

## The Bulletin's Day Book

In a very few days patriotic Americans and even more patriotic Italian-Americans will be celebrating an event that is supposed to have occurred back in the days of 1492. Every Columbus statue from the rock-ribbed coast of Maine to the actor-laden hills of Hollywood will have its queue of orators and cluster of wreaths. Columbus discovered America and there seems to be a universal conspiracy on foot never to let us forget it.

A few days ago another discovery was made that some day may make the Columbus adventure seem by comparison a paltry little trip across a quiet suburban street.

Here Doktor Paul Joseph Goebbels, panjandrum of propaganda for the Third Reich, discovered Palestine.

The exact date on which the gaby one made his startling discovery is not certain. Some day it may offer a fertile field for historians and Ph.D. hunters to delve into. They will write long, arid, these explaining that they have uncovered absolute evidence that the daring young Nazi navigator, after ploughing through a stormy, serpent-infested seas for many months on the stout ship Der Angriif, finally set foot on Palestine's soil. They will count the minutes after three o'clock, Arabian Standard Time, on the afternoon of September 28, 1934.

But the historians and the Ph.D. seekers will have to use the slightest of evidence on which to base their assertions. When pressed they will be forced to admit that they will never count on it that on that afternoon, at that very hour, the natives of Haifa were forced to flee for their lives. They will be told that we can explain the cause of the flight in the following plain language:

"On ye afternoon of ye twenty-sixth date of September, along abouts half past five, on ye third hour post meridian, just as ye worshippers were leaving ye sacred house of worship, our nostrils were assailed by a mighty, fetid odor that was wafted to us from ye ocean. It was such an overpowering odor that ye worshippers made shaft to drop everything and run for ye dear life. Ye worshippers ran for miles until ye foul stench no longer assailed them, mightily bruised nostrils and then dropped exhausted upon ye soothing sands of ye desert."

Now that's pretty strong evidence as far as the sense of smell is concerned, but only the most rabid anti-Nazi will contend that it is conclusive proof that the stout ship Der Angriif had landed and disgorged its fearless explorers on the sands of Haifa's shore.

But who are we to quibble about dates? The all-important facts are undisputed by anyone in his right senses. Goebbels, if not the mighty shrimps in person then, as our private J.T.A. historian has been told, one of the star reporters of his newspaper Der Angriif, landed in Palestine not long ago and wrote a glowing account of his trip of discovery.

The natives, he found, referring to the Jewish population, were doing a pretty good job of work at building up Palestine.

But the star reporter-explorer wasn't going to be panicked into pouring out a panegyric on Palestine all one throw. So he threw in a couple of eye Nazi potshots just to show the boss that he hadn't been entirely overcome by the Holy Land's beauty.

As it has been discovered, wasn't such a garden spot. In fact the cafes crowded with ladies reminded him strongly of the Kurfurstendamm, the principal Jewish

street in Berlin. Moreover, Jewish education in all Palestine, he somewhat pointedly remarked in Der Angriif's story of the astounding discovery junket, resembles the educational system of the Soviets.

And to top it all off, the daring Nazi Columbus found that Palestine is the hottest spot in the East, and that the Jews and the British and the Arabs are sitting on a keg of dynamite, nitro-glycerine and a N.T.T. that might at any moment go boom-boom-boom.

And maybe that's why the Goebbels' sailor man weighed anchor and scooted out of Palestine as fast as the trade winds could carry him.

But the very fact that Palestine is such a tinder-box may quite possibly appeal to the hardy pioneering spirit of the Nazis. Sitting on kegs of high explosives may appeal to their practical minds as much as, and worse than being purged.

Any day now we may expect to see the Mediterranean cluttered up with Nazi vessels bound for the untamed lands of Palestine.

It wouldn't surprise us in the least to see the ocean caravan led by the good ship Der Stuermer-Mayflower, with "Patso" Julius Streicher at the helm. Our old friend Hanfstaengl is first mate. Between the two of them, Der Stuermer-Mayflower will have no trouble getting through the old drums. When the vessel is becalmed, Hanf and Patso get behind the canvas, take deep breaths and start talking. The wind stirred up by their words speeds them to their destination faster than an honest ninety-mile gale. Eventually, they land on a beach known to posterity as Streicher's Pilgrim's Rock.

But our imagination strikes a snag when we try to look beyond that point. The Pilgrims of American history were greeted, if our American isn't playing tricks on us, with arrows that whizzed uncomfortably close to Pilgrim ears.

It wouldn't do to have the Palestine natives toss arrows at the Nazi pilgrims. They might escape the shower or if the arrows struck, they probably would simply crumple against the indignantly tough skulls of the invaders.

