Nazi Exaggerations

Recently Mr. Victor Rothschild was barred from the Barn Club, a roadhouse in London, because he is a Jew. He came to the roadhouse with several friends to get something to eat, and was ordered off the premises. Mr. Rothschild sought no publicity for this incident, but merely remarked:

"It does sound rather like Nazi Germany, doesn't it?"

In England the incident created a sensation. In Germany the department of propaganda, through Goebbels' personal or-gan, the Angriff, sees in it evidence of the rapid growth of anti-Semitism in England.

"Anti-Semitism is making progress in England," writes the Angriff. "The descendant of the Rothschilds, the heir to the vast Jewish fortune made out of the blood of the Napoleonic War of Liberation, has fled in panic to recuperate at a French seaside resort, because he is afraid of the terrible anti-Semitism in England."

And Goebbels' organ concludes that "the Jewish press spreads the cloak of silence over such occurrences."

As the Jewish Chronicle points out "the English press (and by the Jewish press' the Angriff of course means the English press) has not hesitated to condemn the action of the roadhouse in question."

The Daily Sketch referred to the incident as follows:

"It is abominably like (Nazi Germany), and it is the duty of those who value the liberties of our country to jump on this example of anti-Semitism. I believe in combating the beginnings of this, as of other dis-

The Yorkshire Post wrote:

"The great mass of Britishers remain absolutely averse to any such discrimination."

The Birmingham Gazette said: "I have no more than a suspicion of the name of the place at which they declined to serve Mr. Rothschild, but even there they assured me twice during the day that they have no anti-Semitic prejudice whatsoever, and at every other roadhouse at which I made inquiries the answer was the same. Indeed, I imagine that for some time these places will go out of their way to be especially nice in this re-

The Sunday Express said:

It is revealed that a member of the House of Rothschild has been denied refreshment at a roadhouse because he was a Jew. Eighty years ago a Rothschild, also because he was a Jew, secured an alteration in the M.P.'s oath that threw the House of Commons open to talent. He smashed intolerance in politics. To Increase Post Patrols

Fear Renewal of Rioting in Palestine as Moslem Plot Activities

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
JERUSALEM, Aug. 28. — Accentuating the fears being felt by the Jewish population of Palestine that Arabs are plotting to use their forbidden activities in hunting for illegal immigrants as a starting point for renewed riots with Jews as the victims, was an article in today's issue of Falastin, Arabic daily newspaper.

The newspaper announced that a committee of Arab self-appointed coast guards would hold a conference in Jaffa tomorrow at which further mobilization of coastwise patrols would be discussed. Particular attention will be placed on the problem of patrolling Nathania, according to the newspaper, where recently a band of Arab youths garbed as boy scouts were attacked by young Jews who resented their activities in attempting to aid the government's war on illegal immigration.

As a direct result of this fracas, during which one young Arab was wounded, High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope issued a statement forbidding use of unauthorized agents in tracking down immigrants who had no proper passports.

The continued participation of Arabs in guarding the coastline is in open defiance of the edict and has given rise to considerable alarm in Jewish quarters that the Arabs were planning to launch a new onslaught against the Jews as bloody as that perpetrated five years ago. This suspicion was openly voiced yesterday by Haaretz, outstanding Hebrew daily, in a strong editorial in which it declared that Arab jealousy, coupled with annoyance at the great strides toward prosperity which Jewish settlers have made recently, is behind the suspected plot.

Volksblatt Emits Yelp As Non-Aryans Use Cabs Bedecked With Swastika

The Volksblatt is all steamed up that Jews should dare to do any such thing.

"It is an affront," it complains, "to the national symbol to be used for Jewish religious purposes."

Curb on Zionist British Turn

Intercession Fruitless as Home Office Favors Way Government Plans Halt on Activities

KAUNAS, Aug. 28.—The Lithuanian government is considering the suppression of all Lithuanian Zionist youth organizations and the intercession of Jewish groups has been unsuccessful, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today.

Yesterday the chief of police of Siauliai ordered the closing of the Zionist youth organization offices for one year. In recent weeks Lithuania has been the scene of numerous anti-Jewish outbreaks. The Lithuanian government, in a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, minimized some of the incidents and completely denied others. However, Lithuanian Jewish organizations have confirmed the stories and denied government allegations that Jews were responsible for the attacks.

Paul May Buried ${f With Orthodox Rites}$

Late Belgian Envoy to U. S. Is Eulogized for Work at Final Services in Antwerp

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) ANTWERP, Aug. 28. - Paul

May, late Belgian Ambassador to the United States, who died in Washington last month, was buried here today. The orthodox Jewish ritual was followed strictly.

Eulogizing the deceased, Grand Rabbi Wiener described him as having been a faithful Jew, a faithful Belgian and a great personality. Rev. Weill chanted the El Moleh Rachmin, traditional Jewish prayer for the dead.

Among those who attended the services were numerous foreign diplomats, government officials. representatives of Jewish organizations and the presidents of the Brussels and Antwerp Jewish communities.

The body was transported to Belgium aboard the United States Cruiser Pensacola. Earlier, it had been kept in a vault at the Arlington National Cemetery.

Units Weighed To 'Beth Din' By Lithuanians As Problem Aid

of Jews as Solution to Domestic Difficulties

LONDON, Aug. 28.—The Jewish way of dealing with unhappily married couples, is the best, officials of the British Home Office who completed a study of matrimonial problems, announced today.

The report made by the Home office group recommended that Great Britain adopt the Jewish method of setting up a Beth Din, or arbitration court, to settle home disputes instead of bringing the cases into courts.

Each Jewish community customarily has a private arbitration court made up of local Jewish notables and members of the rabbinate to whom cases involving matrimonial and other problems are submitted. In these courts every effort is made to solve the problem offered without recourse to the regular courts. Efforts are also made to reconcile the couples before a divorce is considered.

