#### The Fists

At Baireuth, during the Wagner festival, amidst a mass of brown-shirted storm troops, a Monument of the Nazi movement has been unveiled. The Monument represents a huge fist of bronze in the act of throttling snakes. And the inscription on the pedestal refers to the "sound of storm bells, thunders of vengeance and the dire fate of a people ensnared by dreams."

Whatever may be said of the Nazis, it must be admitted that they have the "courage" of their crimes. No critic of the Nazi movement could better characterize them than they themselves have done it in their monument of the Bronze Fist—with storm bells, with thunders of vengeance, and their salvation of the German from being "ensnared by dreams."

It is a Monument to brute force, to paganism, to barbarism, to war-madness. This is Hitler's contribution to Germany, perpetuated in bronze, which should be preserved as the symbol of disgrace and degradation imposed by him upon the German people.

#### A Costly Vice

Fifty Jewish physicians have been forced out of their positions in municipal hospitals in Vienna, as a result of the German-Christian policy of the new city administration. Notwithstanding all the promises made by the Dollfus government that there will be no anti-Jewish discriminations, the Vienna authorities are emulating the ways of the German Nazis.

As we pointed out at the time the new Austrian Constitution was proclaimed, it is a document that contains vague clauses which could easily be given any interpretations the authorities desire. And now the authorities have already resorted to tricky subterfuges for the purpose of eliminating Jews from civil services.

The little dictator, who is defying Hitler, is borrowing some of his methods. No nation can afford the cost of religious and racial hate and discrimination. Austria can afford it least of all.

#### Nazi Dementia

The Nazi press has intensified its attack on the Jews of America by accusing them of the "German peril." In order to further the conquest of the world by Communism, Samuel Untermyer, according to the Deutsche Wocheblatt, contributed \$50,000 to the Communists. Bernard M. Baruch is described as the biggest individual contributor to the Soviet government, and Professor Felix M. Frankfurter is credited with having elaborated plans for the con-

## African Nazi Admits 'Shirt' Movement Is Based on 'Hot Air'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa, July 23.—The Grahamstown court in which three Fascist Grey Shirt leaders, Motike, Inch and Olivier, are on trial charged with inciting to violence by distributing anti-Jewish literature was thrown into a hum of excitement today when one of the defendants, Inch, asked permission to withdraw his defense.

Spectators, court attendants and attorneys for both sides were taken completely by surprise when Inch approached the bench and declared that he would like to withdraw from the case.

In explanation of his unusual request, which is interpreted as a

clear admission of guilt, Inch admitted that the entire Grey Shirt movement was based on "hot air." Presiding Justice Graham flatly refused to consider the withdrawal saying that it was impossible. To this Inch replied that he was leaving the matter entirely in the hands of the court and then walked out of the courtroom without looking at his co-defendants.

Complete collapse of the defense was further indicated when Motike, referring to the letter allegedly written by a well known Jew in which Jewish domination of the white world is predicted, admitted that he must have been taken in by the document which he claims was planted on him.

## Shoachim Stick To Demands as Deadlock Holds

Judge Hits Wholesalers for Lack of Kashruth Supervision

The deadlock between wholesalers and slaughterers in the poultry industry continued yesterday, with counsel for each faction re-emphasizing their respective demands and neither side willing to concede any, at the second conference called by Judge Otto Rosalsky, the Mayor's mediator, in the judge's chambers in the Criminal Courts Building.

"The Jew," said Judge Rosalsky at the opening of the conference, "is willing to pay more for kosher-slaughtered poultry if he knows that it is kosher. I was dumfounded to hear that many wholesalers have no supervision."

Samuel Weiner, one of the leaders of the wholesalers' delegation, contradicted Judge Rosalsky, "If you think the Jewish public is willing to pay the exorbitant," he said, "then you don't know the Jewish public."

Levin J. Grilbert, counsel to the shoachim, presented their demands in the form of an agreement which has been nominally in force until recently, although, as both sides agreed, the agreement has not been carried through in many respects.

## Rosenfeld Sues Yorkville Paper For \$100,000

Reich Exile Starts Libel Action Against Nazi 'Deutsche Zeitung'

Another libel action has been lodged against the Deutsche Zeitung, American Nazi organ published here, it was learned yesterday. Dr. Otto Rosenfeld, former Prussian Minister of Justice who has been a refugee from Hitler's administration, claims damages of \$100,000.

