Reich Press Reports New Jewish Policy

States Repressive Acts Will End; Observers Are Skeptical

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, Feb. 28.—The policy advocated by Dr. Hjalmar Schacht, Minister of Economics, to modify the anti-Jewish agitation in Nazi Germany, received further impetus today when the Nazi press published a report that "nothing more will be undertaken against the Jews in Germany" in view of the fact that the government does not wish to complicate matters abroad.

At the same time Dr. Schacht informed the Berlin Merchants Association today that no further discriminations would be practiced against its members, many of whom are Jewish.

Would Regain Lost Jobs

These new trends in the Nazi titude towards the Jews does not mean that Jews will be restored to their rights or that they will be reinstated in state and municipal jobs from which they were ousted under the "Aryan" parawas explained here today, remains fully in force. It is only in commerce that Jews will be permitted to continue their activities undis-

American circles here are skeptical as to the sincerity of the Nazi authorities in their talk of easing their anti-Jewish policy. The opinjon which prevails in the American colony here is that Dr. Schacht's move can be explained only by the fact that Germany is greatly af-(Continued on Page Four)

Protocols Trial In Switzerland Put Off Again

Now Slated for April 29; Nazi Defendants Unprepared

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERNE, Feb. 28.—Resumption of the trial against the Nazis in Switzerland for spreading the notorious "Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion" has been post-poned again, this time to April 29. it was announced here today. The trial was scheduled to be resumed in the middle of March.

The delay was due to the fact that Colonel Ulrich Fleischhauer, who has been called in by the Nazi defense as its expert, as well as other Nazi experts who are to appear at the trial are not yet ready with their material.

Meanwhile the Federation of Jewish Communities in Switzerland is collecting new data to prove that the "Protocois" are a forgery used by the Nazis in their anti-Jewish propaganda all over the world and originally disseminated by the Czarist government for the purpose of fomenting anti-Semitism.

It is believed here that the Nazis are trying to drag out the case in order to weaken the interest which the non-Jewish press all over the world has exhibited to-

Will Maintain High Taxes In Poland

WARSAW, Feb. 28. — Poland's policy of overtaxing the city population while imposing low taxes on the peasant population - a policy which has seriously affected Jewish existence in Poland-will have

village population against the city population is essential in order to increase the prices on farm products and to eliminate the middle-man," the Minister explained.

Must Pay Arrears

Vaida - Voevod Resumes Drive Against Jews

Ex-Premier of Rumania **Urges Lower Ranking** as Citizens

BUCHAREST, Feb. 28.-A vigrous campaign to force a change in the Rumanian constitution by which national minorities in Rumania would be declared second class citizens was launched today by Dr. Vaida-Voevod, former premier and a leader of the National Peasant party.

nis anti-Jewish sentiments, demands that the Rumanian constitution be modified in such a way as to introduce difference in citizenship types, in accordance with the ethnical origin of the citizens. Such a modification would mean that the Jews and other minorities in Rumania would be classified as citizens of a lower grade.

The change demanded by Dr. Vaida-Voevod would empower the government to establish quotas for Jews and other national minorities in all occupations and in the professions. The Jews will then officially be restricted, not only as far as employment in government positions is concerned, but even in private enterprizes.

A delegation of prominent Transylvanians, among whom Dr. Vaida-Voevod has great influence, arrived in Bucharest today to urge the government to effect the changes as soon as possible.

Spread Leaflet Charging Hauptmann Victim of 'Ritual Murder'

Anti-Jewish circulars stating that "the Jews have sentenced Hauptmann" and that the Hauptmann sentence is "a Jewish ritual murder" were distributed here yesterday by unknown persons, presumably members of local Nazi organizations, which on Wednesday launched a campaign in Yorkville Casino to obtain funds for releasing Hauptmann.

"Germans and Americans, awake!" the circular proclaims. 'German compatriots, wake up and see in the Hauptmann sentence the hand of the all-powerful Jew in America. A German has been condemned to death on the basis of false testimony.'

The circular charges that Attorney General Wilentz used arguments to influence the jury which fully coincide with certain sayings of the Talmud.

Punitive Nazi Troop Set to Enter Saar

Jews in Fear as Transfer Preparations Are Completed

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) SAARBRUECKEN, Feb. 28.-Considerable apprehension was felt today among the Jews of Saarbruecken, on the eve of turning the Saar over to Germany, in connection with a report that a special force of Nazi S. S. men is stationed in Frankfort ready to enter the Saar tomorrow for the purpose of "coordinating population."

Final preparations for the transfer were made here today by Geoffrey Knox, British Commissioner appointed by the League of Nations for the Saar. Mr. Knox will hand over his powers tomorrow to Joseph Buerkel, the Nazi Commissioner appointed by Hitler to administrate the Saar when it becomes a part of the Reich. The ceremony of transferring authority to Herr Buerkel will take place at eleven o'clock in the morning in the presence of Baron Pompeo Aloisi, chairman of the League of Nations Saar Committee.

