No Easing of Race Laws, Reich Vows

Solution of the Jewish Problem Vital, High Official Says

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, June 5-"The German government will not relent in its racial laws even if the entire Jewish press of the world continues to abuse us," Dr. Frank, Minister of Justice, declared today in address. Justice, declared today in addressing a conference of the League of National Socialist Lawyers in East Prussia.

The German Minister made it clear in his speech that the Jews need not expect any concessions on the "Aryan paragraph."

"The future of our nation depends upon the solution of the race question," he emphasized.

Law for Germans Only

The Minister of Justice asserted in his speech that forty per cent of the lawyers in Berlin are still We must reserve the profession of law for our German student youth," he declared.

The Central Council of the League of Jewish Women in Germany today sent out a circular letter to its members, calling upon them "to meet the requirements of the Jewish traditional laws under all circumstances."

"We expect our members to hold firm the Jewish principles as their duty toward the maintenance of the solidarity of the Jewish community," the circular says.

'Aryan' Routs Nazis

Herr Hahn, a pure "Aryan" whose fight against the anti-Jewish policy of the Nazis in Munich has aroused widespread interest, won today another moral victory.

Herr Hahn is the owner of a large grocery and delicatessen store in Munich. The Nazi Small Retailers' Association, led by the followers of Julius Streicher, the notorious Jew-baiter, has made many attempts to drive him out of business because of his pro-Jewish attitude. Today they smeared his store windows with signs "Hahn's Wife is a Tewess" and "Don't Buy from Jews."

Admits Writing Nazi Article

Jews, But Denies He's An Anti-Semite

Admitting that he is the author of an article which appeared Tuesday in the Nazi press in Germany advocating the sterilization of Jews, Prof. C. G. Campbell of New York told a representative of the Jewish Daily Bulletin yesterday that he is not an anti-Semite, though he is distinctly sympathetic to the Nazi regime and its racial theories.

Prof. Campbell, who resides at the University Club, Fifth Avenue and 54th Street, is the president of the Society for Eugenic Research, which he says is twenty years in existence. He is a graduate of the University of Michigan but has never been connected with any academic institution in the United States.

"My article has never been published in America," the professor said. "It must have gotten into the Nazi newspapers through a few copies which I sent to prominent Nazi anthropologists.

Prof. Campbell admitted that he visited Germany last Summer and that he had a personal talk with Julius Streicher, the notorious Jewbaiter of Germany.

"From a purely scientific point of view, racial mixture should be discouraged. Where divergent races marry, the parties to the marriage should be sterilized," the pro-Nazi eugenist explained. "The difference between the Jew and the 'Aryan' is as insurmountable as between black and white," he continued.

Project Held Up Pending More Experience With City Autonomy

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) GENEVA, June 5-Sidney Moody, Assistant Chief Secretary of the Palestine government, told Mandates Commission of League of Nations today that his government is definitely considering the establishment of a Legislative Council.

"As soon as the experience with the municipal autonomy now proclaimed in Palestine becomes more complete, the question of the establishment of a Legislative Council will be taken up by the government," Mr. Moody stated, replying to questions put to him by members of the Commission.

Mr. Moody emphasized that the Arabs all favor the establishment of a Council in Palestine but the

Refers to Zionist Rift

In the course of his answers, Mr. Moody referred to the fight between the Zionists and the Revisionists as a "serious internal Jewish division." He spoke also on the Arab-Jewish relations in Palestine and stated that these relations are improving despite the tension existing between the Jews and Arabs on political grounds.

"The Palestine government," Mr. Moody said, "is doing everything possible to improve the lot of the Arab and Jewish farmers. A good harvest is expected this year," he

The discussion on the Palestine Mandate will be continued at tomorrow morning's session. Moody is being assisted by Mr. Downie, an official of the British Colonial Office.

German Camouflage in Czechoslovakia

Students of national psychology know how much the fairy tales of each nation are the expression of national psychology, and to what extent they are an expression of fear and desire. It seems that the fairy tale which has influenced the forma-

tion of the character of present-day Germany to the greatest extent is the story of the "Cap of & Darkness" (Tarn-Kappe). This cap lic, and has thus been able to win gives anyone who puts it on his forty-five of the 300 seats of the head the attribute of invisibility. He sees, but is not seen. As long as he has this cap on his head he can follow all his wishes and desires without paying for their fulfor misdeeds. fillment, or without being punished

Dream of All Germans

The dream of all Germans of the Hitleristic stamp is to own such a cap. The word "tarnen" (to make invisible, to camouflage) is new in the German language, and has been used in Hitler circles only since 1923, after the ill-fated Munich Beerhouse Putsch. Since then the following password has been given "German, 'tarn' yourself! Dont say who you are, and what Try to be different you want. from what you appear to be! Take everything upon which you can lay your hands, deny yourself no wish! Always act 'getarnt'."

