## Sachar Hits Propaganda in Colleges

### Tells B'nai B'rith Nazis Are Using U. S. Professors

(Special to the J.D.B.)  
WASHINGTON, May 7.—The increased anti-Semitic propaganda in American universities was dealt with at the B'nai Brith convention today, in a report submitted by Dr. A. L. Sachar, national director of the B'nai B'rith Hillel Foundations.

"Nazi propaganda has changed its technique," Dr. Sachar reported. "American professors are now invited to give courses in German universities, exchange students are welcomed and extended every courtesy.

Tours Guided by Nazis  
"During their sojourn in Germany these professors and students are shown only what is favorable to Nazi interests," Dr. Sachar continued. "All too often they return as ambassadors of good will, immensely more effective than the clumsy propagandists in the past years."

Dr. Sachar emphasized that every director of a Hillel Foundation has been called upon to make replies, to discredit lies, to prepare factual material and to be on guard so that each university sanctuary may be kept unpolluted. Dr. Sachar also reported on the fine cooperation built up between Jewish and Christian agencies on each campus. The Hillel Foundations serve as a liaison between Christians and Jews, he said.

## Zionists Elect Dr. Weizmann

### Urge Jewish Agency to Change Its Palestine Program

LONDON, May 7.—Dr. Chaim Weizmann, ex-president of the World Zionist Organization, was re-elected president of the English Zionist Federation, at the annual conference which concluded here yesterday.

The conference adopted a report of its economic planning committee urging reorganization of the Jewish Agency methods in the up-building of Palestine. The report draws special attention to the fact that Palestine has failed to maintain the former balance between agricultural and urban development, as well as to the fact that land speculation in Palestine is becoming a serious menace.

The report, adopted unanimously, recommends that the Jewish Agency follow a new program of acquiring more national land, strengthening the financial basis of the national fund, coordinating the financial institutions in Palestine by establishing an Economic Advisory Bureau, working out a program for public works and improving foreign markets for Pal-

## Tel Aviv Names Street In Honor of George V

TEL AVIV, May 7.—The Silver Jubilee of King George was celebrated here today with the formal opening of a street named after the King.

Thousands participated in the ceremony, at which Meier Dizen-goff, Mayor of Tel Aviv, officiated. The municipal council of Tel Aviv sent its greetings to the King on this occasion.

In Jaffa one of the local squares was renamed after King George.

## Reich Zionists Ask Full Control Of Jewish Life

### Ben-Gurion Is Among Speakers at Parley of Federation

BERLIN, May 7.—Complete supervision of Jewish life in Germany was demanded today by the Zionist Federation in Germany in a resolution adopted at a special conference.

Leadership of German Jewry belongs to Zionism, was the tone of the speeches delivered at the conference, which was addressed by Kurt Blumenfeld, former president of the Zionist Federation; David Ben-Gurion, member of the Zionist Executive; Dr. Franz Meyer and others.

### Demand Recognition

The Zionist movement must demand recognition to serve as a foundation for a new formation of Jewish life in Germany, the speakers urged. It must demand the personal and organizational transformation of the central and local bodies of German Jewry in a way which will guarantee sufficient Zionist influence for shaping German Jewish life.

The executive committee of the Federation was instructed to realize the demands put forward by the speakers and embodied in the resolutions.

It is believed here that the Zionist attempt to capture control of Jewish life in Germany will produce a serious split in the Jewish community, since it would mean that all aspects of Jewish activities hitherto directed by non-Zionist elements, would have to pass into the hands of the Zionists.

## Warburg Library on Economics Is Given to New York University

A collection of 3,500 books and 2,000 pamphlets on economics, including many early and important works, has been presented to New York University by Felix M. Warburg, it was announced today by Chancellor Harry Woodburn Chase. The gift was made by Mr. Warburg in the name of his mother-in-law, the late Mrs. Jacob H. Schiff, who had acquired the collection from a nephew, Prof.

## 70 Deprived Of Citizenship By Germany

### Nazis Demand All Jews Be Ousted From Judiciary

BERLIN, May 7.—A new list of seventy Jews to be deprived of citizenship was made public today by the Chief of Police here, as part of the general drive gradually to deprive German Jewry of its citizenship rights.

