Austria Acts To Suppress Race Bias

Disbands 'Aryan' Press Club; Forbids Rally of Jerzabeck Group

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) VIENNA, May 21-Two steps to suppress anti-Semitic activities of the Nazis in Austria were taken today by the Austrian government.

The authorities prohibited the holding of a meeting called by Dr. Jerzabeck, leader of the Austrian Anti-Semitic Union. They also suppressed today the "Aryan" Press Club for not complying with legal requirements.

The press in Vienna points out an ironic development arising from Germany's pressure upon Austrian Moving Plea for Aid Is film producers to eliminate their Jewish actors and directors or suffer the penalty of having their films barred in the Reich.

 Directors "Organized"
 As a result of this "Aryanization" of the Austrian film industry, many studios are featuring their Jewish film directors under "Aryan" names.

This has been the fate of Walter Reisch, a Jewish scenario writer and director engaged by the Paramount in America but permitted to remain in Austria in order to direct his new film, "Episode," which he also wrote.

Although everyone knows that Reisch is the director of the film, yet for the sake of Nazi susceptibilities, a "pure Aryan" named Willy Zeyn, previously known as a film cutter, is given as the director.

Herr Reisch expects to proceed to Hollywood to take up his work with Paramount as soon as he completes work on "Episode."

Kept Yiddish Book, Tailor Can't Collect

British Court Refuses to Accept His Accounts As Evidence

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 21—Bookkeeping conducted in Yiddish is not acceptable in British courts as evidence, Judge Spencer Hogg ruled here today in the case of a Jewish tailor,

Louis Simmons. Mr. Simmons sued W. Edwards an insurance clerk. claimed that the defendant ordered a suit, an overcoat and other clothing in 1930 and still owes him a balance of £12. Asked to produce a book, Mr. Simmons opened his from the back, explaining that he keeps

his books in Yiddish. "This is not much good to me," the Judge remarked, issuing the verdict in favor of the defendant.

Report Nazis Seized Chief Rabbi of Saar

English City Forbids Sale of Mosley Paper

LONDON, May 21—The sale of The Blackshirt, the official organ of the anti-Semitic Mosley party, on the streets of Birkenhead, was prohibited today by the chief of police, Capt. A. C. Dawson.

Capt. Dawson also notified the British Union of Fascists in the area of Birkenhead that he will not permit any Blackshirt parades to be held. He emphasized that if the Fascists persist in parading he will be forced to take all necessary steps to preserve

Palestine Visas Asked of King By Rumanians

Dispatched by 200 Students

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BUCHAREST, May 21-A plea to the King of England for assistance in gaining admission to Palestine, was sent today by 200 Jewish students of Rumania. A copy of the request was also sent by the students to Queen Marie of Rumania, asking her to support the appeal.

The students, who are anxious to create a model colony in Palestine, have directed their appeal to the King of England in connection with his Jubilee. The appeal reads:

"Heaven has decreed to bestow His grace on Your Majesty that you may celebrate in full vigor and splendor the twenty-fifth anniversary of Your Majesty's ascendance to the Throne of the British Em-

"When the pillars of the world are tottering mankind looks eagerly towards the solid, unshaken foundation of the Empire Your Majesty is reigning over, and 200 Hebrew students implore Your Majesty, on the occasion of Your Majesty's Jubilee, to kindly dispose that there be delivered to them certificates for establishing themselves in the Holy Land.

Praise of Hitler Race Policies Laid to Rutgers Professor

NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J., May 21-Direct charges of anti-Semitism against Dr. Frederick J. Hauptmann head of the German department of the Women's College of Rutgers University, were made today at the first hearing of the special committee of five members of the Board of Trustees of the University.

The charges were made by Dr. Leinard Bergel, a member of the staff of the German department who charges he was dismissed for opposing pro-Nazi activities among the students conducted by members of the German department.

