominion Catholics to Turn on Jewish Population

The strike of French-Canadian Montreal nationalists as a protest against the appointment of a Jewish chief of staff to the Catholic Notre Dame Hospital and the reference of "Jews Not Wanted" sentiment at Toronto suburb have focused attention on the Jewish situation in Canada.

It was thus coincidental and fortuitous that this week brought Rabbi Harry J. Stern of Temple Emanuel Ed., Montreal, here to New York.

Amplifying over, between conventions—the Rabbi had just come from the Central Conference Convention in Wernersville and was on his way to Montreal, from where, this Saturday, he will leave for London to attend the sessions of the World Conference for Judaism. Rabbi Stern was very happy to discuss the background of the Canadian anti-Semitic situation with a reporter for the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

Can Catholics Understand

As a prelude to all questions the Rabbi informed the reporter that, unfortunately, Americans didn't understand the Canadian situation, especially about the province of Quebec, scene of the recent hospital furor. He said that efforts to develop good will between Jews and non-Jewish neighbors had developed rapidly and that his personal relations with the Catholic episcopacy and the Protestant clergy had been "very friendly."

In this respect he pointed to the fact that as the only Jewish member of O. E. A., an association of Montreal lawyers, he had for the past three years been chairman of the group.

"Differences between the Jew and his Canadian neighbors," he said, "revolve about a historic condition peculiar to French Canada and anti-Semitism today is predicated on an economic basis and the fear of Jewish nationalism that has lately arisen that is fearful of the loss of the French language and culture in Quebec.

Explains School System

"The difference," the Rabbi continued, "as most apparent in our school problems. In 1867 when the Canadian Confederacy was created, the English and the French speaking residents of the province set up another school system. Both systems were supported by government funds."

"At that time, there were few Jews and the educational problem of the group was taken care of by the Shearith Israel Synagogue, a Sephardic congregation. As the Jewish population developed, the educational problem grew. The government offered Jewish separate schools but this was rejected by Jewish leaders who feared segregation. It was settled only a few years ago that a pact made with the Protestant group that calls for the education of Jewish children in their school system for the next fifteen years. This arrangement of the children under this arrangement, no segregation at all as had been the case before the pact was arranged."

Anti Jews and Protestants

Rabbi Stern uses this story to illustrate the fact that the Jews gravitated toward an association with Protestants in the Province of Quebec. The progressiveness of the English and the language made it for a more natural interconnection between Jews and the English Protestants than between the Jews and the French Catholics.

And this is the background of

present anti-Semitic feeling. For many years the English minority and French majority fought bitterly; by now they have grown used to each other or at least have become convinced of the futility of continuing the struggle. The association of Jews with the English minority a wing of the French nationalists opened warfare against Jewry, which is thus placed in the unfortunate position of being the butt of the nationalists' wrath.

In speaking of the latest manifestation, the interners' strike, Rabbi Stern said:

"The finer and official element of L. French Catholics oppose anti-Semitism. This is proven by the fact that Dr. Rabinovitch was appointed to so important a post in the Notre Dame Hospital. The strike of the interners was undoubtedly the result of agitation of a group of nationalists. The administration's standing by its appointment is further evidence of the fact that the majority of the officialdom, both of the church and province.

Papers Favorable

"As a matter of fact, since the accession of the English language to the Quebec diocese every effort has been made to promote better understanding. I have had most pleasant dealings with the Cardinal. Another point to be considered is that the most influential French language daily, Le Canada, has been an open supporter of Jewry. Severe, once anti-Semitic, is now quite friendly to the Jews. Only one publication, Le Patriote, has been a steadfast friend of Jewry and this, incidentally, we understand, is supported by interests outside of Canada. A new weekly, L'Ordre, has lately been founded and has proved itself a friend of the Jews and an enemy of an anti-Semitic publication such as Le Patriote. The English press in Montreal has always been extremely friendly to the Jews."

