B'nai B'rith and the Nazis

The statement made by Senator Alfred M. Cohen, president of the B'nai B'rith, in answer to the recent attack on the B'nai B'rith in Germany published in the Nazi press, will hardly convince the Nazis of the humanitarian and philanthropic work of this Jewish organization. The Hitlerites know very well the scope and the purpose of the activities of the B'nai B'rith, but they are deliberately seeking to discredit this fraternal Jewish order.

"Against the charge made by a malicious or uninformed journal that the B'nai B'rith is a 'secret order against Aryans,' it may not be inappropriate to direct attention to the very many eleemosynary, charitable, educational and patriotic undertakings which B'nai B'rith has supported in Germany, and which, unless interfered with by force, still continue as blessings not only for Jews, but for all peace loving Germans," said Mr. Cohen.

"They include the Manheimer Foundation, the Ahlem Agricultural School, the training facilities for nurses in Berlin, Frankfurt and Munich, the technical schools for instruction of boys in trades and mechanical handicrafts, employment bureaus, a sanatorium for poor Jewish children at Bad Nauheim, a German Jewish children's home at Dietz, numerous orphanages, asylums and schools for backward children, and recreation centers."

Mr. Cohen points out that during the three-year period of 1932-1931, B'nai B'rith expended in Germany \$350,000 a year on these educational and charitable institutions.

The Nazi government regards any educational and humanitarian activities as benefactions directed "against Aryans." The assurance given by Mr. Cohen that B'nai B'rith, unless interfered with by force, will continue to aid not only German Jews but peace-loving Germans is sure to irritate the Nazis still more. For the present murderers of Germany are doing their utmost to shut out any love of peace among the German people. To speak of peace to the Nazis is like waving a red flag to a bull.

A Wise Choice

The appointment of Judge Rosalinsky by Mayor LaGuardia as a member of the city poultry market difficulties is a very wise move. The prestige and authority of Judge Rosalinsky, as well as his genuine interest in the Jewish community, will bring from being dragged into unsavory and shady conflicts, will hasten to restore order in the chaotic situation existing between the wholesalers, the commission merchants and the kosher poultry shochtim.

Lord Rothermere Drops Mosley In Tiff Over Anti-Semitism

LONDON, July 18.—Onward Mosley, leader of the British Union of Fascists, better known as the Black Shirts, has lost his chief backer, Lord Rothermere, powerful publisher of a large and influential chain of newspapers.

An open break between Mosley and Rothermere, chiefly on the Jewish question in Fascism, will be revealed in tomorrow's London Daily Mail, leading Rothermere organ.

Rothermere's withdrawal of his support, which he first gave to the Black Shirt movement on January 15 of this year, came as a result of a letter received from Mosley in which the fiery young emulator of Hitler and Mussolini related his attitude on the Jewish problem.

"We pleaded that no racial or religious persecution would occur under British Fascism," he wrote Lord Rothermere, "but we require that Jews should put their first interests in Great Britain. We don't admit Jewish members into our movement because they have bitterly attacked us and because they have organized an international movement with racial interests above national. Jews, therefore—"

Much Kosher Poultry Bogus, Hearing Told

Simon Makes Disclosure as Shochtim Ask \$45-\$65 Pay

Much of the poultry that goes under the name of kosher in New York City is, in reality, not kosher, it was disclosed yesterday at the first hearing conducted by Judge Otto Rosalinsky, newly appointed mediator of the poultry market difficulties, in his chambers in the Criminal Courts Building.

Arthur Simon, Health Department confidential investigator in charge of Kashruth and adviser to Judge Rosalinsky, said, in investigation of New York City poultry markets revealed that in many markets fowl was being slaughtered so rapidly, under the pressure of market owners, that it was not kosher.

Spokesmen for Shochtim Union Local 440, the organization of slaughterers, agreed with Simon's assertion.

During a heated three-cornered debate involving the attorneys for the slaughterers, the wholesalers and the retailers, J. Sidney Bernstein, counsel to the New York Live Poultry Slaughterhouse Association, organization of wholesalers, declared:

Stavsky Appeal Decision Is Set For Tomorrow

Prosecution and Defense Sum Up—Court Bars Mejid Confession

JERUSALEM, July 18.—Arguments on the appeal to upset the conviction of Abraham Stavsky on the charge of having murdered Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff closed late this afternoon before the Palestine Appeals Court.

Counsel for the prosecution and the defense summed up their arguments. Chief Justice Sir Michael Francis Joseph McDonnell, who presided, announced that the decision of the court would be announced Friday morning. Sitting with the Chief Justice were Justices Baker and de Freitas.

Crowds of Palestinian Jews, anxious to hear the verdict in the case which has agitated Jewish Palestine for more than a year, besieged the building in which the court sessions were being held. In anticipation of the verdict police forces were posted around the building.

Communists Expel Jews From Ranks on Charge Of Adhering to Religion

MOSCOW, July 18.—Four Jewish colonists of the Jewish collective Stalin in the Crimea were expelled from the Communist party today when it was revealed that their male children had been circumcised in the orthodox ritual manner and that religious services had been held in the collective.

The accused, who were being tried by the Communist commission which is in charge of investigating the fitness of members to stay in the party, pleaded that the stubborn religious attitude maintained by their wives was responsible, but the commission held that they were responsible for the actions of their wives.

