## Bar Rejects Racial Ban In Austria

Will Not Allow Planned  
Discrimination, Ass'n  
Resolves

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, July 5.—Declaring itself unequivocally opposed to the introduction of the racial principle in the legal profession the Union of Bar Associations for the whole of Austria today adopted a resolution calling for the preservation of status quo as regards admission into the bar associations, and also as regards the general set-up of these bodies.

This action came as a result of reports emanating from authoritative sources that the government was contemplating division of the present bar associations into two separate bodies, one for the "Aryans" and one for "non-Aryans."

The Government Plan

The government had also indicated that it desired a change in the method of electing members to the executive councils of the bar associations, and that instead of the previous system of direct elections, it would call for the substitution of a system of nominations subject to official approval of the candidates.

This was interpreted as being a direct move against the Jews, who form a majority of lawyers engaged in the legal profession in Vienna. Officially, however, it would appear that it was merely desired to exclude those lawyers who had migrated into Austria from the succession States after the War.

In its resolution, the Bar Association rejected any such action on

## Children Avoid Soviet Authors

Jewish Students Prefer  
Pre-Revolt Writers,  
Survey Reveals

MOSCOW, July 5.—Children in Soviet Jewish schools are not interested in the Soviet literature, a survey conducted in the New Zionist Jewish autonomous region shows.

The survey was carried out among the students of the higher classes. The children were asked which of the Soviet writers is their favorite. All without exception replied that they find no interest at all in the works of the new Soviet writers and that they preferred the works of Tolstoy, Gogol, Pushkin and other writers of the pre-revolutionary period.

With regard to Jewish writers the survey disclosed that the children have little interest in Jewish literature. They know very little about the Jewish writers of the pre-revolutionary era and have no regard for the works by the Jewish Communist authors.

## 12,000 Acres Owned By Jews in Cyprus

LONDON, July 5.—Reporting on the increase of Jewish colonization in Cyprus, an island in the Mediterranean slightly north of Palestine and under British control, the Morning Post states today that Jews now own about 12,000 acres on the island with a gross value of £72,000.

The largest Jewish settlements on Cyprus are located near Limassol and Famagusta.

## Palestine Boom Is Attributed to Jewish Capital

Immigration Is Cited by  
Bank Head as Behind  
General Prosperity

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 5.—A year of prosperity for all branches of trade in Palestine as a result of Jewish capital and immigration was described here at the annual general meeting of the shareholders of the Ottoman Bank which operates in Palestine.

Delivering the annual report, Sir Herbert A. Lawrence, chairman of the general meeting, pointed out that the prosperity in Palestine "has been due to the continued influx of Jewish immigrants and Jewish capital."

Sir Herbert emphasized that the imports into Palestine are too large as compared with the country's exports. This adverse trade balance, he said, he attributed to a greatly increased demand for foodstuffs and building materials caused by immigration.

"The difference," Sir Herbert explained, "is covered by subscriptions from abroad to Jewish institutions, capital expenditure of immigrants, and receipts from tourist traffic. The financial position is satisfactory. The prospects for 1935 are encouraging."

Sir Herbert also reported that the situation in Cyprus is also showing marked improvement due to the fact that Jews are beginning to take an interest in developing Cyprus.

## Grodno Police Refused to Protect Jews, Spread Anti-Semitic Rumors, Is Charge

WASHINGTON, July 5.—Grave charges that the police authorities in Grodno, Poland, are to a great extent responsible for the recent anti-Jewish riots here were made in a memorandum received here today by the Polish Embassy. The memorandum was submitted by the Federation of Polish Jews in America.

Emphasizing that "the Jews in a number of Polish cities are still apprehensive and panic-stricken" because of the riots, the memorandum for the Grodno anti-Jewish riots have not yet been published, the Federation inquires of the Polish Embassy here "as to what further steps the Polish government has

## New Boycott Unit Started In Poland

Jews Form League to  
Protect Polish  
Products'

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, July 5.—Following the announcement that the Anti-Hitler Committee in Poland might be officially liquidated, the most prominent Polish Jewish merchants organized a Jewish League for the Protection of Polish Products, it was learned here today.

An outline of the set-up of the new organization, whose declared purpose it is to boost the sale of Polish-made products in place of goods coming in from other countries, was forwarded today to the authorities for official approval.