The plaintiff, who served the defendant corporation with a summons last Friday, will have as his counsel Arthur Garfield Hays, noted for his activities in Nazi affairs as counsel for the American Civil Liberties Union. The defendant company has been given twenty days in which to answer the summons in Supreme Court.

Another suit for criminal libel, lodged by former Magistrate Joseph Goldstein of Brooklyn, is still in court. This case, as well as Rosenfeld's, has named as defendants William L. McLaughlin, vice-president of the D. Z. Corporation and managing editor of the English language supplement of the Deutsche Zeitung; Carl S. Voelcker, president of the concern, and Walter Kappe, editor of the Deutsche Zeitung.

Under the pretext that the Jewish community was no longer able to maintain the synagogue, Sulzbach authorities announced the confiscation, and revealed that since the Nazi regime has been in power, the 170 Jewish families of the town have been reduced to eight persons, one man and seven women. Hitler's Papers Publish New Anti-Semitic Articles

BERLIN, July 23.—The Nazi campaign against the Jews continues on all fronts (German) with an ever-increasing tempo and bitterness. Leading Nazi papers and by the Volksischer Beobachter, Der Angriff and Julius Streicher's Stürmer are filled with inciting articles against the Jews of Germany and other countries.

# Biblical Facts Are Laid Bare By Holy Land Archaeologists

## Hebrew Union Professor Recounts New Finds Near Petra

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)  
JERUSALEM, July 23.—Modern archaeological discoveries are gradually revealing verification of the age-dimmed geographical and historical times. Through one particular discovery in the field of archaeology this year, modern Biblical students can establish a definite date accurately that the Exodus of the Israelites through southern Trans-Jordan could not have taken place before the thirteenth century B.C.

The checking up of this specific Biblical fact has been accomplished through the combined efforts of the second 1934 expedition of the American School of Oriental Research of Baghdad, the Trans-Jordan Department of Antiquities, the Hebrew Union College of Cincinnati, and the American Council of Learned Societies which finished its findings last May.

In an article printed in the Palestine Post of June 20th, the leader of the expedition, Dr. Nelson Glueck, Bible and Semitic Languages professor at the Hebrew Union College, tells of the accomplishments of the expedition in ancient Edomite territory.

"Immediately outside of Petra, between Eljl and the Sik leading into Petra, the expedition discovered the long sought Edomite site, called Tawilan, which is covered with masses of extraordinarily interesting Edomite pottery. There was a subsequent Nabataean and medieval Arabic occupation on the site. The Edomite pottery may be dated between the thirteenth and the eighth centuries B.C."

### Find Nabataean Sites

The article points out that the expedition also discovered numerous Nabataean sites. Dr. Glueck declares that "it may be accepted as axiomatic that wherever an Edomite site is located, a Nabataean settlement is certain to be located nearby. The latter is now been established between Edomite and Nabataean pottery. The Nabataeans were the immediate successors of the Edomites, whom they displaced and absorbed, and whose culture they adopted and transmuted into the marvelous

forms fashioned by their own genius. The Nabataeans are superior Edomites.

"With the exception of Feinan," the article continues, "no Bronze Age sites have been found in Edom. Certainly between the nineteenth and the thirteenth centuries B.C., in Edom, as in Moab, there were no settled communities. The period between these centuries represents an historical blank.

"As a result of the discoveries of the expedition in Edom, it is concluded that the Exodus of the Israelites through southern Trans-Jordan could not have taken place before the thirteenth century B.C. It is recalled that, according to the Biblical account in Numbers 20, the Israelites had to beg the Edomites for permission to traverse their territory on the way to Promised Land. It was refused then.

"If the Exodus took place before the thirteenth century B.C., the Israelites would have found neither Edomites nor Moabites who could have given or withheld permission."

The article concludes that "because the Edomites and the Moabites had not occupied their respective territories before the thirteenth century B.C., the Israelites would probably have occupied all of southern Trans-Jordan themselves had they arrived there before the thirteenth century B.C. and left the Promised Land for late comers."

## Palestine Rent Courts Tried 249 Cases in June

TEL AVIV, July 9.—The Rent Courts here, which handle all complaints between landlords and tenants as regards excessive rentals, is quite a success if one is to judge by the number of cases tried there without further appeal.

The court, set up by the Rent Restriction Ordinance, has heard 249 complaints out of 280 submitted in the month of June. Only thirty-six appeals to the Magistrate's Court of the Palestine Government were made against the decisions handed down by the Rent Courts.

