### Germany's New Jews

A German Jew, who calls himself a "New Jew," has written a strikingly interesting letter to the C. V. Zeitung, the organ of the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith, in which he seeks to explain the plight of a large number of Jews who have thrown themselves into Jewish activities since the rise of Hitlerism, and who are criticized for this in certain quarters.

The "New Jew" writes: "We may be termed 'New Jews,' we may be ironically described as 'March victims,' we may justly be reproached with the fact of the sudden heel of Jewish life until the occurrences in 1933 drove us in that direction. But now we want to insist in rebuilding German Jewry. And in this work everyone of goodwill should be welcome.

"The reproach against the New Jew which is made is that they have no right yet to express an opinion in a Jewish community of which they have previously known nothing, would not be so important if it affected only a few people. But it is hardly necessary to explain that more than half of the 600,000 or so Jews of Germany lived their life in a way that was only slightly related to things Jewish externally and even less so internally. And there are hundreds of thousands of us, who have come now with an earnest desire not only to learn, but actively to help Jewry. Have we no right?"

The "New Jew" then explains the reasons why these Jews had not been related to Jewish in the past. Their parental homes, he writes, were in no way different from the ordinary German homes, and they had the mezzah on the table, the observance of Rosh Hashonah and Yom Kippur, and in the kindling of the candles on Chanukah.

"Our life was German," he continues. "Our most vital experiences were the War, the revolution, the Weimar Republic. Experiences that we shared with every other German, with the whole German nation. We grew up in the same atmosphere. We were not confronted with any specific problems. . . . Then suddenly came April 1, 1933. Very few of the German Jews had any idea that the world collapses that day about them have adopted an attitude of resignation and activity. The overwhelming majority very soon found a new basis of life. . . . They became 'New Jews.' Judaism now became dominant and significant, and in the next few years experiences taking years and decades, were by these 'New Jews' passed through very rapidly. What had been a slumbering force was now awake. They realized what it means to be a Jew, what a cost and what obligations it involves.

## Greece Restores Ghetto Voting After Tsaldaris-Venizelos Deal

ATHENS, Oct. 18.—In a sensational decree published today, the Greek government ordered the restoration of a separate electoral college for Jews, announcing at the same time that an agreement had been reached between the government and the opposition party, led by former premier Elutherios, providing for the restoration of the electoral college for Jews and the reelection of President Alexander Zaimis.

The decree came as a terrific shock to the Jewish community in Greece, since the ink was hardly

dry on the decree President Zaimis signed a few days ago abolishing the separate electoral college for Jews and praising the Greek Jews for their patriotism and their value to Greece.

At that time, the president declared that he would never consent to the political segregation of the Greek Jews. Other leaders of the government party made the same statement repeatedly.

In Greek Jewish circles the sudden blow at Jewish hopes is regarded as the forerunner of a wave of anti-Semitism in Greece, (Continued on Page Five)

## Yugoslav Jews Pay Homage to Slain Monarch

### Chief Rabbi Precedes General Goering in Funeral Procession

BELGRADE, Oct. 18.—Chief Rabbi M. Alkaly of Yugoslavia was given a place of honor today in the funeral procession which escorted the late King Alexander to his final resting place among the tombs of the Karageorgievitch dynasty.

By special invitation of the royal family, the chief rabbi marched in the procession with the members of the royal family and the members of the government.

Clothed in a black linen robe of mourning, the chief rabbi walked between the Archbishop of Belgrade and the Moslem Grand Mufti. Almost immediately behind him walked Hermann Wilhelm Goering, Premier of Prussia and right hand man of Reichsfuehrer Adolf Hitler.

Similar honors were accorded Chief Rabbi Alkaly at receptions and parades for the arrival of the young boy-king of Yugoslavia, Peter II.

During the funeral services in Belgrade, Jewish communities all over the country did solemn memorial services for the slain monarch.

The royal family and the government of Yugoslavia have been flooded with condolences from Jewish organizations all over the world, including the United States, Great Britain and Palestine.

## Fish Dealers End Four-Day Strike

The four-day strike of the United Retail Fish Dealers Association in the Fulton Fish Market was ended yesterday afternoon as it was begun on Monday. Following a visit to the Mayor at City Hall, the retail organization decided to call a three-day truce during which time a permanent agreement between the wholesalers and retailers could be reached.

Samuel L. LeGarde has appointed a committee of six, three retailers and three wholesalers, to settle all disputes. A delegation of the strikers also visited Commissioner of Markets William F. Morrow yesterday.