The announcement that the Anti-Hitler Committee might be officially dissolved was made yesterday, together with a declaration from an official source that further activity of the Committee might endanger Poland's diplomatic relations with Germany.

Warn of Prosecution

Members of the Committee were at the same time warned that resumption of their boycott activities against Germany would entail legal prosecution.

Actually the Anti-Hitler Boycott Committee in Warsaw has been suppressed since June 19, when the police suddenly raided the headquarters of the organization, seized its records and confiscated the lists of its members throughout the country. The boycott offices were sealed, and the leaders were warned against continuing with their boycott against goods made in Nazi Germany.

The Jewish Telegraphic Agency reported on Tuesday that it had learned from authoritative sources that suppression of the Anti-Hitler Boycott Committee in Poland was one of the conditions made by the German representatives to the Polish government for a renewal of the German-Polish trade agreement.

taken to prevent the recurrence of murderous attacks on Jews."

The memorandum submitted is based upon authentic information compiled in Grodno. It charges the Grodno police with deliberately not protecting the Jewish population from the hoodlums and also with helping to spread the anti-Semitic rumors which led to the riots.

"This attitude on the part of the police authorities," the memorandum states, "makes it easy to understand why of the few hundred participants in the Grodno pogrom, only some fifteen have been placed behind bars, and why the evidence cited even against these fifteen is of the flimsiest possible."

## Amorous Arab Gets 30 Days for 1 Kiss

JERUSALEM, July 5.—For stealing a kiss from a Jewish girl in a public place, Ismail Sassi, a native Arab, was sentenced to one month in prison.

The Jewish girl was selling flags at a local charity bazaar. Hassan offered to buy one of the flags, and the offer was accepted by the girl who thought him Jewish. When, however, Hassan kissed her, the police were called and he was taken into custody.

## 582 Deserted Faith, Budapest Report Reveals

Jews Sought Refuge in  
Christianity from  
Race Prejudice

BUDAPEST, July 5.—A total of 582 Jews in Budapest were converted to Christianity in 1934. It was revealed here today for the first time when the annual report of the Budapest Jewish community was made public.

The report also expresses considerable alarm over the rising tendency of Budapest Jews to withdraw from the Jewish Community.

The greatest number of conversions, the report states, was recorded among the professional elements, who deserted their faith in the hope that they would thus be enabled to engage in the practice of their profession, unhampered by racial discrimination.

## Boasts Hitler Reads 'Stuermer' Diligently

PRAHA, July 5.—Hitler is a most diligent reader of Julius Streicher's anti-Semitic weekly Der Stuermer, according to a report made public here as the result of an interview given by Streicher to representatives of the press.

"The 'Stuermer,'" Streicher boasted to the gentlemen of the press, "is the only paper which Der Fuhrer Adolf Hitler reads from cover to cover."

## Reich Takes Vote From More Jews

25 Native-Born in New  
List of Disfranchised;  
Lawyers Hit

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 5.—The movement completely to disfranchise Jews in Germany gained further impetus today, when the Deutschvölkischer zentraler published its latest list of Jews who are deprived of German citizenship.

Twenty-five names of German-born Jews are contained in the list. In addition a large number of Jews are listed who were born in other countries but had become naturalized German citizens before the present regime came to power.

Ruling on Lawyers

The total elimination of even the few Jewish attorneys who were still permitted to practice in Germany is decreed today by the Labor Court at Magdeburg. The court ruled that while the practice of law involves the consideration of the race of both the attorney and the client, and that therefore a limited number of Jews had been permitted to continue defense of Jewish clients, this was only a temporary expedient.

The court declared that the time has come to call a halt. Jewish litigants will therefore not be allowed to employ Jewish barristers in the future, the court ordered, adding that otherwise there would always be a certain number of Jews.

## Austria Zionists Elect Delegates

Group 'B' and Laborites  
Win Two Mandates  
Each to Congress

VIENNA, July 5.—Seventy percent of all Jews holding Sholemik here went to the polls today to cast their votes for delegates to the World Zionist Congress to be held in Lucerne the week of August 29. Of the six mandates to which the Austrian Zionists are entitled, two went to the General Zionists in Group "B," two went to the Labor Zionists, one to the Jewish State Party, and one to the General Zionists of Group "A."