BERLIN, July 18.—A status quo policy on Jewish rights will be maintained by the German government, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency was informed today by a reliable authority in government circles.

The informant revealed that no special anti-Jewish laws will be issued for some time to come. On the other hand, however, no move will be made to restore Jewish rights even in the slightest degree, your correspondent was given to understand.

'Grandmother Clause' Invoked to Weed 'Non-Aryans'

LONDON, July 19 (Thursday). The former commander of the Gunzenhausen storm troopers, Baer, who was sentenced to serve a term in prison for his part in the Gunzenhausen pogroms, shot and fatally wounded Simon Straus and seriously wounded Straus's son because the older Straus had testified against Baer and eighteen storm troop defendants, the London Times reports today.

Baer following the trial was deposed as Nazi leader and had not yet begun to serve his sentence although the trial was concluded a month ago.

BERLIN, July 18.—A sweeping campaign to completely "Aryanize" Nazi Germany began today under the direction of Dr. Wilhelm Frick, Nazi Minister of the Interior for the Reich and Prussia.

Dr. Frick issued an official order notifying all employees of the German government regardless of their position that they must without delay certify again and again proof that they and their wives are "pure Aryans."

Dr. Frick's order was hailed by extremist anti-Jewish elements in the Third Reich as evidence that the Nazi government had no intention of easing up in the campaign against the Jews.

Added significance was lent Dr. Frick's order by an article published this week in a leading Nazi paper by Dr. Joachim Goerke, head of the racial division of the Ministry of the Interior. Dr. Goerke openly declared that the

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Shortage of Labor In Palestine Admitted

LONDON, July 18.—Captain W. F. Strickland, Conservative, again raised the question of the tremendous shortage of labor in Palestine in the House of Commons today. Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lister, British Secretary of State for Colonies who answered for the government, for the first time admitted that there is a shortage of labor, adding that the Palestine government had granted permission for 500 skilled busmen from Morocco to enter the country in addition to the usual number of Jewish immigrants on the regular quota.

Nazis Call Chicago Convention To Raise Lagging Hatred Spirit

Eleventh hour attempts to revive a lagging Nazi anti-Jewish movement in the United States are under way, it was learned here yesterday.

According to the current issue of the Deutsche Zeitung, Nazi organ, the DAWA, anti-Jewish boycott organization of the Nazis, will hold a national convention in the Stevens Hotel at Chicago, October 21 to 23.

The Nazi paper sets forth attractive rates so that all expenses including first class railroad accommodations from New York, lodging and meals at the Stevens

Hotel, and other essentials can be met by payment of \$77.

According to a release yesterday by the American Jewish Congress, the DAWA is alleged to have enlisted the aid of the North German Lloyd Line in making available special reduced rates to Germans wishing to attend the congress. It further states that a similar offer is being made to secure special favors from railroad companies.

Thousands of Jews throughout the Borough of Brooklyn will at- tend special services in observance of Tisha B'ab this Saturday, it was announced yesterday by the Brook- lyn Federation of Jewish Charities. These services will be conducted by the affiliates of the twenty-five constituent agencies of the Federa- tion in cooperation with synago- gues, temples, community cen- ters, YM and YWHA's of the bor- ough.

Commemorating the fall of Jerusalem, Tisha B'ab is a day of fasting and mourning for Jews throughout the world.

In calling for mutual observance of the Holy Day by Brooklyn Jews, the Federation issued the follow- ing statement:

"At this critical time, when
thousands of our Jewish families
are facing economic hardship,
when our people in Germany are
being disfranchised and deprived
of the simplest opportunities for
themselves and their families,
when hundreds of thousands of
Jews in Poland, in Rumania and
Latvia are persecuted and disori-
ented against, the Jews of
Brooklyn should show their sym-
pathy with their downtrodden co-
religionists in the most extraor-
dinary way. This is
what we aim to do in these special
programs."

The most solemn part of the
services, declared the Federation, will
be the chanting of plaintive
melodies and the reading of Jeremias's Lamentations.

Two others named by former Magistrate Goldstein in his criminal libel suit against the *Deutschland* Zeitung, Nazi organ published here, pleaded not guilty before Magistrate Gasper Lloyd in the City Court House, Brooklyn, yesterday.

Walter Kappe, editor of the German section of the pro-Nazi organ, was held in \$500 bail and Joseph Goldstein, editor of the D. Z. Publishing Corporation, which publishes the paper, was placed in the custody of his attorney for further hearing August 20. Two codefendants, William L. McLaughlin, vice president of the corporation and editor of the English section of the sheet, and the D. Z. Publishing Corporation, who had pleaded not guilty to similar charges last week, were continued in the custody of their attorney, Walter G. Bathson.

The suit is based upon an editorial published in the *Deutschland* Zeitung July 7th last, entitled "The Jewish Goldstein, a filthy liar," accusing Goldstein of perjury in his defense of three high school students who were convicted of assault.

The request for an adjournment of about a month was made by Bathson, who explained to the court that a delay was necessary to enable Goldstein to get an affidavit and to interview County Judge John J. Fitzgerald of Kings County, District Attorney Geoghan and Assistant District Attorney John Keen, whose statements, according to the attorney, prompted the article in the Zeitung.

In the case referred to Judge Fitzgerald said that one of the youths to the New York County penitentiary for an indeterminate term and sentenced the other two to a year in city prison.

