### The McFadden Disgrace

The Republican machine in Pennsylvania has committed the unpardonable blunder by choosing such an irresponsible and discredited demagogue as Congressman Louis T. McFadden to be its spokesman. McFadden's scurrilous and vile attacks on President Hoover and other distinguished Americans, his vicious un-American campaign of hate and malice against the Jews of America have demonstrated conclusively his utter unfitness for office in the House of Representatives of the United States. He has all the qualifications of a second-rate Hitlerite Nazi.

It is amazing that former Ambassador Henry P. Fletcher, chairman of the National Republican Committee, himself a Pennsylvanian, has permitted this unfortunate blunder, thereby alienating the support of vast numbers of Republicans.

The Philadelphia Council of the American Jewish Congress is elaborating plans for a campaign against the re-election of Congressman McFadden. A resolution has been adopted by the executive committee of the Council authorizing the appointment of a committee to arrange meetings throughout the State "to warn citizens of the lurking menace to America in McFadden's elevation to leadership." The resolution also deplored "the indifference to Jewish sensibilities by the Republican leadership."

It is eminently proper to conduct such a campaign against the vituperative and bigoted American Congressman. The Jews of Pennsylvania know McFadden well. His record is disgraceful.

That the Republican National Committee should insist on its position of leadership in the Republican camps, after his unprecedented and vicious attack on an American president, who is the outstanding leader of the Republican Party, passes all understanding.

### Rabbi Goldstein's Film Crusade

Dr. Sidney E. Goldstein, Associate Rabbi of the Free Synagogue and member of the Interfaith Council in connection with the much-heralded campaign against salacious and otherwise objectionable films, has declared that groups will be built up through synagogues and other Jewish organizations during Holy Days to voice their protest against indecent films and other types of entertainment.

Too much fuss is being made about this campaign. We have pointed out the dangers of a Church censorship or any other form of censorship. It is true

## Menace Seen In Attacks on Polish Jews

Official Attitude Brings Gloom as Hooligans Grow Bolder

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Aug. 9.—Renewed attacks against the Jews in Lodz and in Warsaw today have aroused the gloomiest forebodings among Polish Jewry. Feeling is gaining ground that serious days are ahead for Polish Jews, particularly in view of the passive attitude adopted by the Pilsudski regime toward the hooliganism of the anti-Semites.

In Warsaw, just as in Lodz, Jews were attacked on the streets by bands of anti-Semitic hooligans. It is feared that unless the government takes immediate and energetic steps to suppress anti-Jewish attacks, the hoodlum will be encouraged to resume attacks against the Jews on a wide scale.

Although the Nara party was suppressed, Nara hooligans are still at liberty and are daily growing bolder and resuming their outbreaks against Polish Jews. Recent attacks had all the characteristics of organized and planned affairs. Nara bands appeared on streets frequented by Jews at hours when the streets and in the cafes of the streets, carried out their attacks and disappeared.

### Gangsters Hurt 10 Jews In New Lodz Attacks

LODZ, Poland, Aug. 9.—Anti-Semitic gangsters last night renewed their attacks on Jews on the streets and in the cafes of the city. Ten Jews were seriously wounded.

Aron Katz, member of the executive of the Jewish community, was taken to a hospital after he was seriously wounded when anti-Semites attacked Jews strolling on Newerack street. A cafe on Breslauer street frequented by Jews was completely demolished by the hooligans.

It is "unreasonable and without cause," the ambassador, who is on his way to Washington after a vacation in Germany, declared.

Replying to the formal questions of reporters, he said that he had left a Germany sorrowing for Hindenburg.

To the rather bald question as to the effect of the boycott on German trade, Dr. Luther replied in a less diplomatic fashion. Em-

## Reich Controls 40,000 Women Jewish Funds Join the Fight In Holy Land For Clean Films

Reichsbank Keeps Grip on Funds Transferred Under Agreement

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—The Berlin Palestine office today confirmed yesterday's announcement by the Nazi government concerning the transfer of funds owned by German Jews to Palestine.

The Palestine office, however, said several ambiguous points were made in the announcement by the Reichsgovernment, pointing out that actually the German Reichsbank will control the Jewish capital transferred to Palestine even in the Holy Land.

According to the Palestine office, two-thirds of the transferred capital will be paid out in Palestine currency only if the applicant notices Haavara, Ltd., of

## News Held Back For Three Days, Paper Charges

French Patrols Doubled As Ain Beida Has New Outbreak

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, Aug. 10 (Friday).—Moslem attacks on the Jews in Algeria began last Tuesday and were kept secret until they reached such proportions in the city of Constantine last Saturday that their existence, the Daily Herald asserted. Many Jews were killed there and Jewish homes and shops were pillaged, the account continued.

The massacres began in the town of Setif, about twenty-five miles west of Constantine, and continued there for three days before the French authorities would admit their existence, the Daily Herald asserted. The Herald based its charges on disclosures in a letter from Setif received by the Paris newspaper Populaire.