## B'nai Brith Lodges to Hold Conference in Atlantic City

Plans for preserving the strength of the organization and continuing its efforts in behalf of world Jewry will be discussed. There also will be a meeting of the general committee of District No. 3, with District President Frank R. S. Kaplan of McKeesport, Pa., presiding.

## 12 U. S. Foresters Sail To Learn Nazi Methods

Twelve American foresters will sail on Thursday, July 26 for Germany to study methods of forestation there. They will be the guests of the Oberlander Trust of the Carl Schurz Foundation.

Whether or not ancient usages of the axe now revived for meting out punishment to obstreperous non-Nazis will be demonstrated to the visiting Americans is not known.

Dr. Franz Heike, director of the forestry school at Tharandt, near Dresden, has been in this country for three months, studying old American methods of using the axe exclusively on trees. He will lead the contingent back to Germany.

## Palestine Ball Teams Stage Thrilling Game Before Crowd of 2,500

## Tel Aviv Laborites Protest School Plan

## Oppose Decentralization From Country's Institutions at Council Parley

TEL AVIV, July 7.—Laborite members of the Municipal Council protested at the last meeting of the body against attempts to decentralize the direction of schools of this city from others in Palestine. It was argued that the great majority of members of the parents' and teachers' associations in Tel Aviv were opposed to this decentralization, and therefore the Municipal Board of Education was not justified in "ursuing such a policy."

The debate on the school question was tabled until the next meeting of the Council in spite of the motion of the municipality.

## Bronx Jewish Group Holds Parley Aug. 9

Hauser, president, was requested by various member-organizations of the Federated Assembly, which comprises about a score of the largest and most important Jewish units in Bronx County. The nature of the business to be discussed was not revealed by Mr. Hauser.

## Broadwest Will Mark Death of Naumburg

Commemorating the anniversary of the death of Elkan Naumburg, Jewish founder of the annual series of summer concerts given on the Mall of Central Park, the third Naumburg Festival of this season will be broadcast over the radio, WMCA, next Tuesday at 8:30 p. m. The program, which will present symphonic and operatic numbers, will begin with Chopin's Funeral March.

## Jewish Women Fight Bread Price Increase By Baltimore Bakers

BALTIMORE, July 23.—Led by the Housewives' League, a number of Jewish women's organizations in this city is waging a campaign against an increase in the price of Jewish bread. Members of these organizations have been urged to bake their own bread until the one-cent-per-pound increase is withdrawn.

The increase in the price of both bread and rolls, according to the Jewish bakers, has been caused by the increase in the cost of ingredients and by a rise in labor costs following the adoption of the NIRA code. It was explained by the bakers that Jewish bread is made by hand, which requires a larger labor outlay than does bread made and baked by machinery.

## Will Build New School In Tiberias Flood Area

TIBERIAS, July 8.—The Alliance Israelite Universelle, of Paris, has decided to erect a school building on a plot given by the Palestine Jewish Colonization Association. The school was originally intended to be built at a later date, but the recent floods in Tiberias and the Jewish community's unanimous decision to go ahead with the building at once.

## 12,000 Jews in Jaffa

## White Shirt Chieftain Bargains For Anti-Communist League Aid

### Foes of 'Judaistic Communism' Cooperate With Christians in Minor Activities; Agitator Offers Congressman McAdden as Reference

The following is the thirteenth of a series of articles, "This Fascist Rocket," by Mr. McGrady, appearing from the inside, the workings of a typical Fascist organization here, and revealing, through publication of the Fascist "chieftains' correspondence, how and in what manner these racial rockets are operated. When Christians began plucking the strings of Economic Liberty he discovered that all sorts of discordant minor keys emanated from his music box. The most resonant note he has attained thus far is that of anti-Semitism, a pitch he had never anticipated.

His task at present appears to be to harmonize the divergent notes of all anti-Semitic organizations into one blood-curdling scream which will throw all Jews into panic and attract unto his fold the "Aryan" majority of the nation. Those who do not respond to the sweet allure of being persecutors of a minority race he will seek to drive into line, employing much the same tactics as were used by Hitler. He will probably class them as the "Juden-Genosins" (the "Jewish spirited"), and thereby shame many "Aryans" into coming to a defense of their kind.

