Martyr Beilis
The death of Mendel Beilis, the Kiev brickyard superintendent, who was falsely accused by the Tsarist government of "ritual murder" and who was acquitted by the jury, recalls the criminal methods resorted to by the decomposing Tsarist regime in its efforts to justify its pogrom policy and to discredit the Jews everywhere. An ordinary innocent Jew was charged with having killed a Christian boy and used his blood for ritual purposes. Minister of Justice Scholeglov set in motion the entire government machinery at his disposal, fabricating evidence and securing unscrupulous experts to testify that certain sects of Jews used Christian blood for ritual purposes.

The whole civilized world was aroused at the Tsarist attempt to revive the long-explored myth and to convict the innocent Jew. Protests came from various lands. The Vatican also denounced the resurrection of the ritual murder legend in unmistakable terms. The Russian liberals, aroused by the criminal folly and cruelty of the Tsarist government, came to the aid of the counsel for the defense of Mendel Beilis—Gruzenberg, Margolis and others.

The Beilis affair, staged by the government, collapsed. The conspiracy of the Russian government against the Jewish people was revealed in all its horror and stupidity. The government's experts discredited themselves. Mendel Beilis was acquitted.

The "ritual murder" conspiracy, by which the Tsarist government sought to divert the attention of the suffering Russian people from its real enemies, served to hasten the end of the decaying autocracy. This conspiracy was followed by the reign of Rasputin, which precipitated the revolution.

The "ritual murder" myth has been revived from time to time in various lands by the criminal

(Authentic reports received at Prague disclosed that the bullet wounds which caused the deaths of the four were found in the faces and temples of the victims, thus precluding any possibility of the "escape" allegation).

Two other members of the Jewish community, included in the twenty-five arrested by S. S. men and horribly beaten in Nazi headquarters at Hirschberg, were also slain. One of them was named Jakob Roehm. The name of the sixth victim could not be learned.

Fifteen of the twenty-five Jewish communal leaders have been released from custody. Police are still investigating the cases of the remaining prisoners.

15,000 Jews Enter Palestine in Half Year

JERUSALEM, July 9.—At least 15,000 Jewish immigrants entered and settled in Palestine in the first six months of the current year, it was announced today by the Jewish Agency for Palestine. According to the Agency's calculations, nearly 8,000 of this number were capitalists who brought approximately \$5,000,000 into the Holy Land.

This figure, the Agency states, establishes a record for immigration unequalled by any other country in the world during so short a period.

Hitler Is Still Idol of Reich, Traveler Finds

**Removal Would Cause
Indescribable Chaos,
Says Denby**

(Special to the J.D.B.)
PHILADELPHIA, July 9.—Adolf Hitler today is the unchallenged idol of the German people and his removal, forcible or otherwise, from the German political picture would precipitate a condition of indescribable chaos.

Although he left Germany the day before Hitler's bloody "purgings" of Nazi leaders, Charles Denby Jr., Philadelphia attorney and son-in-law of U. S. Senator David A. Reed, said yesterday that the better informed classes in Germany, particularly business groups, had been uneasy for weeks.

Mr. Denby, who arrived in New York on the Europa Thursday, spent three weeks in Germany.

"The possibility of a restoration of the Hohenzollerns to the monarchy," he said, is very remote, and is viewed approvingly by but a small segment of the German nation.

"I don't think that anyone in Germany had the slightest apprehension that the 'purgings' as it is called here, would take place when it did," Mr. Denby said. "When I was in Germany in December and January, the more conservative and better informed classes were uneasy, but their fears had no focus. They had the feeling that Hitler didn't have sufficient control of the army and more bloodiness of his lieutenants, and that the party leaders in the provinces would break loose from the central authority and assert their power in their own local communities."

Fear of Anarchy Is Strong

"Fear of anarchy is too strong and I think it would be more accurate to say that the fear of anarchy in Germany was drifting steadily toward a period of lack of governmental discipline."

Denby said in Germany when the events of late last month took place but even had I been, I am convinced that there would have been nothing visible to indicate the sub-surface events. In Germany, the discipline is so perfect, the censorship of the press so rigid, that the ordinary people simply don't know what is taking place. They may sense it, and they may hear reports, but that is all, and superficially the life of the people remains normal and placid.

"My own impression, gained from conversation with the better informed groups is that Hitler will remain in power indefinitely. I don't think that there is anyone who would or would want to displace him."