Existence of the riots prior to their outbreak in Constantine disproves reports that the massacres were the result of the one-man invasion Saturday of a Moslem holy place by a drunken Jewish soldier, Elie Kalifa, and corroborates the French press, which has been widespread and from other sources that the Jews had been premeditated and followed a careful plan of action.

According to the Herald the anti-Jewish rioting has been widespread and to a far greater extent than the authorities have admitted. The French paper, it was said, is about to publish a document on this of a highly sensational nature.

## Religious Racketeers Wax Fat, Preying on Jew's Best Instincts

One of the most unsavory racketeering deals is yearly milking thousands of New York Jews and Christians—mostly Jews—of untold hundreds of thousands of dollars.

The racket lurks under the protecting folds of the Jewish religion and is legalized by a city ordinance.

The racket diverts money from those who need it most—the destitute and starving—in the well-

lined pockets of unscrupulous gangsters and bogus rabbis.

The Department of Public Welfare is well equipped to handle charity frauds by its powers of investigation and revocation of license.

Balked by Ordinance

The Department can crush all charity racketeers except one. That is a racket incorporated as a religious organization.

Article 18, Section 196 of the Code of Ordinances, states that

"no person, organization . . . shall collect money . . . except upon a license issued by the commissioner of public welfare. . . ."

But here is the hitch. Section 196a says: "This ordinance shall not apply to any corporation organized under the Religious Corporations Law. . . ."

That is where the racket comes in. A group of persons takes out a charter as a Jewish congregation. Inserted in the charter is a

All projects, conferences and tours involving relations with German organizations have been cancelled, it was said at the headquarters of the organization.

## Sabbath Cases Are Dismissed By Magistrate

### Leather Association Had Brought Complaints of Sunday Selling

Magistrate Anna M. Kross dismissed two cases of Sabbath law violation yesterday in Tombs Court when Abraham Kaufman, 67 Mott street, and Leo Kaufman, 68 Mott street, were brought before her on the charge of keeping their leather stores open on Sunday.

Herman Koenigsberg, counsel for the Jewish Sabbath Alliance of America, represented the defendants. On cross-examination he disclosed that the police had observed no sales on Sunday, that the defendants kept closed on Saturday and that no complaints had come from the neighborhood.

It was further pointed out by Mr. Koenigsberg that the complaint had been filed by the Metropolitan Leather and Findings Association, of which Louis D. Greenzweig is the organizer.

Abraham Kaufman, who is a partner in the firm of Banks and Kaufman, declared yesterday that Greenzweig was "working a racket." Although president of a synagogue, Greenzweig was using the Sabbath law to force Jewish dealers to keep closed Sunday and open Saturday, he declared. Kaufman further stated that Greenzweig was being paid by the New Jersey group of leather and finding dealers in order to gain for themselves some of the trade that normally went to New York on Sunday.

#### Parley on Day of Rest

William Rosenberg, Secretary of the Jewish Sabbath Alliance, announced yesterday that an attempt would be made to confer with the Metropolitan Association to see if it would agree to one day of rest in seven, whether it were Saturday or Sunday. The conference was scheduled for last night.

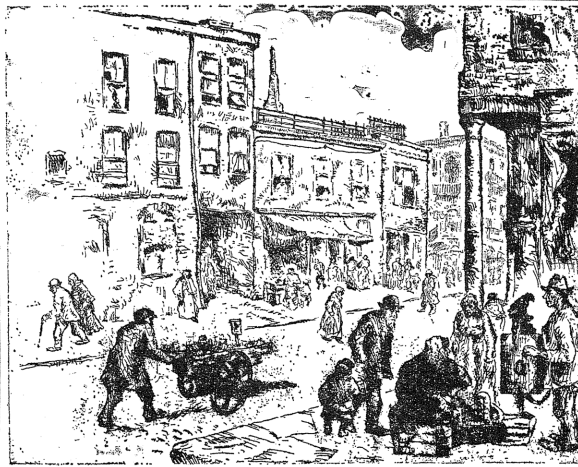
Both the firms of Banks and Kaufman and that of the J. Miller Leather Company, the other firm employing Leo Kaufman, stated they were opposed to joining the Association under any circumstances because of the "underhand methods" used by Greenzweig.

Greenzweig could not be reached for a statement yesterday. In a similar case last month against Charles Horowitz, Mott street leather dealer, Greenzweig claimed he was simply trying to enforce the rules laid down by the NRA and that no personal motives were involved.

## Ten Arrested In Strike Row; Pickets March

### Union Men, Employers Meet in Fruitless Knitgoods Parley

Ten men were arrested yesterday when a large crowd of striking workers of the knit goods industry staged a demonstration in front of the Star Sportswear Corporation, 568 Broadway. Included among the arrested were Harry Duddstein, 32, of 180 Grand street extension, Brooklyn, who was charged with assault by Elsie Fehrs.

Several thousand pickets were on duty on Seventh avenue between Thirty-fourth and Forty-fourth streets, Manhattan. In other thousand pickets marched in Brooklyn. Trouble was also reported in North Bergen and West New York, N. J., where strikers stormed knit goods mills.

