## Put Curbs On Students In Rumania

### Cabinet Enacts a Series Of Restrictions To Insure Peace

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
**BUCHAREST, June 3**—The Rumanian Cabinet today approved a number of measures aimed at maintaining peace in the universities and preventing anti-Jewish outbursts there. The measures approved are:

1. Students guilty of inciting to riot should receive severe punishment.
2. No student should be permitted to join a student organization which is not recognized by the university authorities.
3. Students are to be prohibited from attending political meetings.
4. No student is to obtain special rights and privileges.

The students of the universities in Rumania will have to sign a pledge that they adhere to the above conditions, the Cabinet decree provides.

**Hits at Valda-Voevod**  
 Dr. William Fieldner, president of the Union of Rumanian Jews, in a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today contended that the measures proposed by ex-premier Valda-Voevod for the enforcement of a numerus valdeus for Jewish students in the Rumanian universities are not really designed to reduce unemployment in Rumania but are nothing more than an attack upon the rights of the Jewish population as well as an attempt to make it impossible for Jews to earn a livelihood.

"A real solution to the problem of national labor would proceed along entirely different lines than those proposed," he stated.

## Stuerner Issue Sold In Danzig

### Special Edition Attacks Jews, All Anti-Nazi Groups There

**DANZIG, June 3**—A special edition for Danzig of the notorious anti-Semitic publication, Der Stuerner, published in Nuremberg by Julius Streicher, made its appearance here today.

The edition is full of slanders against the Jews and against all anti-Nazi elements in Danzig.

The official press in Danzig, which is pro-Nazi, stated today on the League of Nations to appoint a jurists' committee to establish whether the anti-Jewish discriminations in the Free City are in violation of the Danzig constitution. "This decision is a victory for the National Socialist Party in Danzig," the government press states.

Led by Dr. Forster, the Nazi "boss" of Danzig, a new anti-Jewish campaign was initiated today in the Nazi press here.

## Rockefeller Museum Is Given to Palestine

**JERUSALEM, June 3**—The Rockefeller Museum, one of the most important institutions in the entire Near East, was officially transferred today to the Palestine government.

The inauguration ceremony upon completion of the museum building, which was to have taken place this week, has been postponed. It will be held in the near future with High Commissioner Wauchope officiating.

## Bureya Settlers To Be Selected In Lithuania

### 150 Will Be First Group Of Foreign Jews To Go To Soviet Region

**KAUNAS, Lithuania, June 3**—The first group of foreign Jews to be admitted into Biro-Bidjan will be selected in Lithuania, was officially announced here today.

The announcement states that M. Rasches, former chairman of the Bureya district, will arrive here shortly to select the first 150 Jews for Biro-Bidjan in accordance with the recent decision of the Soviet government to admit several thousand Jews this year into the Jewish autonomous district in the Far East.

The Jews selected will be provided with the Soviet government with fare and food as soon as they reach the Soviet frontier.

**Jews Ask Protection**  
 A delegation of Jews from the townships of Kurshan and Shawil appeared today before the Lithuanian Minister of Interior asking him to protect the Jewish population in these townships against anti-Semitic attacks.

Third group of young people from Berlin and other cities in Germany, thirty-five in number, today arrived at the Ort farm in Kallinow, near Kaunas, which is the second farm established by the ORT for training young Jews from Germany.

## Jews to Build Big 'Yes' Vote Two Memorials For Pilsudski

### One Will Be In Poland, Other in Palestine, Parley Decides

**WARSAW, June 3**—The All-Polish Central Union of Jewish Communities, called to decide the most fitting way to perpetuate the memory of Marshal Pilsudski, concluded today with decision to create two memorial foundations in Pilsudski's name, one of which is to be in Poland and the other in Palestine.

A central committee consisting of 13 members was elected by the conference. This committee is to appoint an executive from its own ranks to carry out the decision of the conference.

The representatives of the Zionist Central Committee in Poland announced that they will not participate in the Pilsudski memorial committee unless the funds raised spent through the Palestine are used for planting a Pilsudski forest.

The Agudath Israel firmly opposed the spending of the money through the Jewish National Fund. Zionist groups which are not represented in the Zionist Central Committee declare that Palestine participate in the Pilsudski Memorial Committee

## A. Levy - He Built Normandie - Pronounces Liner a Success

One of the 2,170 passengers aboard the record breaking Normandie which arrived in New York yesterday, was Andre Levy, Director General of the Penhoet shipyards that built the new French liner.

