Costly Propaganda

Dr. Hjalmar Schacht, President of the Deutsche Reichsbank and economic dictator, is reported to have ordered the elimination of the Nazi propaganda abroad. According to Berlin representatives of the London press, Dr. Schacht informed Dr. Goebbels, Minister of Propaganda, and Publicity, that no more funds would be available for propaganda purposes in other lands. The amount spent by the Nazi propaganda department is believed to be in the neighborhood of 200,000,000 marks a year.

Dr. Schacht, as financial and economic dictator, realizes better than anyone else among the Nazi leaders the waste in money and loss in prestige resulting from the arrogant and stupid agitation conducted by Nazi agents in foreign lands. While Dr. Schacht has not said and done things that have caused others to accuse him of having caused others to distrust Germany's integrity under the present regime more than ever before, he understands that the Goebbels form of propaganda of hate makes it all the more difficult for him to negotiate his trade and loan agreements with other nations.

According to the National Zeitung of Basle, Switzerland, Dr. Schacht made a private statement to a diplomatic representative of one of the great powers that the economic catastrophe would start in Germany during the month of October. Dr. Schacht is said to have made that statement about two months ago. The Swiss newspaper remarks that since then nothing has changed in Germany either with regard to internal or foreign affairs. Her unparalleled isolation in foreign affairs remains unchanged.

Nazi Germany is continuing to defy international goodwill and ordinary decency. While Dr. Schacht is trying to curb the Goebbels' propaganda abroad, Hitler is honoring Julius Streicher at the Nuremberg party demonstrations. Julius Streicher is the notorious publisher of the Stürmer, the most vicious and filthy anti-Semitic organ in the world. The Stürmer is occasionally suppressed for a few days for publishing incendiary articles, inciting to pogroms, disseminating the ritual murder myth, but the publisher rides with Adolf Hitler through the streets of Nuremberg at the head of the Nazi procession. Hitler's demonstration of friendship for the arch enemy of the Jews is an indication that he has no intentions of modifying his Jew-baiting policy.

Nazis Rebuff French Saar Suggestions

Refuse to Give Pledge on Post-Plebiscite Minority Rights

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Sept. 5.—The Nazi government today officially replied to the French memorandum submitted yesterday to the Council of the League of Nations asking for protection of minorities in the Saar.

The Nazi regime rejected all suggestions that the Saar region be treated as an international territory after the plebiscite, if the territory votes to return to Germany, and also declined to discuss any reference to the present status of the Saar population.

"The people of the Saar know very well that their interests will be served best by their own nation," the German reply stated.

The French note to the League asked for complete protection for minority groups in the Saar after the plebiscite of January 16, no matter what the population voted. The French authorities declared that they were willing to grant full protection under the minority clauses of the covenant of the League of Nations territory voted to adhere to France.

Nazi Germany is now in the midst of a hectic campaign to resist to win the Saar voters to the Third Reich. In the recent mass demonstration at Coblenz, Reichsführer Hitler declared that the Saar was German territory and that Nazi Germany would never surrender the area.

Saar voters will be offered three choices; adherence to Germany, inclusion in the French republic, or continuation of the present rule under the League of Nations Commission.

The League commission recently declared that the Saar police were being terrorized by the German secret police and asked for permission to recruit a force of 2,000 police outside the region.

Anti-Semites Attack Pedestrians in Lodz

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LODZ, Sept. 5.—Jewish pedestrians in the Zgierz district of Lodz were attacked last night by anti-Semitic hoodlums, who also smashed windows in Jewish shops and homes. Israel Malwerman and Isaac Abramson were injured by the attackers and taken to a hospital. Several of assailants, including the Endek leader of the group, were arrested.

Jewish Gem Merchant Murdered in Antwerp

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) ANTWERP, Sept. 5.—Max Hirschberg, Jewish diamond merchant in this city, was beaten to death in a street here by two men who escaped.