Optimistic on Relations

When asked about the future of Jewish-Christian relations in Quebec, Rabbi Stern was very optimistic. He felt that what really counted was the feeling of the better element in the French population. The same manner as it is in the United States, this, Rabbi Stern said, could be countered only by education and the creation of good will through fellowship in Canada. In Western Canada, where there is a large foreign population, there is a distinct anti-Semitic movement that is guided by Nazi in form. It is represented by a publication called "The Nationalist."

Canadian-Jewish Body

Leading anti-Semitism throughout Canada there has recently been established a Canadian Jewish Congress. The Congress had its first session in its less than a year of activity. It was responsible for the recently passed Hyman bill that makes racial discrimination against Jews punishable as such. It has an active anti-defamation and boycott committee.

Recently the B'nai B'rith moved

an effort to establish a branch of its anti-defamation group in Canada but this has met with opposition from Canadian Jewry.

Congress Cooperates

The Canadian Jewish Congress, attempting to become analogous in Canada to the Board of Jewish Deputies in England, offers representation to other Jewish organizations on its board but is not desirous of the formation of a joint council such as is now operating in the United States composed of the American Jewish Congress, the American Jewish Committee and B'nai B'rith, said the Rabbi.

"We," he continued, "are desirous of correcting the mistaken view in the United States that couldn't be helped because of conflicting organizations. We hope through unity to achieve something. The Leaders of the Canadian Jewish Congress movement are S. W. Jacobs, president; H. M. Calserman, secretary; Nathan Gordon, chairman of the anti-defamation committee. Also taking an active part in the work are Rabbis Maurice Eisendrath of Toronto and Joseph H. Hirsch of Montreal. The latter is a member of the Dominion Executive.

Reich Lawyers in Zion Seen as Victims of New Legal Practice Ruling

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERGSLAND, June 28.—A heavy blow to Jewish candidates for admission to the Palestine bar is seen in the text of the draft ordinance governing granting of permission to practice appearing in today's official Gazette.

It provides that permits to practice law will be granted only to citizens of Palestine or those given entry to the country as professional advocates.

Operation of this ordinance is expected to prevent German Jewish immigrants who previously practiced law in Germany from earning their livelihood in the profession here.

AJC and AF of L Urge Rhode Island to Fight Nazism With Boycott

PROVIDENCE, R. I., June 28.—Hundreds of Rhode Island merchants today were being urged to intensify the boycott against Nazi-made goods in a letter sent by Dr. Illo Berger, president of the Rhode Island Council of the American Jewish Congress.

Heads and Jewry in Rhode Island have joined hands in the boycott movement. Thousands of residents affiliated with both organizations have been asked to continue boycotting German-made goods until the Nazi menace is eliminated.

Enroll Peace Workers

CINCINNATI, June 28.—Albert T. Bigley, of Chicago, and Alexander Fetsilver, Brooklyn, students at Hebrew Union College, have been asked to enroll as representatives of the American Friends Service Committee to speak in behalf of international peace.

German Jewish Doctors Cause China to Be Grateful to Nazis

Cal Hirsch, star reporter for the New York China Daily News of Shanghai, who arrived in the Far East recently, reported yesterday that approximately 100 German Jewish doctors have set up offices in Shanghai.

Hirsch, who is recognized as holding one of the most interesting jobs in newspaperdom as a police reporter for the largest English language daily in the Far East, told the Jewish Daily Bulletin that German refugees have prospered since their arrival in China. He said that during the short time they have lived in the city they have come to be regarded as "Hitler's gift to the Far East" by virtue of the medical skill they have contributed to a territory which has long suffered from inadequate medical attention.

"German Jewish doctors," said the newspaperman, "have already established themselves as among the most expert surgeons and general practitioners of Shanghai. None of them seems to be suffering from lack of patronage, while most of them have already established themselves as commanding figures in the city's public health service."

Hirsch, an American, has returned to this country for a six months vacation. During the eleven years during which he has

served Shanghai newspapers he has covered the most noteworthy incidents of the Far East. He was a front-line reporter during the Japanese invasion of Shanghai.