Representatives of employers and union men met at the office of Samuel Blumberg, counsel to the Metropolitan Knitted Textile Association, the employers group at 200 Fifth avenue, but nothing was accomplished. Morris Duhinger, president of the Association, and David Dubinsky, president of the International Ladies Garment Workers Union, of which the striking Knit Goods Workers Union is a branch, attended.

The strike is now in its third day and all factories and mills in New York and New Jersey are closed. The walk out is reported to be complete.

### Polish Jews Announce Aid for Flood Victims

The Federation of Polish Jews of America announced yesterday that it has formed a relief committee for flood-stricken victims of Poland. Benjamin Winter has been appointed chairman.

The group was formed to cooperate with Polish American Jews, to organize and carry out relief activities, as well furnishing the necessary information for remitting funds to Poland. The committee will also see that those funds will be distributed to those for whom they are intended.

### Court Uses President Of Brotherhood Council Charged With Assault

The case of Eugene McNamara, president of the Brotherhood of Painters, Paperhangers and Decorators, District Council No. 9, was dismissed by Judge Jonah T. Goldstein in Yorkville Court yesterday. McNamara was charged with felonious assault as a result of a brawl with members of Local 468, now banned for alleged Communist activities.

Union spokesmen declared yesterday that the Socialist League had issued a proclamation to its members in the union urging them to support the leadership of the strike.

that some of the films produced in this country contain unwholesome and demoralizing features that have an injurious effect on the youth. Efforts should be made by intellectual and spiritual leaders and educators to curb this tendency among the film producers and directors, and to offer a constructive proposal to remedy this serious fault.

But what about the countless number of stupid, almost idiotic pictures that are offered for the entertainment of the American motion picture public, young and old, that give them the distorted views of life, that are an insult to the intelligence of intelligent people, and that tend to lower the intellectual standard of the masses? The Interfaith Council will have no ground to object to these pictures and other forms of entertainment, although they are perhaps even more injurious than the so-called salacious films.

It would seem that Rabbi Sidney E. Goldstein could find some more urgent problems to bring to the attention of the Jews during the coming Holy Days than this film crusade.

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# Adjusting Our Lives

## Jewish Contributions to American Music

"It should not be forgotten that while the form and type of our civilization are in the main English, into that English framework have been poured millions of individuals from the most artistically gifted peoples of the western world, whose genius made up the great artistic past of Europe. Since the beginning of the century the Jews, to take a single example, have exerted an influence out of proportion to their numbers—in music both as patrons and performers, and in pictorial arts chiefly as patrons, though more recently rather conspicuously as exhibitors as well."

In these words, the Jewish share in American art has been underlined in the report on the social trends in the United States. This highly important investigation has been carried out by eminent social scientists entrusted with this mission by former President Hoover.

A short time ago the Jewish Statistical Bureau featured some authentic data on Jewish musicality which fully confirmed the above opinion expressed by a distinguished student of American art.

The statistical material on Jews in American music has been obtained from a special study by a trained psychologist and sociologist, Dr. K. Sward, published in the "Journal of Applied Psychology."

### Jewish Conductors and Virtuosi

In the season of 1932-33, out of 1048 players in the twelve best symphony orchestras in our country, twenty-five percent were Jews. The permanent conductors of these twelve orchestras in that season, and the guest conductors of the four foremost symphony societies (New York Philharmonic, Boston, Chicago, Philadelphia) during the last thirteen seasons, numbered thirty-seven. Of these, seventeen, or forty-six percent, were Jewish.

By and large, about fifty percent of the violin virtuosi and of the maestros and the first violinists of American symphony orchestras, and one-quarter to one-half of the piano virtuosi, are Jewish.

In connection with the revealing figures, these high percentages, one has to remember that the Jews constitute only three and six-tenths percent of the total American population.

### Jews as Composers

The recently issued manual "American Composers," compiled by the American section of the International Society for Contemporary Music, containing a record of musical works written between 1912 and 1932, has provided the investigator with an approximate index of Jewish achievements in modern original American composition. Among the 145 prominent composers listed therein, twenty-one, or fourteen and five-tenths percent, are Jews.

Again, by another criterion of statistical measurement, out of the forty-two composer-artists, who appeared as soloists with the four first-class symphonic orchestras of America, enumerated above, ten, or about twenty-four percent, were Jews.

Now, the study under discussion accentuates the fact that productivity in musical composition is less common among Jews than instrument success to the difficulty of economic survival as composers—and as Jews—plus the well-known historic dependence of composers on church and patronage.

### Jews in Amusement Music

Twenty-three amusement orchestras, principally in the city of New York, had a total of 596 players, including 212 Jews, or thirty-five and six-tenths percent. Here again the propensity toward the string instruments is in strong evidence. Over half of the string section is manned by Jewish players, and nearly three-quarters of the violin assignments are in the hands of Jews. A prominent band leader reports, however, that a trend exists among Jewish violinists to retain themselves on various novelty instruments in view of an oversupply of violinists.

