Nazis Order Factories to Flaunt Bias

Urge Posting of Anti-Semitic Slogans; 38 Jews Lose Vote

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 7—An order to post anti-Semitic slogans in all factories and offices in Berlin was issued today by local Nazi officials. The order advises particularly that extracts from the anti-Semitic weekly "Judenkennner" be posted in the factories. Special attention should be paid, the dictum states, to the slogan in this weekly demanding the death penalty for "Aryans" maintaining relations with Jews.

A list of thirty-eight more Jews whose citizenship has been withdrawn was made public by the authorities here. Withdrawal of citizenship from Jews is officially reported today from Breslau, Luebeck and Upper Bavaria.

Farm Offered to 'Aryans'

The Jewish settlement in Gross-Gaglow, which was liquidated recently by the Nazi authorities, has been offered to fifteen "Aryan" horticulturists, it was learned. The Gross-Gaglow Jewish settlement has been the largest Jewish training farm in Germany preparing Jewish youth for agricultural work in Palestine.

Paul Graupe, one of the leading art dealers in Germany, was forbidden by the Ministry of Propaganda to hold auctions, because of his alleged connections with Jews.

Anti-Jewish signs which were displayed in the bathing resort of Koenigstein were removed today by the local authorities. The Frankische Zeitung, one of Julius Streicher's anti-Semitic daily newspapers, was requested by the local authorities to announce that the anti-Jewish signs in Koenigstein were erected by irresponsible elements without the authorization of the local administration.

1,250 Went to Palestine From Poland Last Week

WARSAW, July 7—A total of 1,250 emigrants left Poland last week to settle in Palestine, it was disclosed today. In addition, eighty tourists went to visit the Holy Land.

Palestine to Permit Its Civilians to Fly

JERUSALEM, July 7—All Palestine citizens will be permitted to acquire private airplanes and to indulge in civil aviation, according to an official announcement published today by the Palestine government.

The announcement states that the government is prepared to encourage civil aviation in the country and that it has acquired a site for a special airport for this purpose in Lydda.

Sunday Laws To Be Relaxed By Hungary

Will Permit Jews to Keep Shops Open; Nazis To Reorganize

BUDAPEST, July 7—The relaxation of the Sunday Law in Hungary to enable the Jews there to keep their establishments open on Sundays, was promised today by Geza Bornemissza, Hungarian Minister of Trade, in a statement given to the press.

The promise was made because orthodox Jews do not keep their stores open on Saturdays and enforcement of the Sunday Law would actually mean that Jewish firms would have to suspend their business for two days.

"It will be of service also to the non-Jewish population if Jews are permitted to trade on Sunday," the Minister of Trade declared.

The failure of the Nazi movement to gain ground in Hungary was admitted today in an announcement by the Hungarian Nazi organization, known as the Pfeilkreuzler.

The announcement declares that the Nazi movement in Hungary will be reorganized and that new leaders will be appointed to develop greater activities.

In Jewish circles here it is believed that no matter how the Nazis reorganize their machinery in Hungary their activities will have no effect.

The publication of the first Hungarian-Hebrew dictionary is announced today in the new Jewish magazine "Beke" which started publication in Debrecin, Hungary.

Grain Plan Hits at Jews In Lithuania

Government Monopoly Of Trading Would Ruin Thousands

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

KAUNAS, July 7—Thousands of Jewish families are in danger of losing their livelihoods in Lithuania because of a new plan proposed by the government which will eliminate Jews from trading in grain.

This plan is considered of such serious import by the Jews that a meeting of grain merchants was held here today to decide upon measures to counteract the intentions of the government.

The government plan provides that the entire grain trade be concentrated under a few big cooperatives. If this project is carried out, it will mean in effect the complete elimination of Jews from the grain trade and the consequent economic ruin of thousands of Jewish families.

The grain industry is today practically the only field which has not yet been monopolized by the government or by cooperatives for generations in grain trading and in the export of grain abroad. The elimination of Jews from this field will not only affect the Jewish grain traders but also Jewish peddlers who deal with the peasants on the basis of bartering their goods for grain.

Kook Continues In Grave State

Dr. Desatti on Way from Paris to Examine Chief Rabbi

JERUSALEM, July 7—The condition of Chief Rabbi Abraham I. Hachohen Kook continues to be grave, although it is somewhat better today, his doctors announced.

Professor Desatti of Paris, noted Jewish physician, is expected to arrive here Wednesday for a consultation on the Rabbi's condition.