A Berlin court was attacked today for granting an eviction order to a Jewish landlord against his "Aryan" tenant who continually insulted the Jew. The attack appears in the Jugend und Recht, a German law organ, which takes violent issue with the court's ruling. "This decision is against our racial ideas," the paper states.

It was stated in well informed circles here today that non-"Aryans" will be accepted in the German army under the new conscription, but not Jews.

The non-"Aryans" acceptable have to prove a predominating percentage of "Aryans" in their ancestry. They will also have to renounce all advancement in rank from the very outset.

### Attack Judges

The demand that not a single Jew be permitted to remain in the German judicial system, was voiced today at the conference of National German Lawyers in Hanover.

Dr. Frank, Minister of Justice, addressing the conference, stated that even now under the Nazi regime there are still many Jews engaged in the German courts under the exemption made for war veterans.

"It will be our great task completely to liberate the German people from these alien substances, and to create a truly German justice," he said.

## U. S. Envoy to Austria Returns to Post Today

George S. Messersmith, United States Minister to Austria, who has been in this country on a visit, will leave at noon today on the Washington to resume his duties in Vienna. When he arrived here more than a month ago, he informed the Jewish Daily Bulletin that the position of Jews in Austria appeared to have improved under the Schuschnigg regime as compared to the Dollfuss rule.

## Court Expert Calls 'Protocols' Forgery

### New Outpost Guards Mediterranean Coast

JERUSALEM, May 7.—A new police outpost, to prevent illegal immigration into Palestine, was established today on the Mediterranean shore near Tel Aviv.

The police in Jerusalem today made an effort to induce the National Labor Organization, a Revisionist labor union, to desist in its attempts to displace Arab workers in Jewish enterprises.

## Scholar Finds Biblical Letters Are Originals

### Deciphering of Pottery Script Completed by Prof. Torczyny

JERUSALEM, May 7.—"The twelve potsherds discovered several months ago at Tel Adduweir, ancient Lachish, dating back 2,500 years to the time of Jeremiah and confirming the Bible references to that period, are original letters and not copies."

This statement was made here today by Prof. Harry Torczyny, expert on Semitic languages in the Hebrew University here, upon completing his task of deciphering the inscriptions on the potsherds.

The potsherds were discovered by J. L. Starkey, head of the Welcome Archaeological Research Expedition, in excavations made in Tel Adduweir last January.

### Gives More Details

At a lecture today before the Antiquity Society Prof. Starkey gave further details of the excavations that created a sensation when announced to the world. Prof. Torczyny, who was present at the lecture, declared that one of the potsherds discovered is an original letter sent to the King in Lachish, evidently from the neighborhood, when Nebuchadnezzar besieged Lachish. This letter referred to the carrying out of the king's orders. The other letters are also originals and strongly support the Bible, Prof. Torczyny explained.

## Prof. Sukenik Discovers Ancient Jericho Fortress

JERUSALEM, May 7.—Prof. Sukenik of the Hebrew University archaeological department, has discovered remnants of an ancient fortress near Jericho, it was announced today. This fortress is believed to be the place where Ptolemy, the King of Egypt, killed Shimon Hachashmonai, more than 2,000 years ago.

Prof. Sukenik is noted for his excavations in Palestine. He is the author of many works on Palestine archaeology and is considered one of the best archaeologists in the Holy Land.

## Believe Dr. Loosli's Testimony Will Clinch Case

BERNE, May 7.—The "Protocols of the Elders of Zion" are clearly a forgery and belong to the category of "scandalous literature of the worst species," the court's non-Jewish expert, Dr. C. A. Loosli, declared today in his analysis of the anti-Semitic document for spreading which a number of Swiss Nazis are now on trial here.

Dr. Loosli's testimony was a complete refutation of the testimony of the Nazi "expert," Col. Ulrich Fleischauer, who for six days tried to prove that the "protocols" are genuine.

### Calls Book a 'Drug'

"The 'Protocols' are calculated to incite readers to brutality, to swerve them from morality and right, to drug their modesty and conscience to the point of inciting them to illegal acts," Dr. Loosli summarized his expert analysis for the court.

### Written by Czar's Agent

The court's expert, a noted author, declared that the "Protocols" are the creation of the Russian Secret Service under the Czarist regime. The Czarist government in Russia had good reasons for fabricating these "Protocols" in order to justify its actions against the Jews, he said.