After sentence was passed Goldstein moved to set it aside, declaring that Geoghan and Keen, who produced the affidavits, had lied and believe that the boys would not be sent to jail.

Charged Deliberate Persecution He charged that the boys had been persecuted because of their race. He said that a detective "named Enright" had offered "to fix the case for \$300."

"That story is a manufactured story," Judge Fitzgerald retorted at the end of the hearing. "You came to my chambers, but never made that disclosure to me. You have the effrontery to stand up here and say that this case was not given full publicity by me. No other case has given me so much concern as this. No promise as to sentence was ever given to you, and I am not sure that you are not lying."

Keppe's bail was set upon the \$500.

suggestion of Assistant District Attorney William A. McGuire. McGuire said he understood the editor was an alien, and in order to assure his appearance at the next session he asked that bail be fixed at \$1,000. Bathson said his client could not raise that sum and the Magistrate fixed the lower figure.

The Libelous Article The article upon which the suit is based follows:

"Joseph Goldstein, an ex-magistrate under Walker, a benefactor of those who commit rape should be dishonored! It was not enough that this scurvy and unscrupulous prostitute before the bar defended three young Jews who committed rape, but he tried to seduce and intimidate an honest man, a Jew, and a Jewess. The fearless Judge Fitzgerald and the equally conscientious District Attorney Geoghan with his assistant Keen, condemn him in certain terms the despicable Goldstein when he said that the court had agreed to let the boys go on a suspended sentence if they would plead guilty."

"No stronger case to illustrate corruption by unscrupulous lawyers in America has ever been shown. This is a type of malpractice few lawyers who have the rank and decency to come before a court and say in plain English that the court made an agreement to free three young men who committed rape when no such promise had ever been made by either the court or by the District Attorney. He went further and said that the policeman in the case had offered to 'hush the matter up' for \$300. When the District Attorney of Kings County, Judge Fitzgerald, charged the filthy Goldstein re- fused to make a complaint. That is evidence enough that Goldstein is a criminal liar of the lowest possible sort."

"Every decent resident of the City of New York should write to the Association of the Bar at 42 Broadway, New York City, and insist that the charges of malpractice and premeditated perjury be brought against former Magistrate Joseph Goldstein so that he can be completely disbarred by the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of the State of New York."

"New York City must be rid of such dirty contemptible wolves as Joseph Goldstein."

Braverman, chairman; Robert Karon, first vice-chairman; Dr. Harry W. Davis, second vice-chairman; E. A. Horwitz, secretary; E. A. Silberstein, treasurer, and Mrs. M. Greenberg, assistant treasurer.

The funds will be turned over to the joint district committee and the Jewish Agency for Palestine to be used for general relief work cooperating with James G. MacDonald, chairman of the relief commission of the League of Nations.

Refuses Offer

Westchester Body Will Not Take Part in Fest, Garvey Asserts

Department Commander J. Garvey of the Veterans of Foreign Wars yesterday announced that the local body of the organization had voted not to participate in affairs of foreign veterans' organizations in the United States.

He declared this held true in regard to proposed celebrations by the Stahlheim, German veterans' group here. On further questioning he said that it did not apply to other groups "such as Italian and French."

"The Westchester County Council," he said, "voted that it had no desire to take part in affairs of the organization because of the disturbed political conditions in Germany."

Jedgar H. Burnham, past commander of the Jewish War Veterans, said his organization did not protest against participation by American war veterans in a Stahlheim celebration which is being scheduled for August 10.

"We haven't objected to it," he declared, "and we haven't even been asked to do so."

Stahlheim Chief Dines Report Captain Robert Liebert-Emden, head of the New York unit of the Stahlheim, yesterday made reports that a German fest in which his organization was to have joined with the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the American Legion and the Stueben Society, had been called off because of non-cooperation by American veterans.

The occasion, which was to have embraced field day exercises and a music festival, was set for August 10.

"I am quite certain that no American military organization can bear prejudice against the American Stahlheim," Captain Liebert-Emden yesterday told The Jewish Daily Bulletin. "Our organization is to be friends with America and many of us are good American citizens."

We are shocked to learn of reports that the affair might be cancelled otherwise than in a friendly way by any American group, particularly veterans."

Captain Liebert-Emden stated plans for the affair had been abandoned because it came close to a celebration planned for Labor Day in Rochester.

All Allied Vets Invited "All American veterans have been invited to be with us on Labor Day. We have sent out invitations to the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion and, as I understand it, they will be there."

The American Stahlheim has been widely commended by the mother organization in Germany, which is composed of 1,000,000 veterans of the World War. A German official of the Stahlheim Nazis to dissolve the Stahlheim and create it anew as a Nazi League of Front Soldiers was not completely successful. The speaker to the same in this country met with no success whatsoever. Hitlerism is synonymous with anti-Semitism. Judophobia is the main theme of the Hitler program. No amelioration in the situation of German Jewry is possible as long as Hitler is in power. The Hitler will not change suddenly his attitude toward the Jews. First Hitlerism will be stamped out, and then the Jews will be expelled out of the rabid disease of anti-Semitism with which he has been infecting them for the past fourteen years.

Jewish Refugees in Paris Form Grave Problem, Bernstein Says

Returns From Survey of Europe With HIAS Head, Herman

Returning yesterday morning on the Italian liner Rex, from a visit to France, Russia and Palestine, Abraham Herman, president of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society, and John L. Bernstein, former president, who have been studying the Jewish work in Europe with special attention directed to the German-Jewish refugee situation, declared that 15,000 Jewish refugees in Paris constitute a most serious problem for HIAS and cooperating societies.

