## Ten Injured In Tel Aviv Sabbath Riots

**Orthodox Jews Smash Store Windows, Oust Taxi Riders**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
TEL AVIV, March 3.—Ten persons were injured here yesterday in street clashes between religious and non-religious Jews, resulting from non-observance of the Sabbath. Ten were arrested as a result of the clashes.

The attacks started after a stormy meeting at which speakers denounced non-observance of the Sabbath by a majority of the Jewish population in the all-Jewish city of Tel Aviv.

Marching from the meeting, the religious Jews began smashing the windows of those Jewish shops which were open. Many of them lined up on the main streets and stopped every taxi passing, ejecting their Jewish passengers who rode in open defiance of the Sabbath laws. A fight between the religious and anti-religious elements developed, necessitating the intervention of British police authorities.

Persons injured in the fight were given first aid by the Mogen David, the Palestine Red Cross. The arrested religious Jews were released under bail and ordered to appear in court for trial.

### Youth Anti-Religious

The street attacks in Tel Aviv yesterday are a result of the conflict between the orthodox Jewish elements in this all-Jewish city and the younger Jewish generation, which is definitely anti-religious.

The orthodox elements object to the fact that trading goes on openly in the all-Jewish city on the Sabbath and on religious holidays. The matter has been discussed several times at stormy sessions of the Tel Aviv municipal council but no compromise could be reached.

Leading the attacks against the non-religious Jews in the streets of Tel Aviv was the orthodox Jewish organization, Shmore Shabbath. The members of this organization are particularly indignant over the fact that sports activities are openly conducted on the Sabbath by Jewish youth.

## Sees Little Hope Of Raising Bars To Immigrants

**But MacCormack Pledges HIAS He'll Help in 'Humanizing' Laws**

Fifty years of helpful activity in behalf of Jewish immigrants were celebrated yesterday afternoon at the Hotel Astor on the occasion of the annual meeting of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society. Two thousand persons were present, including contributors to the society, popularly known as HIAS, and representatives of cooperating religious, labor and fraternal organizations.

Reports tracing the history of the society from its beginnings half a century ago to date were presented by high officials of HIAS, while Colonel Daniel W. MacCormack, commissioner general of immigration and naturalization, and Rudolph Reimer, commissioner of immigration at the port of New York, described the immediate situation as to prospects of increasing the influx from abroad into the United States.

### Traces History

Abraham Herman, president of HIAS, traced the growth of the Jewish population of this country through succeeding waves of immigration and told how immigrant aid work was begun in answer to

## 1935 Parley Is Abandoned By Congress

**Decision by Paris Executive Linked to AJC Elections Hitch**

PARIS, March 3.—The Executive Committee of the World Jewish Congress today decided not to hold the Congress in 1935 as originally contemplated.

The decision was reached in connection with developments in the American Jewish Congress which is calling an extraordinary conference in Philadelphia on March 16. The Philadelphia gathering is being convoked for the purpose of postponing the elections in America to the World Jewish Congress from April 28 to a later date.

The World Jewish Congress will probably be held not before 1936, it was stated here today. In the meantime, the possibility was discussed here of convoking a French Congress during the Summer of 1935. This project, however, is meeting with strong opposition on the part of those Jewish representatives who are seeking to establish in France an organized Jewish representative French Jewish body, similar to the Board of Deputies of British Jews existing in England.

## City Merchants Call Off Strike

**Jerusalem Consents to Regulate Rentals on Stores**

JERUSALEM, March 3.—The general strike of tenant shopkeepers, which was proclaimed by the Jerusalem Association of Rent-Paying Merchants for Monday in order to force the government to regulate the rentals for stores in the city, will not take place, it was announced here today.