Nazis Plaster Villages With Anti-Jewish Signs As Party Parley Nears

BERLIN, Aug. 28.—In preparation for the forthcoming Nazi party congress, all villages in the neighborhood of Nuremberg, where the congress is to be held, have been decorated with large signs 'Jews enter this village at their own risk," "Jews are not wanted here" and "This village is free from Jews."

Die Deutsche Zeitung, important Nazi paper, proudly points out that even in the fourteenth century Nuremberg was already opposed to the Jews.

Nuremberg is the headquarters of Julius Streicher, editor of the anti-Jewish weekly, Der Stuermer, and Nazi commissioner for Franconia. Under his rule Nuremberg has become notorious as the most outspoken anti-Semitic city in Ger-

Lays Misery Of Jews to Poles' Policy

Former Deputy Charges Regime Seeks to Oust Them From Life

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Aug. 28.—The exact manner in which the Jews of Poland are slowly but surely being ousted from the economic life of the nation through a considered government policy was portrayed here today by former deputy Apolinaris M. Hartglas, who delivered the principal speech before the convention of the Polish Zionist Federation.

Hartglas enumerated in great detail the various branches of economic life from which the Jews were being forced and recalled the recent speech made by Premier Leon Kozlowski, in which he painted a gloomy future for Polish Jews and proclaimed that the government would fight against the middlemen (mostly Jews) and support consumer cooperatives. He also dealt with the amended industrial law, soon to go into effect and which, according to Hart-glas, would completely ruin Polish Jewish artisans.

The speaker summarized the situation by saying that "in view of the government's anti-Jewish policy, 2,999,999 of the 3,000,000 Polish Jewish are unnecessary."

Polish Jews, even those belonging to the government party, no longer have any influence, Hartglas said, adding that Polish Jewish leaders have ceased to make demands upon the government, knowing beforehand the futility of

A House Divided

"The Jews of Poland have ceased to believe in their own Polish parliamentary Jewish life is paralyzed and the Jewish parties in Poland now constitute a house divided among itself," Hartglas said.

As an example of the tragic Jewish division, Hartglas cited the fact that even when faced with economic extinction, Jews cannot agree upon the formation of a united Jewish national

Referring to the attitude of the Polish government during the period when the Nara anti-Semites were carrying out widespread attacks on the Jews, Hartglas declared "no one could have foretold how far those riots would have spread if Minister of the Interior Bronislaw Pieracki had not (Continued on Page Eight)

Seek Further Ban On Jewish Doctors

Reporting that Berlin now has 256 fewer Jewish doctors than six months ago, the paper asserts this decrease - eleven per cent-is not sufficient.

Simon Warns Jewish Cattle Dealers Barred By Reich in the Southwes Kashruth Body To Reorganize

Threatens Withdrawal of City's Support at **Stormy Session**

An emergency committee of the Kashruth Association led by Rabbi Nachman Ebin met yesterday with Arthur Simon, Health Department investigator in charge of kashruth enforcement to formulate plans for the reorganization of the Asso-

The conference was called after a heated parley by the Association at the Hotel Pennsylvania Monday night which lasted until early yesterday morning.

Debate and recriminations marked the meeting. At one point, the meeting became so disorderly that Simon and Louis Lande, representing the City of New York, threatened to walk out and withdraw the City's support from the

Simon told the 150 assembled members, for the most part orthodox rabbis, that the Association must be completely reorganized to obviate such wrangling as marked that meeting. Failing that, Simon said that the Association would not be allowed to control rabbinical supervision of poultry markets in New York as was previously planned by Judge Otto Rosalsky, the Mayor's mediator in the poultry market difficulties.

"This conference is called by the order of Judge Rosalsky," Rabbi Ebin, chairman, said in opening it. "Judge Rosalsky told me that he wants to hear the views of the Kashruth Association before announcing his decision in the poultry situation."

Rabbi Ebin and other speakers attacked the Rabbinical Advisory Council of Fifty recently appointed by Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch to advise the City on Kashruth problems.

"The committee spent its time dealing in trifles," Rabbi Ebin de-

Rabbi Ebin quoted Judge Rosalsky as saying, "I won't give a decision unless it is backed by the unified rabbinate."

The Judge was not present at the meeting.

"Not one rabbi in New York will be ignored in the plans for rab-binical supervision," Simon told the

A resolution was adopted backing the stand of the shochtim that they cannot slaughter more than 12,000 pounds of poultry per week and guarantee that it is kosher.

Resolutions thanking Judge Rosalsky, Simon, Mayor LaGuardia, Deutsch, and Lande for their aid to the cause of Kashruth in New York City were passed by acclaim.

The Association resolved that one-half cent per pound of poultry must be allocated for rabbinical supervision and one-half cent for slaughtering.

Plight of Jews Explained by Neville Laski

Briton Conducts Survey of Their Conditions in Poland, Austria

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, Aug. 28. — Neville Laski, president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, stated at Warsaw that the Jews of Poland and Austria are suffering dire destitution, dispatches to the London press from that city reported

Laski is conducting investigations in both countries into the conditions of their Jewish inhabitants and is discussing their straits with the authorities and Jewish leaders with a view to achieving amelioration.

The American Joint Distribution Committee came in for praise from Laski, who said Jews of other countries might well follow the example it has set in helping the Jews of Poland who, he pointed out, comprise a large portion of the Jews in the world.

A. F. of L. Convention Will Discuss Fascist Trends Against Labor

Announcement was made yesterday that a session of the annual convention of the American Federation of Labor will be devoted to a symposium on Fascism.

The convention, which will be held late in September in San Francisco, will seek to rally the support of American working masses against forces, similar to those which have been successful in Europe, aiming to destroy organized labor.