## Film Moves Bigots To Riot in Vienna

VIENNA, Oct. 18.—Anti-Semitic riots broke out in Vienna, movie houses today on the showing of the film, "Jud and Suss" (Lion Feuchtwanger's novel, "Pow-er.") The film is "filled with pro-Jewish propaganda and is unpropagandist," Neuefreie Weltblatt, official Austrian government organ, reported today.

## Latvia Moves To Suppress Artisan Group

### Orders Closing of Offices in Series of Anti-Jewish Acts

RIGA, Oct. 18.—The Latvian Minister of the Interior today ordered the closing of the Latvian Jewish Artisans Federation. The organization was banned in Latvia and its offices were sealed by the authorities.

Latvia's ban on the artisans group is one of a series of anti-Jewish measures undertaken by the dictatorship which has ruled the country for several months. Jewish newspapers have been suppressed and only the organ of the ultra-orthodox Agudath Israel is permitted to appear.

## Zionists Agree On Peace Plan As Parlev Ends

### Accord Is Achieved on Shekel Payment, World Congress

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
LONDON, Oct. 18.—Discussions between the World Zionist Executive and the Union of General Zionists concluded today with a full agreement to exclude certain intermediary methods and propaganda and to enforce discipline in the Zionist ranks.

The Zionist Executive presented a scheme for the reform of the World Zionist Organization and agreed to proposals regarding the reform of the shekel payment and Zionist Congress procedure. Only those who pay the annual shekel tax are entitled to vote in the elections for delegates to Zionist Congresses. It was stipulated, however, that the reforms must be preceded by consultation with the other Zionist parties.

## Asserts Envoy Serves in Dual Capacity Here

### Ambassador Violating International Law, Says Quiz Head

German Ambassador Hans Luther is serving as an agent of the Nazi Party in the United States, charged Congressman John W. McCormack, chairman of the Congressional Committee investigating subversive and un-American activities, in a statement prepared a closed session of the Committee at the Bar Association building, 49 West Forty-fourth street yesterday.

"Evidence before this committee shows that he is an accredited agent of the National Socialist German Workers' Party," Mr. McCormack asserted.

The ambassador was violating international law principles by "attempting to incite the policy of the German government to the confines of a friendly nation," he declared.

He cited the testimony of Ernst Berkenhoff who admitted Monday that he is a member of the Nazi Party visiting here and had instructions to report either to the local Nazi unit or the German Embassy upon arrival.

A wallet lost by Berkenhoff containing documents linking him to the Nazi Party led to his being subpoenaed by the committee. The wallet contained instructions from the Nazi party to report to the branch of the Nazi Party in whatever country he visits.

McCormack declared that Germany is "violating international law and violating the hospitality (Continued on Page Eight)

## Warns Reich Stage To Get Rid of Jews

BERLIN, Oct. 18.—German stage managers were warned today not to produce plays by Jewish authors, playwrights, or which feature Jews. The official organ of the stage department of the German Chamber of Culture, which issues the warning, severely reprimanded the stage managers for favoring Jews and declared that vigorous steps would be taken to "cleanse" the German stage.

## Saar Takes Action In Nazi Race Drive

SAARBRUECKEN, Saar, Oct. 18.—Nazi incitement against the Jews in the Saar plebiscite area received a severe blow today when a plebiscite court here fined a Nazi editor 1,000 francs for publishing a false charge against a Jewish resident of the region. The Nazi Party author also charged with severely refused to publish a retraction of the libelous story.

## Untermyer Chides Gen. Sherrill For Stand on Olympic Games

Samuel Untermyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, to Champion Human Rights, in a letter to General Charles H. Sherrill takes issue with his statement that no discriminations will be practiced against German Jews in connection with the 1936 Olympic Games.

"It is not," Mr. Untermyer writes, "a question solely of whether, in order to secure the great prestige and patronage of having these games held in Berlin the Hitler regime is willing to relax, for the purpose of competition in these games and for that purpose only, the brutal, medieval law and rules of that enacted against Jewish athletes, among others. The question goes far deeper. In that connection perhaps you will answer the following questions:

"1. Are you not aware that Mr. Brundage accepted the humiliating and disgraceful condition that the fact of German Jews being permitted to participate was not to be published in Germany?"

"2. That since the German government on June 7, 1933, made certain pledges with respect to the participation of German Jews in the games, it has been guilty of thirty-two specific acts of breach of that understanding, which I outlined in my letter of September 26 to the president of the American Olympic Association, and his asso-

# Alfred M. Cohen, 75, Carries On For Jewry With Unabated Zest

## B'nai B'rith Chief Not Content to Rest on Past Laurels

One of America's outstanding Jews today celebrates his seventy-fifth birthday. While B'nai B'rith, with which organization his name has been associated for twenty years, on his natal day anniversary as something peculiarly its own, all Jewry joins in paying homage to Alfred M. Cohen.