Appearing as the first witness to testify today before the inquiry committee of university trustees, Dr. Bergel read a prepared statement charging Dr. Hauptmann with Nazism and anti-Semitism.

"The benefits of the anti-Semitic measures taken by the Hitler government were praised by Dr. Hauptmann before his classes," Dr. Bergel testified. He added that Dr. Hauptmann went out of his way to declare to the students that the anti-Nazi reports in the American press are nothing but lies, and that Hitler is the outstanding figure in Germany.

More than fifty witnesses, most of them students in the Women's College, were called by the inquiry committee to testify. Dr. Robert C. Clothier, president of the university, issued an invitation to all members of the faculty and to students of the Women's College to appear before the inquiry committee with evidence in the case.

Arab Labor Bar To Drive Jews In Holy Land Out of Reich

Front; Jew Is Hurt In Moslem Raid

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, May 21-A Jewish worker was slightly injured today in an attack by Arab workers on Jewish laborers near the village Elksan. Several of the Arabs involved in the attack were arrested.

A united Jewish labor front for the purpose of preventing the employment of Arab labor in Jewish enterprises, was organized here to day at a conference called by the National Labor Organization, the Revisionist Federation of Labor.

Despite the differences between the Revisionists and the Histadruth, the conference was attended by representatives of the Histadruth in Jerusalem, by delegates from the Mizrachi Laborites and by representatives of the Poale Agudath Israel, the extreme orthodox Laborites.

The establishment of a bank with a capital of \$250,000, for the purpose of helping Jewish laborers to build their own homes in the rural districts of Palestine, was announced here today.

Group to Push Wreck Stores

4 Groups Form United Nazis Resort to Violence To Achieve Aim in Several Cities

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, May 21-A new system of driving the Jews of Germany out of commerce by wrecking their stores was seen today in the repeated attacks on Jewish firms in Dusseldorf and Munich.

A mob of local Nazis invaded a Jewish store in Dusseldorf today and threatened to wreck it unless the owner immediately left town. Jewish stores continued to be picketed today in Munich by uniformed Nazis who would not permit prospective buyers to enter.

Acting apparently upon instructions, the police in both cities refused to intervene. The Jews in Bavaria are therefore making preparations to liquidate their business there and to proceed to Berlin

Extermination Open Aim The anti-Jewish terror in Ger-

many is now becoming as bad as in the early days of the Nazi dic-Nazi leaders make no tatorship. secret of the fact that their object is the complete extermination of the Jews from Germany.

Seven of the nine German firms manufacturing gramophone records started a case in court against the German Broadcasting Company for breach of copyright. The companies asked for an injunction to prevent the broadcasting of records made in their factories.

In connection with this case, an announcement has now been issued here by Herr Hadamovsky, the Nazi Commissar for the broadcasting stations in Germany, declaring that he would see to it of his own accord that the broadcasting of gramophone records in Germany ceases.

In making this announcement, Herr Hadamovsky implied that the action of the seven companies was part of an international campaign in which Jewish capital was deeply interested."

The case is scheduled to come up in court on May 28.

Book Lists Reich Acts **AgainstJews**

192-Page 'White Book' By Committee Reviews Two-Year Record

A "White Book" against Nazi Germany was issued yesterday by the American Jewish Committee, summarizing the anti-Jewish discriminations in the Reich and giving the complete texts of discriminatory legislation passed in the last two years by the Nazi government.

The "White Book," numbering 192 pages, lists all the laws that have been enacted in the official campaign to exterminate German Jews and German Christians of Jewish descent, as well as Germans married to Jews.

Non-Jews Included

"Although the book deals mainly with the Jews," the American Jewish Committee declares in the introduction, "it must be pointed out that many millions of non-Jews, too, are direct sufferers from oppression in Germany. They are suffering because they are believers in democracy, or because they are Catholics, or Socialists, or Communists, or internationalists, or pacifists. "Yet," the introduction continues,

"these groups can bring about an improvement in their condition by becoming reconciled to the Nazi principle. The lot of Jews and Christians of Jewish descent, however, will remain precarious as long as the existing so-called 'racial principle' obtains, on the ground of which they have been deprived of their universally recognized natural rights."

