Goga, Cuza Enter Pact In Rumania

2 Anti-Semitic Leaders Unite to Organize Christian Party

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
BUCHAREST, July 9—A united anti-Jewish front was created today in Rumania when Prof. Alexander Cuza, notorious anti-Jewish leader and president of the League of Christian National Defense, joined hands with Prof. Octavius Goga, leader of the Rumanian Fascist organization, for the purpose of organizing a National Christian Party.

The two professors, though united in their views against Jews, had previously been unable to find ground for common action. Goga, though conducting anti-Jewish propaganda, always refused to join the anti-Jewish league of which Cuza is the leader.

The agreement reached today between Prof. Cuza and Prof. Goga provides that the Anti-Jewish League for Christian National Defense is to be amalgamated with the party led by Prof. Goga into one body, the main object of which will be to further the demands for anti-Jewish restrictions in Rumania.

Pact Will Aid Vaida-Voevod
The amalgamation reached between the two anti-Semitic professors will be of great assistance to the anti-Jewish propaganda conducted by Dr. Vaida-Voevod, former premier of Rumania, it was pointed out here today. While Dr. Vaida-Voevod does not associate himself with the two professors, he will nevertheless enjoy the full support of the projected united anti-Semitic party as far as his anti-Jewish demands are concerned.

The opinion was also expressed today that the accord between Prof. Cuza and Prof. Goga may enable Dr. Vaida-Voevod to realize his ambition of again becoming the premier of Rumania.

Bolivia Orders Halt on Migration from Poland

WARSAW, July 9—The Bolivian Consul here announced today that he has received instructions from his government not to issue any more visas to immigrants from Poland.

Austrian Jews Accept View They Are Religious Group Only

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
VIENNA, July 9—The viewpoint of the Austrian government that the Jews are to be considered only as a religious community, was accepted by the Union of Austrian Jews in a communique issued today from the headquarters of the Union. The communique states that the Union of Austrian Jews fully agrees with the statement made by Prof. Mayer, head of the educational movement of the Vienna municipality, that he stands on the principle that the Jews are a religious community only.

At the same time the communique emphasizes that the Union of Austrian Jews repudiates in principle any separation of Christian and Jewish students in the educational institutions, on the ground that this would destroy the possibility that afterwards, as adult citizens belonging to different creeds, they work together for the common good of the country.

Mufti Tours Palestine To Halt Sale of Land

JERUSALEM, July 9—Demanding that Arabs stop selling their land to the Jews, the Grand Mufti, Moslem religious leader, today started on a propaganda tour throughout Palestine.

Addressing several thousand Arabs assembled to hear him at the Nablus Mosque, the Grand Mufti vigorously assailed those who sell their land to Jews. In selling to Jews, he warned, the Arabs "are strengthening their enemies."

Polish Rabbis To Oppose New Marriage Plan

Orthodox Body to Appeal to U. S. Jews to Ignore Divorce Clause

WARSAW, July 9—Contract marriages of the sort proposed by the Rabbinical Assembly of America at its recent conference will be combatted by the Agudath Harabonim, the association of Orthodox rabbis in Poland, according to a decision adopted today by the association.

An appeal will be sent by the Orthodox rabbis of Poland to American Jewry to ignore the decision of the Rabbinical Assembly which would allow a deserted wife to obtain a divorce automatically if her husband deserted her for a period of more than three years.

The decision of the Rabbinical Assembly was met here with tremendous criticism among the Orthodox rabbis. Especially condemned was that part of divorce law change which recommends that, before marrying, Jewish couples should be asked to sign a special provision in the marriage contract which would give the wife the right to obtain a divorce if she has not been supported by her husband for a period of three years, or if her husband has deserted her for that length of time.

"Parties obtaining divorces under this provision are, according to the Jewish law, liable to excommunication from the Jewish community," says the resolution of the Association of Orthodox Rabbis. The decision emphasizes that any woman who obtains a divorce under the "contract marriage" sponsored by the Rabbinical Assembly of America, will be forbidden to marry a Jewish man.

