



## **Senate Votes New Polish Constitution**

### **Charter Abolishes Electoral System; Blow to Jews**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
**WARSAW, Jan. 22.**—The Polish Senate today adopted a new constitution which abolishes the proportional electoral system and deals a severe blow to the Jews of the country, who were represented in the lower house by six deputies. Passage of the new constitution in the Sejm is regarded as a foregone conclusion, since the government bloc has an absolute majority there.

Representatives of the German and Ukrainian minority groups in the Senate voted against the new constitution, since they also would be affected adversely.

Jewish leaders are convinced that under the new system not a single Jew will be elected to Parliament as such.

Suggest Minority Action  
 Nass Fregdau, Polish Jewish daily, suggests that the Jewish leaders approach the government and discuss the possibility of introducing a Jewish electoral college, which the paper considers the only chance Polish Jewry has left of securing Parliamentary representation. The paper pointed out the fact that other minority group representatives also voted against the new constitution and suggested the possibility of united action.

Competent political observers believe, however, that the government and the government parties would not be willing to grant separate electoral colleges, even if it comes as a united demand of all minority groups in the land.

The world distinguished himself in the World War and was decorated for bravery by the Italian government.

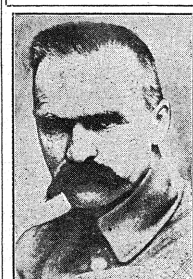
## **Pelley Fraud Case Goes to Jury; State Holds Insolvency Known**

## **Lays U.S. Trade Loss to Reich Import Policy**

### **Boycott Not to Blame, Anti-Nazi Retort to Degener**

Shrinkage of American exports to Germany is in no way traceable to the anti-Nazi boycott, G. E. Harriman, executive secretary of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, declared yesterday in reply to a statement issued by Dr. Albert Degener, secretary of the Board of Trade for German-American Commerce, but is the direct result of "the hampering effects of Dr. Hjalmar Schacht's import restrictions."

Mr. Harriman's analysis was in answer to Dr. Degener's charge that while figures published by the Anti-Nazi League, showing that the Reich has suffered appreciably from the boycott, are perhaps correct, they fail to show the

## **Announces Strictly Anti-Jewish Plank in His Program**

**WASHINGTON, Jan. 22.**—For the first time in the history of this nation the doctrine of anti-Semitism will be put to an open national political test, it was revealed today when Louis T. McFadden, fanatical bigot whose Pennsylvania constituency repudiated him at the polls last November after he had served twenty years in Congress, announced his candidacy for President of the United States in 1936.

"Keep the Jew out of control of the Republican party" is the slogan under which McFadden will strive to achieve the supreme honor owed to an American citizen.

His organization has its headquarters here at the Mayflower Hotel, where the National Conference for Palestine just concluded its sessions yesterday.

John T. McAndrews, McFadden's director of publicity, who in the past has been an associate of James P. True, head of America First and white hope of many anti-Semites in this country, is secretary of the National Conference. He has a platform designed to appeal to any one with a spark of anti-Jewish prejudice in his bosom.

Over 40,000,000 Christian Gentiles won't be wrong in 1938" the McFadden-for-President stationery proclaims. The former Pennsylvania Congressman's "1936 platform" is simple and brief. It has only four planks: "Christianity instead of Judaism; Americanism against

## Canadians Elect Freimanto Head Zionists Again

### Closing Session Adopts Many Resolutions on Vital Problems

(Special to the J.D.B.)

TORONTO, Ont., Jan. 22.—A. J. Freiman, for many years president of the Canadian Zionist Organization, was re-elected last night at the closing session of the twenty-fourth annual Zionist convention held at the Royal York Hotel here.

The convention adopted resolutions reaffirming its conviction of the principle of organized Jewish labor for Jewish enterprises; determined to petition the Jewish Agency for a larger allotment of chulutzim pioneer certificates; protested against the Nazi regime; voted support for the Bhabonim organization; voted to establish agricultural training centers for Canadian youth; expressed confidence in the Canadian Jewish Congress; went on record as opposing a legislative council in Palestine; and the Canadian Zionist Executive for bringing peace between Zionist factions.

A. M. Shimbane, Mr. Levine and H. S. Rosenberg were elected vice-presidents; the Canadian Zionists, while Joseph Fineberg was elected treasurer.