Mr. Bernstein emphasized that Palestine is the only permanent solution for the dilemma in which expropriated German Jews find themselves.

"Palestine," he said, "is the only place to which we would like to see additional Jewish immigration. A feverish activity is seen in almost all lines of endeavor to speed Jewish immigration to Palestine, planning, transportation and education."

Aided Many Refugees
 HIAS, he added, through its participation with Emigrant and Ica, has been a pillar of light to struggling Jewish refugees.

In Russia, the HIAS officials discussed with authorities the possibility of entry for certain classes of German and other Jews. They pointed out that they were replete with sympathetic interest and gave indications of willingness to cooperate. In addition they have concluded an agreement with Torgin to facilitate the aid which some Russians receive from American relatives.

Mr. Bernstein declared it was his intention to return to Russia, where he was born, due to the extraordinary changes wrought by Communism.

Little Communism
 "But paradoxical as it may seem, there is little or no Communism in Russia," Mr. Bernstein said. "There is Socialism, or perhaps, State Capitalism. There is private ownership of personal property and even of real estate sufficient for home and garden."

"People in Russia lead a very hard life. Practically all of them are working—there is very little unemployment in Russia—but their wages are inadequate to provide them with the necessities of life, not to mention the comforts. The young bear their hardship with fortitude. They have faith that things will be better, as the Soviet becomes a beacon light for the rest of the world. But the old are miserable."

"Especially pathetic is the condition of the elderly Jews and Jewesses. They were engaged nearly in business. They had no land. They know no trade. They are not physically capable of doing rough work and they find it hard to fit themselves into the new scheme of things."

Flight of Old Pathetic
 "Many of them have children in America. They have apparently forgotten their existence. Five dollars a month in the shape of an order on Torgin would save these elderly folk from privation and give them a little sunshine in their olden days. We are sure that if the children or other relatives of these people would realize what good their few dollars would produce, they would come to the aid of these hapless beings."

Of Palestine Mr. Bernstein was very enthusiastic. In all his travels he did not encounter a population that looked so happy and contented as the Jewish population of Palestine. Everybody is working, there is no unemployment and because labor is strongly organized,

 LONDON, July 18.—The concession granted by the Palestine government to Moses Novomeysky and his associates to exploit the potash and other mineral deposits of the Dead Sea in Palestine was completely upheld here today when the judges of the Kings Bench dismissed a suit calling for the vacating of Novomeysky's concession.

The plaintiff's allegations that he and his associates were the real concessionaires by virtue of a concession obtained from the Sultan Abdul Hamid in 1910 were dismissed by the court. Costs of the trial were assessed against the plaintiffs.

Novomeysky, who is a Jewish chemical engineer graduated from Russian technical schools and who fled from Russia after the Bolshevik revolution, has been in Palestine since 1918. After many attempts he obtained the concession in 1928 and organized the Palestine Potash Ltd. as a company with managing director. The concession is said to be of immense financial value.

'Andy' Goes Abroad on 'Verboten' Nazi Liner

Andy, Cupid's gift to Harlem's weaker sex, sailed early yesterday morning for Europe on board the verboten Nazi liner the Bremen, accompanied by his wife, Mrs. Charles J. Correll.

Questioned by reporters as to why he was disregarding the anti-Nazi boycott, the love-sick, trouble-hunting partner of the famed Andy and Andy team of the air waves, delivered himself of the following rather lame explanation:

"I have a great many Jewish friends," he said, "as well as numerous German friends. I would not knowingly antagonize a group for the world. The fact of the matter is, that I had not the slightest idea what boots I would take, coming or going."

Garment Strike To Affect 9,000 Jews in Trade

18,000 Knit Garment Workers to Answer Proposed Strike Call

Approximately 9,000 Jewish knit garment workers in New York and vicinity are expected to be affected by a proposed strike which is to be called this week, it was estimated yesterday by an official of the International Ladies' Garment Workers' Union, the parent organization.

Cooperating in the proposed strike, which was announced by the executive board of the I. L. G. W. union at a meeting Tuesday in the Hotel New Yorker, will be the United Textile Workers of America which has jurisdiction over part of the industry.

Together some 15,000 knit goods workers will walk out should the strike become an actuality.

The demands of the knit goods workers are for a wage increase of twenty-five to thirty per cent, the thirty-hour week, classification of wage scales and the closed shop.

Arthur Rosenberg, attorney, in an address last night over radio station WARD, urged all laborers in the United States to rally to the support of German labor by joining in the anti-Nazi boycott as the most effective means of reviving its former power. The broadcast was under the auspices of the American Jewish Congress.

"The labor unions in other European countries," Rosenberg said, "notably Czechoslovakia and France have joined in the boycott movement against Germany. It is the duty of every working person and every broadminded human being to participate in the boycott of German products so that the present regime in Germany may be forced out and labor in Germany may again resume its humane activities and that labor throughout the world may be reassured that its hard-gained victories will not have been in vain."

200 Children Attend Reopening of P. S. 31 Community Playground

Two hundred children, all under the age of eight and in the majority Jewish, yesterday attended the reopening of the roof playground of P. S. 31, Monroe and Gouverneur streets on the lower East Side.