M. Levy was making his second visit to the United States on the 1,025-foot liner that completed her maiden voyage across the Atlantic in 47 days and 23 minutes, for the crossing of 29.65 knots.

The time from Southampton to Ambrose Lightship was given officially as 107 hours and 23 minutes, one hour less than four and a half days. Mr. Levy's previous trip to this country was at the time of the inaugural trip of the Ile de France,

another ship built by his firm.

Mr. Levy, who will return on the Normandie Friday, doesn't think that another liner such as the Normandie will soon be built. "There isn't room," he told an interviewer. ## Frick Warns Nazi Chiefs On Rioting

## Cemetery Desecrated

A number of Nazis were arrested today in Oldenburg for desecrating the old Jewish cemetery there on the night of May 22. The Nazis destroyed many tombstones, among them that of Peter De Vries, who was a godson of the late Grand Duke Nikolaus of Oldenburg. De Vries was killed during the war and the Grand Duke ordered that his body be removed from the battlefield to the Oldenburg Jewish cemetery.

## Vienna Vote 'Yes'

In Vienna 1,467 voted for the establishment of the proposed independent organization, and sixty-four voted against.

In Warsaw, 5,415 cast votes, of which 5,357 were for the creation of a separate body. The complete returns for all of Poland will not be known before tomorrow.

In Jerusalem the first returns show 813 votes for and 24 votes against establishing a separate Zionist organization.

In Tel Aviv, 3,832 voted for and sixty-seven against.

## The Resolution

The resolution which members of the Revisionist Party were called to vote upon read:

"The Zionist Revisionist Organization prescribes the immediate establishment of an independent Zionist Organization and directs the Executive Committee to convene in December, 1935, its Constituent Congress on the basic principle of a Jewish State in Palestine and on the basis of a Herzlian Shekel."

## Local Revisionists Vote for Separation

New York Revisionists displayed great interest in the Shekel. The returns for New York City show that 1,090 voted for the resolution and 62 voted against it.

The vote of other cities in America and Canada will be tabulated and published upon receipt.

## Reich Military Law Explained

An explanation of the new Military Law has been given here by Major-General von Reichenau, head of the Wehrmacht-staff, whose position, deriving from that of Chef des Ministeriums created by the late General von Schleicher, combines roughly the functions of permanent Under-Secretary, right-hand man of the War Minister and the Commanders-in-Chief, and that of Chief of Staff.

The military service obligations from the eighteenth to the forty-fifth year. The length of service with the colors is set by the law, who has last that of the soldier, who is not. In addition to long service non-commissioned officers, volunteers can engage for an extra year in the Army and for four years in the Navy and Air Arm. The personnel of the Navy and Air Arm will be supplemented solely from longer-service volunteers.

### Forced Labor

Compulsory labor service will be a preliminary condition for active military service. It will probably begin on October 1. The classes of 1914 (21 years old) and 1915 (20 years old) are to be examined this year. Men between 25 and 35 who have not yet had military training can, after doing two training courses of two months, enter the reserve system, and those aged 35 and over who have not yet received commissions have just completed their active year. Provision is made for former officers of the Imperial Army and navy, and for those who wish to obtain reserve commissions if they prove themselves suitable. # Between the Lines

### Eyes on Mexico

The anti-Semitic campaign in Mexico which has been renewed this week, need not be underestimated. The petition of the Golden Shirts to the Mexican government for the withdrawal of citizenship from Jews should not be taken lightly.

Behind the Golden Shirts are a number of Mexican leaders who have sworn that the policy of the country. In addition to the Golden Shirts, there is the so-called "Pro-Rasa Committee" which advocates racial purity with Mexico along the same lines as it is being advocated in Nazi Germany. There are also the Society for the Protection of Mexico and the Association of Mexican Nationalists—two nationalistic organizations engaged in spreading anti-Jewish sentiments in the country.

### Anti-Jewish Demonstration

Only a year ago the Golden Shirts were the only force in Mexico to organize public demonstrations in Mexico City against the Jews. At a time when the Nazi authorities prohibit demonstrations of the League Against War and Fascism, the police of Mexico City did not in any way hinder the anti-Jewish demonstrations of the Golden Shirts.