In answer to a question put to him before the closing of the convention, Mr. Freiman declared that Vladimir Jabotinsky, Revisionist leader, was "not a Zionist."

"I do not recognize Jabotinsky as a Zionist," Mr. Freiman said, "since he broke the discipline of the World Zionist Congress."

## Johnson Lauds Jews in NRA in Reply to Critics

### Appointments Made Regardless of Religion, General Writes

In discussing his much publicized quarrel with Donald Richberg in an article in this week's Saturday Evening Post, General Hugh S. Johnson, former NRA head, not only ridicules the charge that he had appointed too many Jews to office, but takes occasion to praise his Jewish subordinates in highest terms for their ability and loyalty.

After telling how Mr. Richberg was appointed and the criticism levelled at him for his choice, General Johnson says: "It was also asserted that I had appointed too many Jews to important posts, and Mr. Richberg was cited against me on that score too.

"Just for the sake of record, Mr. Richberg is not a Jew. If he had been, it would have made no difference to me. I tried to get the best staff I could persuade to serve, and I did not stop to inquire about whether they were Jews or Gentiles. I had several capable Jews, but they were a very scant minority and every single one of them did an outstanding job. Not one was either disloyal or self-seeking."

Communism; Nationalism against Individualism; and Individualism instead of Collectivism (the spelling is McCadden's).

The only clear facts to be gleaned from the McCadden publicity are that the Pennsylvanian would like to be elected President in 1936 and that he doesn't like Jews.

Otherwise, despite the many thousands of words contained in the announcement of his candidacy, McCadden becomes slightly obscure.

For instance, the organization which actually is electing him is variously referred to as the "Independent Republican National Gentile Committee" and the "Christian Economic Independent Republican National Committee."

"His attacks on the Jews testify between denouncing them as incorrigible Communists and as grasping capitalists.

"Jewish Plot" to the Fore

"The Committee consists of both Catholics and Protestants, with a potential membership of many millions, is most desirous of placing every man, woman and child in America's entrance into World Court of the League of Nations," his blurb states.

"The Christians of this great country are suspicious of the aims and object of both the League of Nations and the World Court, and every man, woman and child do believe, that these two parliamentary units are nothing more or less than a plan of world domination to enslave the entire world. . . .

"Regardless of what the Jewish rulers press this plan to convey to the Christian people that we can still adhere to the principals of the Monroe Doctrine, we fully know on the contrary, that by becoming a member of this international court, we immediately lose our identity as a nation and forfeit our pride and self-respect.

"Spirit" of the Founders

"If you forgive me if I have the audacity to say that the spirit of our forefathers in conveying to you a thought which is at present uppermost in my mind is the spirit of the Declaration of Independence, was founded and developed by a persecuted people and those people did not happen to be Jews but Americans, and that the descendants of these people, who are still in a majority (over one hundred million strong), were the framers of the great Declaration of Independence who guaranteed to us freedom of speech, freedom of the press and above all, freedom of religion, which Christians will defend with our lives as our forefathers did in 1776.

"The Jewish element are today in complete control of the press and the radio but they cannot, and never will, control the conscience of our great American Christian leaders and it is through these very people that we, the above committee, intend to carry your rights against any Congressman or Senator who will dare insult us by taking part participation in the selection of a President.

"So we may place you on record, will be you kind enough to inform this committee at your earliest possible moment, what your own convictions are regarding this un-American amendment which is now

## Syracuse Boys Stage Colorful Pageant Based on Maccabiad

SYRACUSE, Jan. 22.—A miniature Maccabiad, modeled after the famous Palestinian games, inspired widespread comment in Jewish circles here today.

Developed as an educational project at the Jewish Community Center during the last three years, the games were opened with a pageant of the boys' club teams participating in the meet.

Among the tableaux which they depicted were sailors at Tel Aviv, Palestine, throwing a lifeline to German refugees; the industrialization of Haifa; the opening of the "Gates of Hope" to Jewish

settlers, and representative types of Jerusalem people.

A tree-planting ceremony symbolic of the afforestation program of the Jewish National Fund was participated in by Boy Scouts. The bugler of the center's troop blew taps during the planting of a tree provided by the New York State College of Forestry in memory of the late Louis Marshall.

