Cohen Scoffs At Protocols Link by Nazis

B'nai B'rith Head Brands Charge False; Trial Resumes April 29

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) CINCINNATI, April 25.-Efforts of the Nazis to involve the B'nai B'rith in the libel suit brought by Jewish leaders in Berne, Switzerland, against local Nazis for spreading the so-called "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," were ridiculed here today in a statement issued by Alfred M. Cohen, international president of the B'nai B'rith.

The trial in Berne will open on Monday, April 29. Mr. Cohen's statement reads as follows:

"The information brought by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from Berne, that efforts will be made to involve the B'nai B'rith in the "Protocols" trial, which will be resumed next Monday, was not entirely new to us.

"Of course the allegations of the Nazis are preposterously false, just as the 'Protocols' themselves The Nazis allege that the action described by the 'Protocols' took place at a session of the 'Congress of Jewish B'nai B'rith Order' and the time they set is 'the year 1897.' Our information is that story involves Hungarian

"As a matter of fact, never has there been a B'nai B'rith Lodge in all of Hungary, and the first lodge in Switzerland was not organized until a much later period. The B'nai B'rith is an American institution, and its conventions are as a rule held in the United States. Only once did the executive committee hold a meeting outside the United States, and that was in 1912."

Trial to Resume April 29 Despite Nazi Efforts

BERNE, April 25.—All Nazi
efforts to secure further postponement of the trial in the "Protocols of the Elders of Zion" case instituted by the Federation of Jewish Communities in Switzerland, failed when it was officially announced today that the trial will resume on Monday as scheduled.

No further witnesses will appear before the court when the trial reopens. There will only be a hearing of three experts and then the lawyers of both sides will deliver their summations.

WarsawSuburb Scene of Riots During Easter

Jews Attacked, Temple, Stores Stoned in Polish Town

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
WARSAW, April 25.—Riots in which many Jews were attacked and the windows of a synagogue and numerous Jewish shops were smashed broke out during the Easter holidays in the township of Ryki near Warsaw.

The riots started when Jewish pedestrians were molested in the streets by anti-Semitic Polish youths Samson Teichman, a Jewish merchant, was taken to the hospital, suffering serious injuries.

Anti-Jewish boycott posters leading to clashes between Jews and anti-Semitic Polish youths were displayed in the city of Chorzow, Upper Silesia. The posters were placed chiefly on the windows of Jewish shops. The Jews, trying to remove them, were attacked by the young Poles. Police intervened, but the posters reappeared later after having been removed under police supervision.

In Danzig many Jewish shops were plastered during the Easter holidays with anti-Jewish placards, and the walls of the main streets in the city were painted with anti-Jewish slogans.

Austria Jews Set to Start Own Schools

First Will Be Opened in Vienna, Government Is Informed

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
VIENNA, April 25.—The first
elementary Jewish school will be opened here by the Jewish community, according to a decision adopted today as a result of the recent order of the government segregating Jewish from non-Jewish children in the municipal

The resolution was transmitted today by the Jewish community to the Austrian government with a letter explaining that "the establishment of the first Jewish school need not be considered by the government as releasing the State from its obligations to provide for the schools of the Jewish national minority.'

Likened to Reich Situation

The segregation of Jewish children from non-Jewish in the schools maintained by the government has created a situation similar to the one in Nazi Germany. Jewish children are embarrassed by the fact that they are segregated. In certain schools there is only one Jewish child on a separate bench entirely isolated from the other children in the classroom.

Under the existing international treaties guaranteed by the League of Nations, the Austrian government is obliged to grant equal treatment to the Jews and other national minorities of the country. These obligations are, however being constantly violated in Austria despite the assurances of Chancellor Schuschnigg that the government does not discriminate against the Jewish population. The segregation of Jewish children from non-Jewish in the schools is only one of the many anti-Jewish discriminations in the country.

Palestine Gets **Chemical Firm**

of New \$500,000 Enterprise

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, April 25.-A new Palestine chemical company, to be known as the Palestine Chemical Industries, was established here today with a capital of \$500,000 by Emanuel Neuman, well known American Jewish leader, and Nahum Menn, a Jewish industrialist of Poland.

Dr. Chaim Weizmann, former president of the World Zionist Organization, has agreed to be chairman of the new company, which was formed after a series of conferences between Mr. Neuman and Lord Melchett, Lord Melchett represented the interests of the Imperial Chemical Industries of England.

