## Soviet Sets Limits On Biro Entry

### Will Admit Only Jews From Nearby Lands The First Year

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) MOSCOW, May 9.—Further details on the decision of the Soviet government to admit the first 4,500 foreign Jews into Biro-Bidjan this year, were made public here today.

Only Jews from Poland, Rumania and the countries directly neighboring Soviet Russia, will be admitted to settlement in the Bureya during the first year.

The Jews to be admitted will be settled in collectives and provided with dwellings and the necessary implements to start their new life. They will be permitted to bring along with them their own belongings.

Soviet authorities have decided to pursue a very careful policy in the selection of immigrants. Only those found most adaptable to the life will be accepted.

With the war danger in the Far East over, the opinion prevails here that the number of Jews from Poland anxious to settle in Biro-Bidjan will be very large, since the war clouds in Europe are growing heavier under the Nazi war threats.

Full details are now being worked out in the office of the Comzet, the government committee which is responsible for Jewish land settlement, for organizing the immigration of foreign Jews into Biro-Bidjan in the most efficient manner, and for taking care of the immigrants from the moment they reach the Soviet frontier.

## Italian Rabbinate Names Phrato New Chief Rabbi

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) ROME, May 9.—Rabbi David Phrato, well known Jewish leader of Italy, was named Chief Rabbi of Italy today to succeed Dr. Angelo Sacerdoti who died recently in Milan.

## British Jews Open Drive Today To Help Poland's Starving

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 9.—Citing the stark, terrible fact that more than a million Jews in Poland are exposed to actual starvation, Jewish leaders in England today issued an appeal to British Jewry to contribute generously to the relief campaign which opens here tomorrow to secure aid for Polish Jewry.

The appeal is signed by Chief Rabbi Dr. Hertz, Sir Osmond D'Avigdor Goldsmid, Nahum Sokolow, Neville Laski, M.H. Davis and Hacham Gaster, representing all leading Jewish organizations in the country.

## State Aid Is Withdrawn From Blind In Reich

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 9.—The Jewish blind will no longer be assisted by State and Municipal funds in Germany, it is reported today in the Manchester Guardian.

The Berlin correspondent of the Manchester Guardian also states today that private associations for the aid of the blind have also received instructions from the government forbidding them to assist Jews.

## Loosli Sums Up In 'Protocols' Trial at Berne

### Court's Expert Declares Document Is Forged And a Plagiarism

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERNE, May 9.—The eyes of Jews and Nazis in Switzerland were focused today on Berne, where the court will issue its verdict Saturday on the notorious "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," which the Jews contend is a forgery while the Nazis claim it is an authentic document that proves the Jews seek to dominate the world.

According to the testimony of the impartial expert appointed by the court, Dr. C. A. Loosli, concluded this afternoon, the "Protocols" are a definite forgery first used by Czarist Russia for anti-Jewish incitement and now used by the Nazis for anti-Jewish propaganda throughout the world.

### Answers Court Questions

In concluding his expert analysis today, Dr. Loosli gave the following answers to the questions by the court:

1. The so-called "Protocols" are forged and not genuine either in form or content.
  2. The "Protocols" constitute plagiarism, whose main source are the work of the French authors

## B'nai B'rith Elects Cohen To 3d Term

### Rubinow Also Relected Parleys to be held Every 3 Years

(Special to the J.D.B.) WASHINGTON, May 9.—Alfred M. Cohen of Cincinnati, was reelected president of B'nai B'rith at the closing session of the fourteenth quinquennial convention this morning.

Mr. Cohen, who is in his seventy-fifth year, was first elected president in 1925 and reelected in 1930. His present term has been changed from five years to three years by an amendment to the organization's constitution adopted by the convention Wednesday.