Thousands of Jews throughout the country are flocking to the synagogues daily to pray for Rabbi Kook's recovery. The gates before the sanatorium where Rabbi Kook is now under care are thronged with Jews eager to hear of the Rabbi's condition.

Jew to Represent Egypt At Language Congress

CAIRO, July 7—Max Maverhof, a Jew and a leading authority on Oriental languages, was today chosen to represent the Institute of Egypt at the forthcoming Congress of Orientalists which will take place in Rome.

Raphael al Adjem, another Jew and a high official in the Ministry of Agriculture, has been made an officer of the Academie Francaise by the French Government, it was also announced.

'Aryanism' Doubted, Reich Bars Jannings.

PRAHA, July 7—Emil Jennings, famous screen actor, has been forbidden to appear in German films because his "Aryanism" did not prove satisfactory to the Ministry of Propaganda, it is reported today from Berlin.

The report states that Otto Gebuehr, another wellknown German actor, has also been barred from German films by order of the Ministry of Propaganda on the charge that his "Aryan" origin has not been proven.

War Urged Upon Hitler By Catholics

Belgian Daily Demands World Boycott; Unity With Jews Sought

BRUSSELS, July 7—The demand that Catholics all over the world follow the Jewish example and start a world-wide boycott of German-made goods is voiced today in La Libre Belge, the leading Catholic daily of Belgium.

"A strong boycott of German goods by Catholics can greatly contribute to the termination of persecution of Catholics in Nazi Germany," the paper states. It adds that the position of the Catholics in Germany is worse than that of the Jews there.

Leading Catholic circles in Belgium, it is common knowledge here, are making an effort to induce the Vatican to issue a proclamation urging the Catholics of the world to join the boycott which the Jews are now conducting against products made in Germany.

Pact Would Aid Jews

In certain Catholic circles here the belief exists that the situation of the Jews as well as of the Catholics in Germany would be considerably ameliorated if the Vatican agreed to join hands with Jewish organizations and sponsor the anti-Nazi boycott movement.

It is pointed out here that a united front of the Vatican and representatives of the Jewish religion was affected several years ago when the Vatican was interested in raising a world-wide protest against the persecution of religion in Soviet Russia. This united front contributed greatly to the fact that practice of religion is no longer considered a crime in Russia.

It is believed here, consequently, that collaborative effort on the part of Catholic and Jewish religious forces against Germany, would produce a similar effect upon Nazi Germany and would force Hitler to soften his attitude towards the Catholics and the Jews in the Third Reich.

The recent renewed wave of repression practiced against priests and nuns in Germany has aroused Catholic sentiment throughout the world.

Jews Offer Best Resistance To Tuberculosis, Doctor Finds

LONDON, July 7—The resistance of Jews to tuberculosis is stronger than of non-Jews, according to an article in the British Medical Journal published here.

The article is written by Dr. E. Fischman and states that during the middle ages and up to the eighteenth century the Jews paid heavy tribute to tuberculosis, but since the beginning of the nine-

teenth century it is generally agreed that their resistance to the disease is much greater and the mortality much less than that of the surrounding population.

Acute form of tuberculosis are extremely rare among Jews, the article asserts. The disease, when it occurs, is showing a tendency to chronicity, thereby enabling the individual to lead an almost normal life.

Ore With Gold Content of 3% Reported Found in Holy Land

JERUSALEM, July 7—Gold has been discovered in Palestine near Hartur, the Falastin, Arab newspaper reports.

One taken from the mines contains three per cent gold, according to the Falastin. It is considered doubtful, however, that the mines can be exploited, since there is little water in the vicinity.

The new Palestine radio broadcasting station, the first permanent radio base in the Near East, will be dedicated and officially opened at the end of November, it was announced today.

A temporary radio station had been set up in Tel Aviv last year for the Levant Fair, but it was dismantled soon after the fair closed.

Proof of Prejudice in Austria

VIENNA. CHARGES made by the League of Jewish Front Soldiers in Austria of "a system which seeks to strangle the Jews in the same way as in the Third Reich" have aroused much interest and comment here, coming as they did on the eve of a visit of a delegation of members of the British Legion headed by Major Brunel Cohen, honorary treasurer of the British Legion, who lost both legs in the War.

The Judische Front, official organ of the Austrian league, reporting two cases of gross discrimination against Jews—one of them involving a Jewish war hero—protests that these are not isolated instances but are symptomatic of a general condition and system.