The Cap has brought victory to Hitler in Germany, and with the same Cap he seeks to gain victories in the international field. He hopes to gain this victory with the help of the Germans living abroad, those smaller or larger German groups which not only live in the countries bordering Germany, but also the groups living in isolated oases in countries not on the German border, such as Russia, Hungary, Yugoslavia, Rumania and even North and South America. Hitler has promised all these Germans that he will "redeem" them. All these Germans, Hitler has hitched to the wagon of his policy of world power and has given them simultaneously the advice "'tarn' yourself!" And the Germans living abroad have 'tarned' themselves.

Victory for 'Tarn Kappe'

"Hitler's lieutenant for Czechoslovakia," Konrad Henlein, has gained a great victory by means of the "Tarn Kappe" and has not only brought great sorrow to the Jews in the German part of Czechoslovakia, but also has caused confusion in the whole Czechoslovakian politics.

Konrad Henlein's "Sudtendeusche" Party was able to poll at the latest parliamentary elections 1,250,000 votes, i.e. two-thirds of all German votes in Masaryk's repub-

Parliament. This party has polled the greatest number of votes of all parties, and will enter Parliament equal in strength to strongest

Czech party, the Czech Agrarians. The progressive German parties, which so far have participated in the government, including the German Social Democrats, have been weakened to such an extent that they are of not much value in formation of the government. Czech government parties have suffered hardly any loss in the election, as the purely Czechian Fascists will only be represented by six deputies, and the semi-Fascists have only been able to add two seats to the fifteen they have held hitherto. But the Czech government coalition has no majority io the new parliament. Thus by the victory of the 'getarnte' German Fascists the formation of the new government has become a difficult problem.

Master of 'Tarnen'

When, about eighteen months ago the government suppressed the German National Socialist Party for Czechoslovakia, which had behaved like a Hitler Troop, the leaders fled to Germany, where they now occupy high positions. In Czechoslovakia, however, a hitherto unknown man has come into the limelight, the gymnastic instructor, Konrad Henlein, who founded the "Sudetendeutsche Heimats Front." He is not a great politician, no fascinating speaker, but a master in the art of "tarnen." Just as Hitler after 1923 in Germany, he started his work with pledges of loyalty to the Czechoslovakian State. There is no more devoted supporter of the Masaryk State than Henlein. He only wants the following: To safeguard the German interests and to unite the Germans. He started his organization with the, in Germany well-proved formation of cells and 'mouth to mouth" propaganda, aided by unlimited financial means about the origin of which nobody knows anything definite.

In the beginning, Henlein tried to "tarn" himself regarding anti-Semitism. In his first public speech he invited the "loyal German Jews" to cooperate with him. However, he soon went back on his own word when he saw that one can't overlook anti-Semitism as an efficient means of propaganda. On the other hand, he had not much to fear from Jews as opponents. Henlein, who became a regular "tarn" artist in his policy toward the Czechoslovakian state, removed his "tarn" helmet in his policy regarding the Jews.

* * *

Follows Hitler on Jews

An important part of the work of the "Sudetendeutsche" Party was formed by propaganda against Jews, who were called enemies of everything German, by boycott of Jewish shops, Jewish employes, ewish lawyers and doctors. The Jews in the "Sudeten German" part of Czechoslovakia are now living in an atmosphere which is growing more and more like that of Hitler Germany. Their rights have not yet been taken away, but they are socially isolated, and their economic existence is in danger. Social boycott is not everything, for the fight is also extended to the ewish hospital and panel doctors, and to the few Jewish judges and State officials. The example of Hitler Germany is slavishly followed regarding Jewry.

Between the Lines

By B. SMOLAR ... Jewish Journalism in U.S.A.

At the convention of the American Newspaper Guild now taking place in Cleveland, William Edlin, the newly elected president of the Jewish Writers' Club in New York startled the delegates with a report about the position of the Yiddish journalist in America.

In his address before the convention, Mr. Edlin related that the economic interests of the Yiddish journalist in America are far better protected than those of the newspapermen working in the American press. He emphasized that the Jewish Writers' Club in New York-which is the professional organization of the Yiddish journalists—has been for years active in securing a decent wage minimum for Jewish newspapermen and that it is much higher than the minimum wage of the English newspapermen.

American Pressmen Surprised

It was a surprise to many delegates at the convention to find out that the hiring and firing system existing in the English newspaper, according to which any member of the staff can be dismissed without notice, is not practiced on Jewish newspapers. For years the Jewish Writers' Club has seen to it that no writer on the staff of a Jewish newspaper may be fired, except on proven charges, after being in the employ of a newspaper for three months.

The high standard of ability required in the profession of Jewish journalism was also news to many delegates at the convention of the American Newspaper Guild. The average American journalist as a rule looks upon the Yiddish press as a foreign institution. He is apt to regard the Jewish journalist as a "foreigner" who is thus of an inferior calibre compared to the English journalist.

Newspaper Guild Stimulated

Mr. Edlin dispelled this false impression. In his address before the convention he gave a clear picture of the high qualities which he must possess before entering the field of Jewish journalism.

The convention seemed much impressed by the facts reported by Mr. Edlin. Heywood Broun, president of the Guild, was so moved that he admitted from the platform that the report of Mr. Edlin was most stimulating to the future activities of the Newspaper Guild, and that the Guild had much to learn from the experiences of the Jewish Writers' Club in the field of economic protection for its members.

