School Heads Plan Curbs On Students

Rumanian Educators Impose Restrictions on Sunday Parley

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BUCHAREST, April 11.—The question of how to hamper the anti-Semitic activity of students was discussed today at a meeting of rectors of Rumanian universities under the chairmanship of the Rumanian Minister of Education.

A heated discussion developed with regard to permitting the students to hold their projected congress in the city of Crajova this Sunday. Fear was therefore expressed that anti-Jewish outbreaks may occur during the congress.

Allow Parley

Following a lengthy debate, the meeting of the rector decided to permit the congress to take place under drastic regulations. The number of delegates to the congress is to be limited, the decision provides.

The entire Rumanian press is devoting much space to the anti-Jewish outbreaks which took place in Bucharest during the last few days. The liberal press demands that the government take energetic measures against the students involved in these outbreaks.

Court Trial for 30

The thirty students arrested during the anti-Jewish riots here this week will be tried in court at the end of the month. It was pointed out here that Rumania is still under martial law and that the thirty arrested may therefore receive severe sentences.

The repercussions of the campaign launched by Dr. Vaida-Voevod are felt in every part of the country, but most of all in Kishineff, where the traditions of Krushchev and the Czarist pogromists of Kishineff are still strong, the Kishineff Yiddish daily Unser Zeit writes in an editorial:

"The agitation has been taken up here with full force. Anti-Semitic speakers are coming here from all over the place and springing up on all sides," the editorial states. "Anti-Semitic publications are appearing one after the other. We wonder where all the money comes from. The Cuzist and Vaida propaganda is making tremendous headway. Among their dis-

Schiff Name Removed From Frankfurt Street

FRANKFURT - AM - MAIN, April 11.—A street named after Jacob Schiff, the American Jewish philanthropist, was renamed here today by the Nazi authorities. It is to be known as Mummstrasse.

A dozen other streets carrying Jewish names were also renamed today, including one named after Heinrich Heine, the German Jewish poet, and after Sonnemann, founder of the Frankfurter Zeitung.

In connection with the latter, it was pointed out that Premier Goering's wife comes from a Sonnemann family and was known under this name until yesterday, when she became the wife of the Nazi leader.

Jews Are Seen Less Subject to Tuberculosis

Mortality Rate Lower Among Race, British Doctors Report

LONDON, April 11.—Tuberculosis is comparatively uncommon among the Jews, it was disclosed here today at a medical conference devoted to reports on the white plague made by medical research experts.

In towns where there is a large Jewish element in the population, the tuberculosis mortality among the Jews is, on the average, only half that of the Gentiles, data presented by the scientists revealed.

Several reasons were given in explanation of why the dreaded disease affects Jews less than non-Jews. It was explained that the Jew, thanks to his town-dwelling propensities, contracts in early childhood a slight and immunizing infection. An alternative suggestion was made that the laws of hygiene laid down by the Talmud encourage a comparatively healthy mode of life.

The theory was developed at the conference that Jews are less affected by tuberculosis because they show a preference for occupations which do not involve them in overwork, which is so often the determining factor in the outbreak of tuberculosis. On the other hand, it was pointed out that as artisans and small storekeepers, the Jews follow trades which are notori-

Replies of Dreiser to Queries Reveal Novelist Is Anti-Semitic

Theodore Dreiser, the novelist, believes the Jews should be willing to occupy a country of their own, he wrote in answer to charges of anti-Semitism made by Hutchins Hapgood, author of "The Spirit of the Ghetto."

"The man who wrote "An American Tragedy" also is convinced that the Jews "are money-minded, very pagan, very sharp in practice and usually, insofar as the rest is

concerned, they have the single objective of plenty of money, by means of which they build a fairly material surrounding."

In addition, the novelist has heard that "the profession of the law is today seriously considering, in such States as Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Oregon, limiting the number of Jewish lawyers."

Children Used To Push Drive On Religion

Drafted in White Russia to Stop Parents From Marking Holiday

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

MOSCOW, April 11.—School children are being mobilized in a number of Jewish townships in White Russia to join the anti-religious campaign in connection with the Passover next week, it was reported here today.

The children in the Jewish school at Zembini have devised a special plan of anti-religious work among their parents, the Oktiabr, Jewish Communist daily, reports.

Every pupil is under obligation to conduct a contest with his parents, to see which of them will do better in carrying out the anti-religious campaign.