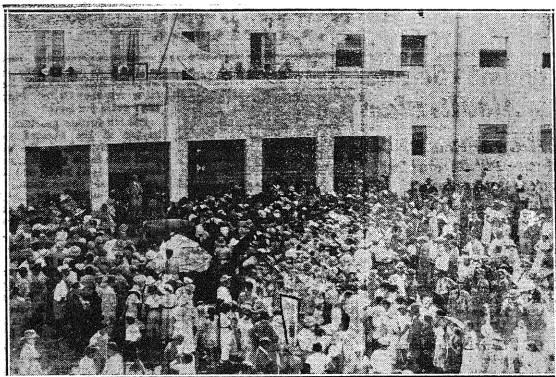
"He is the unquestioned idol of the German people. Their attitude toward him is actually that of idolatry, and if there is blame to be assigned, it is not attached to him, but to his associates. Even his enemies are better informed, the principal criticism of him is that he is not strong enough as a man and as a leader."

Speaking of the Hohenzollerns, he disclosed the surprising attitude on the part of those to whom he has talked that the former Kaiser's family is not wanted.

"There is very little chance of restoration, mainly because hardly anyone here thinks that Hohenzollerns are as they are called back. If there were one eligible member of the royal family, he might be received as a ruler by a larger group, but the German people do not want to saddle themselves with the entire Hohenzollern family and all that such a restoration would entail."

No Runs, No Hits, One Error, Tells Tale of Alliance Defeat

It wasn't a concession after all. It was a point-blank refusal that was made to read like the result of a typographical error on the part of a stenographer in the Board of Education.

That's the explanation of yesterday's story that appeared in the Bulletin relating that the school authorities had decided to split the difference with the Jewish Sabbath Alliance in the matter of its request that school opening be deferred until September 12 because the Jewish New Year falls on the tenth and eleventh.

While Dr. Campbell's letter to William Rosenberg, executive secretary of the Alliance stated that school would be opened September 11, which would mean a concession had been granted, the letter should have read, according to the office of Superintendent of Schools Harold G. Campbell, September 10, which is the date originally scheduled.

In the meantime, officers of the Alliance having been misled by the error, a letter was dispatched yesterday to Dr. Campbell protesting that the supposed concession granted was not sufficient.

"This concession," the Alliance wrote, "is practically without value inasmuch as, according to the precepts of the orthodox Jewish faith both the tenth and eleventh of September are observed as holy time and are equally obligatory." The letter then demands that "out of consideration to the religious sentiment of Jewish pupils and teachers," the board reconsider its action.

Depression Hit By Rabbi Pool As Nazi Cause

**New York Rabbi Speaks
at Virginia Public
Affairs Meet**

CHARLOTTEVILLE, Va., July 9.—The world economic crisis was given as the chief reason for the aggravation of religious intolerance and "unhappy Germany's outbreak against the Jews," by Rabbi Dr. De Sola Pool in an address last night before the Institute of Public Affairs.

Although misery sometimes makes men kin, often because of reality and drives them to a refuge of inferior prejudices, where "they find a scapegoat on whom to blame their misery," he declared.

This is also the explanation, the speaker said, "of the sudden weed-like growth in America of numerous movements of organized prejudice and hate."

While religious differences are historical conditions and inevitable, nevertheless, declared Rabbi Pool, religious prejudices are entirely avoidable.

How to Outlaw War
Possibilities of war can be forestalled only when all men submerge their petty religious prejudices and cooperate in mutual resistance to the many evils threatening human welfare, Rabbi Pool maintained.

"When we are faced by the innumerable problems of race relations, political corruption, the far-reaching network of crime, gangsterism and racketeering, industrial unrest, unemployment, poverty, hunger and human misery, problems threatening the very stability of our society, how can men in their sanity spend their souls in the contemptible pettiness of prejudices instead of joining hands to fight together against these tremendous evils which threaten to engulf us all alike?" he asked.

Christians Puts Thumb - Screws On Congressmen to Aid His Plan

U. S. Fascist Leader Tells McGrady How He Got Rep. McFadden to Introduce a Bill Revamping Money System—Warned Congressmen They'd 'Bum'

The following is the third of a series of articles, "This Fascist Rocket," by Mr. McGrady, exposing, from the inside, the workings of a typical Fascist organization here, and revealing, through publication of the Fascist "chieftain's" correspondence, how and in what manner these racial racketeers are organized. The series appears daily in the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

To understand the man, George W. Christians, commander-in-chief of the Crusader White Shirts, president of the Crusaders for Economic Liberty, etc., it is well to give some consideration to his theory by which he proposes to restore economic normalcy to the United States.