The reason for Jewry's love of Senator Cohen is best expressed, perhaps, by his intimate and close associate, I. M. Rubinow, executive director of B'nai B'rith. In a tribute to his "boss" Mr. Rubinow, listing some of his conspicuous characteristics, speaks of "his inexhaustible industry and capacity for work. His devotion to Jewry and B'nai B'rith—I think I have put them in the right order—has become an obsession. It arises out of his devotion to Judaism and Jewry, not the reverse."

Active 65 Years  
"Truly it is his love of Jewry and Judaism that caused Jewry to love Senator Cohen. His has not been the devotion of a decade or so, the climax of a career devoted to the Jew and B'nai B'rith. The president of the International Order of B'nai B'rith has been devoted, man and boy, for the past thirty years to the cause of Jewry and we may be erring on the conservative side when we do not include the first ten years of Alfred Cohen's life in the scope of Jewish activity."

Certainly from the birth of consciousness, whatever that age may be, Alfred Cohen was conscious of the Jewish people. It was to Senator S. Cohen, an Englishman by birth, was one of the earliest members of the B'nai B'rith. The son who was born in Cincinnati, grew in the cradle of Reform Judaism under the personal tutelage of the founder of the Reform Movement, Isaac M. Wise.

Senator Cohen was one of the youngsters Rabbi Wise had in mind when he first projected the idea of the Hebrew Union College. At the age of twelve, the son of five boys chosen for a Jewish school that the Rabbi was developing as a nucleus for his liberal theological school.

### Studied Law

Alfred Cohen never became a rabbi; he studied law. But years later he was elected president of the house of delegates of the Hebrew Union College. It was just one of the many ramifications of his many sided Judaism. Certainly, with the passing of time today, would be proud of the little boy he placed so much confidence in sixty-three years ago. The Jewish interest, though, is quite naturally B'nai B'rith of which he has for the past ten years been international president. As head of this largest

destruction by the German government, Senator Cohen has appealed to the Secretary of State for his brother lodge members. Though some of the lodges were disincorporated by the German government in Germany is under complete and officially banned by the Nazi govt., B'nai B'rith was never dismantled. This, undoubtedly, is another testimonial to the vigilance of Senator Cohen and the strength he was able to rally to the aid of the German people.

### Hillil His Pet

But although his activities in behalf of the German Jews comprise the most dramatic aspect of Senator Cohen's ten year leadership of B'nai B'rith, there are many who hold that his devotion to the Hillil Foundation is the crowning achievement of his career. Hillil is B'nai B'rith on the college campuses. There are now nine such foundations, each headed by a representative of the B'nai B'rith. It was conceived by the late Rabbi Benjamin Frankel in 1925, the year Alfred Cohen assumed the presidency of B'nai B'rith. It was with his sympathetic cooperation that the movement grew to its present status, so that now there are foundations in Chicago, Los Angeles, Ohio State, Wisconsin, Michigan, Cornell, Texas, Northwestern, California and Alabama, which comprise this year.

The purpose of the Foundation, now under the national leadership of Dr. Abraham L. Sachar, is perhaps best expressed by its founding officer, Alfred M. Cohen. In a speech, he said: "In their most impressive years young Jews were without Jewish contacts at the universities. B'nai B'rith served the orphan, the sick, the aged—it should not shrink its duty to the young people if the next generation was to have leaders."

B'nai B'rith under the direction of Alfred Cohen did not shrink his duties. Further, it has sponsored a Junior Order, Alpha B'nai B'rith, at the Junior B'nai B'rith, each chapter of which is sponsored by a senior lodge. It is now grown to 176 units with a membership of 10,000; between the ages of sixteen and twenty-one. Outside the realm of Jewish affairs, Senator Cohen has also been successful in leading successful the graduate of the University of Cincinnati Law School, class of 1930, is now senior member of the law firm of Cohen, Mack and Hurling, 100 Park Avenue, New York. Politically, Alfred M. Cohen was a Cincinnati candidate at the age of twenty; a two term member of Ohio State Senator. Following his terms at Columbus he was, in 1900, at the age of forty-one a candidate for mayor of Cincinnati. He was thrice a presidential elector, serving twice as president of the Ohio Electoral College, and once as national party president, Taft and Harding. He was a classmate of President Taft and a fellow State Senator with President Harding.