Golden Renamed Other members of the executive committee reelected are: Judge I. M. Golden of San Francisco, vice president, representing District 4; Archibald A. Marx of New Orleans, vice president, representing District 7; Louis Fabricant of New York, District 1; Sidney G. Kusworm of Dayton, Ohio, District 2; Henry A. Alexander of Atlanta, Georgia, District 5; Henry Monsky of Omaha, Nebraska, District 6.

Joseph W. Salus of Philadelphia was elected to the executive committee to represent District 3 in place of Jacob Singer of Philadelphia, who resigned because of illness. The executive committee reelected I. M. Rubinow of Cincinnati as executive secretary.

## Agency to Give Rival Unit Visas

### Number of Farm School Graduates To Set Agudath Quota

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 9.—The Agudath Israel which recently proclaimed the establishment of a separate Jewish Agency, will receive immigration certificates for Palestine from the present Jewish Agency in which Zionists and non-Zionists are equally represented, it was announced here today by A. H. Goodman, leader of the Agudath.

The number of certificates which the Agudath Israel, extreme orthodox Jewish organization, will receive from the Agency which it seeks to rival, will be determined by the proportion of Agudath members in the lands of the Diaspora who are graduated from the so-called Hachsharah, training farms for agricultural work in Palestine.

A. H. Goodman, political secretary of the world organization of the Agudath Israel, today addressed the Agudath Council here on the plans of the Agudath in Palestine and on the organization's plans to carry on political negotiations with the Colonial Office.

## Palestine Plans To Improve Wire Service

### To Spend \$2,500,000 In 5 Years To Make It Best In East

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, May 9.—A five-year plan to make the Palestine postal telegraph and telephone service the best in the Near East was announced today by Postmaster General William Hudson.

The announcement states that the government will invest \$2,500,000 in the project. Mr. Hudson explains that the increased Jewish immigration into Palestine has necessitated a more efficient service by the post office.

During the month of March alone the Jewish population in Palestine increased by more than 14,000. Five hundred and fifty-eight Jewish families entered during that month as capitalist immigrants, bringing not less than \$3,000,000 into the country.

Border Change Reported A change in the Palestine-Syrian frontier is announced today in Falastin, an Arab daily, with additional Syrian territory being transferred in Palestine.

The change has been approved by the French authorities in Syria, the paper states, adding that a Syrian official and the chief engineer of the Palestine government today started surveying the territory and selecting a site for a customs house.

## Reich Puts Exiled Jews At 90,000

### Collected \$25,000,000 Taxes From Refugees, Hitler Paper Reveals

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, May 9.—Ninety thousand Jews have left Germany since Hitler came into power, according to an announcement which is made today by the Voelkischer Beobachter, Hitler's chief organ.

The Nazi government has collected \$25,000,000 in emigration taxes from the refugees who left Germany, the Beobachter discloses. In 1933, the emigration tax yielded to the government treasury 17,500,000 marks, or approximately \$7,000,000. During the year 1934 the emigration tax yielded 45,000,000 marks, which is equivalent to \$18,000,000.

### 10,000 Are Back

Of the 90,000 Jews who left Germany, 10,000 have returned, the chief Nazi organ reveals. The paper believes that the liquidation of the Jewish problem in Germany can be achieved through emigration only.

A new anti-Semitic organization, established by the Nazis as the Anti-Jewish World League, held its first mass meeting last night in Nuremberg. A unique feature of the new organization is that it will be led by a Frenchman named Jean Boissel. The meeting in Nuremberg was addressed by Boissel and by Julius Streicher.

### A Prediction

"Jews will sooner or later be prevented from earning a livelihood in Germany," the Nazi newspaper General Anzeiger, says today.

The elimination of Jewish children from German schools is urged by Dr. Gross, the head of the Racial Office in the National Socialist Party, in an article published by him in the Rote Erde of Dortmund. "A teacher of an alien race has now become an impossibility in Germany, but it is just as essential that the pupils whom the teacher has to instruct should constitute a racial unity," Dr. Gross says, urging the complete segregation of all Jewish children.

