## Nazis Widen Drive Over Large Area

### Mayor Is Ousted From Post for Trading With Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
BERLIN, July 4.—Despite the efforts of conservative elements in the present Cabinet to check the mounting tide of anti-Semitism in Germany, out of fear of the effects such publicity might have on the international question in which Germany is at present engaged, the radical leaders of the Nazi party continue to gain the upper hand in their anti-Jewish policy.

New developments today indicate that the attack on the Jewish position has been intensified throughout the country. The anti-Jewish boycott has been carried out with great vigor, and Jews are being barred from an increasing number of places.

In many instances acts of hoodlums have been officially sanctioned and in some instances the German government, through its Ministry of the Interior, has even punished Nazis for robbing someone in their hatred of the Jews.

Traded With Jews, Fined  
Thus the Ministry of the Interior today dismissed Mayor Graebner of Schellert for his post for allegedly trading with Jews. In stripping the mayor of his position, the Ministry of the Interior declared that it intends to hold this case up as an example warning to other Nazi functionaries who may regret themselves so far as to have any relations whatsoever with Jews.

In Thuringia the district clerk has just taken stern disciplinary measures against the farmers in the southwest part of the State who continue to trade with Jews. As a warning to the other farmers, the most prominent farmer in the district was today excluded from the Nazi Party, and all good Nazis were ordered to shun him.

For farmers in the section were warned that if they are caught trading with Jews again they too will be thrown out of the party and will be ostracized from the society of all "true Aryans."

## Nazis Beat Up 'Aryan' Who Defended Jew

BERLIN, July 4.—A pure "Aryan" was attacked by a mob in Goerlitz today for daring to bear down an anti-Semitic sign that had been posted by Nazi hoodlums on a Jewish shop.

The courageous German was badly messed up by the angry Nazi mob, and was arrested by the police. After having been locked up at the local police station, the German was forced to replace the sign in its former position on the Jewish shop.

## Greek Paper Adopts Stand Against Jews

### Venizelist Organ Was Formerly Neutral On Issue

SALONICO, July 3.—Nea Alithia, organ of the Venizelist faction published here, and which formerly maintained a neutral position as regards the Jews, today turned anti-Semitic and published a leading article bitterly attacking the Jews.

The newspaper alleges that the Jewish community in Salonica has been increasing in government circles so that they may have their Jewish schools housed in the buildings recently erected by the government and originally designated to serve as elementary schools for Greek children.

The Jewish Community today officially denied these charges, declaring them false and unfounded. A protest against the articles appearing in the Nea Alithia was lodged with the authorities by the Jewish Community, which pointed out that they were highly inflammatory and may serve to provoke anti-Jewish attacks.

Dr. Segal was one of the leading chemists in Russia, and served as secretary of the Institute for Organic Chemistry.

## Polish Jews Must Offer United Slate

### Otherwise May Not Get 6 Sejm Seats, J.T.A. Is Informed

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
WARSAW, July 4.—The election of the six deputies to the Polish Sejm, allotted to the Jews under the newly enacted election laws, is conditional upon the creation of a united Jewish electoral list, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today from authoritative sources.

If no united Jewish electoral list is presented, however, then the entire Jewish population of Poland, which comprises more than ten per cent of the whole Polish population, is in danger of being unrepresented even nominally in the next Sejm, it was learned.

3 Zionists on Slate  
Should the Jews unite on a single election list, then in all likelihood the Jewish delegation will consist of three Zionists, two members of the Agudah, and one representative Jewish industrialist, it is revealed by the same sources.

The General Zionists, however, came out with a demand for other day stating that they will abstain from participating in the elections to the Sejm because they believe them to be merely a sham election, since the new election laws virtually deprive the Jews of direct representation.

The Poale Zionists and the Bundists, too, have indicated that they will most likely refrain from participating in the elections.

Jewish leaders demand that the Jews be allotted a representation in the Sejm according to the proportion of Jews to the general population in Poland. Since the new Sejm will have 200 deputies, (Continued on Page Four)

## Lwow Bombing Claims Victim

### Jewish Boy Succumbs to Wounds Received in Attack

LWOW, Poland, July 4.—Emanuel Werbner, one of two Jewish boys injured when a bomb, believed to have been thrown by anti-Semitic gangsters, exploded in the club rooms of the local Jewish sports club Hashachar, died here to-day from the wounds received in the explosion. The victim was only 13 years old.