Thus at seventy-five, Senator Cohen could well sit back and contemplate a successful career. But it does not, he continues to work. He will not cease in his devotion to Jewry and B'nai B'rith. A worker, he will remain so to the end. The vigorous efforts of B'nai B'rith has risen for him is indicative of what his intimates know he most desires. B'nai B'rith is conducting a national membership campaign for 75,000 new members, one thousand members for every year of its present.

of all fraternal lodges, Alfred Cohen has been one of the leaders of Israel. It was he who headed the B'nai B'rith deputation in the Joint Consultative Council of the American Jewish Committee, the American Jewish Congress and it was B'nai B'rith that was called to consider and act for American Jewry on the problems besetting Jews as a result of the Hitler regime. It was Senator Cohen, as a matter of fact, who more than any one else is responsible for the measure of unity among Jewish leaders achieved by the Joint Council. It was he who called the first meeting of the three groups on Washington's Birthday of 1933, the meeting that paved the way for the ultimate adoption of the Joint Council on June 23 of that year. As a result of his efforts in the rebuilding of Jewish life, the B'nai B'rith lodge was honored by being chosen as its chairman.

### Defines Jewry's Need

Senator Cohen's views on the Joint Consultative Council of American Jewry is a board of deputies, made up of representatives of all organizations which assume to deal with matters of national and international character so that duplication of effort may be avoided.

Obviously, the Senator had in mind the establishment of an American equivalent of the British Board of Deputies. In this, he was not quite successful but the Joint Consultative Council is the first step in the direction of unity in American Jewry. From it may eventually come an authoritative international organization Jewish body, something that neither the American Jewish Committee nor the American Jewish Congress, nor the Jewish Council of B'nai B'rith is a leader in this movement and Alfred M. Cohen, of course, shares a major part of the acclaim the lodge merits for its work.

### Aided Relief Jews

Senator Cohen has labored mightily in behalf of the German Jews. As a member of the House of Representatives, he made direct contact with Secretary of State Hull. He personally launched a petition to President Roosevelt, signed by a quarter million persons, half Jews and half Gentiles, which urged the President "to use the good offices of this country through your diplomatic channels and in accordance with the traditions of our country, to make clear that together with the entire Jewish people the American people are struck with horror at these events and their continuance despite the suave assurances of the German Government as to Germany's peaceful intent." # Oops! Nazis, Foes Meet Under the Same Roof

 MILWAUKEE, Oct. 17.—Members of the local chapter of the American League Against War and Fascism, found themselves confronted by what appeared to be mass picketing on the part of Nazis when they arrived at the Republican Hotel, last night for a banquet and meeting.

On the stairs stood booted young men with swastika armbands.

No clash occurred, however. The anti-Fascists discovered the Nazis were merely members of the Friends of New Germany arriving for their own weekly meeting. There was considerable dismay, nevertheless at the thought of the two groups meeting under the same roof.

# Venezelists Back Anti-Semitic Campaign in Greek Elections

(J. T. A. Special Correspondent)  
 SALONICA, Oct. 5.—The Venizelist party, which is intensely anti-Semitic, has begun a bitter anti-Jewish campaign in connection with the forthcoming general election in Greece.

At the same time the party put into effect a boycott against Jewish stores in those portions of the country where Venizelist influence is strongest.

Anti-Jewish leaflets calling for a war "against the Jews and the Freemasons" are being distributed daily in the streets of this city by Christian students belonging to the National Students Union.

"No Greek will hesitate to use any weapon and to fight on the streets in order to prevent Greece from falling into the hands of the Jews," *Imnensis*, a Greek Venizelist paper, declared in commenting on reports that the present government would abolish the special electoral college for Jews.

The Venizelist press also came out with stories declaring that the segregation of Jews into a special electoral college was demanded by the treaties of Lausanne and Sevres, which established the minority rights of the Jews in Greece.

Governmental newspapers, however, support the Jews and a number of high government officials have made it clear that under no circumstances will they favor the segregation of the Jews in a special electoral list, since they consider the Jews as equal citizens to work together with all other citizens of the country. In the meantime the discussion of the Jewish problem occupies much of the talk in the press. Hardly a day passes without the opposition press attacking the government on the electoral college issue and inciting against the Jews.

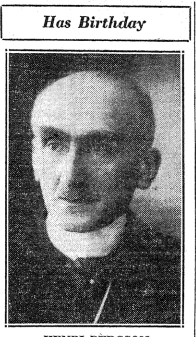

Premier Paniyoti Tzaldaris issued a statement declaring that the Greek government will establish a separate electoral college for the Turks in Greek Thrace, but will never consent to the segregation of Jews. "The patriotism of the Greek Jews can never be questioned," the premier declared.

Former Premier M. Michalopoulos, leader of the democratic opposition and a likely candidate for the presidency, also expressed his regard for the Jews and his opposition to anti-Semitism.