The annual roll call of the center will bring Rabbi Milton Steinberg of the Park Avenue Synagogue, New York City, here Thursday evening as guest speaker. Rabbi Steinberg will talk on "The Making of the Modern Jew."

They were over in New Jersey, laying plans for the complete disruption of the Schuch clique.

Edmondson Hooks on to Wagon

Robert Edward Edmondson, "Investment economist" who peddles anti-Semites at a penny a pamphlet from his dingy office in the Wall Street district, gave a rousing cheer in his cracked voice when he was told that McCadden is in the ring.

"He gets my support until a better man comes along," said Edmondson, who said that he has in his opinion better men than McCadden are few and far between.

And so it went all down the anti-Semitic line. The opinion was generally expressed that at last the forces of hatred and ignorance have a common banner under which they can unite and for the first time show their true strength in the United States.

## Vote for Jews Is in Doubt, Frick Declares

Nazi Official Tells Hearst Man Rights Depend on the Future

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN.—Dr. Wilhelm Frick, Minister of the Interior, is reported by the Voelkischer Beobachter to have told a correspondent for the Hearst newspapers that the question of whether the Jews will be permitted freely to exercise the suffrage depends on "the further shaping of State citizen rights in the German Reich."

"The general, equal, direct and secret suffrage will continue to remain valid," Dr. Frick told the correspondent, according to the Voelkischer Beobachter, "in both sexes of all German State citizens."

According to the principles formulated for the National Socialist party by Reichsfuehrer Hitler, only Germans may be citizens, and only those are German who are of German "Aryan" blood.

"The German Reich is a National State at whose head stands the Leader and Chancellor, Adolf Hitler," Dr. Frick is reported to have said. "His appointment as Reich Chancellor was confirmed by the German nation in a general and secret plebiscite on August 19, 1934, by ninety per cent of the voters."

New Constitution Withheld

The correspondent asked whether there was any intention to give Germany a new Constitution. Dr. Frick's reply was as follows: "The Fuehrer and Reich Chancellor, Adolf Hitler, after he assumed power on January 30, 1933, deliberately held back from consolidating his position immediately through a ready-made Constitution."

"Nor did Adolf Hitler need that, for he himself was at the head of the National Socialist revolution. This movement embraced the entire German nation, and carried through the ideas of Adolf Hitler, who is the creator of the National Socialist movement and of its program."

"Today the government is working to realize the inner political principles of the National Socialist State conception, and is completing along the legal road the new upbuilding of the Reich."

Plan New Charter

"Thus, there is growing organically with advancing development day by day a new bit of the Constitution, and at the conclusion of the four-year term asked for by the Leader, the work will then complete—at least in its rough."

"The German nation will exist have the opportunity to express itself with regard to it."

Dr. Frick has been one of the most violent anti-Semites in the Nazi movement, of which he has been a leader almost from the start, being an order of the year ago which instructed the chief administrative officers of the Reich and the governors of the several states to send the Jews out of the lawfully engaged in business were not molested by Nazi zealots.

He first gave Germany a taste of what National Socialism's rule of law would be like when, as Minister of Education in Thuringia, he introduced anti-Semitic parables as part of the program in the public schools.

Addressing a mass meeting at Chemnitz last month, Dr. Frick warned that the Hitler regime will never relax in its application of the "Aryan paragraph" to the Jews.

"Germany is for the Germans,"

he said, "and no difficulties will divert us from exerting our efforts in this direction."

In September, 1933, it was Dr. Frick who issued instructions that "non-Aryan" Jews all persons of Jewish descent, even though their forefathers never belonged to the Jewish religious community, and also even if the father or forefather was a convert to the Christian religion.

Just one year ago he urged haste in eliminating Jews all persons in public positions, referring to them as "undesirable elements."

## A Revised Constitution

The expected happened. The Polish Senate yesterday adopted the revised Polish constitution abolishing the proportional representation system. The result is that henceforth Jews will have practically no chance for election to the Polish Parliament as Jewish representatives.

The Jewish population in Poland ten per cent of the entire population will thus have to remain mute. Having no representative in the Parliament it will no longer be in a position to voice its grievances except through the Yiddish press.