Speakers at the symposium on Fascism will include William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor; Walter M. Citrine, chairman of the British Trades Union Congress, who will come here to participate in the convention, and B. Charney Vladeck, chairman of the Jewish Labor Committee, which has a membership of more than 600,000 Jewish trade unionists affiliated with the American Federation of La-

Dusterberg Not Killed But a 'Living Corpse,' He Tells Geneva Paper

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Aug. 28.-Lieutenant-Colonel Theodore Dusterberg was released from a concentration camp on August 2, it was ascertained today by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency. Since that time he has been free, it was revealed in the Tribune of Geneva, in which he makes the following statement:

"I was not killed, but I am a living corpse as a result of having been committed to a concentration camp's military jail on some silly suspicion in connection with Roehm."

Jesuit Ascribes Anti-Semitism To Envy of Superior Qualities

(Special to the J.D.B.)
SOUTH NORWALK, Conn., Aug.
28.—A stirring defense of the Jews and an analysis of Judaism was delivered here this afternoon by the Rev. J. F. X. Murphy, faculty member of Boston College, in an address on "International Judaism," a feature of the eleventh annual convention of the Jesuit Philosophical Association of the Eastern States.

Father Murphy, who has frequently expressed the conviction that Christianity's debt to the Hebrew race is so profound that it can never be repaid, in his speech which led a general discussion of the topic, asserted that much of the world's hostility toward Jews today has as its basis "jealousy of the Jew's superior tenacity, perseverance and determination.'

The two-day session, which will end tomorrow, has brought to Manresa Island, a secluded spot just off the coast of this city, some 110 faculty members of all the Jesuit colleges in the association.

Jew's Viewpoint Independent

Among the outstanding points emphasized by Father Murphy in his paper before the convention were the following:

The Jew, in general, is a nonconformer. His moral and social oscillation is far more in evidence than with most peoples. The history of the Jewish race, as delineated by the Old Testament, is ample evidence of the truth of those assertions, Father Murphy pointed out.

The Jewish nationalistic philosophy, he said, is a philosophy of negation, and for that reason the Jew is unassimilable in world populations today to a greater extent than are nearly any other people.

Then, citing the historic example of St. Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Society of Jesus, he pointed to the great esteem in which Loyola held the Jews when he urged greater proselytization among them because they made the best Jesuits.

Decries "Exploitation" Myth

The situation in Germany today was handled delicately by the Jesuit professor, who confined himself to the remark that it would be necessary to await the verdict of historians before arriving at a proper evaluation of its significance.

In discussing the economic aspects of Judaism, Father Murphy struck a blow at the age-old charge that Jews are exploiters of Christians. This charge, he said, was unfair, inasmuch as, like Christians, they did not hesitate to exploit each other.

Inhumanity of man to man, he declared, is a trait common to Jews, Gentiles and others as well.

Hitlerism Denounced

In a paper read prior to the discussion of Father Murphy's topic, the Rev. Laurence K. Patterson delivered a scathing attack against Hitler and "his satellites," when he characterized as preaching a gospel of nationalism "so perverted and ludicrous that it would arouse contempt were it not so danger-

"It is an almost obvious truism," he declared, "that exaggerated and bellicose nationalism is an outstanding world problem to present Holy Father, Pius XI, has written more than once concerning this burning issue. I cite but one passage from many: 'Right order and Christian charity do not disapprove of lawful love of country and of a sentiment of justifiable nationalism; if, however, egotism abusing this love of country and exaggerating this sentiment of nationalism insinuates itself into the relations between people and people there is no excess which will not seem justified, and that which between individuals would be judged blameworthy by all is now considered lawful and praiseworthy, if it is done in the name of this exaggerated nationalism.

"'Instead of the great law of love and human brotherhood which embraces and holds in a single family all nations and peoples, there enters hatred, driving all to destruction."

Vienna's Needy Increase, Face A Hard Winter

50,000 Jews Depend on Charity, Friedmann Points Out

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
VIENNA, Aug. 28.—Fifty thousand poverty stricken Jews in this city, one-fourth of the Jewish population, are now dependent upon the Vienna Jewish community for aid, Dr. Desider Friedmann, president of the community, declared today. Writing in the Neue Freie Presse, important Viennese daily, Dr. Friedmann painted a gloomy picture of Jewish distress in present-day Austria.

He declared that applications asking for relief are coming in from many Jews who only recently were well-to-do, including middle class people and the numerous Jewish bank employees recently discharged from Austrian banks. Distress among the Jews is growing at an alarming rate, Dr. Friedmann said, and the coming winter is certain to see an extension of Jewish misery.

The Austrian government contributed nothing at all for relief work among the Jews, leaving the entire burden on the Jewish community, despite a government decision made in 1927 recognizing the Jewish community's claim to a government subsidy for relief

Adjusting Our Lives

City Federation for Philanthropic Work

The great variety of Jewish social-philanthropic societies and other communal organizations in the United States has brought about the recognition, on the part of the communal leaders, of the

value of co-operation and coordinated activity.



organizations.

In 1927, when the first official census of the Jewish communal organizations was taken by the director of the Jewish Statistical Bureau, Dr. H. L. Linfield, as agent of the United States Bureau of the Census, forty-one out of the 871 independent communities reported the existence of city federations for communal activities. Seven communities had federations of con-

gregations; one, a federation of educationalrecreational societies; and nine, federations of social-philanthropic organizations, such as brotherhoods, sisterhoods, men's clubs, etc. All of these nine, with one exception, were women's

In these city-wide federations, each member society continues to maintain its officers, membership, and other prerogatives of an

Two Types of Federations

In addition to this class of federation of local independent societies, primarily for the purpose of the discussion of common problems, there is another class of citywide federations of much greater importance, which may be designated as the city-wide financial federations for philanthropic ac-

The second type of federation operates with a view to promoting economy in the collection of funds, to securing more adequate support for the work, and to increasing efficiency in the management of the work by avoiding overlapping and fostering cooperation.