Curbs Listed

Enumerating the laws issued by the Nazi government to exclude Jews from civil service, to deny them citizenship rights and to restrict them in the practice of law, medicine, journalism and other professions, the White Book points out that, with certain exceptions, almost all non-Aryans were dismissed from the civil service and had their service contracts with public or semi-public institutions annulled.

As a result of the anti-Jewish laws, practically half of the Jews gainfully employed were ousted from their nosts the White Book reports.

25,000 Lost Jobs

Figures brought out in the White Book show that a total of 15,000 Jews with 13,000 dependents were ousted from civil service and liberal professions. In addition, 10,000 Jews with about 10,000 dependents were deprived of their jobs and income in public health or social welfare work. The Jews are being forced to establish schools at their own expense in order to escape the distortion of the mentalities of their 63,000 children.

The White Book declares that 'Jews have been almost totally eliminated also from commercial and trading enterprises." This process of elimination in the large concerns came through the forces of "coordination" or Nazification. In the

The action was taken after it became evident that the kosher meat trade was not cooperating with the code administration and that there was no legal method of forcing them to pay code assessments.

It was estimated that only about 300 of the 5,000 kosher butchers throughout the city are now exhibiting the blue eagle of the code.

Epstein on the Philistines

Jacob Epstein has discovered the fountain-spring of Philistinism and has declared war on it. The modern Vandal tribes, he says, come from Southern Rhodesia and he has declared war on that land to protect the eighteen statues now ornamenting Agar House in the Strand. The building, formerly the home of the British Medical Association, has been acquired by the government of Southern Rhodesia whose High Commissioner here has announced his intention of dispensing with the Epstein statuary. It is rumored that the government will part unreluctantly with the seven-foot figures for \$10,000 each.

"Vandalism! Vandalism! Sheer vandalism!" snorted Mr. Epstein. "It is as much vandalism to remove those statues as it was when one dynasty in Egypt destroyed the works of a previous dynasty.

"They may own the building," he continued indignantly, but they have no moral right to remove the statues. Neither have they any moral right to sell them."

To a sympathetic reporter, he explained, "The Southern Rhodesia government is evidently going to suit its tastes to its pocket. That's a Philistinian way of looking at the matter if you like!"

In a letter to the Sunday Observer, Sculptor Epstein returned to the battle of words with new vigor. Denying that the statues were "topical", he declared that the figures were intended to have universal appeal "even perhaps understood in South Rhodesia. . .

"The vandalism consists in removing and putting a price upon a decoration, the battle for which was fought out twenty-seven years ago, but the spirit of Philistinism dies not, and united to ownership dictates what shall and shall not be done to a decoration on a London building. We think dynasties that destroyed and mutilated the works

The Unnoticed Book Week

A Jewish Book Week is now being celebrated throughout the United States. But who knows about it?

With all the Jewish educational institutions that exist in America, little or nothing has been done to make this week popular. Nothing has been done to make the Jewish youth conscious of the importance of such a week.

When a general Book Week is proclaimed in America, it is usually taken for granted that there are commercial motives behind it. This motive does not exist in the Jewish Book Week. There are so few publishers of Jewish books in America, that they cannot be suspected of promoting a special Jewish Book Week for their own benefit only. Furthermore, the Jewish publishing houses have practically nothing to do with Jewish Book Week.

A Purpose Meriting Attention

When Jewish Book Week was proclaimed for the first time nine years ago, it was with the object of bringing more Jewish knowledge into the Jewish home. It was founded as an aspect of modern Jewish education, to reawaken Jewish consciousness and to develop among the American-Jewish youth a greater familiarity with the history and civilization of the Jews.