How would it be if the bold pilgrims were greeted with a barrage of the ritual murder insults of Der Stuermer, tossed by them by any army of Palestinian boy scouts? To survive such a barrage, Hanf and Streicher and their lucky band would have to be mighty good doggers.

## Shochtim to Back Kashruth Group

### Union Executives Decide to Support Any Move Made to Enforce Kashruth

At a meeting of the executive committee of Shochtim Union Local 440, organization of kosher poultry slaughterers, a resolution was adopted backing the Kashruth Association in any move it may make to enforce Kashruth. It was announced yesterday.

The resolution came after the Kashruth Association decided to call a meeting at the Hotel Pennsylvania to place a ban on all poultry if the poultry market owners do not accept the decision of Judge Otto A. Rosalsky, the Mayor's mediator in recent poultry market difficulties, by October 8.

Judge Rosalsky's decision provided for the appointment of rabbinical supervision of markets under the control of the Kashruth Association.

It also contains provisions for attachment of tags to kosher-killed chickens to attest to their having been killed in accordance with Jewish ritual, a maximum of 12,000 pounds of poultry weekly to be killed by each shochet and a minimum wage of \$45 for shochtim.

## 2 More Arrested In Butcher Racket

### \$1,000 Bail Set, Violation of Donnelly Act Is Charged; Five Now in Custody

With three officers of the Federation of Kosher Butchers' scheduled to be tried in Queens District Sessions Court October 8, in connection with an alleged kosher meat racket, two more members of the Federation were arrested in the investigation of complaints against monopolistic practices of the Federation by the Anti-Racket Bureau of the New York State Attorney General's office, it was learned yesterday.

The two men arrested, Harry Bender, 6220 Rockaway boulevard, and Hyman Zaidman, 2420 Edgemoor road, Rockaway, were held in \$1,000 bail each for Special Sessions charged with violation of the Donnelly Act. They were brought up for trial October 8 with the other three.

Charles Cohen, president of the Federation, Philip Morris, David Schatz, also officers, were arrested July 31 by detectives of the Anti-Racket Bureau after indictment by the Queens Grand Jury on charges of conspiracy. They are now out on \$1,000 bail each.

## Hippodrome Plans 4 Russian Operas

Max Rabinoff has engaged a complete Russian unit for his season at the Metropolitan Opera Association at the New York Hippodrome, which starts the evening of October 8, with a performance of "Carmen." Four Russian productions have been prepared. The first is "Boris Godunoff," to be given on the second night of the season, with Max Rabinoff in the title role. The second will be "Khovanschina," to be given during the second week. Later "Le Cig O'Yor" and "Prince Igor" will be presented. All operas will be sung in Russian.

They will be conducted by Michel Stokowski, who has had extensive experience with Russian opera in Europe. He was the principal conductor of the Diaghilev Ballet Russe. He has conducted for Feder Chaliapin for the Opera Comique in Paris and has directed in many important European cities. This is his first season in America.

## Art Laskey Takes Rep at Maxie Baer

(Special to the J.D.B.)

FALLSBURG, N. Y., Sept. 30.—"There's no new Jew in Baer than there's Italian in me," announced Art Laskey, the sensational young Milwaukeean, as he stepped into the ring here at the Flagger Country Club in preparation for his ten rounder against Steve Hamas next Friday night at Madison Square Garden.

It was after a stiff workout that Laskey unleashed this blast at Hamas, the champ who sports a Mogen David on his trunks. This fellow Laskey should know a good Hebrew when he sees one. He is an Orthodox Jew and lives up to every tenet of the Jewish religion. In fact he is a fanatic on the history of his race.

"They built up the new heavyweight champ on the Jewish angle from a box office standpoint and it went over big," added the twenty-five-year-old lad, who owns a string of thirty-three knockouts scored in forty-four contests. "Baer doesn't exactly deny his race but he checks the claims and he comes up. He's what you call a trick Jew."

**Laskey Looks Like A Winner**  
As far as the fact that Laskey looks like a winner and much better than Steve Hamas, the pride of Pennsylvania, he also resembles him in physical appearance. Both are good looking fellows with sharp Hebrew features. But like Dempsey and Schmeling, who too, could be taken for twins, Art and Max are not the same. Laskey is a Scotch-Irish-American, Schmeling, German. Laskey is a Russian-Jewish American, Baer is a claimant to be only German American.

As we learned from Maurice Laskey, brother of the Minneapolis mauler and co-manager of the fighter, Art is the first real Orthodox Jewish heavyweight in boxing history and the third prominent candidate for the big honors. His predecessors include Dan Mendoza, a Spanish Jew who ruled with iron fists, so to speak, over the length and breadth of England back in 1795, and Joe Chynoweth, one of the two men to flatten the Negro, Jack Johnson.

