Reich Sage Is Forbidden Speech Right

Buber Victim of Edict; Use of 'Fatherland' Barred to Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
BERLIN, April 29.—Martin Buber, philosopher and one of the most important spiritual leaders of the Jews in Germany, was today prohibited by the Nazi authorities from delivering public speeches.

The Ministry of Propaganda simultaneously issued an order today forbidding Jewish leaders to refer to Germany as their Fatherland in their public speeches. Similarly, they are warned against urging Jews in Germany to remain in the country in expectation of better times.

Scientists Warned

German scientists are cautioned in the Frankische Tageszeitung today "not to shield Jewish colleagues." The paper, which is edited by Julius Streicher, warns the "Aryan" scientists that "a catastrophe will befall them also" if they have a good word to say for Jewish scientists or physicians.

"No matter what contribution Jews have made toward German science, we are not able to accept them," the Frankische Tageszeitung writes. The paper attacks Prof. Specht of the Erlangen University for giving credit to Jewish scientists for certain discoveries.

The entire Nazi press voices its satisfaction at the verdict issued by the mixed court in Cairo in the case which Jewish leaders there brought against the local Nazis. The court refused to recognize the issue raised by the Jews. This, the Angriff writes, makes it clear that the Jews lost the battle.

Airplane Crash Kills Kin of Lord Bearstead

LONDON, April 29.—Arthur Sebag Montefiore, a descendant of the Jewish philosopher and a nephew of Lord Bearstead, was killed today in an airplane disaster in Ramsgate.

The victim was 23 years old. He was active in Jewish affairs and took special interest in the fate of German Jewish refugees.

Split in Shekel System Here Revealed in Mizrachi Appeal

A split in the Shekel system in America, through which delegates are elected to the Zionist Congress, was seen here yesterday from appeals published in the New York Jewish press, urging the Jews of America to buy specific Mizrachi and Judenstaat party Shekolim.

In a statement issued yesterday by Leo Wolfson, chairman of the Central Shekel and Election Board of America, it is pointed out that these appeals "are bound to create a false impression as to the character of the Shekel."

Vandals Smash Pulpit Used by Samaritans

NABLUS, Palestine, April 29.—Unknown persons smashed the ancient stone pulpit in the courtyard on Mount Gerizim, where the Samaritan Jews have been performing their Passover ritual for centuries.

The stone was a relic believed to date back to Golden Epoch in Samaritan history. The police have started an investigation.

Czech Capital Strikes Blow at Drive on Jews

Jails Nazi Leaders of Boycott on Lawyers and Doctors

PRAHA, April 29.—A number of Nazi leaders in Czechoslovakia were sentenced today to varying terms of imprisonment for organizing a boycott movement against Jewish lawyers and doctors.

Dr. Friedrich Chvatel, a Nazi lawyer, leader of the movement, received the highest sentence of two months in jail. Several others were given shorter sentences.

During the trial it was revealed that Dr. Chvatel was in direct contact with Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Nazi minister of Propaganda. Dr. Chvatel urged Dr. Goebbels to broadcast over the radio an appeal from Germany to all Germans residing abroad that they boycott the Jews in whichever country they live.

Deny Anti-Semitism

The Academic Senate of the German University in Praha transmitted a memorandum signed by all its members and by the rector, Prof. Grosser, to all members of the government, repudiating the charges made against the university in many newspapers here that it has become a nest of anti-Semitic swastika racialism.

"Systematic agitation," the memorandum says, "has been carried on for some time against the German University and its professors and students, which has now culminated in an openly proclaimed boycott of the German clinics by some of the Praha sick funds. The principal objection leveled against the university is that it has adopted swastika ideas.

"In the medical faculty of the German University, there are now at work forty-two professors, sixteen of whom are non-'Aryans,'" (Continued on Page Four)

Mexican City Tries to Oust Business Men

Jews of Hermosillo Send S. O. S. to Capital as Officials Aid Drive

MEXICO CITY, April 29.—An S. O. S. from the Jewish community of Hermosillo, in the Province of Sonora, was received here by Jewish leaders and made public in the Jewish press today.

