Spread New Protocols in United States

'Pan-Aryan Alliance' Sends 1935 Version Through Mails

Emulating the forged document known as the "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," another forgery entitled "A Protocol of 1935" made its appearance here yesterday, aiming to stir anti-Semitism in America along the same lines as done in Czarist Russia and in Nazi Germany.

The "Protocol of 1935," which claims to be based on a "careful study of present-day Jewish activities" is published by the Pan-Aryan Alliance in New York. It is a printed booklet of thirty-two pages and is being distributed freely in the mails. The publisher's address is not given in the booklet, but the envelope in which the booklet is mailed gives the return address as Box 476, Grand Central Annex, New York.

Preface Admits Falsity

The booklet is decorated on the front page with a large swastika. A short preface to it admits that the facts contained there are not actual but imaginary. "Mockingly we have been adapting a kind of 'protocol' as it could have been written and printed by the Jews themselves if one of them would have the honesty of sketching an outline of the remarkable trend that his race under the pretense of being a religious sect is following up."

The American "Protocol of 1935" are repeating the old anti-Semitic allegations that the League of Nations has been founded by the Jews and that the World Court is a Jewish institution. Great Britain, France and Italy are pictured in the American "Protocol" as dominated by the Jews.

Discussing the effects of the "Jewish invisible government" in the United States, the anti-Semitic booklet tries to create the impression that the citizens of the United States are "mentally and spiritually" in the hands of the Jews and that "they will do unhesitatingly whatever Jewish crooners tell them to, through press, radio or movie."

The "Protocol of 1935" claims to be copyrighted and registered with the Copyright Office of the Library of Congress.

New Alien Law Hits Jews in Luxembourg

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LUXEMBOURG, March 18.—A new law which limits the economic activities of foreign citizens in Luxembourg was issued here today, making it necessary for many Jewish families from Poland and Germany to return to their native countries.

The government as well as the Jewish community here today declared themselves ready to assist with funds all those Jews who are forced to leave the country as a result of this law. They will be transported to the border at the expense of the government.

Praha Students Demand Action Against Jews

Douse Lights, Spread Anti-Jewish Leaflets in University

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) PRAHA, March 18.—An anti-Jewish demonstration broke out in the German university here today, necessitating the intervention of the rector.

The lights in the university were turned out and thousands of leaflets were distributed among the students, calling for a general strike against "the excessive number of Jews enrolled."

The call for a strike was issued under the slogan "against Jewish professors—for a German university."

Fearing unfortunate developments, the rector of the university immediately invited the leaders of the student council to a conference and asked them for an explanation of the incident. The leaders declared that they were puzzled by what had happened and professed complete ignorance.

Charge of Libel Made Against Haolam Editor

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) PARIS, March 18.—Punishment of the editor of the Haolam, the official organ of the World Zionist Organization, was demanded today from the World Zionist Executive by the Executive of the Revisionist party.

The Revisionists charge that a recent article in the Haolam contained "insolent libel" against Jabotinsky.

Archduke Otto Scores Austria For Its Policy of Anti-Semitism

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) VIENNA, March 18.—Archduke Otto, the pretender to the Austrian throne, today took issue with the anti-Jewish discriminations now practiced in Austria by the present regime.

In a statement issued by him to the Jewish War Veterans organization, the archduke declared that Jews in Austria ought to be treated as equal citizens and that any anti-Jewish legislation in the country is not justified.

The statement by the archduke voices praise of the Jewish War Veterans for their role in the Austrian army during the World War. The Jewish War Veterans in Austria have been totally ignored by the present regime since Premier Schuschnigg came to power.

Definite mistrust of the Jewish War Veterans was expressed by the present regime in Austria during the revolution of last year when it rejected the offer of the Federation of Jewish War Veterans to help the government forces in the days when Vienna was in a state of civil war.