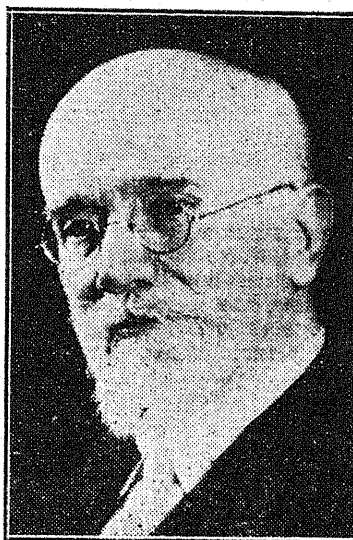
The association decided today to postpone its strike, after it was promised by District Commissioner Campbell that the government would investigate the situation and make the necessary arrangements to regulate rentals on stores.

The association demands that the rent for stores in Jerusalem be regulated by the government along the same lines as room rents. According to the present regulations, no landlord in Palestine has the right to charge more than ten dollars a month per room. The tenants have a right to pay this sum through court if the landlord demands higher rent.

## 'Aryan' Listings Stir Bitter Row In Austria Bar

**Anti-Jewish Directory Hit by Bar Ass'n as Unethical**

VIENNA, March 3.—A serious quarrel broke out today between the Bar Association of Austria and the Association of Austro-German Aryan lawyers, when the former ordered all members of the bar to remove their names from the so-called "Aryan Directory," which was published as a guide in the boycotting of Jewish lawyers.

The Bar Association found that it is not in accordance with the ethics of the profession to be listed in discriminating directories. The Association made it clear in a circular letter that it intended to enforce its order rigorously.

The Nazi and pro-Nazi lawyers, who are organized in the Austro-German Aryan Lawyers Association, issued a communique today replying to the order of the Bar Association, and stating that they do not intend to remove their names from the "Aryan Directory." In this communique the anti-Semitic lawyers allege that their names were inserted in the "Aryan Directory" without their being aware of it, and thus they cannot be accused of disregarding the ethics of the profession.

## Jews Uphold Greek Regime In Uprising

**Government Suspends Venizelist Anti-Semitic Press**

SALONICA, March 3.—Standing fully behind the Greek government, the Jewish population of Greece is watching with unprecedented interest the measures taken by Premier Panayoti Tsaldaris against the insurgents led by ex-premier Venizelos, who has openly committed himself as anti-Jewish.

The entire Venizelist press, which has been pouring out anti-Jewish propaganda ever since the Jews failed to vote for Venizelos in the governmental elections, has been suspended all over the country and will probably not be permitted to reappear. Many of the editors are under arrest.

### Jews Protected

The governor of Salonica today ordered special precautions to protect the large Jewish population in the city against possible attacks. Arrests are still being made in Salonica, where the Venizelists were especially active, where they were prepared to start a revolt upon a signal from Venizelos, who is now in Canea, on the Island of Crete.

Jewish leaders here believe that the Venizelist uprising will end the anti-Semitic propaganda which has reached dangerous proportions despite the fact that the government has done everything in its power to suppress it. The propaganda was conducted and financed by Venizelos, in revenge for the defeat which he suffered in the government elections due to the Jewish votes. Venizelos himself has made no secret of his anti-Jewish sentiments and has declared openly that if not for the Jewish votes, Premier Tsaldaris would not have received a majority.

### Press Stirred Hate

Anxious to return to power, Venizelos recently launched a drive to segregate Jews into a separate electoral college in order to prevent them from voting with the entire Greek population in favor of the Tsaldaris candidates. At the same time, the entire Venizelist press did not miss a single opportunity to stir up animosity against the Jews and to create

## Palestine Laborites Preparing For Expected Collapse of Boom

JERUSALEM, March 3.—Preparing itself for rainy days of unemployment in Palestine, Histadruth, the Jewish Labor Federation, decided today to complete its campaign for a \$250,000 fund for unemployment insurance, towards which \$150,000 has already been collected.

During the present prosperity in Palestine, leading industrial and government experts are predicting an economic crisis in the country in the near future. In order to meet the unemployment

which the crisis may bring, the Histadruth has proclaimed its campaign for the special unemployment fund.