The playground, which is now open for its third summer, is a project of the Community Council of the City of New York. August Heckaher and the Altman Foundation are among the contributors to the Council's funds collected for the foundation of such playgrounds throughout the city.

Ria Oppenheimer, of the Lower East Side Community Council, is supervisor of the playground which will be open all Summer for five days a week from 10 a. m. to 5:30 p. m.

Corporation Counsel Debates if Cantors Can Bind Couples

Assistant Corporation Counsel H. Broadman Epstein will have down early next week a decision on the question whether cantors and sextons may perform marriage ceremonies. It was announced yesterday following a secret session with a delegation of cantors at the Municipal building.

The question was raised by the Department of Health and Hospitals. The present rule states that rabbis and cantors may perform marriage ceremonies. The Corporation Counsel was asked to consider whether the cantors should be included with the rabbis.

During the last few days, Epstein has received representatives from the rabbis, sextons and cantors.

Discussion of the campaign against obscenity in motion pictures from the Jewish point of view and possible drastic action will be the features of today's meeting of the committee on social ethics of the New York Board of Jewish Ministers at the study of Rabbi Sidney E. Goldstein, 40 West Sixty-eighth street.

Dr. Goldstein, chairman of the committee, was busy yesterday rounding up the five members of the committee and informing them of the special meeting. He refused to comment on the subject to be discussed but indicated that some action will probably be taken.

The other members of the committee are the Rev. William P. Rosenbaum, Leo Jung, Elias Solomon, Sidney Tedeshe and Max Drob. The party will be held behind locked doors at 2 p. m.

Among the topics expected to be aired is the "identifying of the scope of activity of the Interfaith Committee of the Legion of Decency. When formerly only indecent films roused the indignation of the committee now both dance halls and theatres are under fire.

It was also announced that the church will be canvassed by local inter-faith committees which will attempt to obtain pledges from all persons to refrain from attending offensive films. These committees are to start work within two weeks.

The Rev. Joseph A. McCaffrey, pastor of the Holy Cross Roman Church, and chaplain of the New York City Police Department, could not be reached for a statement. He was as he was out at a police outing.

It is understood that the chief grievance against the theatres is the "Sevres" movies. Several months ago the burlesque houses promised to reform but have not kept their promise, according to the inter-faith committee.

Another feature of the committee program is to enlist the aid of school children when the fall semester starts. All school children, from college students to elementary school students, will be asked to stay away from indecent shows.

THE READER'S FORUM

Hungarian Jewry
To the Editor of the J.D.B.:
May I take this opportunity to correct the article which appeared in the Jewish Daily Bulletin on July 16, page 5, under the heading "Hungary Backs Move to Solve Problems of Three Jewish Sects," in which a Jewish Tribune Agency correspondent, Mr. A. Wiener.

It is my privilege to know the position of the Hungarian Jews since I was, until recently, chief rabbi in one of the oldest Jewish communities in Hungary. I deem it a necessity to inform the readers of the Jewish Daily Bulletin about the true situation of the Jewish communities in Hungary. About sixty-five years ago, on December 27, 1867, Hungarian Jewry won its emancipation, and in the following year, on December 10, 1868, the Hungarian government called together a congress of delegates representing the Jews. With the approval of the majority of the delegates this Congress decided to submit to the emperor a petition in which it stated that it was not in harmony with the Jewish Code of Law, known under the name of "Shulchan Aruch." On January 16, 1869, Emperor Francis Joseph gave his sanction to this constitution.

Draws Own Code
However, Orthodox Jewry, refusing to submit to the constitution, drew up one of its own, whose principles were in accordance with the Shulchan Aruch. After a hard and bitter struggle, the statutes of the latter Constitution were also officially accepted by the emperor. Having secured a complete legal equality with the Orthodox Jews organized themselves throughout the entire country as a separate, independent, religious body.

A third group, being dissatisfied with the splitting of Jewry into two organized bodies, declared their refusal to submit to either and organized themselves into a third party, called "Status-quo-ant," i. e. everything is to stay as it was before the meeting of the Congress, that every community remain independent and autonomous, without a centralized organization. To this latter party belonged well-known rabbis and eminent laymen, representing about sixty large communities.

Among them were numerous chassidic rabbis and prominent scholars, who belonged solely because they would not submit to a centralized organization as long as there was dissension among the Hungarian Jews. Consequently, although the law recognizes only one Jewish community, there are in reality three factions.

Were Neolog Jews
Those communities which accepted the statutes created by the congress were the progressive or Neolog Jews, who refused to recognize the division of Jewry into three bodies. They used their political influence to force the government to call another Congress into session for the purpose of drawing up a new set of statutes which would satisfy all factions and would thereby preserve the unity of the Hungarian Jews. The Orthodox and the Status-quo-Ante factions refused to participate in the proposed Congress.

The progressive Jewish communities, the so-called Neolog Jews, would not convene without the Orthodox and Status-quo-Ante groups, because by doing so they would be admitting the existence of three separate factions, and they would be denying the possibility that there can and will be a united Hungarian Jewry. Fierce arguments ensued. The Orthodox group said that in the past, organized independence. That, by no means, would bind themselves to any organization of progressive Jews.

The Neolog faction finally recognized that it was impossible to achieve their goal of uniting Hungarian Jewry and they abandoned

it. With the permission of the government they called their own convention, to meet October 15, 1934, for the purpose of completing and modifying their obsolete and outworn constitution.