The remainder of the mandate is being contested by the Group "B" Zionists and the Jewish State Party.

## Caro, Jewish Chemist, Dies in Rome at 64

ROME, July 5.—Nicolao Caro, one of the foremost chemical technicians in Italy, died here today at the age of 64.

Caro was born in Lodz, Poland, in 1871, and lived for some time in Berlin. He was internationally known as an inventor and contributed many articles on scientific subjects to the foremost chemical journals.

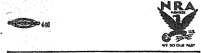

**Allentown, Pa.**  
Allentown Jews contributed \$1,500 to the United World Jewish Congress. In addition, \$250 was collected for the national fund and \$100 for the national chairman, Dr. Eliezer D. Berman, president of the campaign committee.

**Easton, Pa.**  
The Y.M.I.A. here has completed a successful campaign for \$3,000 to meet an outstanding deficit. The drive was directed by Reuben Moss, president.

**Hollister, Mo.**

# THIS WEEK'S EVENTS

Jewish life in America was overshadowed this week by the Zionist convention held in Atlantic City, and by the annual meeting of the American Conference of American Rabbis in Chicago.

It was for the first time that the Central Conference of American Rabbis elected to presidency a rabbi who is a Zionist. It was also for the first time that this Conference of reform rabbis adopted a neutral stand on the Jewish war in Palestine in place of its former attitude of opposition.

The Zionist rabbi who was elected president of the Conference is Dr. Felix A. Levy of Temple Emanu-El in Chicago.

There was an attempt at the Chicago convention to induce the participants not only to give up opposition to Zionism but take an outspokenly pro-Zionist attitude. This attempt was, however, foisted by the other members of the Central Conference. The decision on neutrality was reached as a compromise.

## Gained Attention Airing Public Issues

The Central Conference attracted a good deal of attention not only among Jews but also among non-Jewish circles in America, because of the many issues which it considered, including the issue of war. American Zionists, however, were disappointed in the Conference's decision on neutrality was reached as a compromise.

While a resolution "to refuse to support any war in which this country or another country may engage" was rejected by the Conference, the session decided that the American Zionists should formulate the Jewish attitude towards peace in relation to the Jewish view on war in past history. Thus, no definite stand was taken on the war and peace issue. The committee named will report its decision at the next convention.

## Rabbis Support Senator Nye's Program

While refraining from committing itself definitely on the war question, the Central Conference recommended that Congress adopt a program "without abatement," the program of the Committee headed by Senator Gerald P. Nye to take the present Congress up to date on the war but also out of the preparations for war. The Conference also went on record as opposing the American foreigner for a greater part of the military training in colleges, universities and high schools.

The question of marriage and divorce occupied a good deal of attention at the meeting. Recommendations of the American Jewish Rabbinate be trained to guide young people in the problems of marriage and family life. It was specified that courses on the subjects of marriage and family life be given in the temples.

## Uniform Laws On Marriage

A spirited discussion arose at the convention from a suggestion that uniform marriage laws be introduced in all the States. The delegates pointed out that if uniform marriage laws are adopted, the divorce laws would also have to be passed.

The Conference, however, adopted the recommendation urging separate Zionism far more than twice application for marriage license and its issuance, a thorough medical examination by a reputable physician by those contemplating marriage, and the of-

## fering of elementary courses in the problems of marriage and the family.

## The Zionist Convention at Atlantic City

Quite different from the Chicago gathering was the annual convention of the Zionist Organization of America held in Atlantic City. Taking place immediately after the election of delegates to the Zionist Congress, this conference was supposed to give expression to the attitude which the Zionists of America would like to adopt with regard to many problems concerning Palestine and, especially, the problem of the internal friction between the General Zionists and the Laborites.

The discussion at the convention in Atlantic City made it clear that the Zionist movement in America, though supporting the Laborites as labor unions, intends to fight the political anti-

tion of the Palestine Labor Federation to dominate the entire Zionist movement. Many bitter words were uttered by numerous speakers against those Zionist leaders in America who conducted pro-Histadrut propaganda during the recent elections of delegates to the Zionist Congress. Some of these leaders put forth the Histadrut propaganda by not being elected at the convention as delegates to the World Congress.