Preparations for celebrating the reunion with Germany are being made today all over the Saar territory. Celebrations will start tomorrow with parades throughout all Saar towns, featured by contingents of Hitler Youth and members of the Nazi party. School children will be excused from classes in order to participate in the street celebrations.

Children of Exiles—Berg Is 50

= By Our Paris Correspondent =

Of all the tragic consequences that have followed in the wake of Herr Hitler's rise to power, there is none more poignant than the flight of the thousands of Germans who were forced to flee to foreign countries.

Consisting of pacifists, Socialists and Jews, this new Legion of the Lost-it is estimated to number at least 70,000-is scattered throughout the capitals of Europe, and the situation for them is daily growing more precarious.

Almost without exception these "enemies of the Nazi State" are not permitted to work in the country that shelters them, and they are therefore dependent on char-

Today in London, Paris, Brussels, Amsterdam, Praha, Copenhagen, Zurich and Madrid you can find German refugees, solitary or in families, who are living in the last stages of destitution.

You may see in Paris men who were once judges, lawyers, doctors, or professors selling matches and bootlaces or canvassing for orders in mean streets.

The plight of the exiles' children is, perhaps, more poignant.

Some of the children remember Germany and a happy childhood there before the Nazis came to

Others came into the world as exiles; born by mothers who were half-starved, weary, and desperate.

These children at least are innocent. They know nothing of Nazi or Communist, Gentile or Jew. Yet to the Nazis they are as "unclean" as their parents-and so become objects of slow persecution. Not enough milk: insufficient clothing; no shoes and stockings: these are the commonplace of their little

Public assistance, in most civilized countries, supplies these elementary wants to the poorest child -but not to the refugee child. He is an alien, and the State has no obligation towards him.

Parents and children must remain pent in the towns, terribly overcrowded in furnished rooms. They live huddled together-four, five, and six sleeping and living in a single room.

Brave efforts to relieve the situation in the French capital have been made in recent months by a band of German emigrants themselves, mainly young social workers and physicians.

They formed the "Assistance Aux Enfants d'Emigrees" about a year ago, starting work without financial means or backing.

Swiss and British institutions. especially the Society of Friends, supported them; and, through their efforts, hundreds of children have been saved from tuberculosis and

He tries to justify these dismissals by saying that they were necessary "in order to eliminate the Socialists." He thus wishes to create the impression that all the dismissed Jewish doctors are radi-

to cloak its anti-Jewish action

Such an explanation is not only hypocritical but it is directly anti-Semitic. To assert that several hundred Jewish doctors were dismissed because of the drive against Socialists is like Hitler's alleging that all the Jews are Communists.

A Misleading Explanation

Those who know the situation in Austria know very well that Schuschnigg's explanation is, mildly speaking, very misleading. On more than one occasion Jewish leaders in Austria-leaders who are combatting Socialism just as Dr. Schuschnigg ishave protested against the epidemic dismissals of Jews in Austrian medical institutions because of their racial descent. On more than one occasion it was emphasized that the discharged Jewish doctors were being replaced by non-Jewish doctors only. More than once, the Jews have protested against the introduction of a question about the race and religion of applicants in the application blanks for government positions.

When Dr. Schuschnigg declares that the Jewish doctors in Austria have been dismissed because of Socialism and for no anti-Semitic reasons, one can easily challenge this assertion by asking why not a single Jewish doctor was employed in place of those discharged. Are there no Jewish doctors in Austria who are not Socialists?

Cynical Advice

The same hypocrisy which is noticed in Dr. Schuschnigg's explanation about the dismissal of Jewish doctors is also noticeable in the excuse which he gives as to why the authorities in Austria do not suppress the dangerous anti-Jewish propaganda conducted and financed by the Nazis from Germany. Dr. Schuschnigg advises the Jews to combat this propaganda through their own Jewish press. "The Jews," he says, "have a right in Austria to hold public meetings and can reply publicly to the charges made against them by anti-

Jewish publications." This cynical advice, oming as it does from the head of the Austrian state, is worth remembering by those Jews who still believe in the possibility of reaching some kind of an understanding with the present rulers of Austria. The same Dr. Schuschnigg did not hesitate for a second to suppress the Nazi press in Austria when it was agitating for a reunion with Nazi Germany. He did not hesitate to close down Austrian newspapers which criticized the present state of affairs in Austria. But when it comes to curbing the anti-Jewish propaganda, this very same Dr. Schuschnigg directly encourages this propa-

World Press Digest

Caustic Comment On Reich Censorships

Editor and Publisher, newspaper trade journal, commenting upon the censorship in Nazi Germany, says in a recent editorial:

With all their skill and equipment American and English correspondents could not penetrate the fog of propaganda, deliberate falsehood of public officials, sealed courts and all the rest of the infamous set-up which has as its purpose the entrenchment of weird men in the role of rulers of one of the world's great peoples. Modern history holds no comparable chapter of national degeneracy. Grotesque Hitler leers between the lines of every Berlin despatch. His only service to mankind could be to illustrate the horror which is inherent in fascism.