Police believe the murderers to be Flemish diamond cutters who killed Hirschberg because he was having his stones polished in Germany instead of in Belgium.

Greek Official Pledges Help to Thrace Exiles

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) SALONICA, Sept. 5.—Government relief for 100 Turkish Jewish families, refugees from Turkish Thrace, who were ousted when Turkish authorities forbade Jews to live within certain frontier areas, was promised here today by Greek Minister of the Interior Kyrkos.

A Jewish delegation visited the minister and asked for government help in caring for the refugees, who arrived in Salonica penniless. The Jewish community, he was informed, cannot provide food and shelter for the refugees.

Complete Plans To Bring 250 Children Here

German Jewish Aid Unit to Help Young Reich Emigrants

Arrangements have been completed for emigration to America of 250 German Jewish children, was announced yesterday by Dr. Solomon Lowenstein, chairman of the German Jewish Children's Aid Incorporated. The first group of twenty will sail from Germany shortly.

Present plans provide that these children who range from six to fifteen years of age, will be placed in private homes in various parts of the country, under the supervision of professional social workers. The first group of twenty will be educated here and trained in vocations that will aid them in earning their livelihoods when they grow to manhood and womanhood. The children, it was stressed, are not being brought here for legal adoption, as many of them have both of their parents.

Conversion Drive Is Launched By Catholic Group in Austria

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) VIENNA, Sept. 5.—The impoverishment of Austrian Jewry is being used by Catholic missionaries as a propaganda campaign to convert Jews to Catholicism, it was disclosed today.

A special association for the conversion of Jews has been formed in Vienna with the direct approval of Ralph Cardinal Ince. The group, known as "Pauluswerk," has its own paper which is filled with propaganda urging the mass conversion of Jews as the only way out of their misery. The entire movement is camouflaged under a guise of relieving the terrible distress among the Jews of Austria. Relief, however, when actually given, is accompan-

Hitler Maligns Jews' Culture

Rumania Shuts Lid on Influx of Nazi Literature

Hitler's 'Mein Kampf' Is Prohibited in Drive on Anti-Semitism

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BUCHAREST, Sept. 5.—Importation and translation of anti-Semitic literature from Nazi Germany, including Reichsführer Adolf Hitler's biography, "Mein Kampf," was prohibited today by the Rumanian government.

Rumanian authorities, realizing the spread of Hitlerism among the large number of Germans living in Rumania, recently dissolved the Rumanian Nazi organizations and declared them illegal.

In certain sections of Rumania, Germans had instituted a complete boycott of Jews and were threatening Jewish residents with death if they did not leave.

The Iron Guard, Rumanian anti-Semitic organization, has been accused of receiving funds from the German Nazis. Zeleya Codreanu, leader of the Iron Guard, declared that his organization was modeled entirely on Nazi principles.

Professor Alexander Cuza, notorious Rumanian anti-Semite and leader of the anti-Jewish bloc in the Rumanian parliament, is at present visiting Berlin as a guest of Adolf Hitler.

Shabbatai Levy Slated As Vice-Mayor of Haifa

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) HAIFA, Sept. 5.—Shabbatai Levy, one of four Jewish councilmen in the city council, will be chosen vice-mayor, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today. Levy will be the first Jewish vice-mayor in fifteen years. The mayor, however, will be a Moslem as usual.

Accuses Them Of Impairing Unity in Reich

Tells Nuremberg Parley Nazis Have Ended 'Alien Evil'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) NUREMBERG, Sept. 5.—Jewish influence in the life of Germany was denounced today by Reichsführer Adolf Hitler at the "kultur" session of the Nazi party congress now in session here. Alien culture, the Nazi leader declared, "was introduced in Germany by Jewish intellectualism."

"National Socialism, by its unifying effects on the German people thus has conquered and rooted out the threatening manifestations of destruction," Hitler said. Anti-Semitic posters and caricatures were displayed everywhere in Nuremberg today as Nazi leaders from every section of the country participated in the second Nazi congress to be held here.

