League Federation Assails Reich Laws

Brussels Congress Asks Intervention For Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BRUSSELS, June 12—A resolution condemning Germany for its anti-Jewish legislation and asking the League of Nations and all member governments to intervene effectively to secure the restoration of social and political rights for the Jews in Germany, was adopted here today at the Congress of the Federation of League of Nations Societies.

The resolution was adopted despite the protest of the German delegates who left the Congress yesterday in demonstration against a decision to discuss the Jewish question at this session.

Hungary Alone Opposes

Delegations from eleven countries voted for the resolution. The delegation from Hungary alone voted against it. The Hungarian delegation contended that the resolution could not be voted upon because of the absence of the German representatives.

The resolution was submitted by Dr. Ben-Zion Mossinson, a delegate of the Palestine League of Nations Societies. Other members of the Palestine delegation include Dr. Nahum Goldmann, Dr. Nathan Feinberg, S. Hoofien and A. Tolowsky.

Text of the Resolution

The text of the resolution reads: "This nineteenth annual Congress of the Federation of League

ISTANBUL, June 10—The lodges of the B'nai B'rith in Turkey are expected to be closed by the authorities in accordance with a decision adopted today at a Congress of the Turkish People's Party.

The decision demands the closing of all organizations which have foreign affiliations. The decision will be submitted this week to the Turkish Assembly. It is certain to be passed.

Dutch Senator Fetes Exiles in Zuyder Zee

THE HAGUE, June 12—A Summer fete for the Jewish Refugees from Germany who are now being trained for agricultural work in Holland in the reclaimed area of Zuyder Zee, was given today by Senator S. Van Derbergh, who is interested in helping the refugees adapt themselves to a new life.

The Dutch Minister for Social Affairs, Dr. S. Lotenmaker, who participated in the fete, stated that there are now 152 Jewish youths from Germany being trained in Zuyder Zee.

Schools Are Put On Government Basis in Poland

Agudath Israel Institutions to Be Classed As Public

WARSAW, June 12—The schools maintained by the ultra-orthodox Agudath Israel Organization in Poland were today given the full rights of government schools in an order issued by the Ministry of Education.

The Agudath schools will henceforth be called elementary public schools and will occupy the same status as all the elementary schools maintained by the government. The schools of the Agudath are religious schools. The Agudath Israel Organization in Poland is a Jewish Party supporting the present government.

The schools maintained by the Agudath are only a fraction of the entire Jewish school system in Poland. The other Jewish schools

Nazis Seize Property Of Goldmann

Strip Zionist Leader of Citizenship With 37 Others

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, June 12—The citizenship of Dr. Nahum Goldmann, Zionist leader and president of the Committee of Jewish Delegations in Paris, was revoked here today by the Nazi authorities and his property confiscated because of his anti-German activities abroad.

Thirty-eight Jews and "non-Aryans" were yesterday deprived of their citizenship by order of the Ministry of the Interior. They included Victor Schiff, formerly Berlin correspondent of the London Daily Herald; Erika Mann, daughter of Thomas Mann, and Dr. Rudolf Hilferding, former German Minister of Finance, who is of Jewish descent.

Sell Stuermer Near Temple

Police authorities today gave permission to the Stuermer to put up one of its sales-stands with anti-Semitic posters near the synagogue on the Lindenstrasse here.

The Westdeutscher Beobachter, the central organ of the National Socialist Party in the Rhine and Cologne districts, came out with the allegation that the Jews are smashing their own windows in order to supply material for anti-German propaganda.

"The people who have been arrested in Munich for anti-Jewish terrorism are the tools of the Jews, acting on the orders of the Jews, for the purpose of discrediting National Socialism," the paper writes. "When the ringleaders of the Munich disturbances were looked at more closely, it was found that they were enemies of the State."

The paper warns that "the National Socialist movement will fight vigorously against the criminal machinations of the Jews." It asserts that there is no difference of opinion whatsoever among all authoritative leaders of the State as to how the Jews should be treated in Germany.

Riot Wave Spreads Over Polish Cities

Earl Lauds Record Of Scotland's Jews

GLASGOW, June 12—Tribute to Scotland's Jewish citizens was paid today by the Earl of Airlie at a function at which Glasgow Jewish ex-service men entertained 1,000 members of the British Legion after their parade.

"I have the greatest admiration," he said, "for the great Jewish people."