In these city-wide federations, each constituent organization continues to exist as an entity and maintains its officers, but it agrees that its members shall become a part of the membership of the federation and that the right to solicit funds be vested in the federation. The latter, then, with the membership of the constituent societies as a nucleus, builds up a group of contributors whose donations go into a general fund to be distributed among the various

Functions of Federations

The officers of the federations are elected at the annual meetings of the contributors or members of the federations, though in some cases a part of the board of trustees are designated by the constituent societies. At these meetings there are elected, by various methods, also the officers of every constituent society; and in some cases, the officers of the constituent societies are self-perpetuating; in others, they are appointed by the

Contributions from the public, with a few exceptions as will be noted presently, received by the constituent societies, are turned over to the treasurer of the federation. The constituent societies, however, reserve for themselves certain sources of income, such as dents, the federation membership contributions from the municipalities and the states, payment for the community. services, income from trust funds, special gifts and bequests. The treasurer of the federation is expected to cover the difference between the expenditures of the constituent societies and their "direct" income, if any.

Of the forty-two federations that reported in 1927, sixteen were independent ones, while twenty-six were members of Community Chests, that is, central organizations for the city as a whole.

The membership in ten out of these sixteen independent federations was 89,220, which gives an average of 383 members per 10,000 Jews in the community.

Federations at Work

The organizations that are members of federations include health organizations, such as hospitals; organizations for the care of dependents (family welfare societies, child care societies, homes the event.

for the aged, societies for delinquents, societies for the handicapped, and so on); educational organizations (Talmud Torahs); educational-recreational organizations, such as social welfare settlements, and Jewish centers.

In the City of New York, the amounts contributed by the federations to educational organizations and to educational-recreational organizations are comparatively small, but outside of New York, the work of the local educational associations going under the name of Bureau of Jewish Education, or Department of Jewish Education, is part of the work of the federation. In fact, in the smaller communities the chief beneficiaries of federations are often those organizations maintaining the Jewish Center and the Talmud Torah.

The federations, as a rule, contribute to the support of national organizations, such as the National Farm School, the HIAS, and

Difficulties in Large Cities

Local Jewish welfare federations, at the time of the first official census seven years ago were reported by forty-one communities, New York City having two, one for Manhattan and Bronx boroughs, and one for the borough of Brooklyn. A total of about three and a quarter million Jews, or seventy-seven per cent of the total American-Jewish population, resided in the cities having federations. The number of constituent societies in forty-one federations in 1927, was 497.

The total number of contributing members in Greater New York is less than 50,000, or hardly three per cent of the metropolitan Jewish population. Only 232 of every 10,000 Jews in New York City were federation members, while in Philadelphia, the ratio was 815 to 10,000; and in two cities of the class of 2,000 to 8,000 Jewish resiaveraged 1,596 to 10,000 Jews in

These figures bear out the general view accepted among Jewish communal workers in America that it is more difficult to secure members for federations in the larger Jewish communities than in the smaller ones.

Religious services on the High Holy Days will be held at Ellis Island for Jewish immigrants and deportees detained there, Isaac L. Asofsky, general manager of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society of America (HIAS) announced yesterday.

Rudolph Roemer, Commissioner of Immigration at Ellis Island, has set apart a room which will be transformed into a synagogue. HIAS has undertaken to provide the necessary paraphernalia. Special Holy Day food will be furnished, Mr. Asofsky said.

HIAS has again prevailed upon the Commissioner not to deport any Jewish alien on the High Holy Days. Immigration inspectors will be instructed to facilitate the landing of all Jewish immigrants the day prior to the Holy Days so as to enable them to join their families in this country.

Immigrants whose destinations are cities outside of New York will be provided for by HIAS in its Home in New York City where religious services will be held. Jewish unemployed and homeless who are being fed and sheltered by the society, will also be given an opportunity to participate in services, it was announced.

An isolated incident, of which the offenders are now ashamed, is construed into evidence that "anti-Semitism is making progress in England." The universal condemnation in the English press of this stupid form of intolerance is of course not mentioned in the Nazi press. Thus are the German people being constantly duped by their present leaders.

Education Head Demands Conception of 'Race and Nation'

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence)
BERLIN, Aug. 14.—That there is little relenting on the theory, at least, of National Socialism in Nazi Germany is apparent from consideration of unabased attempts of the Nazi presa and leaders to foist upon the people Hitlerite conceptions, many of which are in no wise meeting with popular approval.

Dr. Schemm, Minister of Education, speaking before a conference of the National Socialist Teachers Federation here, temanded that educators open their doors to the conception of "Race and Nation."

"We go home from this conference," Schemm declared, "with the determination to stand behind our leader Adolf Hitler, the greatest educator in Germany."

Hitler wired the onference expressing his thanks for Schemm's work in "educating our nation for the National Socialist State."

Gauleiter Sprenger detailed the course of Nazi education somewhat more specifically than the minister did. "The foundations of education," he said, "must be reconstructed. Till now they have consisted of erroneous ideas.'

Sprenger said that hereafter the foundation of Ccman thought must be based on German race. Race Issue Paramount

"We are returning to our native life," he declared, "which is home, race, nation, God. These are the foundations of German education. Who denies race denies the foundation of education."

34% Employed In Soviet Shops, Survey Shows

Only 12% Are Peasants, Among Russia's Jews, Kunitz Writes

Thirty-four per cent of the Jews in Soviet Russia are factory workers; thirty-one per cent, office workers; fourteen per cent, artisans, and twelve per cent are peasants. These statistics are incorporated in a survey of the Jewish situation in Russia by Joshua Kunitz, published in the current issue of New Masses. The remainder is divided between professional and miscellaneous occupations.

The writer finds "that seventeen years of proletarian rule have finally solved the eternal Jewish question."