Jewish Publishers Cooperate

The Jewish Writers' Club which has a membership of about 200 in New York, has branches in Chicago and Philadelphia, where several Yiddish daily newspapers are published. It is affiliated with the American Federation of Labor in Chicago and with the United Hebrew Trades in New York. It is a labor union in the full sense of the word, the only difference being that in addition to providing economic security for its members, it also conducts wide cultural activities for non-

Publishers of Yiddish papers as a rule, cooperate with the Jewish Writers' Club. It is to the credit of the Club that with the exception of its Philadelphia branch. no strike has ever been declared on the newspapers where its members are employed.

World Press Digest

British Writer Pays Tribute to Joseph Fels

The London Star, writing on prominent Jews, devotes a special article by George Lansbury to the well known Jew, the late Joseph Fels. Mr. Lansbury writes:

Joseph Fels was a friend of Henry George, and had spent big sums of money helping to spread the Single Tax gospel, but he was a practical-minded business man, and wanted to do something concrete, so in America he started the Vacant Land Cultivation Society, the object of which was to take waste land in towns and allow the unemployed to turn these wastes into vegetables, fruit and potato plots.

So successful was he that he came to London, and, hearing that I also had determined to try to get people on the land, he called me up on the telephone and we met. A friendship as strong and loyal as that between Jonathan and David ensued, and lasted till his death. It will live in my memory till I join the majority with him.

This little man travelled Great Britain, Ireland, and Denmark, interviewing kings, princes, premiers, cabinet ministers, bishops and the clergy, pouring out his money like water, lending it in large and small sums to governments and local authorities, free of interest for stated periods, so that land could be bought or hired for the use of the unem-

Urges Continuation Of Nansen Office

The Yorkshire Observer, an English daily, in an editorial on the importance of the Nansen Office,

The Hitler purge of Social Democrats and Jews has driven out 80,000 from Germany, and Paris has also been at least a temporary asylum for many of these. They are not at present under any Nansen passport, and

may not all have lost their German passports. But their plight is pitiful. The great crime here is that the victims are among the advanced and industrious who wished to be loyal German citi-

This is, then, no time for thinking of closing down the Nansen Office. The new conditions, as complicated by racialism, are in some respects worse than at any stage since the war. It is already feared that if, as the result of Marshal Pilsudski's death, there is a "Nazification" of Polish administration, the three and a half million Jews in that country may provide a fresh flood of wandering refugees.

Reviews Career Of Neville Laski

The Manchester Guardian comments as follows on the appointment of Neville Laski as Recorder of Burnley:

Mr. Neville Laski is the son of Mr. Nathan Laski, head of the Jewish community in Manchester, and he was educated at the Manchester Grammar School, Clifton College, and Corpus Christi College, Oxford. He graduated in 1912, also taking the Beit Prize, and was called to the Bar in 1914.

Mr. Laski served throughout the war in Gallipoli, Sinai, and France, with the 6th Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers, and left the army with the rank of captain. He returned to practise on the Northern Circuit early in 1919. In 1930, when 38 years of age, he took "silk," and is one of the few barristers who have become K.C.s

Masons Warned [By Untermyer Against Reich

Urges Them to Profit by Mistakes Made by German Jews

The German Jews might have averted the catastrophe that has overtaken them if they had realized their peril before it overwhelmed them, Samuel Untermyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, declared last night addressing a meeting of Masonic lodges at the Masonic Temple, Yon-

Mr. Untermyer urged the memrs of the Masonic lodges "to take warning from the fate of German Jews and not to repeat the tragic blunder they made." He spoke of the persecution of the Masonic bodies under the Hitler regime and emphasized that the aversion to Masonry is based on the fact that Masonry teaches equality of all men.

"I urge you and your Christian brethren, before it is too late, to take warning from the situation of the German Jews," Mr. Untermyer said. "Don't repeat the blunder which the Jews of Germany made. They had ample notice but it was understandable, though not flattering to their vision, that they should refuse to believe that the men who had been their fellow countrymen could be converted almost overnight into a sadistic horde of sav e human beasts of prey."

Warns of Pending Fate

Mr. Untermyer warned the gathering that all signs point to the inevitable conclusion that what has happened to the Jews in Germany in store also for the Masons

"Your only effective weapon in destroying these enemies of religion and civilization is the boycott," Mr. Untermyer said, emphasizing that if the League of Nations were to carry out its threat of "economic sanctions" against Germany, the world would be saved from Nazi defiance.

Picturing at length the present tragic situation of the Jews in Germany, Mr. Untermyer emphasized that persecutions in Germany have now assumed far greater proportions than that of a "Jewish ques-What is going on in Germany today is an affront to all humanity regardless of race or creed, he said. The action taken by the Nazis against the Masons is on a par with that against the Protestant and Catholic churches and is dictated by the pro-pagan philosophy of a large group of important Nazi leaders, he declared.

"The Jews have never played a prominent part in Masonry," Mr. Untermyer continued, "but Streichr has nevertheless used it as a basis for his tirades against non-Jewish Masonry and has been supported by the Hitler government.