Such a purpose certainly merits the attention not only of a few individuals but of all the Jewish educational institutions in America. It merits the attention of Jewish leaders, especially at the present time when the Jewish problem is being pushed to the forefront by all kinds of dark

A Service Not Rendered

It is therefore regrettable to see how little has been done by Jewish organizations this year for Jewish Book Week. It is painful to note that the occasion is passing practically unnoticed.

During the last two years, more than at any previous time, books on Jews have been published in America by Jewish and non-Jewish publishing firms. Novels, plays and books on Jewish social problems, have appeared, answering the demand of the average reader, for more knowledge about the Jews.

What a great service to Jewry might have been rendered if this literature, coupled with other literature written by or about Jews in previous years, were exhibited on a large scale in various American cities and in libraries as a part of the Jewish Book Week! What fine propaganda it would have made for non-Jews and what a pageant of knowledge for the Jewish youth!

Shortsighted Leaders

The passing unnoticed of Jewish Book Week this year is therefore a concrete example of the defects of our Jewish cultural organizations. Their failure to convert Jewish Book Week into a nationwide demonstration of Jewish contribution to America's and the world's culture shows how dismally our Jewish cultural institutions have failed as yet to understand their mission.

Credit must be given to Miss Fanny Goldstein, librarian of the Boston Public Library. Despite the indifferent attitude of those who should have been interested in fostering Jewish Book Week, this woman, working untiringly to popularize the week from the very first year of its inception, has done much also this year. World Press Digest

Who Were The Samaritans?

The Irish Times of Dublin draws the attention of its readers to the Samaritans. The paper writes:

People in the present generation have an opportunity of seeing something which may not be seen for thousands of years hence, and which probably had not been seen for thousands of years in the past—the death of a nation.

The origin of this people—the Samaritans—is buried in obscurity. The Jews claim that when the ten tribes were exiled from Palestine by Assyria, the Assyrian King brought these Samaritans over as colonists, and that they were originally pagans, but gradually adopted some of the elements of the Jewish religion, The Samaritans, on the other hand, claim that they are the remnant of the exiled ten tribes. Because the Jews refused to allow them to participate in the building of the Second Temple they built one of their own on Mount Gerizim, of which the only relic is the sacrificial altar. Despite the fact that there have been no sacrifices in Judaism for the past nineteen centuries, the Samaritans retain a memory of animal sacrifice by performing the sacrifice of the Paschal lamb on the eve of the Passover on the ancient altar. Their leader is their High Priest, who claims direct descent from Aaron, and they assert that their scroll of the Holy Law was written by one of Aaron's sons.

How Jew's Books **Escaped Nazi Flames**

The London Standard, reporting that a biography of Lord Reading is now being written by the Austrian writer Paul Frischauer, discloses why Frischauer's books were not burned in Germany despite the fact that he is a Jew:

His book, "Prince Eugene," was admired by the late President Hindenburg, who accepted a copy of it from the author for his private library.

His book "Garibaldi" has a preface by Signor Mussolini.

Signor Mussolini received Dr. Frischauer in Rome just after he had finished "Garibaldi." Dr. Frischauer remarked that he did not think Germans would be allowed to read a Jew's life of the great Italian.

"I shall write an introduction to your book," said Signor Mussolini. "Then I do not think they will touch it."

This booklet gives a clear idea of all the literature by and on Jews in the English language, that is to be found in this country. Transfusion Leaves Nazi 'Aryan' Still

The Renasterea Roumana, published in Bucharest, Rumania, carries the following:

In a district of South Germany a Storm Troop chief was recently the victim of a motor accident. The wounds he received were so grave that one could not take into consideration the difference of race, and the wounded man had to be taken quickly to a Jewish hospital, the nearest to the place of the accident.