In 1930, the commander-in-chief sat with his feet cocked upon the radiator in his Chattanooga office. It was November, and he was pensive. He considered the huge losses he had suffered in the stock market crash, the collapse of his engineering business, and unpleasantness incidental to all this. Because his business was dependent largely upon general conditions he felt the necessity of reviving normalcy throughout the country, and under some happy inspiration he began writing a plan for a Human Effort Monetary System, under which precious metals would be abolished as money standards and human production substituted.

Christians much of a reader, and certainly not a writer, the result of Christians' manuscript was one of doubtful literary use. Concededly, he had paid little attention to economics until he decided to go down to construction to economic engineering. which Christians crashed the offices of congressmen, announcing that "if you don't do your part, we'll make you burn!"

McFadden Introduced Bill

In introducing the bill known as H. R. 4747 to the 72nd Congress, McFadden insisted upon inserting the clause "by request" to the introduction. This, Christians, he permitted.

The bill, according to its terms, provides that: "There shall be coined, printed and issued by the Government of the United States of America a new form of money to be based upon human effort as stabilized in this Act. The money to be coined, printed, and issued as required in this Act shall be of the same denomination as metallic coin as now in use. No gold or other precious metal shall be coined. The standard to be used as a basis of value of the money required to be coined, printed and issued in this Act shall be the average wage of male, unskilled common labor in the states of the union only at the 1928 level, which is assumed to be 42.63 cents per hour."

"The standard of value of the money to be coined, printed, and issued as required under the provisions of this Act shall be maintained by adjusting the interest rate at which this money shall be loaned so as to stabilize the labor wage set out in section 3 hereof. The interest rate shall be negative, if necessary, to restore the said labor wage to the standard as fixed in Section 3 of this Act. The interest rate shall be approved or changed at intervals of not more than one month nor less than one week and shall not be changed more than one per centum upon any occasion, except in case the President shall declare that an economic emergency exists, in which case the rate may be changed by geometric progression."

Only Citizens Eligible

Those eligible for loans are, according to the bill, "only American citizens or combined American citizens, only on first mortgages on real estate situated in the United States and its possessions only or United States Government bonds. The ratio of the value of collateral to money applied for shall be, in case of real estate mortgages, not less than two-thirds to one, based on the market value of the real estate pledged, and in the case of bonds not less than one and one-fourth to one."

Section 9 of the bill provides that, "The paper money to be printed and issued as required by this Act shall bear the following notation: 'The Government of the United States of America pledges its honor and its entire resources to maintain the value of this money by means of the interest rate at which it is loaned so as to stabilize,

as nearly as possible, the average wage of male, unskilled, common labor in the United States at \$42.63 per hour."

Admits Price Rises

Christians concedes that under his system, whereby money will be printed in wholesale quantities to meet the need of capitalists, who are to take advantage of negative interest, prices will rise. Despite this, he is determined to keep the average wage of male, unskilled common labor at forty-two cents an hour, with other wages ranging accordingly. He admits that the wage will not buy as much as it does now or as it did in 1928. Still he persists in maintaining it constant.

When asked whether or not he did not think the capitalists would quickly take advantage of his government's generous offer of gratitudes for borrowed free money, Christians declared:

"These here rich fellows are too dumb to know what it's all about. Before they realize the bargain, the little fellows will be in there ahead of them borrowing all they can get hold of."

Christians did admit, however, that while "these here rich fellows" might be awfully dumb personally, they were smart enough to hire alert assistants strategically placed to take advantage of every opportunity to make more money for their masters.

When asked whether or not he believed it true that all but a few would be ineligible for his generous negative interest, Christians admitted that he did.

"The little fellows will get work."

As far as my questions and his answers would disclose he bases this assumption purely on faith.

The drawing was a crude affair, but with some suggestion of power, with just enough expression of feeling to make me dubious about it. I hated to believe that it was as bad as it looked and thought perhaps that a second look might bring to light its hidden merits, if any.

And so I said: "If you'll be good enough to let me keep it a couple of days so that you know whether I want to use it or not."