Tourist Visa System Hit In Commons

Only Jews Must Post Sum Prior to Palestine Trip, It Is Admitted

LONDON, July 9—Only Jewish tourists are required to post securities when applying for a visa to Palestine, it was admitted today in the House of Commons by Malcolm MacDonald, new Colonial Secretary, when pressed for an explanation of the rule by Col. Josiah Wedgwood.

Col. Wedgwood questioned MacDonald about the refusal of the Palestine government to issue a three-month tourist visa to A. Rosenblatt, a Liverpool Jew, on the grounds that he lacked the necessary sixty pounds security to insure his return to England when the three months are up.

Attacks System
Col. Wedgwood attacked this system of securities, pointing out that it works hardships for poor tourists who desire to visit Palestine and can pay for their passage, but lack the necessary security. He also showed how detrimental this is to Palestine, which is an attraction to tourists of all faiths and from all parts of the world.

In replying, Mr. MacDonald attempted to justify the security-rule by stating that it has proven to be the most effective check against illegal immigrants who come to the country as tourists, find jobs there, and then fail to return to their own countries when the allotted time is up. For that reason, he said, he will not ask the High Commissioner to reconsider this regulation.

Col. Wedgwood, however, refused to accept this answer. When

Ransom Is Paid For Harbin Boy

\$3,000 Wins Return of Railway Man's Son, Captive 26 Days

HARBIN, Manchukuo, July 9—After being confined for twenty-six days in a dark pit in a deserted field behind a Jewish cemetery here, Leib Mali, twenty-year-old kidnaped youth, was today returned to his father by the kidnapers. Protracted negotiations with the kidnapers finally induced them to accept \$3,000 instead of the \$15,000 they had originally demanded for the boy's return.

The youth was kidnaped by White Russians on June 10, in the vicinity of a Jewish synagogue in the heart of the Jewish district here. He was forced by his abductors to send a note to his father pleading that he pay the ransom and not notify the police, or he would be tortured and murdered.

Jacob Mali, the father, a former prominent contractor for the East China Railway, will leave with his son for Soviet Russia.

Dutch Princess Snubs Her Anti-Semitic Kin

THE HAGUE, July 9—Crown Princess Juliana of Holland today refused to attend the christening of the son of a member of the royal family, Prince Von Wied of Dierdorf, because of the latter's anti-Semitism.

The Crown Princess decided not to attend the christening after she received press reports pointing out that Dierdorf, the prince's ancestral seat, is plastered with anti-Semitic posters.

Soviet Allots 30 Millions For Work in Bureya

Power Stations, Cement Factory, 6 Mines Are New Projects

MOSCOW, July 9—Sixty million rubles (nominally about \$30,000,000) were allocated today by the Soviet government for the completion of various industrial enterprises in Biro-Bidjan in the next half year, it was announced here today.

The new enterprises to be developed in the autonomous Jewish region will include a large cement factory, six mines and several power stations to supply electricity to the district, it was announced.

At the same time it was reported that the number of Jewish settlers who made their homes in the Bureya during the last six months is twenty-five per cent below the number called for according to the plan for the settlement of the district.

A total of 2,529 new settlers came to Biro-Bidjan in the half year just ended.

Berlin Jews Cautioned To Act With Restraint

BERLIN, July 9—An appeal to the Jews of Berlin to conduct themselves with the utmost restraint, was today issued by the executive board of the Berlin Jewish Community.

The Jewish Community leaders urged especially that Jews be careful of their behavior in public places and restaurants, and not to let themselves be provoked by humiliating acts and ridicule of the Nazis, because the latter are looking for the least pretext to wreak their wrath on Jews.

Jews Target Of Attacks In Danzig

Set Upon in Streets for Failing to Salute Nazi Flags

DANZIG, July 9—A number of Jews were attacked on the streets here today for allegedly failing to salute Nazi banners.

These street attacks are occurring here with increasing frequency and indicate the intensification of anti-Jewish feeling in the Free City.