Little as the Jewish deputies in the Polish Parliament could influence Polish politics, their voices nevertheless were embarrassing to the government. The present address delivered by the Polish President in which he pictured Jewish privation in Poland and criticized the government for the heavy taxation system, has not yet been forgotten by many in Poland and abroad. The same truth with regard to the Poland delivered recently by Deputy Rotenshteyn.

Now, with the voting system changed, the Polish government will be spared any further such embarrassing addresses. With no Jews in the Parliament the Jewish question can hardly come up for discussion there.

The fact that the Polish Jews will be able to voice their plight only through the Yiddish press, their remaining channel for reaching the world abroad is little consolation. Everybody knows that the Yiddish press in Poland is thoroughly censored although no official censorship exists in Poland.

The full text of the revised Polish constitution is not yet obtainable. It is therefore difficult to say at the present moment whether the paragraphs in the old constitution concerning the protection of the minority rights have also been protected. It is reasonable to assume that the Polish national minority obligations, Colonel Beck, Polish Minister of Foreign Affairs, declared last September in Geneva that these international obligations are not necessary for the Polish state. They are guaranteed by the Polish constitution. It is, therefore, to be hoped that Col. Beck's statement will be substantiated also by the new constitution.

Not in the past several hundred years have the Jews of Europe found themselves in the precarious position they are in today. A somewhat similar fate confronted them at the beginning of the World War, when the Grand Duke Nicolaï Nicolaïvitch, uncle of the late Czar, caused the expulsion of thousands of Jews from their homes on the borderland. But then there was the consolation and hope that the outcome of the war would bring them freedom, since it was believed that the minority nations everywhere would be granted the right to self-determination. The sad fact that in the World War Russia allied itself with the democracies of France, England, and latterly also of America, tended to strengthen the belief that the redemption of the Jews in the lands of the Galut was near and of Jews from their homes on the borderland.

## Hope Seems Likely To Be Realized

Indeed at the beginning it seemed as though the hope would be fulfilled. Thanks to the efforts of the representatives of the "Committee of Jewish Delegations" in Paris, there were written into the Peace Treaties which guaranteed the political-national rights of all minority peoples. We, the Jewish parliamentarians, in collaboration with the Paris Committee headed by the late Dr. Motzkin, continued to press our demand for the protection of Jewish rights. At the Congresses of the Friends of the League of Nations we succeeded to rally about that demand some 40,000,000 people, and the Jewish question was always prominently placed at these Congresses. We have likewise utilized in our struggle the League of the Friends of the League of Nations. We left those Congresses with the conviction

As for the Jews, everything since tended to drag history back to the Dark Ages.

## Situation Has Ironic Aspect

The cruel irony of the situation is that the Jews, who were the process of the elimination of the Jew began already with the post-war period, when the world was rebuilding the waste places caused by the war, and all the historical achievements of the Jews in the realms of the arts, literature, science, economy, commerce, and industry were thought forgotten.

The economic policy of the general European countries led to the total annihilation of the Jew through the creation of state monopolies, cooperatives, where Jews are not employed, and the promulgation of such special rules and regulations for the carrying on of import-export trade as the Jew is unable to meet.

## Jews Are Driven From Professions

Equally ruthless is the policy to eliminate the Jew from the free professions, such as medicine, law, engineering and architecture. The physicians are unceremoniously thrown out from the city hospitals, thus cutting them off from government subsidies.

sidy. The lawyers are first presented with unusual requirements for the practice of law, and afterwards they are ordered to the small provinces where they can hardly eke out an existence. The engineers and architects and chemists are summoned down from government and municipal positions, while the artisan and laborer, too, are continually harassed and limited in their pursuit for a livelihood. And everywhere in the schools there is a numerous classmate for Jews.

## Struggle for Rights Goes On Everywhere

Thus the Jewish position in Germany, Austria, Hungary, Roumania, Poland, Lithuania and other lands. With the exception of Germany, which I have avoided due to the boycott, I have recently visited every one of the above-mentioned countries, and our Paris Committee has been constantly receiving information from all of them.

The Jews of all lands are struggling today for their rights. We have always known that our lot is organically bound up with the lot of Democracy, and that there where Democracy is in jeopardy, Jewish rights, too, are in jeopardy. Unfortunately, the democracies and parliamentary governments generally have been replaced in many Eastern European countries by reactionary governments, Fascist dictatorship. And if in Soviet Russia Jews are not suffering as Jews, religion, Hebrew and Zionism are nevertheless persecuted, and the Jewish people are the victims of the Communist Party.