The appeal relates that in Hermosillo, anti-Semitic activities are assuming dangerous proportions for the entire Jewish population. Anti-Jewish propaganda is being conducted by a group of individual Mexican merchants who wish to get rid of Jewish competitors. This group has succeeded in winning the support of the local Chamber of Commerce.

In addition to a resolution adopted by the Chamber of Commerce obligating its members to boycott Jewish firms, an official announcement was also issued by the Chamber that those members who do not support the anti-Jewish boycott will be expelled.

The governor of Hermosillo, in an effort to help the anti-Jewish merchants in their plans to get rid of the Jews, has raised the tax rates for Jewish merchants only. Jewish firms are compelled by the governor to pay twice as much in taxes as non-Jews.

A warning was issued by the anti-Jewish merchants to the Jews of Hermosillo that if they do not leave the town voluntarily "direct measures will be taken" to force them out.

Welfare Workers Hold Protest Rally

Federation Employees Demand Right of Collective Bargaining

The Association of Federation Workers, an organization of employees of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies, were to hold a mass meeting last night at the Hotel Delano to protest the denial to them of the right of collective bargaining.

The organization has been refused a hearing on the question of the allocation of funds raised in a successful \$2,071,000 drive by the Federation. The association contends that sufficient funds should be allotted to Federation's ninety-one affiliated agencies to allow for the rescinding of salary cuts instituted in the last three years.

In reply to the A. F. W.'s request for a hearing, Samuel Leidesdorf, president of the Federation, stated that the board of trustees does not recognize the organization's demand that employee representatives have a voice in budgetary allocations. He maintained that Federation and the employees in its agencies do not have an "employer-employee relationship."

Nazis Lose First Tilt In 'Protocols' Trial

Court Voids Perjury Charge on Weizmann

BERNE, April 29.—The charges which the Nazi lawyer Ruef has brought against Dr. Chaim Weizmann, former president of the World Zionist Organization, accusing him of perjury in connection with his testimony at the "Protocols" trial last October, have been dismissed, the court announced today at the resumption of the trial.

The Nazi lawyer demanded that the court postpone decision on the charges against Dr. Weizmann until all other perjury charges are settled. The court rejected this demand.

New Farm Bank To Be Formed By Palestine

Will Grant Long Term Loans at Low Rates, Wauchope Says

JERUSALEM, April 29.—An announcement that an Agricultural Mortgage Bank for long-term loans will be established shortly by the Palestine government, was made today by Sir Arthur Wauchope, the High Commissioner of Palestine, addressing the Farmer Day celebration in Acre.

The loans will be granted at low interest rates, the High Commissioner said. The government will also continue its annual grant of \$15,500 for the Research Institute in Rehoboth, he added.

The High Commissioner emphasized the fact that the Palestine government is interested in doing everything to insure rural prosperity in Palestine.

Push Reforestation

Special interest is taken by the government in the reforestation of Palestine. There are today more than 3,000,000 trees in the country, the High Commissioner stated. The government is also sending (Continued on Page Four)

Attacks on Pastor in Geneva Linked to Berne Case

BERNE, April 29.—The "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," the notorious documents upon which anti-Semites all over the world base their anti-Jewish allegations, was termed in the court here today by Dr. Arthur Baumgarten, an expert, as nothing but a forgery and "trashy literature."

Dr. Baumgarten was the first expert called by the court to appear at the "Protocols" trial which was resumed today after a lapse of six months. The trial is a continuation of a court hearing held here last October at which prominent Jewish and non-Jewish personalities testified that the "Protocols" constitute an anti-Semitic forgery. This forgery has been established also by the London Times.

Nazi Objection Overruled

At the reopening of the trial today, the Nazi lawyers made strong but vain effort to have the trial again postponed. Led by Col. Ulrich Fleischhauer, the chief Nazi "expert" who was brought from Germany to appear for the defendants, who are being sued by the Federation of Jewish Communities in Switzerland for spreading the "Protocols," the Nazi advocates asked the court to postpone the trial on technical grounds.