Whereupon the man brooked and with more than a mere suggestion of accent—which I will not attempt to reproduce—said: "What! You want to keep it so you can make a copy from it! No." And the priceless masterpiece went back into its wrappings.

I wonder how he could have found out that we maintain, at great expense, a group of expert copyists among ourselves and the copies of the unsold masterpieces which are daily brought to our attention, and then that we direct the artist to make as originals, at fabulous prices to the dealers on Fifty-seventh street? I thought this was a well-kept secret among ourselves and the copyists and the dealers, but some people are so psychic there's no keeping anything from them!

Poland Sends Three Jews To a Concentration Camp

WARSAW, July 9. — Nathan Buxbaum, Rosenbaum and Zewicki, arrested Jewish working class leaders, will be sent to a concentration camp in the near future, Rabotnik, Polish Socialist paper, reported today.

Earlier reports stated that the men would be released, since the Polish government found no incriminating evidence against them. Their release was expected early this week.

Portable Theatres to Keep Children Off Streets in N. Y.

come a serious menace to the country.

"Whether an organic connection with the German government is proved or not," he declared, "any organization that has the same idea as the Nazis in Germany is a danger to our country."

During the morning session the committee uncovered the following information:

At least two persons maintain joint memberships in the Stahlhelm, German veteran organization, comparable to the American Legion, and the New York National Guard, although neither has taken out first citizenship papers.

Within the Nazi organization there exists a "Schutz Staff," uniformed, disciplined, and functioning in the manner of Hitler's Schutz Staff, or higher grade storm troops.

Swap for Publicity
Under diplomatic manipulation, the committee learned American writers and lecturers have been given free transportation to and from Germany on the basis of their status in the favorable publicity for the New Germany.

All Germans working for a number of German enterprises in the United States have been compelled to join the Nazi Labor Front.

The committee opened hearings with Congressman John McCormack, chairman, Samuel Dickstein and J. P. Taylor.

The committee opened the first private hearings by John Schroeder, an employee of the New York office of the North German Lloyd and the Hamburg American Lines, was read into the record. Schroeder recently returned to Germany.

According to his testimony the following writers and lecturers received free transportation to Germany and back, some at the suggestion of Ambassador Hans Luther:

Karl K. Kitchen, well known New York newspaper editor; Albert Gleason and Col. Alexander E. Powell.

Holmes' Letter
According to evidence introduced from the files of the North German Lloyd Butlin Holmes wrote that concern on April 2, 1934:

"I hope that I may be able to secure through your good offices and those of the railways and the government some striking film material to be used in a lecture that I can use to advantage with my own reels as I did in the case of my recent lecture on 'The New Reich'."

On March 15, in mentioning the desirability of such publicity as he might give the New Germany, Holmes wrote in part: "Newspaper comment is shaped to please reader; pictures speak louder than words and what reaches the public eye is what counts. It has been read or heard is forgotten."

He said, "anticipate some hostile criticism, but be prepared to present the true facts on the New Germany."

Not only was Holmes given a free passage on the New Germany, but also given free passage on an African cruise aboard a German ship, the testimony disclosed. On the African cruise, proclaimed by the German lines, he was accompanied by his wife and two friends.

Walter Feige Quizzed
The United States, which was visited by Feige in June, 1932, joined the local organization of the Stahlhelm on the day of his arrival.

Upholds Hitlerism

Feige testified that he had not applied for his first papers until May of this year "because I had no work and no money." He did admit, however, that he managed to pay his dues in the Stahlhelm, which amounts to \$12 yearly.

In describing his joining the National Guard, he said that many of his friends in the Stahlhelm and himself had been approached to join by "so many persons" he had forgotten their names. An application blank for membership in the National Guard was introduced to show that at the time Feige had not announced application for first papers.

"I don't know anything about that," Feige told the committee. "Just in time, and when I went out of the recruiting office they said everything was O. K."

He became a member of Battery F, Company 1, 21st Artillery, 1st Coast Artillery. His military career, which he still carries, has been signed by Captain Louis A. Imhof.

Membership Illegal
Under the law, according to a committee release, it is necessary for a member of the National Guard to have first citizenship papers.

Feige told the committee that the only papers he had shown to the recruiting officer was his German passport, possession of which he retains.

He was asked about a Fred Nisselbeck, who has been recognized as the creator of an organization called "The National Guardmen of German Artillery," which has cooperated with a number of social affairs with the Stahlhelm unit in New York. Nisselbeck, Feige said, had given him a letter of resignation from the National Guard after some publicity attended his dual relationship with that organization and the Stahlhelm.