"The Soviet government has established a series of Jewish theatres in Moscow, Kharkov, Minsk, Kiev, Odessa, and is now building the first Jewish theatre in Biro-Bidjan," Kunitz continues.

"It is absolutely untrue that the Jewish religion or any other religion is prohibited in the Soviet Union. Of course the Jewish religion is not being encouraged, just as every other religion in the Soviet Union is not being encouraged," the article goes on to say.

Zionist propaganda is prohibited, but Yiddish papers and the study of the language are encouraged, Mr. Kunitz finds, and the last vestiges of anti-Semitism are being uprooted in an area extending over one-sixth of the land surface of the globe.

Refugee Had Advocated Storm Troops; Now Remorseful

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence).

JERUSALEM, Aug. 15 .- Soon after the Nazis had assumed power in Germany, a certain Dr. Sachs, a German Jewish dentist who had become baptized, found that his practice had been ruined by the boycott against the Jews and that there was no chance for him to make a living. He there-fore left Germany, reverted to Judaism and emigrated to Palestine, where he settled in the flourishing Jewish town of Rehoboth. Within a short time he had established a flourishing practice and was earning \$350 a month.

Today Dr. Sachs announced that he would leave Palestine as soon as he finds a country willing to accept him. The decision reveals a curious story.

For Storm Troops

After he had established himself in Palestine, Dr. Sachs wrote a Jewish friend in Germany declaring he had a fine practice and everything was pleasant, save for the fact that he was compelled to live among the "dirty Jews." He also informed his friend that he had many Arab friends and that he would like to form storm troops among them just as the Nazis had done in Germany.

The friend, who had, meanwhile, become a Zionist, turned the letter over to Zionist leaders of his acquaintance. The case was referred to Palestine and was turned over to the German Settlers Association, for action.

The dentist was called before the association and asked to explain the letter. He made no attempt to deny the charges and was advised to leave Palestine for his own interests.

His father, Professor Sachs, of Berlin, interceded in his behalf and offered to contribute a large sum to the Jewish National Fund if his son were excused the consequences of his childish prank.

The association took no action, however, and recently received a contrite letter from the dentist, acknowledging that the charges against him were true and asking only for time to arrange his affairs and secure a visa to some country willing to accept him.

It is significant that, although he is legally entitled to remain in Palestine, the action of the association being entirely unofficial, Dr. Sachs has made no attempt to appeal to the authorities.


'Aryan Paragraph' Robs Doctors, Lawyers, Artists, Professors and Journalists of All Hope; Desperation Heightened by Difficulty of Emigration

The following is the last of a series of four articles that paint an illuminating picture of what Germany and German Jews may expect in the immediate future. The series is based on close observations made by Mr. Smolar, chief European correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency over a period of several

BERLIN.—For the first time since the advent of the Nazi regime, it is possible now to determine definitely, by authentic figures, the actual extent of the havoc wrought upon the economic

life of the German Jews by Nazi legislation. It is possible now to quote authentic figures on the number of Jews who in that time have lost their jobs as government officials, to state definitely how many professors were driven from the universities, how many lawyers lost the right to appear in court, how many doctors were expelled from the sick benefit funds, how many Jewish artists were forced to give up their careers and how many journalists lost their posts in the larger and smaller editorial offices of German newspapers.



The number of these sufferers is by no means a small one. Up to July, 1934, it exceeded 15,000. More than 15,000 families of persons in the professions are now in need in Germany and are dependent upon the help which they receive from various Jewish charitable institu-

Twenty-one months ago, just a month before Hitler came into power, these 15,000 families were the cream of German Jewish life. Not only were they not dependent upon charity, but they were in an excellent position to give charity. They paid great taxes to the Jewish community. They made considerable contributions to various Jewish and general cultural institutions. They gave lavishly on every hand.

Now, after twenty months of the Hitler rule, they are the takers rather than the givers. They sit in the cramped quarters of the Jewish relief organizations in Berlin, Frankfurt, Chemnitz and Leipzig, and wait despondently for slight sums, for occasional heavy work, for a railroad ticket to another city and even for a ticket which will get them a free meal.

The Jewish intellectuals of Germany-not to mention the smallscale Jewish merchant and the Jewish employee — have in the space of little more than a year and a half been reduced to beggardom. The Jewish intellectuals of Germany have been relegated, by the Hitler brand of legislation, to degrading poverty. The "Aryan paragraph" has fulfilled its aim. It has taken the very best of German Jewry-the intellectual stratum-has broken it and robbed it of its courage. These Jews have been ground under the Nazi heel place to which they might migrate. until they no longer see any hope German doctors may no longer for themselves, neither in Ger- practice openly in Palestine. No many nor anywhere else.

Doctors Require Charity

It may perhaps be difficult to believe, but it is a fact that no less than 4,500 Jewish doctors are now dependent upon the aid of Jewish relief agencies. Two thousand of them have actually been classified with such organizations as being in "drastic need."

The "Aryan paragraph" eliminated more than 5,000 doctors from the sick benefit funds. It took away the foundation of their livelihood. It isolated them not only from official practice but from private practice as well. No "Aryan" dares consult a Jewish physician in Germany. "Aryan" officials in public institutions lose their jobs if it is discovered that their wives are treated by Jewish doctors. "Aryan" employees are warned But that is not the case with an ity to continue working in their not to consult a Jewish physi-

tice for a sick benefit fund. Without the sick benefit funds and faced by an intensified campaign against themselves, very few Jewish doctors in Germany are in a position to earn their livelihood. Indeed, very few of them are in a position to keep up a decent office, because their earnings do not ven cover their rent.

That is why these ruined Jewish medicos sit for hours in the offices of the various relief organizations, where they tell frankly and despondently how difficult things are for them and how their economic state grows worse daily.