At the hospital the doctors stated that an immediate transfusion of blood was necessary. A Jew volunteered to place himself at the disposal of the injured man who could be saved from death. The case had curious consequen-

The Council of the local Nazi Party section brought this man before a jury in order to know if a person having received the blood of an "inferior" race was worthy to remain a member of the party. They established, in fact, that the Jew who offered his blood was an old combatant, several times decorated, and that by this the chief of the section could not be regarded as being "pol-

It was therefore maintained in the party that by reason of the exceptional circumstances he remained a "pure Aryan."

Survey Reveals Few Jews Left In Higher Schools of Prussia

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN-The official organ of the Reich and Prussian Ministries dents at the higher public and private schools in Prussia, according to religion, as of May 1, 1934.

The total number attending the public schools in Prussia was 355,362, and at the private schools 40,921, making altogether 396,183 students, 245,529 boys and 150,654

At the higher public schools, 343,257 were of "Aryan" origin, 233,560 boys and 109,697 girls, and at the higher private schools 38,888 -34,451 girls and 4,437 boys-a total of 382,145 "Aryan" students, 237,997 boys and 144,148 girls.

Non-Aryans in 3 Groups

The non-Aryans were divided into three categories: non-Aryans with "Aryan" blood (semi-Aryans), children of front-fighters, and ordinary non-Aryans.

The first category numbered 2,432-1,359 boys and 1,037 girls. At the private schools this category numbered 222-208 girls and 14 boys. In all, there were in the public and private educational institutions in Prussia 2,654 non-Aryans with "Aryan" blood—1,373 boys and 1,281 girls.

Non-Aryans who are children of front-fighters numbered 4,496 at the public higher institutions-2,487 boys and 2,009 girls; and at the private institutions, 5,087-2,632 boys and 2,455 girls.

Ordinary non-Aryans at the higher public educational instituof Education publishes a statistical tions numbered 2,788—1,663 boys survey giving the number of stu- and 1,125 girls; and at the private institutions 416—284 girls and 132 boys. The total number was 3,104 -1,695 boys and 1,409 girls.

3,193 Aliens at School

So there were in all 382,145 "Aryan" boys and girls compared with 10,845 non-Aryans belonging | to all three groups.

In addition, it is stated there are 3,193 foreigners attending the higher schools in Prussia, the greater number of them non-Aryan boys and girls.

Most of the non-Aryan boys and girls attend schools in Berlin. Here the number of non-Aryan boys and girls with "Aryan" blood out of the total of 63,505 was 641 boys and 286 girls. Children of non-Aryan front-fighters numbered \$39 boys and 783 girls, and ordinary non-Aryans 646 boys and 509 girls.

Thus in Berlin there were 6,350 "Aryan" boys and girls against 4,004 non-Aryans. In addition, the proportion of foreigners, including a large number of non-Aryans, is particularly large in Berlin. There are 1,502 foreign boys and girls at the higher schools in Berlin.

Second place in the number of non-Aryan boys and girls in the higher schools is taken by Hessen Nassau (chief town, Frankfort), and third place by the Rhine province (chief town, Cologne).

Educator Hails Role of Jews **I**n Literature

Prof. Cabot Speaks at **Boston Celebration** Of Book Week

(J.D.B. Special Correspondence) BOSTON, Mass. May 20—"Intelligent and open minded non-Jews must learn to realize that the truth about the Jew can better be learned from the testimony of Jewish literature than from the irresponsible utterances of those who seek to harm the Jewish people," Richard C. Cabot, professor emeritus of social ethics at Harvard University told a large gathering assembled at the Central branch of the Boston Public Library tonight, formally opening the local celebration of National Jewish Book Week.

The speaker pointed out that "it was Hebraic mortar that created many of the ideals of Americanism and the early traditions and principles upon which this nation was founded had their origin in the fundamental principles that made rael a great people."