Perhaps one of the most widespread and potentially influential anti-Semitic organizations in the United States and the world is the "Anti-Communist League of the World." Its southern national headquarters are in Houston, over which territory Major Luther J. Powell presides. Powell has been an active aide of "Silver Shirt" Pelley and appears to be willing to rent, for specified fees, his anti-Semitic influence to all comers.

The League's first communications to Christians came in the form of a request that they join Christians has since been striving to align the various departments of the League with his group. The League has been inactive, except through exchange of correspondence; purchase of each other's books; and some slight cooperation in other fields of minor activity. Christians, it is calculated, can bend all these departments into a strong, active group, using books as well as words. Each member officer of the league controls an organization which is active locally or nationally. Just how many organizations comprise the League has not been revealed, but it is safe to assume that there are scores.

#### Ideals of League

The ideals of the League are set forth in the following communication from General Henri C. Fletcher of Salt Lake City, who, as the League Universal Vice-Chairman, serves the organization from Washington, D. C. In the national capital the League maintains only a Post Office address. It is Box 1836. The letter follows:

"To union there is strength, and when (since the day of the crucifixion) have Aryans more needed to be united against the anti-Chris and his organization, Judaistic Communism, Bolshevism, or Sovietism? The peoples of the world must be united through the broadcast of the truth behind the situation in the politics of every Christian capital throughout the world.

"Truth is being audaciously suppressed by the Jewish-controlled press, world wide. . . .

"Please select your counselor at the earliest possible date, and his name and address, with a personal description including his professional title, experience, etc., also a photo from which a cut can be made if necessary."

In England the League is represented by Lt. Col. O. Boulton,

T.D., of The Unity Band, London. Gabriel LeBlanc, international politico-economist of Switzerland has charge of the movement in that country, and in Germany, Dr. Farmer, owner of the "World Service," a German news service, supported by the Hitler government, which restricts its news purely to anti-Semitic topics.

The World News Service is disseminated to a number of anti-Jewish publications in this country. It appears both in English and German, and finds its way to Nazi publications, such as American Liberty, Post in New York, and American Fascist publications such as the Silver Shirt Silver Ranger.

There are many other communications in Christians' files. The one, for instance, from Frank W. Clark, commander-in-chief of the League of War Veterans Guardsmen, which maintains National Headquarters at 16 Trinity avenue, East Lynn, Mass.

On April 28, 1934, Clark wrote, in part, to Christians: "Should any of our forefathers come back at this time they would immediately gather an army, comprising the majority, and overthrow those who have perverted our government, and they would do this without any hesitation.

#### Urges Revolution

"Every move of these capitalists now clearly indicates that there must be some form of a revolution, and such revolution be performed by a majority of the masses, and without the aid of the lawyer, judge, banker, and cheap politician. Such revolution is the only method that will ever again bring real happiness to the masses of producing labor."

"Will advise you that I am in constant touch with key leadership of various organizations throughout the country."

Sensing the worth of this man to his organization, Christians promptly turned the matter over to Charles F. Davis of the Ohio Brokerage Company, Middleport, Ohio, who appears to be another White Shirt cabinet officer. The financial basis upon which the groups could trade was discussed, and it developed that Clark is not averse to earning his living from agitation. He wrote a short time ago to Davis:

"Before I go into the money subject I would rather you knew a little more of myself. First I want to say that Congressman Louis T. McAdden and I are personal friends. We have been fighting shoulder to shoulder against Jewical issues. Should you write to him regarding myself, he will be well pleased, and you may find him ready to go a long way. Regarding the American Groups for Economic Liberty, Oakland, Calif.—had not my finances been so low, I would have been at the conference, and I believe I would have made all the traitor unscrupulous scoundrel bankers and their rat economy run for cover, due to all the things I have done. The first time in American history bring forth for public consumption."

#### Strange Bedfellows

It is this camaraderie among anti-Semites and anti-Democratic factions that makes the present rise of Fascism distressing. The leaders are authoritatively and gifted with the power to sway large masses of people. The followings are not large and are usually the fanatical elements skinned from the normal population. United, the crackpot element would present a threat to American democracy; divided as they are now they can be absorbed by the tremendous forces of sanity which usually prevail.

In the United States the destructive force of public institutions pro-

vided for the abnormal and the rest allowed to carry on however they may see fit, so long as they do not interfere with the peace and well-being of the people.

It has been said before, and it is worth repeating. The danger to American civilization lies in the possibility of emergence of a strong man capable of uniting all these disgruntled elements. Upset economic conditions, hunger, strikes, depression will furnish the ground for their seeds of violence.