The clarinet, trombone and horn are sections strikingly "non-Jewish." Among the players in amusement orchestras, a Jewish birth is probably much more frequent than among symphonists and virtuosi, the investigator assumes.

### A Brilliant Adjustment

"The majority of our Jewish virtuosi," says the author of the study, "sprang from Hungary, Poland and the Ukraine—countries richly steeped in musical culture." Now, environment, especially in early childhood, accounts for Jewish musicality to a degree not less than that of hereditary gifts and temperament.

One-fifth of the entire Jewish population in Eastern Europe emigrated to the United States before 1912. The first immigrants formed 21 percent of the Jewish immigrants in the liberal professions at the time of entry.

The association between the urbanized mode of life and musical culture is one of the chief reasons which stimulated Jewish musicality intensely. Jewish people have been imbued with musicality, due to the urban nature of possible Jewish employment, and later due more to custom and preference. Now, the continuation is peculiarly favorable for the development of exceptional musical talent.

Jewish musicality, thus, can be reduced to a brilliant and desirable adjustment of natural gifts to social conditions and historical forces.

### Preference for Violin

Certain social and habitual roots can also be found for Jewish fondness for the violin.

The instrument is inexpensive and has a religious precedent in Hasidic songs. Last but not least, the professional demand is great for this instrument.

However established, the Jewish preference for the violin could have perpetuated itself by tradition. So, for example, innumerable Jewish parents expose their children to the violin in the belief that the child may "have it in him."

Finally, provided the emotional Jewish temperament be taken for granted, the greater expressiveness of the violin and opportunity for display conspire to make this instrument a Jewish favorite.

## Rothschild Scion Tells Story of Discrimination by London Inn

LONDON, Aug. 9.—Victor Rothschild, youthful heir and nephew of Baron Lionel Walter Rothschild, has disclosed that he was the Jew involved in the first case reported in England of refusal to serve a Jew in a public restaurant.

The heir to the baronetcy told the press that he had entered a roadhouse with a party of friends and was politely informed he could not be served.

"As soon as I entered, the manager came up and asked me whether I was a Jew," Rothschild declared. "My appearance is hardly 'Aryan.' I confirmed the fact that I was a Jew and he replied he was

sorry he couldn't serve me and that I must leave. No explanation was offered. I left with my party."

In answer to comment by a reporter that the incident was most unusual for England, Rothschild, described in the press as "tall, dark, shy and slightly Byronic," replied:

"Ah, we live in a changed age, but this sounds rather like Nazi Germany."

Victor Rothschild was married last January 3 to Barbara Hutchinson, daughter of the British judge. She became a Jewess prior to her engagement, in keeping with the House of Rothschild tradition that male members of the family must not marry outside the faith.

## Groups Get Bequests From Turkeltau Will

The Federation of Jewish Charities is bequeathed \$2,000 by the will of Abraham M. Turkeltau, which was filed in Surrogate's court yesterday. Mr. Turkeltau died on March 12. The following institutions will receive \$500 each: Beth Israel Hospital, the Washington Heights Y. M. H. A., the Jewish Theological Seminary and the Hebrew Free Loan Society.

Mr. Turkeltau left one-fifth of the residue of the estate to his three children, Betty, Harold and Emanuel. They receive the principal at the age of twenty-three, but they lose the legacy if the executors disapprove of their marriages.

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## Many Fine Points of Legality Enter Palestine Potash Suit

LONDON, July 18.—Fine points of international law were involved in the recent lawsuit against the Palestine Potash Company which the judges of the King's Bench adjudicated in favor of the defendants. In this case a concession granted by the Palestine government to Moses Novomeysky and his associates, organizers of the Palestine Potash Co. to exploit the potash and other mineral deposits of the Dead Sea in Palestine was completely upheld by the court. The suit demanded the vacating of Novomeysky's concession in favor of the plaintiffs was dismissed.

At the first hearing of the suit on July 11, the plaintiffs' lawyers stated their client's claims. They declared that in 1910 the Sultan of Turkey, then conqueror of Palestine, had conceded the plaintiffs' sole right to extract salt from the waters of the Dead Sea. The defendants, on the other hand, had obtained a similar concession in 1930 from the High Commissioner of Palestine. Thus the dispute was which of the parties had prior rights to exploit the Dead Sea for mineral deposits.

Representing the plaintiffs were Sir Leslie Scott, Gordon Abrah, Quintin Hogg and Kenneth Diplock. Lawyers for the defendants were Sir William Jowitt, J. W. Murray, Leonard Sutherland and Sir Devin. Attorney-General Sir Thomas Inskip and a Kenelin Freedy watched the proceedings for the Crown. Mr. Justice Roche presided.

An adjournment of one week was granted to the plaintiffs when Sir Leslie Scott, at a later date, had time to peruse a number of documents which had just come into his hands.