## Rothenberg Presents New Plan of Operation

The main issue at the Zionist convention in Atlantic City revolved around the question of how to enlarge the Zionist ranks in America. Mr. Morris Rothenberg, president of the Zionist Organization of America, rightly pointed out that there is a great need for the Zionist movement for Palestine, but this sentiment is not being properly utilized by the Zionist Organization.

Mr. Rothenberg therefore submitted to the convention a plan to convert the Zionist Organization of America into a body which would unite practically all the entire organized Jewry of the United States. He suggested that local committee be formed in each of the United States, comprising representatives of all the synagogues, temples, Jewish centers and other local organizations willing to participate in the work for Palestine. These committees would be given representation at the annual Zionist convention in America. The American Zionists, he pointed out, would thus have the right to speak not only in the name of a small group of organized Zionist members, but in behalf of practically all of American Jewry.

## Plans to Unite Zionists And Non-Zionists

Mr. Rothenberg also suggested a plan to bring together the

Zionists and non-Zionists in America into one united body which would have the right to elect the American representatives to the administrative council of the Jewish Agency and would thus lay a basis for a united body of Zionists and non-Zionists also in other countries.

As a result of recommendations made by Mr. Rothenberg a special committee was appointed at the convention to make sweeping changes in the Zionist Organization of America, after investigating all the details connected with the introduction of these changes.

The convention in Atlantic City also introduced an innovation into the constitution of the Z.O.A. by changing the administration from a governing council to an Executive which is to be organized along the same lines as the World Zionist Executive, with some of its members holding portfolios and being responsible to the entire Executive.

## Change Presages Wider Palestine Campaign

This change actually means that the newly elected administration at the convention intends seriously to start on a nationwide campaign to draft as many Jews as possible into active work for Palestine. With the 4,000,000 Jews in the United States, it is no wonder why the Zionist Organization of America should count only 18,000 members most of whom are as the recruitment of delegates to the Zionist Congress. The members on paper only.

The question of the barrier agreement between Nazi Germany and Palestine was one of the main items discussed at the Zionist convention. Most of the delegates felt that something should be done to prevent the growth of the Jewish ghetto in Palestine. The convention adopted a resolution urging the American delegates at the Zionist Congress to see to it that the Congress look into the matter and remedy the situation.

The delegates elected by the convention to represent the American Zionist Organization at the next World Zionist Congress received instructions to align themselves with Group "A" of the General Zionists which is composed of the American Zionists as the forthcoming president of the World Zionist Organization. Mr. Rothenberg was selected to represent the American Zionist Organization for another term and Mr. Lipsey, honorary president.

## People of Many Lands Find Home in Palestine

JERUSALEM.—The mixing process which is characteristic of the growth of the Jewish population in Palestine, is well illustrated in the rural settlement of the Jewish emek Jerzeel. The bulk of the settlers are from Pinsk, formerly Russia. Some months ago a party of young Jews from South Africa, who had been trained in the settlement, arrived and joined Gerat. They have mingled well, though they are the first organized group of settlement from South Africa, and despite their very different upbringing.

This month another group of thirteen Jews came from Germany to Gerat, assisted by the department for settling German Jews. They are studying Hebrew and local conditions, until they become assimilated.

## What Bulletin Readers Say

**Unity in Zionist Ranks**  
*To the Editor, Jewish Daily Bulletin:*  
It is told of Israel Zangwill, that just before his death, broken in heart and body, he declared: "I have wasted my life trying to unify the Jewish people."

With the approach of the 19th Zionist Congress—when the thoughts of Zionists, all over the world, are directed towards Luverne—the cardinal principle of unity must be considered.

For, if it be true that unity is the basis of all strength, then unity is greatly needed among our Zionists today. Was not Zionism the first real attempt to unify all lovers of Palestine for one purpose and one goal? And was not the Massada fortress for a greater unity in Israel, a unity between Zionists and non-Zionists, all over the world? But now, seven years after the historic conference of the Jewish Agency, we are more divided than united, more hindered than helped. There seems to have sprung into sporadic existence many separate "Zionisms" far removed from one another, each group undermining the work of the other; thus, instead of one Zionism, we have as many as many "Zionisms" as there are groups interpreting differently the term "Zionism."

