#### Nazi Sportsmanship

The American Olympic Committee has voted unanimously in favor of accepting Germany's invitation to participate in the Olympic Games in Berlin, in 1936.

The motion of acceptance reads as follows:

"In the light of the re-port of Mr. Brundage and the attitude and assur-ances of the representa-tives of the German gov-ernment and the German Olympic Committee we accept the invitation of the German Olympic Committee to participate in the 1936 Olympic Games at Berlin and at Garmisch-Partenkirchen."

Mr. Avery Brundage, president of the American Olympic Committee, visited Germany and brought back a number of written answers to his questions, which were read at the meeting and which influenced the which were read at the meeting, and which influenced the
committee decision. The answers to Mr. Brundage's questions were prepared by the Nazi
commissar for sports, von

Then Mr. Brundage asked: "Specifically I ask you if all visitors and athletes, without consideration of rank, religion or race will be received and treated cordially and with respect in Germany at the Olympic Games?"

"Whoever is sent by the different nations as competitor or visitor is their business, but all, I can assure you, will be treated as guests of Germany, and that speaks for itself."

Finally Mr. Brundage asked: "You are aware that the question of the participation of the Jews of all nations in the Olympic Games has been discussed widely and vehemently. Can you inform me how Germany will handle this question, especially the participation of the German

Inform Schuschnigg Schools Edict Is Causing Great Apprehension

VIENNA, Sept. 27.—A plenary
session of the Vienna Jewish community held here last night unan imously decided to request the government of Chancellor Kurt Schu ernment of Chancellor Kurt Schu-schnigg to abolish at once the separate schools for Jewish chil-dren introduced by law at the opening of the public schools this year. The resolution adopted by year. The resolution adopted by the Jewish community declared the Jewish community declared that the ghetto schools were caus-ing the "greatest anxiety and ap-prehension among the Jewish population."

The Zionist groups within the community further resolved to ask the Austrian government for finan-cial subsidies in order to set up a system of "positive" Jewish edu-

cation. The law creating ghetto schools was passed at a secret session of the Austrian cabinet on July 4. Not only were the Jewish leaders left in complete ignorance of the passage of the law, but they left an interview with the Chancellor convinced that such a scheme would never be put into effect.

When schools opened all Jewish children were directed to separateJewish schools, from which all Protestant and Catholic children were removed. Even the children of Jewish converts to Christianity were sent to the Jewish schools, thus setting up a "non-Aryan" school division in the most ap-

#### A. J. C., Maccabis Voice Disapproval

Deplore U. S. Willingness to Participate in Berlin Olympics Meet

The American Jewish Congress and the United States Maccabi Association were the first organi-zations yesterday to register protest against America's acceptance of the Nazi bid to the 1936 Ber-lin Olympic Games.

The storm of protest and indignation from Jewish and non-sectarian organizations that has been brewing for the past year and a half was expected to be ready to burst and inundate the country with righteous objections

The American Jewish Congress addressed a request to the Board of Governors of the Amateur Athletic Union calling upon it to review the situation in Germany with regard to the free participa-tion of the Jews in the Olympics at its convention in December. Their contention was based on the Their contention was based on the ground that the assurances given to the American Olympic Committee by Germany are not in accordance with the facts. The protest, signed by Dr. Stephen S. Winé, honotary president, and Bernard S. Deutsch, president, requested further that

president, requested further that an opportunity be accorded the American Jewish Congress to pre-sent publicly before the conven-tion "full and incontrovertible evidence to the effect that Jews are not free to engage in athletics and sports on the same footing as the

Nazi athletes.
The American Jewish Congress expressed great dismay at the de-cision of the A. O. C. to accept the Reich invitation. The Con-gress held that the A. A. U. has gress near that the A. A. # Nazis Oust Ewald, Grab Control Of German-American Vote Unit

The Nazi bludgeon that has been clubbing members of the German-American societies here into the ranks of a Hitlerite phalanx since last May when Victor Ridder was ousted from the presidency of the German-American Conference, swung again yesterday and landed with crushing force upon the head of another prominent leader of that body who was suspected of being lukewarm in his affections for the local Nazi movement.

The victim of the Nazi bludgeon is Dr. Louis A. Ewald, a surgeon, who only a few days ago had been named by the German-American Conference to act as chairman of its political committee.

Announcement of the formation of this

committee, the avowed purpose of which is to recommend to the 200,000 members of the conference the proper candidates they should vote for at the coming elections, was made on Sunday. According to the first reports of the committee which comprised eight members, it eschewed any relationship whatever with local or foreign pro-Hitler factions.