The club's rooms were bombed on the night of June 23 and two boys were seriously wounded. The other boy, Ephraim Portman, still in the hospital, is in a critical condition. The building, which also houses the Zionist sports group Kadimah, was heavily damaged.

The police have so far not succeeded in apprehending the throwers of the bomb. However, members of a local anti-Semitic youth organization are suspected.

## Weizmann to Head General Zionist Slate

LONDON, July 4.—Chaim Weizmann, former president of the World Zionist Organization, will head the ticket of the Jewish Confederation of General Zionists in the elections for the forthcoming World Zionist Congress, it was learned here today.

According to the number of Shekolim sold in England, the English Zionists will this year be represented at the Congress at Lucerne by twelve delegates.

## Latvia Frees Two Socialists; In Prison Year

### Meisel and Rabinowich Jailed by Fascists on Gaining Power

RIGA, Latvia, July 4.—After languishing a year in prison, Dr. A. Meisel and A. Rabinowich, leaders of the Bund, Jewish Socialist organization, were released here today.

The two Jewish Socialists were sentenced to prison for their radical sympathies when the present Latvian dictatorship came into power more than a year ago.

All political organizations were then declared illegal and were ordered dissolved. The various Jewish organizations, including the Zionists, the Bund and the Poale Zionists, were also declared illegal. The Poale Zionists leaders were given the privilege of leaving the country for Palestine. The leaders of the Bund were sent to jail.

Only the Agudah, Jewish Orthodox organization, and representing only a fraction of Latvian Jewry, was permitted to carry on, and its organ is today the only Jewish publication appearing in Latvia.

## Rabbi Kook's Condition Better, Doctors Report

## Fight War, U.S. Senator Urges Jews

### Veterans Hear Plea by Clark at Arlington Memorial Rites

(Special to the J.T.A.)

WASHINGTON, July 4.—Senator Bennett Champ Clark of Missouri, member of the Senate Munitions Investigating Committee, today appealed to the Jewish War Veterans of the United States to develop a "militant public sentiment" against war.

Addressing several hundred veterans gathered for the patriotic services in the amphitheater of the Arlington National Cemetery, Senator Clark pointed out that the wave of religious persecution now sweeping through several countries of the world "is the best example of the frightful results of the World War."

Senator Clark said that prospects for war "are more imminent today than in 1914." He cited the rapid growth of dictatorships and said, "Liberalism and democracy are now fighting with their backs to the wall."

Pays Tribute to Jews  
In a tribute to the Jews, Senator Clark said that "they are a great people of the world, one of the great nations and one of the great peoples of the world, which is the very cradle of liberty." He told his listeners that it cannot be said that Jewish citizens lack patriotism in any country in which they choose to live.

In a plea for the abolition of war, Senator Clark urged the adoption of pending legislation which would keep the United States in a neutral position in the event of war among the nations. He hit at the propaganda of munitions makers and said that Europe has now a million and a half more men under arms than in 1914.

The patriotic services today constituted the second annual Independence Day observance sponsored on a nation-wide basis by the Jewish War Veterans of the United States. Capt. William Berman, commander-in-chief, also addressed the gathering. He said that the Jewish veterans had dedicated themselves to upholding the principles of democracy.

## 'People Above Party' Is Slogan Planned by General Zionists

CRACOW, July 4.—The "People Above Any Party," is the slogan with which the World Union of General Zionists under the leadership of Dr. Schwabacher, will come to the Zionist Congress in Lucerne on August 20, it was announced here today.

In a manifesto issued by the Union, it was declared that labor and capital must dedicate themselves to the eradication of class

warfare from the life of Palestine. "The sharpened relations between capital and labor," the manifesto says, "are threatening the existence of the Jewish settlement in the Homeland."

The manifesto calls for the harmonious cooperation of all creative forces in Palestine, declaring this to be the prime requisite in the face of the tremendous tasks which now confront the Zionist world.

An American Warns Britain on Nazis

LONDON.