Anti-Faith Slogans

Pupils must decorate their homes with pictures of Soviet leaders and with anti-religious slogans. Special anti-religious discussions are to be held at the homes. There are to be meetings of the parents at the schools during the days of Passover, at which lectures of a scientific character will be delivered showing up the harmfulness of religion.

The Jewish school at Streshin has arranged that in every home the children are to arrange a Lenin corner with anti-religious slogans. All the pupils have undertaken to convince their parents of the harmfulness of religion and to see that

Journalist's Wife Is Vienna Suicide

Estranged Spouse Also Tries to Kill Young Son of N. Y. Daily's Correspondent

VIENNA, April 11.—The American colony here was shocked by an attempted murder and suicide which took place in the family of Leon Schalit, an American newspaper correspondent here and translator of John Galsworthy's works into German.

Mrs. Schalit, who had been divorced from her husband and lived with her child, early this morning shot the three-year-old son and then committed suicide. The child was taken to the hospital in a critical condition.

Leon Schalit is the Vienna correspondent of the Jewish Morning Journal, a daily newspaper published in New York.

Few Jews Get Federal Posts In Holy Land

Arabs Hold Most Jobs, Hebrew Press There Protests

JERUSALEM, April 11.—Jewish officials in government offices average hardly one-half of one per cent of the non-Jewish workers and officials in public works and government institutions, is the complaint voiced in the Palestine Hebrew press today.

Hebrew newspapers emphasize that the Palestine government is systematically neglecting its obligations with regard to employing Jewish workers in public enterprises. Not a single Jew is employed in the extension and improvement works of the Haifa Harbor, they complain. Not one Jew is employed in the works of the Haifa municipality.

Only ten Jews have posts in the government works in Jerusalem, including the government printing press, the post office and the police school. Only five Jews are employed on Jerusalem municipality enterprises.

While using thousands of Arab workers, including Arabs from neighboring countries, in the building projects, the Palestine government avoids the employment of Jews, the Hebrew papers say.

The papers demand that the government reconsider its policy towards the Jews in the face of the \$10,000,000 loan which is to be used soon by the government for public works. This loan is to be repaid chiefly by income from taxes paid by Jews.

Racial Draft Advocated by Ludendorff

Would Ban Jews, States Man Who May Head Reich Army

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, April 11.—Military service in Germany must be conducted on racial lines only, General Erich von Ludendorff, who is expected to be recalled from retirement to take charge of Germany's new military machine, declared here today, making clear his attitude toward the problem of including German Jews in the forthcoming conscription.

Known for his hatred of the Jews long before the Nazis came into power, General Ludendorff is definitely against admitting them into the German army.

Remove Memorial Wreath

The Schild, official organ of the Union of Jewish War Veterans in Germany, discloses today that the Jewish War Veterans were requested to remove the wreath which they laid on the War Memorial in Berlin during the observance of War Heroes Day. When the veterans refused to accede to the demands, the wreath was removed by the authorities.

The same paper reports that many Jewish veterans have received orders from the authorities not to fly the black, white and red flag from their homes, despite the fact that they fought under it during the World War.

The Juedische Zeitung, a Jewish newspaper appearing in Breslau, in an article on the conscription expresses pessimism with regard to the possible admission of Jews into the army.

"We Jews, who are proud of our membership in the Jewish nation, would welcome the decision that general military service should include us too, like all other able-bodied citizens," the paper writes.

Extend Easter Holiday

The Easter vacation for students of the New York City public schools has been extended to include April 13, the first day of Passover, according to announcement made by the Jewish Sabbath Alliance yesterday.

A proposal by Chief Rabbi Dr. Niemerover, the Chief Rabbi of the Federation of Jewish Communities of Rumania and representative of the Jewish faith in the Senate, was adopted. It requires every rabbi in Rumania to preach on the first evening of Passover a sermon on Maimonides, who was born on the eve of Passover 800 years ago, and to see that the local Jewish schools teach the children the significance of Maimonides.

The Two Revisionist 'Petitions'

This is the last of a series of three articles by Vladimir Jabotinsky, the Revisionist leader, written specially for the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

When a man in America says, "I am not a Republican," it means that he is an adherent of some other party, probably a Democrat. When a man says the same thing in England, it means that he is a Monarchist. Which is a reminder that the same term can often cover quite different phenomena: another example is the word "petition."