He testified that officers of the Stahlhelm, the National Guard and the American Legion frequently attended one another's meetings.

Another witness, who previously testified in private sessions, said that he had been brought before the committee yesterday by virtue of his failure to serve him with a subpoena. He is Gerhard Zimmer, who is a member of both the Stahlhelm and the 212th Artillery of the New York National Guard.

Zimmer was asked by the committee at private hearings whether he was a citizen he replied:

"Not exactly."

Never Took First Papers
He records shows that, despite the fact that he was introduced to Captain Marchand of the National Guard by Nisselbeck, now recognized as an ardent Nazi, he never taken out first citizenship. The committee could not make a

false statement on his National Guard application blank by asserting that he had taken out papers on February 17, 1931, no record of which is on file at the Supreme Court. He applied for citizenship papers from the National Guard during the Congressional investigation in June.

When Dickstein asked Feige whether or not he had taken any guns out of the National Guard Armory, Feige replied:

"We use only six-inch guns there. We are artillery."

Schroeder's testimony included excerpts of correspondence between Heinz Schuegel, managing director of the North German Lloyd, and Dr. Rudolf Lettner, the counselor of the German Embassy at Washington. The following letter was written on June 27, 1933, by Schuegel to Dr. Lettner:

Hopeful on Fovell
"On the evening of the departure of the S.S. Bremen Dr. Luther expressed his wish to have transmitted to Col. Alexander D. Powell an invitation for a trip to Germany. Dr. Luther attached great importance to this favor, especially as he expects much good in favor of Germany (to result) from the activity of this well-known statesman."

"In the meantime Kr. Kiep too has spoken to me over the telephone in this matter and he remarked that he is still in touch with the German ambassador, as he intends to make a new arrangement concerning this."

"These lines are merely to serve as a reminder to the work of the ambassador with my entire attention and I shall now wait what I will hear from you or Dr. Kiep. For the time being I enclose herewith our latest sailing schedule."

Fritz Gissibl, preceding Heinrich Kr. Kiep, testified emphatically declared Hitler was the leader of every German, regardless of where he was born.

"For me, anyway leader," Gissibl explained, "I do not mean political, I mean that he transcends racial feeling and is the leader of all Germans, and still he is no matter where they were born."

At this point he ignored a question asked by Mr. Dickstein to lift his head and smile as a photographer taking his picture.

Ninety-eight per cent of the American press, asserted Gissibl, printed lies about Germany.

Effort to End Poultry Strike Meets Failure

Peterson and Morgan Defer Plans to See Wallace

Leroy Peterson, supervisor of the Live Poultry Code Association, and William Fellows Morgan Jr., commissioner of markets, made fruitless efforts yesterday in bringing about a settlement of the dispute between the poultry commission men and the retail dealers. The strike called last Thursday by the Live Poultry Slaughter House Association, the organization which controls eighty-five per cent of the business in Greater New York, continued unabated.

Peterson and Morgan, who had planned to go to Washington yesterday to confer over the situation with Secretary of Agriculture Henry A. Wallace, deferred their trip. Peterson said he would go to Washington today, but Morgan probably will see Secretary Wallace later in the week.

Abraham Franzel, president of the slaughter house association, declared his organization is determined to hold out in its demands for lower coop hire, trucking and storage charges. He said the organization is practicing the setting of an arbitrary daily figure for the wholesale cost of chickens.

Of thirty-eight trucks in the poultry market yesterday, only seven were unloaded, according to reports. These crates were delivered principally to retail dealers, he said.

9 Jews Slain In Germany

(Continued from Page One) the city of Glogau, in Silesia, about sixty miles from Breslau. No details were given as to how the Jews met their deaths.

A shocking tragedy was revealed as having occurred in Berlin. Police last Wednesday evening entered the home of Maximilian Stein, one of Germany's best known lawyers and commercial counselors, and arrested his twenty-year-old son. The youth's body was returned to his distraught parents that evening with the curt explanation that the boy had committed suicide by throwing himself out a window of police headquarters.

The family was warned to conduct the funeral services with the utmost quietness.

The nine deaths thus far reported were not believed part of a general campaign of terror against the Jews but, to represent sporadic attacks incidental to the general disorders which followed the execution of storm trooper units and suppression of violent revolts by the present regime.