THE first case cited by the paper was that of a member of the League who had been house surgeon under contract for a home for the aged and an orphanage. He was suddenly dismissed and told that the action was taken because he was a Jew.

"The notification by the superior authorities also states that he was dismissed because of his membership in the Jewish race," the paper reports. "He tells us further that he was dependent upon the small salary that he received in the institution, that he has never taken part in political activity, that he is a member of the Fatherland Front, was on active service for three years during the War, two years uninterruptedly in the field, and holds the Silver Medal for Valor, the Bronze Medal for Valor, the Karl Military Cross and the Golden Service Cross and Band for Valor."

THESE are the dry facts of one concrete case. It is interesting in this connection to draw attention to a second case which occurred these last few days. The question concerned the admission of a boy to a Vienna grammar school. The director asked the boy's origin and the father explained that the maternal grandparents were Jews. The director thereupon refused to admit the boy, saying that the school was only for pure 'Aryan' children.

"Chancellor Dr. von Schuschnigg repeatedly declared in public here and abroad that the equality of the rights of the Jews in Austria is not restricted, that it is not only firmly anchored in the Austrian Constitution, but is part of the tradition of Austrian culture. Other members of the government have made similar declarations.

"As front soldiers, we have never doubted the honesty of the statement made by our Government of Front Fighters, and we have con-

sidered such occurrences as we have described as infringements by the subordinate officials. There is, however, such a large accumulation of such cases, extending to all spheres of economic life, that it is clear that these are not isolated cases, but a system which seeks to strangle the Jews in the same way as in the Third Reich.

"WE consider it therefore not only our right, but our duty as front soldiers to raise our voice honestly and openly in the protection of our coreligionists. We do this not only as upright men and proud Jews, but above all as good Austrians and loyal sons of this land for which we have bled and whose weal and woe is much more at our heart than at the heart of those who have made it their aim to exterminate Austrian Jewry.

"It is incredible to us that authoritative quarters have not yet recognized what purpose is being pursued by these saboteurs of Austrian unity, as the Chancellor has described them. They seek nothing more than to sow dissension in the ranks of loyal Austrians. Their fight goes much further than only against the Jews. That is demonstrated by the situation in the Third Reich. The fight is carried on along the line of least resistance in order to be afterwards carried further.

"TO National Socialism, Rome is no less hated than Judea. In the centuries of Jewish martyrdom, we have learnt that attacks against Jews succeed only when official quarters have actively promoted them or passively tolerated them. Where a government has with determination stood out against such attacks, they have soon been stopped. These are facts which are known not only to us who have been affected, but to all reasonably-thinking people.

"We are too much attached to our Fatherland Austria to stand by passively when the good name and the prestige of our homeland and the economic credit of our Austrian Fatherland are imperilled," it concludes.

200 A.Z.A. Chapters Attend 12th Convention

HOLLISTER, Mo., July 7—Two hundred United States and Canadian chapters of Aleph Zadik Aleph, junior order of B'nai B'rith, are represented at the twelfth international convention of the organization which opened here today with Irving Hill, president of the order, presiding.

The feature of the convention will be the international finals of the A.Z.A. oratorical contest. Prof. Selig Perlman of Wisconsin University will conduct a campfire forum on "Jobs for Jewish Youth." Harry Friedberg, vice president of the Zionist Organization of America, will lead a discussion on "Palestine and Jewish Youth."

Zangwill's Son Is Given Top Rating at Cambridge

Between the Lines

A Century of Jewish Emancipation
The centenary of Jewish emancipation in Great Britain is now being celebrated by the Jews in England.

A hundred years ago the Jews in England were poor and despised. A Jew was then not allowed to sit in Parliament. Not even Baron Lionel de Rothschild, who was elected Member of Parliament for the City of London. Bills to allow Jews to sit in the Chamber were passed in the House of Commons several times, but were always thrown out by the Lords.

Then, in 1858, the ice was broken. The consent of the Lords was finally obtained and on July 26 of that year Lord Rothschild took his seat. He was so delighted over the end of the long fight that he endowed a scholarship in the City of London School.

The First Jewish Mayor

But the actual emancipation of British Jewry does not start with Lord Rothschild's becoming a member of the Parliament. It starts with the appointment of David Salomons as Mayor of London in 1835. Salomons was the first Jew ever to be so honored by the city of London. His election was the first step towards removing all the civic and political disabilities of British Jewry.