Those documents, Sir Scott stated, were important evidence dealing with the point raised by the defense that the English Court was without jurisdiction in this case. He added that as the case included a claim to real property in a foreign country he must think the action could not be maintained in an English court unless the plaintiffs' lawyers could find in the new documents some contractual or equitable tie between the parties that would give jurisdiction.

**Trial Resumed July 17**  
On the resumption of the trial on July 17 Sir Scott declared that after studying the new documents he had come to the conclusion that there was no real plea of no jurisdiction which the defense raised. Therefore, he added, on behalf of his clients he must consent to judgment.

At this point Sir Jowitt adduced evidence that the defendants had carried on business with success for several years, that it had been made possible for them to extend their operations to the extent of securing additional capital, and that the claim outstanding against them was clearly detrimental.

Sir Jowitt also pointed out that the British government had never recognized the action of the concession. Moreover, he stated the defense's plea of no jurisdiction had been before the plaintiffs since December 1932, and that it had persisted in their claim. To defend this lawsuit, the defendants had been obliged to incur great expense in bringing their lawyers from Turkey, Palestine and Paris, Sir Jowitt added.

"Now the plaintiffs consent to judgment," he said, "and I have continued." But my clients must have the action dismissed generally and not on the narrow ground that there was no jurisdiction to deal with real property abroad. The plaintiffs' claim was entirely unfounded, and I ask that the action be dismissed generally, with costs on the higher scale declared in favor of the defendants."

After a brief recess Justice Roche pronounced the decision. He said that as no evidence or argument had been put before him he would simply give judgment for the defendants with costs. Admitting that he did not know much about the case, since the facts had not been gone into extensively, the justice added that he could not make a definite order himself on the question of costs on the higher scale. However, he directed that the Taxing Master should consider the position and if in his discretion it was found proper to so the Master would allow costs to the higher scale.

Aside from the final findings by Justice Roche, lawyers here showed deep interest in the points of international law involved. In reply to the plea of "no jurisdiction" at the July 11 hearing, Sir Scott admitted that the concession granted by the Sultan to his clients dealt with real property, or what in international law was called "immovables." In view of this, Sir Scott said, the English courts had no jurisdiction over immovable property situated in another country.

"There was a demise of land contiguous to the Dead Sea for setting up a factory," Sir Scott continued, "and I am obliged to admit that the court has no jurisdiction unless I can establish a contractual or equitable obligation on the defendants which the plaintiffs' seeking to establish. No pleading has been put in of such contractual or equitable obligation because my clients had not had enough knowledge of the law."

It was then that Sir Scott made a request for a week's adjournment, so as to study the new documents sent to the plaintiffs, and in which he indicated a relationship of equitable obligation might be discovered.

## New Nazi Ruling 'Aryanizes' Dance

**Wotan Over Terschorchere-'Aryan' Qualifications Not Mentioned for Diplomats**

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—The Volkischer Beobachter reports that German dancing teachers must be of "Aryan" descent.

The Reich Theater Chamber, a division of the Reich Chamber of Culture, has announced, the paper reports, that the prospective dancing teacher must be of "Aryan" descent. He must be more than eighteen years old and must have been examined before being allowed to teach.

"Aryan" qualifications were not mentioned in an article dealing with the duties of the prospective diplomatic services. It said only that applicants for a diplomatic career, apart from their other achievements, must have the same qualities demanded of other government officials.

## German Day Celebrants Ban Nazi Swastika

**'No Politics,' Says Head of Units in Aug. 12 Buffalo Fest**

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
BUFFALO, Aug. 9.—The Swastika will not be permitted in Genesee Park, scene of the annual German Day celebration sponsored by the United German Singing Societies of Buffalo, on August 12.

This step was taken, it was explained, to show that no form of politics whatever will enter into the celebration, which will be attended by over 25,000 German Americans.

According to Gustav Mueller, president of the United German Singing Societies, the formal German flag for the day will be the old German emblem, black, white and red. "Politics in no form whatever will be permitted. It will be a day given over to promote peace and harmony among Germans. It will be a day for Germans who remember, above all, that they are now Americans first and last," he said.

The motion to ban the swastika is known to coincide with the views of Reine Bettinger, former president of the Bavarian Men's League and now vice-president of the Federation of German Societies, who clashed recently with such pro-Nazi organizations as the Friends of New Germany and the DAWA.

"Any attempt to raise the swastika on the grounds of Genesee park," Mr. Bettinger said, "will end with instant action on my part."

"I will personally remove this symbol of the Hitler administration. I am an American citizen and I stand for all the ideals and principles of Americanism."

## N. Y. Bank Denies Giving Nazis Funds

**Secretary Sends Letter to Anti-Nazi League, Which Had Received Inquiries**

Denial of reports that the Central Savings Bank of New York had contributed funds to the Nazi movement in this country has been made by August Sidler, secretary of the institution, in a letter to Ezekiel Rabnowitz, secretary of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League.