The entire session today was devoted to the testimony delivered by Dr. Arthur Baumgarten, an expert for the plaintiffs. Dr. Baumgarten reviewed the history of the "Protocols" and pointed out the discrepancies existing in the different versions. He gave proofs that the "Protocols" were composed in France by an agent of the Czarist Russian government which was looking for an excuse to justify its anti-Jewish pogroms.

Expert's Testimony

From a literary viewpoint, the "Protocols" are definitely "trashy literature," Dr. Baumgarten testified.

Under the existing laws in Switzerland the publishers, who are now being sued by the Federation of Swiss Jewish Communities for libel, were obligated to inform their readers of all facts concern- (Continued on Page Four)

German Agents Battle Guards, Kidnap Exile on Czech Border

PRAHA, April 29.—A German Jewish refugee, Joseph Lampersberger, was kidnaped by Nazi agents last Saturday on the Czechoslovakian frontier under the very eyes of Czech officials, it was disclosed here today.

The Nazi agents, believed to be of the German Secret Service, attacked their victim on the Czech side of the frontier station Eisenstein and hustled him towards the German side of the border. A Czechoslovakian customs official

who was inspecting the passports, heard the cries of the refugee and hurried to his aid. He also was attacked by the two Nazis who then dragged their victim across the frontier into Germany despite the protests of customs guards.

An investigation into the abduction was started today by the Czech authorities. The Czech press emphasizes that the kidnaping of Lampersberger is similar to that of Berthold Jacob who was lured from Switzerland by Nazi agents to the German frontier.

SOME LONDON NOTES

Cats, Kings and Clothing

LONDON.

This is Jubilee Year as every one must know by now. Every corner of the far-flung British Empire is celebrating the twenty-fifth year of the reign of George V and Queen Mary. London is beginning to take on a holiday appearance for the great jubilee events early next month.

To one unfamiliar with the British it is not easy to comprehend the intangible bond uniting even the lowliest and unhappiest British citizen with his sovereigns. But a strong tie is there, binding East End and Mayfair, Tanganyika and Scotland in this remarkable common link.

Preparations for the Jubilee threaten to overshadow the Stressa conference in public interest. Newspapers are full of suggestions for means of honoring the royal pair. Every one talks of the Jubilee plans. Every organization, every group of citizens is preparing some form of observance from the tiniest hamlets to the greatest cities. Chief Rabbi Hertz has prepared a special prayer for the King and Queen to be recited in all the synagogues of the Empire. Souvenirs are being designed, manufactured and rapidly sold. Medals have been struck honoring the royal couple. There has been public rejoicing that the expression of fealty and love of the sovereigns is improving the business of British manufacturers and craftsmen.

And then comes the Nazi fly in the ointment.

Medals and plaques in the officially approved design are being cast by the thousands in Germany and are being offered for sale at prices below those of the native manufacturers. The patriotic Briton is in a dilemma for the German medals are not stamped with the name of the country of origin as would be required in the United States and unless the purchaser has expert knowledge, he is not able to distinguish between the inferior Nazi product and that of the British craftsman. And even the man in the street is resentful at the "chiseling in."

Cats and Kings

Some time or other I remember being told that even a cat may look at a King. But the story didn't say that the cat had to have a lot of money to pay for the look. I don't know how much money Londoners and visitors to London are going to pay to see the King in the formal Jubilee procession to St. Paul's Cathedral on May 6, but it's going to be a lot. The procession will pass through historic Fleet Street. Window space from

which one can witness the procession and see His Majesty, is selling from \$35 to \$100 per person, depending on the desirability of the location and the amount of comfort it offers for the investing spectator.

New Clothes for Men

Joseph Good, better known as Moshe Ovyed, the erratic genius, is dissatisfied with men's clothing, thinks it is designed all wrong. To put things aright, he has designed a new style and has had a suit made up in it which he wears. A friend of mine met him near the British Museum last week, and Moshe Ovyed lectured him about clothes, unbuttoned his ulster (England's Spring is somewhat delayed this year) and revealed his creation.