Speakers in National Broadcast Assail Anti-Semitism

MOSCOW, April 25.—A special radio program to combat anti-Semitism was broadcast this morning over all Soviet stations, in connection with the growing anti-Jewish movement throughout Eu-

The speakers cited the pogroms which took place in Russia under the Czarist regime and denounced anti-Semitism as a "counter-revolutionary tool" and as a means to "incite workers against workers."

Gifts valued at 100,000 roubles (approximately \$60,000) were sent today by the city of Kharkov to Biro-Bidjan, the autonomous Jewish region in the Far East, on the occasion of the first anniversary of the proclamation of the region as an autonomous part of Soviet

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, April 25.—A resolution of compromise "to submit to Zionist discipline, retaining at the same time liberty of action in accordance with Zionist conscience," was adopted by the Judenstaat party, a Zionist group which concluded its party convention here yesterday.

Reich to Ban All Jewish **Publications**

Nazis Compiling Index of World's 'Aryan' Lawyers

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, April 25.—All German Jewish papers in Germany may be compelled to suspend publication as the result of a new law made public today, providing that racial and religious publications are henceforth forbidden.

The same law provides that persons who cannot prove their 'Aryan" origin from the year 1800, may not be publishers of a newspaper or directors of publishing

A world index of "Aryan" lawyers will be compiled by the Nazis in Germany, it is announced in the Fraenkische Zeitung, a Nazi daily published in Nuremberg by Julius Streicher.

The paper reports that the Central Bureau for International Law at the Nazi Lawyers Association has started to compile the index "in order to facilitate the supply of racially fit attorneys all over the world."

Cites Difficulties

"It is not easy to get the Jews out of Germany," the same paper complains today. The Streicher organ emphasizes that "it has been possible to clear the Jews out of public offices but there is no possibility of preventing them from being engaged in commerce unless no German ever buys anything again from a Jew."
"Unfortunately," the paper

writes, "this seems a very remote likelihood. Nor is it possible to prevent the Jews from practicing in liberal professions. It should, however, be possible to keep the Jews out of practice in the official Sick Funds for these are public institutions and should be regulated in the same way as all other public offices."

"Honorary Aryan"
The Hessische Landeszeitung complains that it has received information from a reliable source in Frankfurt-am-Main that a well known Jew there is to be proclaimed an "honorary Aryan.

Dreiser Disavows Nazi Link, **Anti-Semitism in Interview**

The question whether Theodore Dreiser is anti-Semitic, which has created much discussion since the publication two weeks ago of a letter by the novelist criticizing the Jews, has been answered by himself in the negative.

"I have no hatred for the Jew and nothing to do with Hitler or Fascism," says Dreiser, in a statement in the current issue of The New Masses.

Dreiser's statement was made as the result of an interview with representatives of The New Masses, and a further discussion in the magazine's office.

An editorial in the magazine ex-

presses dissatisfaction with Dreiser's statement, but voices the hope that he will not find it impossible to "regain his traditional place as a fighter for human liberty."

Dreiser's statement said, in part: "I make a distinction between classes. I draw a distinction between the Jewish worker and the Jewish exploiter. Everybody knows that I am an anti-capitalist. I identify the interests of the Jewish workers with the interests of all other works. . . . If my letters are used by the Nazis as propaganda, I repudiate such use. I have no hatred for the Jew and nothing to do with Hitler or Fascism."

Isserman on Social Justice

(Special to the J.D.B.)

DETROIT, April 25.—Rabbi Ferdinand M. Isserman of Temple Israel, St. Louis, was one of the principal speakers at the first mass meeting of Michigan members of the National Union for Social Justice, held here last night. He was on the platform upon the invitation of Father Charles E. Coughlin, radio priest founder of the organization which the content of the organization which the content of the organization which the content of the organization which will be the organization wh

founder of the organization which claims a membership of 8,500,000 qualified voters throughout the country.

Following is the full text of Rabbi Isserman's address:

"All over the world. Jews are celebrating this night, the close of the Passover festival, which commemorates the emancipation of the ancient Hebrews from the tyranny of the Pharaohs. Rejoicing in their divinely achieved freedom, they crossed the Red Sea and exultingly marched into the desert to receive the Ten Commandments, the cornerstone of civilized morality. In that ancient ethical code, the ideal of social justice found expression. From Sinai to this day, social justice has been part of the religious tradition of Judaism. At the hands of the prophets, it received immortal articulation. Hear again the words of Isaiah, read for centuries in the synagogue on the Day of Atonement, the most important day in the Jewish religious calendar: 'Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry and that thou bring the poor, that are cast out, to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?'