The officially prescribed way in which a private group or individual in Palestine can approach the Permanent Mandate Commission in Geneva, is by sending their request or memorandum through the High Commissioner; and the document thus forwarded is called "petition." It may bear many signatures or one only: the Revisionist memorandum was signed by Mr. A. Weinschal on behalf of the Palestinian Revisionists.

This has nothing to do with the "Petition Movement" initiated by the Revisionists a year ago. That movement demands signatures en masse: between April and June, 600,000 signatures were collected, and this year we intend to raise the number up to several millions. The mass petition is not addressed to the Mandate Commission or to the League of Nations; its four different texts are explicitly addressed (a) to his British Majesty, (b) to the British Parliament, (c) and (d) to the government and parliament of the country where the petitioners reside. And, in fine, this mass petition has not yet been "presented" either in London or in any other capital, but will only be presented after many preliminary manifestations, culminating probably in a World Congress of the petitioners themselves.

Those who are genuinely interested should, therefore, remember that anything that may have happened in Geneva to Dr. Weinschal's memorandum, officially described as "petition," or may subsequently happen to his next memorandum to Geneva, has no bearing whatsoever on the progress of the real petition—the mass movement petition.

The two have also different aims. The mass petition is primarily meant to register all those who actually and personally want and need repatriation to Palestine. Secondly—to impress upon the governments of those countries where the Jewish distress has become a grave local problem that it is in those governments' interest to start a friendly talk with the British Mandatory about facilitating Jewish immigration. Thirdly—to bring home to British Jews' suffering, and to British public conscience the discrepancy between a pledge and a reality. The memorandum to the Man-

dates Commission had another aim, to "draw" that body into a discussion on that all-important subject: what is the true meaning of a "national home"—is it a Jewish State or just a new Jewish minority?

I know, of course, that there are people who consider such a discussion undesirable. We Revisionists consider it necessary and intend to go on promoting it until we obtain the inevitable final result: an admission, on the part of the League's organ supervising the Mandates, that "a national home for the Jewish people in Palestine" means Palestine transformed into a self-governing commonwealth with a Jewish majority; that this was the intent of the Balfour Declaration and of the Mandate. As I said, such an admission is inevitable provided there is a discussion: wherefore, we will see to it that the discussion should continue.

In forwarding to Geneva Mr. Weinschal's memorandum we knew, of course, that the first reaction of the Mandates Commission would be negative. For the last seven years or more I have been quoting in my public addresses a proverb current in one of the Mediterranean countries: "In politics, just as in true love, it is only after the seventh 'no' that you can hope to hear the bashful 'yes.' No important political advance has ever been reached in any other way but via several preliminary refusals: the first very dry and curt, the second probably angry. This is how the Jewish Legion was formed: the story began with Kitchener's "no." The same applies to the story of the Balfour Declaration, or to any political story worth telling. Whoever fears that preliminary cold drop had better renounce all hope of ever getting anywhere.

The Mandates Commission has said its first "no." That important body must forgive me for pointing out that this answer clashes with the Commission's own attitude with regard to all the problems implied in our question. Logically, the present situation in Palestine can only end in one of the following three ways: (a) the Mandatory withdraws, leaving Palestine a State with an Arab majority; (b) the Mandatory stays on forever and ever; (c) a State with a Jewish majority.

As to the first eventuality—the Permanent Mandates Commission at half a dozen of its sessions, when dealing with the question of a Legislative Council for Palestine has always stubbornly maintained that any kind of majority rule by the Arabs would endanger the Jewish national home, would therefore be contrary to the Mandate, and was therefore inadmissible—which all, and a fortiori, applies to an Arab State.

As to the second eventuality ("the Mandatory strays on forever")—that would be tantamount to annexation, therefore contrary to the very letter and essence of the League of Nations' Covenant. Some people in England may desire it, but there is at least one body under the sun which simply cannot admit such a perversion of the Covenant—and that body is

Between the Lines

Dreiser an Anti-Semite

Ever since Sinclair Lewis won the Nobel Prize for Literature, Theodore Dreiser has been sore at the world. Considering himself "the greatest American novelist"—though one wonders on what grounds—Mr. Dreiser feels that the world has done him an injustice by overshadowing him with Lewis.

Dissatisfied with everything and everybody, Mr. Dreiser is also dissatisfied with the Jews. He finds the Jews in America "multiplying in number." He speaks of the Jews as being "money-minded, very pagan, very sharp in practice." Their single objective, according to Dreiser, is "plenty of money."

