Nazi Leader Advises Use Of Violence

Streicher Tells Students Spiritual Weapons' Fail Against Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, June 23-Physical violence against the Jews in Germany was urged last night by Julius Streicher, overlord of Franconia, addressing the students of the Erlangen University.

"It is impossible to fight the enemies of Germany with spiritual The Nazi regime weapons only. could not exist if the National Socialist Party pursued such policy," Herr Streicher said.

Warning that "Germany may perish" if no violent measures are taken against the Jews, Herr Streicher advised the students to refrain from mixing with Jews "because they have passed a death sentence against Germany."

"We must destroy this devil among nations," the notorious anti-Semite concluded.

The Jews in Germany must bear the consequences of their defeat in same way the entire German nation did "through all those terrible years up to 1933," Alfred Rosenberg, Hitler's right-hand man, declared today in an article in the National Zeitung, Goering's publication in Essen.

"The Jews have not been entirely eliminated," Rosenberg writes, "but they have been pushed back so that there is no longer any danger to the cultural formation of Ger-

"Unfortunately," Herr Rosenberg continues, "there are many among whom the so-called humanitarian ideas are again beginning to stir. They do not realize that the problem of the Jew in Germany is not one of persons but one of principle. All Jews must as one man bear the consequences of Jewry's criminal activity, its abuse of all that was spiritual, great, and noble in Ger-

Heavy Vote Is Recorded By Zionists

55 Congress Delegates Are Elected by 5 Parties

The heaviest voting in a Zionist election in recent years was reported by the Central Elections Board yesterday as all over the country Zionists cast their ballots for fifty-five delegates, the number the United States is entitled to send to the World Zionist Congress at Lucerne, August 20.

Excellent weather in New York City was given as a reason for the last minute flood of demands for additional ballots from the polling places throughout the city. Similar active voting was expected throughout the country.

No official results were available last evening, but on the eve of the election it had been announced that more than 132,000 persons had bought the Shekel certificates entitling them to vote.

500 Polling Places

More than 500 polling places in 260 cities and more than forty states closed at eight o'clock last night, and tallying of ballots was immediately begun.

Little trouble was reported by the Shekel Board in conducting the election. Hundreds of persons who telephoned during the day were directed to the polling places nearest their homes. It was said that attempts at ballot-stuffing would be decreased this year by a system whereby the voter must surrender his Shekel when he votes and the total number of Shekels are later tallied with the total number of ballots.

VIENNA, June 23-The Austrian government was today openly accused by the Association of Jewish Front Soldiers of duplicity in its attitude toward the Jewish population.

"There is quite a difference between the theory which government authorities are advancing with regard to the Jews and the way the Jews are treated in practice," the association's official organ, the Jewish Frontier, charges.

The paper enumerates cases of discrimination against Jews which contradict the promises made by Premier Schuschnigg and other members of the Austrian Cabinet.

Child Marriage Curb Planned in Palestine

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, June 23-A proposed law prohibiting marriage of children under 15 for Moslem, Jewish and other communities in Palestine, was forwarded today by the government to the heads of the different religious groups, soliciting their opinions on this matter.

The measure provides that no minors be permitted to marry unless proper medical examination proves that the girl will not be hurt by consummation. The marriage of minors is widespread in Palestine among Arabs and Sephardic Jews.

DetectiveTried To Organize Ottawa Stores

Plot Against Jewish Shops Revealed at Tissot Hearing

(Special to the J.D.B.)

OTTAWA, Ont., June 23-Evidence of a conspiracy to set up a League of Christian Merchants aimed against Jewish business men was given at the hearing of Jean Tissot, Ottawa detective who is accused of criminally libeling A. J. Freiman, president of the Canadian Zionist Organization and owner of a local department store.

William Graham and Harold G. Munro, department store officials who appeared as prosecution witnesses, testified that Tissot had approached them with a demand for financial assistance in his campaign against Jewish merchants.

This campaign, the witnesses declared, particularly harmed Freiman's business because he is one of the leading Jewish merchants of this city.

The two witnesses explained that their reasons for not joining the campaign was that it was against Christian ethics.

At the opening of yesterday's session of the trial, Magistrate Strike barred Saluste Lavery, Montreal lawyer known for his anti-Semitism, as Tissot's counsel on the ground that he came from the province of Quebec and therefore could not practice in Ontario.