Louisville Couple Prepare for Study On Beaux Arts Prize

Clerics' School Engages Jews As Lecturers

Episcopal Church Runs Summer Sessions in Cincinnati

(Special to the J.D.B.)
CINCINNATI, June 28. — Although conducted under the auspices of the Episcopal Church, the Cincinnati Summer School for Candidates for the Ministry and Junior Clergy, which will open its twelfth annual session here on July 6 at the Diocesan House, will have a number of Jewish lecturers.

These include Dr. Maurice Levine, assistant professor in psychology in the College of Medicine, University of Cincinnati; Dr. Isaac M. Rubinow, international secretary of the B'nai B'rith; Dr. Abraham Frankel, professor of education at Hebrew Union College; Dr. Louis A. Lurie, psychiatrist at the Jewish Hospital; and Rabbi Samuel S. Cohen, professor of theology at Hebrew Union College.

Dr. William S. Keller, director of the summer school, has announced that one or two meetings during the summer will be held in conjunction with the Summer School of Religion at the Hebrew Union College.

Dr. Rubinow is to be the principal speaker at a dinner meeting on July 17 at Christ Church, Glendale, on the subject, "Religion and Our Present Civilization."

Dr. Levine is on the program for a series of four lectures—July 16, "Contribution of Psychology to the Understanding of Inter-Personal Relationship"; July 18, "Role of Mental Disease in the Problem of Human Happiness"; July 20, "Comparison of Normal and Abnormal Mental States"; July 23, "Causes and Varieties of Chief Types of Psychoses and Psycho-neuroses." Survey of Methods of Psychiatric Treatment, including Psycho-analysis.

Dr. Franzblau will speak on "Education and Religion," on July 25, "The Education of Jewish Children," July 27, Dr. Lurie is scheduled to lecture Aug. 15 on "Behaviorism as Related to the Duties of the Jew," and Dr. Cohen on Aug. 22 on "Education and Religion from the Standpoint of Judaism."

Atlantic City Holds Flower Day to Aid Palestine Pioneers

United States Won't Tolerate Race Hatred, Opines Dr. Eliot

(Special to the J.D.B.)
SEATTLE, Wash., June 28. — "Anti-Semitism in this country? No chance! I hope no Jewish friends have no apprehensions over violence against the Jews in America. We'll not stand for imported race hatred in this country."

The Rev. Dr. Samuel A. Eliot, nationally prominent Unitarian minister and for twenty-seven years president of the American Unitarian Association—son of one of America's most distinguished educators, the late Charles W. Eliot, president of Harvard expressed his views on the Christian-Jewish problem in an interview with the Jewish Daily Bulletin. He was in Seattle to deliver the baccalaureate address at the University of Washington.

"Ritualism? It's revolting," he said. "But I am not convinced how much good we are actually doing when we, here in America, express our indignation and horror at the Middle Age barbarities of the Hitler regime. I wonder if it helps Jews any in Germany."

"I say to all Jews: Exalt your race and value your racial heritage. Fight for your own, in the glorious Jewish tradition!"

"What do I think about the tacit understanding which exists at most Eastern colleges, including Harvard, that only a certain percentage of Jewish students be allowed entrance? I rather agree with it. You understand, this arrangement is not a racial official; it is just understood. It is not a matter of religious prejudice. It is based on race, not religion. I think such an arrangement is good because if you do not have a tacit understanding of this sort, the universities like Harvard would be all-Jewish, as in the case at the College of the City of New York."

"And I am in favor of Gentiles and Jews mixing. If there were too many Jews at Harvard, for instance, non-Jews would cease to go. It would become a Jewish institution."

"I admire and respect the many

Jewish virtues. What are the Jewish faults, you ask me? Well, I think they are two. But first, understand that I do not blame the Jew for these traits I do not find so desirable. I know full well they are traceable to the Jews' experience in ghetto days—an experience forced upon him by the non-Jew."

"The faults are, first, acquisitiveness—that is, too eager a desire for material success — and second, perhaps, a tendency to be too blatant, because the Jew feels the necessity of self-assertion. With the free social intercourse of Jew and non-Jew today, these ghetto-born characteristics are fast disappearing."