Of the \$150,000 which has already been collected for this fund, the major part came from special dues imposed by the Histadruth upon its 60,000 organized members. Part of it also came from voluntary contributions made by employers as well as by individual Jews who are interested in preventing unemployment in Palestine.

## Police Are Called to Quell Riots By Jewish Beggars in Warsaw

WARSAW, March 3.—A mob of Jewish beggars invaded the offices of the Executive of the Jewish Community today, demanding relief.

The police had to intervene to restore order, since the mob refused to leave the Community building without receiving immediate assistance.

Today's invasion is one of the series of such attacks by beggars which have taken place during the last few weeks when the Jewish

Community was left without means to take care of charitable institutions and was compelled to shut down its free soup kitchens due to lack of funds.

The number of Jews dependent upon charity and free kitchens has increased tremendously during the last month. It is estimated that more than one million Jews in Poland—a third of the entire Jewish population—have been made dependent upon charity due to the heavy taxes which the Polish government is imposing.

Where the Rambam Was Born

MADRID.

There are places on earth like eyes. They have more than a proportionate share in the light and in the fire. They hold, within a fragilit cup of space, journeys far beyond the physical scope of their flesh.

Cordoba, the city where the Jewish philosopher Maimonides, whose 800th birthday will be celebrated at the end of this month, is one of those places.

Cordoba is an eye within the face of Spain. Within Cordoba stands and speaks today the idea of Islam. The mosque is open though the Spaniards call it a Cathedral. Islam speaks and Cordoba answers.

Cordoba is proud. Its pride is intricate as the Talmud, hard and abstruse as the mystic creed of the Sufi, and open as a page of Aristotle.

Not by chance was Seneca the Stoic born here, and Averroes the Commentator, and Moses ben Maimon, the first rationalist of the Jews, and Lucan, and Spain's modern poet, Luis de Congora.

Not by chance was this the home of the most perfect Arab knight, the quiet and strong Al-Mansur who ruled Spain and who decreed Sunday to be a day of rest in deference to the Christian slaves of Islam.

The Christian Copts brought their woman worship to Sevilla, whence came the first impetus toward the dogma of the Immaculate Conception. Don Juan, autoerotic and fallen angel, is of Sevilla. The gypsies found heaven in Granda for their Black Sea spells, whence sprang the aesthetic sadism of Spain.

Cordoba forbids such.

Here grew to be a kingdom of balance and of peace. Within a hundred years of its conquest, Islam forgot conquest and sought peace with Christian Europe.

The Caliphate of Cordoba became the seat of urbane monarchs who collected pagan and Christian songs from the Bay of Biscay, who collaborated with the Jews to bring the schools of Babylon northward, who founded the autonomy of science and of speculation 700 years before the recantation of Galileo.

The Cordoban spirit is Reason and Balance. It is in the Mosque. It is in the streets whose sumptuous palaces raise unassertive the homes of the poor. It is in the walls beside inns and convents and Juderia, the mediaeval quarter of the Jews, where the houses cluster as in reticent prayer about the transformed synagogues and hide patios of shade and brilliant color. It is in the wider, modern streets: the camerero at your cafe suggests

# Between the Lines

The decision adopted in Paris by the Executive Committee of the World Jewish Congress not to hold the Congress in 1935 and again to postpone it for a later year did not come as a surprise to those who know what is going on behind the scenes of the World Jewish Congress.

Though it is explained that the reason for postponing the Congress lies in the complications which have arisen in America and which have necessitated the American Jewish Congress to call its extraordinary session in Philadelphia on March 16, this is not the actual reason.

## The Real Reason

The real reason for not holding the World Jewish Congress in 1935 lies in the hidden opposition of the Zionists. A number of Zionist leaders, though openly participating in the preparations for the World Jewish Congress, are nevertheless against this gathering, since such a Congress would be in competition to the Zionist Congress.