Shop windows, homes and walls everywhere were decorated with huge pictures of Reichsführer Adolf Hitler and Commissioner for Franconia Julius Streicher. Side by side with the portraits of the Nazi leaders were such slogans as "Beware of the Jews and their oaths."

Jewish stores in Nuremberg were closed and the Jews of the city kept off the streets at night, and even during the day, while the Brown Shirt armies were in Nuremberg. The city is completely given over to the Nazis and to anti-Semitism.

Hitler's Address The Nazi revolution in Germany is over and the return for the Germany of the future has been set for the next 1,000 years. Adolf Hitler declared in an address to a huge group of Nazi

Holy Days Postpone Penn. Legislature

(Special to the J.D.B.) HARRISBURG, Pa., Sept. 5.—Owing to the fact that the Jewish Holy days begin, on September 10, the special session of the Pennsylvania legislature, hurriedly called for that date, has been postponed until Wednesday noon, September 12.

Governor Gifford Pinchot called a special session of the legislature after Federal Relief Administrator Elmer Hopkins refused to advance funds for the relief of Pennsylvania unemployed until the legislature acts in regular session. Learning, however, that the date selected fell on Rosh Hashanah, Governor Pinchot delayed the opening in deference to the Jewish members of the legislature.

A. B. Samuels Buried Today; Died of Stroke

Was Active Republican, Lawyer, Insurance Executive

Funeral services will be held this morning for A. Bertram Samuels, lawyer and insurance company executive, who died of heart attack Tuesday at the age of forty-eight. Services will be held at the Riverside Memorial Chapel, with Rabbi Joseph B. Wise officiating. Burial will be on the Free Synagogue plot in the Westchester Hills Cemetery.

Samuels, who lived at 1016 Fifth avenue, had just returned from Ithaca to the offices of the Manhattan Mutual Auto Casualty Insurance Company when he collapsed. Associated said he appeared to be in excellent health directly before the stroke which resulted in his death.

He was a prominent Republican and served as Deputy Assistant District Attorney under Charles S. Whitman. He became special assistant to the attorney at the beginning of the World War.

He retired to the insurance business when the War became president of the Consolidated Indemnity and Insurance Company. Liquidation of this company began last May, and Samuels was retained by the Manhattan Company as vice-president, director and counsel.

Samuels is survived by a widow, Edith; a daughter, Arline, three brothers, Emanuel, Jack and Gustave; and two sisters, Mrs. Birdie Lefkowitz and Mrs. Estelle Herzberg.

Nazi Securities Unsound, Says Research Man

Dr. Max Winkler Warns Against Investing in Reich Credits

(Special to the J.D.B.)
EDGEMERE, L. I., Sept. 5.—The boycott against Nazi Germany must be extended for moral and practical reasons, declared Dr. Max Winkler, research director for the Boycott Committee of the American Jewish Congress. Dr. Winkler was to speak at the Shikla Zedek congregation here tonight under the auspices of the Boycott Committee.

Speaking of the moral reason, Professor Winkler described the systematic torture of Jews, liberals, laborites and pacifists in Germany.

The practical reason for the boycott, he said, is the fact that since Hitler has come into power American investors have lost more than a billion dollars by German refusals to meet her obligations.

Until Hitler's advent, Dr. Winkler pointed out, American money was prompt in paying her debts. With the accession of Hitler to power, a law was passed which made repayment of debts possible.

Dr. Winkler declared that a number of American bankers are trying to interest investors in German credits to gain commissions, although they know German bonds are unsound.

"It is the American of average means who is the principal sufferer," he asserted, "not the bankers. It is foolish to invest in German securities."

Schacht 'Gangster Financier,' Declares London Newspaper

(L.T.A. Special Correspondence)
LONDON, Aug. 28.—Dr. Hjalmar Schacht, virtual economic dictator of Germany, is accused of "gangster finance" in a long editorial in the Financial News.