## Problem Is Where To Find Assistance

Unfortunately, European Jewry is not in a position to help itself. What then shall we do of them? Who shall intervene, and who shall champion Jewish rights?

Already in 1931, at a conference following the Zionist Congress, called at the initiative of the American Jewish Congress, there was brought up the question of creating a united Jewish World Organization, founded on democratic principles, and endowed with the privilege of championing our rights before the whole world. A presidium of six was then elected, consisting of Dr. Motzkin, Dr. Wengrowitz, S. Deutsch, Isaac Greenbaum, Oscar Kahn and myself. It was then that the idea of a World Jewish Congress was first formulated. During the years 1932, 1933 and 1934, at the conferences held at Geneva, participated in by prominent Jewish leaders of all nationalities and representatives of associations and orders, the decision to call a World Congress was unanimously reached.

## Appeals for Central Aid Headquarters

As recently as November, 1934, I witnessed a session of the American Jewish Congress, the accredited leaders of Polish Jewry sat, participated, and they were all strongly for the calling of a World Jewish Congress. The same sentiment prevailed in Roumania, Austria, Lithuania, the countries of the Balkan peninsula and the countries of the East and in England, all Jews who hail from Eastern Europe are for the Congress, and with them is also a large number of Jews who hail from Western Europe. The vote of the Alliance Israelite was equally divided on the question, and so was the vote of the Central Jewish Council.

Some of the most powerful individuals and groups in the United States hold that unless the United States enters the League of Nations, the world's peace machinery will function properly.

Whether the movement to bring America into the League of Nations is for the good or not, the propaganda carried on by the Independent Republican Party that "the League is a tool in the hands of world Jewry" will be the effect of this thinking person. In the light of the recent action of the League with regard to the Jews in the Soviet Union, it is not surprising that the League of Nations is controlled by Jews."

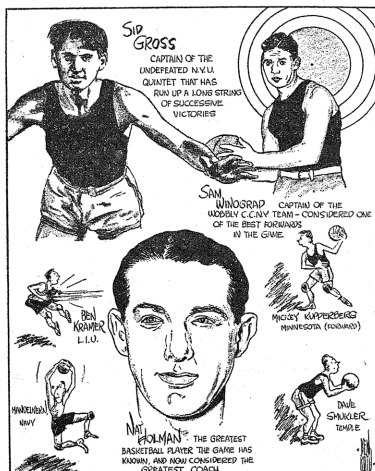

flower racket. Today, as in the last ten years, there are many Jewish lads among the top-notchers and headliners, but very few among the prelin boys. This is, we believe, due to the fact that the Jewish lads have the correct slant on the boxing game. As long as the public was willing to reward leading fighters with huge purses, the boys were willing to stand up to the snaf in the ring.

### Boxing Sense

The scarcity of Jewish fighters in the amateur and prelin ranks is due to this boxing sense. Having spoken to more than a dozen of fair-to-middling fighters who quit the ring, we are sure of it. These lads were willing to serve an apprenticeship before galleries partly filled with disinterested spectators who had come early to secure choice seats. They were willing to wait their turn in preliminaries for very little money but for necessary experience and prestige. But, if the first three or four fights disclosed that they were not good enough to climb out of this class, they were the first to recognize their shortcomings and quit while the quitting was good.

Parental objection had to do somewhat with their quitting also. However, whatever the reasons for this, we believe that the mere fact that so few Jewish boxers are in the amateur and preliminary ranks of the fight game is a healthy sign. There is nothing more pitiable than a punch-drunk fighter who refuses to quit or who cannot afford to drop out of the game.

### Jews on Big Ten Fives

The Western Conference basketball season, according to a Spokesman flash, clicked into high gear last week with more Jewish play-ers participating on their respective quints than ever before in the history of the game. Ten Jews of Big Ten teams are either regulars or substitutes. Sid Rosenthal is considered the outstanding man of the lot. He is a regular forward on the University of Iowa five. Speedy and shifty, Rosenthal played on the

mental part in the first three victories of his team. He is third high scorer in the Western conference league. The Iowa campus paper relates that Rosenthal is exceptionally useful to speed up Iowa's offense against a tiring team. He is very aggressive, a swift dribbler and an excellent passer. He is a junior, and won his letter last year as a soph. His hall from Marshall High School in Chicago, where he starred in three sports. He is five feet seven and weighs 145 pounds.