"In the war their record was magnificent, and in peace they are an example to all."

Healey Is Given 60 Days in Jail As an Agitator

Young Irish Nazi Posted Anti-Jewish Sign In Yorkville

America's Hitler, the self-assumed title chosen by Raymond J. Healey, will spend the next sixty days in the Workhouse, to which he was sentenced yesterday afternoon by Magistrate Louis B. Brodsky in the West Side Magistrate's Court. The pseudo-editor and racial agitator was found guilty of disorderly conduct last Saturday in the same courtroom, when George Gordon Rattle, acting for the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, appeared against him.

Magistrate Brodsky, who had been charged with "prejudice" by John S. Wise, Jr., who acted as Healey's counsel Saturday, read a fifteen-minute statement explaining his reasons for sentencing Healey. He declared that an investigation had revealed that Healey was "a

New Attack on Jews Follow Clashes In Grodno

WARSAW, June 12—Premier Slawek today received Dr. Henryk Rosmarin and Dr. P. Hartglass, Jewish members of the Polish Parliament, who asked the Premier to intervene to check the wave of anti-Jewish riots which has spread through Polish cities in the last few days. The Premier displayed great interest in the details reported to him by the Jewish parliamentarians and promised a strict investigation.

WARSAW, June 12—A wave of anti-Jewish riots in which many Jews were injured was reported today from many cities in Poland to the Warsaw office of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

In addition to last week's riots in Grodno, during which sixty Jews were reported injured, anti-Jewish disturbances broke out in the last two days in the city of Suwalki and in the township of Racionz, near Warsaw.

More than twenty were injured in Suwalki Sunday evening when an organized group of Polish youth began to attack Jews on the streets and to smash the windows of Jewish homes. Among the injured was Dr. Staropolski, vice-president of the Suwalki Jewish Community. The hooligans also demolished

Danzig Frees Jewish Editor

Loewy Given 3 Days to Leave City; Lester Intervened

(Special to the J.D.B.)

DANZIG, June 12—Theodor Loewy, the correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency in Danzig who was arrested three days ago by the Nazi-controlled administration of the Free City without reason being given, was released today upon the intervention of Lester, in the League's High Commissioner in Danzig, and the American Consul here.

Mr. Loewy was ordered to leave Danzig within three days.

During his arrest Mr. Loewy was held incommunicado. No lawyer was permitted to see him. The place of his detention was not given out by the authorities.

Mr. Loewy is a Latvian citizen. He has been residing in Danzig many years and was the editor of the Danziger Echo, the only Jewish newspaper appearing there in German language. His reports on the Nazi activities in Danzig assumed to be the reason for his arrest.

Jewish Divorce Law Is Urged Upon England To Check Rising Tide of Marital Troubles

LONDON, June 12—A recommendation that the divorce laws of England be amended so as to follow the Jewish religious divorce law, was submitted today to the Home Secretary by a special committee appointed for "marriage mending."

The committee was set up six months ago by the Home Office to examine the problem of matrimonial disputes now heard almost every day in the police courts in England. Its duties were to study the divorce laws of different countries and religions with a view to amending the divorce law of England.

Examining the practice of the Beth Din—the Jewish religious court—the committee came to the conclusion that the best way to deal with matrimonial disputes is the Jewish way. It established that a marital dispute between Jews is rarely taken to police courts, simply because it is straightened out by the Beth Din.

The report to the Home Office, the official title of which is "The Report and Recommendations of the Police Court Social Services Committee," states that the committee has found that once a couple has reached the police court, the chances of reconciliation are remote. The committee therefore recommends in its report a procedure similar to the Beth Din, whereby when a wife takes out a summons, the couple will be privately interviewed by a probation officer.

Should that intervention fail, the magistrates may direct the husband and wife to see them in their private chambers. Only when that fails will the case be brought into court, and even then it may be heard behind closed doors.

This procedure, the committee believes, will greatly decrease the 15,000 separation orders which are being issued by English courts every year. More than 3,000 men in England were sent to prison last year for defaulting payment of alimony.

The Jews in Greece

SALONICA.

Greece remains under the impression of the painful events of last March when, as a result of the Venizelist insurrection, civil war raged for two weeks. Martial law is still in force and court martials have pronounced sentences upon hundreds who were implicated in the insurrection.

The government, invested with unlimited powers at a memorable session of the Chamber, has promulgated the drastic reforms to re-establish order and to avoid in the future new attempts, and also to rid the army of the troublesome elements which had brought it into the political turmoil.