Whether these attacks are representative of a situation existing generally throughout the Reich could not be told today with any degree of certainty. No attacks on Jews were reported up to July 3.

The Jewish community organization conducted a survey by sending representatives to all provinces. What has happened since that date, with the exception of the cases cited here, could not be established with any degree of accuracy because of censorship and other inquiries into the provinces almost impossible.

Gen. Guido Luizi Heads

Turin Jewish Community
ROME, July 9.—General Guido Luizi, famous Italo-Jewish military commander and director of the Turin garrison and war-time commissary-general of the Italian army, was elected president of the Jewish community today. General Luizi is prominent in the Italian Fascist party.

(Continued from Page One) fainted and was quickly revived. Only a small portion of the throng gained admittance.

Body Is Brought
Promptly at two o'clock the body was brought to the synagogue from the Memorial Chapel. The hearse made its way through the streets of the East Side with a large throng following, while windows of nearby houses were crammed with the curious. Groups peered down from roofs of tenements.

When the casket, draped in black, was carried into the synagogue, all jumped to their feet. The casket was placed in the center of the room. The immediate family seated themselves in an enclosure in front of the pulpit.

David Parnes presided over the services. Rabbi Elie Idelson, of the synagogue, officiated. The cantor Samuel Kantaroff chanted the "El Mole Rachamin," prayer for the dead.

Speakers reviewed Beilis' tragic career. They told how he was imprisoned in Russia twenty-three years ago, charged with "ritual murder," instigated by the Russian government for the purpose of a Semitic campaign. Beilis, a Kiev brickyard superintendent, was held incommunicado for two years. The charge was the murder of a young girl, finally the accused was released.

'His Name Is Holy'

"His name is holy to Jews throughout the world," Rabbi Idelson said. "With tears streaming down his face he pointed to the weeping family and said, 'Don't think that only the family has lost a dear one. The Jewish people have lost a great man.'"

The congregants burst into tears.

In the family pew Esther Beilis, wife of the deceased, was on the verge of collapse. She lay crying in the arms of her daughters, May and Ray. The two surviving sons, David and Teddy, stood sobbing in front of the pulpit.

The rabbi told how the Russian government, realizing its mistake, offered a release Beilis secretly but the martyr refused. He demanded a public trial at which his innocence would be proved.

"Beilis is not leaving us now," Rabbi Idelson continued. "As long as the Jewish people live so long will the spirit of Beilis survive."

Large Crowd Follows

The speaker concluded with a simple eulogy. "He was a fine and true Jew," he said.

The services over, the crowd moved slowly into the streets where it broke up peacefully. Morris Kulkof, who befriended Beilis upon his arrival here six years ago, was in charge of the funeral. He paid all expenses.

Endeks Sought Downfall Of State Through Attacks

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, July 9.—The destruction of the Jewish property and attacks upon the persons of Jews as a means of causing violent overthrow of the existing Polish government, was the chief program of the Polish government, it was announced.

The act of indictment filed against a group of young Endeks arrested at Czenstochowa a short time ago charges them with having conspired against the government, and stated in part:

"The young Endeks intended to destroy Jewish property and to attack Jews, purposing thus to provoke a violent overthrow of the Polish state."

Held 29 Polish Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) HAIFA, July 8.—According to a police report today, twenty-nine Polish Jews were arrested last night in Haifa for entering the country illegally.

Polish Jews Hampered By British Consulate In Zion Immigration

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, July 9.—The British Consulate here is placing increasing difficulties in the way of Palestine-bound tourists. The Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today. The difficulties, it was revealed by prospective tourists, are even placed in the path of those Jews who are able to deposit the required £60 with the Consulate. Reason for this action is ascribed by the Consulate to the fact that a number of Jewish tourists have allegedly forfeited their deposits and remained illegally in Palestine.

3 Faiths Move To Clean Movies

(Continued from Page One) Caffrey, rector of Holy Cross Church, Rev. Walter M. Hoyt, Rev. Dr. Newell, Rabbi Sidney E. Goldstein and Rabbi William F. Rosenblum, Charles H. Tuttle, former United States district attorney and counsel for the Federation of Churches of Greater New York, was present as legal adviser.

Father McCaffrey, who presided at the luncheon and later acted as spokesman for the group, declared that the participation of the Catholic Church in the movement for a "clean" film industry, more than 1,200,000 Catholics in the Archdiocese of New York were behind the movement.