Rabbi Louis M. Epstein, an outstanding scholar in rabbinate, paid high tribute to the contributions and personality of Moses Maimonides, pointing to the medieval scholar as "the greatest Jewish thinker of all time,'

A solemn-faced London policeman on traffic duty on the corner was unable to point them out-had never noticed them. Industrious and courageous neckcraning in the midst of a busy street finally was rewarded with a glimpse of some of the figures four stories above the street, obscured by the thick cloak of soot and grime that covers most of the city's buildings. They are almost impossible to see. Artist Epstein should welcome their removal to a more convenient location.

League Scored 500 Brooklyn Leaders For Inaction On Germany

Anti-Nazi Women's Unit Demands It Call World Boycott

A resolution criticizing the League of Nations for its inactivity in the face of German defiance of the Versailles Treaty and demanding that the League declare an international boycott against the Third Reich was adopted by about 200 representatives of women's organizations who met under the sponsorship of the women's division of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League at the Hotel Astor yesterday after-

Mrs. Mark Harris, chairman of the division, sounded a call for a reintensified boycott of German Hotel to discuss the growth of ingoods and services and appointed a number of committees to check rise of Nazi activities and to plan up on retailers who are selling Ger | possible means of preventing their man goods and to plan for a more vigorous boycott.

Mrs. Harris presented Department of Commerce figures to prove that the anti-Nazi boycott has aided American trade. She prophesied that the boycott will bring the Nazi ence, known as "Inter-Denominagovernment to its knees if it is continued to be pressed vigorously.

Other speakers were Dr. Kurt Rosenfeld, exiled former Prussian minister of justice and Mrs. Rebe-Kohut, author and social worker.

Cite League Covenant

The resolution, presented by Mrs. Julius Ferber, chairman of the resolutions committee, declared that "the Covenant of the League of Nations provides for the imposition of economic sanctions against nations that violate their obligations . . . and those who offend against civilization and humanity.

Pointing out that the League promised after Germany's announcement of rearmament to inwoke economic sanctions if Gerviolated the Versailles Treaty again, the resolution stated that the revelation that the Reich is building submarines constitutes another violation.

"Therefore be it resolved," the resolution concluded, "that this conference protest against the inaction and continued omission of the League to enforce the provisions of the Covenant and the Treaty and herewith demands that it impose a boycott or economic sauctions on the part of all its members against the present German government and that same be maintained until the latter ceases violation and retrace the steps it has taken in these direc-

Seek to Improve Trade With Egypt

Palestine Officials Go Cairo; 1934 Exports £3,217,562

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, May 21—A delegation to improve trade relations between Egypt and Palestine left for Cairo today, headed by the government treasurer, Mr. Johnson.

Figures made public here on Palestine exports and imports disclose that exports from Palestine in 1934 reached 3,217,562 pounds sterling, while imports during the same period amounted to 15,132,781 pounds sterling.

Almost twenty-five per cent of the goods imported to Palestine came from England, which occupies first place in the Palestine market. Germany ranks second and the United States third. The figures disclose that German imports to Palestine rose in 1934 to 1,676,000 pounds sterling, as compared with the 1,204,000 pounds sterling in the previous year. The value of the Pal-

Clearing Away Difficulties

Mr. Kaumheimer disclosed that the difficulties besetting the German Jewish refugees in his country are many but that slowly and inexorably they are being overcome. Although hesitant to venture an estimate of the exact number of German Jews in South Africa he stated that a "goodly number have already arrived."

"There are no political or social restrictions facing these people,' he continued. "But the difficulties arise in finding employment for them. This we have been doing for the past eighteen months as a result of our first drive and we hope to continue to be able to do as much through the medium of the South African Fund.'

"The difficulties facing these people and the committee may further be seen when the unemployment situation in South Africa is considered. It is only by titanic work on the part of the German-Jewish refugee committee that we have made as much progress as we have in the last year and a half.

'White Book' Lists Nazi Repressions

500,000 Still There

Despite the emigration of Jews from Germany, there are still half a million left who are urgently in need of relief, the White Book discloses. It estimates that at least 25,000 German Jewish refugees now scattered throughout Europe are in need of actual relief.