Opposition Leaderless

The entire social and economic life of the country seems as though suspended. Everybody awaits the return of complete calm. It is hoped that peace and tranquility will reign anew after the June elections have taken place.

The opposition has lost its leaders. Venizelos has fled. His friends are in prison. Public opinion is violently against the Venizelists, whose folly brought about so much harm at a time when economic life was on an upward trend. The Venizelos Party is now outside the law. Its newspapers, with minor exceptions, have not been permitted to reappear. The victory of the governing party at the election polls was taken for granted for weeks before the election. This victory is the expression of the popular will to give the country, at least for some years, tranquillity

An Easy Slogan

The March revolution brought about a hard time for the Jews of Greece. It, as well as the following weeks, have caused them many days of anxiety.

It is to be remembered that the Venizelists, the instigators of the revolution, in recent years had identified themselves with the anti-Semitic movement of the country. They reproached the Jews with combatting Venizelos and favoring the government of Premier Tsaldaris. The Opposition found anti-Semitism an easy election slogan and incited their voters against the Jews of Salonica and the neighboring provinces. This campaign of hatred was kept alive by the newspapers of the Opposition, slanderous accusations were hurled against the Jews, and often the bitter effects of this propaganda could be seen quite clearly. It is only necessary to recall the memory of the incidents at the Salonica Campbell suburb in June, 1931, when bands of hooligans, incited by

the writings of the main organ of the Opposition at Salonica, the newspaper Makedonia committed their outrages.

Tactics Often Successful

These maneuvers often proved successful. Several elections took place, in which, under anti-Jewish slogans, the Venizelists carried the day at Salonica.

Of what avail were, in face of these successes, the weak protests of the great chiefs of the party, whose liberal opinions clashed with the anti-Semitic ideology? The stronger the position of the Tsaldaris government grew, the more stiff-necked the Opposition became, and any onslaught naturally was launched in the first place against the Jews, who were easy victims.

As soon as the cries of "revolution" were raised in Macedonia and Thrace, the Jewish population of those parts of the country trembled. It had everything to fear from the insurgents, should they be drunk with victory. The apprehensions of the Jews were justified. It is quite well known that in order to enroll volunteers the revolutionaries promised them the liberty of plundering Jewish homes and Jewish shops. On various occasions during the subsequent court martials testimony by witnesses has been heard which leaves no doubt about the intentions of certain of the revolutionaries.

Relieved at Result

It is easy to understand with what joy the Jews received the news of the end of this nightmare; the news of the victory by the Minister for War, General Kondylis, over the rebels. A wave of contentment engulfed the country and the Jews took their part therein, as friends of order and law. However, one shadow remained: the fear for the future.

This shadow hindered them from delivering themselves to unbounded joy, and to manifestations of happiness which have been exaggerated abroad. The Jews have not forgotten that the Venizelos Party counted among its adherents nearly half of the Greek nation and that for a long time it had been the arbiter of the destinies of the Hellenic people, and that finally it sooner or later can play this role again. Should this day come, the Jews would have to suffer disagreeable consequences and nobody of sound sense would make the Jewish position more difficult by celebrating the defeat of Venizelos.

Thoughts Turn to Palestine

The memory of those terrible moments of anxiety linger in the minds of the Jews of Greece and cause them to think deeply about the future. Anew, they think of emigration. But, where shall they go? They look to Palestine, and fervent supplications are addressed to the bureau which distributes the immigration certificates.

Within a fortnight 800 families had registered at the Palestine office. Together with the great number of previous candidates for emigration, the proportion of the Jews of Greece desiring to go to the Holy Land has become the largest of any community in the Jewish world.

If it were possible, several small communities of Macedonia or Thrace would go en masse. But this is a dream only, and one must, willingly or unwillingly, think of future life in this country.

Pogroms in Poland

Hundreds injured. Dozens of houses attacked. Stores demolished. Windows smashed. Population in panic.

This sounds like a war bulletin. Actually, it is a report about a wave of Jewish pogroms in Poland.

While Poland is still mourning the death of Marshal Pilsudski, pogroms are already reported from numerous Polish towns. In Grodno alone there are 300 Jewish victims. In Suwalk, more than twenty Jews have been injured and many Jewish houses and stores demolished. In Raciondz, near Warsaw, Jews were attacked, and their stores pillaged.