Approval by Narrow Majority Expected at Hedera Parley

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, March 18.—Eighty-nine delegates to the Laborite convention in Hedera voted against ratifying the peace agreement with Jabotinsky. Seventy-four voted for the ratification. The final decision depends now upon the votes of the twenty-two members of the Executive. The agreement is expected to be ratified by a narrow majority.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, March 18.—A sharp division of opinion as to whether the Laborites in Palestine should ratify the peace agreements signed by Ben-Gurion and Jabotinsky in London was seen today when the results of elections to a special Laborite convention in Hedera were made public.

The convention in Hedera, called to ratify the agreement Jabotinsky, opened last night. A majority of the delegates are Laborites who are definitely opposed to entering any agreements with Jabotinsky.

Vote on Two Slates

Delegates to the Hedera conference were elected throughout the country on two slates. One contained the names of delegates who favored ratification of the London agreements between Ben-Gurion and Jabotinsky. The second listed those who opposed ratification.

In Jerusalem the list favoring ratification received a majority of two votes. In Tel Aviv, however, 600 voted in favor of the agreement, and 800 for the list opposing it. In Haifa 200 voted for the agreement and 800 against it.

All the Laborite leaders, including Ben-Gurion and Shertok, left for Hedera today in an effort to influence the convention so that

Visas Made Easier To Get by Britain

Consulate in Warsaw Drops \$300 Deposit for Tourists to Palestine

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, March 18.—The British Consulate has notified Jewish institutions here that it will ease conditions on which tourists to Palestine may obtain visas.

Instead of the \$300 deposit required by the immigration regulations from each tourist as guarantee that he will not remain in Palestine, the British Consulate will accept written guarantees from travel bureaus or from the Polish Palestine Chamber of Trade, upon which it will issue the desired visa.

The modification announced by the British Consulate will make it possible for many Jews from Poland to proceed to Palestine as tourists for the Maccabiad and for the Passover holidays.

Bialik Exhibit Slated For Tel Aviv in April

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) TEL AVIV, March 18.—A full month's exhibition depicting aspects of Jewish cultural life in Palestine will be opened here on April 14, it was announced today. The exhibition will bear the name of Chaim Nachman Bialik, the late Hebrew poet.

An appeal to persons possessing Bialik manuscripts was issued today by M. M. Ussishkin, Meier Dizengoff and Shemarya Levin, leaders of the committee arranging the exhibition. The owners of such manuscripts are requested to send them in for the exhibition.

Aid Polish Jews With Exports, Is Gepner Plan

Metals Magnate Urges It as Solution to Present Crisis

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, March 18.—Polish Jewry wishes no charity. All it wants is credit aid.

This was made clear here today by Abraham Gepner, the king of the Polish metal trade and vice-chairman of the Jewish Merchants Association, in an article dealing with the present position of Polish Jewry.

In this article, Mr. Gepner suggests that a body be set up to promote and finance the export to England and America of finished goods made by Jews in Poland. The export of Jewish-made goods in Poland can be greatly developed, since labor is cheap and since many products can easily be sold in the United States on a large scale.

The difference between the Polish Jews and the German Jews, Mr. Gepner believes, is that a hurricane has passed over German Jewry which has wiped out their means of existence. "To such ruination we must respond at once and with drastic, radical measures," Mr. Gepner suggests.

Polish Jewry has not been ruined, Mr. Gepner writes. It is experiencing a severe economic crisis which is partly the result of the general crisis in the country. Relief in the form of a campaign for funds, no matter how big the result, will not relieve the situation. The Polish Jews do not need alms. They want help to enable them to continue to carry on their livelihood. Such help can be given only in the form of credit.

Merchants Set to Quit Danzig As Nazi Group Grows Stronger

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) DANZIG, March 18.—Jewish business men in Danzig were preparing today to liquidate their businesses and leave Danzig before the Nazis succeed in obtaining full control over this Free City, which is under the jurisdiction of the League of Nations.

With the experience of the Jews in the Saar fresh in their minds, the Jewish leaders were highly perturbed by the open campaign which the Nazis started yesterday

Hitler Aide To Get Sole Rule on Jews

Goebbels to Be Assigned by Fuehrer to Push Campaign

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, March 18.—The fate of German Jewry will be handed over exclusively into the hands of Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Nazi Minister of Propaganda, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned here today.