Says Hitler Follows Bismarck on Jews

The Birkenhead News, a daily published in Birkenhead, England comments on Hitler's policy with regard to the Jews as follows:

Just as Bismarck used the Jew fifty years ago as the scapegoat for the establishment of his policy, so Hitler was using the Jew in exactly the same manner today. The Jew had been the scapegoat that had been sacrificed on the altar of Germany's national calamity for the sake of demagogic politicians. For 2,000 years the story of the Jew had been the most tragic thing in the history of mankind. Must it continue forever to be so? He did not believe it. He believed with a perfect faith that the time would come when it would cease, but he also believed that it would not come of itself. "You and I will have to help in the consummation of that glorious future," he said. "I think one of the best ways of combating group prejudices in general, and anti-Semitism in particular, is through education."

Tells Why Jews Are Oppressed

The New English Weekly, a British publication, commenting on the "Jewish Questions," says:

The Jewish question is a national, not a race question. That is to say, the Jews are an oppressed nationality in precisely the same way as the Irish, the Indians or the Koreans. The only difference between them and these other nations is that they have not one but a number of oppressors, owing to their pecu-

ganda by stating that the Jews, and not the government, should combat it.

Good for the Nazis

One can easily imagine how happy the Nazis in Austria will be to read Dr. Schuschnigg's advice to the Jews to handle the Nazis all by themselves. Such advice is nothing but a definite indication that the government is actually not interested in protecting its Jewish citizens from libelous, slanderous and dangerous incitement.

Dr. Schuschnigg's statement makes clear that there is no hope for the Jews in Austria under the present regime. A different statement would probably have been made by Dr. Schuschnigg if the Jews of the world were to adopt towards Austria the same open and outspoken method they have adopted towards Nazi Germany.



Shklovsky Is Dead In London at 80

Anglo-Jewish Journalist Used Pen Name 'Dionee'; Born in Russia

LONDON, Feb. 28. - I. W. Shklovsky, internationally known Anglo Jewish journalist who wrote under the pen-name of "Dionee," died here today. He was eighty years old.

Shklovsky was born in Russia and was considered one of the best foreign journalists. Prior to the Soviet Revolution he worked in London as the correspondent of the famous liberal Moscow daily, Russkia Vedomosti, which was very influential and was considered the mouthpiece of the Russian intelligentsia. He also contributed to many Russian monthly publications. His writing on England were always considered the most authentic and the best in-

After the revolution Shklovsky worked for a number of Russian publications published outside of Russia and also for British newspapers. He also contributed to the New York Jewish monthly magazine. Die Zukunft.

ROME, Feb. 28. — The charge that the German Nazis are busy fomenting anti-Jewish agitation in Palestine, in cooperation with the Mufti and with the former mayor of Jerusalem, Ragheb Bey Nashashibi, is made today in the Osservatore Romano, the official organ of the Vatican.

The circular cites many quotations from Der Stuermer, the notorious Jew-baiting publication of Julius Streicher, published in Nuremburg and condemned by the entire civilized world.

"Germans and Americans awake!" the leaflet exhorts. "The eleventh hour has struck. Don't wait until the twelfth hour begins. It will then be too late for you. You may then find yourselves in the Jewish Communist World Collective. The sentence issued in Flemington is but a consequence of what is going on in Washington, Albany and New Jerusalem (say New York)," the proclamation says, attacking Bernard Baruch, Secretary Morgenthau, Governor Lehman, Mayor LaGuardia and others.

The allegation that "the Hauptmann case is a Jewish conspiracy against the German nation" was also made by a number of speakers at a meeting called by the New York Nazis on Wednesday evening at the Yorkville Casino. The meeting was attended by more than 3,000 persons and was addressed among others by Mrs. Hauptmann and by Hauptmann's lawyer, Edward J. Reilly.

The meeting, at which the Nazi greeting, "Heil Hitler!", was shouted several times by the audience, was called for the purpose of collecting funds to revive the Hauptmann case. Attorney General Wilentz was termed by the speakers "a representative of the Elders of Zion." The entrance to the meeting was guarded by Nazi storm troopers in uniform.

Says Nazi Treatment of Saar Jews Will Be Watched (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, Feb. 28.—The hope that Germany will keep its promise given to the League of Nations not to victimize the Jews in the Saar at least for twelve months is expressed today in the Manchester Guardian in connection with the transfer of the Saar to the Nazi Reich tomorrow.

Pointing out that nothing can now save the Trade Unions in the Saar as well as the anti-Hitlerite press there from being liquidated by the Nazis, the Manchester Guardian emphasizes that public opinion abroad will watch closely how German officials in the Saar treat the Jews and those who voted during the Saar plebiscite for a status quo.

"The world at large," the paper says, "has a right to expect that Germany will keep its pledge to refrain from victimizing any of those residents of the Saar who did not vote for the return of the Saar to Germany. Public opinion abroad and particularly the League of Nations should see to it that this pledge given by Germany is not broken."