## Legion Turns Thumbs Down On Nazi Memorial to War Dead

(Special to the J.D.B.) CHATTANOOGA, Tenn., May 9.—Dedication of a monument erected by the Nazi government to the German war dead buried in the National Cemetery here has been indefinitely postponed by the German Consul in St. Louis on the heels of the local American Legion Post's refusal to participate in any ceremony connected with the present Hitler government.

The Legion officials notified the German Consul that the local post was willing to honor their war

## Goebbels Returns to the Fray

BERLIN.

Der Angriff, the newspaper owned by Propaganda Minister Goebbels, recently announced that the Nazis, who had been occupied by other, more important matters, were again returning to the Jewish question "with renewed zeal." That, it goes on to explain, is not entirely because the Nazis wish to return to the Jewish problem again and again, but because the Jews are forcing them to. The well known Goebbels logic elaborates this theme.

But if there had been a respite for the Jewish community, it is to be regretted that its members were not informed. For they had no surcease from the steady, persistent sniping at their position, from the perpetual attacks by Nazis major and minor, from the thousand and one harassments that are their lot. And someone should certainly have told Herr Streicher there was a rest period, for he did not abate one jot from his campaign to exterminate the Jews and draw upon himself a veiled, delicate rebuke from Dr. Schacht's council for national economy for pestering Jewish shopkeepers.

\* \* \*

### The Citizenship Law

And it was in this period of apparent inattention, according to Dr. Frick, Minister of the Interior, that the cabinet worked on the new citizenship laws which will give Jewry the status of "German subjects" but not German citizenship and will keep Jews out of the military arms of the country. Likewise, it was in this same period that the Reich press chamber's president issued the vaguely-worded decree that may mean the suppression of the Jewish press in Germany.

Herr Goebbels may have been too busy with Danzig, the new army and replies to the Stresa resolutions and subsequent League Council statements to worry about the Jews, but his colleagues under the swastika certainly were not.

At any rate, the Jews of Germany are now advised that Dr. Goebbels is again giving the Jewish question the benefit of his attention.

"We are now going to deal again a little more vigorously with the Jewish question during the next few weeks," proclaims Der Angriff under the sensational headline, "New anti-Semitic drive." "We know that the Jews will immediately shout that there is a new anti-Semitic wave. We also know that certain other well-meaning but inexperienced Germans will say: 'Why don't you leave the Jews alone? They have been excluded from everything.'

# Between the Lines

### A Word to "Older Americans"

It was a fine address which James Marshall delivered the other day before new and prospective American citizens in New York. It contained advice to the new citizens as well as a word to "older Americans."

Mr. Marshall frankly emphasized that among some of the "older Americans," feeling against aliens is growing despite the fact that such feeling is contrary to the interests of America as a unified nation. He deplored this attitude of prejudice against minority groups. The best way to cement unity in a nation is not by suppressing the minority groups within this nation, he said, but by developing a feeling of respect for one another.

**The Immigrant's Contribution**  
The view expressed by Mr. Marshall will no doubt be shared by every liberal person in America. It reflects the opinion not only of the Jews but of all fair-minded elements in the country.

There are few in America who would deny that Jewish immigrants as well as other national minorities in this country have greatly contributed to the economic and cultural development of the United States. This was emphasized only a few days ago by Mr. Byrns, Speaker of the House of Representatives, in an address which he delivered in Washington. It has been emphasized many a time also by different Presidents of the United States.

### Fostering Anti-Alien Feelings

Nevertheless, there are elements in this country that are trying to capitalize on the prejudice which they can stir up against national minority groups. Some of these elements are frank in admitting that they work under the direct influence of Germany, but others naively believe that they are acting in good patriotic faith by fostering anti-alien feeling.

It is to the latter that the anti-immigration forces in this country belong. It is among this group that Congressmen are found who demand the complete cessation of immigration.