"Busy with the restoration of the German army, Hitler and General Goering decided to leave the campaign against the Jews in the capable mouth of Dr. Goebbels," it was stated today in authoritative sources.

Jewish Editor Seized

Dr. Fritz Neulaender, the editor of the official organ of the Jewish community of Cologne, was arrested today and his paper, the Juedische Gemeindeblatt, was suspended for three months. The authorities explained that their action is based on an article published in the Gemeindeblatt, allegedly offending a Nazi paper. The Nazi paper referred to is the Westdeutscher Beobachter, Hitler's mouthpiece in western Germany.

The Voelksische Beobachter, the chief organ of the Nazi party, announced today that on April 11 a case will come up in the courts of Cairo, Egypt, brought by the Jews against the local Nazis for defaming Jewry. The suit is brought by the Jewish attorney, Leon Castro, of Cairo, representing the World League for Combating Anti-Semitism. The defendant is the president of the German club in Cairo, who is charged with publishing defamatory statements against the Jews in a pamphlet issued by the Club.

The lower courts in Cairo had refused to recognize the rights of an individual Jew to bring action against the German club. Mr. Castro thereupon lodged an appeal with a higher court. The German club will be represented by Professor Grimm of Hesse, who will proceed to Egypt for this purpose, the Voelksische Beobachter, states.

Press Gagged on French Visit to Jewish Hotel

The Furor Over Epstein

LONDON.

A new war of the critics has disturbed London's calm. Art circles are heatedly engaged in dispute. Letters are being written to the Times. Jacob Epstein has done it again.

The Jewish sculptor, who has provoked so many controversies over his work in the past, is responsible for his new wave of agitation which centers around the eleven-foot, seven-ton carving, "Ecce Homo" (Behold the Man), which went on exhibition recently at the Leicester Galleries.

of the spirit of these craftsmen in 'Behold the Man.'"

The Times ventured no estimate of the work, contenting itself with describing at length the technical details responsible for the carving's impression of great size. It reported, however, that "neither the mass nor the material can be said to have been enhanced by the carving," and significantly, "to turn from 'Behold the Man' to the portrait bronzes is to exchange duty for pleasure."

James Douglas, editor of the Sunday Express, went into ecstasies over the work. "It is a mighty and majestic work of art, too mighty and too majestic for the blind eyes of this blind age. It is eleven feet in height and weighs six tons."

The Daily Mail's critic was disappointed in the work, finding it as shallow as are the artist's incisions into the marble.

Despite the furor over the huge sculpture, there has been nothing but acclaim for the bronze busts in the exhibition which, according to the Guardian, "finds Epstein at the height of his strange and sensitive powers."

Among the busts attracting attention is one of Dr. Chaim Weizmann which must rank among Epstein's best. A lively bronze portrait of George Bernard Shaw, a bronze of Lord Beaverbrook, and several of women, are included in the exhibition.

First visitors to the exhibition were divided in their opinions as were the critics and their comments varied widely.

Between the Lines

Purim and Hitler

The Purim holiday which the Jews are celebrating today is of particular significance at this time, when the Nazis are making it clear, as they did again only last week, that they don't want any Jews in Germany.

Like the Persian minister Haman 2,500 years ago, Hitler—the Haman of modern times—is trying his best to plot not only against the Jews of Germany but against Jewry as a whole. The anti-Semitic propaganda which is being subsidized from Berlin in different countries including the United States, is nothing but a plot which Hitler has undertaken against the Jews of the world, with the intention of annihilating them.

History Repeated

But history repeats itself. Just as Haman in the long run suffered a complete defeat, this very same end will probably be faced also by Hitler. The world is beginning to realize how dangerous Hitlerism is becoming for humanity. And if any special proof were necessary, the revival of the German army in defense of the Versailles treaty constitute this proof.

The celebration of Purim coincides this year also with the celebration of the eight hundredth birthday of the Jewish philosopher Maimonides who was born in Spain. Like Germany today, Spain was under a Jewish boycott because of the Spanish Inquisition. This boycott has never been officially rescinded. Officially it is still valid even today.