The obvious insincerity of this denial of a Nazi taint to the political body was immediately exposed by the Jewish Dally Bulletin which pointed out that at least two of its members are prominently connected with Nazi activities here. One is Dr. Herbert Schnuch, national president of the Friends of New Germany. The second is G. K. ## Nazis Accused As Smugglers Of Propaganda

#### Use Advertising Shroud, House Body Told; Data Presented

Evidence of Nazi propagands smuggled into this country under the guise of commercial advertis as forwarded yesterday the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, of which Samuel Unter-myer is president, to Chairman John W. McCormack of the House committee investigating Nazi prop aganda activities here.

"Pamphlets, speeches and other printed matter preaching Nazi doc-trines," it was pointed out by the League, "are flooding the country disguised as commercial matter The propaganda material is en-closed with circulars or letters from industrial firms so that they go through the mails appearing like business transactions

#### In "Practically Every Mail"

"Importing firms have reported to us that practically every mail from Germany offering products for sale has official propaganda literature enclosed."

Among the items forwarded to Chairman McCormack was an advertisement for a German laxative for babies sent to the Pure Product Syrup Corporation of Brooklyn. Enclosed with the treatise, lauding the qualities of the stomach ache remedy and quoting testimonials as to its efficiency, were copies of the speech of Adolf Hitler delivered before the Reichstag on July 31 and copies of the speech recently made by Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Minister of Propaganda, in Warsaw.

#### Attack Gushes Vitriol The Goebbels' pamphlet carried a vitriolic attack on the Jews. It

said in part:

"It should be borne in mind that before we came into power, the Jews in Germany exercised a paraence on the whole of intellectual life. They ossessed most of the movable and immovable capital invested in the country. They had the press, literature, stage and film absolutely and unreservedly in their hands.
"In large towns, for instance, in

Berlin, they represented up to seventy-five per cent of the total medical and legal professions. By imposing excessive interest rates they brought agriculture to the verge of ruin. They made public opinion. They controlled the stock opinion. They controlled the stock exchange and had Parliament and the political parties under their protection. At the same time they represented only nine-tenths of one per cent of the population. It will be understood in the light of these facts that the defensive measures against them were in-evitable."

To settle definall misunderstandings about this question, now and in the future, I declare with all the future, I deciare with an frankness that no Jewish sportsman will be excluded from the Olympic team of Germany, provided that his ability and performance are good enough. That is the only reason which may be assigned for non-admission."

Then comes the climax of

these Nazi assurances: "Adolf Hitler, the President and the Chancellor of the Ger-man government, has the definite will and wish-and that is the law for the German people that the Olympic Games v surely be held in Garmisch Par-tenkirchen and in Berlin in 1936. Adolf Hitler wishes that every nation—all peoples and every athlete who enters the German stadium in 1936 will be received and treated politely and hospit-ably. Will you please inform ably. Will you pleas America accordingly?"

And Mr. Brundage has in-formed America accordingly: He reported that he had conferred with representatives of Jewish sport organizations in Germany was assured that there would be no discrimination. According to The New York Times, Mr. Brundage, at the meeting in New York, cited as the deciding argument "the opinion of a German Jewish banker of international renown whose name he was not permitted to mention on this moot question. He had said that the sports angle only should be conside

Mr. Brundage might have asked the Nazi sport represen-tative this question:

"Are you now according fair and equal treatment to sport organizations and their members in Germany, regardless of race

truthful answer to this question must contain the admis-sion that there is discrimination even in the field of sports in Germany on racial or religious grounds. The statements made to Mr. Brundage by Jewish sport clubs in Germany or by a prominent Jewish German banker can hardly be regarded as vol-untary and unprejudiced evi-dence in a land that is ruled by ruthless terrorism and espion

The truth is that the Nazis today are discriminating against Jews in the field of sports and athletics, even though certain attempts have recently been made to camouflage the issue and to give the impression that the disabilities imposed upon Jewish athletes and sports or-ganizations had been removed. Even the latest decree, which permits sports clubs to admit "non-Aryans," provides that the officers and employers must be 'Aryanc.'

The assurances of the Nazi sports commissar, like the as-surances of Reichsfuehrer Hit-ler, that they will accord fair treatment to participants in the Olympics Games in 1936, regardless of race or creed, cannot be taken seriously in view of the fact that they are now violating all the rules and principles of honorable sportsmanship.