"One thing I do think: The similarities of all religions, rather than their differences, should be stressed. What we need today is not so much to talk about the rituals and ideals of our own particular brand of religion, but to practise true religion!"

The Bulletin's Day Book

From The New York Times: "BERLIN, June 27.—Considerable scurrying around on the part of the German Olympic committee in a search for Jewish athletes and prodding of recalcitrant local 'pure Aryan' athletic clubs followed the announcement by the chairman of the American Olympic committee that he would arrive here in August to decide whether the United States would participate in the games."

The scene changes. We find ourselves in the Reich, cloaked with invisibility, able to listen in on telephone conversations and to read telegrams, letters and official documents over Nazi speakers. Fortunately we are temporarily bereft of the sense of smell.

Here, this one sounds good. "Hello, that you, Julius?" This is Kurt. Say, listen, Julius, can you ship me four Jewish sprinters right away, by fast freight?" "I don't know, Kurt. There's an awful scarcity of Jewish sprinters these days. I know where I can lay my hands on three, but you might have to go somewhere else for the fourth."

"Well, anyway, so what you can, will you, Julius?" But say, listen, the goods must be perfect. That last batch you sent me was in pretty poor condition. One of them had a double spavin and two or three others had nasty bone bruises on both knees. I'm glad you brought that up, it, because it gives me a chance point out that you ordered them in the hoof. You didn't have done that. It's a long walk from Nuremberg to you, you know."

"I know, I know, but that was the best the American guy told us he was coming over. This time, though, I'm spending good money in freight charges and I expect he'll have the perfect goods. I want to be spending a fortune on veterinarians. Oh, and by the way, get thoroughbreds if you can. In the very least they must have an full-blooded parent. We have to make a good impression, you know."

Well, that's that. Let's see what this bull-necked Brown Shirt is reading.

"Official communication N.O. 260." It has been called to the attention of this office that storm troopers have been hunting Jewish athletes out of season and without proper game permits.

This ruthless depredation of our none-too-plentifully-served preserves must stop. We call to your attention the virtual extermination of the American Jew, due to just such thoughtlessness.

"This office realizes the storm troopers are mischievous and must have a place, a place for the time being, outside the practice to those Jews who are certain are not athletes.

"This communication is not to be taken as an attempt on the part of this office to spout your law, but merely a request for co-operation in the face of a national emergency."

"We promise you the open season will be on again after 1936."

Let's take a look at this letter to the president of the "Aryan" Carillon Club.

"Dear Friend Willy: "I hate to ask you to do this, but we are running very low on Jewish fencers and need your help toward getting a couple right away."

"They tell me your territory used to be very productive breeding grounds for Jewish fencers, but in the last year or two you boys, with your practical jokes, have had all the fun out of the crop by using folks with real points to practice on Jews using weapons with blunted ends."

"I got a good laugh when I first heard about that, but the situation is a little different now. We have to put a couple of Jewish fencers on display for this American who's coming over in August, and I don't think he'd be willing to recognize the kind that are punched full of foil-foes."

"Now here's my suggestion: Scout around a little and see if you can find something in this line. I believe there's an abandoned pig pen behind your club house. You can stable them for the time being, feed them up a bit and get a little flesh on their ribs, and then bring them over to Berlin."

"After the American goes back, you'll have some nice juicy material to practice on, so after all it'll probably be worth the trouble. Catch on?"

"Anything for a laugh, hey kid?"

Dickstein Says SettlementAids Reds for CWA

Charge Results From Probe Into Activities of Communists

A charge that the Henry Street Settlement was assisting members of a Jewish East Side Communist organization in obtaining CWA jobs in preference to "more deserving citizens" was made yesterday by Congressman Samuel Dickstein. The charge, according to Dickstein, grew out of an investigation he made recently into Communist activities in connection with the Congressional committee probe into Nazi propaganda in the United States.