Christians will not be the successful prophet of a new era, for he does not have the mental or physical properties which must make up the American dictator: Pelley will not be it, for his appeal is of a psychic nature (and he can never live this down, regardless

of changes in policies) and he appeals only to the most frenzied of the cultists; other Fascist leaders thus far announced are too narrow in vision to appeal to the "whole of the country, and they perforce must fail.

Meanwhile, all these leaders cultivate the spirit of reaction and rebellion in their particular fields of enterprise, and by virtue of their efforts, the prophet will find much of his work already done for him, when and if he should make an appearance.

Critical Moments

It has been our experience that the more deeply engaged in the promotion of anti-Semitism are the readiest and loudest to declaim:

"But I personally am not anti-Semitic."

We once wrote a magazine story to this effect. We quoted Julius Streicher, Baldur von Schirach, Edmund Heines, Paul Joseph Goebbels, and an assortment of other Nazis to this effect.

Since that time we have discovered in conversation with a score or more leading lights in the American anti-Semitic profession that they too are "personally not anti-Semitic."

We are pleased to report that a few weeks ago, we uncovered a real anti-Semite. He admits of being an anti-Semite, "personally" and however else you'll have your anti-Semitism served.

This rare species comes from the mountains of Kentucky. He happened to stay at our hotel in Lexington—that is, in the bar room (he was there on each of those frequent occasions when we sought respite from the outer heat of the city; and, according to the bartender, seldom repaired to his room, apparently preferring to sleep where the beer fumes were thickest).

He was big and broad and smelled of moonshine and good horse flesh, in which his particular kingdom happened to abound. He was clad in a buckskin jacket, vintage of Kit Carson days, and in his belt was shoved an overgrown revolver which had been used in the civil war. His hound dog that lay snoring at his master's feet throughout the whole of the day and most of the night was about as old as the gun.

The Kentucky gentleman, when he wasn't napping or mumbling to himself, was pretty friendly sort. He told me of the renewed troubles he had suffered with revenuers since the repeal of the Eighteenth Amendment; of the difficulty he had in collecting for consignments of moonshine run down into the city by Lexington dealers; of the seven year itch which had overstayed its leave in his family some sixty years; of the part his pap and grandpap played in the Civil War until its termination (in his part of the hills) in 1931; and of the shooting affairs between his clan and the Payne family, which had been brought to an end only on the demise of the last Payne,

who fell under his bullets "amoral" and "agranitic" like a stuck pig! four years ago since September. With regard to this last he said in a somewhat whimsical manner, "It's been doggone lonely up there since we ain't had nobody to be neighborly with."

It must have been after our eighth or twelfth beer that we looked the gentleman from the hills squarely in the eye (the one that was still open) and accused:

"You look anti-Semitic."

What caused this remark on our part we are still at a loss to explain, unless the fact that his comments, so interesting and yet so free of prejudice against Jews, and the general atmosphere of non-anti-Semitism was beginning to weigh on our nerves.

He opened the other eye and asked, "What's 'at' it?"

So we repeated the accusation, and he leaned back, relieved at something or other, and drawled, "Oh. Well I guess I am. In fact I guess I'm damned what you just said I was."

Hal! We were getting back into our element. An anti-Semite from the foothills! We encouraged him to go on.

"I'm all for wipin' 'em out. Tear 'em to pieces, 'at's what I always say. Be better if we didn't have a one in the country. This war a fine bit of land afore they came in."

"And what makes you feel that way against Jews?" we queried.

"Jews?" says he. "Who's talking about Jews? You asked me if I was again! I'm only tellin', didn't ya? Well, I'm the only tellyn' I'm again 'em and always will be. Ya can't walk on the durned things 'less ya blisters your feet or get runned down by one of those danged automobiles."

When he stopped by to say "so long" the next day, he asked, "Say son. What was that there word you used meannin' bein' against ceme'l roads?"

We told him it was anti-concrete.

**Other Screen and Theatrical News**

The Winter Garden, one of Broadway's older houses has been renovated and from now on will be air cooled. The next show to move into the almost ancient theatre, which has to-date played fifty-five productions, exclusive of motion pictures, will be "Life Begins at 8:40" a revue written by Ira Gershwin, E. Y. Harburg, David Freedman and Harold Arlen. Early August is scheduled for the opening and the Shuberts will be the sponsors. In the cast will be 125 actors headed by Bert Lahr, Ray Bolger, Luella Gear and Frances Williams.