The letter came in reply to inquiries made by the League, because of the numerous complaints received by the League office that such contributions had been made. Officers of the bank are largely of German extraction, Mr. Sidler's letter reads in part:

"We beg to acknowledge receipt of your inquiry in which you state that you are in receipt of many inquiries as to whether or not it is true that this institution has any connections with the Nazi movement in this country or abroad and whether any of its officials have made contributions to this cause."

"We appreciate the care which you exercise to avoid giving misleading information and, accordingly, pleased to inform you that neither this institution nor any of its officials have any affiliations or sympathy with the Nazi movement and have not made and are not inclined to make any contributions in support of it."

"It is quite inconceivable that any such affiliation or sympathy should exist. You can, therefore, safely disregard inquiries indicating a belief that they might exist."

## Junior Federation Seeks New Members in Drive

The membership campaign of the Junior Federation, auxiliary of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, gets under way September 1, it was announced yesterday. Organized in 1929, the group has increased its active paying membership from 350 more than 1,300. It is self-sustaining and is not dependent upon the senior group, to which it contributes approximately \$15,000 a year for relief purposes.

## Tailors' Strike Ends; Workers Win More Pay

**20 Per Cent Increase Set for Montreal Union; Sweathops Hit**

(J.D.B. Special Correspondence)  
MONTREAL, Que., Aug. 7.—After two days of negotiations between the Amalgamated Clothing Workers Union and the Manufacturers Association, the strike of the 4,000 tailors was amicably settled. Both sides signed an agreement, containing twenty clauses, the most important of which dealt with higher wages and overtime.

Wages are to be increased twenty per cent. Final details are to be worked out by an arbitration committee, of which Mr. Nathan Gordon is impartial chairman.

The negotiations for the union were carried on by Joseph Schlossberg, secretary-treasurer, Hyman Bloomberg, first vice-president, and E. Rabkin, organizer of the Amalgamated Clothing Workers Union of America. The Manufacturers' Association was Horace Cohen.

The International Ladies Garment Workers Union has declared a war to the bitter end against small independent manufacturers who have greatly contributed to sweatshop conditions in the industry.

Commenting on the situation, Bernard Shane, union organizer in Montreal, stated: — "There are such concerns whose existence we have never even suspected. Bedrooms, sitting rooms in houses everywhere, with one or two persons employed at starvation wages and sweating for the house. It is against these real 'sweatshops' that our activities are now concentrating."

## More Zion Entrants Allowed by British

**Rothberg Announces Receipt of 650 Certificates for 'Capitalist Class'**

Morris Rothberg, president of Zionist Organization of America, announced yesterday that the Palestine government has agreed to admit 650 certificates for the 'capitalist' category, persons possessing \$5,000 or more.

Rothberg pointed out that heretofore the practice of the Palestine government had been to supply the Passport Control Office in Amman with 100 certificates for "moneyed" immigrants to the Holy Land. The number of such immigrants during the past year, he said, had increased to such an extent that this limitation proved onerous. On representations of the Zionist Organization of America to the Passport Control Office for an increased number of certificates of the capitalist category, the Jerusalem officials had agreed to issue 650 certificates. The Passport Control Office the additional supply of such certificates, he said.

# Religious Rackets Mulet Thousands

## Prey on Jews' Best Instincts While City Law Protects Them

clause permitting the "congregation" to carry on charity and relief work.

From this point on the method of operation varies little. An office is opened, usually on the lower east side. Sham religious services are held once a week or less frequently.

In the meantime, at some distance from the office, a "boller room" is opened. This is the technical name for a bare, obscure garret, where a battery of telephones are installed to carry on the real operations.

### Fictitiously Listed

The telephones are listed under a fictitious name. From here "coxeys" do their work. The "coxeys" are the high-power salesmen of the firm. More than half of them have been known to have court records, usually for fraud and obtaining money on false pretenses.

The next step is to obtain the name of a judge or other official to employ in soliciting funds from prospective victims. Usually the name of an out-of-town judge, whose last name corresponds to that of a prominent New York jurist, is used. The judge is either paid for use of his name or duped into giving permission.

In one case it was found that the "coxeys" were using the name of a commissioner of deeds, equivalent to a notary public, which corresponded with that of the New York Police Commissioner.

"Commissioner O'Ryan asked me to call you for a donation. . . . The "coxeys" then told their victims over the telephone. . . . It was entirely legal.

### High-Powered Salesmen

Using the Blue Book and other directories, the "coxeys" call a prominent person, tells him that Commissioner Jones or Judge Jones asked him to call for a donation to the . . . Then follows a high-powered talk on the great work the charity organization is doing. The fact that it is a religious corporation is never mentioned.

Jews have been found to make the best "caps." ("Cap" is the name applied to a prospective victim). In the first place, the Jew is indiscriminately charitable by tradition. Secondly, many Jews, driven to be "regular" and fit into the community, think that responding to a phone solicitation is the "regular" thing to do.

Let us take a typical case. The "coxeys" phone a "cap." "Good day, sir," he opens. "I'm calling for Judge Jones. He has asked me to call you for a donation to our charity. We are engaged in helping the poor. We give out bread and coal, we . . . and so on. Levine, our fictitious "cap," promises to do. Immediately the "coxeys" phones the office from where a messenger is sent out. These messengers are often young rabbis or rabbinical students.