The first open quarrel between certain Zionist leaders participating in the Executive Committee of the World Jewish Congress in Paris and a number of Executive members who are not Zionists took place this month long before it was decided to postpone the Congress. The Zionists insisted that the World Jewish Congress should be postponed in order that it should not coincide with the Nineteenth Zionist Congress, which is definitely taking place this year. Two international Jewish gatherings cannot be held in the same year, they pointed out.

## The Zionist Threat

The serious differences of opinion which arose between the Zionists and the non-Zionists in the Executive of the World Jewish Congress in Paris resulted in a threat to the non-Zionists, that in Poland and in other countries the Zionists would obstruct the elections to the World Jewish Congress if they coincide with the elections to the Zionist Congress.

This threat, coupled with the decision of the American Jewish Congress to also postpone its democratic elections to the World Jewish Congress from April 28 to a later date, gave the final blow. The non-Zionists in the Paris Executive have seen in the American decision a plot between the Zionist leaders in Paris and some of the Zionist members of the American Jewish Congress in New York.

## A New Idea Born

This suspicion about the role played by certain Zionists in America with regard to the World Jewish Congress idea has provoked a bitter feeling among the non-Zionists in the Paris executive. It is due to this feeling that an idea was born to give up altogether the project of calling a World Jewish Congress and to concentrate instead on the creation of a Board of Jewish Deputies in France, along the same lines as the Board of Jewish Deputies existing in England.

Whether such a Board will or will not be established in Paris, one thing is, however, certain: in the silent internal fight between the Zionists and the non-Zionists, the former won their aim. The World Jewish Congress will not be held this year. And—who knows? Maybe it will never be held.

The Hitler Government came into power at the beginning of 1933, and the "boycott" was not discussed until several months later. It is true that, while our total imports in 1934 show an increase of 25 per cent. in dollar value over those in 1932, our imports from Germany alone show a decline of 6 per cent. No doubt a good deal of this comparative decline is due to the refusal of many private American citizens to buy German goods. But what, meanwhile, has happened to Germany's purchases from America? The most drastic change has occurred since Germany put into effect its "new economic policy" last September, compelling every importer to get a certificate from the Government for every import made.

## Times Exposes Lippert Fallacy

The New York Times, in its Friday issue, comments editorially on Dr. Julius Lippert's appeal to America to discontinue the boycott on German goods:

The speech of Dr. Julius Lippert, State Commissar for Berlin, before the American Chamber of Commerce there, is amazing even in these days not only for its bland disregard of the most glaring facts but because it is impossible to know what purpose he could seriously have expected it to serve. Ostensibly deploring the curtailment in German-American trade in the last two years, Dr. Lipper held that "the principal cause lies in the special difficulties created by the so-called Jewish boycott movement in the commerce world center of New York."

# Brooklyn 'Y' Marks Its 25th Anniversary

May, Lazansky Among Speakers at Williamsburg Dinner

The importance of community work among the youth of Brooklyn was emphasized by speakers at the twenty-fifth anniversary dinner of the Williamsburg Young Men's Hebrew Association held last night at the Association building 284 South Ninth street, Brooklyn.

Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, president of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, and Presiding Justice Edward Lazansky of the Appellate Division emphasized the necessity of interesting the young men and women in character building groups. Lack of spiritual Jewish education is the cause of many modern-day evils, according to these leaders.

The Association, which is one of the twenty-five constituent agencies of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities and one of five community centers affiliated with that Federation, draws about 4,000 participants in its activities every week, according to the executive director, Louis Notkin.

## Plan New Building

Because of the fast growing membership, the present building is inadequate, according to Mr. Notkin. Plans to attract contributions for a new place to be built on the present site were discussed at the dinner.