The progress made by British Jewry during the Victorian reign towards its emancipation and the gaining of equal rights was chiefly due to the liberal attitude of Queen Victoria herself. The great Queen of England had no animosity whatsoever towards Jews. A few months after her accession to the throne she made history by knighting the first Jew. This was Sir Moses Montefiore, who received the title from the Queen personally on November 9, 1837.

With the bar removed, Sir Isaac Goldsmid was the first Jew to be made a baronet in 1841. The first to receive a peerage water was Lionel Rothschild.

The King and the Jews

The pro-Jewish sentiment introduced by Queen Victoria has become a tradition in the British Court. The King of England today has a great admiration for the Jewish people and though he has not so many personal Jewish friends as his father, King Edward VII, he has met nearly all the leading British Jews. His warm sentiments for the Jews were displayed best by him only a few weeks ago when on his Silver Jubilee he surprised Whitechapel—the Jewish section of London—with a special visit.

The complete emancipation of the Jews in England has not been regretted by the English people to this very day. The services rendered to Great Britain by such Jews as Lord Reading, the late General Sir John Monash, Sir Herbert Samuel, Sir Philip Sassoon, the late Lord Melchett and other outstanding figures in Jewish life in England and the acknowledgement received by these Jewish statesmen from the English people are the best proof that the anti-Semitic feeling now raging in Germany and other countries will find no root in England.

The Jews in England today are playing an honored and prominent part in almost every sphere of British life, without any handicap. They had to fight stiffly for their rights during the last century, but they have proved well worthy of these rights. Enjoying complete emancipation, the Jews in England are at the

Some Film Posers Put to Goebbels

In the form of an open letter to "Herr Doktor Goebbels", Nazi Minister of Propaganda, *Today's Cinema*, published in London, comments on the ruination of the German film industry as follows:

Misguided Zealot,—
You seem in a rather confused state.

Can't you make your mind up? On the one hand we receive news that you are modifying your previous attitude to the Jewish element in foreign films, pleading for a lifting of the embargo. You fear a counter embargo.

On the other hand it is reported that an even more bitter and ruthless persecution of the film industry has begun.

Firms are being struck off the register, wholesale, and films are being decimated so as to remove the baneful influence of Non-Aryanism.

A strangely muddled state of affairs, Herr Doktor.

That you made a very grave error, from your own point of view, in victimizing the Jewish members of the industry is now very clear.

Where is your foreign film trade?

It is virtually non-existent. Here and there, in a few—a very few—scattered quarters a German film is showing—mainly to an exclusive and highbrow audience. What few there are take some finding.

We do not know of one in England at this moment.

The great German industry which produced "Vaudeville," "The Last Laugh," "Destiny," and "Caligari" is only a memory. The industry which evolved geniuses like Pommer and Lubitsch, Grune and Veidt, is but a shadow, an insipid meaningless reflection of its masters' will.

Can it be wondered that some among you—possibly even yourself—are changing their tune, realizing that political and racial passion is but a poor moulder of industrial destiny—a paltry vehicle for national prestige.

We can well believe that influences will be brought to bear to arrest the rot, that there will be

same time devoted to Jewish interests, and no movement to convert them to Christianity has so far been successful.

some among you to whom this new recrudescence of physical and moral blackmail is a tragic policy. They, maybe you, may want to retract.

But it will be too late, then. The damage is done, irreparable damage to your industry, your nation and your own prestige.

Says Reich Acts Can't Be Forgotten

Pointing out that the fate of the Jews in Germany is becoming steadily worse and that all appeals to the "better nature" of Germany against the anti-Semitic barbarities of the Nazis have been of no avail, the *Manchester Guardian* says that these things cannot be overlooked in the present Anglo-German relations. Says the *Guardian*:

A good many friendly overtures have been made to Germany during the last few months. But whatever the policy of this country may be and whatever attitude the British people may choose to adopt, in the form whether of visits by ex-servicemen or of other courtesies or so-called "friendly gestures," the things that go on in Germany all the time must by no means be overlooked or forgotten. Some people are just indifferent to them; many weary of hearing an old tale of injustice; some say that other things as bad go on elsewhere; some that the "domestic affairs" of Germany are no concern of ours. But these things touch us all. If they happened in England, or France, or America, the rest of the world would have the right, and the duty, to protest as it has now when they still go on in Germany.