As I understand it, the jacket is cut square, without collar lapels and the ornamental button hole; the vest is in pullover design, with two pockets at the bottom, and the trousers are cut along the lines of a sailor's. My friend was unconvinced and unconverted.

Missions to Jews

One of the things about London that must interest the Jewish visitor is the number and activity of the missions seeking to convert Jews to Christianity. It is really amazing to note the number of people and organizations devoted to this type of work and the extent to which it is carried on.

The other night, walking home through a Bloomsbury street, I noticed a poster in Yiddish and English before an imposing church announcing that Christian services were to be conducted there in Hebrew.

And an attractive-looking lass, Miss Olga Levertoff, who recently quit a career as a revue-dancer, was hailed last week as the first Jewess to deliver a sermon from the pulpit of an Anglican church. She is the daughter of the Rev. Dr. Paul Levertoff, who abandoned Judaism at the age of 18 to spend his life trying to bring Jews into the Christian fold.

There is a terrific amount of missionary work being attempted in the teeming Jewish sections in the East End. While the social service work of the missions, I understand, is accepted, the success of the proselyting activities has been disappointing.

Yachtsman

Lord Melchett, who divides his time between an active interest in Jewish affairs and extensive business interests, has become a full-fledged yachtsman with his purchase of the yacht Izme III. He has changed the vessel's name to Amy Gwen and is expected to take a prominent part in yachting activities. He was not expected, however, to return from the Macabaid in Tel Aviv on time to take part in "Cowes Week," the great yachting event of the year.

Back in the days when Hitler was newly come to power, the Marquess of Reading resigned from the Anglo-German Association of London in protest against Nazi persecution of the Jews. Last week the association dissolved because its counterpart in Berlin no longer existed and there was consequently no reason for the continued existence of the London body.

Killing the Jewish Press

The order issued last week by the Nazi authorities prohibiting the appearance of non-Nazi publications, may put an end to the German Jewish press which now enjoys the largest circulation it ever had.

Driven into ghetto life, the Jews in Germany are now reading more of their Jewish press than ever before. It is in the Jewish press that they find an echo of their own life and a link with Jewish life abroad.

Larger Circulation

It is therefore small wonder that a publication like the Central-Verein Zeitung, the organ of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, now has a larger circulation than the Berliner Tagesblatt, once the most widely read German newspaper in Europe. The circulation of this German Jewish newspaper reaches 50,000, which is almost as much as the circulation of the Angriff, one of the two leading Nazi papers in the country.

The same is true also of the Berliner Gemeindeblatt. This paper, which is the official organ of the Berlin Jewish community, enjoys a paid circulation of about 50,000. It is not sold on the streets and limits itself to subscribers only. The volume of advertisements which this paper carries is far larger than that carried by the Berliner Tageblatt or any of the Hugenberg publications.

More Advertisements

The Juedische Rundschau, official organ of the Zionist Federation in Germany which appears twice weekly, has a circulation of 35,000, and its advertising pages exceed the advertising seen in any of the Nazi publications, excepting the Voelkischer Beobachter.

The list of Jewish publications in Germany enjoying a large circulation is not exhausted with the above. There is the Hamburger Israelitische Familienblatt with a circulation of more than 35,000. There is Der Schild, official organ of the German Jewish War Veterans, with more than 20,000 subscribers. There is the Israelit, an orthodox publication with about 5,000 subscribers, and the Juedische Allgemeine Zeitung, published by the Liberal Jewish group of Germany, with an approximate circulation of 8,000.

Forced Liquidation

All these publications, as well as a dozen other smaller community papers, may now under the new regulations be liquidated by the authorities. The last means of inter-community contact will be lost to German Jewry. It will be deprived not only of the means of voicing its grievances from time to time through its own press, but also of knowing what is going on in Jewry throughout the world as well as in Germany.