The long list of these violations has been published in The Jewish Daily Bulletin. The case

against the American Olympic ommittee's participation in the Olympic Games in Germany in 1936 has been presented by Samuel Untermyer clearly, truthfully and logically. The American Olympic Committee has been hoodwinked by the Nazi representatives.

To ask the Nazis whether they will observe all rules and regula-tions for the Olympic Games in 1936, whether they will treat participants and visitors fairly, without reservation and without discrimination, in 1936, while they are violating these rules and regulations, practicing dis-crimination in 1934, is equivacrimination in 1934, is equiva-lent to asking a criminal, who is still committing his crime, whether he would give assur-ances that he would be an honorable gentleman two years la-ter and join other honorable gentlemen upon terms of equality.

Naziland is today violating all rules and regulations of honorable sportsmanship not only in the field of sport but in almost all other fields—in science, in the arts, in commerce and labor and industry as well as in international relations. Germany under the present regime has repudiated her moral and financial obligations. She has added new "scraps of paper" to the notorious "scrap of paper" of 1914.

Nazi promises must be judged in the light of Nazi perform-ances. The American Olympic Committee was taken in meaningless Nazi promises.

# Mystery Seen In Retirement Of Hindenburg

Late President's Son Ouits Role 'of Greatest Importance'

CHICAGO, Sept. 27. — Retirement of Colonel Oscar von Hindenburg, son of the late President denburg, son of the late President of Germany, leaves unsolved the mystery of exactly what role he has played in the rise to power of Adolf Hitler's Nazis, the Chicago Daily News says, hastening to add that "the only certain thing is that the role was one of the greatest importance."

In a dispatch from Wallace R. Deuel, Daily News correspondent in Berlin, it is asserted that the Colonel, as a Prussian land-owning Junker, probably hoped to use the Nazi movement for the furtherance of the Junkers' nationalist aims, "chiefly the building up of

a powerful army."

"Colonel von Hindenburg has been credited," the dispatch states, "with having played the role of special pleader to his father on behalf of the National Socialists. This, however, appears to be true in only a limited sense."

Characterized as "one of the most mysterious and, at the same most mysterious and, at the same time, most important figures of post-War Germany," Colonel von Hindenburg, as his last public act, it is recalled, supported Hitler in radio speeches before the recent plebiscite.

The report continues:
"His next to the last act was to refrain fext to the last act was to refrain from delivering his fa-ther's political 'will' to Hitler—al-though the old general had writ-ten on the envelope in which the estament was found:

"'To be delivered to the Chancellor by my son, Oscar von Hindenburg.'
"Baron Franz von Papen, the

Vice-Chancellor, delivered it instead.
"Throughout his father's presi-

dency, Colonel von Hindenburg acted as his personal adjutant. He never left his father's side and for several weeks at the end of the general's life only Oscar and the President's chief of cabinet, Otto

Meissner, could see him.
"It was through them that the dying old man received all that he knew of what was happening in the nation of which he was the Chief Executive."

The question of Zionism will loom hard on any Jewish horizon. Our attitude as a group, just as it must be non-political, must be neither pro—nor anti-Zionist. It has room in its membership for people of all

who are hitterly opposed to Zionism.

However, surveying Zionism in much

the same manner as Jewish rights are surveyed anywhere else in the world, we must take the attitude that what is ours shall not be taken away from us. Certainly England, by written promise, dedi-cated herself to the support of this proposition and at the same time the promise was made meant the establishment of a

Since that time, dealing with weak leaders and realizing that as an effective unit the Jews are a joke, apathetic and disunited, Eng-land felt quite free to disavow her word and to quibble on the terms of the agreement. All she was to sible placating of a group of savage and fanatic Arabs.

Not only did she not aid Jewish emigration to Palestine as she clearly promised to do, but she deliberately sabotaged the Jewish endeavor in every conceivable man-

Contrary to the mandate, she first sliced off two-thirds of Palestine to create Trans-Jordania, a papier-maché country which Jews aren't even allowed to enter, though this prohibition does not apply to non-Jews and though residents of Trans-Jordania are free to enter-into Palestine.

She has reduced immigration to the pitiful maximum of 14,000 a year at a time when the Jews of Europe are being mercilessly assaulted, when their need of a haven is the greatest. At the same time, she allows Bedouin Arabs to cross the borders without re-straint, and to take advantage of the fine labor of the pauperized Jews of pogrom countries.