Purpose of Congress
I want to state in opposition to your correspondent that according to a decree of June 2, 1934, issued by the Hungarian government, the purpose of the Congress will only be to modify the old constitution and to adjourn after this has been accomplished and not, as your correspondent has stated, to "become a permanent institution which will be regularly convened whenever Hungarian Jewry finds it necessary to decide momentous problems of the day."

Also, as opposed to a statement made by Mr. Wiener, the fact is that the new Congress can only be called together by a decree of the government and not by the Jewish leaders alone.

In closing, I offer my final criticism which is that the writer was wrong in stating that this Congress raises at a unification. It actually ratifies "tripartitism." Despite the fact that the "Progressive" Jewry law recognizes only one religious community, it is apparent that, by giving its consent to the new Congress, the government said in accepting the post, "have three independent divisions to govern their own religion, and so forth." Through this new development "tripartitism" has become stronger than ever in Hungarian Jewry.

Letters of Christians to Aides Reveal Mad Desire for Violence

And His Assistants, Without Hindrance From Authorities, Pass Call to Riots on Public, Correspondence Shows

The following is the tenth of a series of articles, "This Fascist Racket," by Mr. McGrady, exposing, from the inside, the workings of a typical Fascist organization here, and revealing, through publication of the Fascist "chief-tail" correspondence, how and in what manner these racial rackets are operated. The series appears daily in the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

Despite his frequent protestations of a "press conspiracy of silence" against his movement George W. Christians, head of the Crusader White Shirts, appears to be doing pretty well for himself.

By having a number of his aides in various parts of the country lead ignorant workers in demonstrations, the only possible objective of which is to publicize the movement, he has succeeded in gaining public notice.

Christians has a habit of claiming credit for every demonstration among strikers. He is ready at any time to lead any group into action (providing it doesn't jeopardize his own tender hide) for the publicity that will spring from it. Perhaps the only publicity he has received during recent months, aside from that given him by one or two German Nazi propagandists in German language periodicals is that in which his aide in Tampa, Fla., was mixed up in some agitation in which shady tactics at primary polls

are charged. The aide is T. O. Busbee, secretary of the League for Honest Voters. In a long letter, written in passing merely once. Here they were referred to by one person, the County Solicitor, as "The American Nazis."

"Due to Get Further publicity" Busbee, in a long letter to Christians, wrote in part: "I think it is a good opportunity to bring the Crusade movement before the public by filing a damage suit against the County Solicitor and the Tampa Morning Tribune. . . .

"I expect to call on my next meeting in the next ten days, at the Band Stand in the Court House Yard. The League of Unemployed congratulated me on my last meeting last Friday night. They were there in great numbers. They agreed to get together several thousand of their unemployed members, bring them to the Court House and do their 'Whoopee Stuff' while our speakers lambast the public officials."

"They are impressed with the fact that our speakers can publicly advocate violence and mob tactics, being brought before the public. The Leaders of the Unemployed came upon the stage at the Municipal Auditorium after the meeting and congratulated me, saying, 'You men have said things here tonight, that they would have thrown us into jail for saying.'"

"Christians' letters to his lieutenants indicate an insane desire to create violence in the name of the 'Crusader White Shirts' regardless of the consequences—regardless of whether or not workers realize their demands.

"Christians' attacks on Christians writes "sizzling" letters. The one to Thomas F. McMahon, president of the United Textile Workers of America, for instance. He says in part:

"Sooner or later, whether you A. F. of L. men like it or not, we are going to take the matter out of your hands and put on a general nation-wide strike for Economic Liberty and get it."

"The General Hugh Johnson, NRA administrator, in spite of recent ballyhoo to the contrary, no one really expects any honest patriotism from a Wall Street Racketeer who is the side-sick of a New York Jew Communist. However, you should have intelligence

only to Secretary Wallace in the Department of Agriculture. I took the job free on assurances that I would be free to conduct an independent writing and political contacts and would not be expected to act as propagandist for the department.

"It affords me an immediate opportunity of bringing my ideas to bear at once on the situation and I hope that you will regard me as a 'free lance' through which my ideas can be given attention. As you know, my feeling all along has been that President Roosevelt feared the mob to immediate, practical means through which reform could be obtained, and as his administration is moving in the right direction, I believe that now I can most usefully work with it for the objects which I have been advocating on the outside. Yours Very Truly

On February 7, 1934, Carter wrote: "Have received and acknowledged Fullman's letter, which caused a distinct fluttering in the doves-coats, but left me somewhat doubtful as to his sincerity. The only point is: How many people does he influence? How many people take the trouble to follow him? You along Fascist lines? What methods do you propose to follow to gain your power? In other words, is the simple business value of your political purposes or is there any real belief in your inner councils that Fascism, organized as a political party, will get to first base in this country?"

"Now as a practical man, I don't care how we get economic liberty, whether through HR4747 or anything else, but I do care whether we get it through the man who you call Democratic party, the Communists, or the 'American Fascists.' As a practical man, however, I believe that the shortest route to action lies through the man who has the power of initiative and political action, namely President Roosevelt, and all of my present activities are directed to making desirable action politically expedient, where you would make failure to take that action politically dangerous."