Lessons for Naziland

The attitude of Spain towards the Jews has changed very much in the years since the Inquisition, and world Jewry today entertains the friendliest feelings towards the Spanish nation. The elaborate program which the Spanish government has arranged for the Maimonides celebration throughout Spain is also the best proof that the Spanish people of today are far from approving of the anti-Jewish persecutions which took place in ancient Spain.

The Nazi leaders in Germany, if only they cared to learn a lesson from history, would realize the mistake which they are making in their efforts to annihilate the Jews. The consequences suffered by Haman in Persia and the political and economic degradation suffered by Spain could serve the Nazis as the best food for a second thought.

Cases Worth Studying

Ancient Persia and ancient Spain were in their times, as flourishing countries as Germany is today. They also claimed to be as cultural as Germany claims to be now. Their economic and cultural role in the world, however, changed from the moment their rulers engaged in anti-Jewish persecutions. They, more than the Jewish people, were the sufferers in the long run.

On the occasion of Purim these facts will perhaps be taken into consideration by those in Germany who ought to know them. History, after all, repeats itself. That Hitler will not succeed in annihilating the Jews is something which is certain, but whether Nazi Germany will remain the same as it is now is something that can very definitely be questioned. The case of Haman and of Spain prove it best.

World Press Digest

Sees Melchett Advice Aid to Revisionists

The *Spokesman* of Louisville, Ky., commenting on Lord Melchett's article in the *London Times* demanding the opening of Transjordan for Jewish immigration, says editorially:

When Lord Melchett, in an article in the *London Times*, recommends that Transjordan be opened to Jewish immigration, he unknowingly loaded the Revisionists' cannon with gunpowder for their present bombardment of America. Not only did Melchett endorse a salient plank in the Revisionist platform, but he at the same time placed his stamp of approval on the Revisionist method of diplomacy.

Melchett, wise in the ways of diplomacy, did not urge England to open the doors of Transjordan to Jews because Jews are good people, deserving people, or for any like reason. No. Instead he preferred to gain his point by telling Great Britain that if Jews were prohibited from entering Transjordan, which is under British Mandate, they would settle in Syria, which is under French Mandate; and if Jews did settle in large numbers and did colonize Syria, England would be helping build up in the Eastern Mediterranean just such a competitor for trade and power that she fought the Crimean War to prevent.

Praises Committee On Its Report

The *Philadelphia Jewish Exponent*, commenting editorially on the report of the American Jewish Committee, says:

The American Jewish Committee did well to re-emphasize the baselessness as well as the menacing character of the anti-Jewish agitation now in full swing in this country. Unfortunately the effort to discredit the Federal Administration by exploiting anti-Jewish prejudices, reprehensible though it is, is gaining ground. Time and again it has been pointed out that there is no foundation for the accusation that Jews outnumber all others holding public office, yet there are those who continue to spread this canard. What is worse, there are those who believe it.

A New Nazi View Of Relativity

Everyman, a London publication, carries the following editorial:

Much has been said and written about relativity since Professor Einstein introduced his conclusions to a world which, for the most part, was not quite up to them. Now a Nazi professor has announced that there is nothing at all in the whole idea but "an example of mass-gestation put over by the Jewish press." If that is an example of forcibly feeding the masses with ideas that they can instantly grasp, some of us would like to see an instance of giving them something that is really beyond the range of their limited comprehension. If it be "mass-gestation" that has put relativity on the map, the masses must be equipped with a far more accomplished and receptive type of intelligence than they are ordinarily given credit for.

Caustic Comment On London Daily

Time and Tide, a London publication, carries the following editorial:

The changes in the policy of Rothermere Press, which were noted last week, have evidently not come to an end yet. Having found a clergyman to write a splash article on why he admires Hitler, the *Daily Mail* hires control this week decided it had better have an article by a Jew, drawing attention to the persecutions which the Jewish people have suffered, and explaining why he is proud to be a Jew.

This presentation of two sides of a question is not at all like our old *Daily Mail*.