This last feat was accomplished by Joe back in 1901. Chynoweth never reached the dizzy heights of championship but old-timers agree that he was "a considerable heavyweight." It was an Englishman named Jackson to stop short Chynoweth's achievements.

Laskey, during the last month, has cut short practice on each of the six Holy Days despite the ravings of manager Giv Rooney.

At present Art relies as favorably on the hard-hitting and clever Steve Hamas at the price of \$ to \$ to \$ of the best of the boxing betting boys are ready to lay 1 to 2 that Hamas will be there at the end of the tenth round. "This, we believe, is the way it should be, because Art is the rip-tearing type of fighter who pleases the fans. He's the kind that never stops from the moment of the opening bell until he scores a knockout—or is carried out. Laskey is a murderous punter who gives no quarter and asks no mercy."

## 'The Greatest Jewish Prizefighter'

It's quite some time since we completed the contest that elected Benny Leonard as the Jewish champion of all time. However, the Jewish Chronicle of England has one or two protests.

"Our boxing correspondent, com-

menting on the results of a competition in an American contemporary to find the greatest Jewish prizefighter of all time, says that, as is usual with Americans, they have apparently confined their interest to those who have fought mainly in American rings. They have entirely ignored the claim of the famous Ted 'Kid' Lewis, whose proud record can compare with any for whom they have voted. Lewis' record is too well known to call for recapitulation, but here are the titles he held: Featherweight champion of England, welter and middleweight champion of Europe, and welter champion of the world."

## Lewis Fought Benny Leonard

"Ted's cyclonic type of fighting earned for him the sobriquet of the dashing, smashing, crashing 'Kid' and it is true to say of him that his name will be a legend to those who follow him. Lewis fought many notable battles in American rings, where he was much admired. He met Jack Britton there for the welter title on several occasions and these two must surely hold the record for the number of times—about twenty—each met each other, holding decisions one over the other."

"Lewis also fought the famous Benny Leonard when he was world's lightweight champion and Lewis was a welter champion. Although Lewis was in the heavier division, it was doubtful whether he was the heavier for this bout which was a six rounds no-decision contest."

"There can be no quarrel with the result of the competition, which declared that Benny Leonard was entitled to be regarded as the great Jewish boxer of all time. But our correspondent gives it as his opinion that Lewis should have been considered in connection with the competition, will apparently he was not. Lewis also met the famous Welsh champion, Johnny Basham, with whom he fought memorable bouts on more than one occasion. The last contest, when he knocked out Basham in the nineteenth round, was, in the opinion of many critics, the finest and most thrilling bout ever seen in England."

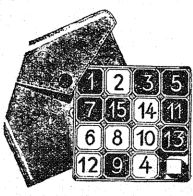

## Reform Temple Problems Up to Buffalo Parley

Western N. Y. Temples Will Meet to Study Needs

BUFFALO, Sept. 30.—Delegates from Buffalo, Rochester and Syracuse will meet next Sunday at the Temple of the Society of Concord in a conference to discuss problems of the Reform Jewish congregations of the western part of the state. The conference has been called by Samuel J. Harris, rabbi of Buffalo, as part of the program of the Northeast Religious Union, regional division of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations. Delegates will be present from Temple Beth Zion of Buffalo, Temple B'eth Kodesh of Rochester and the Temple of the Society of Concord of Syracuse.

The conference will start with a luncheon for all the delegates. Greetings will be extended on behalf of the Society of Concord by Benjamin Stolz, the president, and by the rabbi, Benjamin Friedman, the main address at the luncheon having been delivered by Dr. Joseph L. Fink, rabbi of Temple Beth Zion of Buffalo.

The luncheon will be followed by two group meetings, one for men and one for women, to discuss membership and financial structure, temple management, brotherhood programs and sisterhood activities. The two groups will join for a late afternoon session at which they will be addressed by Rabbi Philip S. Bernstein of Rochester.

unemployed in the country has dwindled, claiming that in the last six months the figure has been reduced two-thirds. Then, again with an eye to support from the farmers, loudly announced that the Hitler government considered speculation in food a crime of the first magnitude. "The living standard," he admitted, "is still too low for many but we will now take improving working conditions."

Paul Joseph Goebbels, Minister of Propaganda and Enlightenment, opened the Thanksgiving program. He sounded the "German salute" when he told the massed thousands.

"The whole German government is behind the farmer."