There are but eight stage shows open on Broadway this week and by next week the list may be further reduced. "Steverson," "Men in White" and one or two others are on the way out. As a matter of fact, "Steverson" closing night was up last week but at the last minute the Theatre Union decided to hold the doors open for the time being.

Broadway may be suffering from scarcity of theatrical attractions but no such condition exists in the suburbs, as a matter of fact the "little" hardscrabble houses are going full tilt but, I am sorry to report, are not attracting a large patronage. Last summer this type of playhouses couldn't handle the crowds, but so far this year the self-exiled city folks and the natives are showing a definite inclination to stay away. This change in attitude may be blamed on the profusion of productions. There is hardly a hamlet from the well manured lawns of Westchester to the rocky coast of Maine that does not boast of at least one summer company; however it will save money in the end for Broadway theatres who have had to see a script enacted before making an investment.

The return of the sizable Kate Smith to the radio after a season's layoff reminds me that the career of this sentimental songbird on the stage was in no way improved by her radio popularity. Before she ever thought of singing into a microphone Miss Smith found steady work on the stage and always enjoyed some popularity but after her radio fame became a byword and she tried the stage it was found that the big girl failed to draw the crowds. There should be some moral to this!

# The Human Touch

ON the day, more than one month ago, that news reached us that Rosenblatt and Achimier were both acquitted of the murder of Dr. Arlosoroff and Stawsky was found to be guilty, a prophet in this

very office was saying: The appeal court will not sustain the conviction of Stawsky. You'll see. The judges of the lower court deliberately found guilty the man against whom the evidence is weakest in order to make it easier for the higher court to sustain the appeal and reverse the decision. Then why not, I asked, declare everybody innocent and let it go at that? To save face, our prophet advised: the court being unwilling to admit that it had reached no solution and giving the world the conviction of Stawsky as a sop to sedition and vengeance.

In any event, no Jew stands in the charge of having killed Dr. Arlosoroff and that, at least, is a mild comfort. Even if certain probabilities have been eliminated, the question of Who Murdered Dr. Arlosoroff? is as dark a mystery as it was on that fatal night of more than a year ago. Perhaps our prophet was in error as to the motivations of the lower and upper courts, but with his prophecy verified in its end results, I incline to the belief that it was verified also in the outline of the intermediate reasoning.

Our office prophet will have to make three errors in prophecy in succession before we forget that he was the one to predict the liberation of Stawsky on appeal. As soon as he returns from his vacation, we'll let him read our paper and buy him a crystal globe, if we can obtain one at a bargain price.

## You Tell Her

About a week ago, a person with whom I was well acquainted, picking up a copy of the Jewish Daily Bulletin and reading therein that Stawsky had filed an appeal, or something to that effect, asked: "Who is Stawsky?" "Oh," I said negligently, "he is the man who was found guilty of having murdered Arlosoroff." "And who is Arlosoroff?" asked the bright person, otherwise very well informed. Whereupon I became practically incoherent.

## The Dogmatic Turkey

We were talking about the dogmatic, authoritative streak in men, and women, what of us was pleased to call the teacher temperament. And then the eldest among us told this story:

He was one of a group of political prisoners in Caserta Russia. He had been little more than a schoolboy at the time of his arrest. Political prisoners seem to have a certain liberty at that time, according to an old Continental custom. At least they were allowed to read books and hold converse with one another. At this particular prison they would get into heated debates. I have no direct personal knowledge of what political prisoners talk about but I suppose they are essentially the same things that groups of radicals on Union Square talk about—revolutionary tactics, the transformation of the capitalist state, etcetera.

An unbidden guest at the heated debates of the political prisoners was the dogmatical Turkey who would listen attentively from about half a yard behind the door. Often, after having got only the rough-

est idea of the nature of the debate, he would burst in on them, point a finger at a man whose argument he didn't like, cry, "Shut up!" and, indicating another debater, say "You're right!" It was impossible, however, to determine whether the Turkey was an Anarchist, a Social Revolutionary, a People's Party man, a Socialist, or any one of six other possibilities because he agreed, and differed, not out of principle, but out of sheer caprice, to show these politicians that his, after all, was the last word.