### Bills in Congress

There are now before Congress a number of immigration bills intended to work great hardship on aliens as a result of the growing anti-alien propaganda. Some of the bills demand cutting the present already limited immigration quota to sixty per cent. Others suggest cutting it to forty per cent. There are extremists who even go so far as to demand the complete closing of American doors to aliens for at least ten years.

The Congressmen introducing such bills forget about the role immigrants have played in the development of the United States. Not only are they against the admission of new aliens into our country, but they are even doing their best to make it difficult for those already in the country to become American citizens.

### Nationalism and Tolerance

It is to these Congressmen that James Marshall appealed in his address here the other day. It is to the Americans who forget that anti-alien feeling is an un-American feeling that Mr. Marshall directed his plea. These "older Americans" were told by

shall seem to be merely engaging in anti-Jewish hostility for the sake of tradition, because we don't want to leave the Jews alone. The fact is," it apologizes, "that in the last few months we have been able to deal with the Jewish question only as a side issue, because there were other more important questions. That does not mean, though, that the Jewish question has disappeared.

"It is not a question that depends only on us," the paper asserts defensively. "The Jew himself would not wish it to be settled. It is in his interest that it should be talked about and conceived as a problem. Nothing would hurt him more than to have it considered as a side-issue, as something of no moment."

\* \* \*

### What Jews Want

"The Jew wants to have the Jewish question, and he would always bring it up himself. He only puts a condition. It must not be beneath the proper level. Ritual murder, the Elders of Zion, Jewish cultural Bolshevism, rapacity, jobbery, all these things must be left aside. Blonde girls will be left alone by Jewish men, and the rest is scientifically untenable.

"We have not forgotten the Berlin Police President, Isidor (Dr. Bernhard Weiss), or the cultural level of Piskator, Lion Feuchtwanger, Georg Bernhard, Leopold Schwartzschild and Magnus Hirschfeld.

"We have a very definite attitude on this question and there can be no question of a new wave, or waves of anti-Semitism when we consider the relations of the modern German to the modern Jew."

\* \* \*

### Always Anti-Semites

"There have always been anti-Semites, and there is hardly a German philosopher who has not made critical observations about the Jews," the article observes. "But things changed completely when National Socialism came into power. An entire nation, an entire State has decided on the Jewish question with legal effectiveness. "It seems as if it is the Jews outside who are working against anti-Semitic Germany that has provoked them. Of late the energy of the Jews has been directed towards obtaining legal decisions on non-German soil against the German ideology, as at Cairo and Berne.

"The second method is to use the churches on behalf of the Jews, with Jewish propagandists, particularly in England, working up the churches against German new heathenism.

"Faced by such a situation, there can be no question of any new anti-Semitic wave." Der Angriff explains. "There is a state of tension between Jews and Germans, the end of which cannot be foreseen. We for our part have made a clear demarcation from which we shall not retreat. It depends entirely upon the Jews how matters are going to develop in the future. It is not only the Jews in Germany, who are now keeping quiet, that are responsible, but those who are making a row in the various stations to which they have emigrated."

# World Press Digest

## The Developments In Manchukuo

"Israel's Messenger," a Shanghai publication, reporting on the pledge given by the Manchukuo government to curb anti-Semitism, says:

The Harbin Consul General, Marishima, invited officially the president of the Jewish community, Dr. A. Kaufman and a member of the presidium, Mr. I. Berkovich. The conversation lasted about two hours, the Consul General evidencing keen interest in the affairs of the Jewish community. He stated that there existed a friendship between the Japanese and the Jewish people for several years and he was sure that this relationship would be continued uninterruptedly in future. Mr. Marishima expressed the wish to study and investigate the needs of the Jewish community. It came to his knowledge that the latter were facing hardships and even hostilities from certain sources which he felt sure he could suppress immediately. As a representative of Japan which was friendly disposed toward the Jews and as a representative of the power protecting the new state of Manchoukuo, it would be his duty to take into consideration the disabilities under which all the element of the community had lived and suffered. He invited the Jewish leaders to hear from them what grievances they had so that he could render them full assistance.