Resentment because of the difficult economic situation here is being fanned by Nazi anti-Semites into a flame of anti-Jewish feeling. Jews are generally blamed by the Nazis for the deflation of currency, which they themselves engineered.

Press Launches Drive
Headed by the anti-Semitic paper Vorposten, the entire local press has launched a bitter campaign against the Jews, blaming the economic distress of the Danzig populace on "Jewish Capitalists" and "Jewish Usurers."

About six weeks ago the Jewish Community of Danzig protested to the League of Nations against the acts of the Nazi-controlled Senate of the Free City. In a petition to the League Council, the Jews demanded that nine unconstitutional laws affecting the rights of the Jews in Danzig be abrogated, that changes be made in the Danzig administration to prevent anti-Jewish discrimination in the future, that adequate protection be given for all citizens of the Free City against defamation, and that strict measures be taken to halt the anti-Jewish boycott propaganda in Danzig. Although the president of the Danzig Senate declared that the Danzig government stood ready to repeal its anti-Jewish legislation if it was found to be unconstitutional, no efforts have been made in fact to curb the anti-Jewish activity in the Free City.

On the contrary, there is every evidence that the Senate is adhering to its policy as set forth in its reply given to the League of Nations. The Senate stated: "The Jewish situation in Danzig is growing worse because of the attitude of the local populace towards the Jews. It is not the task of the government to combat this attitude."

Leaders of the Jewish Community here are very much alarmed over the situation which is daily growing worse.

Butcher Code Body Bankrupt; Action Taken by Own Attorney

The Retail Kosher Meat Trade Code Authority has been thrown into involuntary bankruptcy by Nathan Langsam, one of its employees, it was learned yesterday.

Langsam, who was employed as associate counsel, said he hopes to collect through the action some portion of back wages due him. The Code Authority suspended business about two weeks before the NRA was invalidated by the Supreme Court, owing back wages to a number of employees.

It was found that the Code Authority had more than \$500 in cash besides other assets when it was thrown into bankruptcy. Employees and creditors have six months to file claims.

Fascism in France

PARIS.

THE growth of Fascism in France, handicapped by the failure of its leaders to seize their opportunities, nevertheless is a source of great concern to the believers and defenders of democracy and to the Left. It resulted in the last elections in a "united front" of Communists and Socialists which accounted for surprising Communist gains.

Since the municipal elections, France has gone through another Parliamentary crisis, resolved, for the time at least, by the establishment of the Laval government. A state of tension, however, strongly remains, partly due to the spread of many rumors as to the intentions of the Croix de Feu, the only important Fascist organization.

THE Croix de Feu, under the leadership of Col. de la Rocque, now numbers about 250,000 members. It has lately been most active in a series of giant rallies in France and North Africa. The Left has been most vocal in its alarms over the organization's fleet of thirty airplanes which participated in the Algiers Fascist rally. The organization, apparently, is well-financed—according to the Communist papers by the leading French industrialists.

The Croix de Feu, unlike the Camelots du Roi, are not openly anti-Semitic. Col. de la Rocque has been at pains to deny that the organization is anti-Semitic, recently sending a delegation to participate in services for Jewish war dead. The organization, however, is treated by the Jews with much reserve, since many of its members are known to harbor anti-Jewish feelings.

THE growth of the Croix de Feu and the increasing talk of dictatorship have been largely responsible for one significant development in French politics in recent weeks—the broadening of the Socialist-Communist "united front" into a "popular front" including the left-wing Radicals and the bourgeois elements. Among the names now to be associated with this movement are M. Deladier, Radical leader, and Leon Blum, the Socialist spokesman in the Chamber.

At a recent rally of anti-Fascist forces, M. Deladier, speaking for his party, stressed the need of co-operation between the proletariat and the bourgeoisie. M. Blum, speaking for himself rather than his party, expressed the conviction that the anti-Fascist forces would have to assume the duties of the government in order to secure France against Fascism. The Socialist party, he said, would support an anti-Fascist government.