Jews in Panic

The entire Jewish population in Poland is now in a state of panic because of this wave of anti-Jewish terror which seems to have been instigated by organized forces. The local police seems always to appear too late on the scene of the riots.

In Grodno Jews locked themselves up in their homes for three days, fearing to appear on the streets. Jewish mothers were afraid to send their children to school. The same is reported from Nowodwor, a township near Grodno, where one Jew was killed and many injured during anti-Jewish riots last Friday.

Reports Censored

It is clear that the accounts received by cable about the anti-Jewish riots in the different Polish cities do not give a complete picture of what has occurred. Whether because of censorship or for some other reasons, these reports tend to minimize the bloody events. One can realize, however, what has taken place when the situation has reached a point where the Jews have been compelled to organize themselves into self-defense units.

Serious days are now ahead for Polish Jewry. The bloody events in Grodno and in the other cities seem only the beginning of a plan mapped out by the Naras and the anti-Semitic youth of the National Democratic Party, to terrorize the Jews of Poland in the same brutal manner as in Czarist Russia. It now remains to be seen what the new Polish government will do to check this plan.

Waiting for Government Action

No matter what grievances the Jews of Poland had towards the Pilsudski regime—and God knows they had many!—they refrained from coming out openly with these grievances because they appreciated Pilsudski's effort to suppress any physical terror against the Jewish population. Will Pilsudski's successors share the sentiments of their late leader? Will they use their full power and all the means at their disposal to stop the anti-Jewish wave of terror at its very beginning?

The new Polish government, which consists of men who are anxious to follow in the tradition of Pilsudski, will now be closely watched by world Jewry. Depending upon the measures the government takes against those who organized the riots, the Jews of the world will know what to think of the present Polish regime and how to act towards it.

Nazi Race Theories Are Ridiculed

The St. Joseph Gazette, St. Joseph, Mo. daily, in an editorial entitled "Fallacy of Racial Purity," says:

Probably no country in the world has better demonstrated the strength that comes from mixing the best racial strains than the United States. In the veins of the average American is mingled the blood of the Gaul, the Celt, the Teuton, the Anglo-Saxon and the Mediterranean peoples. The results of this melting pot are fairly obvious.

Our mixed blood probably gives most Americans a skeptical attitude over the policy announced by Julius Streicher, the notorious German anti-Semite, who says his government is preparing to ban all marriages between "Aryans" and "non-Aryans," meaning between Gentiles and Jews. This would be, of course, the logical outcome of the Nazi demands for "racial purity," whatever that may be.

The Germans' conception of themselves as "Nordic" people is absurd. Many of the greatest Germans have been of Jewish or foreign blood. There is no people in the world of an unmixed descent. Look at the racial invasions that have swept over nearly every country in the Old World or the New. England is part Norman and Dane. Northern Italians bear the stamp of their Lombard ancestry. People of Irish blood are in evidence wherever civilization has penetrated. History reveals, indeed, that pure racial stock is practically non-existent and that usually it has been immeasurably improved by mixture with other good strains.

There is no basis in fact for the racial purity theme of the Nazis. It seems to be another of the singular delusions with which the Germany of Hitler is filled.

Stresses Importance Of Zionist Congress

The Zionist Record of Johannesburg, commenting on the importance of the forthcoming World Zionist Congress in Lucerne, writes:

There can never have been a moment when deliberations upon Zionist affairs held a greater significance for the Jewish people than today. There has never been a time when world events have brought such convincing evidence, even to the most skeptical among our people, that in Palestine and the Jewish national movement is to be found the key to the Jewish problem. A Zionist conference must therefore command the

close and universal attention of all Jews, however remote or even non-existent may have been their previous knowledge of or association with the Zionist cause.

London Paper Views Anti-Semitism

The Sunday Referee of London, commenting on the question of anti-Semitism, says:

Men hate most the enemy that is present in themselves. Does there exist a Jewish usurer so vile as to deserve the condemnation of anti-Semite canaille of the type of Hitler, Goebbels, and Goering? I think not.

Do Jews of the worst type wield an evil influence on the world? Perhaps. Do Gentiles of the worst type wield an evil influence on the world? Certainly.

Where does race come in? Nowhere. The roots of the evil lie in the social system which persecutes enlightenment and transforms all things into property, into money power.

In this system the Jews are less powerful than the Gentiles. Hitler would still be whitewashing latrines if this were not so.