Ten of the original members were present. They are Mrs. Jacob Jacobson, Stewart Engel, Municipal Court Justice Jacob S. Strahl, Charles I. Mandel, I. T. Perlman, Dr. Charles Dumay, Louis Lorence, Leon Cooper and Isaac Fenster. Mrs. Margaret Levy of the women's organization and Mrs. Fanny Rubinowitz of the Philanthropic League, cooperated with Abraham L. Doris, deputy comptroller of New York State, and vice-president of the association, in arranging last night's affair. Mr. Doris presided.

Guests of honor were M. Maldwin Fertig, Supreme Court Justice Harry E. Lewis, Supreme Court Justice James C. Cropsey, County Judge Algeron I. Nova, Frank V. Kelly and John R. Crews.

## Welfare Group to Hold Annual Meeting Tonight

The United Jewish Aid Societies, sole family welfare agency of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities, will hold its twenty-fourth annual meeting tonight at the Temple House of Congregation Beth Elohim, Eighth avenue and Garfield place, Brooklyn. Mortimer Brenner, president of the organization, is scheduled to retire and will be succeeded by Mortimer Schwager. Other officers and directors will also be elected for 1935.

Commissioner of Public Welfare William Hodson and Dr. Solomon Lowenstein, executive vice-president of the Federation for the Support of Philanthropic Societies, as well as Mr. Brenner, will discuss the relationship of the private family welfare society to the public relief agency under present conditions.

The changed functions of a private family welfare agency, as shown by the work of the United Jewish Aid Societies, will be illustrated by Mr. Brenner in his annual report in which he is expected to cite statistically the type of his agency's services and the manner in which it cooperates with the public relief systems operated by the city, state and Federal government.

# Students Hear Jabotinsky Tell Of Party Aims

Justice Demands Arabs Give Up Palestine, He Declares

Vladimir Jabotinsky, president of the World Union of Zionist Revisionists, presenting the case of his party in an address Saturday night in the auditorium of the City College School of Business and Civic Administration, Lexington avenue and Twenty-third street, said social justice dictates that the Arabs give up Palestine to the Jews.

An audience of 1,200 heard the Revisionist chieftain's remarks. The occasion was a mass meeting arranged by the Manhattan chapter of Avukah, American Student Zionist Federation.

## Ethics Involved

Asserting that the conflict with the Arabs involved "unpleasant ethical questions," Jabotinsky pointed out that 40,000,000 Arabs occupy a territory whose equivalent in area in Europe is peopled by ten times that number, while "little Palestine" is less than one per cent of Arab land.

"If you admit self-determination for the Arabs," the speaker asked, "where shall the Jews go? There is nowhere for them to go. Shall they go on starving and suffering because the world has not been evenly distributed?"

## Avoids Current Problems

For the most part, Jabotinsky skirted current problems connected with the establishment of the Jewish homeland and concentrated his attention upon those questions "which worry the brain and conscience of the young student of Zionist phenomena."

Jacob de Haas, historian, who also spoke, said:

"So far as the solution of the Jewish problem is concerned only one answer is possible—the creation of the Jewish state."

Of a new appeal by the Juedische Rundschau for suspension of the anti-Nazi boycott, De Haas declared:

"We will not be moved by that paper's apologetics."

# Holds Judaism More Important Than Zionism

Rabbi Herbert Goldstein Explains Why in Sermon on Palestine

Judaism above Zionism was the slogan sounded yesterday by Rabbi Herbert S. Goldstein in a sermon on Palestine at the Institutional Synagogue, 148 West Eighty-fifth street. Rabbi Goldstein said in part:

"I was asked, 'Do you favor the Zionist Organization?' I answered, 'I am opposed to it.' 'The Revisionists?' I oppose the Revisionists. 'The Histadruth?' I oppose the Histadruth. 'But,' exclaimed my questioner, 'You oppose the Zionist Organization, the Histadruth and Revisionism. What do you favor?' 'Judaism, Judaism,' was my answer.