Denies He's a Crusader

On March 30, 1934, Carter again wrote: "Tell Higgins I immediately and formally contradicted his statement that I am a supporter of yours in the political sense of yours and not never have been. I am supporting Roosevelt and will continue to do so until further notice, as you very well know."

"Your financial plan for economic liberty is what I am interested in, but your political methods are entirely different to my own, and I want it perfectly clear that I am no more taking orders from you than you are from me. I have no more intention of wearing your livery than I have of coming out as a Fascist or Communist. I'll work with Roosevelt so long as he is going my direction, as he is now. Yours—"

Christians was more eager to surrender the above correspondence to me. I believe he may have poured in this material at Carter's failure to join him wholeheartedly. It is possible that Christians had the number of other persons whose confidence was exposed here had outlived their usefulness to him.

Also in the Christians' correspondence some correspondence from Senator Huey P. Long's office. Long, I mentioned in an earlier series, is head and tail of the nation's "Man A King." The gentleman from Louisiana has promised to abolish poverty, hunger, long hours, and practically all the unpleasant things in life. He would give every man an income of about \$10,000 a year, long trips during vacation, and the right to follow any career to a million a year income. As to whether or not this system would

entail a dictatorship by the Louisiana, Mr. Long maintains as a deep secret—perhaps as a surprise. In any event he claims to have a following of almost a half million.

Senator Long Not Choosy

The good Senator does not hesitate to fraternize with other movements of a radical character, as the following correspondence of correspondence will indicate.

From Earle J. Christenberry, Long's Secretary, to Christians, on the following correspondence has been seen in the newspapers that Senator Long plans to issue this Summer a national weekly which will give to the public an accurate explanation of legislative matters here in Washington. I believe it will be possible for us to mail out about 200,000 copies of every copy over a period of several weeks, and I am wondering if there would be any objection to your furnishing Senator Long a list of your members and their addresses. If this is agreeable and your names appear on addressograph plates, I would be very glad to do what ever the cost is for having them run off on cards."

"I regret that I can not furnish you with a list of our members for various reasons, the principal one being that we are under obligation to the Crusaders for our ship. We greatly appreciate the Senator's activities in tearing down and showing up the Wall Street Racket. It is a lunch-meat. We have done a lot of this destructive work too."

"However we feel that the destruction of the old is necessary and that it is time to forcibly present our constructive program. We are starting this with a patriotic demonstration on the Crusaders for Economic Liberty on July 4th at Columbus, Georgia. We cordially invite the Senator to take part in the demonstration and feel sure that his own interests would be immensely benefited by getting on the band wagon at the start."

Long Sends the lunch-meat Christians hopes of having the colorful Long lend his services to the White Shirts were in vain. He erred somewhat in giving as the

prime reason for failure to present the list of followers because of obligations not to reveal the membership. As Christians once told

"If I have a single paid-up member, I don't know about him, the financial matters I leave to the rest of the boys. I have frequently pointed to as being in the movement purely for the 'graff'."

Long wrote through his secretary, graciously acknowledging his failure to proselyte the Christians following on July 4th as follows: "I am certainly sorry your communication did not reach me in time to advise you sooner that a previous speaking engagement made it impossible for Senator Long accept your very kind invitation to participate in the patriotic demonstration sponsored by your organization at Columbus, July 4th. . . . I should have realized that your membership could not be revealed even before you reminded me the fact."

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The Bulletin's Day Book

Risking the fate that awaits all who dare in the field of convention a flood of letters demanding the scalp of the such-and-such who had the gall to write so-and-so about this-and-that—the day's Day Book will be devoted to pigs.

To the average citizen of the North American continent, the statement that "pigs is pigs" needs no further explanation. But in the Jewish household the phrase which was coined by Ellis Parker Butler in 1904 and is used at all, usually has a corollary, "Pigs is traife." Every Jewish lad old enough to babble or understand Yiddish knows that corollary.

Since time immemorial, orthodox and even not-so-orthodox Jews have sedulously avoided the porker as part of their diet. Something about the animal's personalia has caused the patriarchs to appeal to the patriarchs who formulated the dietary laws. Other factors possibly entering into the official ban on piggy were the absence of a cleft in his hoofs and the fact that in the pagan days of old piggy had the misfortune to be eaten by heathens in their pagan rites.

However, despite the Jewish dietary ban on pigs, that creature has managed to do rather well in this world. It has found favor on the tables of the humble and the tables of the meanest, and its reputation for the stomach, it has gained the praise of gourmands, epicure and just plain mouth-stuffer. Even the Eastern European, piggyed by several words and analogies because the hog has lived very well for themselves in this world. In fact, in fact, it comes as a complete surprise and a distinct shock to hear that a prominent Nazi official has fondly eaten upon himself to rise to their defense.

Were it not for the fact that the modern pig has been given international significance by this newest expert on grunters, by this newest crop of dragging the Jewish question into it, the literary effort of the pig-defender would undoubtedly have escaped notice.

The Nazi Sir Lancelot who has thus gallantly rushed to the rescue of the swine is none other than Herr Richard Walther Darré, that clever man who not so long ago said that all German political parties should be merged into one and have been founded by Jews, must have had another of his Nazi-heaven-sent inspirations when he set out to compose the following tid-bit which enlivens his new book:

"Pigs," he is quoted by Die Neue Weltbühne as writing, "have had a reputation for long because the Jews hate their noble qualities and spread lies about them."