Allows Rich to Enter She magnificently allows wealthy She magnificently allows wealthy Jews to enter Palestine, but it must be pointed out that it was the intention of the mandate to provide a haven above all for Jews

who came as working men, as tillers of the soil.

In considering this situation we must first of all recognize that it has been promised to us. We must next of all consider that Palestine is very necessary to the Jews. It is very necessary to the Jews. It could provide Jewry with a seat on the League of Nations, where its word could be heard officially. Zionists exist to whom it is the land of dreams. It is a haven of refuge for persecuted Jews, who once uprooted, as they are in Ger-

many, have no other place to go to mend their shattered lives. From all of these viewpoints a united Jewry cannot agree to Eng-land's contemptible tactics in attempting to ruin the Jewish, enter-prise which has been so dearly paid for in blood, suffering and sacrifice. It is our duty to see that this word is kept.

England Vulnerable

England is a small, highly in-dustrialized nation and highly vulnerable. Even her experience with the Irish, whom she similarly mistreated over a considerable period, proves that. The determined hatred of Irishmen for England the world over, finally forced the British to yield.

We should point out to the world that of all people the Jew, with his natural inclination towards personal independence, is the most natural anti-Communist. Only where the Jew is broken and in despair, willing to turn towards anything which will rescue him from chaos, will he turn like many of the Russian Jews under the Czar, to a radical philosophy. The Jews in Palestine, if left to their own artifices, will develop into a sober, industrious people, a bul-wark against international disor-

It will be argued that there is not room for the persecuted Jews of Europe in Palestine. The reply will have to be that whether there is or not we should not yield a jot of what is ours.

A Virile People

Moreover, the Jews are basically a virile, conquering people. Pacifism is only a passing phase with Jewry. Once established in Pales-tine the Jew will seize the great, mighty desert that lays just out-side its borders to make room for his tortured brothers in the Diasns tortured prothers in the Dias-pora. There is room in this vast desert, needing only energy to make it fertile, for all the Jews in existence and still leave space for ten times as many Arabs as there are A virile nation will certainly not allow an arbitrary Mandate boundary to box them in, and in this respect can be relied on to settle their own problems.

This new nation might even become a haven for the persecuted British to yield.

ing Nazi tide establishes itself everywhere, so it need no longer be afraid of the opinion of Chris-tian nations. Christianity is, after all, the child of Judea and a Jew-ish nation, built on the Jewish traditions could not allow these refugees from pagan torture to per

No one who is even half an ob-No one who is even half an ob-server can avoid realizing that our young Jews are being taught to be self-seeking and contentious. In-dividual ambition has become our Mammon. The old fierce, proud soul of Judah has become a distorted, unrecognizable thing.

History will again teach the cold lesson which it has unfailingly taught in the past, that a loss of faithfulness, devotion and the spir-it of individual sacrifice constitutes an actual degeneration. Its fingers clutching us as a group will finally clutch us each individually: the unfortunates of Germany, Hun-gary, Poland, Rumania and Alge-ria can bear mute testimony to this.

Our realism is not realism at all as history is proving once more. It is simply a mad seeking of individual shibboleths and a courting of destruction.

As an undisciplined mob with no As an unascriptined mod with no hegemony of spirit, no factor of unity save the suppressive devices of our enemies—we are a pitful, uninspiring lot. If Jewry is inter-ested in even the most elementary axioms, it will stop cringing and wailing. It will become pridefully aware that the principal condition aware that the principal condition to happiness and survival is an inherent strength and binding force of its own.

#### Will Hate Self

Otherwise outer coercion must finally reduce its soul to abject bitterness. Churning desperately for relief from unbearable persecution Jewry will turn half its detestation upon its mother for bringing tion upon its mother for bringing it into the world. Hateful and pitiful, it will hate itself. Its emotions shattered, our people will be flung far from the path of world destiny. Its broken soul will grovel in the future annals of mankind until deserted one by one by its emisting world in the flutter annals of mankind until deserted one by one by its spiritually-maimed sons, it will eservedly perish.
This is the swift harsh coming

of tomorrow, senility and death un-less we justify our right to live. The world's frontiers are shrink-ing. There is no longer room for the weak and timid to hide. Unthe weak and timid to hide. Un-less we reach back again into the Jewish way of life, becoming once more strong, vital, disciplined and haughty, fate will spew us into ob-

Men of fibre and courage would not dare leave this formidable prospect to their unfortunate children.