Cahan, 75, Says Anti-Semitism Will Wane as Depression Lifts

War Not Imminent in Europe, Editor Holds On Birthday

Seventy-five years old yesterday, Abraham Cahan, famous Jewish editor, novelist and Socialist, viewed the possibilities of a European war in the near future as very slight and predicted that anti-Semitism in Europe will decrease as economic conditions improve.

He was reached by the Jewish Daily Bulletin for an interview at a nearby seashore resort where he was spending the day quietly with Mrs. Cahan. If it hadn't been Sunday, he would have celebrated the cent working at his editor's desk of the Jewish Daily Forward Building.

As he interpreted European events, Mr. Cahan regarded war as unlikely because the dictators who rule Europe realize that war would be disastrous to their own power. "No dictator," he said, "can afford a war today."

Says Bias Will Wane

Discussing the question of anti-Semitism, he expressed the opinion that in every country except Germany where anti-Jewish sentiment exists, it is a result of economic depression and he predicted that when conditions improve anti-Semitism will wane.

In Germany, he continued, the anti-Jewish policy tends to be more political in character. "It is due," he said, "to the pressure which the allies exercised on Germany after the war, forcing the country to inaction."

He gave as a second cause of Hitlerism the propaganda of the German Communists in which, he said, they agitated against democracy and thereby paved the way for Hitler.

'Hitler Business Unreal'

"This Hitler business has never seemed real to me," Mr. Cahan declared. "It is too much like a nightmare. I always loved Germany and considered her in the forefront of the highest culture and progress."

But Mr. Cahan was optimistic about Palestine. He declared that the development of the Jewish homeland is "wonderful" and lauded the cultural contributions which refugee German Jews are making in Palestine.

Mr. Cahan recalled the day in 1897 when he first became editor of the Forward. "We had a lot of fanatics," he said, "who were well-meaning but didn't understand what a newspaper was. I saw things wouldn't work out, so I retired from the post."

Was Police Reporter

For five years he worked under Lincoln Steffens as police reporter for the Commercial-Advertiser. Then, in 1902, the Forward asked him to come back. He did—on the condition that he would have a free hand with the paper's editorial policy.

From a circulation of 6,500, Mr. Cahan built it up to 200,000, mainly featuring reader-interest material. "I used American methods of putting out a newspaper," he said. "We went out after human interest stuff. We expanded our news staff. We started a sports page." He recalled with a chuckle the furor that Socialists raised at the introduction of sports into the paper.

Mr. Cahan was born near Wilno, then part of Russia, in 1860. He came to the United States a poor immigrant and spent a great part of his life in New York's Jewish East Side. He became one of the founders of the first Socialist society in America. He was the first to make a Yiddish Socialist speech and he founded the first Jewish union in the country.

Hadassah Unit Adds 1,500 to Its Roster

Junior Group Now Has 11,500 Members; 15 New Groups Are Organized

(Special to the J.D.B.)

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., July 7—Junior Hadassah has gained 1,500 new members, bringing the total national membership to 11,500, it was announced here today by Miss Nell Ziff, national membership chairman of the organization.

Miss Ziff's report covers a one-year period to July 1. The increase is the largest recorded for Junior Hadassah since 1932.

During the past year fifteen new groups were organized, most of them in the east. Junior Hadassah groups now function in 200 cities in various parts of the country.

Miss Ziff also announced that Junior Hadassah raised its full administration budget of \$11,000.

One of her last acts of philanthropy before the Baroness Edmond de Rothschild died a few weeks ago was the contribution of \$7,500 to Hadassah to repair the Hadassah Hospital in Safed, Palestine, it was announced yesterday at the organization's headquarters here.

The property of the hospital building was given to Hadassah by the late Baron de Rothschild shortly after the World War and is the only hospital for tubercular patients in Palestine. In the last few years the condition of the building had become so bad that the hospital would shortly have had to be condemned as unsafe. No funds for repairs were available. When the situation was communicated to the Baroness she responded immediately with the gift. Extensive repairs are now possible.

H. A. Goodman, reporting on Kfar Hayovel, the colony established on the occasion of the Silver Jubilee of the Agudah, said that the central office of the Keren Hayishub had decided to place land at the disposal of the Pro-Palestine Fund for the purpose of the colony.

Louis B. Mayer of Los Angeles, head of Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Studios, and an outstanding leader of the motion picture industry, will share the west coast representation with former Governor Julius L. Meier of Portland, Oregon. Henry Wineman, Detroit; Aaron Waldheim, St. Louis; Sidney Lansburgh, Baltimore and Judge Phillip Forman, Trenton, are the other members selected for the country at large.