As a result of the increased anti-Jewish spirit now prevailing in Mexico, leaflets can be seen posted in the streets of Mexico City reading: "Friedly Cooperation Between Jews and Mexicans is as Impossible as Hitler and Einstein Dining from One Plate." The yellow poster appeals to the Mexican people to support the 10,000 Jews who came to Mexico and are taking bread away from the Mexicans. "Use your rights and drive the Jews out of our country," the appeals urge.

### Press and Government

The attitude of the Liberal press and of the Mexican government, though they are not anti-Jewish, is also not sufficiently pro-Jewish. The Liberal press does not come out openly against the anti-Semitic propaganda because it fears losing the advertisement income. The Liberal press, which most of the newspapers depend. The government, while officially assuring full protection for the Jewish population, is nevertheless in many cases supported to control its local authorities, a large proportion of whom are outspokenly anti-Semitic. It is established fact that the police have in many cases supported the activities of anti-Semitic groups.

### Intervention Can Help

Under such circumstances, it is easy to understand why the 16,000 Jews now residing in Mexico are in constant fear for their lives. The majority of the 16,000 Mexican population is still primitive. The anti-Semitic agitation may therefore bring tragic consequences if not properly checked now.

Some time ago a Committee to Protect Mexican Jewry was formed in America. This committee, in May, 1934, intervened through the United States against the Jew-baiting activities of the Golden Shirts in Mexico. What has happened to this committee now? Is the petition of the Golden Shirts to withdraw the citizenship of Jews in Mexico, going to be left unchanged? Are the Jews of Mexico going to be left to the mercy of the anti-Jewish agitators in their country?

# World Press Digest

## Irish Paper Comments On Zionist Split

The Irish Times of Dublin, commenting on the secession of the Revisionists from the Zionist World Organization, says in an editorial:

After two thousand years the tribulations of the Jewish people are not ended. There are signs, moreover, that Jewish affairs may become a world concern ere long. The Zionist Party has split—how seriously we cannot judge until events show whether the new departure has as strong a following as at first appears. Mr. Vladimir Jabotinsky, the organizer of the Jewish regiment which fought in the Great War for the liberation of the Holy Land, has gone out from the official party, demanding that a claim be made for the establishment of a free Jewish State on both sides of the Jordan. Such a claim, of course, may be beyond what British policy has secured for the Jewish people in their ancient fatherland—a "national home" a region in which numbers of the race may settle and live in the manner of their ancestors, speaking the Hebrew tongue and cultivating Hebrew learning in a university of Jerusalem, but only as equal settlers with other races, under the flag of the Mandatory Power.

The Moslem commentators, Exodus 20:3, "Thou shalt have no other gods beside me," implies that formerly other gods had been worshipped in Israel. ## League Can Force Danzig to ObeY

The Manchester Guardian, writing on the outcome of the petition of the Danzig Jews to the League, says editorially:

Though A.V. the terms of international treaties and the League Constitution the Jews, like all other religious and racial minorities in Danzig, are protected from any discrimination, yet since the National Socialists first gained power in 1933 they have been subjected to a systematic boycott hardly better than they might expect in Germany itself. The officials of the government, who have taken oath to respect the constitution with all its guarantees against oppression, have in nearly every case also pledged themselves to the National Socialist faith, of which anti-Semitism is a fundamental tenet. Those who thought otherwise, who imagined that the callous terrorization of the Jews in Germany would pass with the first ardor of the "revolution," are refuted by the fresh outbreak of these brutalities in Germany to-

day, when National Socialism has settled firmly in the saddle and the revolution has been forgotten or forgotten. But Danzig is not Germany, though it is German, and not Nazi, though its rulers tried to make it say so, and while in Germany can only be a matter of shame and sorrow to those outside it, in Danzig it is unconstitutional, illegal and wicked, the power of the League to stop.

# Appeal Aides To Hold First Meeting Today

# Argentine Jews Will Overcome Imported Bias, Editor Declares

### M. Stolliar Here to Study Immigration Problems of America

An interesting picture of the life of the half million Jews in the Argentine was given yesterday by M. Stolliar, editor and publisher of the "Die Weltzeitung," the largest Jewish newspaper in Argentina, who is in New York to investigate immigration problems in the United States for the Argentine government.