"It must be admitted," the editorial states, "that Dr. Schacht is a ready Nazi apprentice. A penultimate recruit to the Hitler gang, he is proving himself more Nazi than the Nazis. The speech he delivered last Sunday at the opening of the Leipzig Fair is a perfect example of Nazi morality applied to finance."

"The foreign exporter for foreign goods," said Dr. Schacht, "Germany's foreign currency position has never been a secret."

"This sort of logic has hitherto been the leading principle of operators—who has now become the commercial and financial code of the Nazis. It is the mug's lookout if he is bilked," said Al Capone. "And so says all of us," comes the ringing Nazi chorus.

"Dr. Schacht repeated for the hundredth time another favorite argument of his, namely that he is wickered for Germany, insisted upon being paid, they refused to accept goods in payment. The facts are that the German trade balance, which shows big deficits between 1924 and 1930, produced huge surpluses between

Congress House Opening Ready Soon, Says Mrs. Wise

Linen to help fit out the new Congress House, center for German-Jewish refugees, was obtained last night through a shower held by the Brooklyn division of the Women's Association of the American Jewish Congress.

Mrs. Stephen S. Wise, who recently returned from a tour of Europe, said one of the most important problems facing American Jews is that of aiding in the re-orientation of German refugees who come to this country.

Many persons, she said, who are temporary refugees in various countries in Europe will come to the United States insofar as immigration laws permit. Congress House, she pointed out, will serve as a center for these refugees where they can become accustomed to the new country. Congress House will be opened by the end of September, she said.

Payments to UJA Relief Drive Are in Arrears, Says Warburg

Intensified Efforts to Collect on Pledges Is Urged by Campaign Head to Assure Assistance for Victims of Nazi Persecution and Others

An urgent appeal for cash payments on account of pledges made to the United Jewish Appeal was issued yesterday by Felix M. Warburg, who announced that the pledge drive is in arrears. The effort for the benefit of the Jews of Germany total \$1,675,000. The United Jewish Appeal, of which Mr. Warburg is chairman, is seeking to obtain \$2,000,000 for the Jews of America for the economic relief of the Jews of Germany and other lands and the settlement of Jews in Palestine.

The organizations represented by the United Jewish Appeal are the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee and the American Palestine Campaign. Associated with Mr. Warburg as co-chairmen of the drive are Paul Baerwald, Louis Lipksi, Morris Rothenberg and Rabbi Jonah B. Wise.

Achievement Called Splendid

The total of \$1,675,000 in pledges, Mr. Warburg stated, represents the response to the United Jewish Appeal by approximately 450 communities throughout the country, since the launching of the campaign in March, 1933.

Taking into consideration the unsettled economic conditions prevalent here, that is a splendid achievement, and indicates how sympathetic with the afflicted German brethren," he said. "With the end of the summer season, the end of additional Jewish communities in the United States and Canada will launch drives in behalf of the United Jewish Appeal, and am convinced that the goal of \$3,000,000 will be achieved, or at least, be in sight, before many months have elapsed."

Cash Payments Fall Short

"Unfortunately, however, the cash payments thus far received from the various communities that have participated in the United Jewish Appeal have not kept pace with the urgent need for ready cash to enable the participating organizations to meet their commitments, whether in Germany or in the refugee countries or in Palestine. Our records show that the cash received at our headquarters, 100 East Forty-second street, from these communities amounts to about one-half of the sum represented by the pledges."

"On the other hand, the Joint Distribution Committee which is cooperating with the leaders of the Jewish and local relief committees in the refugee countries is about \$500,000 behind in its commitments; and the American Palestine Campaign is behind in its commitments for the work of settling refugees from Germany and Jews from other countries in the Holy land to an approximately equal amount."