That the thirst for such knowledge is now strong among German Jewry is best evidenced by the fact that the total monthly circulation of the German Jewish press is now estimated at 1,040,000, averaging two newspapers a month for every German Jew, which was hardly the case before the Nazis came into power.

Nazis Worried

To appreciate the significance of this average, it is sufficient to say that in Germany today there is one paper to every 20,000 of the non-Jewish population, and even this proportion is gradually declining since the German people have lost interest in their press and its contents.

London Times On Maimonides

The London Times, writing on Maimonides, says:

Moses ben Maimon, usually called Maimonides, was the most important Jewish scholar of the Middle Ages. He was born at Cordoba in 1135, but left Spain in 1160, and after spending five years at Fez, passed on to Egypt, where he remained until his death at Cairo in 1204. As early as his sixteenth year he produced a philosophical work, and he soon became celebrated as an authority on Jewish dogma and law, which he was the first to codify in his work Mishneh-Torah, produced in 1180. By that time he was the recognized head of the Jewish community in Egypt.

By profession, however, he was a physician, and acted in that capacity for Saladin and his sons, for one of whom he wrote a number of medical works. These, like the bulk of his books, were written in the Arabic language, though he appears always to have used the Hebrew alphabet himself. He is best known through his great philosophical work, called the "Guide for the Perplexed," which was soon translated into Latin, and in that form exercised a considerable influence on medieval philosophy.

Hamlet Had a Word For Ludendorff

The Catholic Times of London, commenting on Ludendorff, says:

There is just a possibility that General Ludendorff is in his dotage. At one time, the extravagance of his pronouncements on the Jewish menace and German paganism was regarded as sufficient proof that his mental faculties were not as great as they had been, but the way others have since spoken clears him of suspicion.

On his seventieth birthday he proclaims that he is "an anti-Christian and heathen and proud of it." He tells us that "Christian teaching is there for only one purpose—to help the Jewish people to domination. Only through complete renunciation of Christianity will the German people achieve unity."

"These tedious old fools!" as Hamlet exclaims. We must bear with them and pity them.

Our Guess Is: 'Behead Him'

The London News Chronicle quotes Nietzsche on the Jewish question as follows:

What a blessing a Jew is among Germans! See the obtuseness, the flaxen head, the blue eye, and the lack of intellect in the face, the language, and the bearing; the lazy habit of stretching the limbs, and the need of repose among Germans—a need which is not the result of overwork, but of the disgusting excitement and overexcitation caused by alcohol.

"What would Herr Hitler say to that?" the News Chronicle asks.

of the fact that they are greatly concerned about the substantial decline in the circulation of the German press. It is by the suppression of the Jewish, Catholic and Evangelic confessional publications that they hope to increase the number of readers of the German press. Needless to say, this will never be achieved as long as the press of Germany remains under the heel of Nazi censorship. The suppression of the non-Nazi press of Germany will not result in more foreign newspapers being read in the country, but will wield no increase for the newspapers appearing in Germany.

Nordic Superiority Called 'Poppycock'

The Chicago Daily News, in interviews with a number of professors on the racial question, quotes Prof. Fay-Cooper Cole, head of the department of anthropology at the Chicago University, as saying that the "Nordic myth of racial superiority is sheerest poppycock." Prof. Cole said:

"The idea of a superior race is preposterous, scientifically speaking. 'The Nordic race has been so diluted that even in the Scandinavian countries not fifty per cent are pure Nordic. There is no German race. Apparently Hitler is as much Alpine as Nordic. Neither is there an 'Aryan' race, as Herr Hitler is now trying to call the Nordics. 'Aryan' is a linguistic term, and is used to designate those peoples who speak an 'Aryan' language, such as the Hindoos, who are just as good 'Aryans' as Hitler. Moreover, the Jews are just as good Caucasians as the Germans. Nor are they a race in the biological sense. They are a religious group with a set of traditions of their own."