The terror is like some octopus that stretches out its tentacles in search of those who have sought refuge from it. Those tentacles paw and probe neighboring countries, especially when those countries are relatively weak, like Czechoslovakia or Switzerland. It is by no means sure that the capitals of stronger countries are safe—Paris, for example—and that the monster has its eye on London was shown recently by activities connected with the kidnapping of Berthold Jakob. The most recent of the monster's catches was made the other day on Czech soil. A German refugee was actually arrested outside of Germany by German armed officials, kicked and beaten, and then carried into Germany, a Czech official who tried to save him being seriously injured. Switzerland is making a determined stand on behalf of Berthold Jakob and refuses to be put off with the false or evasive replies made to Swiss representations. It is to be hoped that Czechoslovakia, one of the few countries in Central Europe where the individual is still respected as such, will show equal determination.

### On Nazi Kidnaping

"The Manchester Guardian," in an editorial commenting on the Nazi terror in connection with the kidnaping of German-Jewish refugees on foreign soil, says:

Mr. Marshall to remember that America is a cultural extension of Europe and the creation of a unified nation here would greatly suffer if the social and cultural backgrounds of all types of Americans—of old as well as of recent stock—were merged.

The views of Mr. Marshall were fully substantiated by D. W. MacCormack, Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization. Addressing the same gathering, Commissioner MacCormack spoke of the spirit of nationalism which is too strong in America and appealed for a more tolerant attitude. This appeal is no doubt very timely considering that the anti-alien forces are now mobilizing in Congress for a campaign to have Congress pass all the anti-immigration bills before the present session closes.

# Medical World Now Turns Its Gaze on Britain

## Influx of Reich Jewish Doctors Has Shifted Research Center

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
LONDON.—England has suddenly become the world's center in medical research—because of the influx of German Jewish doctors, an article in the Sunday Pictorial here points out.

Among them are some of the most brilliant of Germany's workers in medical research, and they are now engaged in London with some of England's most talented investigators on inquiries of high importance.

When the Jewish refugees first arrived in this country their position was a little difficult, as, of course, they could not practice here.

It was soon recognized, however, that the vast field of research was open to them, and the newcomers were eagerly welcomed by British investigators.

### Handicaps Overcome

The majority of British workers on medical subjects have been severely handicapped by their ignorance of the German language.

The opportunity which has now arisen for personal co-operation with some of Germany's most brilliant intellects is of incalculable benefit. It may be said with truth that research work of a character more vital than any the world has hitherto known is at this moment being carried on in England.

The Medical Research Council has realized the opportunity and has allocated the sum of £4,000, given by the Stock Exchange Dramatic Society, to the London Hospital for the promotion of research into the value of short wave radiation in the treatment of diseases.

In this task Sir Robert Stanton Woods and Professor D. T. Harris will have the assistance of Dr. E. May, a German refugee who was one of Germany's first workers in this field.

Dr. T. Reiter is another refugee who has written on the short Hertzian waves in medicine.

### Based on Research

In giving these answers the court's expert explained that his testimony is based on facts compiled by him from authentic files. The collection of material comprising the forged anti-Semitic "Protocols" was made in 1884, he said. The first appeared in French and was translated and published in the Russian language in 1903 by the anti-Semitic Russian newspaper *Kokeye Znamya*, notorious for its baiting and for inciting the population to Jewish pogroms.

The "Protocols," Dr. Loosli continued, were later completed by the Chief of the Czarist Secret Service Police Ratchkowsky and expanded by the Russian author Nilus.

### No Relation to Congress

"The 'Protocols' bear no relation whatsoever to the first Zionist Congress held in Basle in 1897, as the Nazis allege," Dr. Loosli testified.

Dr. Loosli urged the court to prohibit the spreading of the "Protocols," "obscene and trashy literature."