Lavery immediately countered injured and one stabbed to dwith the threat that Quebec would were organized beforehand, not admit Ontario lawyers. Magistrate Strike ignored him.

The judge is expected to decide next Wednesday whether Tissot shall be held for triol.

thorities today confiscated the issues of every newspaper in Warsaw reporting the fact that the headquarters of the Jewish Anti-Nazi Boycott Committee has been closed down by the Polish govern-

The news bulletin of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, published in Warsaw, was also confiscated today for carrying the report.

The authorities notified the press that any further mention of the affair will result in similar action against the newspapers.

The official reason for liquidating the boycott committee was given by the government as mis-The real reason, management. however, is seen in the fact that a Polish delegation left last night for Berlin to negotiate a new trade agreement with Nazi Germany.

The Polish government is seeking to induce the Nazi authorities partly to abolish the currency restrictions existing in Germany and to pay out to Polish exporters a proportion of the debts which German firms owe them. It is believed that some kind of barter arrangement will be reached between Poland and Germany by the Polish delegation, which will on the one hand increase the export of German goods into Poland and, on the other, enable Polish firms to collect their debts in Germany.

Grodno Riots Organized, Polish Paper Charges

Greek Jews and the Monarchy Problem

SALONICA

DURING the last few weeks, Greece has suddenly been faced with a new political problem. The issue has been forced by those who had no interest in bringing it forward, i.e., the Republicans. The new situation has been created by those who, in March of this year, tried to overthrow the Tsaldaris government by force. The outcome of >

In the beginning, the Greek Parliamentary elections had the aspect of the usual testing of political opinion, with the expectation that the government would be strengthened. But suddenly, about four weeks before the elections, at the moment when censorship and martial law were lifted, the country was engulfed by a wave of monarchial sentiment. After some vague illusions in the foreign press-trial balloons-a good deal of public opinion, several political leaders started a campaign to call George II back to the throne.

AT PRESENT, the situation is somewhat curious. The governing party, the People's Party. were the fighters for a monarchial regime during the whole time when Venizelos, the leader of the Republicans held sway. However, when two years ago the People's Party gained the majority, Venizelos was only too willing to yield power into their hands, on the People's Party promising to uphold the republic. Premier Tsaldaris gave this pledge and formed the new government.

After the March insurrection by the Venizelists, a faction of the People's Party, led by Metaxas, issued a program which demanded the immediate restoration of the monarchy. They contended that this was the only means of re-establishing tranquillity. Tsaldaris, adhering faithfully to his pledge, replied that the people themselves would have to decide by a plebiscite. This resulted in a rift in the People's Party. The moderate elements were in favor of a plebiscite after the election, whereas Metaxas was striving for a majority at the election in order to effect an immediate restoration.

THE parliamentary elections therefore confronted the voters with the task of choosing between Royalists and the only Republican Party, led by the ex-dictator General Pangalos, and two National Socialist Parties, imitating Hitler, and the E.E.E., the well-known nationalistic anti-Semitic organiza-The latter group, however, has not much chance of sending deputies to the Chamber.

WHAT is the position of the

They, as well as all other inhabitants of Greece, desire above all quiet and internal peace. During the twelve years of the Republican regime, Greece has had twelve different governments, more than ten revolutions, or attempts at revolution, the official dictatorship of General Pangalos, the veiled dictatorship of Venizelos, etc. The air is saturated with revolt; trouble has broken out again and again in the life of the country. The people are at their wits' end. They want some years of neace without the constant menace of civil war; they want to bring their affairs into order, without constantly being har rassed by Political problems.

As always in cases of disorder, the Jews have suffered more than the others. They desire ardently a truce between the two hostile camps of Helienism, the Republicans and the Royalists. The Premier is very popular with the Jews, for his government has promulgated a number of measures favorable to them.

T IS significant that three of the four Jewish periodicals of Salonica openly advocate a restoration of the Monarchy, while the fourth maintains a strict neutrality. The antagonism between the Jews and the Republicans started when the Greek army conquered Salonica and the New Provinces. At that time the Jews were accused of having poisoned Greek soldiers, plotted against the Greek army, etc. Only recently M. Jassonides, one of the chiefs of the Venizelos Party at Salonica, openly accused the Jews of Salonica, while speaking in the Senate, of high treason, i.e., of having demanded in 1912 the intervention of the Austrian navy against the Greek army which came to conquer the city.