From Maimonides to Einstein the Jews have been divided and persecuted by the very forces which a brainless anti-Semitism maintains they control. If world power fell into their laps they wouldn't know what to do with it, because their future is bound up with the rest of mankind.

Reich Acts at Home Belie Peace Talk

The London Daily Express, in an editorial on Germany, writes:

Hitler denies that he wants war. He denounces bombing from the air. He assures us that Germany has no aggressive aims.

In Germany the Protestant pastors still go to prison. Collectors for Catholic charities are assaulted by the Nazi Brown-shirts. Jews are chased from their homes and livelihoods—simply for being Jews.

No business of ours, you say. Perhaps not. But are you ready to believe that a government which knows no method save force at home really believes in reason and moderation abroad?

School to Mark Charter Grant By New York

Teachers' Seminary to Map Expansion at Parley Sunday

Representatives of 500 New York Jewish organizations will attend an all-day conference under the auspices of the Jewish Teachers Seminary and People's University on Sunday at the Hotel Pennsylvania to take official cognizance of the granting of a charter to the Seminary-University by the State of New York and to discuss plans for the expansion of the Seminary-University. It was announced yesterday by Philip Gingold, executive director of the institution.

Similar regional conferences will be held in various parts of the United States during the Summer in order to find a common bond between those elements interested in the cultural aspects of Jewish life in this country and the Seminary-University. A national conference will be called in New York early in the fall.

David Pinski, well known dramatist, will preside at Sunday's conference.

Among the invited speakers are Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch, Dr. S. Margoshes, editor of The Day; B. Charney Vlodeck, business manager of the Jewish Daily Forward; David Ben-Gurion, head of the Jewish Labor Federation of Palestine; Dr. Hayim Fine-man, professor of literature at Temple University, Philadelphia; and Dr. Jacob S. Joffe, professor of soils at the New Jersey College of Agriculture.

Founded 18 Years Ago

The Jewish Teachers Seminary and People's University, which was founded eighteen years ago, is the first secular institution of Jewish learning in this country to be granted official status by legislative act.

By a recent act of the New York State Legislature, the Seminary-University achieved the rights and privileges accorded to any college in the country and is now empowered to grant and confer degrees, to register students from abroad and to bring in foreign professors. The institution is planning to offer a place on its faculty to a number of refugee professors from Germany.

Created originally to train Jewish young men and women for teaching positions in Jewish elementary and secondary schools, the Seminary-University is now preparing to expand its curriculum to include courses in Jewish history, religion, ethics and social and labor relations as well as all other subjects found in the curricula of colleges and universities.

\$50,000 Quota Set For Federation Day

26th Observance of Annual Event to Be Held in Brooklyn Today

The sum of \$50,000 has been set by the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities as the quota for Federation Day, which is to be marked for the twenty-sixth consecutive year throughout Brooklyn, it was announced yesterday.

Jews Mark 150th Year In Szeged, Hungary

BUDAPEST—The 150th anniversary of the existence of the Jewish community in Szeged, the third largest Jewish community in Hungary, was celebrated here this week.

The Jewish community in Szeged this year spent about 15,000 pengoes (about \$5,000) for Jewish cultural work, chiefly for the maintenance of Talmud Torahs in which 560 Jewish children are receiving systematic Jewish education.

Zionist Groups Put Up Joint Congress Slate

150 Candidates Named By Z.O.A., Hadassah And Sons of Zion

A joint slate of 150 candidates for delegates to the World Zionist Congress in Lucerne has been agreed upon by the Zionist Organization of America, Hadassah and the Order Sons of Zion, it was announced yesterday by Morris Rothenberg, president of the Z.O.A.

The slate will appear on the official ballot as Ticket Number 1. Elections will be held throughout the country on June 23, polls having been set up in all the principal cities. The World Congress will open in Switzerland on August 20.

In making the announcement, Mr. Rothenberg issued a statement attacking Party Zionism in which he said the Congress "will focus its attention on Zionist problems at one of the most decisive stages in the development of Palestine."

Will Be Severe Test

"With all of Palestine's remarkable achievements in the past year, with the beginning of an era of mass immigration, the Homeland is on the threshold of a period of activity that will constitute one of the severest tests of world Jewry's responsibility," Mr. Rothenberg said.