"Anti-Semitism in Argentina is an imported product," Mr. Stolliar stated in the course of an interview. "Until the rise of Hitlerism in Germany, no one in the Argentine knew about anti-Jewish feeling. Since Hitler came into power his agents have, however, invaded Argentina and infected the peaceful atmosphere with anti-Jewish propaganda."

**Propaganda Little Feared**

Although the majority of the 150,000 Germans in the Argentine are connected with Nazism, the Jews in that country fear little of their anti-Jewish propaganda, Mr. Stolliar explained. The Jewish leaders there consider the present situation temporary. They are certain that the wild Nazi propaganda will not succeed in spoiling the relations between the Jews and the Argentinian people.

The Jews, Mr. Stolliar said, are contributing to the agricultural development of the country just as much as to other phases of life.

Speakers at the Jews as farm workers. Mr. Stolliar declared that the 26,000 who are now living on the soil in the Jewish colonies in Argentina offer the most striking example of Jewish adaptability to land work. "These 26,000 Jews live a normal and productive life and constitute the strongest weapon against any kind of anti-Semitism."

### 300,000 Ashkenazim

Mr. Stolliar related that of the half million Jews in the Argentine today, 300,000 are Ashkenazim who came mainly from Russia, Poland and other East European countries. The other 200,000 Jews are of Sephardic origin.

There is quite an intensive Jewish cultural and social life in the Argentine which finds expression through a net of Jewish and Hebrew schools and numerous cultural and relief institutions. The Jewish press in the Argentine has influence upon the Jewish population. Since the advent of Hitlerism and its echo in Argentina, the Jewish press has become more active. Aires has attracted new readers. The interest in Jewish life has grown even among those Jews who considered themselves assimilated.

### Zionism Strong

Of all the political movements prevailing among the Jews in the

Argentine, the Zionist movement is the strongest.

"I am proud that Argentina is my home," Mr. Stolliar stated, emphasizing that of all the countries he visited in South and Central America, Jewish life in the Argentine is more stabilized and more secure.

Mr. Stolliar will remain in the United States for more than a month. In addition to studying the immigration problem in America for the Argentine Government, he will also make an extensive study of the newspaper industry in the United States.

Declaring that Dr. Krauskopf's dreams were nearer realization now than at any time in the thirty-six years of the existence of the school, Dr. Fineshimer declared that, though the Jews were divorced from farming for more than 2,000 years, they have never lost that heart-hunger for the soil, that yearning in their bosoms for the product of the land."

# Hope Is Voiced Roosevelt Will Protest to Nazis

## Jews Warned Against Meekness by Wise At Order's Parley

(Special to the J.D.B.)

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., June 3.—The hope that President Roosevelt will sooner or later come out with an official statement against the persecutions in Nazi Germany was expressed here today by Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, addressing the forty-eighth annual convention of the Independent Order Brith Abraham.

Rabbi Wise warned the Jews of America not to be meek and to protest energetically against any anti-Jewish discrimination in the United States. He spoke of the danger of anti-Semitism in America and emphasized that numerous colleges in America are nests of Nazi propaganda.

Italy Is Praised

Reviewing the Jewish situation in Europe, Rabbi Wise praised Italy for its friendly attitude towards the Jews and emphasized that he fears for the future of the Jews in England because of the growth of the Mosley movement there.

Rabbi Wise praised Soviet Russia for its fight against anti-Semitism. He criticized the Soviet government, however, for its opposition of the Hebrew language and for the prohibition of the Zionist movement in that country.

In Poland the present policy of the government brings indescribable misery for the Jewish population, Rabbi Wise told the delegates at the convention. The danger of anti-Semitism in Rumania is great despite the fact that King Carol is very liberal in his attitude toward the Jews.

### Attacks Hungary's Leaders

Rabbi Wise bitterly attacked the Jews of Hungary. The situation of the Jewish population in Hungary, he asserted, is very precarious, but the Jewish leaders there do not make the slightest attempt to fight for their rights.

Rabbi Wise appealed to Brith Abraham to participate in the rebuilding of Palestine and to establish it in Palestine a nation named after the Order in connection with its fiftieth anniversary. He also appealed to the delegates to work hand in hand with the American Jewish Congress.

"The Order should concentrate on winning the Jewish youth into its ranks," he said. "It should actively participate in all matters concerning Jewish life in the United States."