Between the Lines

'Intourist' Patronizes 'Stuermer'

It was a very unpleasant surprise for me to read in the Manchester Guardian that the "Intourist," a Soviet travel agency which has branches also in New York, has taken advertising space in Der Stuermer, the Jew-baiting organ of the notorious Nazi leader, Julius Streicher.

Curiously enough the "Intourist" has inserted an advertisement in Der Stuermer inviting German tourists to the Moscow theatre festival which opens in September.

At a time when the Nazi government definitely prohibits its citizens from visiting Soviet Russia; at a time when the entire civilized world is boycotting Nazi trade; at a time when Der Stuermer is considered even in Germany an obscene sheet; at a time when this publication of Julius Streicher is devoted exclusively to anti-Jewish incitement—at such a time it is difficult to explain how the "Intourist," a Soviet government institution, has seen fit to patronize Der Stuermer with its advertising.

'Intourist' Must Explain

The leaders of the "Intourist" will have a hard job explaining what prompted them to insert their advertisement in such a publication as Der Stuermer which is as much opposed to Communists as it is to Jews. In the same issue where the advertisement of the "Intourist" appears one can read several attacks against Communism. Do the leaders of the "Intourist" believe that their paid advertisement will move Julius Streicher to cease his attacks against Soviet Russia? Do they sincerely assume that the readers of Der Stuermer are of an element which would be ready to visit Moscow for the theatre festival there?

The fact that a Soviet institution which is largely patronized by Jews abroad is helping to break the boycott against Nazi Germany by inserting advertisements in the most venomous anti-Jewish publication extant will disappoint many sincere friends of this institution. The Soviet government would certainly not wish to be held responsible for this irresponsible act of the "Intourist" leaders, but the "Intourist" office will no doubt invite upon itself a lot of justified criticism.

Soviet Funds to Streicher

The act of the "Intourist" could perhaps be reasonably explained if relations between Soviet Russia and Nazi Germany were normal. This is, however, not the case. Every newspaper reader knows that if Germany is now preparing for war it is conducting these preparations with an eye to crushing Soviet Russia. Under such circumstances how can Soviet money be paid to Nazi papers which are advocating the downfall of the Soviet government?

The Jews of the world felt very much embittered several days ago when the news came from Poland announcing that the Polish government has forbidden the Jews to conduct anti-Nazi boycott propaganda. This prohibition was a result of the secret agreement existing between Nazi Germany and the pro-Nazi Polish government which provides for the suppression of anti-German acts in Poland.

Whether the Polish government acted wisely in suppressing the anti-Nazi boycott conducted by Jews in Poland is a different matter, but one can imagine the resentment which an advertise-

Ban on Uniforms In Turkey

The Church Times of London, commenting on the latest ordinance in Turkey prohibiting clerical dress, says:

Only the Patriarchs of the Orthodox and Armenian Churches, the Moslem Grand Mufti, and the Jewish Grand Rabbi, are now allowed to appear in public in the robes that all clergy of the faiths in question have worn for centuries. The less-exalted must wear the ugly "reach-me-downs" that are an offence to the eye in the city that we must now call Istanbul.

The only people who now have the right to show their profession by their dress are the soldiers. All other distinctive uniforms are forbidden in obedience to the sacred principle of "laicisation."

Calls Jews Nation's 'Economic Conscience'

The Belfast Telegraph, a daily newspaper in Belfast, reports the following:

The Italian Marshal Badoglio has created something of a stir by contributing an article to the Rome newspaper "Popolo di Roma" in praise of the Jews and extolling their services in preserving world civilization by creating the "economic conscience of the nation."

The Marshal, who is not a Jew, declares that throughout the Middle Ages the persecution of the Jews forced them to accumulate their savings, which contributed materially to social developments. Without their aid civilization would not have achieved its greatest successes.

He defends the Jews against the charges of anti-patriotism and parasitism by recalling how many times they have come to the rescue of public authorities and extricated them from the most disastrous economic and political situations.

The Zweig Libretto And the Nazis

The News Chronicle, in an editorial on Stefan Zweig's libretto to Strauss' last operetta, comments:

So Herr Stefan Zweig—discreetly described as "the well-

The mistake ought to be rectified. The "Intourist" owes an explanation to the Jews for patronizing the vilest anti-Jewish newspaper in the world.