Faiths Must Assist

Rabbi Sidney E. Goldstein, who was delegated to arrange for an interview with motion picture producers in which the three faiths appeared, said that the group would explain their objections to current films, declared that it was essential for Jews to assist in the cleansing.

A careful study of the motion picture industry reveals the fact that production, distribution and exhibition is largely controlled by Jews. Dr. Goldstein said that is true, a special responsibility rests upon the Jewish people, more particularly upon Jewish leaders, to do the utmost to clean the motion pictures of all suggestiveness, indecency and obscenity." Dr. Goldstein declared.

We are cooperating with the Catholic and Protestant groups both because we believe the motion picture is frequently a danger to the moral life of the community and because we are convinced that many pictures produced by Jewish concerns and issued by Jewish executives are a dishonor and a disgrace to the Jewish people.

"The New York Board of Jewish Ministers and the Central Conference of American Rabbis mean to do the same thing," Dr. Goldstein said. "We are determined to purge the motion picture industry and theatre, and to remake both the theatre and the motion picture into what they ought to be, an instrument of education and enlightenment. There are certain occupations from which we are excluded by others. There are also certain enterprises from which, because of the ideals of Israel, we must deliberately exclude ourselves."

Italo-Jewish Savant Sued by Reich Firm For Purse Reichsal

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) MILAN, July 9.—Despite the fact that officially it is practically impossible for Italian Jews to buy German-made goods, most Italo-Jews are doing so, and are being systematically avoided all contact with Germany, it was revealed today.

Dr. Joseph Weiss, Jewish professor, head of an important state institution, was approached by a German firm and asked to buy a new X-ray apparatus for use in his institution.

Labor Zionists Are Assailed At Herzl Rites

Switch From Ideal Is Laid to Them by Revisionists

An attack on general Zionism and Labor Zionism for swerving from the ideal of Herzl's Zionism was the keynote of a memorial service for Dr. Theodor Herzl, the Organization and the Brit Trust, held for Dr. Theodor Herzl and Chaim Nachman Bialik last night at the Grand, Fifteenth street and Irving place.

"When in 1897," said Louis Altman, Revisionist leader, "Dr. Herzl assembled the first Zionist Congress, the Jewish Socialist movement assembled somewhere in Eastern Europe to establish their organization entitled 'The Bund.' A bitter rivalry between the two ideologies—that of Herzl's Zionism on the one hand and that of Marxian Socialism on the other—developed. The career of Jewish public life for decades.

"The Poale-Zionists have tried for the last decade to reconcile the Zionism of Herzl with the Socialism of the Bund. But instead of bringing the Jewish Socialists into the Zionist camp, they converted Zionists to Socialism."

Epstein compared the Stavsky case to the Dreyfus affair. "It is a tragedy," he said, "because it is displaying its inconsistency by holding memorial meetings for Dr. Herzl. They who have abandoned the moral law of Jewish public life have no right to shelter themselves in its shadow."

"Supine leadership and weak political action are the hallmarks of present-day Zionism, have nothing in common with the Herzl's Zionism."

It was also told that Dreyfus was greatly instrumental in influencing Dr. Herzl in his determination toward the idea of Zionism, because of his position in the position of Jews to continue to live in the European atmosphere. Dr. Herzl was fundamentally shocked and repelled by the anti-Semitism and slander against the Jews that the Dreyfus trial brought about.

"What shall we say now when among ourselves in the Zionist ranks some things are being repeated? Stavsky is being sacrificed on the altar of political machinations of the Histadrut in Palestine. The hatred displayed on the pages of the Histadrut press reminds one of the French press in the days of Dreyfus."

Dr. Goldstein said that the Revisionists constitute a danger to the Jewish people. He drew a parallel between Herzl and Vladimir Jabotinsky and asserted that the Revisionists were the "lovers of Zion." He said that he propagated the founder's ideas as he expressed them in his Yudenstern.

Danzis pointed out that the Revisionists constitute at the present time the only political Zionists in the entire Zionist movement. After the death of Dr. Herzl, when Dr. Weizmann came into power, political Zionism had disappeared. The movement then reverted to the original ideal of the "lovers of Zion." With the appearance of Jabotinsky, world Revisionist leader, Danzis declared, political Zionism was revived.

The memory of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement in this country, was honored at a meeting last night at the Theodor Herzl Society, 125 East Eighty-fifth street, Manhattan.