### The Split

The messenger arrives at the victim's place of business with surprising speed. If the donation is forthcoming, the messenger keeps ten per cent., twenty-five to forty-five per cent. goes to the "coxeys," and the rest to the promoters.

There is no honor among the thieves. The "coxeys" call the promoters to find out whether the "cap" "came across." If the promoter says he didn't, the "coxeys" checks up by phoning the "cap" again.

A pretense of doing relief work is kept up by handing out free lunches and, sometimes coal. It was found on investigation that in almost all cases the food and coal

were not bought but received by donation or solicitation.

In the meantime the Department of Welfare can do practically nothing. On occasion, the "boller rooms" are raided on some pretext or another with the aid of the district attorney's office, but the racket cannot be wiped out.

While the method described above is the usual mode of solicitation, circular letters also are used. The letterheads never mention that the organizations are incorporated as Jewish congregations. Some even mention that they are non-sectarian. A non-sectarian Jewish congregation!

### Sometimes Falls in Net

Once in a while a promoter oversteps himself. In a self-assurance he uses an official's name without permission, or commits some other error which pushes him over the pale of legality into which he hovers so precariously.

Then the Department of Welfare intervenes. The promoter is taken to court and penalized. But it has been found that promoters usually open rackets under different names immediately afterward.

In the case of Rabbi Jacob Bienefeld, connected with the Downtown Center of Relief, Herman N. Levin, Welfare Department investigator, asked the Rabbi said over the phone that he was a certain official. The person who was asked for a solicitation, Levin said, recognized the voice. An arrest followed, and the case is now going through the process of numerous adjustments.

Four organizations are now under investigation as possible rackets. The Jewish Daily Bulletin has their names and will publish them if the facts uncovered by the inquiry establish beyond a doubt their shady nature.

### A Typical Charter

All these organizations are incorporated as Jewish congregations. A typical charter reads in part:

"Purpose: To congregate on Sabbath and Holy Days and to work for the purpose of prayer and religious work and to voluntarily aid . . . its members, co-religionists, and other persons in distress."

The letterheads of the four organizations were inspected in an extensive Jewish Daily Bulletin investigation. None of them mentioned religious affiliation. One said "non-sectarian."

Two "honorary officers" of one group were asked to be the names removed from the letterheads. They were Senator Robert P. Wagner and David Marcus. Neither of these could be reached to discover their reasons for becoming dissatisfied with the organization.

Repeal Urged  
Repeal of the sub-section exempting religious organizations from the necessity of Welfare Department licenses would place a weapon in the hands of the Department to investigate these four organizations fully.

The Board of Aldermen could repeal the paragraph. Until it is repealed or revised, it seems certain that insidious rackets will continue to flourish under the protection of the Jewish religion. A concerted movement is under way for repeal.

Dr. Judah Magnes, Solomon Lowenstein, Magistrate Joseph J. Goldstein, and other prominent Jews have already expressed themselves for repeal of the exemption paragraph.

Police tactics used in the arrests of four men charged with soliciting funds for charitable purposes under false pretenses were scored by Magistrate Anna M. Kross when the accused were arraigned yesterday in the First District Magistrate's Court. The arrests were part of a city-wide campaign against charity rackets instituted by city authorities.

The criticism first arose during the arraignment of Jacob Bienefeld, 55, of 1057 Hoe avenue, The Bronx, said to be a rabbi, head of the Downtown Synagogue at 98 Liberty street, and his seventeen-year-old son, Myron. It was alleged that the names of prominent persons, as well as jurists from other communities were used by the two defendants to influence donations through the telephone and the mail to their so-called charitable organization. It was alleged further that young Bienefeld had accepted a \$74 check, signed by Rudy Vallee, from Detective Harry Lichtblau, posing as Vallee's secretary in Vallee's office.

At the hearing yesterday Assistant District Attorney John J. Sullivan requested a postponement, pleading that he had just been assigned to the case and that he had not had sufficient time to prepare the evidence. Two postponements had already been granted since the arrests of the Bienefelds on July 29.

Henry Gerson, lawyer for the

defendants, asked Magistrate Kross to deny the request for further postponement. "The manner in which the District Attorney's office and the arresting officers have dealt with this case is a travesty on justice," Gerson charged.

### Describes Arrest

When the Magistrate asked Gerson to explain his charges the lawyer described the manner in which the elder Bienefeld had been arrested. He stated that a riot squad had raided the Downtown Synagogue on July 29, at which time Bienefeld was apprehended. He was taken in a patrol wagon and later denied permission to communicate with his lawyers, Gerson said.

Detective Lichtblau refuted Gerson's description of the arrest. Thereupon Magistrate Kross asked the detective what he thought so important in the case to justify the calling out of a riot squad and a patrol wagon to raid a synagogue. Lichtblau defended the raid, stating that the defendant had resisted arrest.