"There are many who will consider the extraordinary strides of Palestine's economic progress the peak of its reconstruction, but these persons fail to take cognizance of the elementary fact that an increase in Palestine's population and economic activity continually create greater opportunities for expansion and immigration. Although Palestine is a small country, it still has large tracts of land that can be made available to hundreds of thousands of Jews, to provide a home for the Jews of Central and Eastern Europe who have been caught in the vise of economic discrimination and political persecution.

United Leadership Needed

"The present World Zionist situation requires above all things a program based on a policy of a unified leadership unhampered by party differences and inter-group dissensions.

"The fundamental differences between the General Zionist Ticket No. 1 and the Tickets of the other parties such as Labor and the Miz-rachi, can best be summed up by the phrase that has become the slogan of the Zionist Organization of America, Hadassah and the Order Sons of Zion in their joint effort to elect the General Zionist majority delegation to the World Congress. That phrase is 'Palestine Above Parties.'

"General Zionism represents an unshakable allegiance to the Basle Program which brooks no detour from the basic principles of the movement to rebuild Palestine as

the Jewish National Home. We do not challenge the sincerity of those Zionists who are affiliated with special labelled parties. But it is a well-known fact that one that will be admitted generally that party Zionism in its very nature involves separatist loyalties that sooner or later must break out into open conflict. Party Zionism means dual allegiances which result in obscuring of a Palestine serving the entire Jewish People and a dissipation of energies in disputes that have only incidental relevance to the mainspring of Zionist effort."

Memorial Rites For Dr. Levin Held in London

Tributes to Dead Leader Voiced by Zionist Executive

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, June 12—A memorial meeting for Dr. Shmarya Levin, veteran Zionist leader who died in Haifa this week, was held here today in the offices of the World Zionist Executive.

The meeting was addressed by Nahum Sokolow, president of the World Zionist Organization, Dr. Chaim Weizmann, and by Berl Locker.

Dr. Weizmann stated that there were only two men in Palestine "whose voices rose above the clamor. These two men were Shmarya Levin and Chaim Nachman Bialik. Now they are both gone."

"It is impossible to indulge in personal reminiscences," Dr. Weizmann added. "It is something like speaking about one's self. Dr. Levin was the last of the group of which I am the youngest."

Mr. Sokolow praised Levin's long and fruitful life. "His loss is an irreparable one," he asserted.

Fund Leader Here Pays Tribute to Levin

Tribute to Dr. Shmarya Levin was paid yesterday in a statement issued by Dr. Israel Goldstein, president of the Jewish National Fund in America. Emphasizing that the death of Dr. Levin will be felt particularly in America, Dr. Goldstein stated that the growth and development of Zionism here is traceable chiefly to Dr. Levin.

"American Zionism will forever remain in debt to the generous, untiring zeal and self-sacrifice of Shmarya Levin, who spent the treasures of his great intellect and the gift of his eloquent tongue in ploughing and cultivating the then fallow American field for the fruit and blessing-bringing seed of the Zionist ideal and of the Hebrew renaissance," the statement says.

of Nations Societies recalls the resolution on the situation of the Jews in Germany adopted at the seventeenth annual Congress, and the appeal directed in connection with that Congress by Lord Cecil in the name of the Federation to the German League of Nations Society.

"The Congress regrets that this appeal has not brought the desired results in the shape of any improvement in the situation of the Jews in Germany; on the contrary, the legislative and administrative measures since taken by the German government against the Jewish citizens of Germany, solely and exclusively because of their membership in the Jewish race, have been considerably intensified.

Challenge to Civilization

"It is the opinion of the Congress that the retention of measures which exclude Jewish subjects of the Reich from equality of rights and deprives them of their integral human and citizen rights, constitute a challenge to the elementary principles upon which the League of Nations and human civilization have been established.

"The Congress considers it the duty of international society to guarantee to the minorities of race, language and religion of all countries the application of the general principles of justice and liberty. It protests against the entire extent and ramifications of the persecution to which the Jews of Germany

Wave of Rioting Spreads Over Cities in Poland

20 Hurt in Suwalki; Grodno Victims Total 300

number of Jewish stores. The police authorities found it difficult to restore order. A number of the rioters have been arrested. Today order prevails in the city, but the Jewish population is still in a state of panic.

In the township of Racionz, members of the anti-Semitic National Democratic Party started a riot Sunday evening, attacking every Jew they met on the street and storing the windows of Jewish houses. The police were at first helpless in checking the rowdies. Increased police forces were summoned to restore order.