AN AMERICAN warning to Britain not to be duped by Nazi pledges and Nazi speeches and not to draw distinctions between Nazi domestic and foreign policies, injected much interest here on its publication in the London Times.

The warning was in the form of a letter from Hamilton Fish Armstrong, famed authority on international politics and editor of the publication, Foreign Affairs.

Replying to a series of letters which have appeared in The Times from outstanding Englishmen, Mr. Armstrong states:

"SIR—Some remarkable views about Germany have been expressed in letters to The Times during the past week. Mr. M. Young has asked the outside world to 'suspend judgment' on Nazi policy. Sir John Marriott has supported the plea so far as Nazi actions within Germany are concerned, though graciously reserving to us the privilege of continuing to hold and express views regarding Nazi action in the foreign field. Dr. John Murray has brought forward the novel idea that perhaps Hitler is the great demagogue in disguise. To use his own phrase, 'Hitler is not so very far from the kingdom of demagogues.'"

"It is an old idea that we get the sort of government we deserve. The writer, who is an American, hopes that Mr. Young, Sir John Marriott, and Dr. Murray will not get a Nazi government or anything like it. But if there are very many people who demagogues, it is not so far from really obstinately about the preservation of human rights and democratic processes of government, and who have paid no attention to the development of a technique by which those processes have been destroyed in one country after another, then there is ground for believing that that is precisely what they deserve."

"How long is 'suspension of judgment' to be continued? How long is to be the series of outrages against what in modern times has been considered honesty in act and truth in utterance, fair play for the weak, and a decent regard for contrary opinions? Before people may, without fear of offending against the amenities of gentlemanly conduct, express themselves? And what if those whom we do not criticize prove not to be grateful, but instead take silence for approval or as a sign that the rest of the world is already half-blind?"

The Curse of Conversion

A tremendous movement of Jewish conversion to Catholicism is going on in Poland. The center of it is in Warsaw, but cases of conversion are registered also in the provincial cities.

If the Polish government were in the habit of publishing monthly reports on the number of conversions taking place throughout the country, the world would be amazed to learn the extent to which Jews in Poland are leaving the Jewish community and joining the Catholic Church. Discriminated against as Jews, thousands of young men—most of them—seek with a higher education—a solution to their economic problems. Accepting Catholicism which opens the doors of certain institutions somewhat wider for them as "non-Jews."

It is impossible today in Poland to establish whether one is a Jew or a convert. You sit in a company and take the train with your companion is a Jew. Later you find out that a man who you have taken for a "good Jew" has long ago renounced his Jewish religion.

Push Children's Apostasy

Fathers who, for one or another reason, do not see their way to conversion, are only too happy to see their children go. The future of their children, they believe, would be better secured if they desert the Jewish religion while still in their teens. Most of the only several years ago considered mixed marriages the highest misfortune for a Jewish home, are now only too glad to see their sons marry with Polish girls, believing that such intermarriage will help them attain economic stability in the Poland of today.

The flood of baptisms which perhaps not cause so much worry to the Jewish communities in Poland, if it weren't for the fact that the government is making use of these converts to check Jewish communal life. Working under the assumption that "a Jew is more pliant than a Catholic," the Polish authorities are now appointing Jewish converts as government commissars for Jewish Community Councils throughout the country, and are thus handing over the supervision of Jewish communal life to elements that have deserted this life.

Regime Not Mistaken

And the Polish authorities are not mistaken in their assumption. The convert, becoming the representative of government in the administration of the Jewish Community, knows whom he is to serve. He knows that he is a government agent. Despising as Jews and Jews, he tries to serve his master to the best of his ability, and goes out of his way to heap trouble upon the Jewish communal institutions which he is to control.

The Polish authorities are happy. For the convert is the best "expert" on Jewish affairs and the most beloved "representative" of Jewish interests. Unhappy are, however, the real Jewish leaders—those leaders whose influence on Jewish life is being lowered almost to nothing by the appointed government commissars, deserters from the Jewish religion.