"I didn't," said the Jew. "We lost because there were too many Jewish officers in the armies of the enemy."

British-Reich Amity Draws Ire of Adams

Conservative M.P. Cites Army Bar on Jews Despite Hindenburg Praise

LONDON, July 9—An ironic commentary on the recent movement for friendship between British and German war veterans, inaugurated by the Prince of Wales, is furnished by Vyvyan Adams, Conservative member of the House of Commons, in a letter to The Times.

Describing the distinguished German-Jewish war record, Mr. Adams points out that "today in Germany the son can no longer wear the uniform in which his Jewish father fell," and quotes a letter by von Hindenburg extolling the Jewish heroes of the war.

"The survivors of the 96,000 Jews who served in the ranks of the German Army during the War have recently been excluded from German service organizations," he comments. "During the War, 2,000 Jews received commissions and 35,000 received decorations, including those implying the greatest distinction. Among the German dead were 12,000 Jews: no fewer than thirty of the 100 German Jewish air pilots fell in action."

"A little before his death one of them wrote in a letter: 'The bullets of the enemy have not learned how to discriminate between Jew and Gentile.' Today in Germany the son can no longer wear the uniform in which his Jewish father fell. Yet the late President Hindenburg wrote in acknowledging a book containing the names of all Jewish casualties: 'I shall include your book in my war library in honored memory of the Jewish comrades who gave their lives for their Fatherland.'"

Lvovitch Given \$15,150 for ORT At Fete Here

J.D.C. Adds \$10,000 at Luncheon in Honor of Three Leaders

A check for \$15,150 was given yesterday to Dr. David Lvovitch, vice-president of the World ORT Union, by the People's ORT Federation at a luncheon at the Hotel Commodore. The Joint Distribution Committee has contributed \$10,000 in addition to this sum, it was announced. The entire sum is to be used in furthering the activities of the ORT throughout the world.

The luncheon was given in honor of Dr. Lvovitch on the eve of his departure to Europe; Dr. Henry Moskowitz, chairman of the board of directors of the ORT Federation, who has returned from a lengthy tour of Europe and Palestine, and Louis B. Boudin, acting chairman, who will leave for Russia shortly.

Dr. Moskowitz, speaking first, expressed great admiration for the achievements in Palestine, especially in the agricultural field.

Mrs. Florence R. Dolewitz, president of the Women's ORT, announced receipt of a letter from Mrs. Albert Einstein accepting the honorary chairmanship of the Women's ORT of America.

Mr. Boudin reviewed the deplorable economic status of European Jewry and announced that Dr. Lvovitch will return to this country in September to start a national \$250,000 ORT campaign.

Dr. Lvovitch, in his address, thanked the People's ORT Federation and the J.D.C. for their understanding of the problems of European Jewry. Emphasizing the importance of the ORT, he declared that "it is not a charity organization, but a movement to revolutionize the economic and spiritual status of Jewry."

over France in the past year and resulted in the numerous restrictions on foreigners engaged in gainful occupations here, capped by recent enactment of a law prohibiting aliens from entering the practice of medicine.

The narrowing economic outlook was also responsible for the student riots which on occasion took an anti-Jewish aspect, and for the recrudescence, some time back, of Camelots du Roi rowdiness directed against the Jews.

For the present, anti-Fascist forces are united in a strong counter-movement to Fascism. The executive branch of the government is on record as firmly opposing Fascism and the French parliament, fearing dictatorship from any quarter, is equally opposed.

Fascism, in France, is not a force to be disregarded but for the present, it cannot be considered a menace. Time—and political expediency—will determine the stand of its attitude toward the Jews.

Anti-Hitler Leaflet Circulated in Reich

Quotes Promises He Made in 1933, Cites Failure to Keep Them

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 9—A leaflet surreptitiously distributed in Germany is described by a reader in a letter to the editor of the News-Chronicle here.