Today's session of the convention was greeted by Dr. David Levitch of the World Orit Organization. Mr. Wolfkenson greeted the session in the name of the Denver Sanatorium and Rabbi Winer Margolis, in the name of the Yeshiva College of New York.

Today the cyclists, who come from Palestine on a mission of good will from sports organizations there, were entertained in Kansas City, where they were greeted by a delegation headed by Harry Friedberg.

From Denver, the world-riders go on to Salt Lake City and thence to San Francisco.

# Colonize Jews On Crown Land, Party Demands

## State Group Asks Britain To Guarantee Public Loan for Purpose

At the annual party council of the Jewish State Party of America, held Sunday at the Central Jewish Institute, the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:

1. That the British government institute a colonization regime in Palestine which shall make possible the immediate colonization of Jews on Crown lands, both sides of the Jordan.

2. That a public loan be floated, guaranteed by the government of Palestine jointly with the Jewish Agency, to enable the colonization of 100,000 Jewish families on land on both sides of the Jordan.

3. That the Mandatory shall encourage the industrialization of Palestine by appropriate tariffs and international trade treaties.

The following speakers reported on various phases of Zionist and Jewish State Party activities: Prof. Chaim Chernowitz, honorary president of the Jewish State Party; Dr. P. Churgin, S. Booksman, M. Chochem, A. R. Malach, Rabbi B. Schochet, I. Baratz, Julius L. Fischbach, M. Gottlieb and others.

## Assault Turkish Code

In his address, Prof. Chernowitz pointed out the serious handicaps imposed on the transfer of lands by the Turkish Code, which is still in force in Palestine. This code makes the transfer of clear title to land almost impossible and at best a very expensive and long-drawn-out affair. Prof. Chernowitz declared, and he demanded that it be abolished and a modern, civilized code adopted for the entire Mandated area of Palestine.

Upon Dr. Churgin's motion, a resolution was unanimously passed, calling upon all elements of Jewry in Palestine to publicly respect all Jewish laws, customs and traditions. According to reports from Europe, the Jewish State Party will be represented at the next

Zionist Congress by at least forty delegates. The party council also decided to invite the president of the World Executive of the Jewish State Party, Meir Gossman, to visit the United States shortly after the Zionist Congress, in the interest of the Jewish State Party of America.

The following committees were elected at the Council meeting: praesidium—Julius L. Fischbach, M. Chochem, I. Baratz; secretary—A. R. Malach, Raphael Schochet; organization—Geller, Booksman, Baratz, Gottlieb; resolutions—Chochem, Reichel and Berger; platform—Prof. Chaim Chernowitz, Dr. Churgin, A. R. Malach, Raphael Schochet.

## Friendly to Britain, Jabotinsky Averts (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, June 3.—Vladimir Jabotinsky, the leader of the Zionist Revisionist Party, addressing a large meeting here today, declared his friendship for England but criticized the present state of affairs in Palestine.

Mr. Jabotinsky demanded that Transjordan be opened for Jewish immigration.

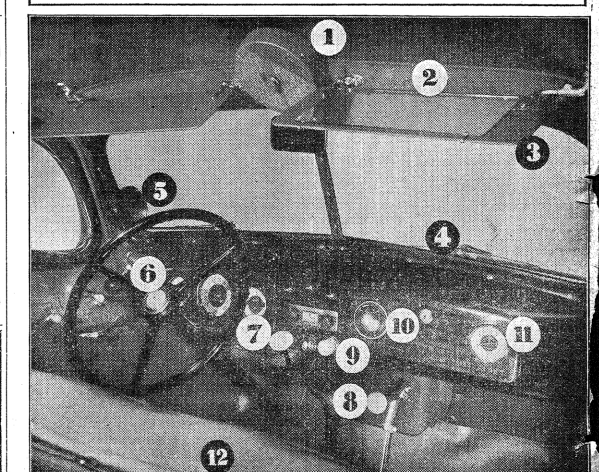
(these demagogic propaganda activities," Dr. Filiderman says.

Dr. Filiderman points out that there cannot be any question of an overcrowding of the professions in Rumania, for there cannot be sufficient doctors while the infant mortality is as high as sixty per cent. Dr. Filiderman emphasizes that there are only 286 students of veterinary medicine at a time when enormous numbers of cattle—one of the most important items of export in Rumania—are of various ailments.

"It is necessary to distribute the academic professions more effectively instead of inciting against the Jews," Dr. Filiderman declares.