Reviewing the effects of the Nazi decrees against non-Aryans, the White Book brings out that these decrees permitted the withdrawal of non-Aryans' licenses as professors, instructors, and lecturers at colleges and universities; excluded persons of non-Aryan descent from service as officials of the Reich, states, and communes, and dismissed those who married persons of non-Aryan descent; provided that numerous non-Aryan holders of honorary offices be dismissed; cancelled the admission of non-Aryan lawyers and excluded others from practice; provided that non-Aryans be rejected as arbitrators; excluded them as tax consultants; expelled them as physicians and dental technicians from the national health insurance panels forbade partnership of "Aryan" and non-Aryan doctors; limited the ratio non-Aryan students in both the public and private schools; eliminated the rabbis from the local committees of education; restricted non-Aryans in the motion picture, theatre, journalistic, and broadcasting enterprises; curbed them in stock exchanges; limited the possibilities of their securing contracts; and in other ways restricted their rights as citizens and their opportunities for participation in the economic, social, and cultural life in Germany.

A considerable section of the White Book is devoted to an account of the agitation preceding the enactment of these laws. Modern anti-Semitism in Germany, the White Book declares, "was manufactured or at least stirred into flame by the Nazis in a campaign estine pound is approximately \$4.90. dating from 1920.

Mr. Kaumheimer, who came to this country with his wife five weeks ago on their first visit to America, expressed enthusiasm at the work done for the Jewish people by the leaders of American

"I was particularly pleased," he said, "to find that such men as Untermyer and Rabbi Stephen S. Wise are devoting so much of their time to the betterment of Jews throughout the world. It was the work of these influential Jews which I observed in my visits to many cities in America that gave me the greatest satisfaction."

Mr. Kaumheimer, besides heading the committee that comprises the South African Fund for German Jewry, is also in charge of the South African Jewish Orphanage at Johannesburg. This institution, housed in model buildings and harboring more than 400 Jewish children, is not only one of the finest orphanages on the South African continent but one of the outstanding organizations of its kind in the world. The orphanage has a tremendous acreage and buildings that are unsurpassed in beauty and facilities.

His Service Lauded

While Mr. Kaumheimer was in London he received the following dispatch from the members of the committee, among whom are included Chief Rabbi Dr. J. L. Landau, president, Rev. A. P. Bender, and Mr. Justice Greenberg:

"In taking over the office of vice-chairman of the South African Fund during your absence overseas, I would take advantage of the opportunity to express on behalf of my colleagues and self our appreciation of your efforts to assist the German Jewish immigrants arriving in Johannesburg.

"Whenever your services have been required you have placed yourself unreservedly at the disposal of the Committee, and have always been willing to give your time and assist them with valuable and far-seeing advice."

Mr. Kaumheimer will go first to London before departing for Johannesburg for meetings with Chief Rabbi Dr. Hertz and other leading Jews in England in order to discuss plans for the forthcoming drive for funds.

Short of Goal

Allied Jewish Drive Nets \$219,148; 29 Agencies Get \$165,000

(Special to the J.D.B.)

DETROIT, May 22-The Allied Jewish Campaign came to a close here with a total of \$219,148 subscribed towards the entire quota of \$270,000.

Of this sum, \$165,000 was raised for the maintenance funds of twenty-nine local, national and international agencies, including German-Jewish relief and Palestine's reconstruction. Kurt Peiser, executive director of the Jewish Welfare Federation, announces that althoug the maintenance funds fell \$5,000 short of the goal, there will be no cuts in allowances to the agencies included in the drive.

The balance of \$54,000 will be used for the building fund for the Jewish Old Folks Home, which was included in the drive for a quota of \$100,000. Negotiations are under way to have the Jewish Hospital Association turn over the \$42,000 in its treasury towards the Old Folks Home funds with the understanding that it should be used to care for the aged, infirm and chronic ill in the new home.