## Judaism Vital Force

"The political implementation involved in the creating of Zion for the Jew in the land of his fathers assumes a diversity of forms and formulae, but at the core of it all I feel there must be one force from which all work toward a homeland in Palestine must spring and without which we will develop nothing more than a soulless commonwealth. That force is 'Judaism.'

"Before we can create a Jewish civilization in Palestine, whether it meet with the approval of the Zionist Organization or the Histadruth or the Revisionists, it must meet with the approval of God.

"The importance of the upbuilding of Palestine lies in the fact that here may be created a spiritual center for Israel, which may become a spiritual reservoir for all Israel everywhere.

"Yet how can we hope to have established in Palestine, this central dynamo of Jewish culture, of Jewish thought and expression, if culture, if thought, if the needs of the spirit, if Judaism itself is discarded by the Zionist Organization, by Revisionist and the Histadruth?"

## Sees 3 Powers Opposed to Peace

## Montefiore Sees No Betterment For Reich Jews

### Cites Continued Propaganda in Hesse, Franconia

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
LONDON, March 3. — Doubt that the economic situation of the German Jews is improving in any way was expressed here today by Sir Leonard Montefiore, prominent Jewish leader, in an address before the Anglo-Jewish Association.

Discussing the report of the Joint Foreign Committee on the German Jewish situation, Sir Leonard stressed the seriousness of that situation and pointed out that the propaganda activities of Julius Streicher's Sturmer and of other anti-Semitic periodicals have not abated. In Hesse and in Franconia, Sir Leonard declared, anti-Jewish feeling is stronger than ever before.

In a reference to Iraq the speaker said that he does not believe the anti-Semitic movement there is of serious proportions. Rumors of dismissals of Jews, he said, were actually only an outgrowth of employment shiftings.

Neville Laski, president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, reporting on the Joint Foreign Committee's findings concerning the recent anti-Jewish disturbances in Algeria, disclosed that the Alliance Israelite has taken the matter up with the government in Paris.

### Lays North Africa Crisis To Pan Islam Movement

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
PARIS, March 3.—The crisis in North Africa, which has resulted in anti-Jewish rioting several times during the past year is not an outgrowth of economic difficulties, as has been declared in various circles, the Petit Parisien says in an editorial today.

The warning, occasioned by the fact that the Minister of Interior has decided to go to Algeria himself in order to get first hand information regarding the disturbances, asserts that they are the fruits of the efforts of the Pan-Islamic movement, initiated by the Pan-Islamic Congress held recently in Jerusalem. The movement, Le Petit Parisien asserts, is a threat to the peace of the entire Levant.

### Lippert Speech Signals New Drive, Is Warning

That the speech recently delivered before the Berlin American Chamber of Commerce by Nazi Commissar Lippert, attacking the anti-Nazi boycott in America, is the signal for new Nazi anti-Semitic activities is declared in a statement issued yesterday by the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League in New York.

"Within a fortnight," the statement points out, "Hitler himself has rejected Schacht's plea for a more subdued form of anti-Semitism to overcome boycott resistance. Yet a few days later the Nazi Commissar Lippert asserts freely that the anti-Semitism complained of never existed."

### AJC Youth Will Fete Maccabi Olympics Squad

The youth division of the American Jewish Congress will give a farewell reception and dance on March 9 to the members of the United States Maccabi team, which is to compete at the World Jewish Olympics in Tel Aviv from April 2 to April 7. The reception will be held aboard the U. S. S. Illinois, at the foot of 97th street and the Hudson River.

## Will Permit Jews to Fly Reich Colors After All

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BERLIN, March 3.—The central authorities today overruled the order issued by the Secret police in Frankfurt-am-Main, prohibiting Jewish institutions and individual Jews from displaying Reich colors.

The order was issued yesterday and delivered to the Board of the Jewish Community of Frankfurt-am-Main, stating that "the Secret Police does not desire Jews and Jewish organizations to display the Reich banner." The Jews were, however, permitted by the Secret Police to fly the city colors.