Those elected from New York are Carl Austrian, attorney, and Dr. Solomon Lowenstein, executive vice-president of the New York Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Organizations.

In order to relate the national bodies affiliated with the committee more closely to the organization, the following leaders in these bodies have been elected to serve on the governing body: Simon M. Goldsmith, grand master of the Free Sons of Israel; Louis Moss, president of the United Synagogue of America; Mrs. Maurice L. Goldman, chairman of the executive committee of the National Council of Jewish Women; John L. Bernstein, of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society; Mrs. David de Sola Pool, long actively engaged in the work of Hadassah, and Judge William B. Lewis, former grand master of Brith Sholom.

Last year, Marenberg was awarded the Mallory Medal for the best essay on the constitutionality of the National Industrial Recovery Act.

Says Reich Will Press Curb On Jewish Doctors

Nazi Medical Tourist '9' Predicts New Cuts In Their Numbers

The future policy of the German government will be to decrease further the number of Jewish doctors, Dr. Herman Brauneck, official spokesman of the sixty-three Nazi physicians who are here for a tour of the chief medical centers in this country, declared yesterday.

Exhibiting with pride a metal "No. 9" which he wears on his lapel, Dr. Brauneck explained that every physician wears a similar numbered tag and that they prefer to be addressed by number.

Explaining the attitude of the Nazis toward Jewish doctors, "No. 9" said:

"Jewish doctors will have to confine their practice to Jewish patients exclusively. As far as the government is concerned, only Jewish war veterans will be permitted to practice. "Aryans" will receive medical care from "Aryan" physicians, just as white people in America are treated by white physicians and Negroes by Negro doctors."

Asked how many Jewish doctors will be permitted to practice, Dr. Brauneck said he did not know, but that the number would be commensurate with the Jewish population. He said, however, that no force would be applied to "black 'Aryan' sheep" who stray from the fold and insist on being treated by Jewish doctors.

Court Halts Hamid In Harlem Picketing

Sufi Abdul Hamid, so-called "Black Hitler of Harlem," was enjoined from picketing the Lerner Company, a women's apparel store at 224 West 125th Street, by Supreme Court Justice Cotillo.

Greater Trade With Palestine Aim of Czechs

Consulate at Jerusalem Elevated to General Status

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

PHAHA, July 7—The Czechoslovakian Consulate in Jerusalem has been elevated to a Consulate General, as a result of the growing economic relations between Palestine and Czechoslovakia.

The Czechoslovakian-Palestine Chamber of Commerce reports that beginning next Spring, a new branch for the import of Palestine goods will be opened here. Vegetables grown in Palestine will be made available on the Czechoslovakian market.

The report states that Czechoslovakia is importing vegetables from Egypt, and that these same varieties are now being grown in Palestine with greater success. The importation of vegetables by Czechoslovakia has until now been hindered by certain transport and tariff regulations, but these, the report adds, will be settled during the present year.

The Chamber of Commerce also publishes a statement concerning the new Consulate General in Jerusalem. In welcoming the decision

of the government, it states that hitherto Czechoslovakia had been in a somewhat unique position in Palestine as it was the only European country not represented by a Consulate General there.

Tanned by Suns of Many Lands, Maccabi Cyclists Continue Tour

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Twelve Tel Aviv motorcyclists who have been touring the world as representatives of the Palestine Maccabi Association, will leave here for London Thursday.

Arriving in New York last Wednesday, the youths were received by Aldermanic President Bernard S. Deutsch who greeted them in behalf of the city. Previously, they had visited Atlantic City and the reception given them there completely halted the deliberations of the delegates to the Zionist convention.

The cyclists, tanned and hardened by their trip, told a Jewish Daily Bulletin representative that they had covered 14,000 miles by cycle since they left Tel Aviv last April. Their travels took them across the Egyptian desert to Alex-

andria. From there they sailed to Italy, traveled through Europe and finally sailed for Montreal where they began the last leg of their tour.

They covered Canada and entered the United States by way of Detroit. Once in this country, they spanned the continent, motoring to San Francisco and then east to New York.

Joseph Tamari and Zelig Reicher, leaders of the group, said that the purpose of the trip is to stimulate interest in the 1938 Maccabiah, or Jewish Olympics. They reported great success, especially in Canada where, they said, many Jewish communities had promised to organize Maccabi sports clubs.

After arriving in London, the cyclists intend to tour the Balkans and return to Palestine via Persia and Syria.