This afternoon, the Congressman, as a member of the special House body, resumes his one-man hearings of Nazi subversive activities. The session, to be held at the Bar Association Building, 42 West Forty-fourth street, will be seen by Dickstein, who is expected to reveal the witnesses he expects to examine.

On the subject of the Communists getting CWA jobs he was more verbose.

"My investigators have discovered," he said, "that within the past few weeks Communists have obtained between twenty and 150 jobs in the CWA. Some of these jobs got through influence wielded by some member of the Henry Street Settlement. I'm going to make it my business to find out how it is that hoodlums who spend their time parading through the streets and waving red flags get these jobs to get them more deserving citizens."

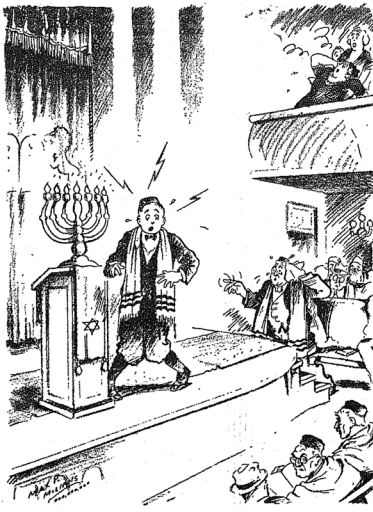
Dr. Nathan S. Abrams, assistant to Helen Hall, director of the Henry Street Settlement, when apprised of the charge, characterized it as "entirely without basis." He said there was no one in the settlement who was working with the Communist organization in the manner charged.

"Is the Land of the Soviets?" is the latest importation sent to this country by Amkino from Russia, and I must hastily add, one of the best non-plot films to come from that turbulent and exciting land. At the present moment it is being shown at the Acme Theatre on Fourteenth street and anyone who wants to see a graphic and exciting picturization of everyday life under the Soviets should not miss it.

No attempt has been made to inject propaganda into the film, but by showing such things as the daily life of a Russian peasant on a collective farm, a winter sports meet in Leningrad, workers going off on a vacation, the May Day celebration and other activities of the Soviets, the producers of this film have been able to create a favorable impression of living conditions in Russia today.

Fascism's Foes Launch Attack On Nazi Courts

Aid Body Asks Protest by Conference of Jews, Christians

That the National Conference of Jews and Christians take a stand against the Nazi "People's Courts" which start operations on July 1 is the request made by the National Committee to Aid Victims of German Fascism. It was announced yesterday by Alfred Wagnemacht, executive secretary of the committee.

The appeal was sent to the conference on the eve of its two weeks convention at the University of Virginia, Charlottesville, which convenes Sunday to discuss Protestant, Catholic and Jewish relations in America.

According to the letter, prisoners who are now held in concentration camps will come up for trial before the newly decreed Volksgericht (People's Court), Ernst Thaelmann is the first prisoner scheduled to be tried under its provisions.

Objections to the People's Courts are based on the following grounds, according to Wagnemacht: 1) Judges are not having special experience in the field of combating treasonable activities—that is to say, storm troopers. 2) The victim may be tried, sentenced and executed in twenty-four hours. 3) No appeal may be taken from the verdict. 4) All usual trial procedure is bypassed. 5) The sentence is decreed for printing or distributing printed matter, maintaining treasonable organizations, conspiring to high treason, using radio for propaganda and espionage.

Protests against the courts, the appeal suggests, may be made by letter to Chancellor Adolf Hitler, to the German Embassy in Washington and to all German consulates in the cities where they exist.

Inquiry Group Invites Luther To Be Witness

Hays Gives Ambassador Chance to Defend Hitlerism

Hans Luther, German Ambassador to the United States, is invited to testify before the American Inquiry Commission, which begins its sessions July 2. The invitation, signed by Arthur C. Hays, a member of the commission, informs Luther that he may submit "any testimony" which he "would care to place before this tribunal."

The commission will hear witnesses on legislation, education and civil liberties in Nazi Germany, and will investigate particularly the status of law and political trials now pending in Germany.