If the noble Darré had to condescend to discuss pigs—or do we do the noble pig an injustice by assuming that he is not a pig of their level?—it seems a pity that he wasn't endowed with the literary powers of a Charles Lamb.

When Lamb told that delectable tale of the origin of roast pig, the reader instinctively felt here was a man who knew not only the value of pigs. His essay probably did much to raise pigs in the estimation of mankind. The only other effort at all comparable to Lamb's in this respect was that movie cartoon, "The Ten Little Pigs," by Walt Disney.

Darré, incidentally, would probably be considerably disconcerted to hear that a Jew, Earl Hore, played a rather important role in promoting and publicizing that cartoon. And Disney's pigs, by the way, are so cheek full of noble qualities that anyone who could eat any part of a porker after seeing them in action must cer-

tainly be classed at the very least as a confirmed anti-vegetarian.

On second thought, however, one can readily understand that may have prompted the pig-lover Darré into rushing to the defense of the four-footed noble. Birds of a feather, someone long ago observed, flock together. And pigs, as Ellis Parker Butler wrote, is pigs.

But before condemning the noble porcines to so humiliating a fate as being classed in the same bracket with a Nazi cabinet minister, we should at some not too distant future like to hear from the onk-onk family on the matter. We imagine the grunters will have several snorts to emit that won't be flattering to the ears of the Nazi cohorts.

Rothschild Film Starts New Run At The Rivoli

Picture Finds Favor With Reviewer—Shown at Popular Prices

Whether "The House of Rothschild," the magnificent production presented by Joseph M. Schenck under the banner of 20th Century Pictures and starring George Arliss, which opened last night at the Rivoli Theatre at popular prices, following its long two-day run at the Astor Theatre, is pro or anti-Semitic propaganda, is not the concern, at the moment, of this column. I am concerned solely in telling you that I think this is one of the most entertaining, stirring and fascinating picture that has come out of Hollywood since the mid-twenties and camera were introduced.

Arises the Jew

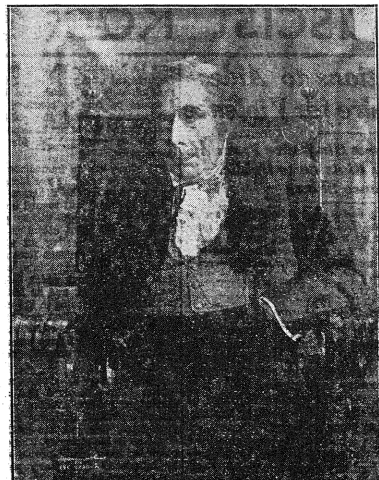
The picture is successful because George Arliss is a great and fine actor. Although not a Jew himself, his portrayal of the dual role of Mayer Rothschild, head of the family, and Nathan, the eldest son, is so warm, sympathetic and typical of the type, that it will be difficult to convince any one that he is not one of the "Chosen." He is ably supported by Boris Karloff, who plays the part of the anti-Semitic German anti-Semite; Loretta Young, the Rothschild girl who wants to marry a Gentile; Helen Hayes, who plays the part of the family, and Robert Young, as the lover.

Glorifying the Money Lender

No attempt has been made to follow the history of the Rothschild family, the author has picked up the family as it exists in the Ghetto of Frankfurt and follows its fortunes to the knighting of Nathan Rothschild by the King of Prussia.

Mayer Rothschild, founder of the family, is shown as a money lender who cannot exist because of the restrictions against the Jews. He is forced to leave the town which he built, his wealth, and deal surreptitiously. When he is about to die, he orders his sons to found banks in London, Paris, Vienna, Rome and Frankfurt. Nathan (George Arliss) is head of the London house and no more astute a money genius has ever appeared on a screen. His cleverness, his trick in getting the great post-Napo-

leonic War loan after it had been refused him because he is a Jew, are faithfully told. The crisis in his life comes when Napoleon escapes from St. Helena and a new war is impending. The Frenchman offers the Rothschilds the largest rate of interest but they refuse because, as Nathan points out, the peace of Europe can be maintained only if Napoleon is defeated, and although the other nations are persecuting the Jews, Nathan is loyal to them. Before lending them money, however, he insists that the restrictions against Jews be lifted. How Rothschild alone saves the credit of England when things look blackest gradually brings the picture to a climax.

Sentimental Reality

"The House of Rothschild" is a sentimental portrayal of the world's greatest family of money lenders. History is not quite clear about the exact date when the Rothschilds felt about each other, but the allies against Napoleon, but this picture certainly gives the family the benefit of the doubt. In treating it as a family of human beings the producers of the picture likewise have not been too critical. They are shown as humble, modest men; kindly, intensely charitably interested in Jewish things, observing in religious matters and anxious, above all, to raise the status of the Jew. How the Rothschilds felt about each other, we will never know but if they were nearly as loyal a family as 20th Century Pictures had made them, then they certainly are entitled to glorification.

Jewish Scenes Interesting

It is obvious that this picture will be of great interest to Jews. The scenes in the Ghetto, showing how the Jewish quarter was chained up every night, how the Jews lived, what they looked like, how they were treated by the Gentiles, are vividly produced. A particular moment is a series of camera shots picturing a "pogrom" with the Jews fleeing in panic from their vicious stone-throwing mob which has been egged on by governmental officials.

Ten years ago we might have said back and forth among such such things, but now they are a little terrifying and too close for comfort.