Misrepresents Facts

Apparently ignorant of the fact that there are thousands of Jews engaged in farming in the United States, Mr. Dreiser makes the allegation that the Jews "do not enter upon farming." He deliberately closes his eyes to the well known fact that there are tens of thousands of Jewish workers in America and venture to say that "the Jews are not the day laborers of the world." To him the Jews are "by preference lawyers, bankers, merchants, money-lenders, middlemen and brokers."

Mr. Dreiser is not satisfied with just attacking the Jews. Like the Nazis, he speaks also of half-Jews and quarter-Jews. They too are not kosher to Mr. Dreiser, for "because of their Jewish blood they adhere acially and religiously with Jewry."

"Remove" Jews, He Urges

Exposing himself as a protagonist of Hitler's racial "blood theory," Mr. Dreiser, who for years posed as a Liberal and even as a semi-Communist, is dissatisfied with the fact that Jews are using American names and "deliberately pass as Americans." He recommends nothing more nor less than the "removal" of all the Jews to a separate territory. He urges that various nations "now quarreling with the Jew and his internationalism" should call an international conference with all Jewry and "therein thrash out all the problems now seemingly worrying so many of the nations as well as the Jews."

A "Liberal" Exposed

As far as American Jewry is concerned, little attention will probably be paid to Mr. Dreiser's outburst. Hutchins Haggood, who has brought out Mr. Dreiser's views on the Jews by publishing in the Nation, deserves, however, the credit for exposing Mr. Dreiser. Knowing what Mr. Dreiser things of them, the Jews of America will now know what to think of Mr. Dreiser.

Is Dreiser an anti-Semite? the current issue of the Nation asks, making public his anti-Jewish views. Certainly, will be the answer of the Jews of America. And not only of the Jews, but of every liberal-minded person.

Jewish Council To Open Parley Here Sunday

400 Delegates of Local Groups Expected to Attend

Problems of Jewish communal organization and the relation of local community councils to federations of charities and other institutions will be discussed by a number of speakers at the annual convention of the Jewish Council of Greater New York which opens at two o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Hotel Pennsylvania.

Delegates from more than 400 organizations, congregations, societies and lodges of Greater New York are expected to attend.

The Council which has, for a number of years, been working together with the American Jewish Congress and other organizations, devoting itself specifically to questions relating to local relief, adult education, and similar activities, aims to give organized form to the community—in line with the Keshillah idea—by the creation of a central clearing house and information exchange that will coordinate and unify various scattered undertakings. Already the Jewish Information Bureau, 103 Park avenue, which the Council has helped to establish, is fulfilling part of this function.

The annual convention will be addressed by Morris Rothenberg, president of the Zionist Organization of America; M. Maldwin Fertig, Abraham Goldberg, Carl Sherman, Dr. Joseph Tennenbaum, chairman of the boycott committee of the American Jewish Congress; Max Silverstein, grand master of the Order of Brith Abraham; Rabbi M. A. Heller and others.

A review of Jewish recent events will be presented in the address of the chairman, Bernard G. Richards. Jacob L. Warkow, secretary, will deliver the annual report.

Replies of Dreiser to Queries Reveal Novelist Is Anti-Semitic

Pennsylvania Bar Association correctly, the fine integrity which at least is endorsed and, to a degree, followed by the lawyers of other nationalities," Dreiser explains.

An interchange of letters, published in the latest issue of the Nation, reveals that Dreiser thinks an international conference would be a big help to Jews, "anti-Semitism being what it is today, culture and liberality to the contrary notwithstanding."

"They should now take steps to assemble and consider their State and their future," the novelist wrote under date of December 28, 1933. "There are lands as well as nations . . . which should be willing and able to furnish them forth not only with an entirely adequate country but with the loans and equipment necessary to start them upon an independent and, as I see it, certain to be successful and even glorious career as a nation."

"But not wanting that, some anti-nationalistic if not anti-social feeling or mood animating them, why not a program of race or nation blending here in America, the type or kind of race or nation blending that has been in progress here since America was founded among the English, French, Germans, Italians, Poles, Hungarians, Russians, Swedes, Chinese and others?"

"As Shaw urged only recently, why not every Jewish male forced to marry a Gentile female, and every Jewish female a Gentile male?"