Helen G. Goldenberg has finally reached a point where the Jewish press in Poland has openly demanded that Polish Jewry be relieved from supervision of Jewish converts, and that the govern-

## Stir Created by Therniak Arrest

The Near East and India, semi-official organ of the British Colonial Office, reporting on the raid of the ICA offices in Turkey, states:

The arrest and the subsequent release of Mr. S. Therniak, who is the delegate in Istanbul of the Jewish Colonization Association, has caused a sensation which does not appear to have been limited to local quarters only. As the delegate of ICA, Mr. Therniak is a member of the Istanbul committee of the League of Nations, and, in that capacity, directs the evacuation of Russian Jews from Turkey. At the same time, he has been entrusted with the task of advising the British Consul-General in Istanbul in the distribution of labor visas for immigration into Palestine.

Mr. Therniak's arrest occurred in the office of the delegation of the ICA on May 26, and was maintained for two days. Part of the archives was seized and has been transferred to the General Direction of the Police; in a greater room has remained in the same room in the said office. Mr. Therniak and his subordinates' private rooms were also searched. According to one account, the decision was deliberately taken at a meeting of the Jewish leaders attended by Herr Hitler himself in March, when Herr Dürkel, the Nazi Commissioner for the Saar, reported that the Jews had "acted unpatriotically" in the plebiscite. The story perhaps obtains confirmation from the abusive leaflet which is being circulated in the Saar to encourage an anti-Jewish boycott as "a shining example to the whole Reich."

## To Hold Services For Bialik July 22

World Zionist Executive Asks Rabbis to Honor Memory Of Jewish Poet

Yesterday marked the first anniversary of the death of Chaim Nachman Bialik, the Jewish national poet. According to the Jewish calendar, however, the anniversary is the twenty-first day of Tammuz, which falls this year on July 22.

The executive of the World Zionist Organization in London has addressed a proclamation to its branches throughout the world, asking them to dedicate the day to Bialik's memory. The proclamation calls for observance of the anniversary with public meetings.

In connection with the anniversary, a campaign for funds will be launched and the receipts used for Hebrew cultural and educational work.

## I. Goldenberg Dead In Washington at 62

Headed Department Store in Capital Was Native Of Germany

WASHINGTON, July 18.—Federal services for Isaac Goldenberg, prominent Washington merchant who died here late Monday afternoon, was held yesterday morning with Dr. Abraham Simon of the Washington Congregation officiating. Interment was in the Washington Hebrew Congregation Cemetery.

## Chilean Poetess Voices Appeal For Refugees

### Gabriella Mistral Urges Countrymen to Shun Hitlerism

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

SANTIAGO, Chile, July 4—An appeal to the countrymen of South America to open their gates to Jewish immigration, and especially for refugees from Hitler Germany, was published here by the noted Chilean poetess, Gabriella Mistral, who is now Chilean Consul at Madrid.

The poetess published her plea in *El Mercurio*, the oldest and most influential newspaper in the country. The appeal called forth a warm and enthusiastic response by the entire press.

Mistral admonishes the South American peoples to reject the methods and prejudices of Nazi Germany, and not to follow in the footsteps of Hitler's cohorts whose actions are a reversion to medievalism. She enumerates a list of Jews who achieved greatness in every field of human endeavor, and whose virtues are of benefit to the whole of civilized humanity.

"The persecution of the Jews," Mistral stresses in her appeal, "has done the most heinous and harmful to the world even as much as to the Jews."

### Citroen Dead at 57; Was Jew by Birth

#### French 'Henry Ford' Never Played Any Role in Jewish Affairs

PARIS, July 4—Andre Citroen, French motor magnate, who died here yesterday at the age of 57, was born in Paris of Dutch-Jewish extraction. However, he never participated in any Jewish affairs.

M. Citroen was one of the most dramatic figures in French industry after the World War. Not many years before the war, he was an unknown engineer struggling for success. During the War he was in charge of the great arsenal at Rouanne, which turned out 55,000 shells per day. His organizing ability and inventive genius contributed greatly to the victory of the allied forces.

His methods of production earned for him the name of "the Henry Ford of France." But the depression and increased competition hit hard, and he was finally forced to turn his business over to creditors a few months ago.

Citroen had been ill for many months with a cancer in the stomach. This and his grief over the recent loss of a daughter, brought about his end.