Dr. Loosli ridiculed the Nazi allegations that the "Protocols" are a record of the first Zionist Congress held in Basle in 1897. He declared that this forged document, which aims to prove that the Jews wish to dominate the world, was based on an essay written as far back as 1864 by Maurice Joly, a Frenchman, under the title "A Dialogue in Hades Between Machiavelli and Montesquieu," which is a satire on Napoleon III.

## Palestine Body Seeks Big Loan

### Vaad Leumi Plans to Use \$600,000 to Build New Schools

JERUSALEM, May 7.—Negotiations for a loan of \$600,000 were started today by the Vaad Leumi, the Jewish National Council of Palestine, with the Prudential Assurance Company of London, after it became known that the same company has completed the formalities for granting a loan of \$5,000,000 to the city of Tel Aviv.

Simultaneously, it is reported in today's press that Prudential will also grant a loan of \$250,000 to the Supreme Moslem Council, representative body of the Arabs in Palestine.

The Vaad Leumi loan from the London company will be assigned to building Jewish schools in Jerusalem, Haifa, Tiberias and Safed.

## The New Czechoslovakian Parliament

PRAHA.

A beautiful dream was dreamt in Czechoslovakia during the last weeks by the Zionists and the other national Jews. They hoped that the new election law would make it possible for them to appear as an independent Jewish party at the elections of May 19 and to gain at least four, possibly even five seats, thus being able to form an independent Jewish group within the Parliament.

Such a position in Parliament would have considerably strengthened the Zionist Jewish party with the masses of the Jewish voters and would have led to the formation of a unified Czechoslovakian Jewry with the exception of the extreme Czech-Jewish assimilationists and the orthodox adherents of Rabbi Spira of Munkacevo. For the idea that the Jewish people best can safeguard their interests and their honor by Jewish representation in each country has but few opponents nowadays.

### New Electoral Plan

In connection with the impending elections the Czechoslovakian government submitted to the Parliament an election reform bill which, among other things aimed at elimination of extremely small parties. It was therefore agreed that a party was qualified to send representatives to Parliament only if it could muster at least 120,000 votes throughout the whole country, or a minimum of 20,000 votes in any single electoral district.

To insure representation for the Jews an exception was recommended for the Jewish and Polish minorities. This exception provided that only a minimum of 50,000 votes for the whole country and 20,000 in at least one electoral district, was necessary. The Jews of Czechoslovakia, numbering about 375,000 in a total population of 15,000,000 would have been able, if united, to produce 120,000 votes throughout the country. The total number of Jewish voters is estimated at 180,000, as women may vote too.

### Dream Shattered

This dream has come to an end. The government has not been able to maintain the intended concessions for the minorities. The nationalistic Fascist and semi-Fascist press voiced a lively opposition against such "preferences" for the national minorities.

Even within the government party it was pointed out that one could not make concessions to Jews and Poles which were denied to other minorities such as the Hungarians and the Russians. Therefore, the government decided to take the paragraph which provided for an exception in favor of Poles and Jews out of the project.

In 1920 the Jewish party received 97,661 votes and in 1925 a

total of 89,830 votes within the whole country, but in both elections they gained no seat as they had not attained the necessary minimum in a single electoral district. At the election of 1929 the Jewish party joined the Polish minority. They received 104,464 votes or four seats, which were divided between Jews and Poles, although the Jews could have demanded three seats as their votes by far outnumbered the Polish ones.

The members of the Jewish party in the present Parliament are the lawyers, Dr. Angelo Goldstein of Prague, and Dr. Julius Reisz of Bratislava.

At the present moment a coalition with the Poles is impossible. Firstly, because they are disunited among themselves, and secondly, because their loyalty towards the Czechoslovakian State has, in a certain sense, undergone a change.

### Coalition Necessary

As the Jewish party could not hope to reach 120,000 votes for the whole state, or a minimum of 20,000 votes in a single electoral district, it had to resolve to seek an election pact with some other party.

As the middle parties of the country don't wish to burden themselves by a pact with the Jews, the only party was the Czechoslovakian Social Democratic party. Here, too, stubborn resistance had to be overcome and even Minister Bechyne, member of this party, vigorously opposed a pact with the national Jews.