The intellectual leaders of Greek Jewry have for a long time tried to participate in the political life of various Republican parties. When all these parties formed the Venizelist Bloc, the Jews, under the influence of their intellectual leaders, gave nearly all their votes to Venizelos. Even after the pogrom of Campbell (a suburb of Salonica) in 1931, the Jews voted for a Veni zelist mayor.

HOWEVER, the Jews fully dissociated themselves from the Republicans, when, beaten at the general elections, the Venizelists of Salonica started a virulent anti-Jewish campaign in which the whole arsenal of anti-religious and anti-racial propaganda was hurled against the Jews.

But the Jews, like the whole Greek population, want peace. As Jews they want to see the end of the disorders which were caused by the anti-Semitic agitation. They therefore have to fight the anti-Jewish parties. They do not want to be the bone of contention between the political parties which try to get their votes either by intimidation or by violence.

The Jews are demoralized by the political instability, and by the economic crisis to such an extent that their only wishes are to be left in (Continued on Page Three)

After the Zionist Elections

With the elections of delegates to the next Zionist Congress over in America, the eyes of all those interested in Zionist problems will be turned this week toward the convention of the American Zionist Organization in Atlantic

This convention will be of especial importance because of the split in the ranks of the World Organization of General Zionists and also because of the political prospects in Palestine.

In view of the fact that the Zionists in America will come with a larger delegation to the World Zionist Congress this year, the convention in Atlantic City would do well to reach clear decisions on the following problems to be faced by the Congress in Lucerne:

1. Unity in Zionist ranks. The Zionist movement cannot afford to lose the 200,000 Revisionists and their sympathizers as well as the other groups which are still in the Zionist Organization but constantly threatening to leave it. To bring about peace between the different Zionist groups is therefore of first and foremost importance.

Dangers to Combat

2. The Legislative Council. The danger which the establishment of a Legislative Council in Palestine holds for Jewish achievement there is not disputed by any Jewish group. Concrete measures to prevent this danger are therefore essential.

3. Land speculation. The menace of land speculation in Palestine has been established by all. Energetic measures to combat this menace must be decided

4. The much feared crisis. Everybody in Palestine speaks of the inevitable economic crisis which must follow the present boom. A plan must be mapped out, if not to prevent this crisis, at least to ease its effects.

5. The situation of the middle class. The majority of the members of the Zionist Organization the world over belong to the middle class. While prosperity is now being enjoyed in Palestine by capitalists and by labor, the middle class there is already suffering economic difficulties. The interests of the middle class must become the interests of the Zionist Organization.

New Markets for Palestine

6. Palestine Exports. The problem of creating new markets for Palestine products is causing a great deal of worry to Palestine industrialists and owners of orange plantations. How to secure such markets is one of the serious problems demanding a solu-

7. Barter with Nazi Germany, A clear-cut decision must be adopted on the shameful commercial dealings now going on between Palestine and Nazi Germany. Palestine is today the only country where German goods are imported and sold by Jews. This breach in the Jewish united front against Germany must be forcefully condemned.

8. Jewish Officials. The problem of the marked decrease in Jewish officials in the Palestine government system must be given serious consideration. While the number of Arab officials in the government offices in Palestine is constantly growing, Jews are leaving government positions because of the desire to earn more money in private enterprises. At present the government offices in Palestine are practically "Judenrein," and the Palestine govern-

9. Immigration and Transjordan. The significance of these two problems are clear to everybody, except to the Palestine government. To make the Mandatory Power accept the Jewish view on these problems is one of the basic needs of the Zionist movement.

10. Jewish Education. While the Palestine government fully maintains the Arab school system in the country, it refuses to do the same for the Jewish school system, despite the fact that the government derives its income mainly from Jewish sources. To force the Palestine government to accord equal treatment to Jewish education is a question which must be dealt with seriously.

The problem of the Jewish workers' deserting the Jewish fields is also deserving of serious discussion. Also the problem of the relations between the Zionists and the non-Zionists. The Zionist convention in Atlantic City must formulate a clear-cut policy on all the problems enumerated.

Germans Fail To Regain Lost Surgical Mart

Anti-Nazi League Blocks Effort to Discredit Japanese Rivals

A futile attempt by German manufacturers of surgical instruments to recapture the American market they are losing as a result of the anti-Nazi boycott by conducting a campaign against Japanese instruments was revealed vesterday by the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League.