### Jugoslav Prince Sees B'nai B'rith Leader

## Dr. Nirenstein, Noted Educator, Is Dead at 58

### Argentine Economist Was Friend of Prof. Einstein

BUENOS AIRES.—Dr. Maurizio Nirenstein, noted economist and literateur, and one of the leading personalities in Argentinian intellectual circles, is dead here. He was 58 years old.

Dr. Nirenstein came to Argentina as a young boy with his father, who was among the earliest Jewish immigrants to settle here. The Nirensteins came from Galicia.

The professor was secretary of the Buenos Aires University and lectured on philosophy and literature in the faculty of jurisprudence. He also wrote considerably, and his translation into Spanish of Heine's "Romanero" is considered among the best Spanish translations of the German-Jewish poet's works.

In his younger years Dr. Nirenstein came estranged from Jewish life, when he married the daughter of a local German scholar. His house was a typical Christian home, and his sons were raised in the Christian manner. This resulted in a great internal spiritual struggle, which became intensified after the "patriotic" anti-Semitic excesses in Buenos Aires in 1919, when his own son was one of the leaders of the patriotic anti-Semites.

This had such a tremendous effect on Dr. Nirenstein, that he again became interested in all things Jewish, and he was very active in Jewish literary circles here. He was a strong advocate for the establishment of a special chair for Hebrew literature and Judaism in the philosophy faculty here.

Dr. Nirenstein was a warm friend of Prof. Albert Einstein. Prof. Einstein had presented a picture to him on which was inscribed: "Wherever Nirenstein enters there peace doth reign."

Dr. Nirenstein was laid to rest at the aristocratic cemetery in Buenos Aires. His widow, who has a warm love for the Jews, did not permit any Christian rites to be performed. Leaders of Argentine and Jewish literary and educational circles eulogized him. Representatives of the various student bodies also participated.

### Argentina to Raise \$125,000 for JNF

Rabbi Zlotnick's report of recent new land acquisitions of the Jewish National Fund were received with enthusiasm.

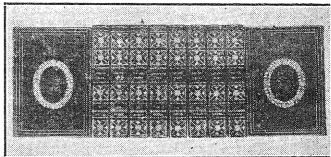

# Court Ruling Is Awaited By Kashruth Body

## Expect Verdict Tuesday In 'Plumbas' Suit by Poultry Firm

Supreme Court Justice Peter Schmuck is expected to give a decision Tuesday in the request of the S.S.B. Live Poultry Corp. for an injunction restraining the Kashruth Association of Greater New York from forcing the poultry market to use the association's plumbas, or leg bands, to attest that the fowl is kosher-slaughtered. In the hearing before Justice Schmuck, Allan Deutsch, counsel for the plaintiff, accused the association of "mercenary" motives. Rabbi Nachman H. Ebin, chairman of the association's administrative committee, replied with an affidavit declaring that the association was not only making no profit, but was incurring a deficit.

After hearing George Z. Medalle entered the case as counsel for the association.

### Explains Cost

Rabbi Ebin asserted that the suit constituted a challenge to the orthodox rabbinate and the Hebrew religious laws. He said that the plumbas cost the association \$130 a thousand and were sold to dealers for \$19 a thousand, the difference being consumed by salaries for supervisors and rabbis and by administrative expenses.

The plaintiff seeks to restrain the association from publishing statements that its product is not kosher because it does not use the leg bands.

### Rabbi Ousted for Aiding Poultry Firm's Suit

A rabbi who had allegedly signed an affidavit favorable to the S.S.B. Live Poultry Corp. in its suit against the Kashruth Association was stripped of membership in the Federation of Rabbis of Greater New York, an orthodox group, at the closing session of its convention Tuesday night.

The action was taken after Louis J. Grubis, associate counsel for the Kashruth Association, had appeared before the rabbis and asked their support. A resolution was adopted backing the association.

At the convention, Rabbi Israel Dushowitz announced his resignation from the presidency, a post he had held for a long time. No reason was given for the action.

On Rabbi Dushowitz's suggestion, a system was adopted whereby the organization's administrative committee will be the controlling body and the committee members will alternate as chairman.

## Germans Aid Jews In Syracuse Charity

The Atonal Choral Group of 75 voices, a unit of the German Societies, gave a program of songs, including "Die Lorelei" by Heinrich Heine, German-Jewish poet whose works are now taboo in Germany.