"At various times I have expressed my sympathy toward the Jews whose activities I consider beneficial to the country," the former premier said. I am against segregating Jewish voters because it would help hamper their assimilation. Venizelos plays a double game with the Jews. He helps them when he needs them, but he attacks them when he is no longer interested in their support.

Governor General Francis Riallis of Salonica also attacked the Venizelist anti-Jewish agitation pointing out that in 1925, Venizelos himself opposed the segregation of the Jews.

# Bergson Is 75; Spends Day at College Office

## Leader of Philosophic Revolt a French 'Immortal'

 PARIS, Oct. 18.—Professor Henri Bergson, famous French Jewish philosopher, writer and lecturer, today celebrated his seventy-fifth birthday. The world-famous philosopher, an usual, spent the day in his office at the Collège de France, where he has held a chair since 1900.

At a recent meeting of the International Philosophers Congress in Praha, Czechoslovakia, Professor Bergson was elected honorary president of the organization.

Professor Bergson, one of the "forty immortals" of the French Academy, is the sponsor of the famous theory of creative evolution and led the modern philosophic revolt against intellectualism.

He is the author of a number of highly important works on philosophy, including "L'Evolution Creative," "Matiere et Memoire" and "Essai sur les Donnees Immediates de la Conscience."

Thirty years ago Professor Bergson paid a visit to the United States, where he delivered lectures at all the leading universities. The noted philosopher's lectures attracted thousands of listeners.

# Reports Spread of Rebellion In Mosley Body

## English Paper Expects Shakeup in Blackshirts Ranks Soon

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) LONDON, Oct. 8.—Revolt is spreading among the rank and file of Sir Oswald Mosley's Blackshirts, the News Chronicle reports.

"The Bristol 'insurrection,' exclusively reported in the News Chronicle, has been smoldering for months, and now the Paddington branch office and other officials have sent in their resignations."

"A protest, addressed to Sir Oswald Mosley, is being circulated throughout the movement, and an inquiry is expected shortly that will shake the whole Blackshirt organization."

State of Siege "Mysterious instructions are alleged to have been issued to tradespeople to stop supplies to the headquarters of eighty British Fascist 'rebels' who are still occupying premises in Parkstreet, which were branch headquarters."

"The attempt to cut off supplies for the canten is part of the state of siege in which the premises have been for days."

"A denial of a split in the Bristol ranks was issued from the national headquarters of the B. B. F. F. in Chelsea. Mr. A. V. Gough, formerly District Area Officer, and other officers were dumfounded when told yesterday of the denial."

"We absolutely and unconditionally stand by the statement of our revolt which appeared in the News Chronicle," said Mr. Gough. "The facts are incontrovertible."

"That reward of \$250,000 to anyone who will make the nation discard its Silver Shirts surely acts an all-time record in Jewish offerings for men's cast-off garments."

No details of the alleged offer are furnished. Declaring that "Sunday in Washington resembles Yum Kippur in Manhattan's business districts," an article entitled "The Battle Cry of Fed 'Em" attacks Bernard M. Baruch, General Hugh Johnson, General Johnson's secretary and the NRA.

## Savants to Seek Biro-Bidjan Facts

## Doctors and Scientists Plan Expedition to Survey Problems There

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) MOSCOW, Oct. 8.—An expedition of doctors and scientists will be sent to Biro-Bidjan by the All-Ukrainian Institute for Experimental Medicine, most important institution of its kind in the Ukraine, to study medical and hygiene problems of the Jewish autonomous territory.

The expedition will investigate Biro-Bidjan's mineral springs, its climate, its effect on inhabitants, diseases peculiar to the region and similar problems. It will work according to a plan proposed by Professor Lifschitz, director of the All-Ukrainian institute. A practical medical aid plan, to be administered by the institute, also has been prepared by Professor Lifschitz and is new under consideration.

## Soviet Honors Jewish School

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) MOSCOW, Oct. 7.—A government prize for excellence has been awarded to the Jewish machine trades technical school at Kharkov. It is the only school in the Ukraine to be so honored in a contest including all of the technical high schools and institutes of the U. S. S. R.

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) ISTANBUL, Oct. 8.—Professor Reichenbach, a Jewish refugee from Germany, represented Turkey at the international philosophy congress in Prague.

## Charges Jews Fail To Speak Turkish

## Government Newspaper Says They Use Tongue Least of Land's Minorities

(J.T.A. Special Correspondence) ISTANBUL, Oct. 20.—None of the national minorities in Turkey speak Turkish enough, and the Jews speak it least of all, complains Cumhuriyet (The Republic), the official government newspaper.