"From the teachers of Israel, the social justice principle entered into the soul of Jesus and thus was woven into the fabric of the Catholic and Protestant tradition. The social justice encyclicals of Popes, the proclamations of Protestant church bodies, the statements of rabbis and synagogue organizations are merely the extended shadows of the social idealism of these Hebrew spiritual giants. The Central Conference of American Rabbis, in keeping with Judaism's finest tradition, drew up a program of social justice before the depression, which maintained that human rights take precedence over property rights, and urged the recognition of the principles of collective bargaining; a living wage; unemployment, sickness and disability insurance: oldage and mothers' pensions; the five-day week; the protection of women in industry, and voiced op-

position against child labor.

"Like most of my colleagues in the rabbinate, I have been an advocate of social justice since my ordination. Having served as a member of the Social Justice Commission of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, and five years ago having been the organizer, and still being the chairman of the St. Louis Commission of Social Justice, I accepted the invitation of the Rev. Father Charles E. Coughlin to speak with a Protestant clergyman, some congressmen and himself on the necessity for social justice before this meeting.

"I am not a member of the National Union for Social Justice, but in sympathy with much though not all of its program. I speak as an individual, representing no organization, inspired by my faith to serve my followers of all creeds.

"In order to be here tonight, I had to absent myself from the Passover services in my own congregation this morning. But how better could I celebrate the festival of freedom than by raising my voice in behalf of social justice? Is it not true that without freedom there can be no justice? When Moses dared to champion the cause of the oppressed slaves in Egypt, even though he was a member of the royal house, he was compelled to flee into exile. If, among the slaves, there had been prophetic spirits, they could not have raised their voices on behalf of social justice in the face of Pharach's

"Even as in those days, so the modern Pharaohs, whom we now call dictators, rule with an iron hand and with a reign of terror. With democracy lying prostrate, with liberty sneered at as an outworn superstition in lands where these Pharaohs rule, the champions of social justice are either terror-stricken or bemoan their fate in concentration camps. If it were not for the liberty and democracy that prevail in America and that with the help of God will continue to prevail in our land, this meeting and the national organization which sponsored it, would not have been possible. * * *

"We who believe in social justice, no matter how we differ on the application of these principles to the American scene, must be one in the determination to maintain at all costs, and at all sacrifices, the principles of democracy and of liberty, not only sacred because of the sacrifice of our heroic (Continued on Page Three)

Between the Lines

The Nation this week starts a series of articles on "Nazi Jew-Baiting in America," reviewing Nazi activities in the United States which were reported months ago in the pages

Similar series of articles have appeared recently in the magazine Today and in other American publications, bringing to light the Nazi movement in different parts of our country and the anti-Semitic activities it is conducting throughout the nation.

of the Jewish Daily Bulletin.

While the Jews of America will certainly be grateful to The Nation and the other publications for exposing the Nazis in the same way as the Ku Klux Klan was once exposed by the general press, it seems to me that these exposures, though they are well intended, also have their negative side.

Harmful Publicity

Some may agree and others disagree with me when I say that the Nazi movement in America is not so strong as to deserve the publicity it is given. This publicity only serves the Nazi cause. It keeps the Nazis always in the public eye. It makes the average American believe that the Nazi organization in America is a strongly organized force. It quotes the Nazi speakers and brings their words to the attention of millions of readers who would otherwise never have known about the Nazi propaganda in this country.

This is exactly what the Nazi leaders in America desire. They know very well that they could not reach the large American public through their own sheets. They know very well that their meetings would hardly be attended by Americans. They are therefore more than satisfied to see articles and reports about them in the general press, no matter how antagonistic these articles may be.

A Mysterious Informant

It is no coincidence that the Jewish Daily Bulletin, being a Jewish publication and naturally 100 per cent anti-Nazi, is nevertheless being constantly informed of the Nazi activities in America by Nazis themselves. From time to time someone with a marked German accent telephones our editorial offices, offering information on the doings of the Nazis. This information is always of an unfavorable nature to the Nazis. Nevertheless, some mysterious informants seem to be very much interested in seeing this information published.

The information offered is very seldom used, although upon verification, it turns out as a rule to be correct. The mystery about it is, however, that the informant, who seems to be a well-posted Nazi insider, never consents to give his name when he gives information over the telephone.