For many years, the league reported, Germany had been able, arough low labor costs, practically monopolize the American market for the finer surgical instruments. As the German boycott became effective, importers turned to Japanese manufacturers, who improved the quality of their instruments and began not only to meet the demand, but to undersell the German manufacturers.

In a strategic move to regain the market, the German manufacturers set up a dummy trade association which called for a boycott of Japanese goods as a menace to American industry.

The scheme was discovered by supporters -of the anti-Nazi boy cott, the report stated, and the campaign fizzled out. Hospitals and members of the medical profession were informed of the forces behind the drive and disregarded attempts to enforce an anti-Japanese boycott.

Agitators Warned By General Smuts

Will Keep Order at All Costs, He Tells 11th Congress of So. African Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency JOHANNESBURG.-Stern warning that all fomenters of racial strife will be dealt with severely by the authorities was issued by General Jan C. Smuts in a message to the eleventh congress of the South African Jewish Board of Deputies.

"Law and order," he declared, "will be maintained at all costs, and if those who foment racial and religious strife between various sections of our population find themselves in trouble, they will have only themselves to blame.

General Smuts urged the board to continue to give "a wise and far-sighted lead to their people in these anxious times."

Mayor Freeman of Johannesburg, who is Jewish, welcomed the congress in behalf of the city. The board resolved to launch a vigor ous campaign against anti-Jewish propaganda.

Another resolution called on Parliament to "take such action as may be necessary to prevent the dissemination of propaganda calculated to create racial strife between the white races of Africa."

Prof. Askenazy Diesin Warsaw; NotedHistorian

Represented Poland at Geneva from 1920 To 1923

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, June 23-Prof. Simon

Askenazy, famous Polish-Jewish historian and diplomat who represented Poland at the League of Nations in Geneva for a number of years, died here last night at the age of 68.

Prof. Askenazy was one of the outstanding Polish historians, occupying a chair of philosophy in Warsaw University since 1927. Previously, from 1897, he was professor of history at Lemberg University.

Born in the township of Zawichwost, near Radom, in the Polish part of Russia, Prof. Askenazy studied in the universities of Warsaw and Goeetingen. In 1920 he was appointed delegate of the Polish government to the League of Nations, and kept this post for three years. He was recalled from Geneva when the anti-Semitic National Democratic Party came into power in 1923.

The principal works of Prof. Askenazy are considered the best sources of Polish history. They deal mainly with Polish history of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. He was especially prominent for his three-volume work. 'Napoleon and Poland.'

Prof. Askenazy has also written a number of historical treatises on the history of the Jews in Poland. His death is considered a great loss not only to the Jews of Poland but to the entire Polish nation.

Funeral services will be held on Monday. Burial will be in the Jewish Cemetery in Warsaw.



Europe's Jews

Kraemer Opens Parley Of Sons of Zion at Bradley Beach

(Special to the J.D.B.)
BRADLEY BEACH, N. J., June 23-Palestine remains the only permanent solution of the plight of Jewry in various parts of Europe, Joseph Kraemer of Newark, grand master of the Order Sons of Zion declared in his message to 200 delegates attending the twenty-sixth annual convention of the Order, being held here today and tomorrow.

Pointing out that the "degradation and uprooting forced upon our people in parts of Europe has not been lightened during the past year, but with the continued breakdown of democratic governments it has been made the heavier," Mr. Kraemer asserted:

"Many fine men and women have come to the relief of these twentieth century exiles, but it is tragically evident that all they can do is to afford alleviation, and that for the permanent solution of their unfortunate plight we must provide them with a new home where they can live in peace and security, dewelop their talents, lead a creative life, and enter into the fabric of a nation in the remaking; and that of necessity must be in Palestine."

Concerning matters of internal Zionist policy, the grand master declared: "The Supreme Zionist body is the World Zionist Congress. It can act and speak effectively only if behind it is the authority of the entire Zionist membership; and that is based upon the discipline and loyalty of its members and parties. Any member or party that flouts the decision of the Congress undermines its authority."

Mr. Kraemer further asserted that the Order's "capacity for effective Zionist work has been demonstrated." In 1932, he said, the Order contributed \$3,000 to the National Fund; in 1933, \$6,000 and last year \$9,000.

Mr. Kraemer also cited the practical strength of the Order at this time, its cultural interests, and pleaded for the spread of a greater number of youth camps.

In a financial report submitted by Samuel M. Suckgold of New York, it was noted that as of May 1 last the Order had total assets of \$330,024.61 and total reserves of \$334,997.59.