## Naras Raided While Planning Drive on Jews

### Police Surprise Heads of Anti-Semitic Group in Secret Session

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
WARSAW, March 3.—Plans for a renewed anti-Jewish and anti-government drive in Poland were discovered by the police in Warsaw today during a raid on the quarters of the illegally existing anti-Semitic Nara Party. Ten ring-leaders were arrested as a result of the raid.

The police received word that the leaders of the Nara Party were holding their executive sessions in a certain building in Warsaw, despite the fact that the party was officially dissolved by the government. A force of detectives sent to the building caught the party leaders in the midst of formulating plans to start a new campaign against the Jews and against the present regime. Many documents were confiscated by the detectives after a thorough search of the building.

The raid is a result of the investigation by police authorities to discover the perpetrators of two fires started by unknown persons in Jewish premises on Freta Strasse in Warsaw.

The anti-Jewish propaganda, led by the Venizelist press, reached such a point that Jewish leaders were compelled to appeal for protection to the central authorities, especially to Governor Rhallis of Salonica. Governor Rhallis, who is friendly towards the Jews, has issued a public warning against spreading racial hatred in the press, but since no censorship exists in Greece, the Venizelist papers continue to ignore this warning.

## 5 Jewish Groups Aid Birth Control Measures

WASHINGTON, March 3.—Five Jewish organizations have given their support to pending federal legislation which would permit dissemination of contraceptive information by responsible medical agencies, it was announced today by Dr. Robert Gordis, corresponding secretary of the National Committee on Federal Legislation for Birth Control.

The organizations are the Rabbinical Assembly, the Central Conference of American Rabbis, the Social Service Committee of the United Synagogues of America, the National Council of Jewish Women and the Federation of Jewish Women's Organizations of Greater New York.

## Rites for Sachs, Philanthropist, Set for Today

### Banker Died Saturday at 83; Gave to Many Institutions

Private funeral services will be held at ten o'clock this morning from the Hotel Pierre, Fifth avenue and Sixty-first street, for Samuel Sachs, philanthropist and banker who died early Saturday morning of heart disease.

Mr. Sachs was 83. For many years the senior partner of the famous banking firm of Goldman, Sachs & Co., which he entered in 1882, Mr. Sachs retired about seven years ago, becoming special partner.

Particularly interested in philanthropy, Mr. Sachs made a number of contributions to the Montefiore Hospital, of which he was director for a time, to Bellevue and Allied Hospitals, and to the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies.

Mr. Sachs is survived by his widow, Louisa, and by three sons, Paul J. Sachs, Professor of Fine Arts at Harvard University; Arthur Sachs, and Walter E. Sachs, partners of Goldman, Sachs & Co. Burial will be in Salem Fields Cemetery, Brooklyn.

## May Bar Jews From Frontier Areas of Saar

### Restriction Is Hinted in Nazi Press; New Paper Attacks Jewry

BERLIN, March 3.—Jews will not be permitted to reside in the frontier areas in the Saar, it was hinted today in the Nazi press.

Despite the reports that the Nazis intend to modify their policy with regard to anti-Jewish propaganda, severe anti-Jewish attacks appeared today in the "Judenkenner," a special publication recently started in Berlin for the purpose of continuing anti-Jewish propaganda among the German population. The new publication resembles greatly Der Sturmer, the notorious Jew-baiting organ of Julius Streicher.

The new anti-Jewish paper urges that the campaign against the Jews should not be modified. "The Jews are again planning to become the masters of Germany," the publication writes.

## Dizengoff Back on Job As Mayor of Tel Aviv

TEL AVIV, March 3.—Meir Dizengoff, the seventy-four year old mayor of Tel Aviv, who has been seriously ill and for whose recovery special prayers and fasts were proclaimed by the Jews of Palestine, today resumed his duties.