The exact number of Jews injured has thus far not been established. The Jewish population avoids appearing on the street in fear of further riots.

300 Grodno Victims

More than 300 Jews registered themselves as victims of the anti-Jewish riots in Grodno. The Jewish community of Grodno is continuing registration of victims in order to establish the exact number of those injured and the extent of property damages suffered. Detailed reports from Grodno today show that the anti-Jewish riots there were more serious than pictured in the first reports.

The eight Jews who were arrested in Grodno for taking the lead in organizing Jewish self-defense during the riots were released today by the authorities.

Many thousands participated in the funeral of Israel Berizowsky, the 21-year-old Jewish youth who was killed during the Grodno riots. Amid tragic scenes, the victim was buried at dawn yesterday. The president of the Jewish Community in Grodno, Mr. Tropkrinsky, eulogized the dead youth and said the Kadish over his grave in behalf of the entire Jewish community.

All Jewish stores in Grodno were closed for six hours in mourning for the Jewish victim of the riots.

State Probe Denied In Rutgers Affair

'Unfair' Until Trustees End Quiz, Governor Tells Undermyer

TRENTON, June 12—Governor Harold G. Hoffman today informed Samuel Undermyer, president of the non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, that "it would not be fair" to start a legislative inquiry into Nazi activities at the New Jersey College for Women of New Brunswick before the present hearing of the trustees at Rutgers University is concluded.

The hearing in New Brunswick, into charges that Dr. Frederick J. Hauptmann, head of the German department, is spreading Nazism and anti-Semitism, will be resumed tomorrow.

Governor Hoffman welcomed the offer of Mr. Undermyer to furnish information to the inquiry committee of the University's trustees. He invited Mr. Undermyer to appear before the committee with this information.

professional agitator" and that he had had no means of livelihood for more than a year except the collection of funds to further his anti-Semitic activities.

A 'Pseudo Editor'

The Magistrate described the youthful Irishman as a "pseudo editor" and stated that his publication, Healey's Irish Weekly, hadn't appeared within the last couple of months. His publication The Storm, also had an irregular history of appearance.

The investigation disclosed, Magistrate Brodsky said, that Healey had "no affiliation with any Irish-American groups."

He also brought out the fact that Healey had lied to the court when he stated that his father had died while serving in the armed forces of the United States. The senior Healey, investigators reported, was still very much alive.

Healey's attorney, John S. Wise, Jr., who entered the case during the last fifteen minutes of the original hearing, did not appear in court yesterday. When Healey was questioned as to this, he stated that he expected the attorney. Magistrate Brodsky immediately got in touch with Wise's office to learn that he was not retained by the defendant.

Mr. Wise's office later informed the Jewish Daily Bulletin that Mr. Wise is not a Jew and that he had not been connected with the case since his first appearance in court.

Sign Torn Down

Healey's troubles started when he appeared in court last Friday to press charges against Julius Alexander, who on the previous night had torn down an inflammatory anti-Jewish sign hung in front of Kreutzer Hall, 228 East 86th Street, which read: "Gentiles Organize! Auto Crash Kills Cutler, Creator Of Puppet Show

Yiddish Writer, 39, Was Touring West With Marionettes

Yosl Cutler, well known Jewish humorist, cartoonist and creator of the Yiddish Marionette Theatre, was killed in an automobile accident Tuesday in the vicinity of Minneapolis, it was learned here yesterday. He was on his way to Denver.

The body will be brought from Minneapolis to New York on Friday. Preparations are being made for a funeral ceremony to be held on Sunday. The funeral will be arranged by the International Workers Order, of which Cutler was a member.

Mr. Cutler was thirty-nine years old. He was born in Troyanetz, Russia, and came to the United States at the age of 15. He was a student of art at the National Academy and at the Jewish Educational Alliance. His first short story, "The False History of the World," was published in New York in 1921.

Ten years ago Cutler, in collaboration with another Jewish artist, Z. Maud, started the first Yiddish Marionette Theatre in New York, known as the Maudcut Theatre. This theatre later became a travelling marionette show which gained a reputation not only in America but also in many European countries. The last performance was given by Cutler on Monday evening in Minneapolis.

Mr. Cutler was also the author of "Muntergang," a book of poems and short stories. He illustrated a number of works of other authors and was a member of the staff of the Freiheit, a New York Jewish daily.