"When an Armenian or a Greek fails to speak Turkish he at least speaks his own language, but a Jew who does not speak Turkish speaks Ladino or some other European language."

"We would have nothing against the Jews if they spoke Hebrew, their national language," Cumhuriyet says. "But we would like to have them speak neither their own language nor the language of the land."

A call to all the Jews to use Turkish in their business dealings was issued during the High Holidays. It was sent out by the Hachamim, the Jewish Culture Society.

Herr Fischer, who was in the publishing business in Berlin since 1880, was responsible for introducing Thomas Mann, Hauptmann, Bernhard Kellerman and other noted writers to German readers.

From Congressman McFadden:

On second thought, this letter had better not be published. After all, the Jewish Daily Bulletin is a family paper and not the Congressional Record.

From George W. Christians, of Chattanooga, Tenn.: (Remember him? He's the commander-in-chief of the American Fascists, the White Shirts).

"No! I won't congratulate you on your tenth anniversary. Why should I? I haven't seen my name mentioned in your lying columns since Pat McGrady used his imagination freely in describing my innocent activities in behalf of a Jewless United States. I dare you to print this letter! F. S. If you do, I'll send you a five thousand word letter telling the world just why the Jewish Daily Bulletin is a public servant deserving of nothing but the best."

# Smolar Predicts Jews of Europe Face Decade of Untold Suffering

## Only a Startling Turn of Events Will Save Them, He Feels

Unless something startling—a war, for example—takes place within the next ten years, the Jews of Europe are facing a decade of untold suffering without parallel in their history.

The above prediction has been made by Boris Smolar, a man of European notabilities. It has been made frequently of late by visiting American notables who have returned here with tales of ill-fated suffering they have encountered in Jewish communities throughout the continent. It has been made by statesmen and by preachers, many of them speakers more than hearsay than from personal knowledge.

Yesterday, however, the prediction was made by a man who spoke with the authority of a trained newspaperman who has seen many more things than he is permitted to write, a man who knows Europe like a district reporter knows his "beat." It was made by Boris Smolar, chief European correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, who arrived here earlier in the week to undertake some work in connection with the agency.

A mild-mannered, soft-spoken man, small of stature, with graying hair and brown eyes that sometimes sparkle, Smolar has seen an entire people subjected to in many lands. Mr. Smolar is perhaps the world's leading authority on the Jews of Europe. Speaking from the conviction and with the authority that comes from close observation over

a period of more than ten years, a period in which he has seen at first hand how the flames of anti-Semitism has swept across our border after another with the speed of a prairie fire, Mr. Smolar has the following to say:

"If there is no such startling event to interrupt the trend as it now is, I can see for the Jews of Europe during the next ten years suffering even worse than what have experienced in the past ten years.

"This will be so not only in Germany, but in Austria, in Poland, even in Czechoslovakia and in Hungary, nations considered friendly to Jews. In fact, all Central and Southeastern Europe will display the effect of the anti-Semitic propaganda now rampant in all Europe."

## Reporter Finds League Disappointing in Its Relief Efforts

Smolar said, is proving disappointingly ineffectual in alleviating the hard-pressed condition of the Jews on an international scale.

In Poland, he pointed out, approximately 3,000,000 Jews are in three million Jews there are reduced to a state of beggary. There, he said, it is not a question of the Jews retaining their political rights. The all-absorbing question there is the problem of providing bread.

"Thousands of Jewish families," he declared, "are actually in such a condition that bread is a luxury rather than a mere necessity."

The situation of Jewry in such countries as Lithuania and Latvia, Smolar pointed out, is rapidly growing worse. In Lithuania, formerly friendly to the Jews, non-Jewish organizations have been in their attempts to squeeze their Jewish competitors out of business.

In Latvia, the plight of Jews is even worse. There, he said, there are many of the country's leading Jews have been arrested and thrown into jail. Zionist units, particularly youth organizations, have been closed by the government and liquidated. Jewish traders are seriously hampered in the export field by a new decree which makes importers. Licenses are being issued chiefly to non-Jews with the result that the Jewish exporters are more financially stricken than many observers believe him to be. The reign of terror employed by the Nazi regime is so powerful a presence that it is so physically because it is physically impossible of achievement. Everybody fears to express his thoughts to his neighbor or closest companions.

And the same fear that is holding Germany's millions in thrall, will serve to swing the Saar back to France, he felt. The forthcoming plebiscite, Smolar predicted, will be one of the chief subjects of discussion. And if Germany fails to comply with the expected League request, the former Smolar declares, may become a major issue in deciding it to defer the plebiscite indefinitely and keep it under League control.