"When I was in Passau railway station, a leaflet was surreptitiously put into my hand," he writes. "On one side were two quotations from speeches made by Hitler, the first in 1933—

"Germans give us four years and then judge for yourselves."

"And the second in May of this year—

"No colonies, no raw materials, no capital, no foreign credits, only heavy burdens, sacrifice, taxes and little recompense."

"There followed question marks—'What will Hitler say in 1937?'"

"On the other side was depicted a blindfolded donkey—the worker—with the words: 'Are you still for the NSDAP?'"

Col. Evarts to Attend World Zionist Congress

HOLYOKE, Mass., July 9—Col. Benjamin Evarts, president of the New England Zionist Region, will be included in the delegation of the Zionist Organization of America which will attend the Nineteenth World Zionist Congress in Lucerne, it was announced here today. Mr. Evarts polled tenth in the elections held at the recent annual convention of the Zionist Organization at Atlantic City. The inability of several other delegates to take advantage of their mandates makes Mr. Evarts the next eligible delegate.

As president of the New England Zionist Region, Mr. Evarts brought forty delegates to the Zionist convention, one of the largest delegations sent by any part of the country.

Rabbi's Heirs Want Laborador; Claim It Was Gift of British King

Because 230 years ago Rabbi Joseph de la Penha of Portugal paid off a 2,000,000 guilden loan for King William III, a Jamaica, L. Urges Revival Of Old Church For Polish Jews

'Syria-Chaldaic' Branch Offered as Solution By Catholic Paper

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, July 9.—The reviving of the "Syria-Chaldaic" branch of the Roman Catholic Church is proposed as a means of solving the Jewish problem in Poland, by the Athenaeum Kaplanske, organ of the Catholic clergy in Poland.

The periodical sees in the "Jewish Christians," i.e., baptized Jews, the group to act as pioneers for the realization of such a plan. The German methods of solving the Jewish problem it regards as utterly impracticable and as un-Christian.

"At present," it writes, "the Jewish and the Christian communities have nothing in common and perhaps don't desire to have anything in common. The only group that would be able to bridge the gulf between these two communities are the 'Jewish Christians'. But at present this group is neither organized, nor does it want to retain anything Jewish. As soon as they leave the old faith, they strive very hard to separate themselves entirely from the Jewish people and to assimilate themselves with their non-Jewish surroundings. This is why the baptized Jews are liked by neither Jews nor Christians.

"The reason why only a few Jews embrace Christianity," the paper goes on, "is not because Jews are anxious to uphold their religion, but because of an hypertrophic Jewish nationalism which finds its expression in Zionism. To counteract the influence of Zionism, it would be necessary to organize the 'Jewish Christians'."

"The Jews have already played a role by spreading Christianity, but that was during the first centuries of the Christian era. The new Jewish promoters of Christianity ought not to lose their identity, but, on the contrary, should form a quite separate branch of the Church, the 'Syria-Chaldaic Church.' This 'Jewish' branch of the Catholic Church should then become the organism which in the end should absorb all Jews, and thus solve the Jewish problem... at least in Poland. This Church, of course, would have its own clergy, of Jewish descent, as non-Jewish Catholic clergymen are not able to understand the Jewish nationality."

"Such a solution," the Athenaeum Kaplanske concludes, "should induce the Jews to flock to Christianity, for the embracing of Catholicism would not force them to separate themselves from the Jewish people. All this, however, would not eliminate the most burning Jewish question in Poland, namely, the economic plight of the Jews, but would, nevertheless, mean a great step forward in this direction."

The paper winds up with a warning to take the matter in hand without any delay, as any procrastination would lessen the chances for the ultimate success of this plan of solving the Jewish problem.

Brooklyn AJC Honors Judge May on Birthday

A resolution congratulating Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May on his sixty-fifth birthday was adopted by the Brooklyn division of the American Jewish Congress last night at the Hotel Granada. A "birthday gift" in the form of 1,000 new A.J.C. members was pledged. Rabbi B. Leon Hurwitz and Magistrate Nathan D. Perlman spoke.