Of course, it is to be expected that diversity of opinion should arise on a subject as vital as Zion-

ism is. Diversity of opinion helps, sometimes, to clear the goal and purpose of the cause, but when it becomes a "personal" question, a battle not "ishem shomayim"—for the sake of the cause—but for some personal or group end of an individual or group—then it means suicide.

We can well understand that since the death of Theodor Herzl, on July 3, 1904, since that time the course of Jewish life has assumed a new direction. Momentous changes have transpired affecting every group and every point of view. Zionism, too, had to undergo changes. But the goal of Zionism—the advancement of the Jewish renaissance movement, and the creation of a concrete basis for the Jewish Zionist organization—has remained the same. "Personal" questions must be left out at the annual American Zionist Congress, and also at the Ninth Zionist Congress. The purpose of the convention and the Congress should have as their main question the life or death of the Zionist movement. The Jewish people should consider, is growing more and more antipathetic towards Jews and Judaism, wherever and in whatever form Judaism may exist. It stands ready, therefore, had instead of fighting one another, all Jews should fight the common enemy.

# Einstein Evolves New Theory, Linking Up Space and Matter

## Builds a 'Cosmic Bridge' In Collaboration With Dr. N. Rosen

Prof. Albert Einstein's latest contribution to science is a "cosmic bridge" which will aid in linking the infinitesimal atom and the heavenly astronomic system into one unified system, it was disclosed on Friday.

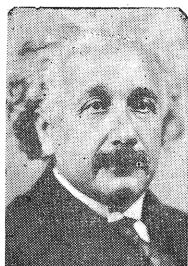
Working in collaboration with Dr. N. Rosen at the Institute of Advanced Study at Princeton, Prof. Einstein evolved a series of mathematical equations which prove that space and matter are phases of the same thing.

The announcement of the new theory was made in an article in the Physical Review. His new theory presupposes a new particle, much smaller and simpler than the previously discovered atom and proton.

This "bridge particle" between space and matter he obtained by combining the use of the mathematics of gravitation and electromagnetism. He concludes that a particle is mathematically a form of space.

## Argentine Jews Set For Sports Parley

### 12 Maccabi Clubs to Map Physical Culture Program For Youth

BUENOS AIRES, July 5—The first Congress of Jewish sports organizations in Argentina is scheduled to open here Sunday.

The Congress will last two days, and is being sponsored by the twelve Jewish Maccabi clubs in Argentina, which are affiliated with the International Maccabi Organization.

The leading Argentine Maccabi group is established in Buenos Aires. It has more than 1,000 members and is prominent in the local sports world. This club has already won a number of honors in contests with non-Jewish sports groups. It has secured special distinction in the boxing field, and this year won the silver cup for amateur boxing.

The sports groups of all Jewish youth organizations in the Argentine have been invited to partici-

pate in the Congress, the main function of which will be to develop a unified program of sport and physical culture for the Jewish youth in Argentina.

## Says Polish Jews Have Lowest Living Standard

WARSAW, July 5—"The substantial level of Polish Jewry is the lowest in the world," Dr. Leo Abramson, president of the World ORT Federation, declared in a farewell speech at a banquet tendered him here today prior to his leaving the country.

The economic structure of Polish Jewry can be rebuilt only by activities of the ORT which seeks to make the Jews productive and establish arable (cooperative work shops and trade-schools for them, he said.

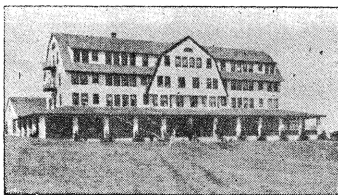

# Practical Zionism

By MRS. A. SILVERMAN

FROM the time I attended my first Zionist Congress in 1927, I realized then and I realize it even more today, that, admirable as it would be if Keren Hayesod could do all the colonization work needed in the land—and the need grows greater year by year as the refugees come pouring in—it is impossible for that organization to cope with the problem in its entirety. Particularly is this true when due to the falling off of Keren Hayesod collections all over the world, the money is not forthcoming to cover the monster budget necessary.