Soon after it was decided to hold the public inquiry, the commission agreed to offer both official and unofficial representatives of the Hitler government an opportunity to testify on behalf of their regime and to cross-examine witnesses.

Hansfangei Silent As the first step in that direction a telegram was sent last week to Ernst Hansfangei, Hitler's right-hand man, now visiting the University, following a class reunion. Although Hansfangei was asked to reply clearly to the commission's request that he testify or cross-examine witnesses, up to a late hour Wednesday no reply was forthcoming, according to Raymond L. Wise, secretary of the commission.

Explaining why the invitation to the German Embassy was not sent earlier, Mr. Wise declared that it was felt that the Hitler representatives should be given ample opportunity to acquaint themselves with the preparations of the commission and the witnesses who are to testify.

In addition to Hays, members include George Gordon Battie, United States Senator Edward P. Costigan, Clarence Darrow, Stanley High, Dudley F. Malone and George Z. Medaille.

The letter to Ambassador Luther came in part:

"The Commission will inquire into the legal situation, the alleged persecution of minority groups, German education, the status of women, the question of civil liberties and like matters. "We wish to approach this task in a spirit of fairness and we are pleased to consider any testimony which you, acting for your government, would care to place before this tribunal. "If the press should act as an observer or, if you desire, of some lawyer who will have an opportunity to cross-examine witnesses."

Dawes Elected Head Of Rosenwald Museum

(Special to the J.D.B.) CHICAGO, June 28.—Rufus C. Dawes, president of a Century Club, was elected president of the Museum of Science and Industry, founded by Julius Rosenwald, in Jackson Park, at a meeting of the board of trustees. The choice was made at the museum after the close of the World's Fair.

Locker Fears Stavsky Case Imperils Peace

Cautions-Zionist Parley to Temper Zeal With Tact

(Special to the J.D.B.)
OHIOGAGO, June 28.—A plea to the Jewish people not to create "quills and undisciplined passion by insisting that the nation is on trial" in the case of Abraham Stavsky, Zionist Revisionist convicted of the murder of Dr. Beniamin Akosfortov, was made by Dr. Berl Locker, Laborite member of the World Zionist Executive, who spoke at the opening session of the Zionist annual convention at the Poale Zion-Zeire Zion held here at the Hotel Sherman. More than 2,000 persons were present.

Mr. Locker said the Poale Zion merely desired to see justice done Stavsky, and every effort should be made to determine if the man is guilty. He warned, however, that the case of Stavsky and peace must be preserved in Palestine.

Proud of Progress
The speaker brought greetings from the World Zionist Organization and recalled the fact that at the Poale Zion convention in 1927, delegates returned from the thirty-fifth annual convention of the Zionist Organization of America and reported that they had been told that they were incapable of carrying out political action and should be content with building cities and working as laborers. "But," he said, "in 1934 a Laborite greet you in the name of the Jewish people and the Jewish Zionist Executive. The fact of the recognition of the political ability of the Laborites as a great victory for the organization and stressed the role that the speaker played in the upbuilding of Palestine. The Laborite leader pointed out that every action of the Laborite mentioning Palestine in the past has been approved by the 250,000 Jewish workers who voted the Laborite ticket.

Discussing the conflict between the Jewish factions in Palestine, Mr. Locker said that neutral persons are not helping to ease the situation, especially when they are "neutral on one paper."

Basic Hope Labor
"The Poale Zion has the interests of the Jewish masses at heart, and as a representative of the Jewish masses I believe that only through labor can a new life be built in Palestine. The Labor party has played an important role in the rehabilitation of the country and has also assumed the lead in the future."

Mr. Locker told questioners that the Poale Zion merely desired to see justice done in the case of Abraham Stavsky, convicted of the murder of Dr. Beniamin Akosfortov and whose case comes up for appeal on July 16. He said that the Laborites believe that every Jew should exert every effort to determine the guilt or innocence of Stavsky, but added "it is dangerous and unnecessary to try to determine the guilt or innocence of Stavsky by instigating that the Jewish nation is on trial and thus help create further antagonism."