# Says Race Racketeers Mult Many Jewish Industrialists Here

Prominent Jewish business men have made substantial contributions to a racketeering organization known under the name of anti-Communism, is waging a high-powered anti-Semitic campaign, John L. Spivak charges in the fourth of a series of articles entitled "Plotting the American Pogrom," in the New Masses issue out today.

Spivak names Harry A. Jung of Chicago as the head of this "wide-spread espionage organization, the American Vigilant Intelligence Federation," which, he says, was originally founded to spy on Communists and Socialists, but which, in its search for "a new terror-inspiring 'issue' with which to attract money from suckers," has now become one of the national leaders "in the distribution of anti-Semitic propaganda."

"There is no actual evidence," Spivak writes, "that the Jews who contribute to Jung knew their money had been and is being used to spread anti-Semitism."

Spivak writes that the most prominent firm which he claims have contributed to Jung's organizations are:

# Prussian Ritual Murder Case Is Resurrected

## Retrial of Xanthen Butcher Asked by Stuermer

(Jewish Telegraph Agency) BERLIN, Oct. 18.—Ritual murder accusations against a Jewish butcher were resurrected today by Julius Strecher's weekly, Dr. Stuermer, which features in the current issue the famous Xanthen, Prussian ritual murder trial in which the Jewish butcher, Adolph Buschoff, was absolved from blame in the death of five-year-old John Hegemann.

Anti-Semitic material published by Strecher carries alleged pictures of the Xanthen trial as well as photographs of Hebrew passages from the Hebrew book of Leviticus, the Zohar. Attached to the photographs are mutilated translations from the Hebrew text which are alleged to prescribe ritual murder as a part of the Jewish religion.

**Demands New Trial**  
An angry editorial in the paper denounces the acquittal of Buschoff, who was convicted in the United States after the trial, and demands a retrial of the case.

According to Dr. Stuermer, the population of Xanthen is once again being stirred by anti-Semitic songs current at the time of the trial. Only the complete expulsion of the Jews from the Rhine districts will end anti-Semitism, he declares. Dr. Stuermer declares.

### Child Found Murdered In Neighbor's Barn

On June 29, 1891, a five-year-old child was murdered by a farmer's maker in Xanthen. The body was found in the barn of a neighbor. Police were immediately called, but failed to find any clues to the criminal. Among anti-Semitic groups in the town began to circulate rumors that the little boy was killed by Jews in performance of religious rites.

Investigation centered on Adolph Buschoff, a Jewish butcher and a former shot. A local priest named Bresser lent color to the rumors by publishing a series of articles on ritual murders in a local paper.

On October 14 Buschoff and his family were arrested. The evidence against him was so slim, however, that he was soon discharged.

**Bribery Charged**  
The anti-Semites immediately set up a howl that Jewish financiers had bribed the officials to release the butcher. The case then became a "cause celebre" culminating in a heated debate in the Prussian Diet. The court chaplain, Stuermer, who was the first to make the charge, repeated the accusation of ritual murder and declared that Jewish money was being used to bribe police officials.

In February, 1892, Buschoff was arrested again and placed on trial in a Clives court. During the trial it was clearly seen that the entire accusation was based on hearsay. The prosecuting attorney himself moved for dismissal of the charges, which the jury did at once. The real murderer was never discovered.

**Quit the Country**  
The unhappy Buschoff and his family emigrated to the United States.

Admiration of Mrs. Franklin Delano Roosevelt for not being content to be only the first lady of the land and for doing her own share toward making a better society was expressed by Magistrate Anna Moskowitz Kross speaking at luncheon after the annual B'nai Jeshurun Sisterhood Harvest Luncheon.

Urging women, and particularly Jewish women, to take a greater part in civic affairs, Mrs. Kross said, "It is not enough for women to be a wife and mother, to rest on her laurels after rearing a few children and to be satisfied to keep receiving comforts without going out into the world to help solve some of its problems in the social, economic and political spheres."

Dr. Israel Goldstein, rabbi of B'nai Jeshurun declared that "The Jewish congregation of America has become a rallying point for the advancement of our general community relationships as well as being an institution for Jewish welfare work." He said that Jewish organizations are enriching Jewish women a means of enforcing their own and of strengthening the fibre of the Jewish people.

# Police Arrest Four In Daiches Death

## Seek Fifth Accomplice in Murder of Chicago Advertiser

(Special to the J.D.B.) CHICAGO, Oct. 18.—Irving J. Weitzmann, wealthy South Side baker, was arrested here today as a suspect in the murder of Eli Daiches, prominent advertising executive whose body was riddled with machine gun bullets last March 9. Weitzmann is a brother of Louis J. Weitzmann, chief beneficiary of Daiches' loan insurance.