However, during its last session, the central committee of the Czech Social Democrats resolved to offer the Jewish party two assured seats on its list. Should the number of Jewish voters be higher than expected, this party would also accede a seat to the Jews in the Senate.

The question whether this offer should be accepted or not, caused lively debates within the Jewish party during the past weeks. The president of the Jewish party, Dr. Emil Margulies of Leitmeritz, and a number of leading members of the Executive of the party vigorously opposed acceptance. They pointed out that the meaning of the Jewish party would be betrayed by passing the word that all Jewish voters have to vote for the list of the Social Democrats.

However, the central committee of the Jewish party at its meeting at Maehrisch-Ostrau resolved by a majority vote to enter an election pact with the Czecho Social Democratic party. As its candidates the Jewish party nominated Dr. Angelo Goldstein and the director of the Hebrew High School of Munkacevo, Dr. Chaim Kugel, both well-known Zionists.

As a result, Dr. Emil Margulies and other members of the Executive have resigned from their posts. They, as well as their closest political friends and also certain Mizrachist circles, have seceded entirely from the Jewish party. The Revisionists also will remain aloof. All these circles intend, in spite of the pact of the Jewish party with the Socialists, to enter the next election campaign as an independent group, although they will have no chance of gaining a seat.

# Between the Lines

### Prof. Brodetsky's Call

Prof. Selig Brodetsky, head of the political department of the World Zionist Executive in London, deserves great credit for his attempt to bring the Revisionists back to the Zionist Organization.

The speech which he delivered this week at the convention of the Zionist Federation in England, asking the Revisionists to return to the Zionist ranks, will go on record as evidence that not all members of the Zionist Executive in London are responsible for the present split in the Zionist Organization.

### A Sincere Desire

Prof. Brodetsky, a man with a logical trend of mind and with a sincere desire to serve the interests of the entire Zionist movement rather than the interests of one group, has always been for peace at any price within the Zionist ranks. Carrying the heavy responsibility for the political work of the Zionist Organization before the outside world, Prof. Brodetsky realized, more than any other member of the Zionist Executive, the harm which the movement will suffer once the Revisionists are pushed out of the organization.

The sentiments of Prof. Brodetsky were, however, little shared by Mr. Locker, the other member of the Zionist Executive in London. By promulgating various schemes, Mr. Locker succeeded in forcing the Revisionists out of the Zionist Organization, acting more in the interests of certain groups in the Labor party than in the interests of the entire Zionist movement which he is supposed to consider as the head of the organization department of the Zionist Executive.

### A Difficult Task

It will be difficult to make good now what Mr. Locker has destroyed in the Zionist movement. Once the Revisionists have publicly announced their intention of organizing a separate Zionist party, after they had been refused a round table conference, it will be difficult to induce them to change their decision.

Prof. Brodetsky's invitation to the Revisionists is nevertheless not a call into space. It is only a question whether the call will be supported by other members of the Executive, or whether Prof. Brodetsky will remain isolated in his efforts for peace, as has been the case hitherto.

### Support Essential

The efforts of Prof. Brodetsky to bring the Revisionists back to the Zionist Organization deserve the support of all elements interested in seeing the Jewish Agency united, with no rivals to compete in the political activities before the Colonial Office and the Mandates Commission. It deserves the support of the non-Zionist elements in the Jewish Agency who are more interested in the prestige of the Jewish Agency as a whole than in the internal friction within the Zionist ranks.

With the approaching Zionist Congress in August, the proper thing for Jewish leaders of the type of Prof. Brodetsky would be to see whether, after all, a compromise cannot be reached with the Revisionists and even with the Agudah, for united work in the cause of Palestine. Should such a compromise not be reached, the next Zionist Congress will be worth little, since nothing but chaos will develop in Jewish political representation before the outside world.

# World Press Digest

## Brisbane Terms Nazi 'Too Silly'

Arthur Brisbane, in his column, *Today*, in the Hearst press, comments as follows on the testimony of Col. Fleischauer, the Nazi "expert," at the "Protocols" trial in Berne:

Herr Ulrich Fleischauer has fresh news. As a "Nazi expert," he says the League of Nations was planned by Jews, "to unify the language, money and religion of Israel." Also, Herr Fleischauer discovers that Jews "gain their ends by starting revolutions." Believe it or not, they started the Russian Revolution, having first hired somebody to assassinate Archduke Ferdinand at Sarajevo, thus starting the World War.