Col. Fleischaer, the Nazi expert, succeeded Dr. Loosli this afternoon in a three-hour rebuttal. He did not answer Dr. Loosli's charges but devoted himself mostly to defending the Nazi theory against Jews. He

## Rabbi's Braille Code To Be Widely Used


### Hebrew System Adopted by Temple Council is Work of Blind Chaplain

The Synagogue Council of America has adopted a Hebrew Braille for the blind, it was announced yesterday by Rabbi Harry J. Brevis, chairman of a committee that drew up the code.

Rabbi Brevis is the blind chaplain of the New York Guild for the Jewish Blind. He has worked on the problem for four years. As a result of his efforts and the council's approval an international Hebrew Braille is brought into use for the first time.

According to Rabbi Brevis, the code differs from the standard Braille in the number of vowels, more numerous in the Hebrew system, and in the codification of sounds peculiar to the Hebrew language.

#### Palestine a World Solution

"Palestine is the solution not only of the German-Jewish problem, but of the problem of victimized Jews throughout the world," declared Prof. Norman Bentwich, former attorney general of Palestine, at yesterday's session of the convention.

"In Palestine," he declared, "a home is being built not only for Jews, but for Judaism."

Prof. Bentwich said that the hope of eventually going to Palestine was the chief factor in the present sound morale of German Jewry. "Palestine offers opportunities for hundreds of Jews who are denied the most elementary rights elsewhere in the world," he said.

Lashing out at Poland and other Eastern and Central European countries, Prof. Bentwich declared

that conditions of Jews in those lands are fully as bad, economically, as they are today in Germany. He said that in his opinion the Polish government is not anti-Semitic, and even attempts to stem the tide of Jew-hatred, which nevertheless is rising because of a spirit of rabid chauvinism on the part of the people. The economic basis for Jews in Poland, Austria and other countries has been completely cut away, he said.

"Of the 3,000,000 Jews in Poland, 1,000,000 are actually supported by public charity," Prof. Bentwich continued. "The other two million are living at a level below that of human decency. The same conditions are true in Austria and Hungary, where the same anti-Semitism and lack of opportunity exist. Throughout eastern Europe, the Jews are struggling to retain the basic status of emancipation they won during the 19th century."

The situation cannot be fought by force, nor even by diplomacy, he concluded. "It is necessary," he said, "for world Jewry to make a great constructive effort to help the younger generation, both in Germany and in other benighted lands. In this work, American Jewry has done far from its proper share," he declared.

"There are 100,000 refugees from Germany since Hitler came to power," said Dr. Bentwich. "Eighty thousand are Jews. Twenty-five thousand have been integrated into Palestine economy and are taken care of. One thousand are being absorbed into the economic life of countries across the seas, including the United States, and about

8,000 in European countries, but there remain some 1,000 Jews from Germany who today face starvation and demoralization, those who have not been absorbed anywhere and cannot be absorbed anywhere. They must have a home provided for them immediately, or they perish. Many are drifting toward suicide and madness."

German Jewish youth must be sent to other lands, where they can grow up away from the scorn and hatred that surrounds them at German public schools, according to Dr. Bentwich. He added that only 6,000 Jewish children attended Jewish schools in Germany before Hitler's accession, but that between 30,000 and 40,000 attend schools today.

#### Constitution Changed

An insurgent move to curtail the broad powers of the B'nai B'rith Executive Committee broke out on the convention floor late yesterday afternoon and succeeded in bringing about sweeping changes in the organization's constitution.

One of the outstanding changes provides for a convention every three years instead of every five years as at present.

This change means that the headquarters of the B'nai B'rith will be moved to Washington within three years instead of five as had been indicated in a resolution adopted by the session earlier in the day.

Several convention delegates criticized the executive committee for its authorization of huge expenditures in the conduct of B'nai B'rith activities. These charges were followed by other charges al-