### Others Named

Another Jewish boy at Iowa is Dr. Schwartz, a junior forward, who has seen but little experience this season because of a slight leg injury. He hails from Dubuque. At Michigan Jack Trottenbach is the only member of the quintet. Milt Rosenthal and Jack Grossberg are bearing the Purple of Northwestern into the basketball wars. Stan Kaplan and Bob Weiss are two prominent members of the Chicago five. Both are guards. And of course, Mickey Kupperberg and Eddie Steizer are the New York representatives on the Minnesota basketball tournament. Abe Mitchell is the sole Jewish player with the fighting Illini.

### Nazis Out to Spur Interest in Declining Party Organs

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Jan. 22.—Alarm by the rapid and steady decline in the daily circulation of Nazi party papers, leaders today launched a week-long drive to spur interest in their leading newspapers.

That the Nazis have cause to worry is revealed by their own official figures, showing that the circulation of the Volkischer Beobachter, No. 1 Nazi paper, has dropped from 359,760 to 326,537 since September, 1934. The Angriff, mouthpiece of Propaganda Minister Goebbels, has only 58,000 out of its former 100,000 readers left. In the last two months the paper lost 15,000 readers.

## Flood Brings Malaria Fear To Colonies

Mosquitoes May Breed in Stagnant Pools in Upper Sharon

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) HEDERA, Palestine.—Pools of stagnant water on what was formerly waste land at Umm Khald, Hanoun and Zamin are causing concern among inhabitants of the Northern Sharon plain, who fear the possibility of a malaria epidemic.

Malaria mosquitoes begin to breed in February. Water also has collected in other places as a result of floods early this month, and authorities are being urged to take immediate steps toward drainage.

### Bus Service Curtailed

Business and building activities may be seriously retarded if Summer visitors are discouraged from going to the Nathania seaside resort.

Anticipating failure in government repair of the Nathania-Tulkarem road, the Nathania Settlement Council has sent out gangs of laborers to mend the worst sections.

Only two buses are being run daily between Tel Aviv and Nathania, since a single trip requires from five to eight hours under present conditions. Normally five buses, each of which makes the journey in two hours, are run. The three company threatens to suspend service entirely until repairs are made.

## Vienna Firm Announces A New Herz Biography

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA.—A new and definitive biography of Dr. Theodor Herzl by the Jewish scholar Dr. Alexander Bain will be published shortly by the Pöhl Publishing Company announced.

The book is a full-dress biography of the life and career of Dr. Herzl in 650 pages and with ninety illustrations.

## Hadassah to Sponsor Lectures on Palestine

A series of ten lecture-tours on "Modern Life in Palestine" was announced yesterday by Mrs. Samuel Inselsbuch, chairman of the educational committee of the New York chapter of Hadassah, as part of the women Zionist group's cultural program.

The first lecture is scheduled for this afternoon at the Nueces-decort Street Y. M. H. A., with Charles Cowen speaking. Dr. David de Souza Pool will lecture at the Seia Pool on February 6.

## Amman Resident Seeks Wide Power

Col. Cox Will Remain in Transjordan if He Is Permitted to Halt Economic Debacle

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, Jan. 22.—Lieut. Col. Charles H. F. Cox, British resident in Amman, Transjordan, has consented to remain at his post only on condition that he be given wide political power to enable him to remedy the trying economic condition in which the territory finds itself.

As British resident, Col. Cox could only advise Emir Abdullah, ruler of the area, and had no power to enforce his advice. While Palestine is enjoying the greatest prosperity in its history, Transjordan is in a bad financial state.

Jacob Ezekiel addressed President Tyler on the importance of referring to the American nation as a "Christian people" as he had done on the occasion of the death of William Henry Harrison. In a private reply President Tyler conceded that suggestions of sectarianism are irrelevant in public documents.

## Greek Agitator Gets Jail Term For Race Attack

### Editor of Makedonia Was Involved in Salonica Pogrom of '31

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

SALONICA, Jan. 22.—The notable Greek anti-Semite, a pastor, Fardis, editor of Makedonia, most violent anti-Jewish paper in Greece, was sentenced today to serve four months in jail for having written a series of anti-Jewish articles in a new paper, Elepheros.