Liverpool U. Accepts Esperanto as Study

LIVERPOOL, July 9.—Esperanto, the international language recently ordered prohibited in Germany because it was the invention of a Polish-Jewish oculist, Dr. Zamenhoff, is now on the curriculum of Liverpool University. The university is the first in England and the second in all the world to give the language formal recognition.

Beginning with the Fall term, students for the B. A. degree may study Esperanto as one of the four subjects they are obliged to take in their first year, but the language will not count as one of the three examination subjects either for degrees or final term examinations.

Yiddish Writer Dies In Warsaw at 45

Leski-Koprowski Was on Staff of Dailies; Was to Cover Congress at Lucerne

WARSAW, July 9.—Leon Leski-Koprowski, well known Polish-Jewish journalist, died here today at the age of forty-five.

Mr. Leski-Koprowski had been for many years on the editorial staff of the Nasz Przegląd, a Polish-Jewish daily in Warsaw. He was also the expert political writer of the Moment, one of the largest Yiddish daily newspapers in Poland.

Mr. Leski-Koprowski was interested in the Zionist movement. He had been assigned by his paper to cover the World Zionist Congress which opens in Lucerne August 20. The Association of Jewish Journalists in Poland is making the arrangements for his funeral.

Clothing Trade Pledges Its Aid To Appeal Drive

Big Part of Quota Has Been Raised, Jaffee Says at Dinner

The sum of \$25,000 was pledged last night by the leading members of the clothing industry and allied trades toward the \$1,250,000 fund which the United Jewish Appeal is endeavoring to raise in Greater New York for the relief of German Jews, at a dinner held at the Metropolitan Club, 105 West Fifty-seventh Street. One hundred prominent members of the industry attended and were guests of Charles D. Jaffee, chairman of the clothing division.

Following the dinner, Mr. Jaffee announced that an intensive drive will be conducted in every branch of New York's clothing industry. Committees have already been set up, he said, in various sections. A large part of the quota of \$25,000 has already been obtained, he announced.

Speakers at the dinner included Dr. Henry Moskowitz, who has just returned from a trip to Europe and Palestine, William Rosenwald, national co-chairman of the United Jewish Appeal, and I. Edwin Goldwasser, co-chairman of the Greater New York campaign.

Mr. Rosenwald in his address gave a brief resume of the status of the Jews of Europe.

"There are still a half-million Jews in Germany," he said, "who have withstood the terrific economic, social and psychological pressure the last two years and who are threatened today with further indignities and oppression, who despite all this are maintaining their dignity. There are 3,000,000 Jews in Poland and a third of these are actually starving."

Polish Mizrahi Refuses To Boycott Sejm Vote

WARSAW, July 9.—A decision not to join in the boycott of the forthcoming election to the Polish Sejm, was adopted here today at a meeting of the Mizrahi, religious Zionist organization.

The Mizrahi also expressed itself in favor of a united Jewish front at the elections so that the Jews may win the six seats allotted them under the new election laws.

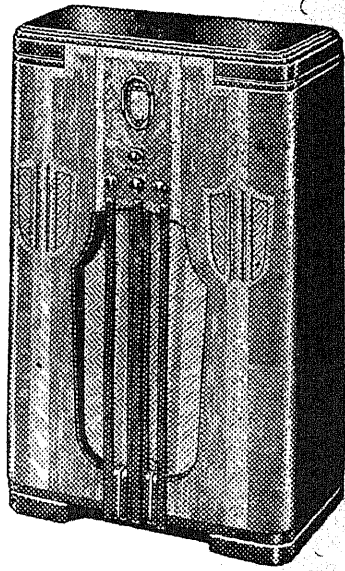

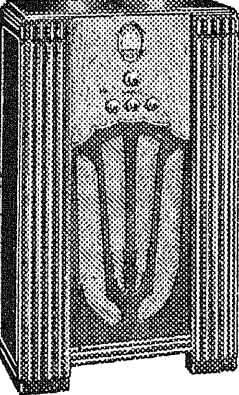