Silent Checking Preferable

It is quite clear that any publicity given to the activities of the Nazis in America is only helping them. Ignored by the press, and left to themselves, the Nazi groups in America would die a natural death since

Put Alien British Jews At 55,000

Interesting figures on the Anglicization of British Jews are given in the following editorial in the London Jewish Chronicle:

According to the latest published figures, the number of aliens in England and Wales dropped from some 280,000 in the year 1911 to some 230,000 in 1921. In the following decade they dwindled still further to some 180,000. In twenty years, therefore, their number has fallen by 100,000, or more than a third. Even the past three years, with their improved trade and German refugee influx, registered not an increase but a small drop. Clearly there is no "aliens problem" in this country, though whether the diminution of neighborly contacts with members of other nations is a moral or political gain in these times is another matter. Owing to the absence of a religious census it is impossible to say exactly how many of the 180,-000 aliens in the country three years ago were Jews. Assuming that the 55,000 enumerated Russians and Poles were such, and omitting the smaller numbers of the other nationalities, we should arrive at a total of 55,000 foreign-born Jews in our community of 350,000. The Anglicization of British Jewry, even making allowance for foreignborn Jews in Scotland not included in the present figures, is proceeding apace. It is the

very few would hear of their existence.

This does not mean, of course, that the Nazi work in the United States should be left unchecked. The checking should be done, however, by institutions, such as the MacCormack Congressional Committee or any other private or government investigating body, rather than by the press. The organizations interested in investigating the Nazi machinations in America will get much better results if the press of America ignores the Nazis for the time being.

The articles in the Nation on "Nazi Jew-Baiting in America" will certainly be appreciated by the Jews. I am afraid, however, that they will be appreciated also by the Nazis. They convey Nazi propaganda indirectly by reproducing Nazi leaflets and quoting Nazi slogans. This is exactly what the Nazis in America wish. They wish to reach those Americans whom they cannot attract through their own publications and their own meetings.



them reaction would remain unchallenged, greed and avarice would rule undisturbed, and the woes of suffering men would continue. Lest we be led astray by Fascist whisperings that freedom and democracy are inefficient media of government in a complex industrial civilization, we must remember that wherever democracy has been destroyed, it has been destroyed not to help the common man, but further to degrade and enslave him. I would rather be a beggar in rags eating a dry morsel, the master of my destiny and the captain of my soul, than a sleek, well-fed, pampered, servile hireling, goose-stepping to the whims and caprices of a dictator or despot.

"Moses, a prince in Egypt, preferred starvation in the desert with freedom to royalty with acquiescence in oppression, injustice and slavery. The first plank in the program of any social justice group must be a rededication to and a declaration of faith in democracy and liberty.

"In this vast continent, which a kind and generous Destiny has entrusted to our safe-keeping, there is no moral and no practical reason why millions of persons should be the wards of private or governmental charity, and millions of others should live continuously on the border line of starvation, while factories are idle and fields lie fallow.

"We suffer not from over-production, but from under-consumption. We have not been as generous in distributing the bounties of nature as Providence has been with us. Who stretched this country from the Atlantic to the Pacific? Who ploughed the courses of its rivers? Who raised its beetling mountains? Who filled its hills with mineral wealth? Who put coal in its mines and oil in its lands? Not man, but God, working through nature, preparing through arduous centuries the abundance now within our grasp.

"We must in the administration of this vast domain be as generous as was God in endowing it. We must, by applying the principles of social justice to our economy, guarantee to every man, woman and child, born and living under our azure skies, the fundamentals of existence, the opportunity for life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. To the rights guaranteed to us in the constitution, we must add a new moral charter, the right of every individual to a job and to freedom from economic insecurity as far as the limitations of our resources permit. These can be attained through the American scheme of government without the importation of any foreign political 'isms.'

"If this National Union for Social Justice will rally to maintain democracy, and if it will endeavor to secure social justice for men and women of all creeds, of all denominations, of all races, if its program will equally include black and white, Catholic and Protestant, Jew and Christian, native and foreign-born, if it will be animated not with malice but with mercy, not with hate but with love, not with frenzy but with reason, not with feat but with faith, then it

Replying to his attackers, Dr. Naumann branded them as Zionists and emphasized that even if the situation for the Jews in Germany grows worse, he and his followers will still remain loyal to the Nazis and their program.