In answering one of Dreiser's letters, that dated October 10, 1933, Hapgood sums up his impressions of it as follows:

"This letter of yours," he de-

clares, "is a clear expression not only of anti-Semitism but of intense nationalism in general. If you hadn't signed the letter I might have thought that it was written by a member of the Ku Klux Klan or a representative of Hitler."

Dreiser denied exaggerating the number of Jews in the United States.

"It is true that the census for 1927 shows the total Jewish population in the United States to be 4,288,000 as against a total population of 118,000,000, but the accuracy of this can certainly be a question," the novelist stated, "particularly in the face of the fact that so many Jews deliberately pass as Americans, using American names and, to a degree, this would be further qualified because of the number of half-Jews and quarter-Jews who, none the less, because of their Jewish blood, adhere racially and religiously with Jewry."

Lublin Yeshivah Given Important Privileges

Seventh Junior Hadassah girls contributed \$2,100. The out-of-town guests came from twenty-three cities in the Midwest Region. The sum of \$7,000 was raised outside Chicago.

World Press Digest

Natural Law Held Supreme to Rambam

The Manchester Guardian, in a long article devoted to Maimonides in connection with his 800th birthday, says:

The created world displayed to us by Maimonides is one in which natural law is supreme. The world is patterned on its creator, and its creator is one; nor is he capricious; his monarchy is constitutional. This conception gives the key to a logic for science: the book of nature is a book of law. But since nature is the work of God, natural law is the law of God. Science is thus more than science. It is the gateway to religion. This idea of the divine reference of the rational universe has sometimes made Maimonides seem a pure rationalist. Rationalist indeed he was, but his rationalism was of a kind which was impregnated perforce by historical and psychological considerations.

The breadth of his intellectual interests reflects a breadth of human sympathy, and Maimonides' correspondence abounds with touches which suggest not the mere student but the leader and educator.

they do not observe Passover.

The Jewish school at Retchitcha is arranging that the school children must see that their parents must all work in the fields on Passover. On the Seder Nights there will be anti-religious performances in the schools, and all pupils and their parents will be required to attend. The same is being done in most of the Yiddish schools in White Russia.

Reports are arriving from other places, however, the Oktibr complains, that the anti-religious work is being neglected. In Uritche there was once an atheist club, but it has gone out of existence, the paper points out, warning that the clericals are again active in the town.

"They (the clericals) have converted one of the houses into a synagogue," Oktibr writes, "where even members of the artisans cooperative go to attend the services. There are many members of the artisans cooperative who do not even go to work on Saturdays."

"In Turov, another town in White Russia, things are even worse," the paper complains. "Some of the pupils in the Jewish school there have fallen under the influence of the clericals and are carrying out religious ceremonies."

Report Nazi-U. S. Radio Exchange

Mr. Ludwig Lore writes in the New York Post as follows:

Hearst newspapers, usually exceptionally well informed regarding Nazi propaganda, reported several days ago that negotiations are being attempted with the State Department in Washington which "if successful would eventuate in an exchange of broadcast programs between the networks hereabouts and German radio stations. . . . The purpose back of the German overtures," the dispatch continues, "is to neutralize as far as possible hostile sentiment in the United States concerning the German dictator."

Official Nazi propaganda with Washington's stamp of approval? . . . It sounds fantastic! Attention, anti-Fascists . . . !

Randolph Churchill Lauds Banker Jews

The London Morning Post, reporting a speech delivered by Randolph Churchill on the Jews, quotes him as saying:

"Only two races in the world understand banking—the English and the Jews.

"As a result of the liberal and tolerant treatment meted out in this country, we have probably the finest set of Jews in the world. It is only because the Germans are such a dull, brutish people that they cannot compete with the Jews."

In England, said Mr. Churchill, Fascists were trying more and more to imitate the Hitler form of Fascism than the more benignant form of Mussolini. "Fascism is stamped with the same mark of blonde beast as the Nazi party."

Prince to Speak Sunday At Anti-Hitler Meeting

Prince Hubert von Loewenstein will be the principal speaker at a mass meeting to protest Chancellor Hitler's military policy which will be held Sunday evening at Mecca Temple under the auspices of the Friends of German Democracy.

Dr. Harry Lee Franklin, former American consul at Berlin and Leipzig, will also speak and Mayor LaGuardia is expected to appear for a few minutes. Eugene F. Grigat, president of the America First and Always Society, an anti-Nazi group, will be the chairman.