Nazis Here Use Noted Names to Aid Propaganda

Hint Coughlin, Roosevelt Approve of Them, Writer Reveals

That the Nazis in America are utilizing the names of Father Coughlin and even of President Roosevelt for propaganda purposes is disclosed by George Seldes in an article published in Today, magazine of which Prof. Raymond Moley is editor. The article relates the following:

"Fuehrer" William H. Roth, addressing a meeting of the Friends in New Jersey, did not hesitate to state—although he asked his audience not to quote him—that he had been told by the national Nazi officers in New York that they were 'in closest touch with Father Coughlin' and had decided to join his League for Social Justice in a body.

Seeks Catholic Aid

"The object of this false propaganda, of course, has been to obtain sympathy from the Catholics, who have been among the leaders everywhere in fighting Hitlerism.

"The propaganda concerning the President is being spread by Carl Nicolai, second in command in New York, and head of the Bay Ridge, Brooklyn, local of the Friends. According to Herr Nicolai, he sent a letter to President Roosevelt inviting him to participate in a celebration of the Saar victory. The president replied, Nicolai tells audiences, in a letter which expressed regret that he could not accept the invitation because of a previous engagement. That might easily be true. But in an open meeting Herr Nicolai declares that the President also invited him to the White House for a conference 'at some future date,' and, from this, he deduces that President Roosevelt assured him of the 'fullest sympathy.' He further declares friendly recognition of the Friends of the New Germany.' Therefore, Herr Nicolai urges his audiences, 'go ahead with our propaganda.'

Bragged of Espionage

"At one meeting Nicolai boasted that he was arrested in Pittsburgh in 1918 as a German spy, that he was in jail six months, that he refused to take out American citizenship in 1915 'because the damned Americans did not recognize our German rights,' that throughout the war he served the cause of Germany; and that he was 'proud that, in the capacity as an officer of the German-American Conference and the United German Societies, he had delivered these organizations to the Friends of the New Germany.'

"Our principal goal," he said, "is to make America an ally of Germany. Let us not be disturbed by some of these Americans (referring to the German societies which have refused to join the Nazis)—we are going to fight for the German cause. The German flag protects the Star Spangled Banner."

50 Leaders of 3 Faiths In Plea for Tolerance

A plea for the protection of religious freedom in the United States was issued yesterday by fifty leading laymen of the Jewish, Catholic and Protestant faiths.

"Taking cognizance of attacks in various nations upon freedom of conscience, the undersigned Protestant, Catholic and Jewish laymen unite in public emphasis upon the fundamental truth, deducible from human experience, that the destruction of religious liberty is followed by the destruction of social, economic and political liberty," the plea says.

Library of Congress Exhibits Rare Editions of Rambam Works

Display Arranged By Dr. Schapiro, Chief of Semitic Dept.

WASHINGTON, March 18. — In commemoration of the 800th birthday of Moses ben Maimon, better known as Maimonides or the Rambam, one of the greatest sages and philosophers of the Jewish people, the Library of Congress has set up an exhibit featuring the writings of this great scholar.

Arranged under the direction of Dr. Israel Schapiro, chief of the Semitic division of the Library of Congress, the exhibit is said to be the most representative collection extant of early and rare editions of Maimonides' works. In addition, the exhibit includes valuable editions of early writers who in their work referred to Maimonides' philosophical and religious views.

The exhibit in the Library of Congress occupies several immense cases and is located on the second floor of the main hall, near the shrine of the Declaration of Independence. Among the distinguished visitors to view the display was the Spanish Ambassador.

Maimonides was born in Cordoba, Spain, in 1135, and before his death in 1204, succeeded in becoming one of the greatest Jewish philosophers, the compiler of the most comprehensive and logically arranged code of Jewish law, one of the earliest and most lucid commentators on the Mishna, a renowned practicing physician, and an author of medical treatises of historic importance. This range of writing is well represented in the Library of Congress exhibit. Among the outstanding are his "Commentary on the Mishna," the "Mishna Torah" (the Code), the "Moreh Nevuchim" (Guide for the Perplexed), "Responsa," and several important documents on medical subjects. Some of his works are in Arabic and others in Hebrew. Numerous translations in many other languages are included in the exhibit.