The German discoverer does not explain why Trotzky, head of the Bolshevik army, one of the ablest of the Bolsheviks, was expelled from Russia, if that was a Jewish revolution. The Nazi fanatic seems not to know that it is possible to be too silly.

## Reviews Kidnapings By Reich Agents

The *New York Post*, commenting editorially on the repeated cases of kidnaping refugees by Nazi agents, says:

The arrogance, brutality and disregard for law and decency that mark Hitler's rule over the German people make their appearance in his relations with neighboring States.

Swiss, Czech and now Dutch territorial integrity has been violated by the kidnaping of refugees in disregard of fundamental principles of international law.

The anti-Fascist journalist

Jacob was kidnaped from Switzerland. Hans Lampersberger, a former member of the Republican Reichsbanner organization in Germany, has been abducted from Czechoslovakia. And now a German laborer named Gutzeit, a refugee from the Hitler Terror has been forcibly seized in Holland and taken across the border.

In each case the kidnaping means death or worse within the torture chambers of that sadist paradise, the Third Reich.

## Dreiser Attitude Termed 'Shock'

The *Nation*, commenting editorially on Dreiser's statement "that he is 'not against the workers,'" says:

The Dreiser-Hapgood letters published in *The Nation* for April 17 have created general excitement, and rightly so. Intelligent people have come to look upon Mr. Dreiser as a champion of sense and decency in public affairs, and it was a distinct shock to them, as it was to the editors of *The Nation*, to discover that he entertained opinions about the Jewish race which were almost an exact duplicate of those held by the Nazis, the Ku Klux Klan, and other anti-Semitic groups. The *New Masses*, whose cause Mr. Dreiser has long befriended, immediately asked him to justify his position, and the result of its editors' talks with him was printed in its issue of April 23. Mr. Dreiser hemmed and hawed and protested his "good intentions" toward the Jews, but he retracted almost nothing.

# Hail New Curb On Prejudice By Institutions

## Law Forbids Racial Bias in Colleges Supported by Public Funds

Jewish organizations and leaders here hailed yesterday the enactment of a State law which prohibits racial or religious discrimination by educational institutions supported wholly or in part by public funds or by contributions solicited from the public.

The act, introduced by Assemblyman Samuel Weisman, is in the form of an amendment to the civil rights law. It was signed by Governor Lehman Monday.

Under the amended act, which went into effect yesterday, the following classifications of institutions are included: public libraries, kindergartens, primary and secondary schools, academies, colleges, universities, professional schools, extension courses and all other educational facilities "supported in whole or in part by public funds or by contributions solicited from the general public."

The old law applied simply to "all educational institutions under the supervision of the Regents of the State of New York."

Opposition to the bill, when it was introduced into the Assembly, was voiced chiefly by Dr. Dixon Ryan Fox, president of Union College, who charged that the bill would "prevent a private school or college from determining its own character."

# 1,000 at Deutsch Dinner Hear Call for Stronger Nazi Boycott

## Pay Tribute to Retiring President of Jewish Congress

A plea to all Americans to participate in an organized, nationwide boycott against Nazi Germany and to the League of Nations to employ economic sanctions, in order to isolate Germany and prevent a world conflict, was issued last night by outstanding representatives of the Jewish community at a testimonial dinner at the Hotel Commodore to Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch upon his retirement from the presidency of the American Jewish Congress, an office which he held for six years.

One thousand men and women representative of the civic, professional, business and political worlds paid tribute to Mr. Deutsch's leadership in the movement to combat Hitlerism and pledged themselves to a renewed battle against Nazism.

### Plea Not Partisan

In the addresses of Dr. Stephen S. Wise, new president of the American Jewish Congress and Mr. Deutsch, it was emphasized that isolation of Nazi Germany is imperative because of its threat to engulf the world in war. The speakers declared that theirs was not a partisan appeal in behalf of Jews alone, for the Jews of Germany are doomed whether there is peace or war, as long as Hitlerism remains enthroned in Germany.