"I am inclined to agree with the defendants' lawyer," Magistrate Kross asserted. "It has been my observation that the police department of this city has often exhibited brutality in making arrests. Such brutality is corrupting the efficiency of the police department. They are vicious practices, destructive to a Democratic government. Certainly there was no justification for the excessive force used by the police."

### Rebukes Sullivan

Assistant District Attorney Sullivan then repeated his request for a postponement on the grounds that the Magistrate, by her criticism of the police department, had shown prejudice in the case, thus nullifying her right to sit as presiding judge.

# Hitler Amnesty Frees 10,000 Foes of Nazis

## No Communists to Be Liberated—Seen as Move for Support

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BERLIN, Aug. 9.—Hitler government, in an amnesty decree today, will free from 8,000 to 10,000 minor criminal offenders and political prisoners. Hitler will deliver a plea for popular support on August 17, two days before the scheduled plebiscite on his policies. It was also learned today.

It was indicated that no Communists will be liberated. The decree will affect most of the Nazi storm troops incarcerated in connection with the alleged Roehm plot.

Offenses made subject to amnesty by Hitler's decree include: acts arising from overzealousness in the Nazi cause, acts against the national prestige, for which they were not held responsible, and against the Hitler government.

Prisoners convicted of treason, violence and terrorism will not be released.

Observers saw the amnesty decree as a move by Hitler for popular support in the August 19 plebiscite.

Hitler accompanied his decree with an explanation that it was issued as a mark of generosity to the people for the accession of a new chief executive.

Preparations are going forward for Hitler's speech on August 17. Loud speakers are installed in every public square. Nazis in towns throughout Germany are inviting families without radios to come to their homes to hear the speech.

Hitler's "election campaign"—a campaign in which he is opposed by the Jewish League, is mentioned in address by Propaganda Minister Goebbels.

## Poland's Zionists Meet To Fight Formation of Palestine Lower House

WARSAW, August 18.—The Jewish State Party, formerly known as the Democratic Revisionists, has issued an invitation to all Zionists in Poland to attend a meeting to unite on action to counteract plans for the formation of a legislative council in Palestine.

The conference has been called for Monday. A decision will be taken by the assembly with regard to the Jewish League and Zionist groups in the opposition to the proposed legislative council, which is based upon the argument that it will give the Arabs an undue great voice in the government, with consequent disproportionate representation for the Jewish population.

## Ukraine Jews Prepare For High Holy Days as 'Red' Persecutions Protest

MOSCOW, Aug. 9.—Great preparations for the coming High Holidays are being regaled by the Soviet press in the Ukrainian towns of Kamenetz-Podolsky, Bar and Nemirov.

Synagogues in these and other towns are being repaired by local Jews, it is reported.

The Communist newspaper, Emes, demands immediate action to be taken to hamper these preparations.

# 'Ritual' Food Is Permitted Silesian Jews

## Frick Order Sanctions 'Shechita' After a Long Prohibition

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BERLIN, Aug. 9.—Reichminister of the Interior Dr. Wilhelm Frick today issued an order permitting shechita, the killing of animals for food.

Under the order, the orthodox Jewish ritual, in Upper Silesia, which is a plebiscite area under the control of the League of Nations.

Shechita was prohibited in Germany soon after the Nazis came into power on the ground that it was cruel to the animals. Displaying the utmost solicitude for animals, the Nazis not only forbade shechita, but imposed unusually heavy prison terms for the slaughter and butchers accused of practicing shechita.

While nothing is mentioned in the order as to the reasons actuating the change, the question of defeats suffered by the Nazi government when it attempted to extend anti-Jewish measures to Upper Silesia are no doubt at the bottom of this unwanted display of Nazi generosity.

German anti-Semitic measures in Upper Silesia were protested by the League of Nations in connection with the Bernheim petition and the Nazi government was protesting to the League of Nations.

serious riots yesterday, but military forces in control of the town succeeded in crushing the new movement before it assumed dangerous proportions.

The mayor of Ain Beida issued a call to the population to preserve order and announced that severe punishment would be meted out to those guilty of race incitement.

Smoldering racial hatred in Constantine which flared into the brutal pogrom is plainly felt in the city, with the authorities extremely anxious to suppress it.

The seven military police which furnished an escort for Governor General Jules Caron on his visit to Constantine are still here circling above the city watching for concentrations of Arab pogrom bands.

Jewish districts on the outskirts of the city appeared to be free of any appeal to the military forces for protection.

Anxiety is felt over the fate of isolated Jewish families in the remote hinterland of Algeria, on farms and in little townships where they are surrounded by savage Arab tribes. It is believed that most of the isolated Jewish families were exterminated by Arabs.

Funerals of Jewish dead were held today and passed off quietly. Twenty-seven victims of the pogroms were buried in the Jewish cemetery amid the deep mourning of the Jews of the city. Heavy detachments of Senegalese troops guarded the funeral processions.

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Several Arab rioters of Jammah were sentenced to death to serve one year sentences in jail for participation in the attack against the Jews.

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