In setting up the display, the Library of Congress has joined in a world-wide celebration of the octocentennial anniversary of Maimonides. Officially, the observance is to start from March 30 and extend to the eve of Passover, April 17.

Dr. Greenberg Named Chairman of Drive Unit

Dr. Jacob Greenberg, associate superintendent of schools, has accepted the chairmanship of the educators' division of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities in the Spring campaign of the Federation to raise \$543,000 to meet 1935 minimum requirements of its twenty-five affiliated social service organizations.

Professor A. Broderick Cohen of Hunter College, leader of the teachers' group for the past five years, was named honorary chairman. The quota allotted to the teachers in the Federation's campaign was \$10,000.

First Hebrew Parley Set for Tel Aviv May 6

The first world congress of lovers of the Hebrew language, in which delegates from all continents will participate, will be held in Tel Aviv, Palestine, on May 6, it was announced yesterday by the Histadruth Ivrit of America.

Menachem Ribalov, editor of the Hebrew weekly Hadoar in New York, is authorized to arrange the election of American and Canadian delegates to the congress. The congress will be held under the official supervision of the Tel Aviv municipality.

I. Parshelsky Is Dead at 59 In Brooklyn

Federation Director for 20 Years Was Native of Iowa

Isaac Parshelsky, building supply dealer and a member of the board of directors of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities for more than twenty years, died yesterday afternoon at Long Island College Hospital where he underwent an operation on Saturday. He was 59 years old.

Mr. Parshelsky was born in Des Moines, Iowa, the son of Joshua and Theresa Parshelsky, but spent most of his life in Brooklyn. He was active in the affairs of the Brooklyn Hebrew Home and Hospital for the Aged; vice-president of the Industrial Home for the Blind; one of the founders of the School for Biblical Instruction; a member of the board of directors of the Brooklyn Hebrew Orphan Asylum and was also the founder of the Parshelsky Scholarship of Union College in Schenectady which, under its terms, is awarded to one Jew, one Catholic and one Protestant every year.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday morning at 11 o'clock at the Brooklyn Hebrew Home and Hospital for the Aged, 813 Howard avenue, Brooklyn. Burial will take place at Acacia Cemetery, Woodhaven, L. I.

Mr. Parshelsky is survived by two brothers, Moses L. and Abraham.

Statements of condolence have been issued by Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, president, and Assistant District Attorney Ralph K. Jacobs, secretary, of the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities.

Funeral Rites Today For Jennie Biderman

Jennie (Sheindi) Biderman, wife of I. W. Biderman, well-known Yiddish writer and book dealer, died at Israel Zion Hospital Sunday evening, following an operation for a tumor, it was learned yesterday.

Mrs. Biderman was 39 years old. She was born in Dorochoi, Rumania, and came to America in 1907. Funeral services will be held at the hospital at noon today.

(Continued from Page One) zigs has hitherto laid its hope upon the belief that the Polish government would never consent to give Danzig up voluntarily to the Reich. The statement of the Nazi government to England makes it clear, however, that some kind of understanding exists between Poland and Nazi Germany about Danzig. Thus the Jews in Danzig can no longer count on assistance from Poland.

Most of the Jews in Danzig are Polish citizens. In liquidating their business in Danzig they contemplate returning to their native country. A number of Jews in Danzig are also stateless, since they were formerly citizens of Germany.

Split in AJC Ranks Is Avoided By Compromise on Direct Vote

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

PHILADELPHIA, March 18.—The 345 delegates who attended the extraordinary session of the American Jewish Congress which concluded here yesterday, left today for their communities in various parts of the country. Upmost in their minds was the compromise reached at the Congress providing that direct elections of delegates to the American Jewish Congress be held not before 1937.

The compromise provides that only two-thirds of the delegates in 1937 are to be elected by direct voting. The remainder are to be appointed by various national organizations throughout the country.

Threatened Split

This compromise was reached as a result of severe opposition by the Labor bloc to the recommendations of the administrative committee of the Congress, which urged complete abolition of the system of direct elections. The Labor bloc threatened to break away from the Congress if direct elections were abolished.