In offering praise to the celebration of the Jewish Home, the president of the German Societies stated that he wanted to show that the Jews and Germans in Syracuse are fellow-men, even though they may be of different racial descent.

## Davison Fund Gives \$2,500 to Jewish Charity

### Report 93 Groups Have Aided Federation's Brooklyn Drive

A \$2,500 gift by the Davison Fund established by John D. Rockefeller, Jr. to the Brooklyn Federation of Jewish Charities was reported yesterday by Joseph Salzman, chairman of the trade and membership council, chief fund-raising body of the Federation.

The report, which was made to Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, president of the Federation, urged continued support of its twenty-five agencies through the summer months "when the summer months of income is likely to be alarmingly disproportionate to the need, which is undiminished."

Ninety-three trades and professions have participated in the Federation's fund-raising activities this year, Mr. Salzman stated. The total funds raised to date amount to \$214,069.94, it was reported. Of this total, the women's division raised \$27,045.75, and the Junior Federation, \$15,000.

"There is every reason to believe that the majority of Federation supporters will not slacken their efforts during the summer months," Mr. Salzman informed Justice May. "The needy must be given care and service in the summer time as well as at any other time of the year."

Dr. Joseph J. Schwartz, executive director of the Federation, reported that "a number of our agencies find their burdens heavier because of the summer months. Special services must be provided to residents in many of the congested quarters of Brooklyn where the majority of our twenty-five agencies operate."

## Weekly in Kaunas Combats Prejudice

### Union of Lithuanian Jewish Banks Starts Publication to Fight False Reports

KAUNAS, July 4.—The Union of Jewish People's Banks has started publication of a weekly in the Lithuanian language to counteract the anti-Semitism that is finding expression in a large section of the Lithuanian press. The new publication publishes facts concerning various false reports about the Jews and their activity in Lithuania which find their way into newspapers here.

The latest manifestation of anti-Semitism occurred at the Kaunas University. The students of the medical faculty met to have a group picture taken, but the Lithuanian students refused to be photographed together with the Jewish students and demanded that the latter be photographed apart from the Lithuanian students.

In protest, the Jewish students refused to be included in the photograph at all.

## Jewish Groups Set World Parley Date

### Polish Federations to Meet in London Sept. 7 to Air Relief Problems

An international conference of federations of Polish Jews to consider relief for the Jews in Poland will be held in London September 7, it was announced yesterday.

The date was set so that the conference could be held right after the World Zionist Congress, which opens at Lucerne August 20. This was done at the request of the Federation of Polish Jews of Palestine.

Federations of the following countries will be represented at the parley: Great Britain, United States, Palestine, Argentina, France and Belgium. Communications have been sent to Jewish Jews in Canada, Cuba and Mexico asking them to send delegates.

Details of American participation in the conference will be worked out Monday at a meeting of the Federation of Polish Jews in America.

## British Youths to Work With German Refugees

## Statue to Lessing is Erected On Jewish Square in Vienna

VIENNA.—A statue to Gotthold Ephraim Lessing, famous German poet, dramatist and critic of 180 years ago, whose essays and plays stimulated the emancipation of the German Jews, has been erected in the Judenplatz (Jewish Square) here.

Jews were once burned alive in the square where the statue now stands. A tablet still remains with the inscription, "Jewish dogs were burned here."

In spite of this, when Vice Mayor Lahr announced that the name of the square had been changed to "Lessingplatz," there were some objections in Jewish circles.

The idea for the statue was conceived twenty years ago by a committee headed by the then Premier Ernst von Koerber and Josef Ungfer.

The unveiling was witnessed by leaders of Vienna intellectual circles and admirers of Lessing, including Chief Rabbi David Feuchtwang, Federal Council Frankfurt, Prof. Giesecke of the German People's Theatre and Dr. Fischer, historian.

The dedication address was made

by former Minister Oswald Redlich, president of the Academy of Sciences. The government was represented by Vice Mayor Lahr.

Herr Lahr pointed out that Lessing had described Vienna as a city where one is allowed to write and speak in freedom, adding: "Let us hope that Vienna will soon be such a city again."