Migration Is Barred

A great part of them would like to migrate, but they lack the funds. Others among them would like to find places for themselves in other professions, but there is no profession in Germany toward which Jews can turn with assurance that they will not immediately be forced out. About three thousand of them are already middle-aged or past that. All their lives were spent in the medical profession. It would be almost impossible for them, at their age, to become acclimated in a new profession.

The need and desperation of these Jewish doctors continue to grow. And no one can advise them as to how they might help themselves. There is scarcely a in Egypt. And China, too, has many Jewish doctors from Germany. And it is generally difficult to get into France, England or America. So that the Jewish relief committees in Germany are the one hope of salvation, the one place to which a Jewish doctor, once a giver of charity, now can turn to ask aid for himself.

Lawyers Also Suffer

Nor is the position of more than 4,000 Jewish lawyers whom Nazi legislation expelled from the court room in accordance with the "Aryan" paragraph any better.

In fact, the position of the lawvers, is much sadder than that of the doctors. A doctor can at least hope that, now and then, a private patient may find his way to him. ousted Jewish attorney. Jews will chosen fields. cian if he has the right to prac- not consult a Jewish advocate, not

under the present Nazi regime, a Jewish lawyer can hardly win the case. Non-Jews will not consult a Jewish lawyer because they will immediately be made to suffer for having patronized a Jew.

Jewish attorneys in Germany even those who because of their service during the war have not been excluded from the courts, are now in a very difficult position. The more so those who may not make their appearance in court.

In Prussia alone there are now, according to the official figures, 1364 Jewish advocates who have lost their right to plead in court simply because they are Jews. The number of such Jewish advocates all over the country is conservatively estimated as 2,000. This includes only the older lawyers, those with a wide reputation.

No Hope for Young

But, in addition to these older men, there are more than 2,000 young lawyers who have lost their profession. Two thousand socalled "junior barristers." thousand graduate lawyers who in compliance with the existing laws were always forced to serve for a certain length of time in a recognized lawyer's office before they were accepted by the court as lawyers in their own right.

Now these 2,000 junior barristers are without any prospects whatsoever. They will never be admitted before a court. Nor have they any hope of remaining with recognized lawyers, for if a lawyer has nothing to do, what need has he of an assistant?

These young Jewish attorneys are now trying to learn new occupations. They are going in for hard labor. They spent their best years studying German law, but now they are learning to become tailors, shoemakers, building laborers, bakers and whatever else possible. They will never be lawyers, they know now. The "Aryan paragraph" will not soon be abolished in Germany. Not even if Hitler should fall. Not even if some other power should come to Germany.

Tragic, too, and without hope is the condition of the Jewish government officials who have been ousted.

In Prussia 2,700 Jews have been thrown out of their jobs in government offices. Two thousand of them are persons with academic training. More than 1,500 of them worked in courts, in tax bureaus and in various administrative and municipal institutions. Two hundred and fifty of them were employed in the postal and telegraph systems. Others held positions in institutions for social service and in various departments of the Prussian government system.

Now, however, not one of them retains his position. All are without work, and most are dependent

upon charity. The great number of Jewish notaries who have been deprived more German doctors are wanted of their right to practice is not included in the above figures. The official Prussian "Press Service" states that in Prussia alone 1,199 Jews may no longer practice as notaries. In all of Germany the number of such Jewish notaries is certainly not less than 2,000. The complete number of ousted Jewish government officials in all of Germany is conservatively estimated at 3,000. Five thousand persons, therefore have lost their positions without any prospect whatsoever of other work.

It must be difficult for a person on the sidelines to realize that no less than 8,000 Jewish artists and 1200 Jewish journalists are now scattered over Germany, having been driven from their positions and robbed of the opportun-

sions harder than it did any of the others. These 1200 Jewish journalists were specialists. Each one occupied an important position in the general press of Germany. Each one helped to make the German press the best in Europe.

Professionally Ruined

Now they are all on the outside. All are without bread. Not only may they not work in a German editorial office but they may not even print an occasional article in some newspaper. They are simply dead professionally.

The same is true of the 1200 Jewish artists. Less than two years ago they were the best actors on the German stage. They were among the most famous They were considered singers. Germany's best regisseurs. They made Berlin the world's greatest theatre center.

Now they dare not set foot upon a stage. Now they are, almost every one, hungry. They have nowhere to earn anything and nothing they could earn it

Teachers Must Beg

Similar is the plight of some 800 Jewish teachers and professors at German high schools and universities.

The Jewish professors and high school teachers were never wealthy individuals. They never received high salaries. They never had the opportunity to save anything for a rainy day. Now that that day has come, they are the first to be forced to beg for their bread.

In the professional stratum alone, fifteen thousand Jewish families have been broken up as a result of the "Aryan paragraph."
The havoc created by the "Aryan paragraph" among Jewish employees is a chapter in itself, one I shall have occasion to write about later

Berates Those Who Minimize Geneva Parley

New England Branch of A. J. C. Hails Work of Conference

(Special to the J.D.B.)

BOSTON, Aug. 28.-Unalloyed praise for the recent Geneva World Jewish Conference and condemnation of "a few leaders who are seeking to undermine the influence and the prestige of this great world Jewish gathering by questioning its validity" are contained in a statement issued today by the New England Branch of the American Jewish Congress here.

"We heartily welcome and cheerfully endorse the manly and courageous stand taken . . . in regard to the convocation of a World Jewish Congress in 1935," statement declares in part:

Opening of Jerusalem's new Luna Park, says an advertisement in the Palestine Post, has been deferred pending completion of the ferris wheel.

What a curious train of thought arises from the announcement that this city, breeding place of more history than perhaps any other in the world, is to have a Luna Park!

Somehow the idea at first glance seems indecently frivolous. Jerusalem, we always have felt, is meant to be the scene of ponderous events. In her lap this mothercity has fondled and nurtured the world's three most important religions. Plot and counter-plot, bloodshed, an age-old heritage of misunderstanding — these have been the lot of the Holy Land's chief city.