Others slated to speak were Harry M. Warner, chairman of the committee of sponsors; George Z. Medahe, former United States Attorney, Henry W. Taft, former president of the New York County Bar Association, and Rebekah Kohut, president of the International Federation of Women's Organizations.

Mayor Fiorello H. LaGuardia addressed the guests by long distance wire from Washington.

Louis Naizer, director of the Film Board of Trade, was the toastmaster. The proceedings were broadcast by radio stations WOR and WMCA.

### Leadership Praised

Tribute was paid by the speakers for his incisive leadership as president of the American Jewish Congress in bringing "home to the American people the horrors of the Hitler regime and the necessity of defending America against its invasion."

Dr. Wise, who preceded and succeeded Mr. Deutsch as president of the American Jewish Congress, pledged that the organization would continue the anti-Nazi fight, declaring:

"Whatever others may say and do or fail to say and do, hundreds of thousands of Jews who directly or indirectly are represented within the American Jewish democracy and of the Jewish people."

### Urges Self Defense

Urging self defense as Jews and as Americans, without force and without violence, Dr. Wise, called "for the intensification of the economic and moral boycott which civilization initiated and has maintained almost since the beginning of the Hitler regime."

"We do not war upon Germany," he declared, "for there is no Germany. We do not war upon the German people whom we would liberate, but no man, Christian or Jew, American or European, who chooses to stand within the pale of civilization is morally justified in having any traffic with the Nazi Reich, at a time when the rise of Hitlerism has made Europe an armed camp, comparable to the

Mr. Sulzberger, who will be 44 years old September 12, is a native of New York City. He is a graduate of Columbia University.

## Sachar Scores Anti-Semitism In Universities

### Tells B'nai B'rith Nazis Use U. S. Professors for Propaganda

The investments in the Hillel Foundation have now been levelled at about \$60,000 a year, Dr. Sachar informed the convention. For this sum, ten foundations are functioning on ten great campuses of the country, reaching more than 7,500 Jewish students.

The Foundations have developed great cultural and religious activities among the Jewish students at the universities, especially among students with little Jewish background and all too often the desire to escape the responsibilities of Jewish life. The social welfare program of the Foundation has also been successful, Dr. Sachar reported.

#### A. Z. A. Report Heard

At today's session Sam Beber, president of the supreme advisory council, reported on the activities of Aleph Zadik Aleph. Maurice D. Rosenberg reported on the work of the Washington Bureau of the B'nai B'rith.

In his report Mr. Rosenberg dwelled at length upon the immigration and naturalization laws and emphasized the work the Washington Bureau has done in combatting defamation over the radio. He also enumerated cases where the B'nai B'rith intervened with the State Department when alarming reports were received about the Jewish situation in Poland, Mexico, Bolivia and other countries.

Louis J. Borinstein, chairman of the wider scope and fund raising commission, reported on the activities of his commission. A report of the committee on constitution and by-laws was submitted to the convention by Edwin J. Schanfarber. Judge A. B. Frey reported on the Leo N. Levi Memorial Hospital and Milton L. Anfenger submitted a report on the National Jewish Hospital.

#### Watch Alien Bill Hearings

Representatives of the B'nai B'rith will appear throughout the year at naturalization hearings of the immigration committee of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and lend their voice to matters vital to the Jewish alien, it was reported today by Sidney K. Kusworm, executive director of the Americanization committee.

Mr. Kusworm reported on the assistance the Americanization committee has given to Jewish immigrants in becoming citizens. He reported on the classes established by the B'nai B'rith lodges in many communities to teach American history and other necessary subjects to make it possible for Jewish applicants to pass the naturalization tests.

#### 'Every Jew a Citizen'

"Every Jew an American Citizen," is the slogan which some day I hope will be a reality," Mr. Kusworm said.

Declaring that "there are too many Jewish aliens in the United States," Mr. Kusworm said there will be fewer if the B'nai B'rith lodges cooperate with the Americanization committee in its naturalization activities.

Numerous changes in the naturalization laws introduced during the last years have been detrimental to the aliens, Mr. Kusworm declared. The B'nai B'rith together with other organizations successfully fought some of these laws. The organization was especially active in fighting the Registration Bill which is inimical to every immigrant. Mr. Kusworm reported.