Victims Depend on Aid

"It is clear that unless these two bodies are speedily supplied with funds to carry out their work of relief, the victims involved, great hardships will be visited upon the hundreds of thousands whose only hope for a better life depends on aid they receive from their American brethren."

"I am therefore urging the local campaign committees throughout the country to intensify their collection efforts for the sake of those whom we are endeavoring to aid." Mr. Warburg said, in conclusion, that about 100 local drives for the benefit of the United Jewish Appeal will be held within the next two months.

Among the major cities that will raise funds during that period are Atlanta, Baltimore, Buffalo,

Chicago, Cincinnati, Denver, Des Moines, Milwaukee, New Orleans and Rochester.

Many of the local campaigns, he said, will be conducted jointly with the Jewish New Year and special pleas on behalf of the drive will be made in about 2,000 synagogues and temples during Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

Cooper of Edmonton, won the first prize in the senior division of an essay contest held in connection with the United Jewish Appeal campaign in Canada, it was announced here. A student at the University of Alberta and a member of Young Judea and Alpha Epsilon Alpha, his section of Eretz Britan, will get a free trip to Palestine and return. Cooper wrote his essay in Hebrew. His subject was, "Will Palestine Solve the Problem of Jewry or Judaism?"

The second prize, a golden book certificate, goes to S. H. Abramson, student at McGill University, whose subject was, "Jews and Arabs—An Attempt at a Solution."

Wine Copy of Biak's Poems

The third prize, a special copy of Biak's poems, was won by Morton Wilfred Bloomfield of Montreal, student at McGill University, president of the Macababean Circle, who wrote on "The New Jewish Ideology as a Factory of Jewish Life in Western Countries."

stand taken by the courageous Archbishop of Munich, Cardinal Faulhaber, who denounced anti-Semitism and the Nazis on the day of the Hitler "plebiscite" in the following terms:

"When I stood out a few months ago against the inhuman race hatred which has seized hold of a part of our German brothers, they were in a storm. My life was in danger. But I was not afraid, for what I do is of absolute conviction. The Jews are being persecuted everywhere in the world. But the methods of persecution in our homeland are a shame and a disgrace to us. History teaches us that the God who punishes those who persecute His Chosen People, the Jews. No Catholic agreed to the persecution of the Jews in Germany."

"When God sent June 30th (the Hitler blood purge) as a Court of Judgment for a part of those who persecute the Jews, the punishment was well-deserved. My Catholic brethren, do you not see that this was God's punishment? Hatred and persecution will never exterminate the Jews. The oldest people of the world has suffered much; it suffers and will always suffer, because it has remained true to its great faith. We should take an example from the Jews. We should honor and respect them, for they have given the world its most precious possession, the Bible. Make it clear to your brothers that race-hatred is a poisonous, unchristian attitude. Exterminating this dreadful, inhuman prejudice against the eternal suffering people."

"This great spiritual lesson Germany uttered the day after Hitler to Hitler on election day. It will be long remembered by a grateful people, by the Jews, and also by the German people after Hitler is gone."

Detroit Abend Post Attacks Judge Kross

Editorial Points to Reversal of Neutrality Policy on Nazi Issue

DETROIT, Sept. 5.—An editorial in the Detroit Abend Post, local daily German newspaper, points to a reversal of this paper's previous policy of neutrality on the issue of Nazism.

In an editorial entitled "Who sows the wind . . ." the Detroit German paper attacks what it calls dual justice, stating that Jewish judges mete out light sentences to Jews and heavy ones to non-Jews.

The case commented on is that of Rabbi Bienefeld and his son, who, the paper states, were treated with silk gloves by Magistrate Anna M. Kross. The Abend Post editorial declares that Magistrate

Kross reprimanded the detectives for bringing the rabbi and his son to court in a patrol wagon rather than a taxicab.

The Abend Post warns that "who sows the wind harvests the storm," and by implication warns that eventually the innocent Jew will suffer with the guilty.