Data Discloses Race Resists Many Ailments

But Doctors Find Jews Hard Hit by Diabetes, Nervous Ills

LONDON.—Jewish susceptibility to various diseases as compared with that of the Scotchman, the Irishman and the Englishman, was established here by medical data, producing the greatest surprise among doctors.

Mortality figures for all the principal diseases were collected. There were enough of them to ensure that any deductions were correctly drawn and not based on coincidences.

This is what they show:

1. That Jews suffer far more from nervous diseases than Christians. Under similar conditions, the number of Jewish patients may be two or three times as great. This, the psychologists explain, has a fairly obvious cause. For centuries the Jews have been persecuted. Years of worry and unhappiness have left an indelible imprint on the race.

Subject to Diabetes

2. Jews are from two to six times as liable to diabetes, according to the locality, as compared to other people. The reason is unknown.

3. The Jew comes off well in infectious diseases. Epidemics of diphtheria, measles and cholera may sweep a country, but statistics show that the individual Jew is only half as likely to be infected as the average non-Jew.

4. In smallpox, Jews have only one-tenth the mortality of non-Jews.

5. The world tuberculosis death rate among Jews is only half that of the average race, and only one-fourth that of Italians and Irish.

Although no definite explanations can be given as yet for these figures, one theory is advanced that the inbreeding among Jews has led to a strain which can resist certain diseases.

The twenty-fifth anniversary of Young Judaea will be observed Sunday at a jubilee dinner at the Grand Street Boys' Clubhouse, where outstanding Jewish leaders will join members and friends of the organization in the anniversary celebration. According to an announcement by David Levine, national president of Young Judaea, Judge Julian W. Mack is honorary chairman and M. Maldwin Fertig, chairman of the dinner committee.

Messages have been received from outstanding personalities not only in the United States, but from leaders in Canada, England and Palestine. Temple Women Hold Annual Meeting Here

State Body Hears Falk Outline Plan to Spur Membership

More than 100 women, representatives of thirty-seven temple sisterhoods throughout the State, assembled yesterday at the Community House of the Central Synagogue in an all-day session at the annual meeting of the board of the New York State Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, heard Rabbi Jacob Falk, northeastern regional rabbi of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, tell of the project to bring a "back-to-the-synagogue" movement into being.

The plan, which is taking shape, Rabbi Falk said, involves joint action by the three leading groups in the Jewish laity. It aims to stimulate large numbers of men and women to resume intimate connections with the synagogue. A metropolitan drive toward this goal has already been launched here jointly by members of Conservative, Reform and Orthodox congregations.

The rabbi pointed out that in New York State the number of Jews actively affiliated with the synagogue is not more than 60,000.

The morning session was taken up with the reading of reports and a meeting of Mrs. Albert J. May of New York City, president of the state federation, with her cabinet, comprising chairwomen of various committees.

At the luncheon session the guests of honor were Rabbi Falk, Mrs. Judah Dresner of Yonkers, president of the state conference of the National Council of Jewish Women; and Mrs. Fred Guggenheimer, of this city, president of the women's auxiliary of the Free Synagogue.

Mrs. Richard Percy Limburg, another speaker, called for cooperation in the newly launched campaign of the United Jewish Appeal. She is chairman of the women's division of the campaign here.

Out of 200 members of the faculty of our university, there are seventy-five non-'Aryans,' amounting to forty per cent of the staff, while in the Czech University, the non-'Aryans' are only ten per cent of the faculty," the memorandum asserts.

Nazis Lose First Tilt as Trial On 'Protocols' Opens in Berne

ing the authenticity of the book. "From my investigations," Dr. Baumgarten summarized his testimony, "and from the answers which I have given to the questions directed toward me, it becomes quite clear that the 'Protocols' are a forgery and that the plans set forth there of an allegedly existing secret government, have nothing whatever to do with the cultural, political and economic aims of Judaism."

Early Verdict Seen

Col. Fleischhauer, the Nazi expert, will give his testimony before the court tomorrow. He appeared in court today accompanied by three assistants, one of them a woman. There will be no session on Wednesday. The verdict is expected at the end of this week.