And now we are told Jerusalem is to have a Luna Park. Twentieth century entrepreneurs, to whom nothing is sacred, have decided that even this birthplace of countless sorrows may have its lighter moments, and they mean to capitalize on them.

Had there been a Luna Park a couple of thousand years ago, history might have taken a different

When Christ was contemplating preaching his sermon on the Mount, his disciples might have said to him:

'You'll have to put it off for the time being. You'd never be able to raise an audience. Everyone spends all his spare time out at Luna Park these days."

We can picture the Bedouin of tomorrow, riding in from the desert to search for his wandering

"What are things coming to?" he wails. "Here I have a rich caravan all lined up for a raid, and that low-life son of mine leaves me in the lurch! A special costume dance at Luna Park tonight, he tells me! Before you know it he'll be settling down in one place and earning his living honestly, like these foreign goodfor-nothings."

Into the park stalks the indignant Bedouin, bent on recapturing the headstrong youth and leading him back into the desert by force, if necessary.
"Ov-ah he-ah! Ov-ah he-ah!"

shrieks the barker for the "cootch" show. "See the famous fan dance, as done originally at the Chicago World Fair by Sally Rand! Right this way, folks!"

The angry Bedouin suddenly feels someone tugging at his robe. It is one of the girls in the show. "My sheik!" she giggles. "Come

on inside and we'll show you some stuff that'll make the sands of the desert look cold."

Five hours later, in the topmost car of the revolving ferris wheel, the Bedouin sits scratching his chin through his beard, looking out over the Holy City and musing over the march of time.

"Maybe that kid has more sense than his old man, after all." he says to himself with a contemplative chuckle.

At the entrance gate to the roller coaster is a large sign in flamboyant red letters:

"Zionist Revisionists and Laborites will please occupy different cars, to avoid unnecessary accidents."

One of the most popular spots in the park is the shooting gallery. It is divided into several separate

"Step over here, you Arab spies!" shouts the come-on man at one of the stands. "Every target on this range is an illegal Jew-

ish immigrant!" For both the Arab and Jewish laborers, of course, there is the Orange Grove Owners Section, where the workmen may vent their spleen on the effigies of their employers.

Through the park marches a motley welter of humanity. Almost every creed, race and color is represented. German Jewish refugee stands in line behind devout Mohammedan, each awaiting his turn to enter the House of Fun. To the uninitiated the mingling of Oriental and Western garb gives the place the appearance of a costume pageant.

One little fellow, trotting along at his father's heels, has never been in an amusement park be-Each new sight claims his rapt attention. But most fascinating of all is the merry-go-round, with its bouncing horses and its hurdy gurdy music.

"What's that thing, Daddy?" he asks, pointing to the revolving

"That," says his wiser elder, "is the merry-go-round, a mechanism invented by the British government to symbolize its attitude toward Jewish immigration in Palestine. In some countries, where the thing is operated by nanual means, it is also known as the run-around."



JAFFA, Aug. 9.—Raising the hand in the Nazi salute and pledging loyalty to Germany was a feature of the Hindenburg memorial service at Sarona, German Templars' colony near Jaffa, according to an Arab source. The entire congregation, come to mourn the late Field-Marshal, swore an oath of fealty to the Reich.

It is said that in accordance with old German custom a grave was dug in the Sarona cemetery around which the congregation stood while the president of the community eulogized the dead Marshal.

According to reports, the German Christian community of Palestine has long shown sympathy with Nazi ideas because of its dislike of the Jews. The German Christians here are on extremely good terms with the Arabs.

Palestine Will Enforce 'Capitalist' EntryRuling, Arab Paper Declares

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) JERUSALEM, Aug. 12.—Stricter control over persons wishing to settle here in the capitalist classification is to be carried out by the Department of Immigration, according to Falastin, Arab daily.

The department is said to be aware of many cases of persons entering the country by borrowing the requisite minimum £1,000 to enable them to qualify under the capitalist category, submitting their application and having it approved, and then, after their permit for permanent residence has been issued, repaying the loan of £1,000 to the owner, plus an interest charge.

Stirs Parley

Features Deliberations of General Zionists at Krakow

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) KRAKOW, Aug. 28.-A highly confidential letter from Dr. Chaim Weizmann on the internal situation in the Zionist movement was read last night at a closed session of the General Zionist conference now in progress here and immediately became the center of deliberations, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency

Professor Selig Brodetsky, member of the political department of the Jewish Agency in London, outlined the Zionist policy as envisaged by the World Zionist Executive, calling for peace within the Zionist ranks as the only basis for discipline. He also called for an agreement not to draw the Zionist funds into party conflicts.

The main point of the debate which followed Professor Brodetsky's speech was how to solve the differences between the A and B groups within the General Zionist party. Their chief point of difference is the personality of the Zionist leaders.

The conference elected a presiding body of eleven, including Rabbi Joshua Thon, Dr. Ben-Zion Mossinsohn and Dr. Samuel Margoshes of New York.

Warsaw Zionists Confer On Internal Conflicts

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, Aug. 28. - The Polish Zionist conference, now in session in Warsaw, is dealing with the same problems of internal Zionist conflict which are being discussed at the Krakow conference of the General Zionists.

However, the group following Isaac Gruenbaum, head of the immigration department of the Jewish Agency in Jerusalem, is opposed to union with the General Zionists. Since the group constitutes a majority, Polish Zionists are not expected to join the General Zionist party at this time. Even a minority proposal calling for the sending of greetings to the Krakow conference was defeated by the Gruenbaum group.

Palestine Treasurer To Quit Over Tax Issue

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) JERUSALEM, Aug. 12.—According to Doar Hayom, William Joseph Johnson, treasurer of the Palestine Government, who is now on leave in England, has submitted his resignation and will not return to this country. The paper gives as the reason for Mr. Johnson's resignation official disapproval of his scheme for an income tax in Palestine.