Developments indicated that the slaying will be solved soon, police declared. In addition to Weitzmann three others are in custody, one of whom, investigators reported today, is "ready to talk."

Arrest of a fifth suspect, now being sought, will give them a complete case, officials said.

Daiches was mysteriously killed here last Spring while his wife, Mrs. Belle Daiches, was in Palestine.

The advertising man, president of the Thomas Bowers Agency, was the son of Rabbi Israel Hymen Daiches, patriarchal senior rabbi of the English Synagogue. Jewish philanthropies and educational institutions received bequests under his will.

# Blames Dealers For Accepting Unfit Poultry

## Witness at Trial Says New York Holds Key to Industry

The statement made by Walter L. Rice, special assistant to the Attorney General, that New York City is the main source of all diseased and sick poultry was reiterated yesterday by Theodore Tottis, expert witness for the United States Government in the official procedure charging the A.L.A. Schechter Poultry Corporation and the Schechter Live Poultry Market, Inc., with conspiring to violate the live poultry code.

Tottis, buyer for the Dexter Food Co., Inc., 1000 East Forty-ninth street, Bronx, also charged that demoralization of the New York Poultry Market is the cause of demoralization of poultry markets throughout the country. The code stipulates that if market men are prohibited from selling diseased poultry, chicken shippers in other states will discontinue sending them to New York.

Questioned by Prosecutor Rice, Tottis asserted that since the code's adoption in April, 1934, there has been a vast improvement in the industry. Recent shrinkage of the industry he attributed to "unfair competitive methods practiced in the industry."

Another witness for the government was W. D. Termohlen, senior agricultural economist of the poultry unit of the United States Department of Agriculture. He testified that "it is necessary for members of a given industry to request a code of fair competition before it is given." Defense Attorney Joseph Heller denied this.

Termohlen will be called to the stand this morning.

# Nazis Seize Firm Dutch Jews Own

## Confiscate Entire Property of Hamburger Clothing Company

(Jewish Telegraph Agency) BERLIN, Oct. 18.—Confiscation of all the property of the Hamburger clothing company, a German Jewish concern, was ordered today by the Nazi government. The official reason assigned for the act was the flight of Carl Jacob Hamburger, senior member of the firm, from Germany.

Notwithstanding the fact that the members of the Hamburger family are citizens of the Netherlands, the government, together with distributing companies in various German cities, was taken over today by Nazi officials.

The main factory of the concern is located at Steffeln, Germany, and employs 100 workers.

The Jewish owners of the concern fled shortly after the Nazis came into power, fearing that their lives were not safe.

# Pioneer Group Told of Growth At Convention

## Hear Goldie Meyerson Report Reading During Chicago Parley

(Special to the J.D.B.) CHICAGO, Oct. 18.—Organization of convention, luncheon and presentation of Goldie Meyerson's report by Deborah Rothbard completed the program of today's session of the Pioneer Women's Organization of the City of Chicago.

Miss Rothbard was here as a representative of the organization's national executive body, in place of Miss Meyerson, who has gone to Palestine.

Mrs. M. Brooker of New York City presided. Mrs. R. Liviatich of Montreal was appointed Jewish secretary of the convention, while Miss Boba Halperin of New York City was named English secretary.

**90 Clubs Now**  
Miss Meyerson's report shows that the organization has grown from twenty-nine clubs in this country in 1932 to ninety at present.

The report deals at length with participation of Pioneer Women in the activities of the Jewish National Fund, the contribution toward the political fund of the Poale Zion-Zeire Zion Party; and their cultural efforts within their own communities.

Miss Meyerson gives particular attention to the work of new English speaking clubs and to educational efforts among younger girls' groups; also to the cooperation members have given to the Poale Zion-Zeire Zion Party and to the National Labor Committee.

The convention was greeted by David Pinski, Jewish writer; Dora Rothbard, acting secretary; David Werthman, national secretary of the United Jewish Community; Mrs. David Bloom, New York City Women's League for Palestine; Maurice Cohen, secretary of the Young Jewish Center; and Dr. Irving Rubelsky, western manager of the National Labor Committee for Palestine. A cable greeting from Joseph Sprinzl, Palestine labor leader, was read.

Elišavka Kaplan, member of the executive of the Women's Council of the Histadrut, Central Palestine office, in consideration, declared that women's role in the upbuilding of Palestine is steadily becoming more important.

"At all times we have had an institution as to when the nation was in peril and through their womanly power in the home brought hope and an end to their despair. That is the last attempt of a desperate people to rebuild itself. That is the reason labor in Palestine fights so tenaciously to hold its own."