**Welfare Program**

Jewish social welfare, and for an organized relationship between national Jewish agencies and the communities they appeal to for support, was stressed by Ira M. Younker, vice-president of the National Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds, addressing yesterday's session of the convention.

"The principle of cooperative unity, as it exists in local communities through Federations and Welfare Funds must be extended to become a national principle in Jewish welfare," Mr. Younker said. "It is not sufficient that individual communities have found it imperative to organize to meet their local needs. The question is broader than that. Each community is part of a larger community and subject to problems and conditions national in scope."

## 30 Nazi Leaders Camping With British Youth

### Find Young Hitler Aides Spreading Sympathy for Germany

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON. — Thirty young Nazi leaders in Hitler's youth organization are staying with thirty English and Welsh lads at the first Anglo-German camp in this country at Bryanston School, Dorset, the News-Chronicle discloses here. The British members of the camp are five young miners, five cigarette factory hands and a number of public school boys.

"Glimpse of the youth of Hitler's Germany—an impressive, if to me, somewhat disturbing glimpse—may be caught at Bryanston school, Dorset, where thirty members of Hitler's youth movement are in camp with English boys," J. L. Hodson writes in the News-Chronicle.

"They live; work and play together and are becoming friends," the writer continues. "The aim of Herr Jochen Benemann, a pleasant young German journalist, that the youth of both countries should understand one another better—he doesn't hope they will become single-minded—is undoubtedly being realized. He has addressed twenty-three public schools and fifteen factories; has founded what he calls 'islands' at Manchester, Birmingham, Nottingham, of people who share his wish for better relations.

"Already 100 English boys have applied for membership of later Anglo-German camps in Germany. Herr Benemann is on the Hitler youth movement staff. Most of the German boys I saw are 'leaders.'"

An English boy said: "They say there are no class distinctions in Germany now—it doesn't matter whether you are a millionaire or a tramp. They say the worst that happened to the Jews was that some windows were broken," Mr. Hodson reports, but an English youth who has attended two or three of the camps, he adds, said that on the Jewish question, however, the boys don't get any closer together at all.

## Court's Expert Calls Protocols Clear Forgery

### Testimony of Dr. Loosli Will Clinch Case, It Is Believed

Dr. Loosli also declared that under the Kerensky regime, when the Czar was forced to abdicate it was proved that the "Protocols" were fabricated by Czarist agents. Material discovered in the Russian archives left no doubt that the Czarist secret police were responsible for the document.

The unmistakable denunciation of the "Protocols" by Dr. Loosli created a strong impression in the courtroom, especially since Dr. Loosli does not represent any side being the court's representative. Dr. Loosli's testimony will play the decisive role in influencing the verdict. It coincides fully with the testimony of the pro-Jewish expert, Dr. Arthur Baumgartner, and completely contradicts the testimony given by Col. Fleischauer, the Nazi "expert."

A sensation was created in court today when a letter was read from Alexander Kerensky, the head of the former Kerensky government of Russia, branding as false the Nazi allegations that he and the members of his Cabinet were all Jewish.

#### Denounces Nazis

Dr. Loosli preceded his expert analysis at the trial today with a dramatic denunciation of the anti-Jewish propaganda which the Nazis are carrying on in Switzerland. "This propaganda against the Jews is only a shield for Nazi criminal intentions against the in-

## Wilson Foundation Honors Masaryk

### Czech President Gets First Medal Since '29; \$5,000 for Exile College

The directors of the Woodrow Wilson Foundation, at their annual meeting yesterday, voted to confer on Thomas G. Masaryk, president of the Czechoslovakian Republic, its medal which hasn't been awarded since 1929.

The medal, a bronze plaque, fifteen inches in diameter and designed by Ivan Mestrovic, has been conferred in the past on Viscount Cecil, Elihu Root, Col. Charles A. Lindbergh, and the League of Nations, Geneva, on the occasion of its tenth anniversary.

At the same time money awards were made to The Graduate Faculty of Political and Social Science (the University in Exile), the National League of Women Voters, Washington, D. C., and the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, Washington, D. C. The first named organization received \$4,000; and each of the others, \$3,000. In addition, a contribution of \$5,000 was made to the League of Nations Association, to be used in its discretion for the furtherance of its educational work.