Ukraine Helps Upbuilding Of Biro-Bidjan With Gifts

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) MOSCOW, Aug. 14.—The Ukrainian Commissariat of Agriculture today announced that it would aid in the upbuilding of the Jewish autonomous region of Biro-Bidjan. Six trained agronomists and four veterinary surgeons employed in the commissariat have been dispatched to Biro-Bidjan. Thanks to the gifts of the Ukrainians Biro-Bidjan will have a veterinary surgeon in each of the four districts and research laboratory.

In addition the Ukrainians announced a gift of twenty-eight speeially picked stallions for breeding purposes, forty-five agricultural machines and spare parts for in this country. tractors and other machines used agriculture.

Secret Missive 'Misquoted,' Deutsch Charges By Weizmann On Return From Mexican Tour

(Continued from Page One) and completed, or are in the course of completion. I called attention only to the progress made in connection with these public works and improvements. The whole context of my address was directed to the public improvements which I had just inspected and had no bearing whatsoever upon the attitude of the Mexican government, either in the past or at the present time, as to religious freedom.

"My activities and efforts for tolerance and religious freedom during the past decade ought to be sufficient assurance that I would not, for one moment, condone any effort on the part of any government to discriminate against any part of its people because of religious belief, and that I would not for one moment be party to any attempt to minimize religious persecution."

Conferred With Calles on Jews Discussing his meeting with the delegation of Golden Shirts, Mr. Deutsch said that he had had a long conference with General Plutarco Elias Calles, Mexico's "strong man" in which he discussed with General Calles the Jewish troubles in Mexico, among other things.

"It was after I had told newspaper men that the General assured me that certain political elements were endeavoring to lift themselves up by the boot-straps through anti-Semitic agitation and that such agitation would shortly be nipped in the bud-it was after that that I received my visit from the Mexican fascismoif they can be called that.

"Jews Control Industry"

"They called at the hotel where Mrs. Deutsch and I were staying and sent up word that a Mexican commission awaited me in the

"I came down and was confronted by six or seven big Mexicans who told me that they represented the Golden Shirts.

"Who are the Golden Shirts, I

"I was told that they represented the Mexican people who were opposing the Jewish element in Mex-

"Why do you oppose the Jews? I asked, after they told me that I was meddling in Mexican affairs and that they resented my statement that the anti-Semitic movement was political.

'I was told that the opposition to the Jews was not based on their religion but on the fact that the Jews controlled the industry of the country.

"How long have the Jews been here? I asked, and how many are there?"

Sought to Pose With Deutsch

"I was told that the Jews had only been there ten or twelve years and that there were about 125,000.

"This was absurd and I told them so, pointing out that actually there were only about 12,500 Jews in the country and that ten or twelve years ago the country had practically no industries.

"I then told them that they were wasting their efforts on behalf of the Mexican people and might do much better to champion the cause of the Mexican worker and Indian in the back-country than to fight a non-existent Jewish menace.

"They then asked me to pose with them for pictures and observing that we were already being photographed, I told them that if they wanted to pose with me after me telling them some homely truth, I was willing."

Resented by Catholics

While Mr. Deutsch's remarks on Mexican treatment of minorities was the subject of high praise in editorial comment by the newspaper La Prensa in Mexico City, it provoked a storm of resentment on the part of Catholics and Jews

let, Catholic newspaper, the Catholic attitude toward this remark and another, in which he was quoted as saying that "during my three weeks' visit here I found no persecution of any class here," was crystallized in the following comment:

"Mr. Deutsch, it will be racalled. was one of the most active opponents of the present government in Germany because it persecuted the Jewish people. He has denounced intolerance loudly and regularly, insisting upon liberty and fair play. It was not necessary for him even to visit Germany," the newspaper sarcastically wrote, "before rushing to the defense of liberty."

Forward-Looking Mexico

"Recently," the Tablet continued, "he went, ostensibly on a vacation tour, to Mexico. Arriving there, where Catholics have been subjected to the worst persecution in modern times—far worse than that accorded Jews in Germany-Mr. Deutsch in a public address pronounced Mexico forward looking.'

"The fact that Mexico has closed every Catholic school and charitable institution; seized hundreds of churches and expelled their occupants; permits only one priest for every 100,000 people; has arrested and jailed hundreds who sought to exercise the freedom of worship which every country but Russia tolerates; prohibits the wearing of the clerical collar; fosters the vilest type of legislation, including laws in the State of Tabasco which compel any priest to marry, and carries on a militant campaign to make atheists of every child, does not impress Mr. Deutsch."

The Tablet then said it had received many letters about Mr. Deutsch's conduct which it promised to withold until such time as he had returned and was able to answer them.

In many Jewish quarters, as well, Deutsch's remarks were severely criticized as highly improper and ill advised. It was pointed out that his speeches would do injury to the common cause in which Catholics and Jews were bound, to wit, opposition to Nazi persecutions. Mr. Deutsch's position as president of the American Jewish Congress, which is active in fostering the boycott, was also pointed to as giving to the statement a semi-official character.

London Jews Discuss Hartglas Expose of Poland

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, Aug. 28.—The widest interest was displayed in London Jewish circles today in the speech made in Warsaw by former deputy Apolinaris M. Hartglas, who pictured the tragic plight of Polish Jewry and accused the Polish government of deliberately ousting the Jews from the economic life of the nation. The speech was compared with a series of articles recently published by the Jewish Daily Bulletin of New York, written by Boris Smolar, chief European correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic agency, who declared that the Polish government had embarked deliberately on a policy of economic extermination of Polish

Mr. Smolar's suggestion that a non-Polish Jewish commission be appointed to survey the situation will be considered at the next meeting of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, when the situation of the Polish Jews will be discussed.