He declared that organized labor in Palestine is also desiring peace. "However," he said, "let those who speak about peace bring their tactics. Labor is not afraid of threats. The Arab and Italian dance must cease because of the very real danger involved in the atmosphere of suspicion.

Won't Be Frightened
"The world must think of the Jewish organized labor as doing only one thing, the upbuilding of Palestine, and will not be frightened by any threats or intimidations. The defenders of the Jewish people are also willing to defend the development of Palestine without

fear of personal sacrifice. Jewish labor is not seeking revenge. It stands always for justice and constructive work in Palestine."

Other speakers included Joseph Sprinzak, Palestinian Laborite; Chaim Greenberg, editor, Der Kaempfer; Goldie Meyerson, David Wertheim, David Nisim, Isaac Hamlin, Louis Segal and B. Miller, representative of the American Zionists.

The remaining sessions of the convention will be held in the Mid-west Athletic Club.

Loan Society Gave Nearly \$1,000,000

15,465 Aided During Past Year, Hebrew Group Announces

Nearly a million dollars was loaned without interest charges to 15,465 individuals during the past year by the Hebrew Free Loan Society. This was learned yesterday when the group's annual report, for twenty-nine years president of the organization, made public his yearly report at the Society's forty-second annual convention at 108 Second avenue, the group's main office. Offices are also maintained in Brooklyn and the Bronx.

This year's total loans is the latest record in duration of any of the five years preceding this one. It contrasts with 13,292 loans the previous year and only 9,557 loans in 1929. Since the founding of the society \$29,439,000 has been loaned to 533,551 borrowers.

It remains a question, however, whether Dr. Brunsing will consent to participate in a Hitler cabinet unless certain policies which appear to be implicit with his own regime are eliminated.

Storm Troops on Way Out

There seems little doubt among qualified observers and close students of the present German situation that the Nazi storm troops are going to go under official leadership, with many of their members unquestionably "red" in tendency, they represent a doubtful factor which may become a threat to the government. Their dismissal would ease Hitler's position in foreign affairs and would remove a dangerous burden from the German government. On the other hand, dismissal might result in a large part of the storm troops joining the underground united front movement. Hitler's regime is now known to be functioning.

Despite this latter danger, and its realization by Hitler and his associates, the German people believed here that the Nazi chancellor will take the chance and dissolve his private army.

WAWA, June 28.—Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Nazi Minister of Propaganda and leading spirit in the radical Nazi faction, will resign from the Hitler cabinet and will be replaced by Hermann Goering, former Chancellor of Germany, will emerge from retirement to become Foreign Minister, the usually well-informed Kurjer Warszawski declared today.

The changes in the cabinet will be accompanied by an improvement in the status of the Jews of Germany, in order to terminate the worldwide boycott of the Reich and an attempt to end Germany's present isolation among the nations, states the Kurjer. It is noted for its excellent sources that the German government will emerge from its diplomatic isolation. Mussolini, in his meeting with Hitler at Venice, and official Polish circles on the occasion of the trial of Goebbels, have urged the German government to change its Jewish policy and also its attitude toward conservative elements in Germany, the paper declares.

"A government crisis is imminent," it states, "and some of the cabinet members admit it. Among them are Goebbels, Goering, and the Minister of Agriculture Darré. The dissolution of the storm troops, and the restoration of Jewish civil rights, the Jews are expected to enter the liberal professions and the Reichswahr, the paper asserts. Roehm is commander of the storm troops, and Goebbels and Minister of Agriculture Darré is a leader of the left wing of the Nazi party.

Dr. Brunsing, leader of the now dissolved Catholic Centrist party has been in retirement since the advent of the Hitler regime and is now residing in a German monastery.

Veterans Protected

Credence to the report of the Kurjer Warszawski is strengthened by the fact that the German government is today in rebuking the radical faction of its party which had clamored for the dissolution of the Reichswahr. It is also a promise that the German veterans' organization is to be allowed to exist without further attack by the storm troops.