## Educational Allegory

Here is a story which may give some of us intellectual white collar boys a sour smile. I cut it from Jacob Richman's collection, "A Laugh from Jewish Lore," to which I have been previously indebted:

Thirty years ago two Russian Jews landed in the United States. One was a scholar, an erudite, an ignoramus. For two months the immigrants wandered along the streets of New York without finding a place to settle. At last they decided to try their luck at some religious work.

A certain synagogue on the East Side was looking for an "ashmun" or beadle, and the two set out to apply for the job.

As the office of beadle in American-Jewish congregations entails a considerable amount of secretarial work (I am still quoting Mr. Richman) the illiterate man naturally was rejected and his learned friend was chosen for the post.

The unfortunated fellow was greatly disheartened. The value of education now dawned upon him in full force, but he had no money. He had missed it in his youth. However, upon the advice of friends he got himself a pushcart and began to hawk hosiery and trinkets. He succeeded in getting money and was enabled to open a small shop on Grand street. He continued to succeed and in a little longer time than it takes to tell became the owner of a large establishment on Broadway.

One day he offered a tempting bargain in real estate and went to his bank for a loan of \$50,000.

"What do you need a loan for?" asked the bank president, as he examined his customer's bank book. "Why, you have a balance of \$100,000. Can't you read?"

"No," replied the merchant, not at all put out.

"Too bad," the banker sighed compassionately. "If you're as successful as you are without a knowledge of reading and writing, just imagine where you'd be now if you did know how to read and write."

"If I knew how to read and write," replied the business man, "it would now be a headache in a synagogue."

## Pelley Gets More Time To Consult the Spirits On His Ultimate Fate

WASHINGTON, S. C., July 23.—William Dudley Pelley, bankrupt mystic and anti-Semitic, who has from now until September to call his occult powers into play to help himself out of his present predicament, was found guilty by a state of South Carolina for his firm and his two business associates, Robert C. Summerville and Don Kellogg, of the theft of money and property with the state's "blue sky" security laws in the sale of Galahad Press, Inc., stock.

At the request of the counsel representing the three defendants, the case was continued until the September term when it was called into Buncombe County Superior court.

# Drought God's Punishment for Attacks on Jews, Peasants Say

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 23.—The drought, which has so severely affected German agriculture and which threatens German food supplies, is the direct punishment by God for Nazi crimes against Catholics, Protestants and Jews, peasants in the rural districts of Germany told a special investigator of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency who has just returned from a tour of provincial regions.

Farmers whose crops have been destroyed by the drought, gathered in village beer halls, told the investigator that the "drought is God's punishment for the government policy of fixing prices in order to maintain the low cost of foodstuffs.

The Nazi government will draw support from German farm-

ers who have business dealings with Jews, the Frankische Tageszeitung, Nazi paper, threatened today.

"The farmers of Nuremberg are today openly and shamelessly engaged in business dealings with Jews," the paper declared, adding that transactions with Jews are incomprehensible since Jews are to blame for the present plight of the German farmers. "The Jews exploit the farmers to death," the Nazi paper said.

The campaign initiated by the Frankische Tageszeitung is obviously designed to counteract the growing discontent of the German farmers with the Nazi government policy of fixing prices in order to maintain the low cost of foodstuffs.

## Catholic Bishop Heads Meeting of University Religious Faiths

(J.D.B. Special Correspondence)

LOS ANGELES, July 16.—For the first time in this section a Catholic prelate presided over a group in which all religious faiths were represented and to which reports were made by ministers of all denominations. The occasion was the annual meeting of the University Religious Conference held at the University Club here.

In addition to Bishop Cantwell, the principal speakers were Bishop W. Bertrand Stevens of the Episcopal Church and Rabbi Edgar F. Magnin, newly elected president of the conference.

Tribute to the work of the University Religious Conference as an instrument in bringing the students of the three local colleges in definite contact with their respective groups was paid by the speakers.

"Despite our religious differences," Rabbi Magnin said, "we are all brothers and sisters engaged in a concerted effort to regard the Jewish people as a group to man, to develop a love and friendly understanding and to encourage our fellow men and women to look to God for his wealth and love and understanding."

## Many Nationalities in Zion

JERUSALEM, July 8.—The mixed population of Palestine is shown by a government report issued here listing the various nationalities represented by the 1,672 Jews who became Palestinian citizens by the issuance of 1,146 certificates of naturalization last year. There were 370 Poles, 318 Russians, and 2 British included among the new citizens.