The defendants, all of whom are Swiss Nazis, are charged with violating the Swiss law prohibiting the publication and dissemination of literature calculated to excite vile instincts.

Pastor Target of Attacks

With the attention of the Swiss Nazis and Nazi foes focused on the Berne trial today, an attempt was made last night by the Nazis to attack Rev. Dr. James Parkes, pastor at the American church in Geneva, who is active in promoting good-will between Jews and non-Jews, especially through the International Student Service.

A servant of Dr. Parkes was attacked by Nazi assailants who, the police assume, had mistaken him for his employer. The attackers then entered the clergyman's home and stole many documents which are of great value in the Berne "Protocols" trial.

The police, who arrived later at Dr. Parkes' home, found the servant lying unconscious in the doorway. When he regained consciousness, he testified that he had been blinded by a flash and remembered nothing more after that. Dr. Parkes himself was not at home when the attack took place in the early evening hours.

Warned by Police

The Swiss police are definitely under the impression that the attack on Dr. Parkes' residence is closely linked up with the Berne trial of the Nazis. The authorities in Berne last week cautioned Dr. Parkes to be careful as the Secret Police was in possession of information that the Nazis were plotting an attack against him in order to steal some of his files which contained material on anti-Semitism, on Germany and on matters which would be detrimental to the Nazis at the Berne trial.

A thorough investigation into the attack on Dr. Parkes' home was started today in Geneva by the federal authorities, who are inclined to believe that the attack was carried out by the same Nazi organization in Switzerland which kidnaped Berthold Jacob, the German Jewish journalist who disappeared from Switzerland on March 9 and was later discovered to have been lured across the border into Germany by Nazi agents.

Parkes Had Information On Nazi Exile Spies

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

GENEVA, April 29.—The attack on the home of Dr. James Parkes was made by the Nazis who sought to steal information which the pastor of the American Church here allegedly possessed about provocateurs among refugees from Germany.

This theory was advanced by the police today, in addition to the theory that the invasion of the

home of the clergyman was for the purpose of stealing documents which would discredit the Nazis at their trial, which opened today in Berne, on charges of spreading the anti-Semitic "Protocols of the Elders of Zion."

The Swiss press is indignant at the terroristic methods of the Nazi agents, of which the victim this

time was the servant of Dr. Parkes. Simultaneously, the Swiss press today reports that the government of Switzerland insists, in a note delivered to Berlin last Saturday, that if Berthold Jacob, German Jewish refugee who was kidnaped by Nazi agents in Switzerland, is not released, the case will be referred to the International Tribunal in The Hague as violating the German-Swiss Treaty of 1921.

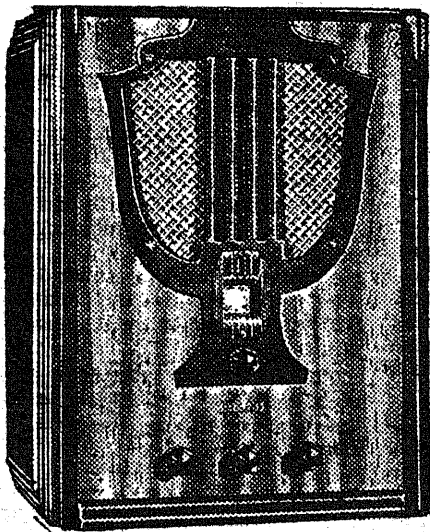

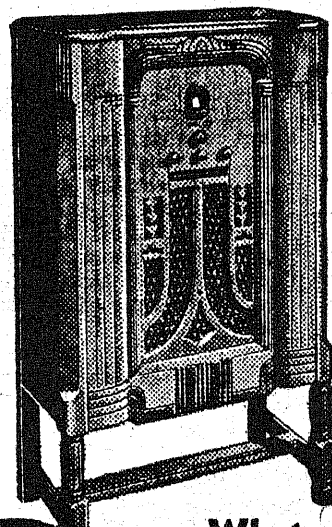