Under his editorship Makedonia, organ of the Greek Jewish community, constantly incited the population of Salonica against the Jews. On several occasions Makedonia succeeded in arousing actual pogrom sentiment in Salonica, necessitating posting of heavy guards around the Jewish quarter.

Fardis was accused of having instigated the brutal pogrom of 1931, which led to the burning of the entire Jewish quarter by anti-Semites. He was later released for lack of evidence.

Subsequent to his release, Fardis offered to give one of the Salonica Jewish newspapers' the names of all those who took part in the actual pogrom on payment of 1,000 drachmas.

tended that not a single one of the purchasers of stock named in the indictment has appeared to prosecute the defendants.

Bertha Altus, it was said, was the only one actually brought into court and she denied she bought stock, but said she donated the money to the Pelley enterprises and was later given the stock when she asked for it.

Ford told the jury that the North Carolina "blue sky" law specifically declared it did not condemn isolated sales of stock and that unless the state proved the defendants made a practice of selling stock in North Carolina they are guiltless.

The state insisted that the state's evidence regarding the alleged insolvency of the Galahad Press had been effectively controverted.

boomerang effect the trade ban is having on this country.

"It is absurd to complain that America does not sell to Germany when such sales are hedged about with restrictions that seal the German market, when an embargo has been declared that blocks payment and debt service, and when Germany has demonstrated herself a poor credit risk by out-and-out repudiation of obligations," Mr. Harriman points out.

**Boycott Aid to U. S. Industry**  
"Far from being illegal, as Dr. Degener charges, the use of the boycott is specifically sanctioned by the League of Nations, and is the chief means of enforcement of the NRA contemplated by the American government."

Taking up Dr. Degener's allegation that the boycott has been injurious to all classes of American working men, Mr. Harriman continues:

"The boycott has been a stimulus to American industry. Our own government has had a part in the creation domestically of many items formerly imported from Germany. They are now

made here and provide work for thousands."

Dr. Degener in his statement accused the Anti-Nazi League of omitting figures for the second half of 1934, which he said would disclose "the catastrophic and deplorable shrinkage in American exports to Germany. Mr. Harriman's answer to this follows:

Answers Degener

"These figures were not available at the time our survey was made. Yesterday they were made public in The New York Times in a signed article from Berlin by Mr. Otto D. Follschus. Now for the first time the figures have been made public and they only serve to reinforce our contention and even increase the estimate we made in our survey of the effectiveness of the boycott."

In conclusion the anti-Nazi league secretary says:

"Samuel Untermyer, president of the . . . League and of the World Council, supplied the German government with a list of the requirements that will have to be met before the civilized world will suspend the Anti-Nazi boycott. Perhaps the time is not far off when instead of squealing that the boycott pinches, the Hitler regime will consider the wisdom of restoring the forfeited human liberties which have provoked such measures."

day have received permits to enter France from the Saar, it was announced today by Eduard Heriot, the French Minister, in reporting to the Cabinet on the situation of the Saar refugees. Mr. Heriot estimated that at least 2,000 Saar citizens already are finding refuge on French territory. The number of visas issued since the Saar plebiscite was estimated by the Minister at 8,000, of which more than half are held by people still in the Saar but ready to leave the region as soon as they liquidate their belongings there.

Jewish organizations. The left wing Jewish bodies opposing the appointment of Daniel Auster as vice-mayor of Jerusalem continued to insist today that Auster must resign from his post even before he is inaugurated. On the other hand, the Jewish groups supporting Auster flatly declined to agree to Auster's giving up the vice-mayorship voluntarily.

The Palestine government, which has appointed Mr. Auster to the vice-mayorship, thus far has not taken sides in the issue. It is understood, however, that the government does not intend to cancel Auster's appointment unless Auster himself withdraws from the post to which he was appointed.

The Yaad Leumi, Jewish National Council of Palestine, while it is not supporting Auster's appointment, today began negotiations with the Sephardic-Jewish group to vote for Haim Solomon, the Jewish rival of Auster. The Sephardic-Jewish groups have been siding with Auster throughout the dispute.