A budget of \$150,000 for the ensuing year was adopted by the special session of Congress. This sum is to be raised by an assessment on national organizations, individual membership and quotas imposed on local community councils of the Congress, which will be organized as permanent groups throughout the country.

Committee Enlarged

Reorganization of the Congress machinery did not meet opposition at the session. Henceforth the administrative committee of the Congress will consist of ninety-five members, sixty-five of them residing in New York.

The importance of the administrative committee will be much diminished by the decentralization system which the Congress here voted. This system provides for the creation of seven regional chairmen, six of whom were elected at the session. The six elected are Dr. Harry Friedenwald of Baltimore, Seaboard Region; Samuel Kelesky, New England Region; Rabbi Solomon Goldman of Chicago, Midwest Region; Professor H. Ettlinger of the University of Texas, Southwest Region; P. Miller, Eastern Pennsylvania Region comprising also Southern New Jersey and Delaware; and Oscar Robins, Tri-State Region, compris-

ing Western Pennsylvania, Ohio and Oregon.

Rabbi Stephen Wise, who was elected president of the Congress, in accepting the presidency, stated that he returns to active harness only because a veteran was needed in these days of crisis in Jewish life. He pledged himself to "lead the American Jewish Congress to the end that in conjunction with all the forces of civilization in America and in every land we American Jews will not compromise with Hitlerism but will help to destroy it."

One of the resolutions adopted by the session endorses the work of rebuilding Palestine and promises co-operation in all the fund-raising efforts for Jewish work in Palestine.

Benes Intervenes For Czech Jews

PRAHA, March 18.—The Czechoslovakian consulates in Germany have been instructed to intervene in behalf of the Jewish citizens of Czechoslovakia residing in Germany and suffering from the boycott instituted by the Nazis against Jewish firms, it was disclosed today by Foreign Minister Benes.

Mr. Benes stated that several Czechoslovakian Jews suffered losses in Germany when compelled to leave the country. The Czechoslovakian ministry of foreign affairs announces that it is taking measures to secure for them whatever redress is possible from the German authorities.

Ask Nansen Office To Aid Reich Exiles

GENEVA, March 18.—The Nansen Office here was questioned today by leaders of the trade unions in Switzerland as to whether it would be in a position to help Jewish and other refugees from Germany who are now without passports, since they cannot return to Germany after the recent mass arrests there by the secret police of Jewish emigres who returned to Germany.

The administration of the Nansen Office replied that supplying Jewish refugees from Germany with Nansen passports would be outside its competence, since the refugees from Germany are to be dealt with by the autonomous body established by the League of Nations under James G. McDonald.

Temple Is Burglarized By Nazis in Kassel

BERLIN, March 18.—Nazis invaded a synagogue in the Kassel district today and desecrated the interior of the building.

The culprits stole the Ark of Covenant and destroyed two Holy Scrolls. Three other scrolls were stolen by the invaders.

Finland Pays Many Honors To Hebrew Poet

Dr. Tschernichowsky Is in Helsingfors for Kalevala Fete

HELSINGFORS.—The famous Hebrew poet, Dr. Saul Tschernichowsky, is now in Finland as the guest of the committee arranging the big national festival for the centenary of the publication of the national epos Kalevala, which Tschernichowsky translated into Hebrew.

Like all the other invited guests, he is the guest of the Finnish State, and the blue-white flag is displayed outside the hotel in Helsingfors, where they are staying among the other flags.

Welcomed to Mantere

Tschernichowsky, together with the other official guests, has been received by Minister Mantere in the name of the Finnish government and by the representatives of Finnish literature and science. He has also been received by the Presidium of the Jewish Communities of Helsingfors and Finland.

The Jewish Community has arranged a big reception in honor of Tschernichowsky; Dr. Pargament, the president of the Community, presided and said that the Jews of Finland were proud that their literature was represented by such a great Hebrew writer. Dr. Simon Federbusch, Chief Rabbi of Finland, welcomed Tschernichowsky as one of the founders of Hebrew literature and one of its greatest masters. He had been received in Finland not only as the representative of Hebrew literature, but of the Jewish people.