Furthermore, and this is most important, there are people with small means who can be, and want to be settled within already established colonies, and since the Keren Hayesod cannot and does not do this kind of settling, it is well that some one is doing it. These settlers are more than happy to be guided and settled by reputable development companies who do not go in for speculation and misrepresentation—it is to be deplored that there are all too few such trustworthy companies, the while there are far too many leeches and bloodsuckers in the land—so, a private company, properly named, properly organized, can do a tremendous piece of work supplementary to the work of the Keren Hayesod in the land.

DURING a visit to Palestine in 1933 I became interested in the completion of a plan for the formation of a "Geulah Hamsayim" (Waters company) and a building and developing company. We were bored and, to the rejoicing of the populace, water was found. And with the prospect of really finding water, the Jewish Development Company, Ltd., was organized, of which I was appointed chairman.

The Israel Development Company, Ltd., stresses and encourages the planting of trees in the land for Jewish consumption, namely mixed fruits and vegetables. About seventy-five per cent of the vegetables used by the Jews come from Arab, Christian, German, and out of the country sources. This is a tragic state of affairs. In addition, too, the amount of money sent out of the country is positively staggering. After ten years of experimentation in various sections of the land, it has been found that mixed fruits can be grown most successfully.

## Police Refused Aid To Grodno Jews

Describing in detail how the savage mob raged for several hours beating up every Jew it caught, stabbing many of them, breaking windows with rocks, and looting whatever they could lay their hands on, the memorandum emphasizes that "the authorities remained inactive until the municipal sanitation workers joined the hooligans."

Touching upon the anti-Jewish riots which followed the next evening in Forstadt, near Grodno, the memorandum declares that a detail of ten policemen would have been sufficient to check the hooligans from invading Forstadt. This detail was, however, not assigned by the authorities.

"The pogrom in Forstadt was even more terrible than in Grodno and lasted from ten o'clock in the evening until two the next morning without any interference whatever on the part of the authorities," the memorandum says.

The memorandum enumerates all Jews who were wounded by the hooligans and estimates the number of seriously injured Jews at more than fifty.

"That the hooligans felt perfect-

ly secure and immune in their daring activities and feared no interference on the part of the authorities is made perfectly obvious by the fact that they attacked and robbed Jews in the very center of the city, right near the Governor's residence and but a few steps away from the office of the local military headquarters," the memorandum points out.

Nazi Rowdies Fined

The higher court at Krefeld today increased the fine that had been imposed on two Nazi rowdies by the police court at Aachen for defacing a Jewish house, and passing signs all over it bearing insults to the Jews.

The two Nazis pleaded not guilty, contending that they were merely carrying out their official duties as regards the anti-Jewish campaign that had been decreed by Der Fuehrer himself. The defacement of the Jewish house, they maintained, was only the outward expression of the Nazi "Weltanschauung."

The advocate for the Jews, however, pointed out that no individuals in the Third Reich have the right to carry on the fight against the Jews by their own methods. "Hitler alone," he said, "has the right to determine precisely in what way the Jewish influence in Germany shall be extirpated."

Karl Holz, right-hand man of Julius Streicher, Germany's most fanatical Jew-hater, stated in a

speech at Dresden today that "Aryans" who happen to be employed by Jews should not be held to blame for the fact that there still are Jewish employers in Germany.

Tailor Mobbed

The Jewish owner of a tailor shop at Heidelberg was today taken into "protective custody" to save him from the wrath of a Nazi mob.

The mob was incensed with the Jew because he is alleged to have made insulting remarks to an "Aryan" in his employ.

The mob stormed the home of the Jewish tailor and demanded that the honor of the "Aryan" race be avenged for the insult which the Jew is alleged to have heaped upon it.

For the crime of cooling off in a swimming pool in Gnutzt in the company of a German girl, a Jewish youth was today forced to parade through the streets of Koenigsberg carrying a placard reading: "I Am the Jew Who in Crants Bathed with a German Girl."

The boy was followed through the streets by a large mob of enraged Hitler youth, who taunted him and hurled insulting epithets at him. When he finally broke from the crowd and tried to escape the mob beat him up.

## Santiago University To Give Hebrew Course

SANTIAGO, Chile.—The Santiago University will add a course in Hebrew to its curriculum as a result of the efforts of the Educational Department of the Chilean Zionist Federation.

The administration of the University has promised to make the course available for all students desiring to enroll for it.