A great ovation was given the mayor when he visited a Hebrew film show at one of the local theatres.

## Wauchope Visits Haifa, Pleased With Progress

JERUSALEM, March 3.—The High Commissioner of Palestine, Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, today visited Haifa and discussed various schemes for the extension of the city's harbor. Col Wauchope expressed satisfaction with the transportation improvements in the harbor city.

## Can't Pay 60c Fine, Spends Night in Jail

WARSAW, March 3.—A curious scene illustrating Jewish misery in Poland was enacted in a Warsaw court today when a Jewish shopkeeper was convicted for violating the Sunday closing law.

The judge fined the shopkeeper three zlotys, approximately 60 cents. The accused then pleaded that he would prefer being sentenced to imprisonment since he was not in a position to pay the imposed fine. The judge obligingly sentenced him to one day in jail.

## Warsaw Bans Protest Meeting On Subsidies

### Rally Tonight Was to Hit Withdrawal of Support for Yiddish Schools

WARSAW, March 3.—The authorities today prohibited a protest meeting arranged by the Central Jewish School Organization for Monday against the government's withdrawal of subsidy from the Yiddish schools in Poland.

While discriminating against the Jewish school, the Polish authorities have given the status of public school to private religious Chedaram, which are long out of date from a pedagogical viewpoint. Tens of thousands of Jewish pupils in the Yiddish and Hebrew school system are affected by the government discrimination.

At the protest meeting scheduled for Monday, the speakers were planning to base their complaints on the fact that the Jewish population in Poland, being only ten per cent as compared with the general population, contributes as much as forty per cent toward the government budget. This extraordinary proportion, they were to point out, entitles them at least the same proportion of government subsidies as the schools of other denominations are receiving.

## 1,500 Butchers Hail NRA Code At Convention

### Will Protect Public From False Kosher Claims Andron Declares

The beginning of a new era in the retail kosher meat trade was hailed by members of the Code Authority for the industry and David S. Andron, general counsel for the Code Authority, at the opening session yesterday of a two-day convention at the Hotel Commodore. More than 1,500 persons from every part of the country were present in the first convention of the kosher butchers under the NRA code.

Speakers at yesterday's session included Mr. Andron, Charles Cohen, executive chairman of the Code Authority; John M. Brunjes, executive secretary, and the following Code Authority members: Abraham Avreen, Isidore Escann of Baltimore; Morris Harris, Hyman Schulman of Boston; Oscar Spitalnick, Jacob Schatz, Isidore Batkin, David Goldberg of Newark; Emil Horn and Abraham Belsky.

**Code Will Protect Public**  
Mr. Andron declared that the administration of the code will guard the Jewish public against misrepresentation of the quality of meats and the sale of non-kosher meat as kosher.

Mr. Cohen asserted that the code "embodies everything that the kosher meat trade has been seeking for years."

The sentiment of the trade for continuance of the NRA was voiced by Mr. Brunjes, who declared that "the kosher butchers stand 100 per cent behind President Roosevelt in his drive for fair competition in all industries."

Mr. Andron was toastmaster at a banquet in the Commodore's Grand Ballroom last night attended by more than 1,000 persons. Among those on the speakers' list were Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch, Congressman Emanuel Celler and Samuel Dickstein.

A conference regarding fair trade practices under the code will be held at this morning's session. Regional and local code administrators will be designated during the afternoon. Other features on today's agenda are: formation of plans for permanent fair trade practices and adoption of a national emblem. The convention will close with the adoption of resolutions.

es in the present laws."

In sharp contrast with conditions which prevailed two and three decades ago, Colonel MacCormack disclosed, only one immigrant comes to the United States today for each 4,000 persons already established in this country and, for each new immigrant, two return to their native lands.

Rev. H. Masliansky, speaking in Yiddish, said HIAS does a holy work and called for blessings on America, the only country which "shines brightly for the Jews today."