Farmers from all sections attended the huge Buckenbaug meeting, which was featured by military manoeuvres. Hundreds of thousands of peasants, and "noblemen of labor" participated in the nation-wide thanksgiving ceremonies of this national harvest festival, which was held off as scheduled after two thorough rehearsals yesterday for organized groups, including Reichswehr troops, members of the S. A., and labor service units.

Harvest emblems and mottoes decorated every hamlet, town and city throughout the breadth of Germany with local cities taking place in the more remote villages. The Propaganda Ministry's plans worked to perfection, slogans doled out to agriculture were displayed everywhere.

"Wine, bread, love and fidelity" ran the inscription on millions of buttonhole miniatures on sale at all corners.

## Orthodox Body Denies Decision To Join Council

Agudath Israel Weighs Entering Proposed Palestine Unit

(Jersey Telegraphic Agency)  
LONDON, Sept. 30.—Reports that the Agudath Israel, ultra-Orthodox Jewish organization, has decided to enter the Palestine legislative council, were denied here today by M. Goodman, London representative of the organization.

In a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency Mr. Goodman declared that the world executive body of the organization has the matter under consideration and will act only in accordance with general Jewish opinion, since the matter does not involve religious principle.

Palestine Jewish leaders are strongly opposed to the proposed legislative council, terming it a clear violation of the provisions of the Balfour Declaration. They also point out that the Arab representatives together with the British will constitute a majority opposed to the Jews.

The Palestine government announced that the legislative council will be formed shortly, despite the tremendous amount of opposition the proposal has aroused.

## Anti-Nazi Session At Chicago Ends

Resolutions Assail Nazis, Fascism and War Plans

CHICAGO, Sept. 30.—The second United States Congress Against War and Fascism today denounced Nazism and Fascism, specifically condemning the Hitlerite persecution of the Jews. More than 3,500 delegates from the United States and fraternal delegations from all over the world attended the congress.

The congress was devoted to reports of anti-Fascist and anti-militarist activities and to formulating plans for future action. The Young Congress Against War and Fascism was held here at the same time, attracting a wide attendance from youth organizations.

## Fishman Accuses U. S. Prisons Of Fostering Sex Degeneracy

In "Sex in Prison," a book dedicated to the Guggenheim Foundation, Joseph Felling Fishman charges that failure to solve the sex problem in American prisons is in a large measure responsible for present prison unrest.

Mr. Fishman, as chairman of the committees of the American Prison Association and as inspector of prisons for the federal government for a period of six years, has investigated every penal institution of importance. He reports that there is a rampant sex degeneracy in American prisons and that prison authorities refuse to recognize existence of the evil or to take steps towards its eradication.

He advocates, as a means of curtailing sex perversions and abnormalities now rampant, the possibility of furloughs for prisoners of one day a month so that they may visit their wives and families, a solution used in many European countries, particularly in Soviet Russia.

He claims the fact that prison administrators do not face the problem squarely and states that there is a "conspiracy of silence" about the sex problem in prisons and open discussion of the problem at official meetings of the American Prison Association, something that they may have been unwilling to do, in his opinion.

Mr. Fishman condemns the enforced idleness and bad living conditions which characterize American prisons.

"In our prisons," he writes, "the two great topics of conversation are crime and sex. The enforced idleness, the lack of diversion, accentuate and contribute to the seriousness of the problem."

The author denounces the practice of placing two or more men in a cell which is in effect in as many American prisons.

As his solutions to the problem, Mr. Fishman urges hard work.

## New Rules Fixed On Border Crossing

Identification Cards Now Required by Labor Dept., I.I.A.S. Announces

New regulations in respect to border crossing have been issued by the Department of Labor, according to an announcement by Joseph Shulman, director of the American Society.

In regard to border crossing the new rules provide that citizens or aliens living on either side of the border and wishing to cross on business or pleasure must provide themselves with identification cards for which application must be made.

Identification cards must be renewed from time to time and can be taken up or canceled within the discretion of the immigration officials.

## Hamburg Jewish Paper Confiscated by Nazis

newspapers that the decree would be rescinded proved untrue. The government reiterated its intention of carrying out the full terms of the law.

At the same time the government broadened the scope of the recently introduced ghetto school law and began to segregate Jewish children in a number of schools, where it was found technically impossible to introduce all-Jewish schools. In these schools separately housed Jewish children and for Jewish children and for the children of converted Jews, effectively isolating them.

Austrian Jewish leaders denounced the attitude of the government and said that efforts to terrorize the Jewish community and throttle protests would be unavailing. They have been protesting since Friday by the Reichspost, official government newspaper, to end their protests against the school law, and charging that the protests were being instigated by Marxist anti-government groups. Jewish circles pointed out that such an accusation is sheer nonsense, since Austrian Jews are not Marxists.