Angriff Attacks Jews;
Jewish Graves Desecrated

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
PRAGUE, June 27.—Continuing

Nazi efforts to arouse a new outburst of fanatic aggression against Jews in order to divert attention from the war between the Nazi storm troops and the Stahlhelm, Der Angriff, newspaper owned by the German Minister of Propaganda, night demands that an "example" should be made of the Jews who it reported were arrested last night at a secret meeting held behind closed doors in a room with curtained windows. The meeting, said the paper, was held "for seditions discussion" of the position of Jews in Germany today. The article was printed under the caption, "Treachery."

Slogan Is Carved

Reflecting General Goering's anti-Semitic utterances at Hamburg yesterday, an anti-Jewish slogan was carved in stone on the grave of Gabriel Riesser, advocate of Jewish emancipation in Germany in the 19th century, at the Jewish cemetery at Hamburg. Nineteen stones were desecrated by vandals, some being completely destroyed.

The destruction of the cemetery complained to the authorities of repeated stone-throwing by vandals and continual insults hurled at him.

Communism May Overrun Reich, Steel Declares

The prediction that large sections of the Nazi storm troops would desert to the Communist ranks as soon as Hitler goes to prison, as a Communist avalanche may overrun everything, as a consequence, was made by Otto von Guericke, former German official, in the fourth of a series of articles on the Nazi situation being published by the Berlin Kurjer.

To forestall this possibility, which Steel emphasizes is still only a possibility rather than a probability, the German government that the Hitler government is considering complete disarmament and dissolution of all Nazi storm troops. His information, Steel says, comes from private and reliable dispatches from Berlin, which further reveal that "activities of the Communist and Social-Democratic parties in the Brown Army are the reason for this development."

Realize Betrayal

"Within the last three radical party and army organizations to carry their propaganda right into the heart of Nazism," the article states. "At first the loyal Nazi soldiers were not permitted to believe that Hitler was nothing but the puppet, manipulated for the sake of German industrialists and German as well as foreign bankers."

"But during the last three months the awful truth of their betrayal carried out with increasing clarity. The ordinary man conception has dawned upon them."

The storm troops, the German people are now waking up their nightmare. They are waking up. They are in rebellion.

"About the middle of this year," the article states, "the storm troops are not even the brutal discipline enforced by their officer band of morons could keep the discontented stormtroopers in check. The whole Brown Army was therefore ordered. All storm troops are asked to surrender their arms on July 1, the beginning of their leave."

"If Hitler hopes that he can stave off the disaster indefinitely by thus misdirecting the storm troops, this development automatically strengthened the Conservative, Steel Helmet and Monarchist opposition.

Rabbi Wise wrote: "I have as you know the very highest admiration for Mr. Szyk as artist and man, and not unfortunately an out-of-town engagement will make it impossible for me to return before midnight."

press here expressed alarm over reports from London stating that the British Quakers organization has undertaken a campaign to bring peace to Palestine through a private scheme, the presentation of a legislative assembly, placing of Jewish immigration under the control of an international commission, and restriction of sale of land to Jews.

A Quaker committee visited Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lester, British Consul General, who was said to have asked the British Government to permit Palestine to be filled with Jews. He was also said to have informed the committee that High Commissioner Sir Herbert Wauchope would pursue the policy of granting fewer certificates than asked for by the Jewish Agency for Palestine.

Hebrew papers suggested the immediate dispatch of a Jewish delegation to London to counteract the effect of the Quaker campaign.

Executive Belittles Quakers' Efforts

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
LONDON, June 28.—The Jewish Zionist Executive informed the Jewish Telegraphic Agency that it has been in touch with two Quakers, Oliver and Tostad, here from the Near East to attend the Quaker conference, and is not inclined to attach importance to their efforts directed against the Jewish Agency. The executive declared that the story had been "exaggerated by interested persons desiring to create a state of alarm in the Jewish community."

The Colonial Office confirmed the visit of the Quaker committee to the Colonial Secretary, but declined officially that Sir Philip had used the language attributed to him.
